DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the fan lamp (parts shown in broken lines not considered part of claimed design);

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the fan lamp (parts shown in broken lines not considered part of claimed design);

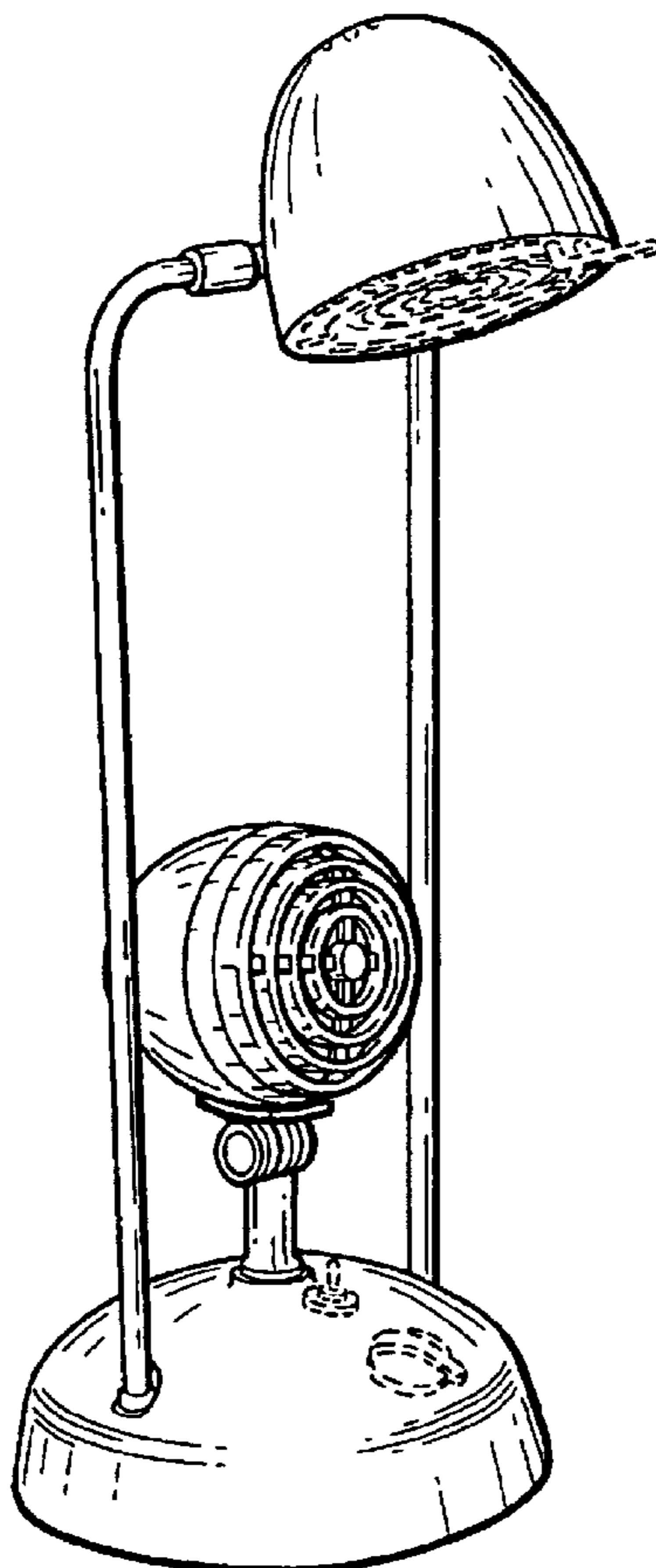
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the fan lamp (parts shown in broken lines not considered part of claimed design);

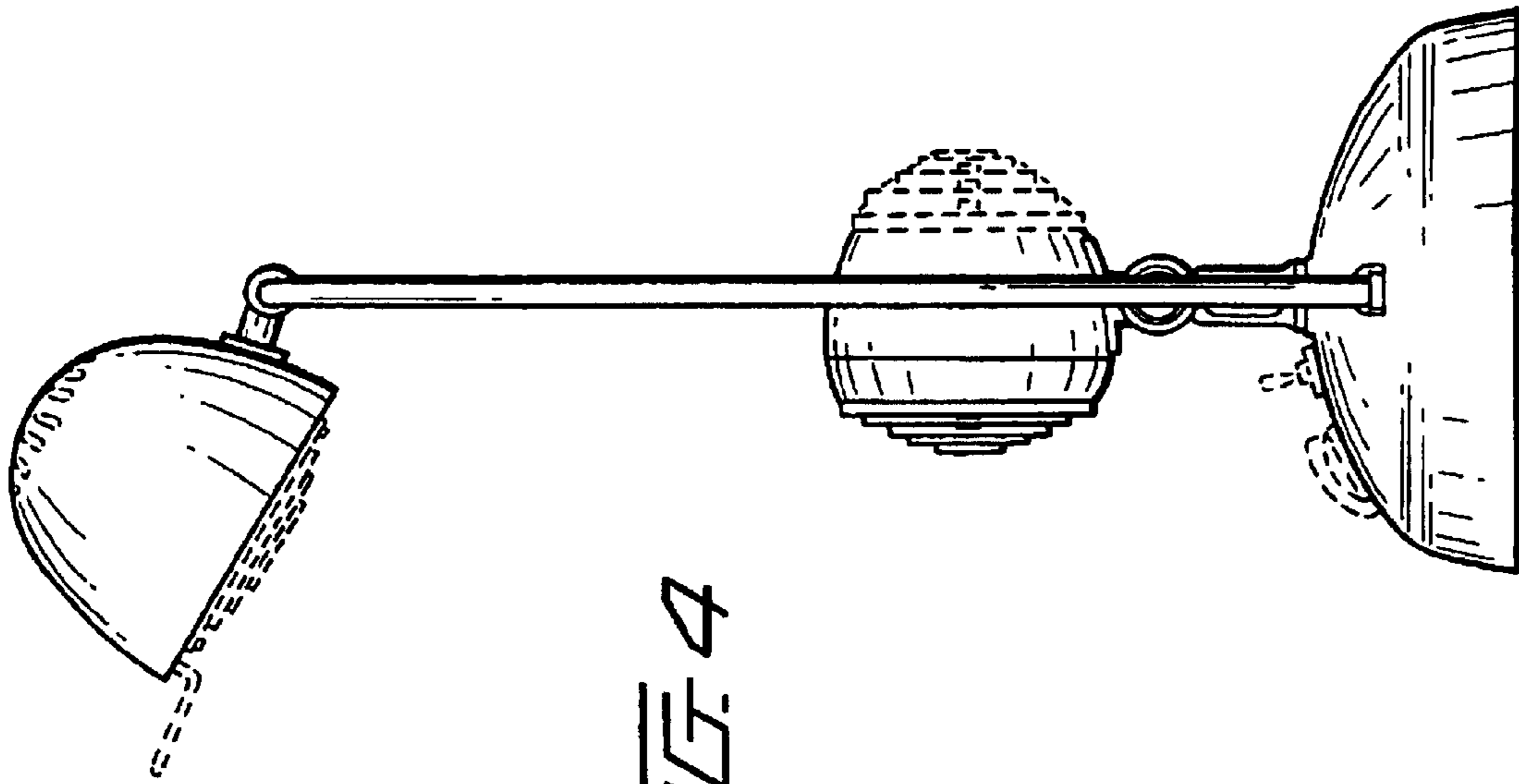

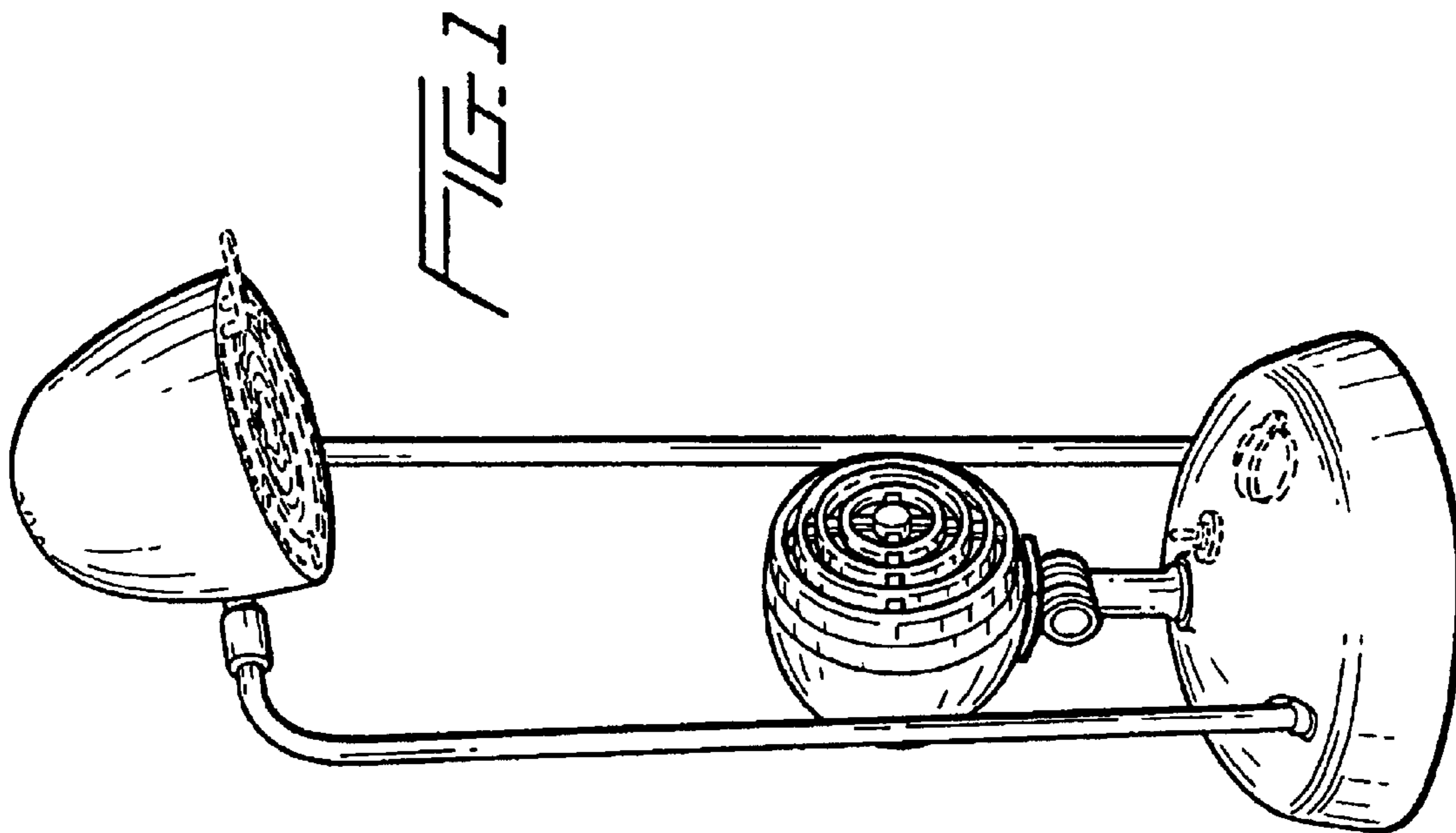

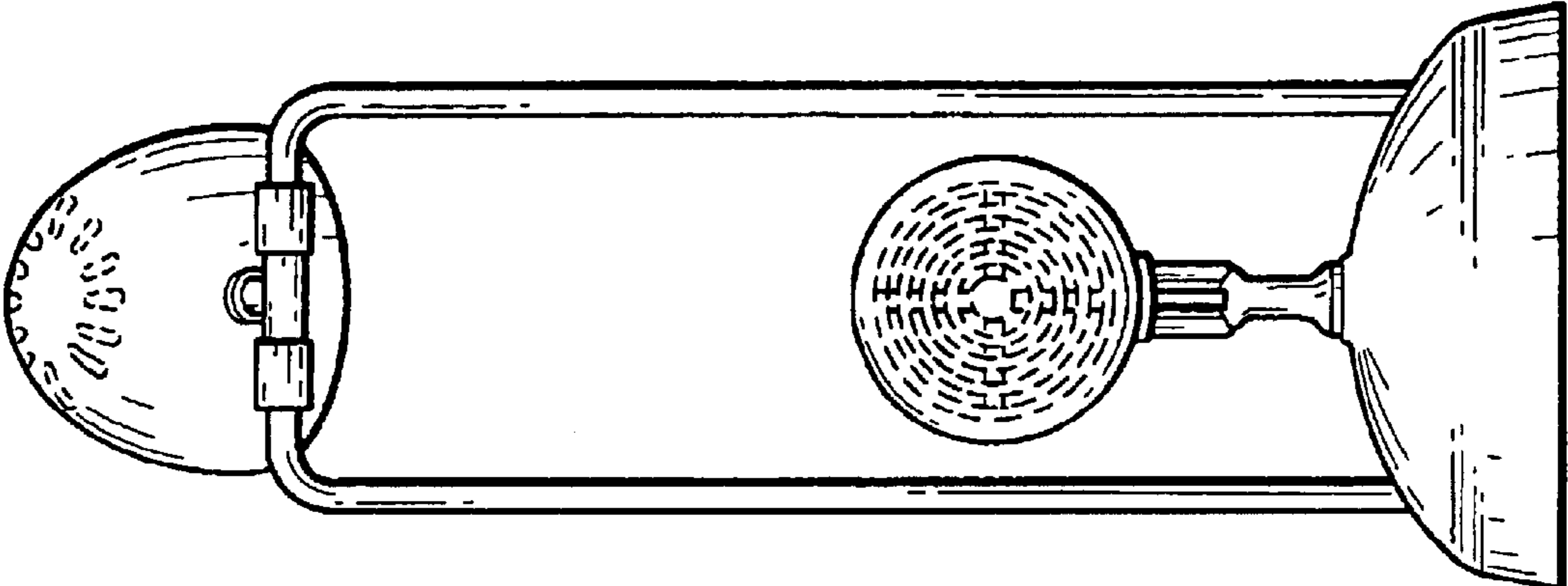

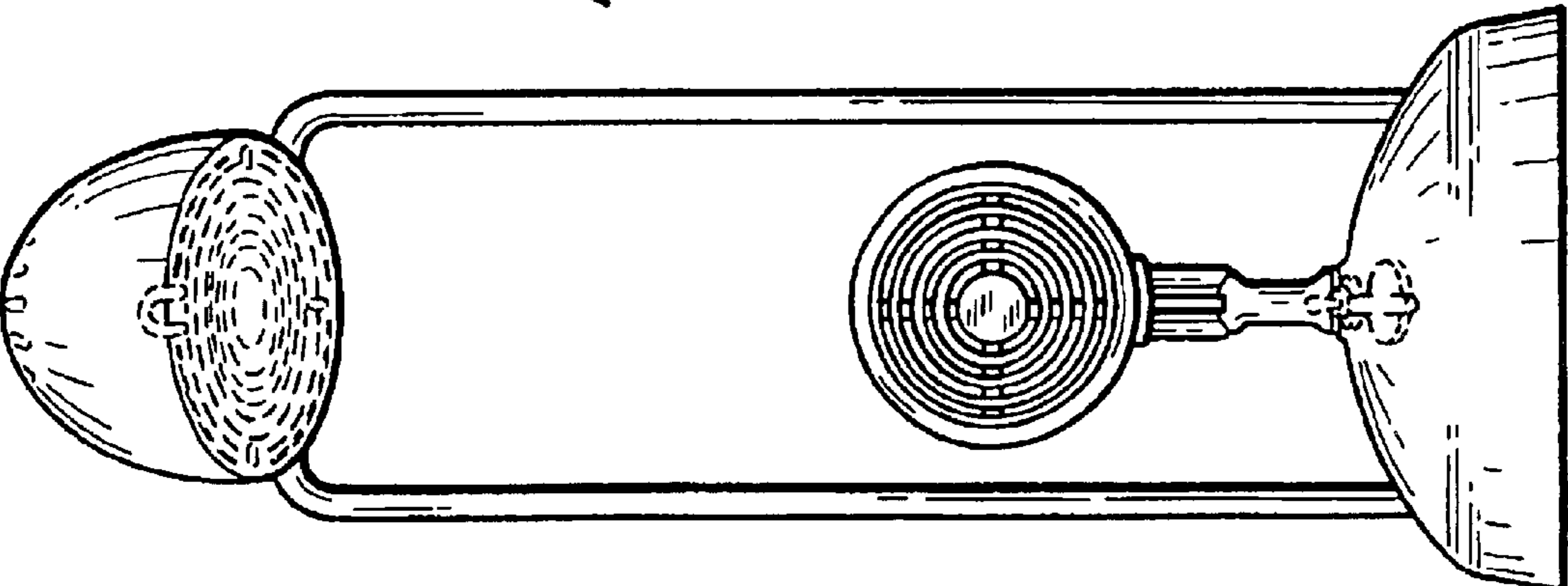

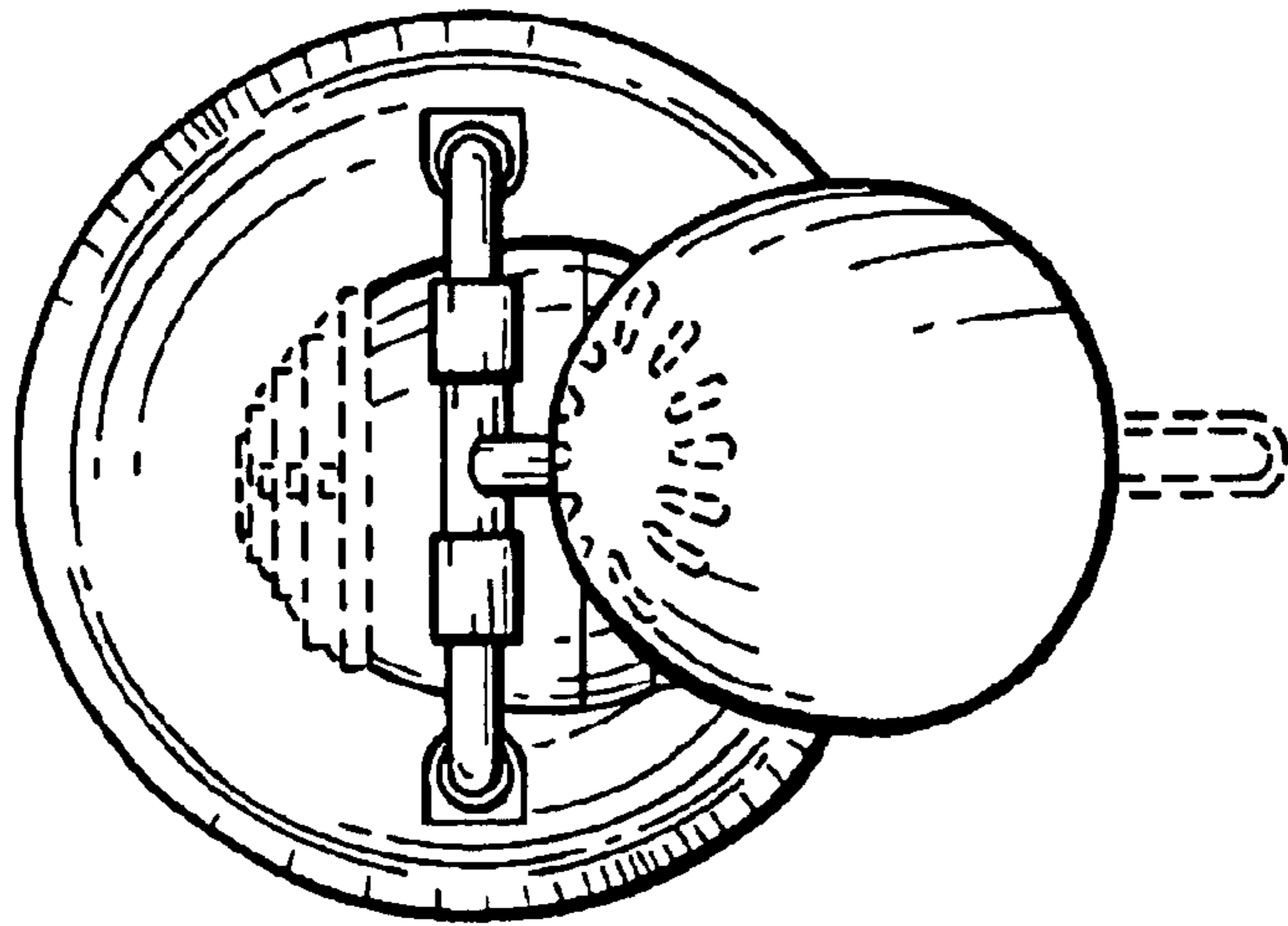

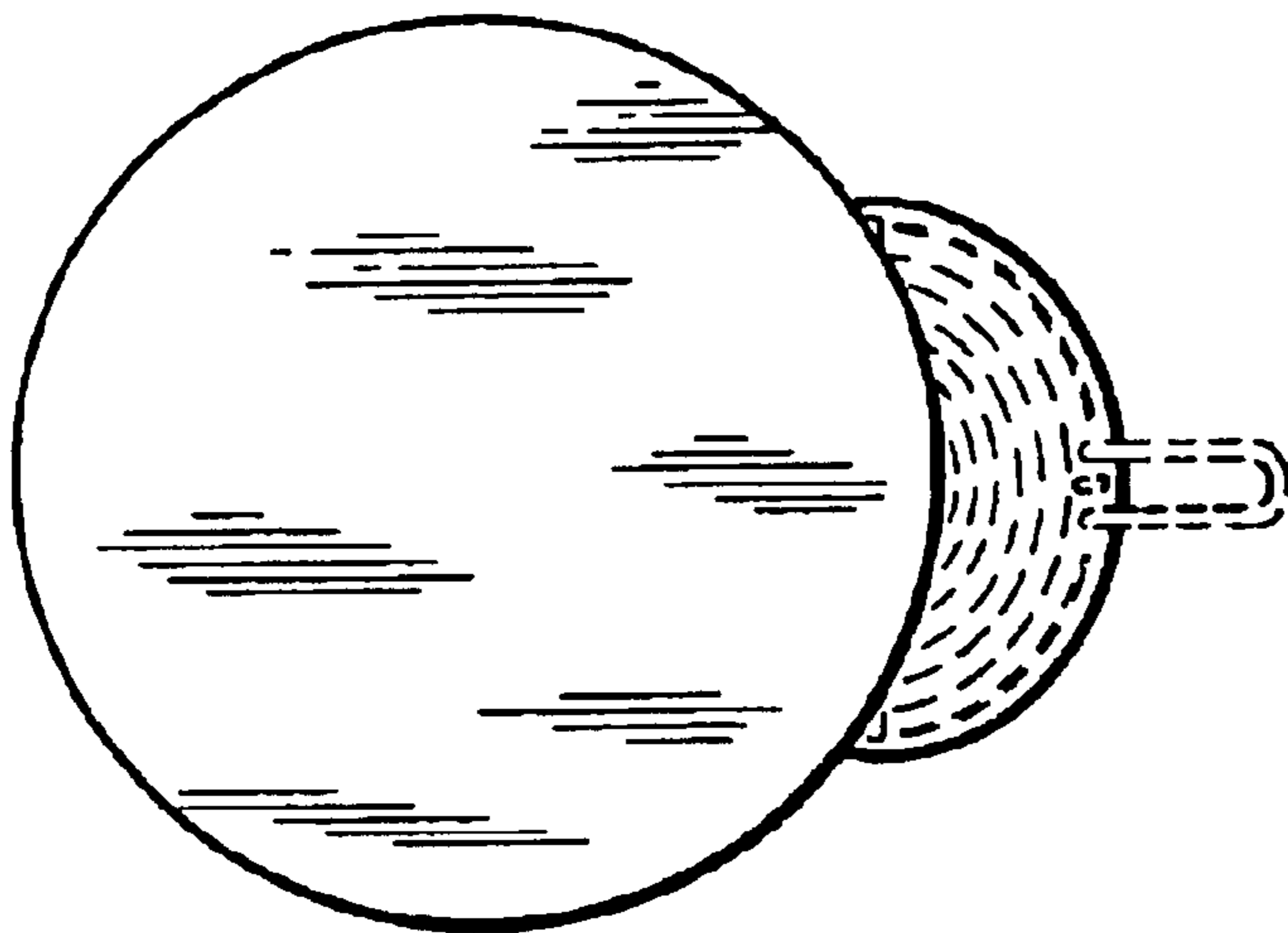
