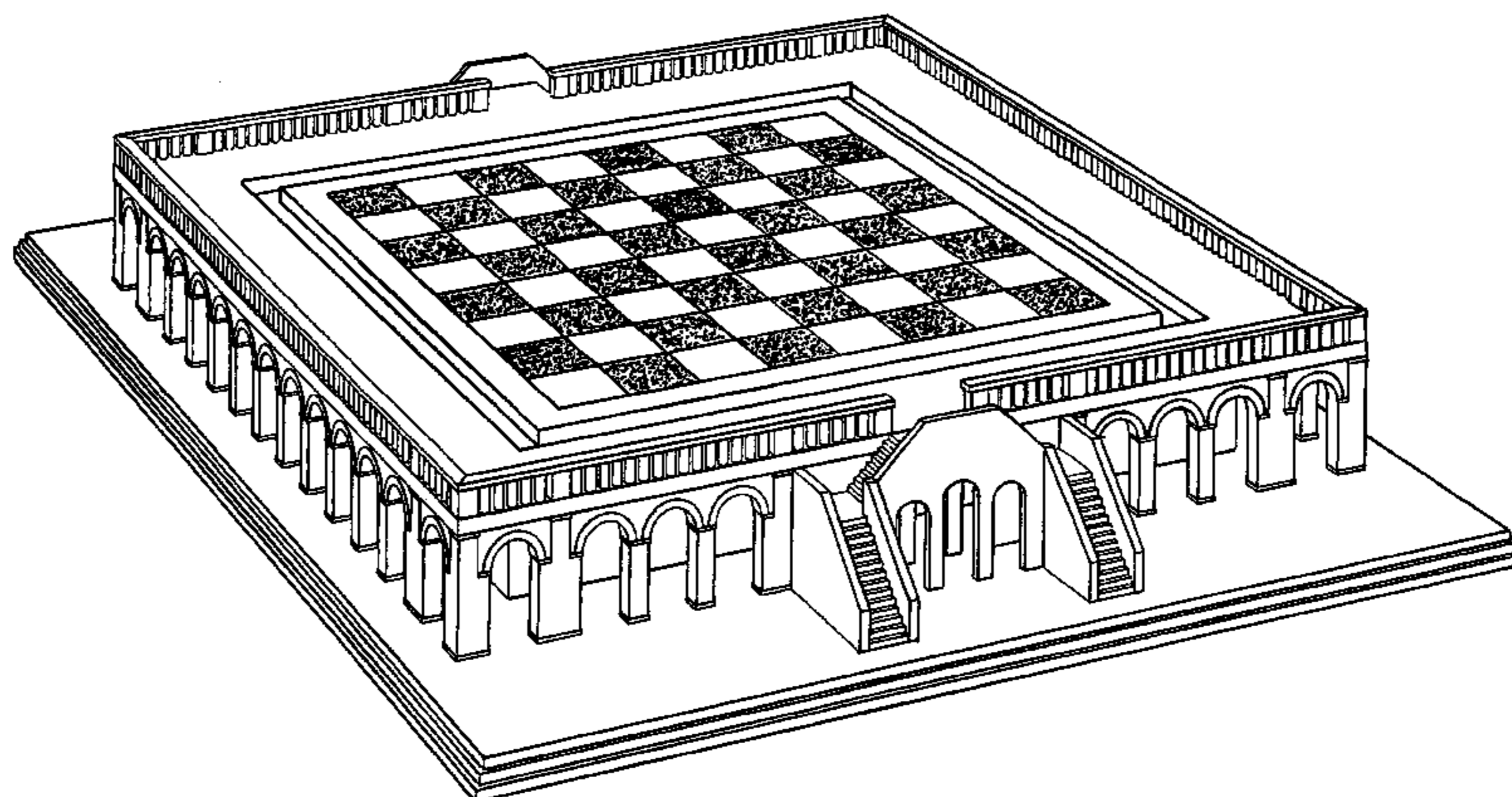
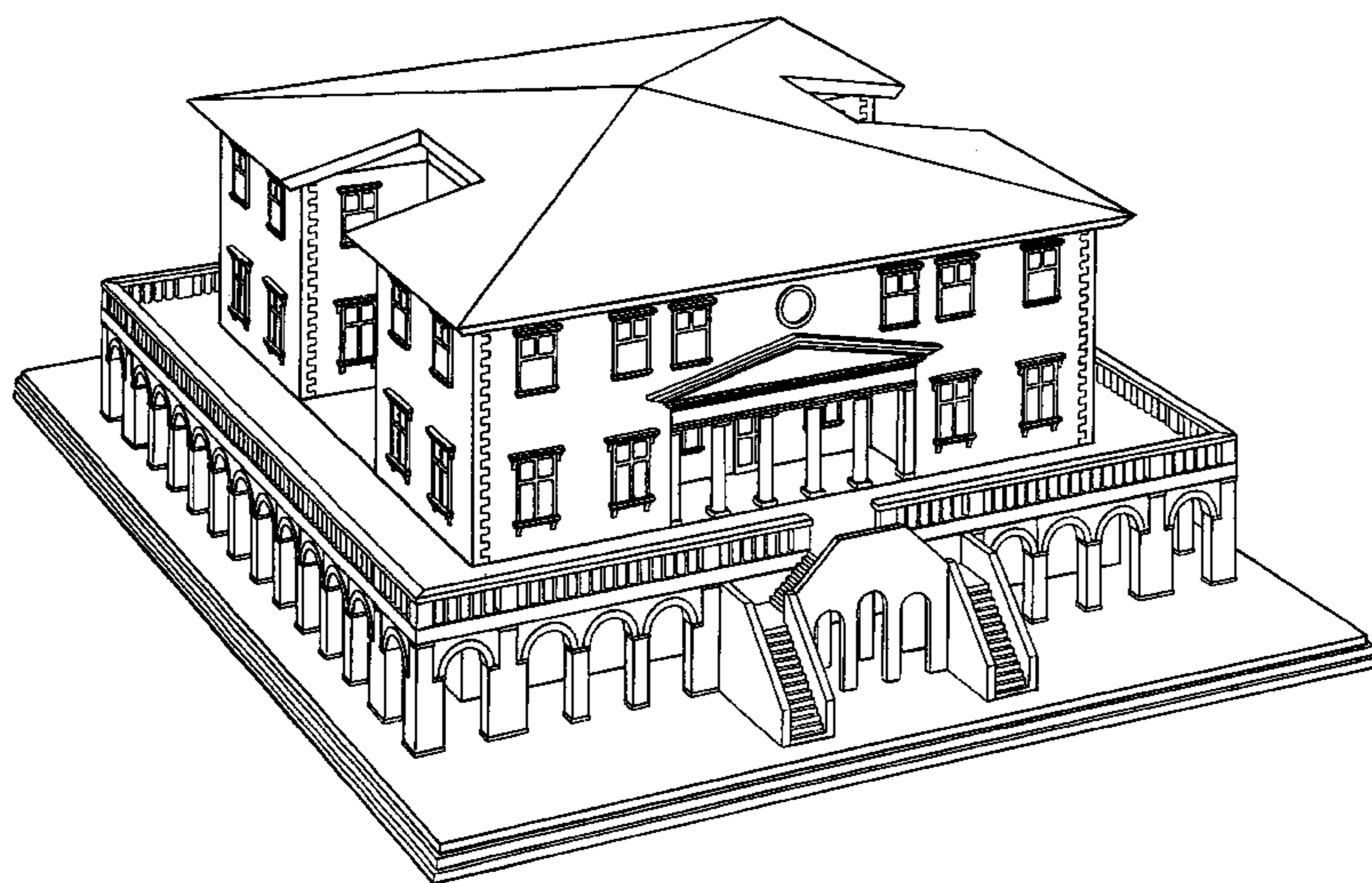
Both designs are preferably made of wood, where the

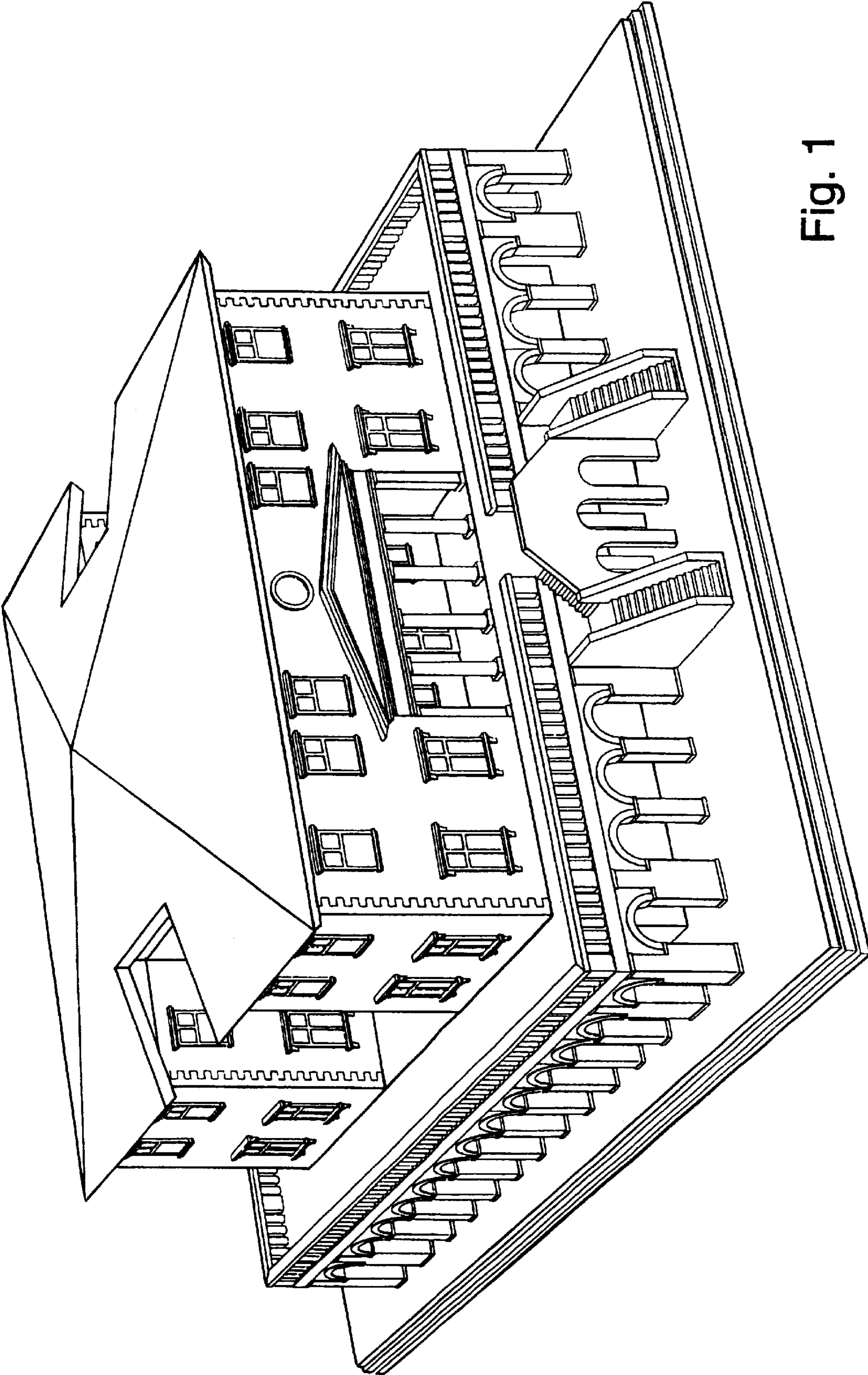

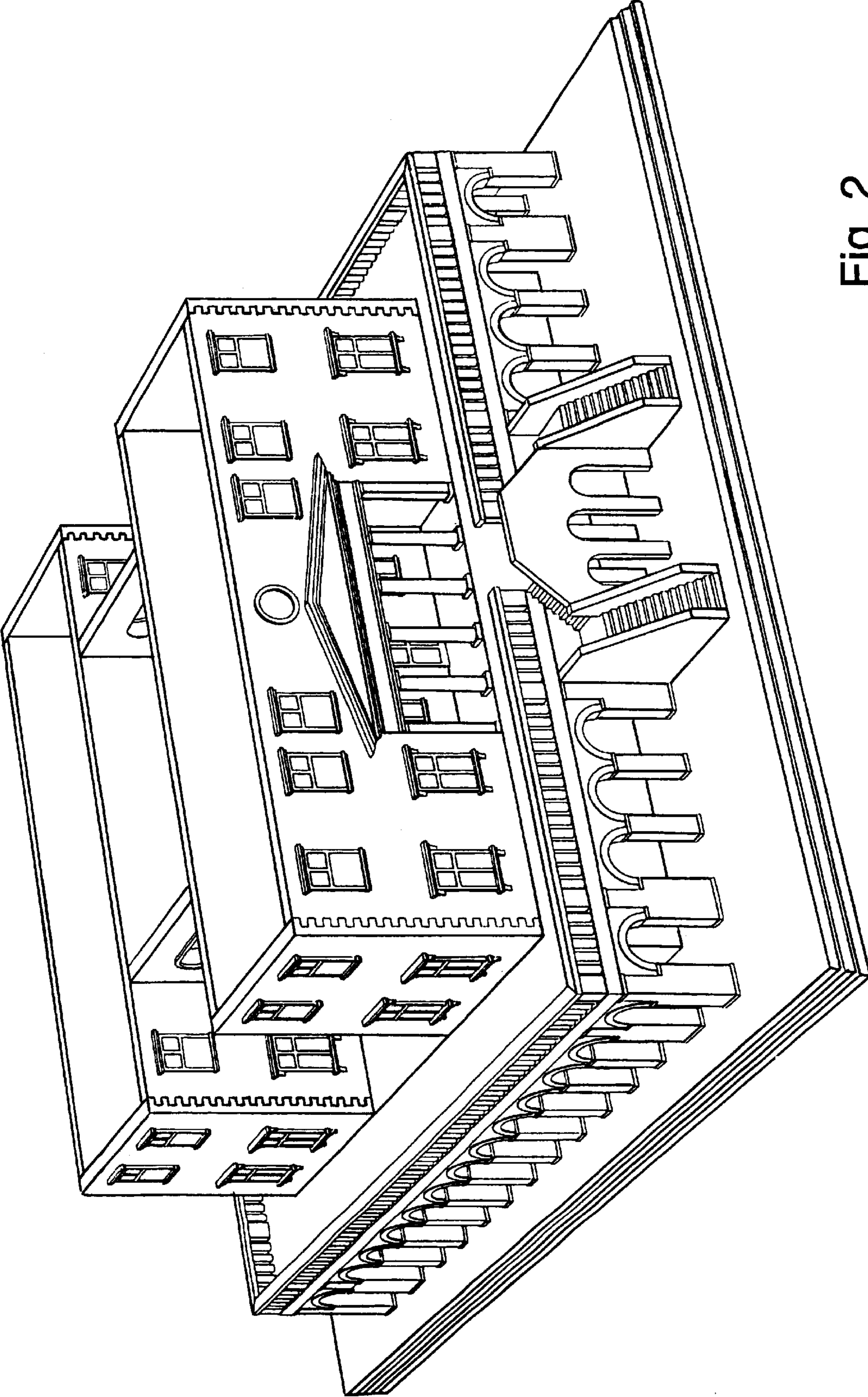

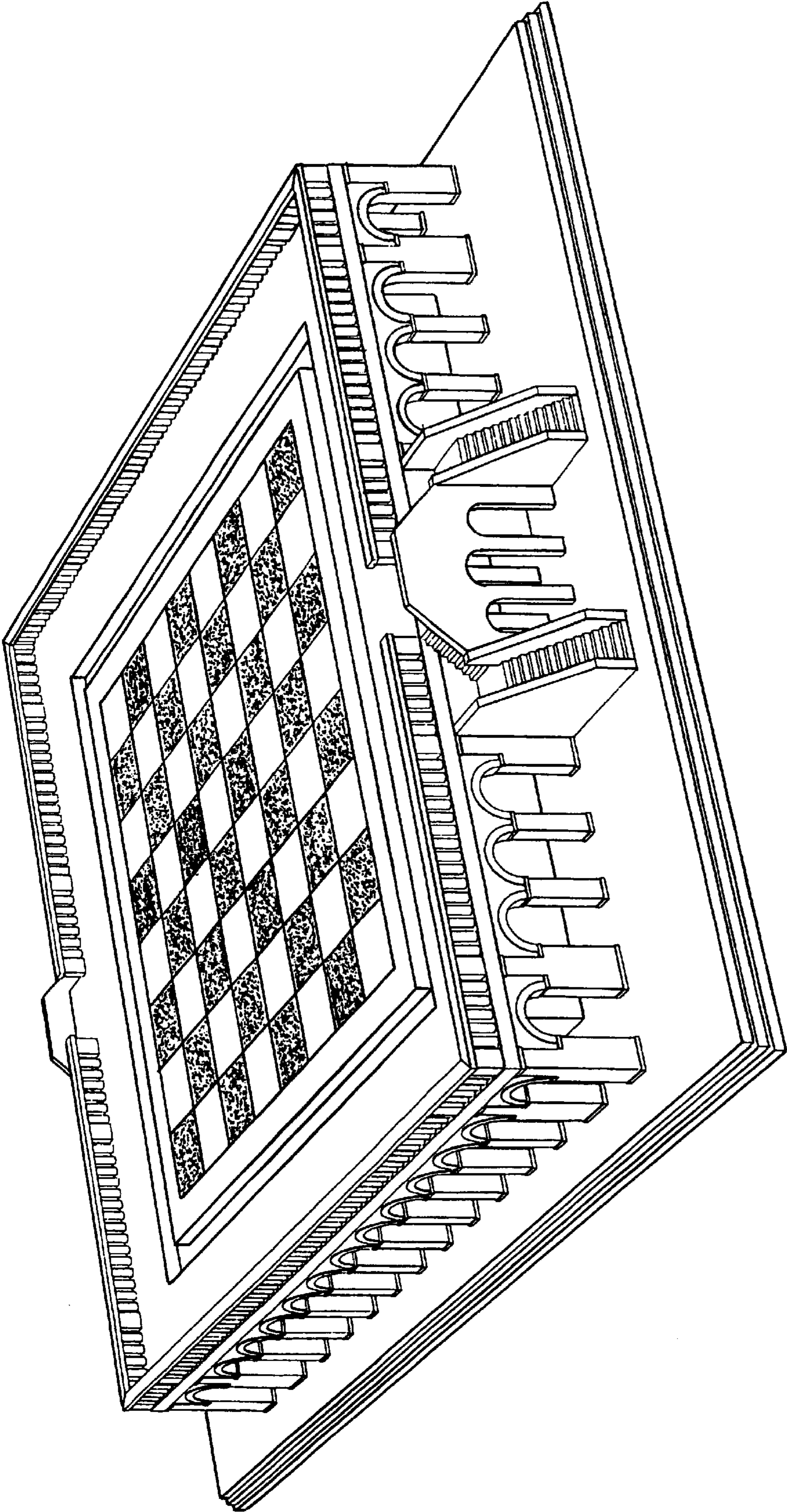
