DESCRIPTION

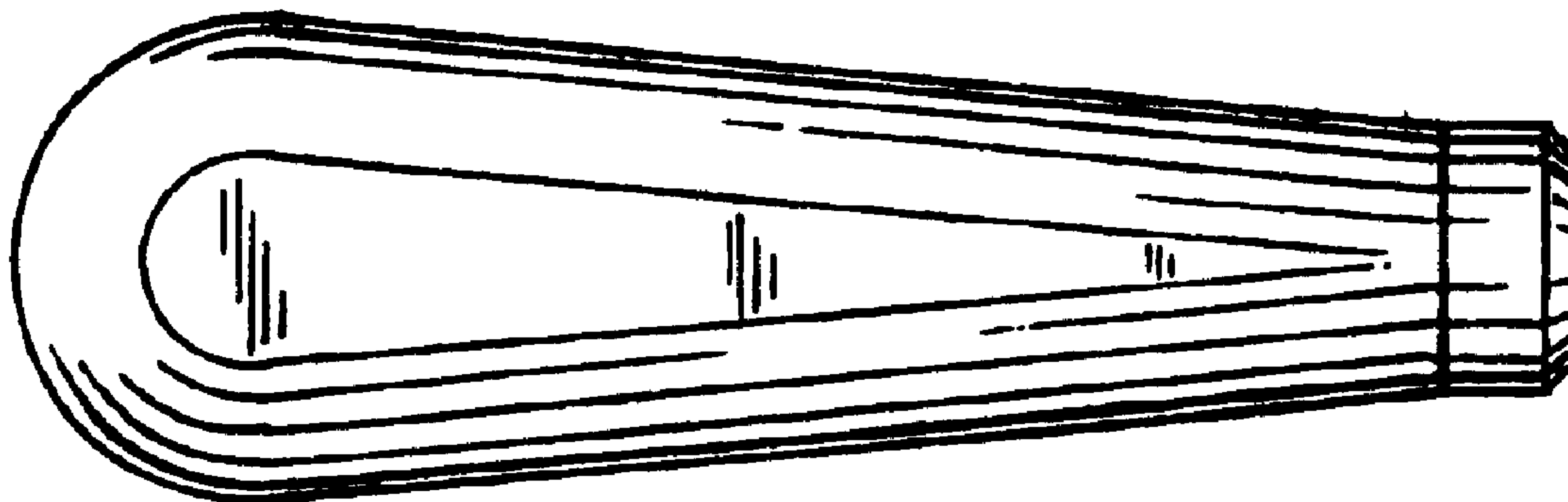
FIG. 1 is an elevational side view of a handle for utensil showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

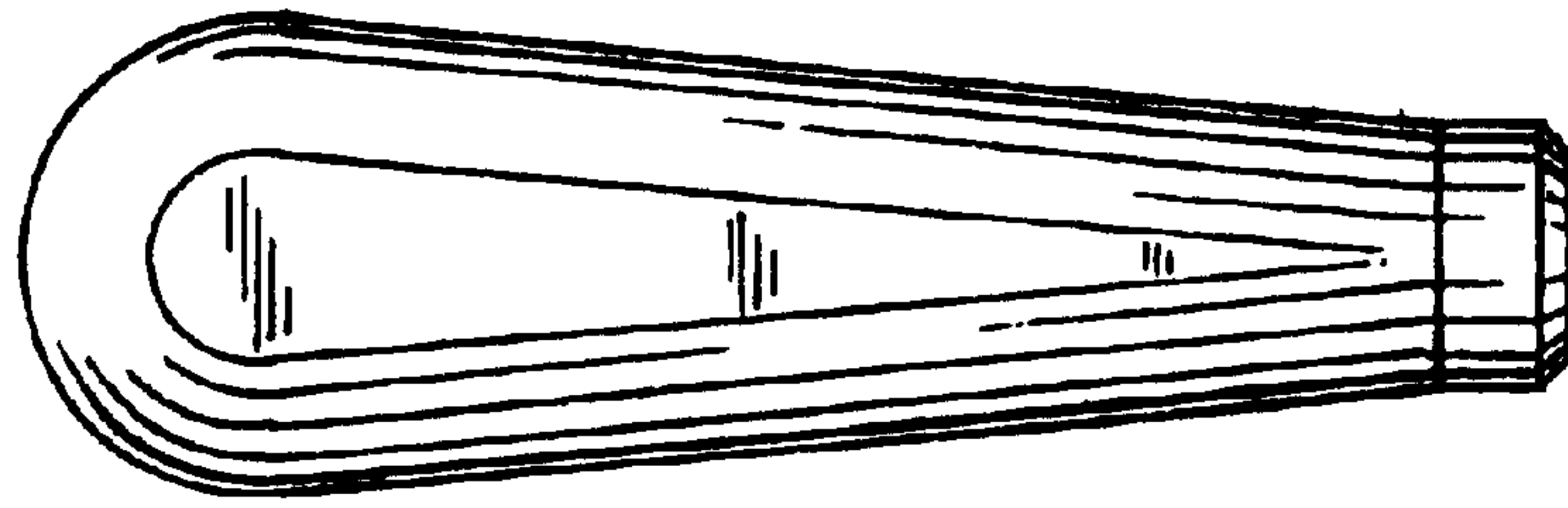

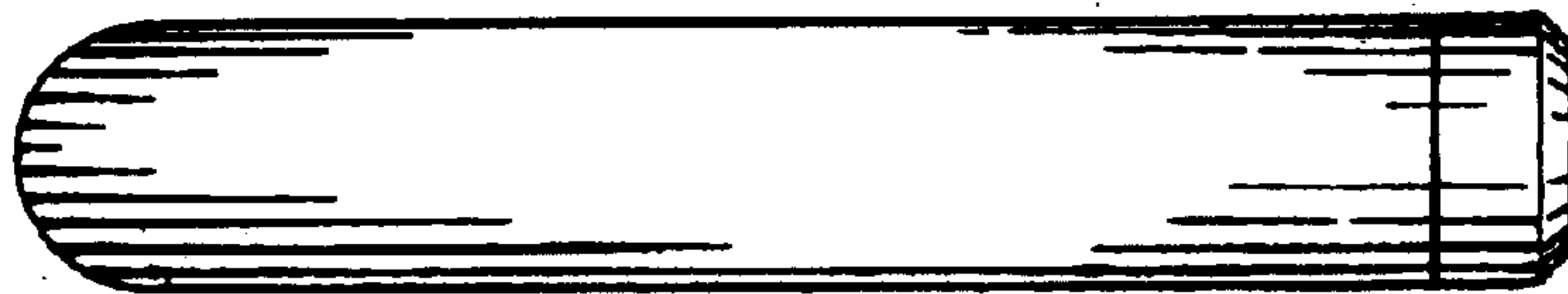

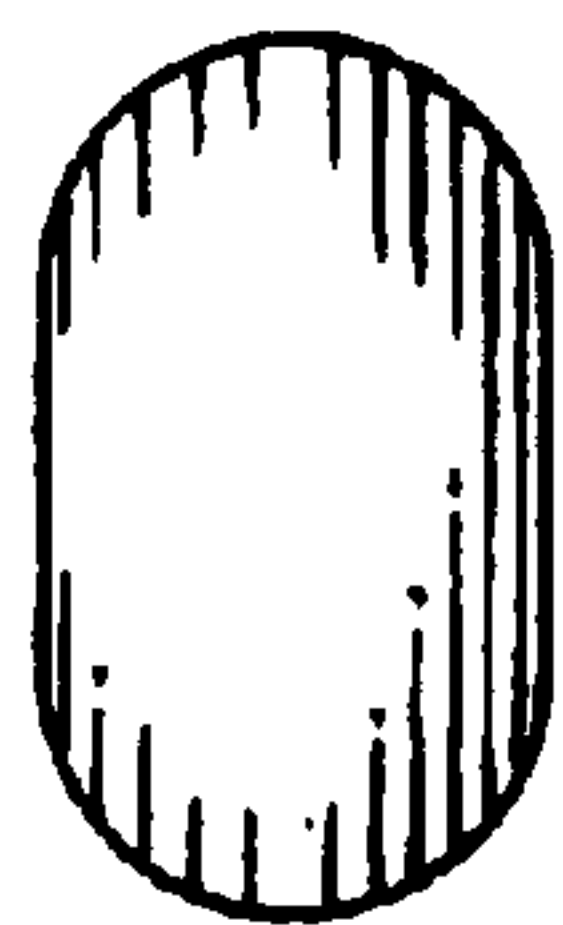

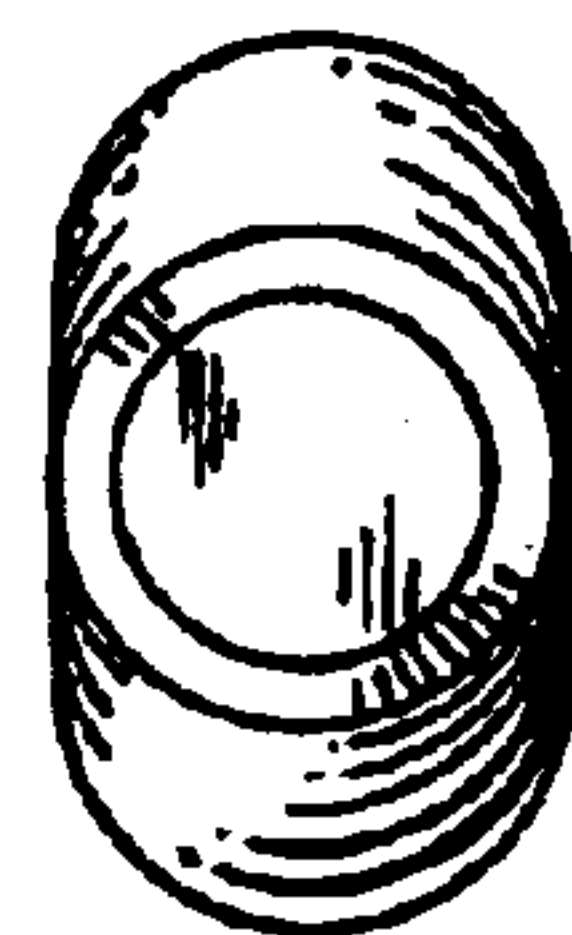
