FIG. 2 is a first side elevational view thereof;

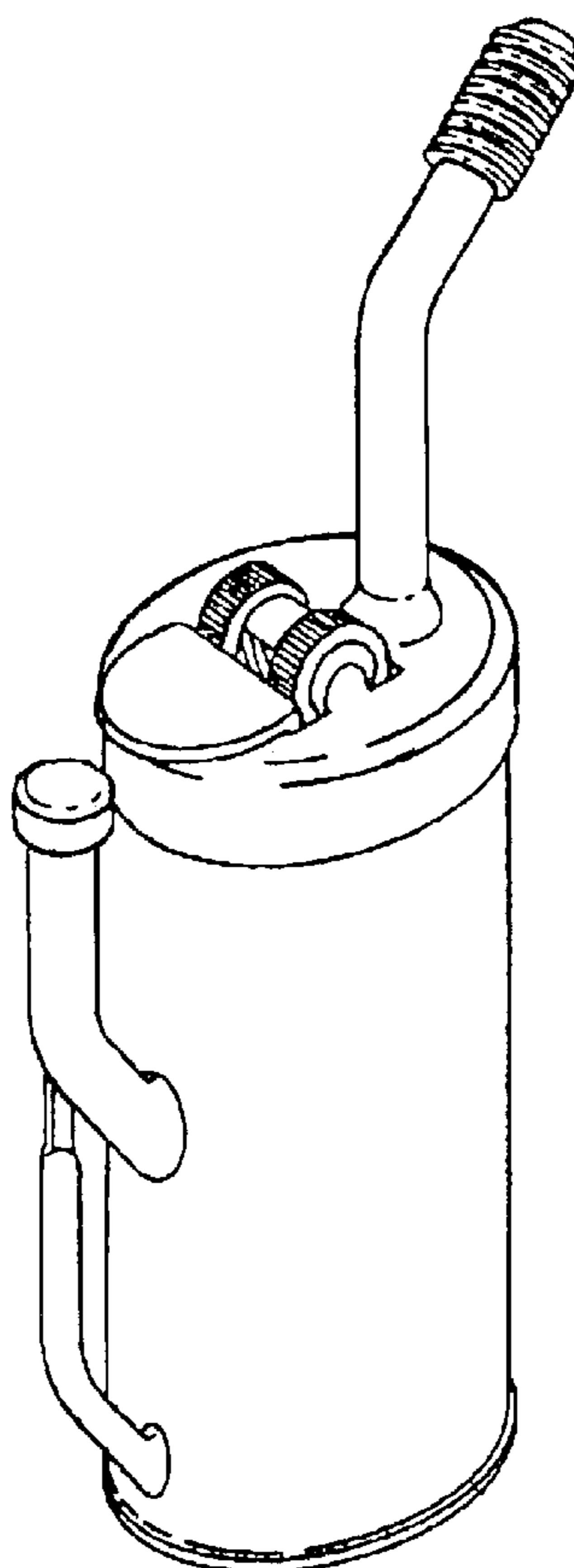
FIG. 3 is a second side elevational view as seen 180 degrees

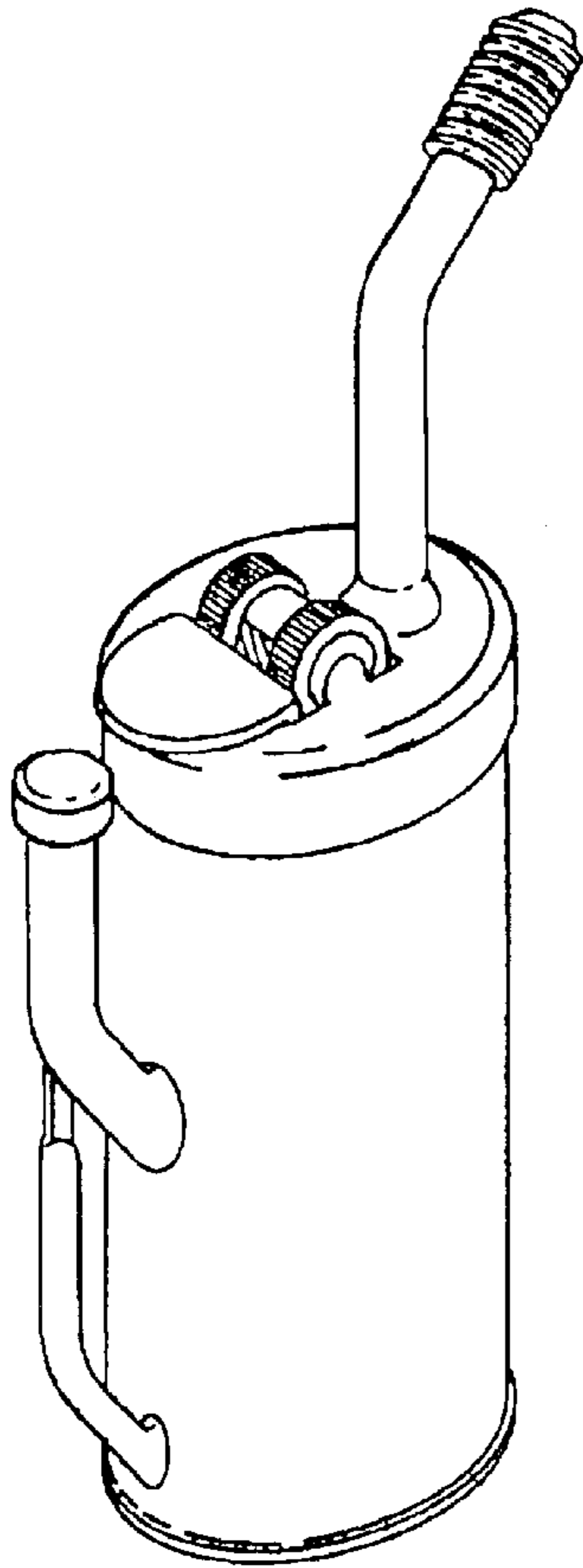

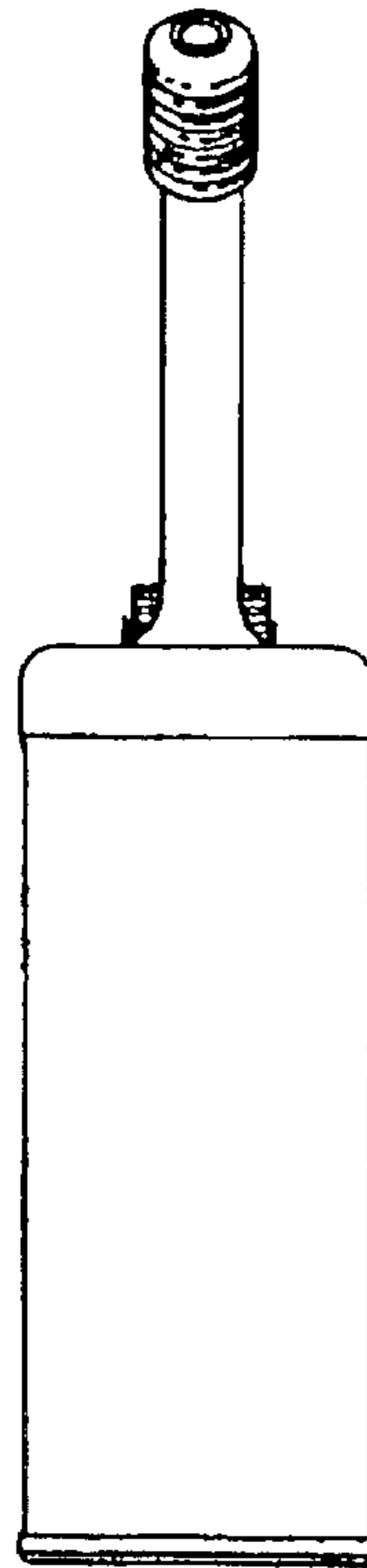

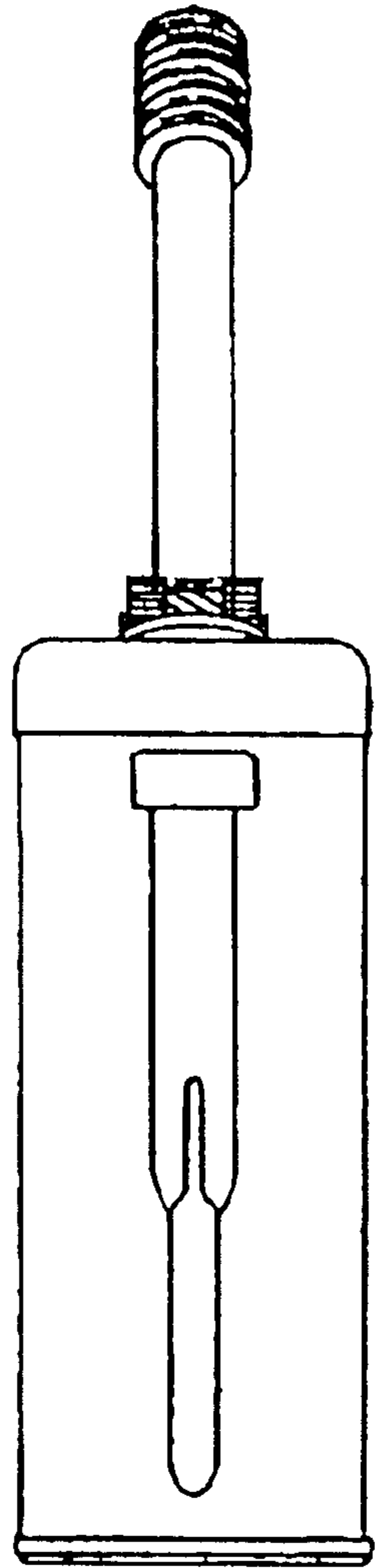

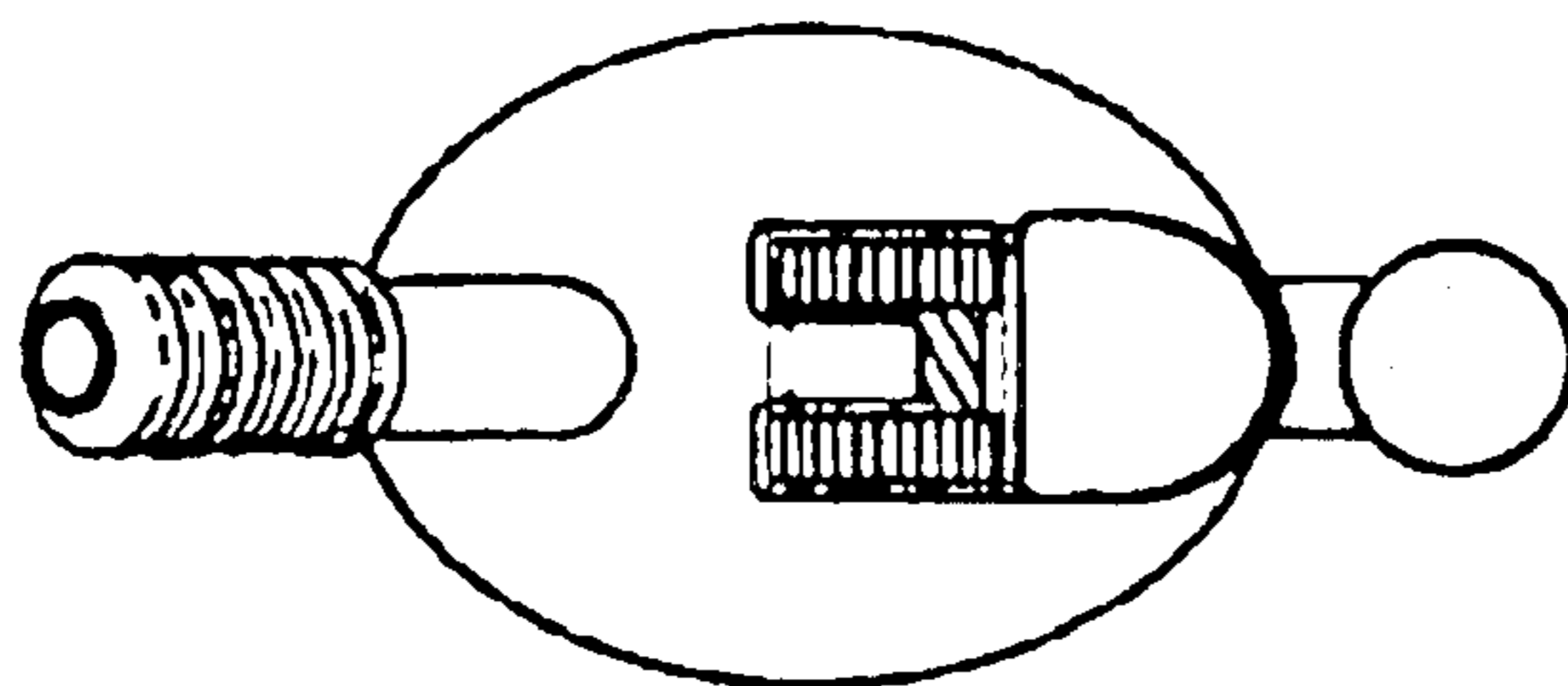

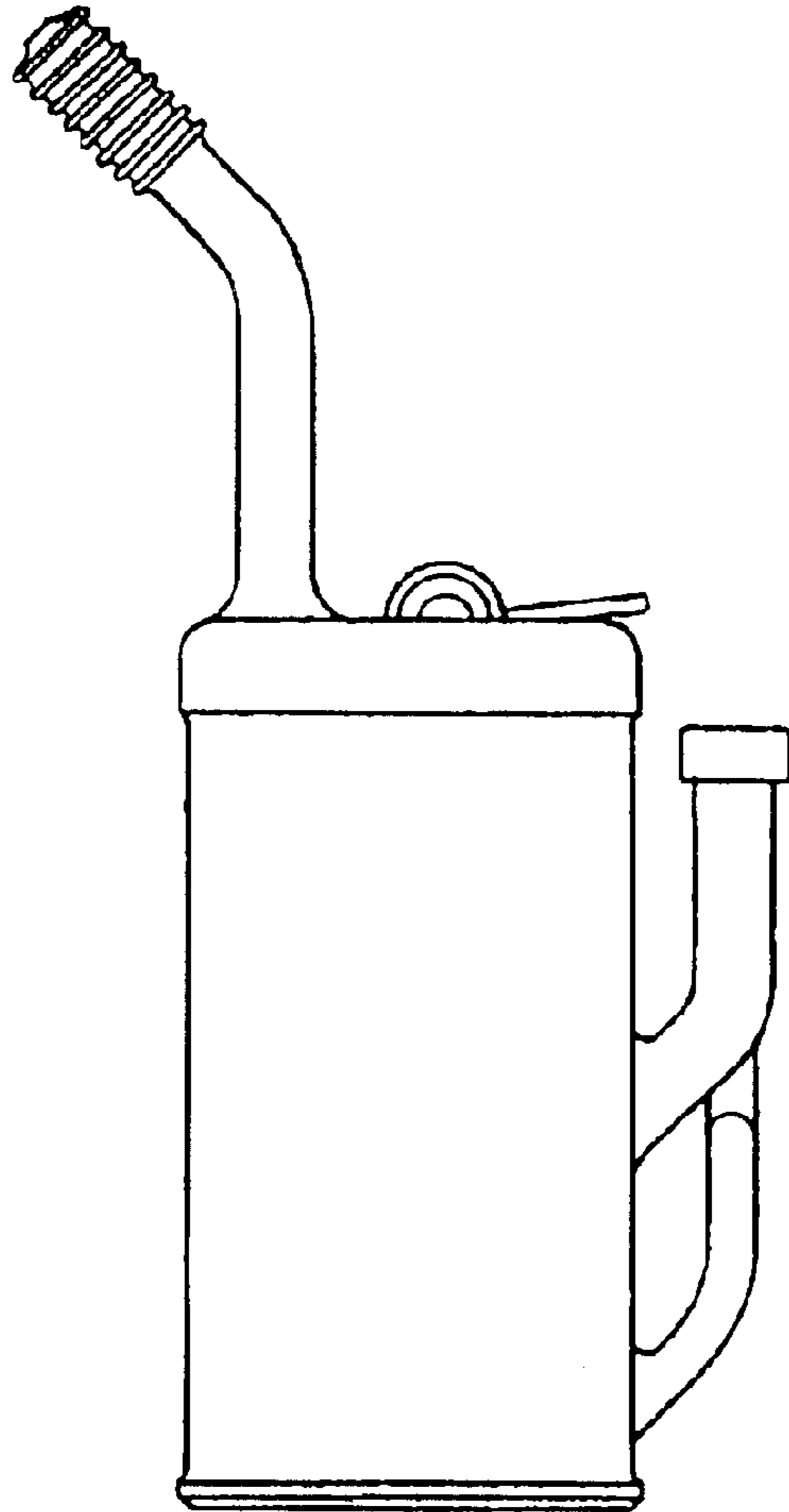

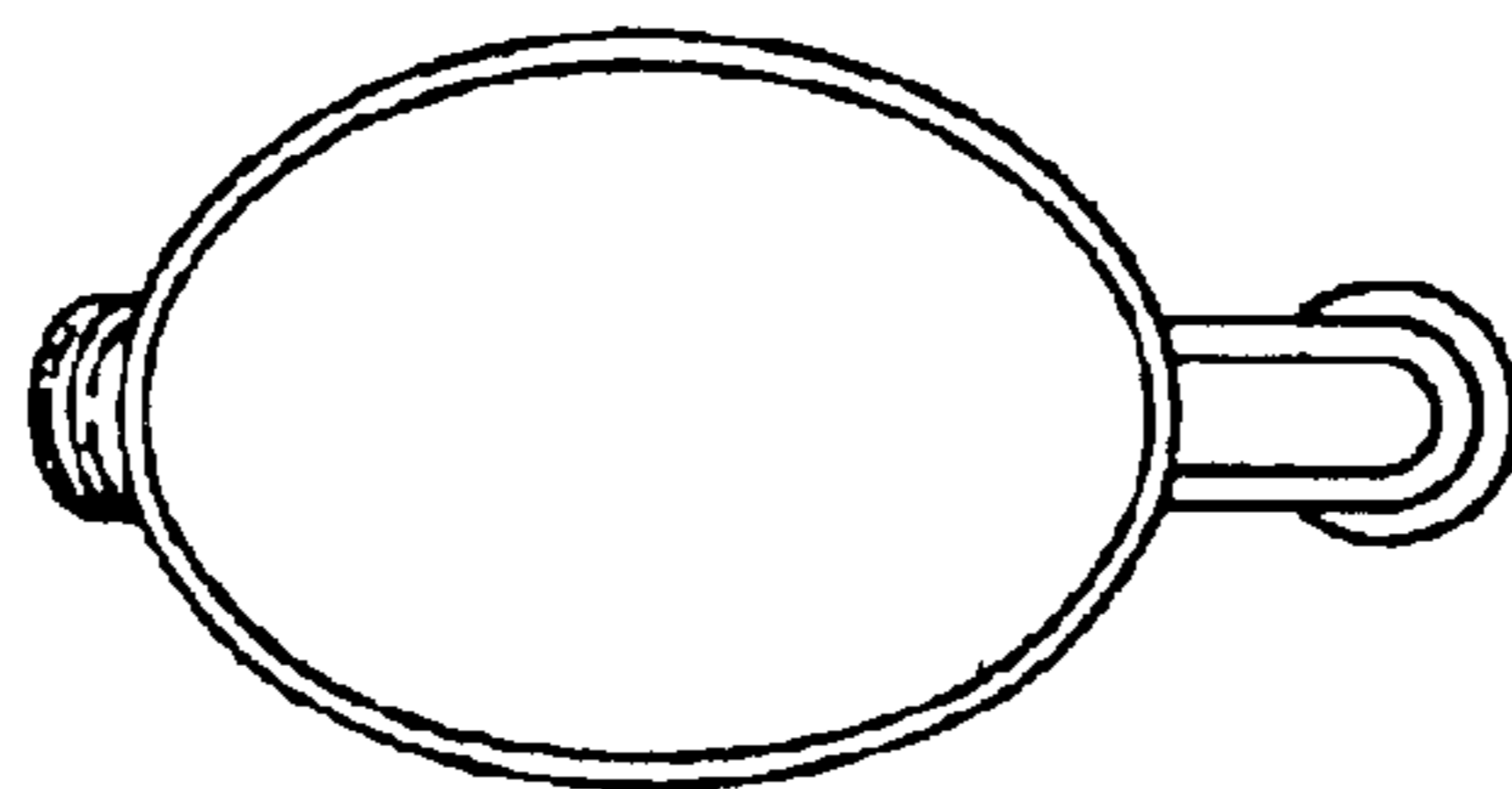
