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
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
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

O'Planick(57) **CLAIM**The ornamental design for a tire tread, as shown and  
described.**DESCRIPTION**FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tire tread showing our new  
design, it being understood that the pattern repeats uni-  
formly throughout the circumference of the tread;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; the opposite  
side elevational view being identical thereto; and,FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view  
thereof.In the drawings, the broken lines defining the sidewall, inner  
bead and the peripheral boundary between the tire tread and  
the sidewall are for illustrative purposes only and form no  
part of the claimed design.The dark stippled surface shading represents the recessed  
portion of the tread grooves having a depth as best shown in


