(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foot strap, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the foot strap;

FIG. 2 is a medial side view of the foot strap;

FIG. 3 is a lateral side view of the foot strap;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the foot strap;

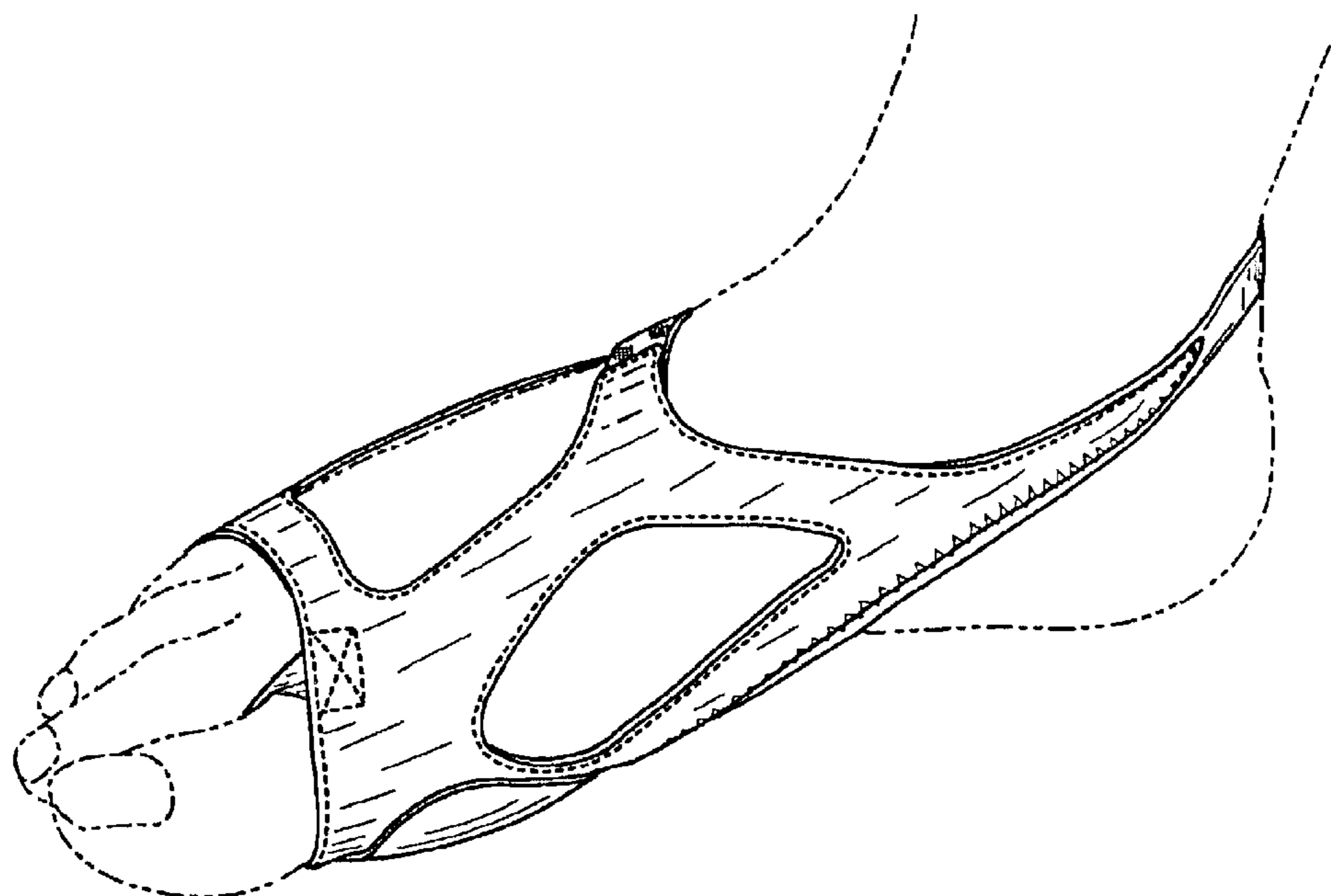
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the foot strap;

FIG. 6 is a front view of the foot strap; and,

FIG. 7 is a rear view of the foot strap.

The foot strap shown in FIGS. 1–7 is a right foot strap. The left foot strap is a mirror image of the right foot strap. Elements in the figures shown in uneven broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

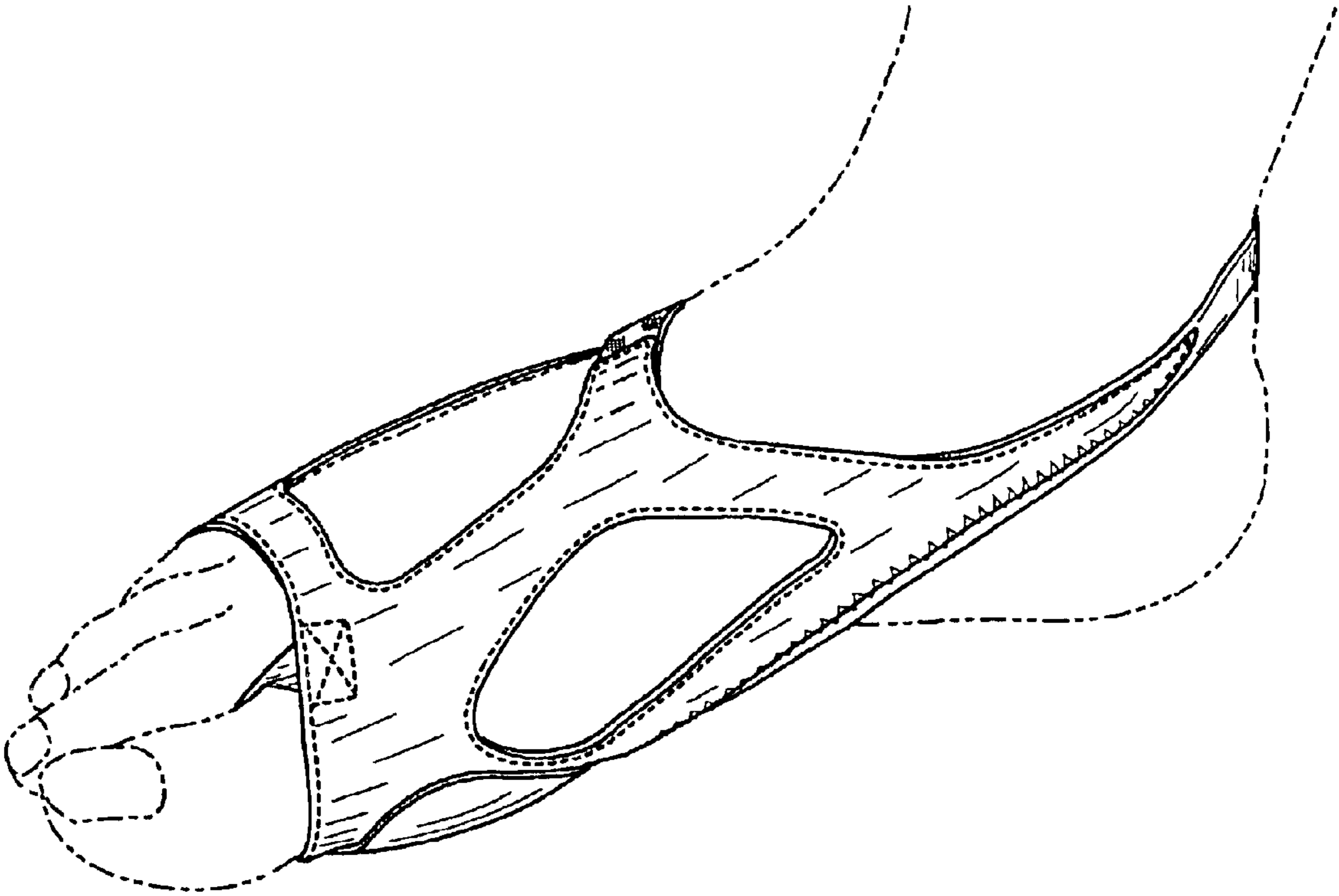

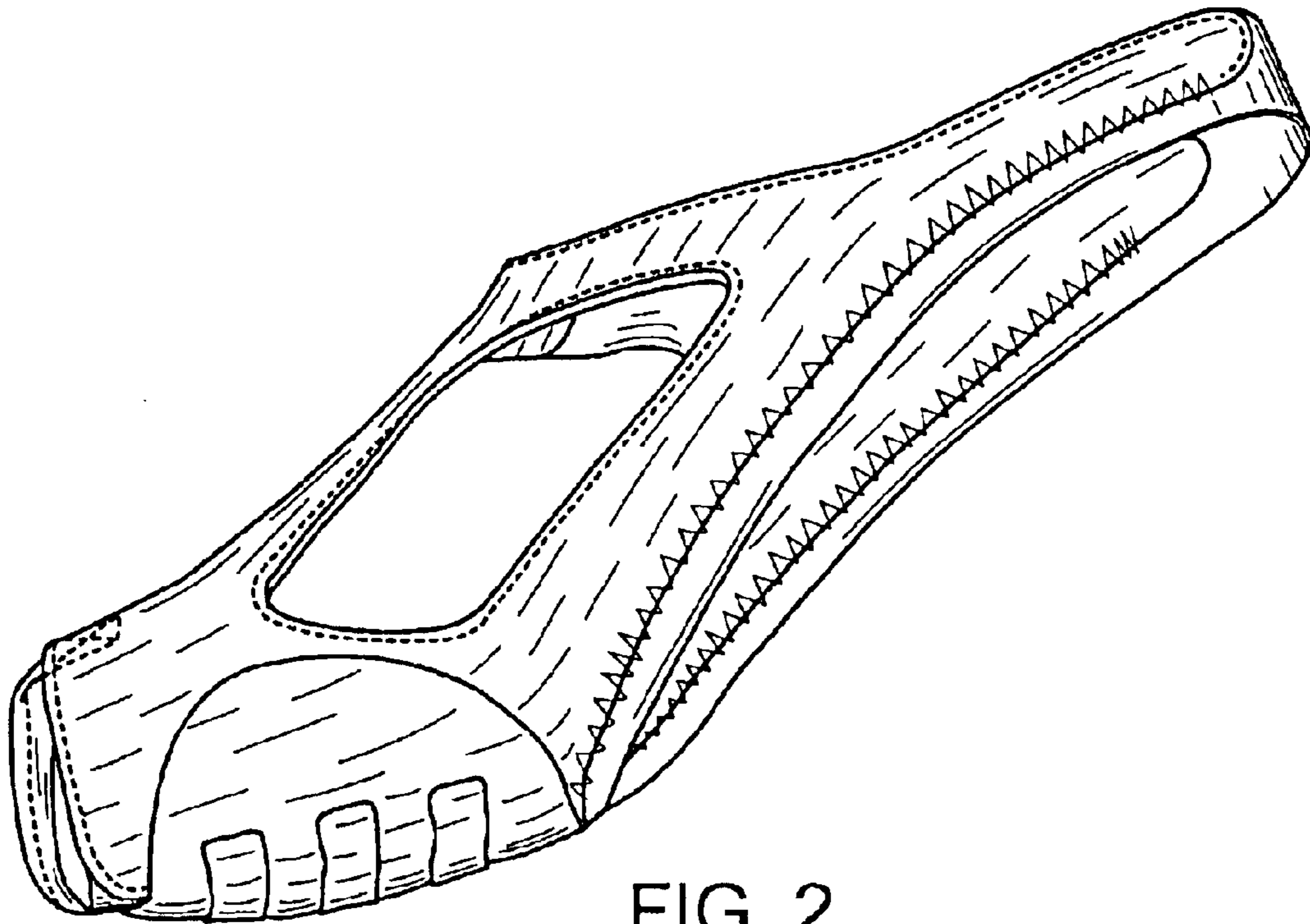

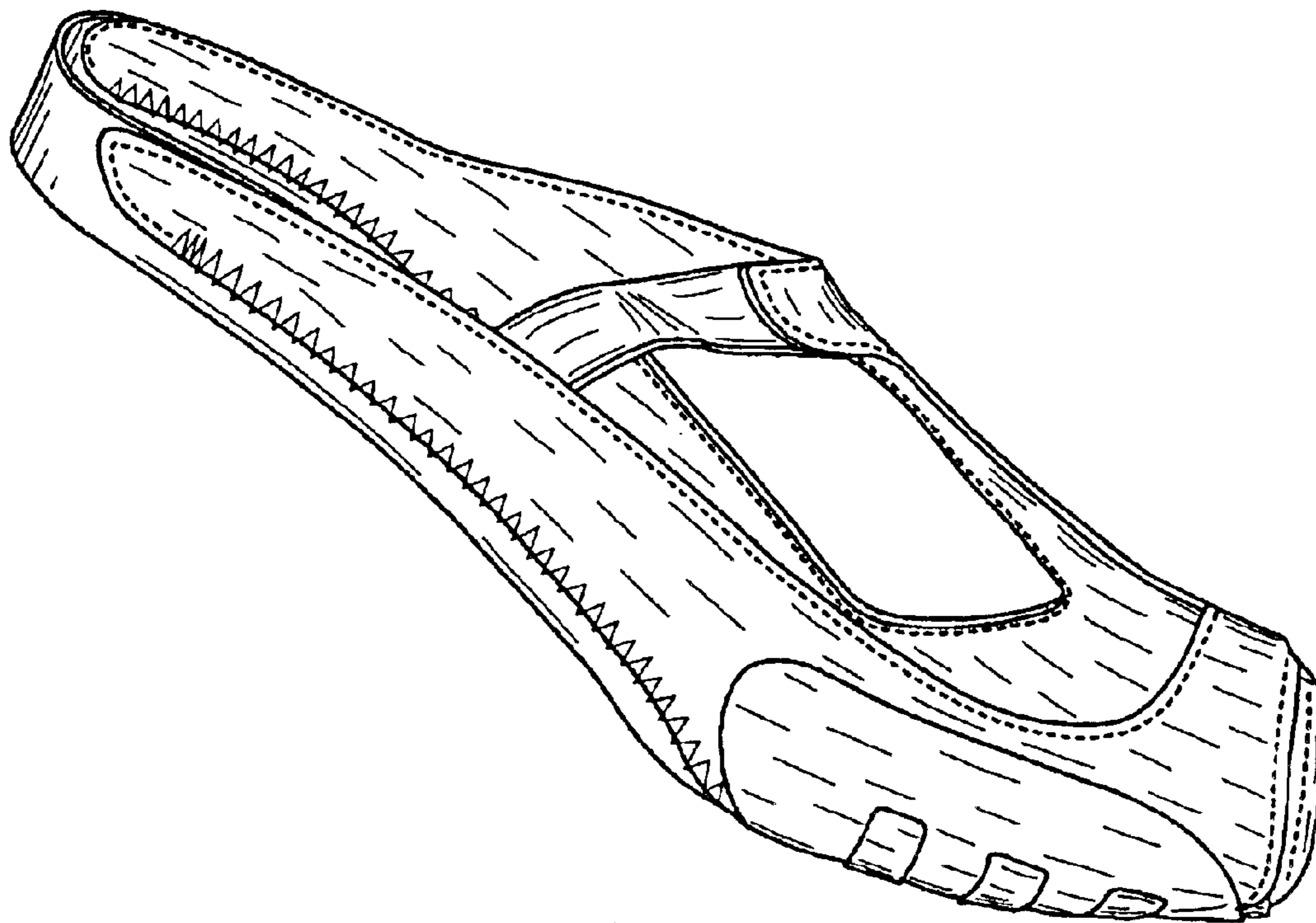

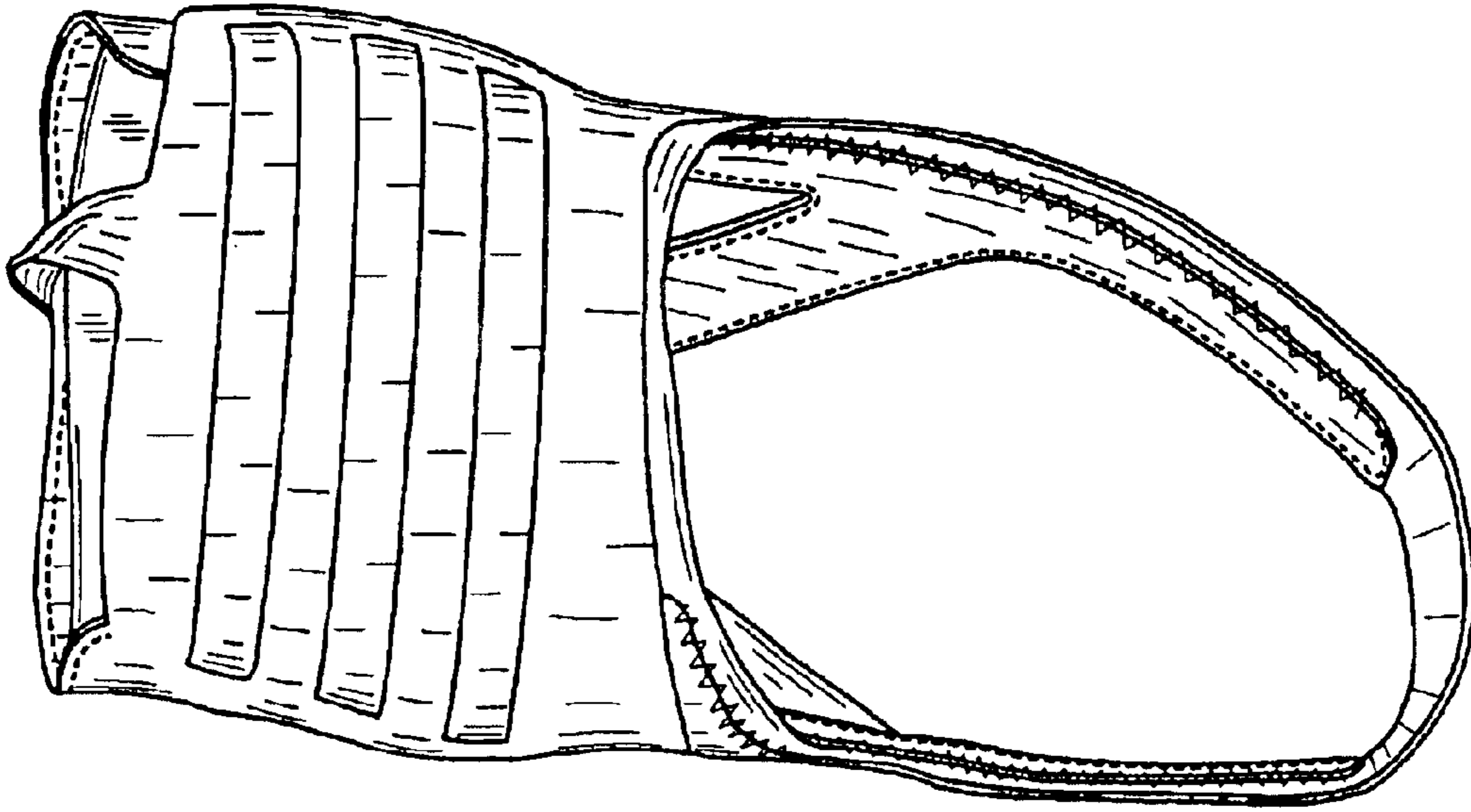

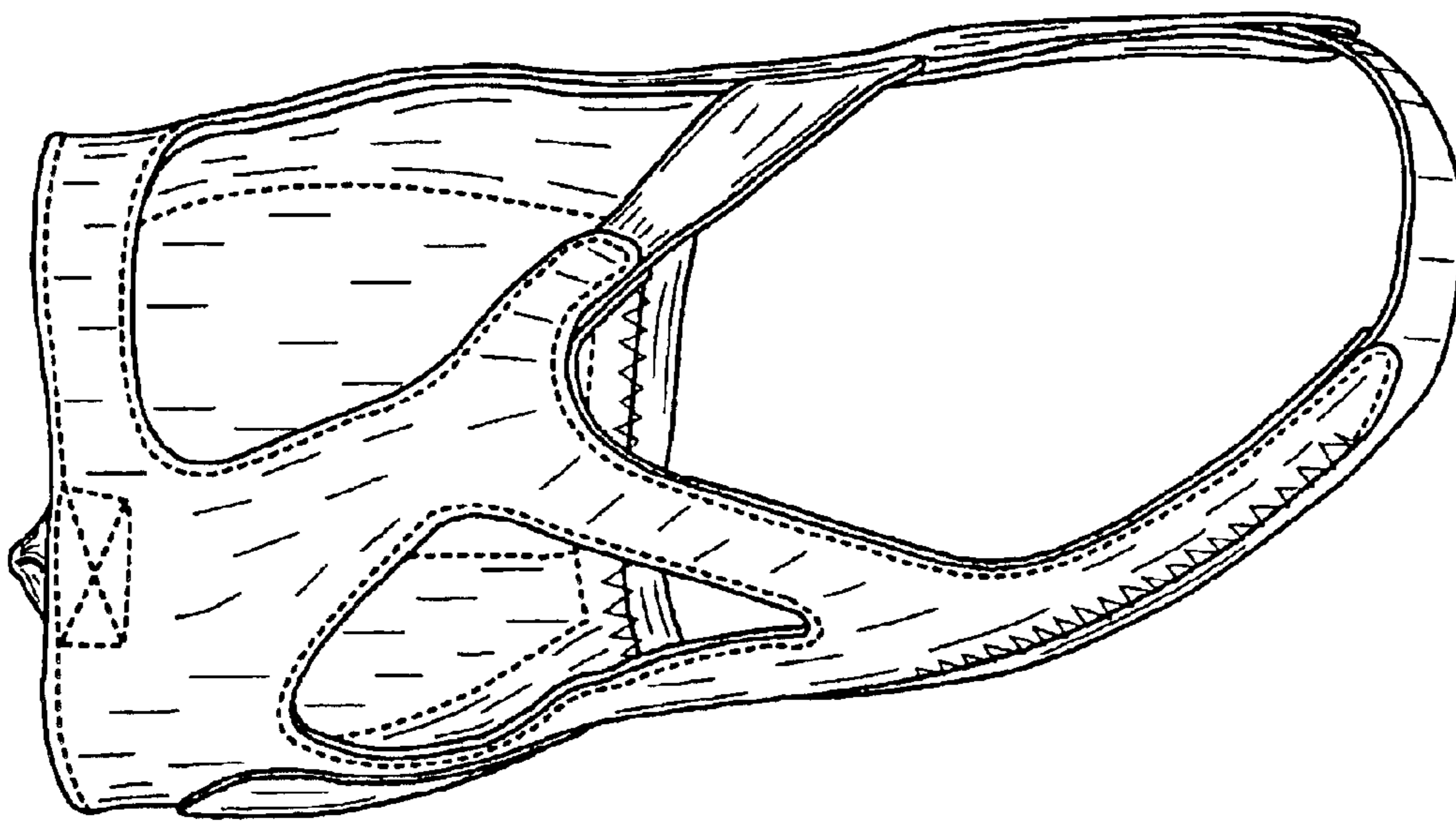

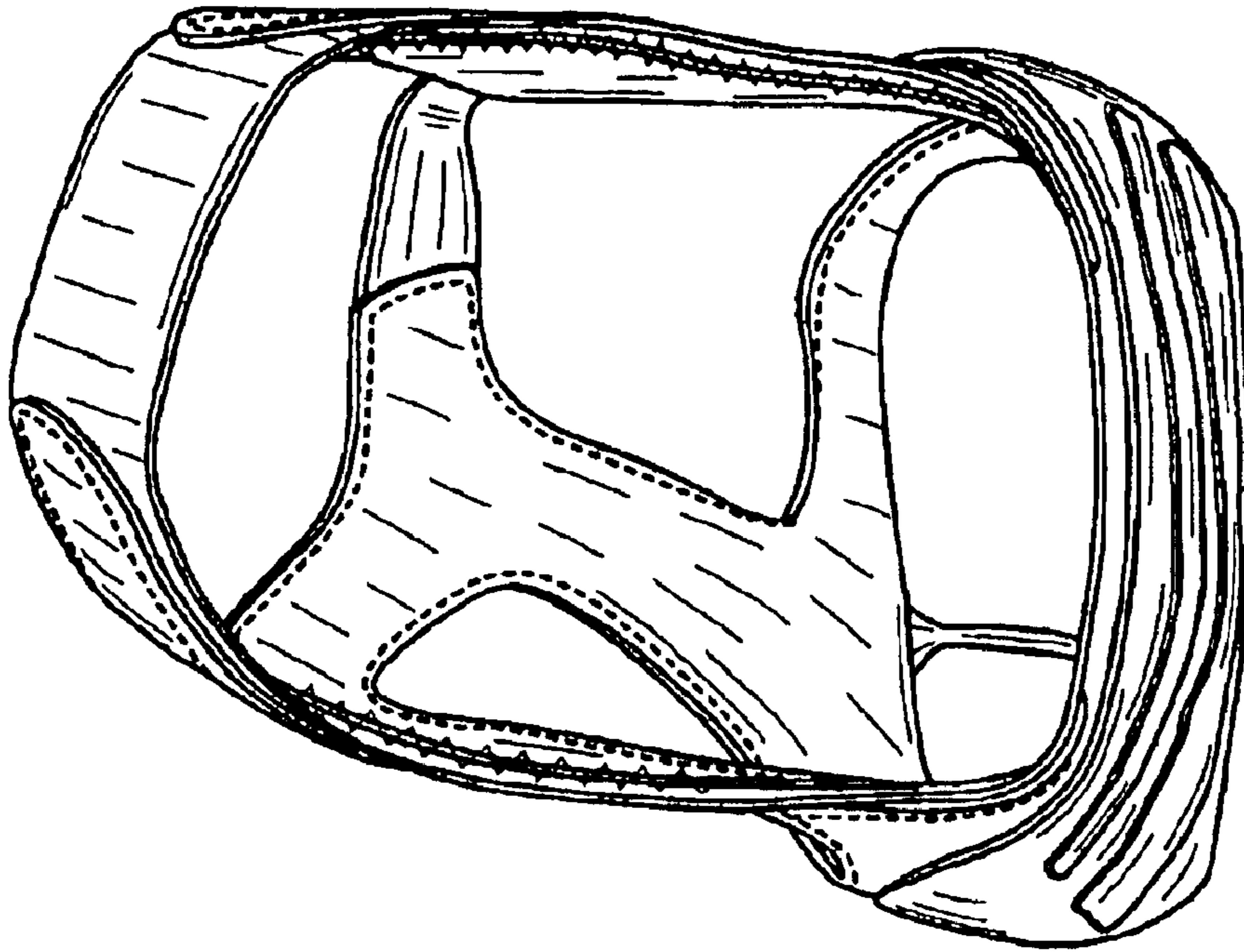

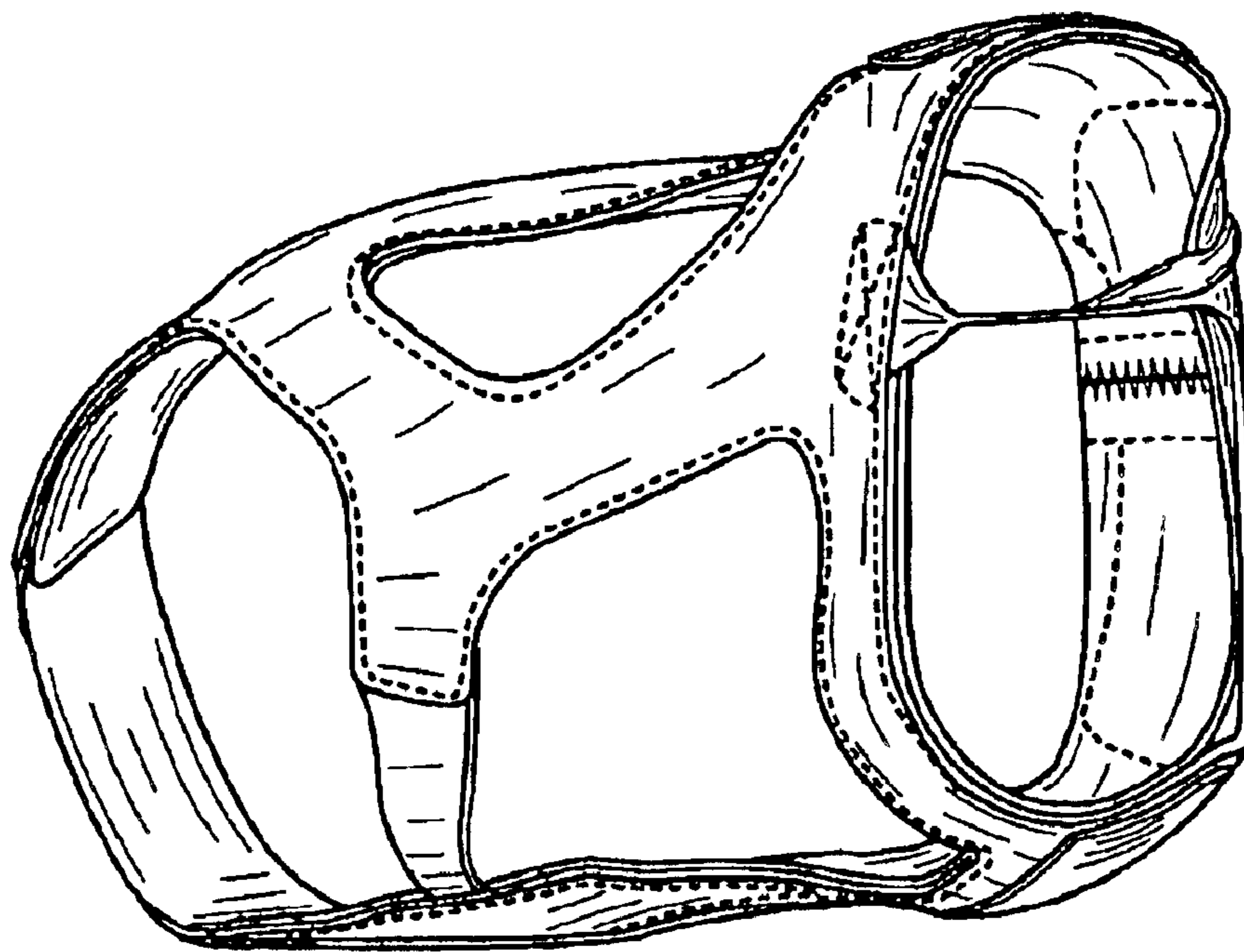
