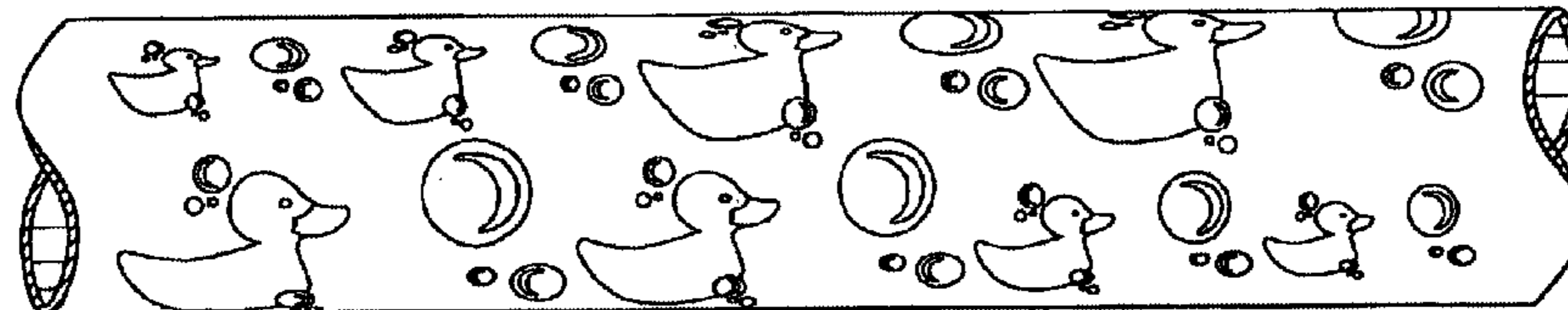
FIG. 1 is a partial front view of a shower rod showing our

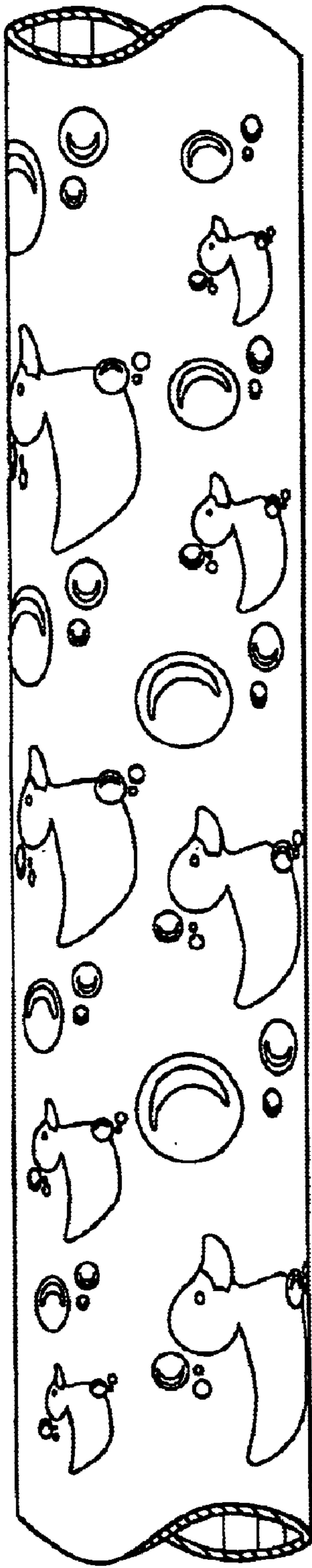

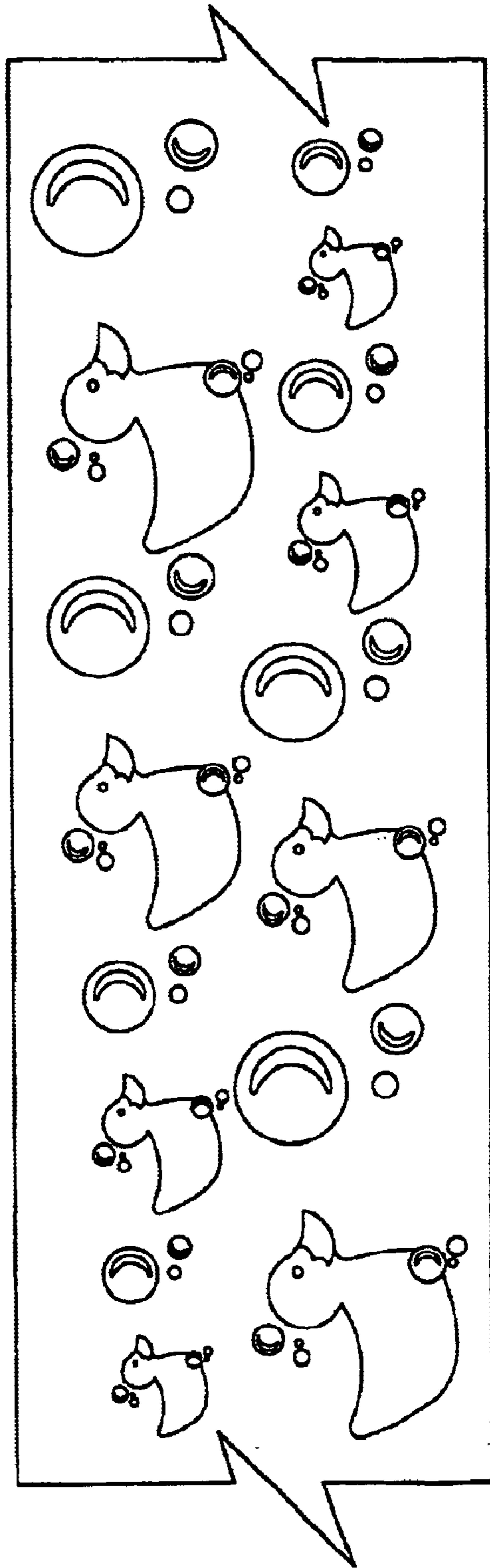
