The ornamental design for the closure, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the closure according to the present invention without a tamper evident band;

FIG. 2 is a plan view of the closure as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front/rear view of the closure as shown in FIG.

FIG. 4 is a right/left side view of the closure as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an inverted plan view of the closure as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the closure according to the invention with the tamper evident band shown in phantom;


FIG. 7 is a plan view of the closure as shown in FIG. 6;
















