The ornamental design for a flower bouquet holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a first embodiment of a flower bouquet showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of a second embodiment of a flower bouquet holder showing my new design, the opposite side view being a mirror image;

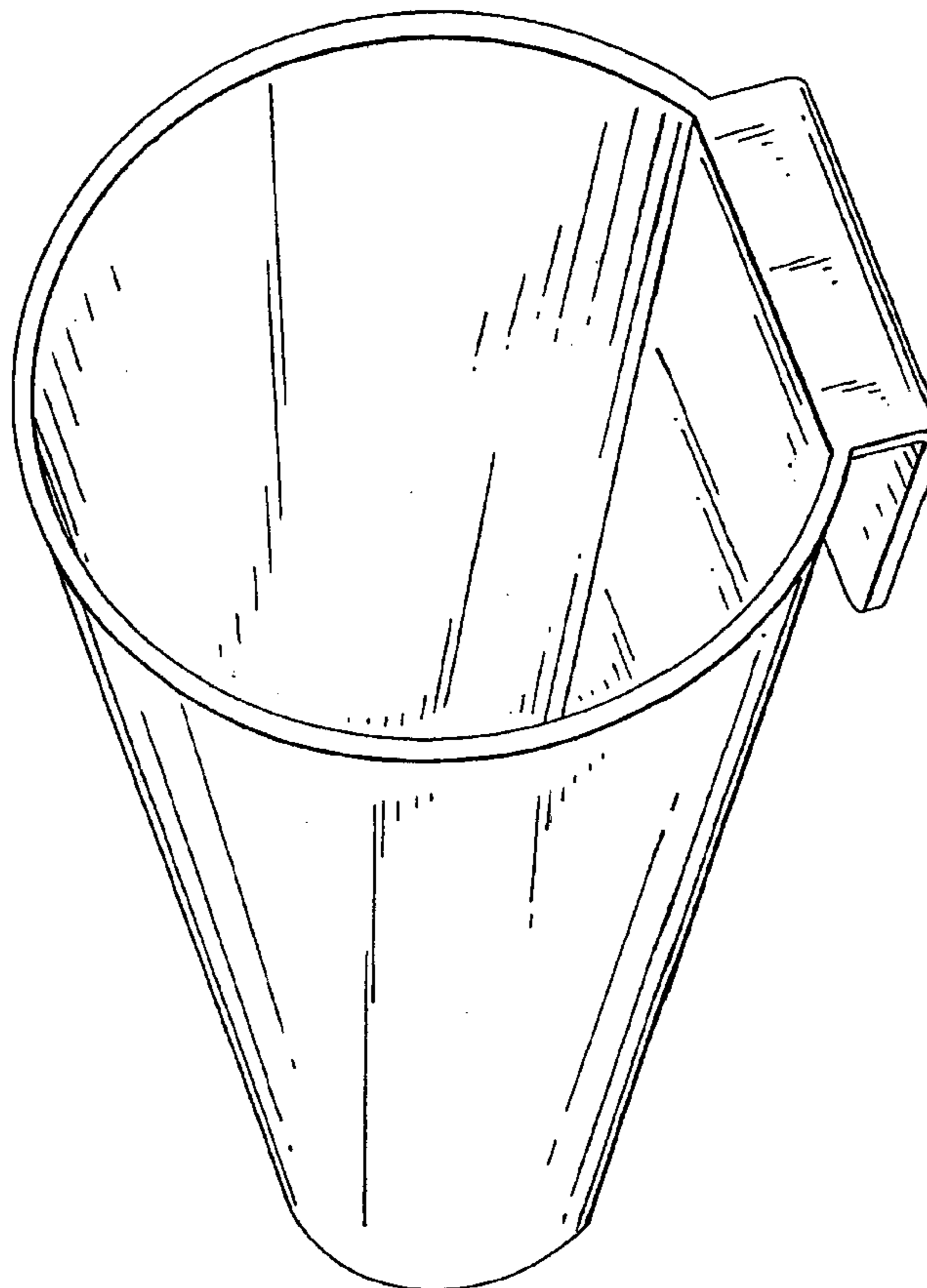
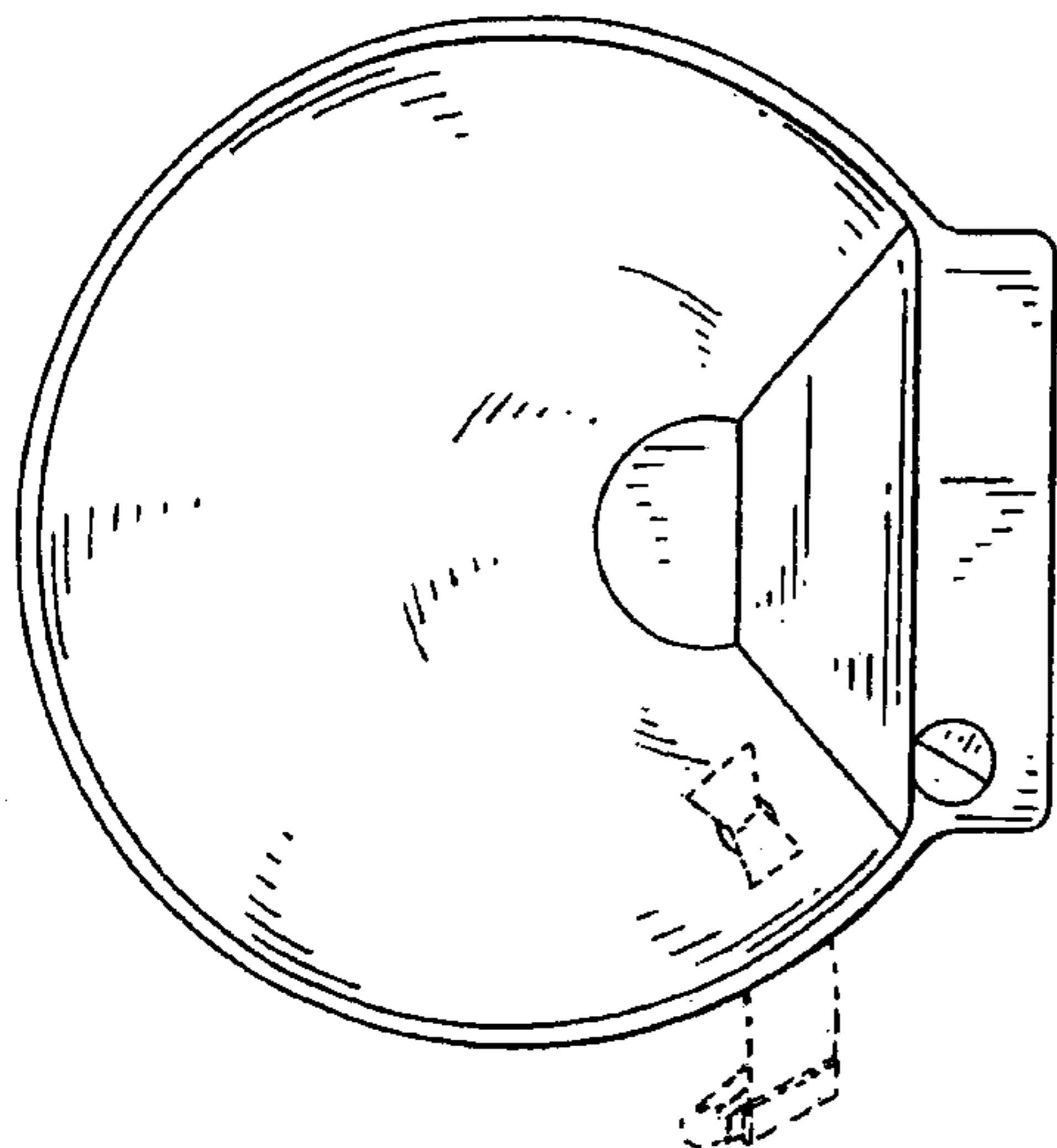
FIG. 5 is a rear view of FIG. 4;

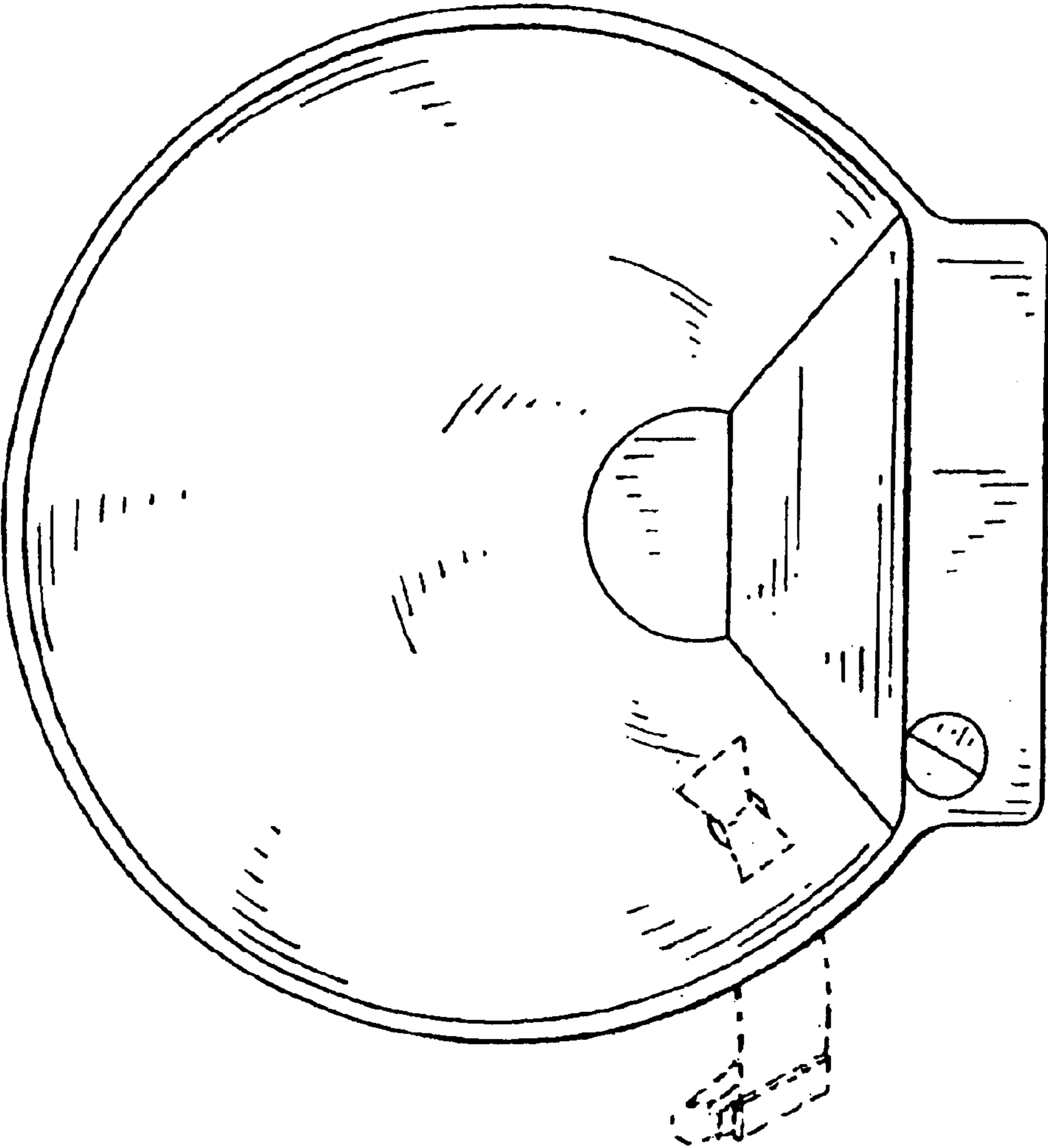

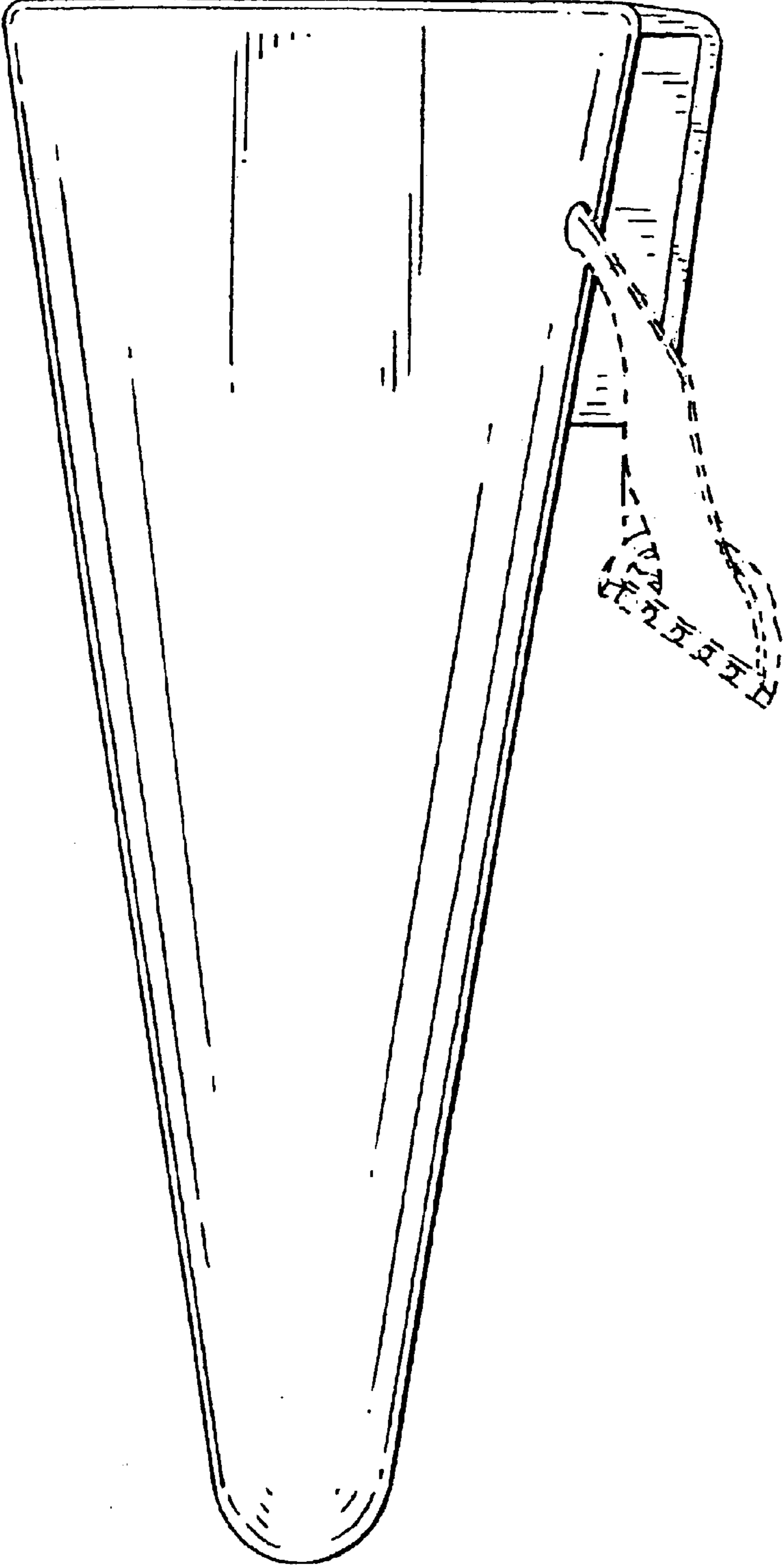

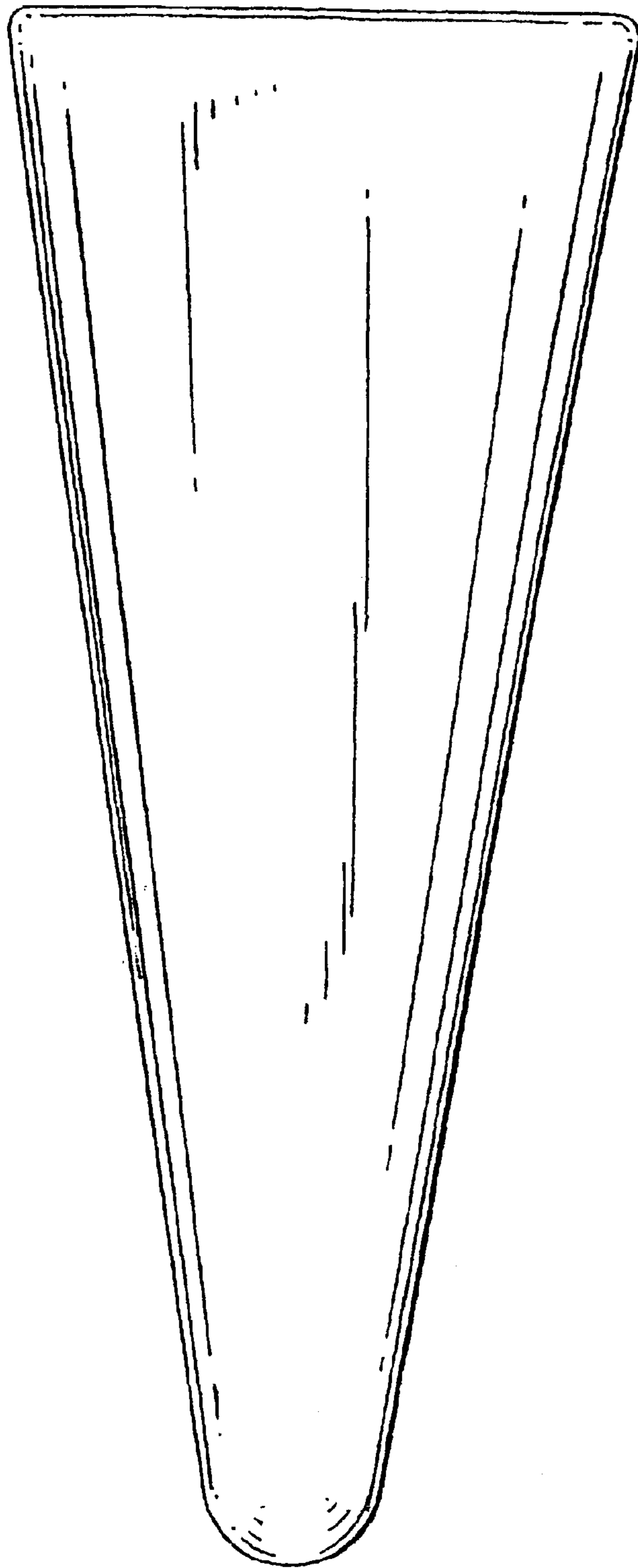

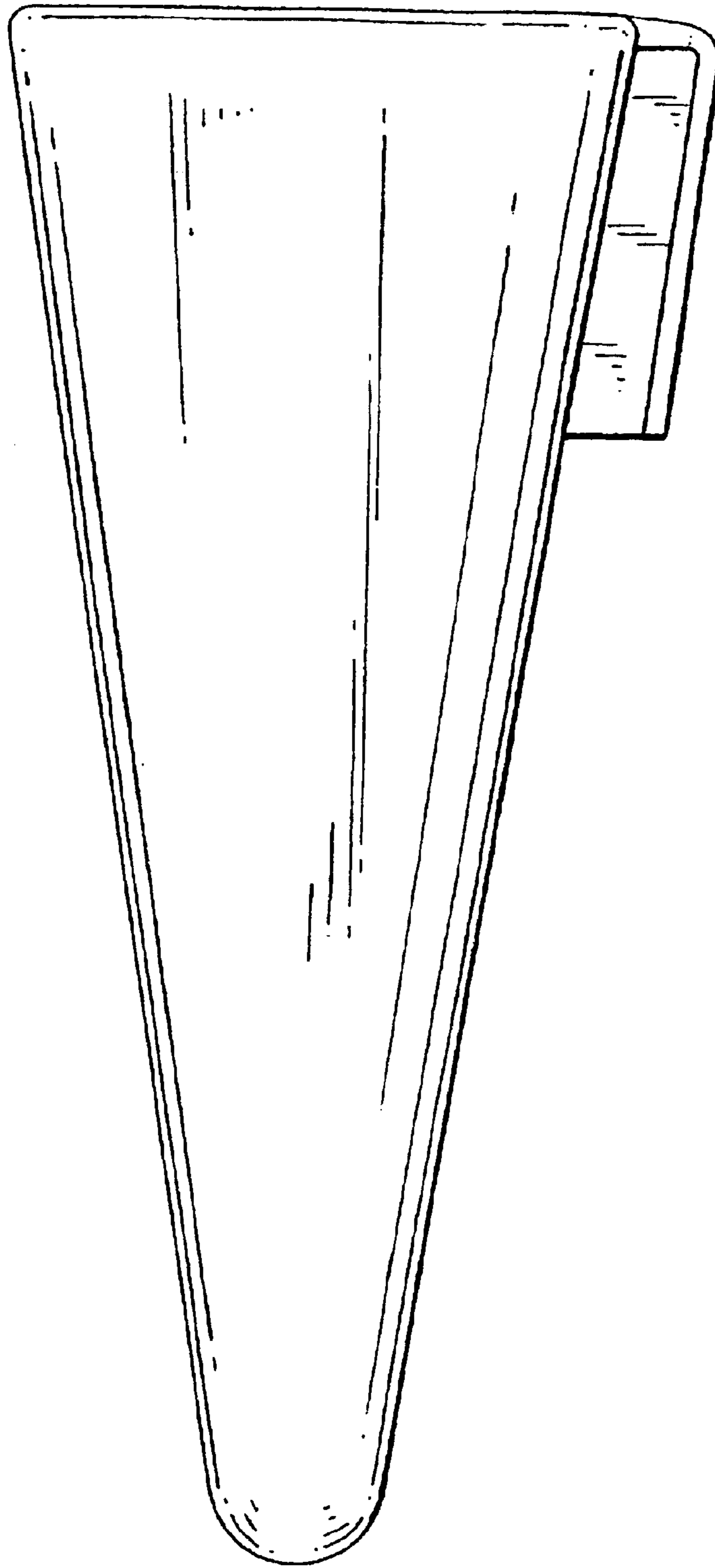

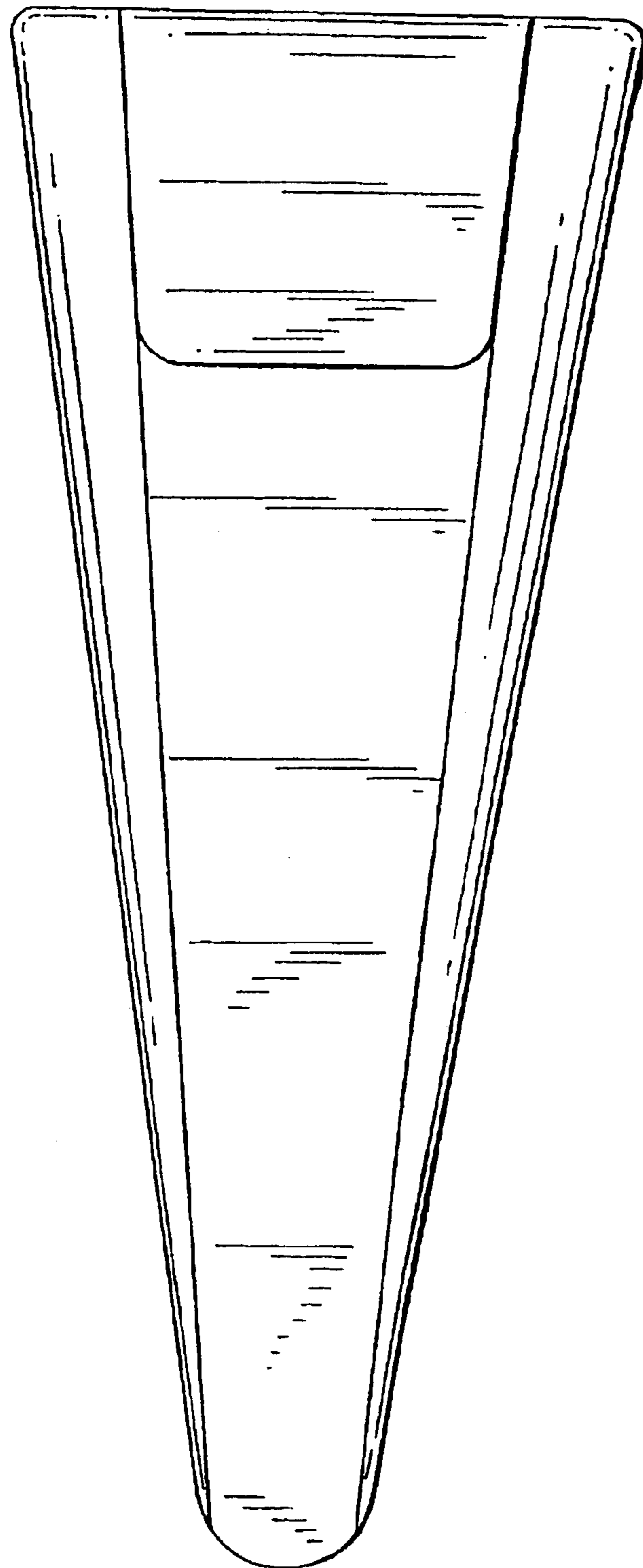

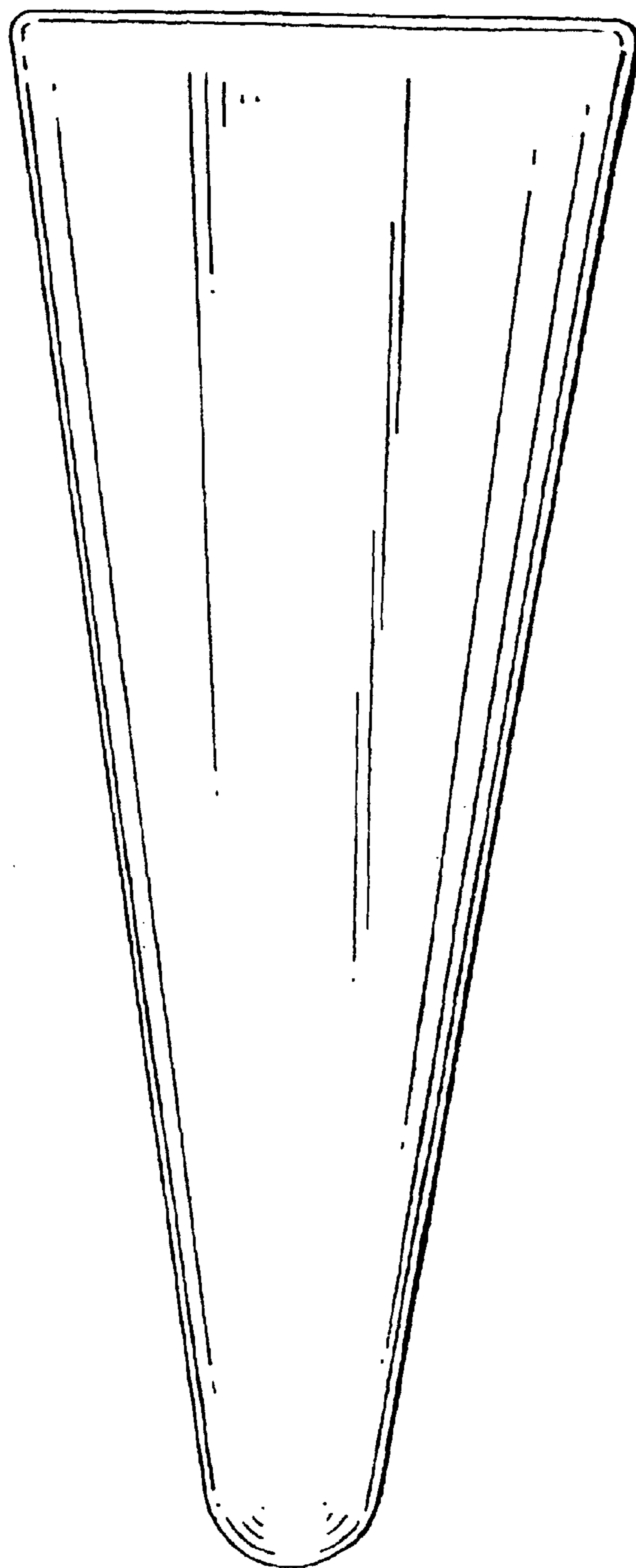

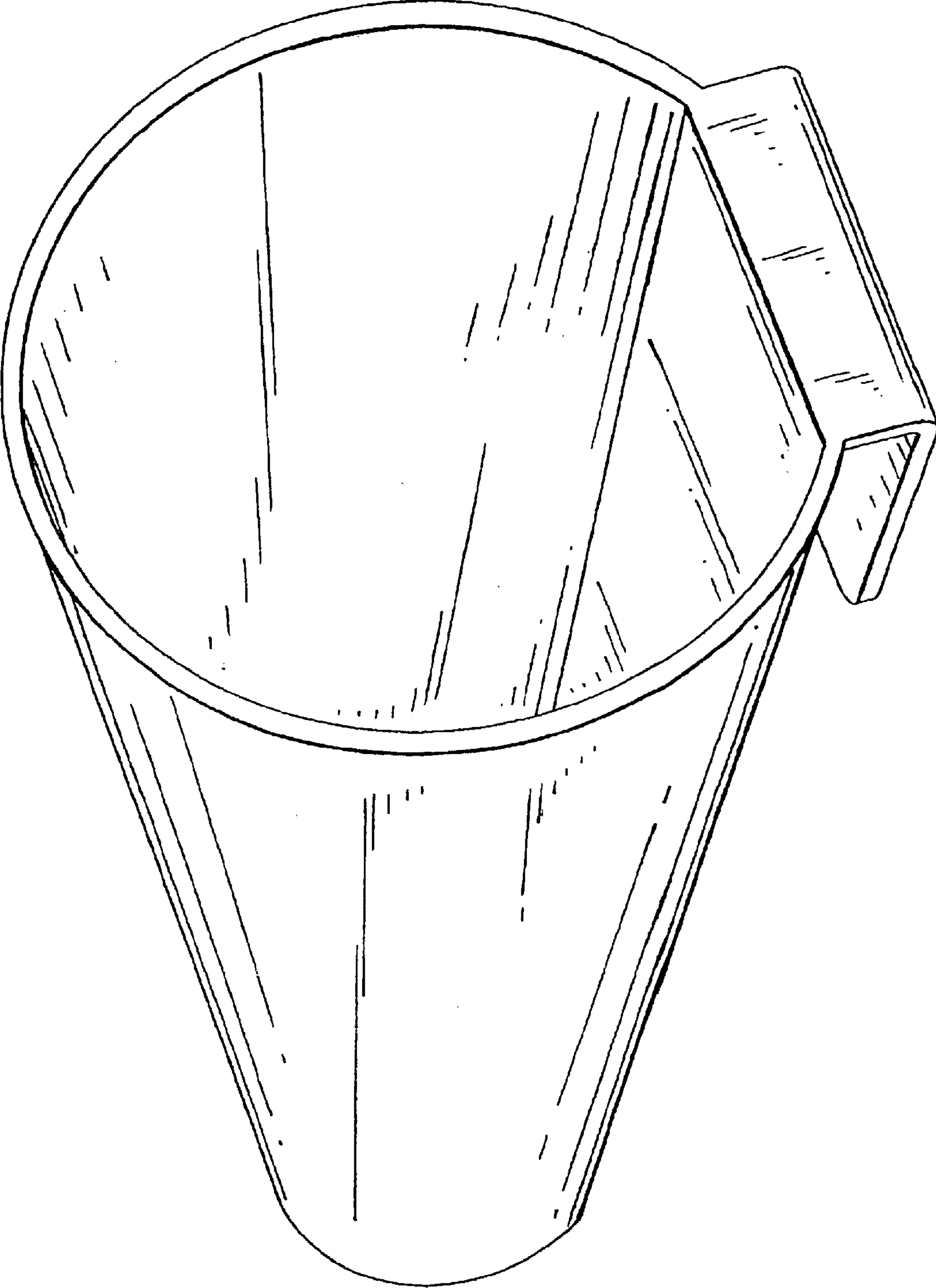
