The ornamental design for a game, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

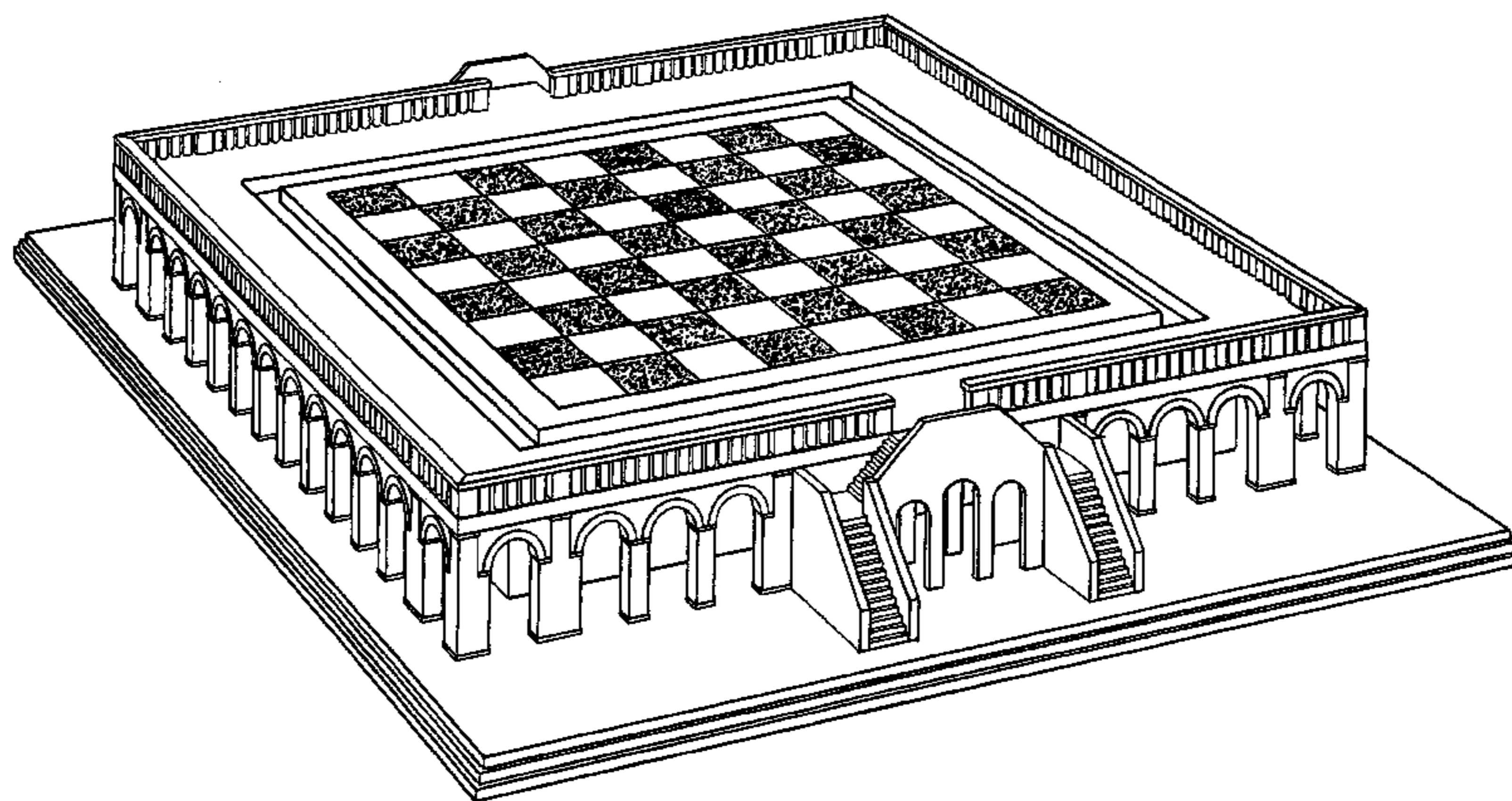
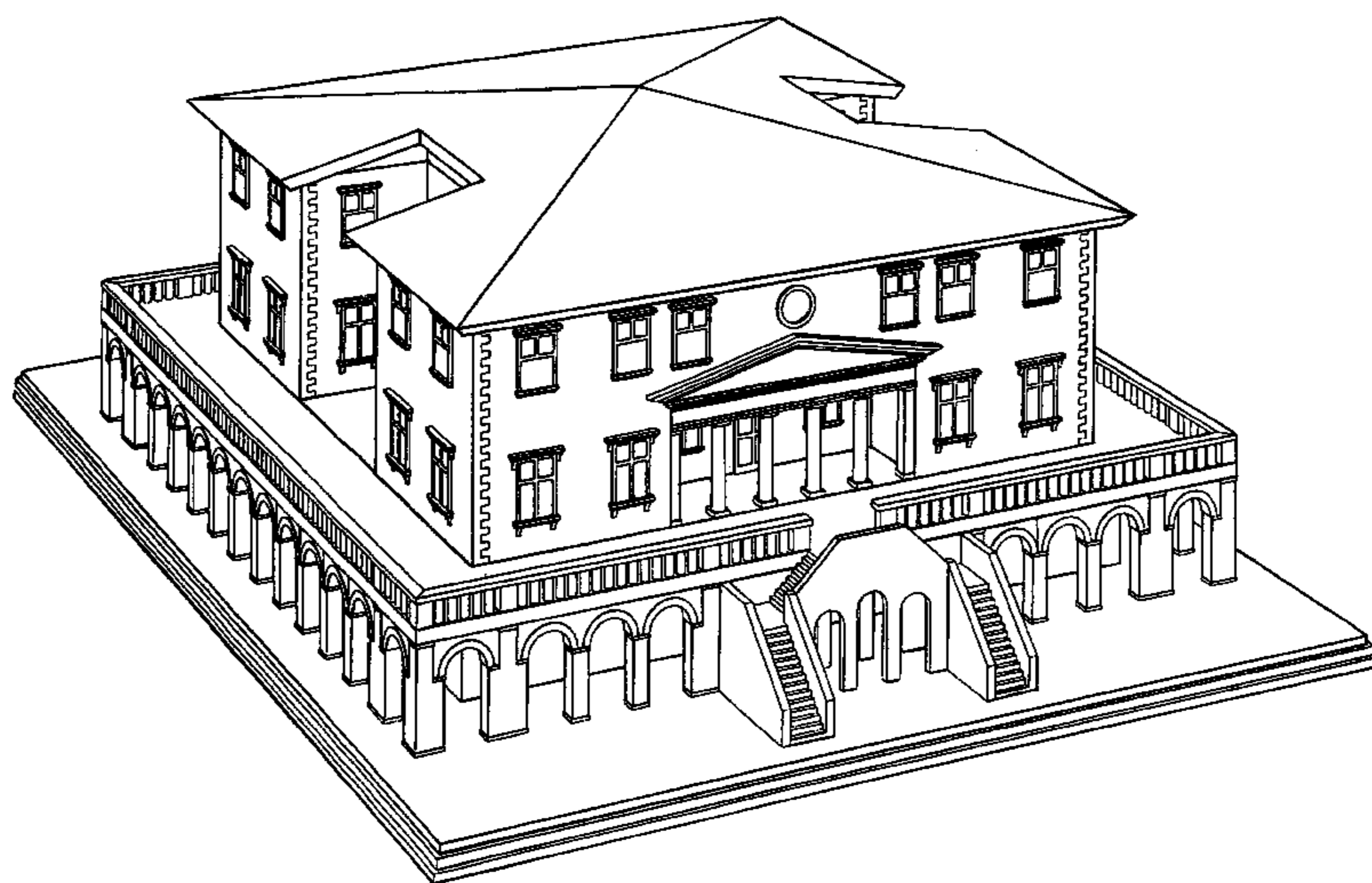
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a game, showing my new design, comprising three stacked components;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, showing the top component removed; and,

FIG. 3 shows a perspective view thereof, showing the bottom component.

Both designs are preferably made of wood, where the wooden surfaces may be natural wood, stained or painted. The surfaces moreover may be with glossy laquer, matted, oiled, waxed or metallized, e.g. gilded.

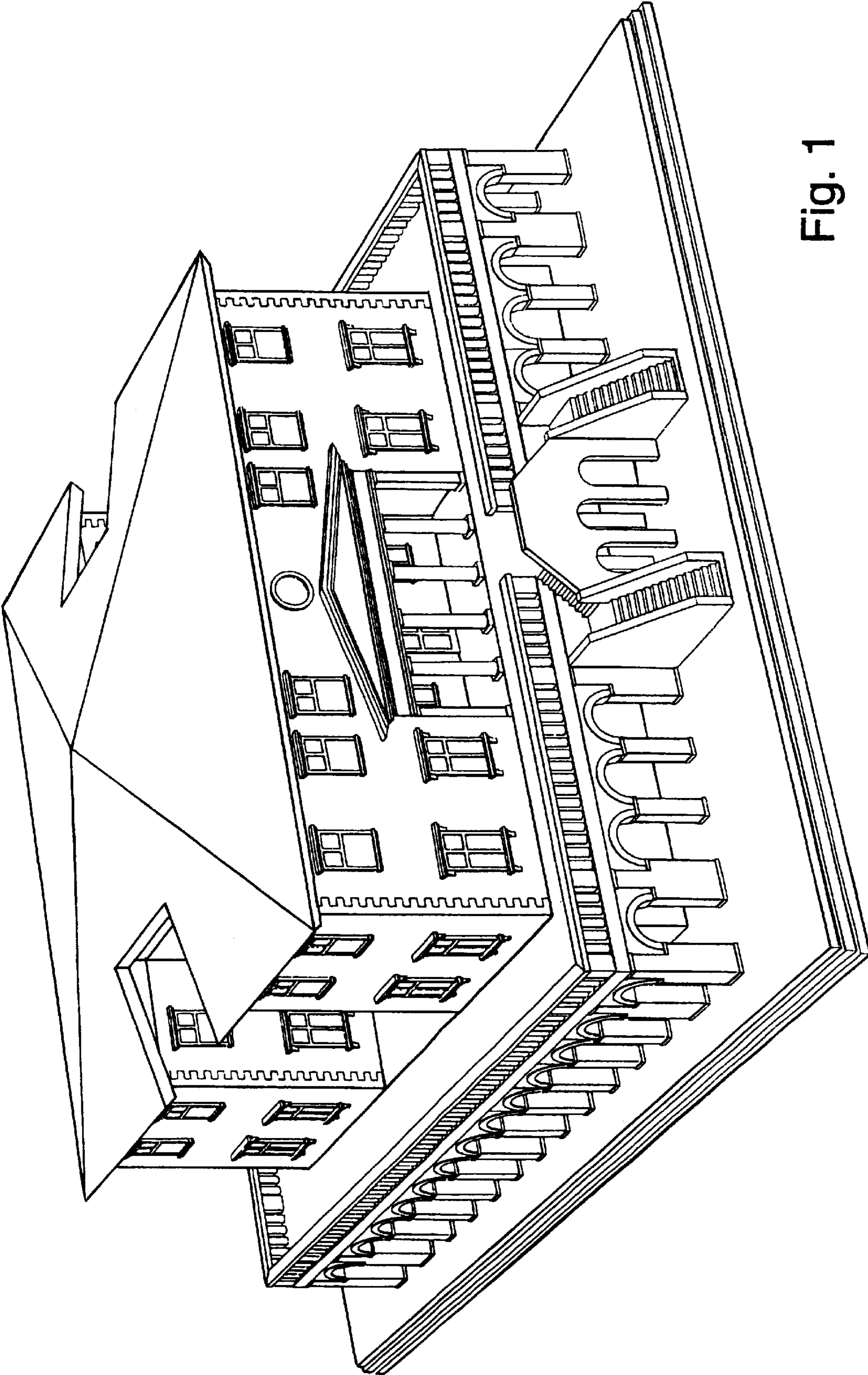

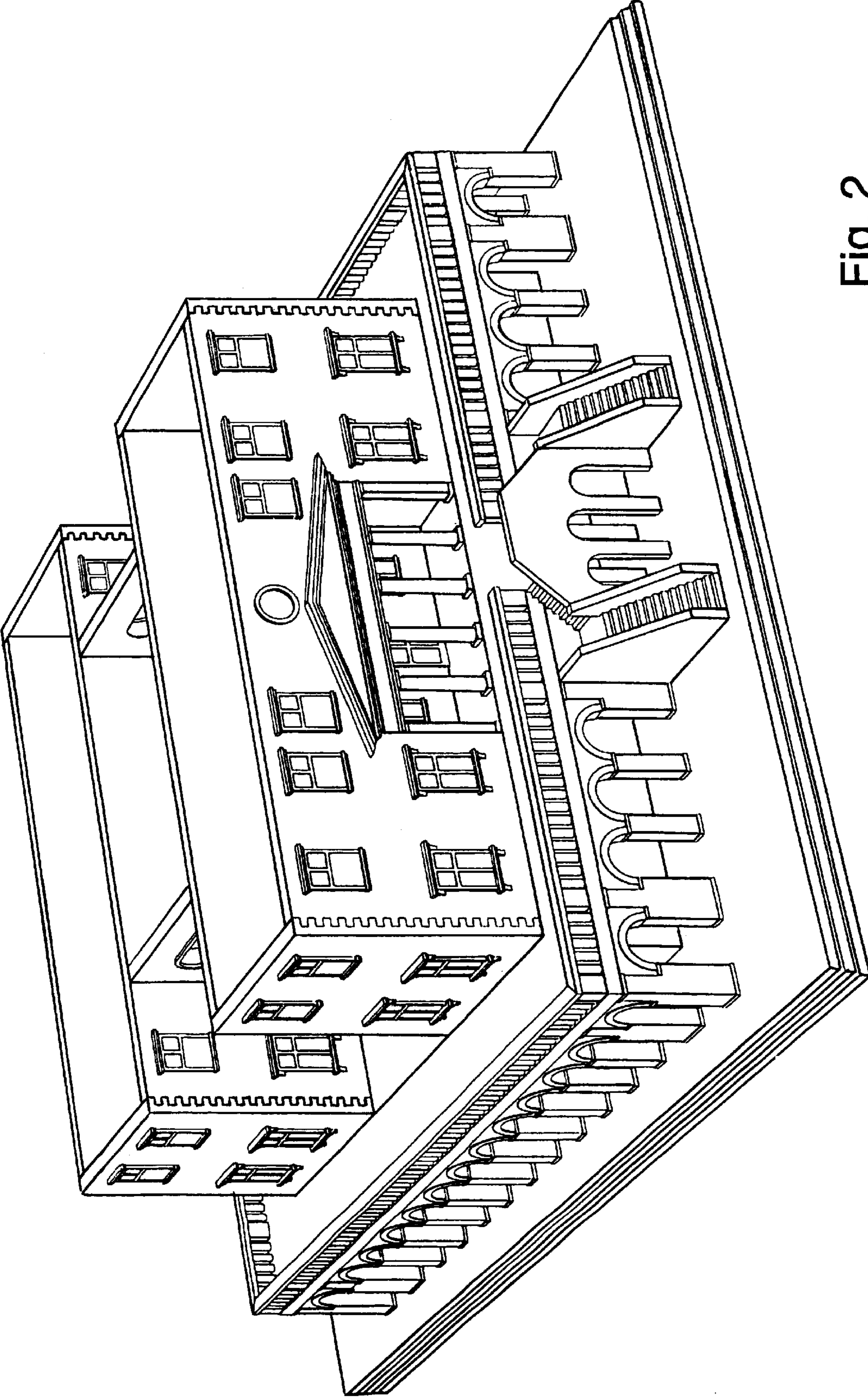

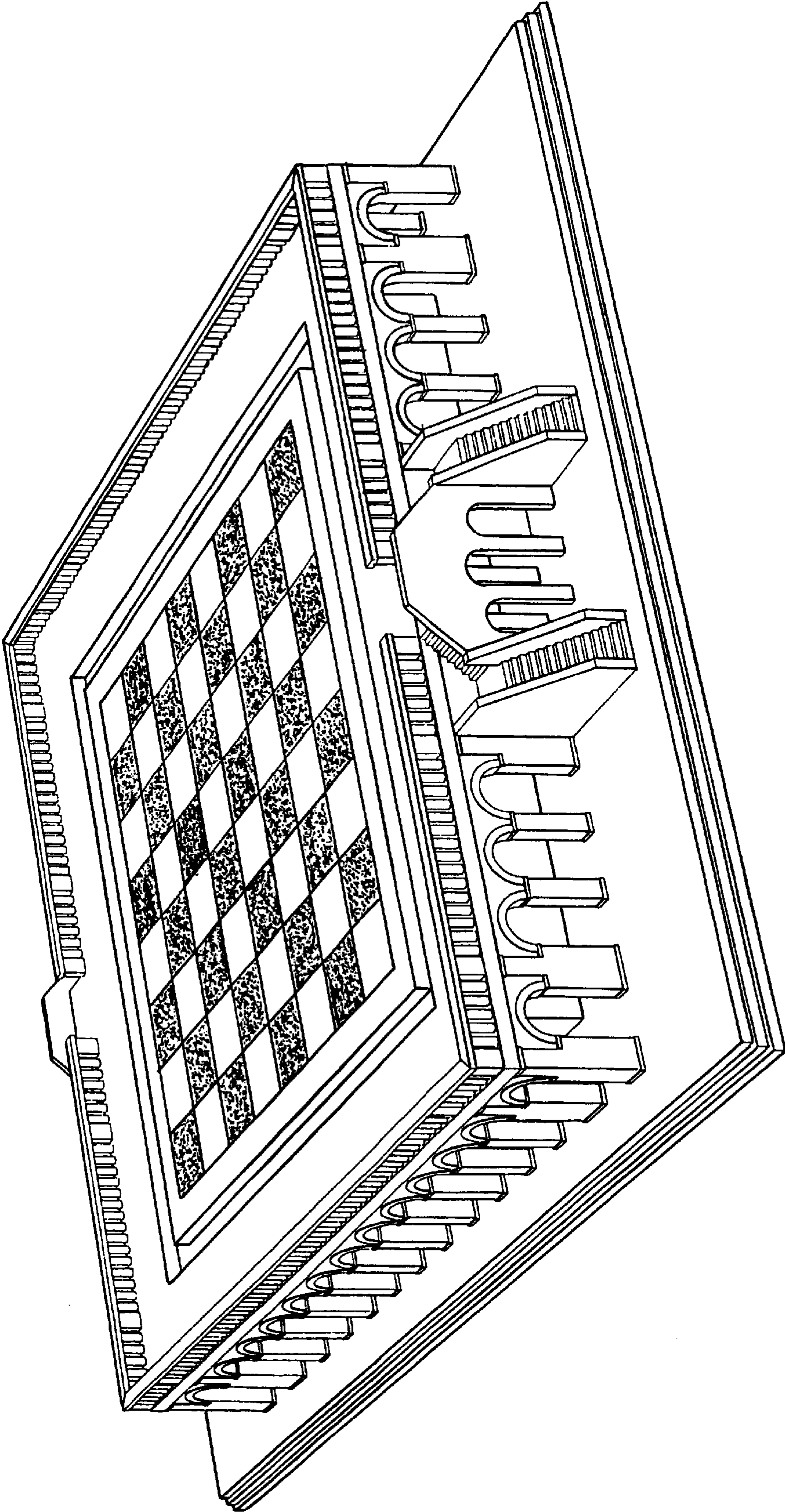
