DESCRIPTION

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product the other side elevation view being a mirror image thereof.

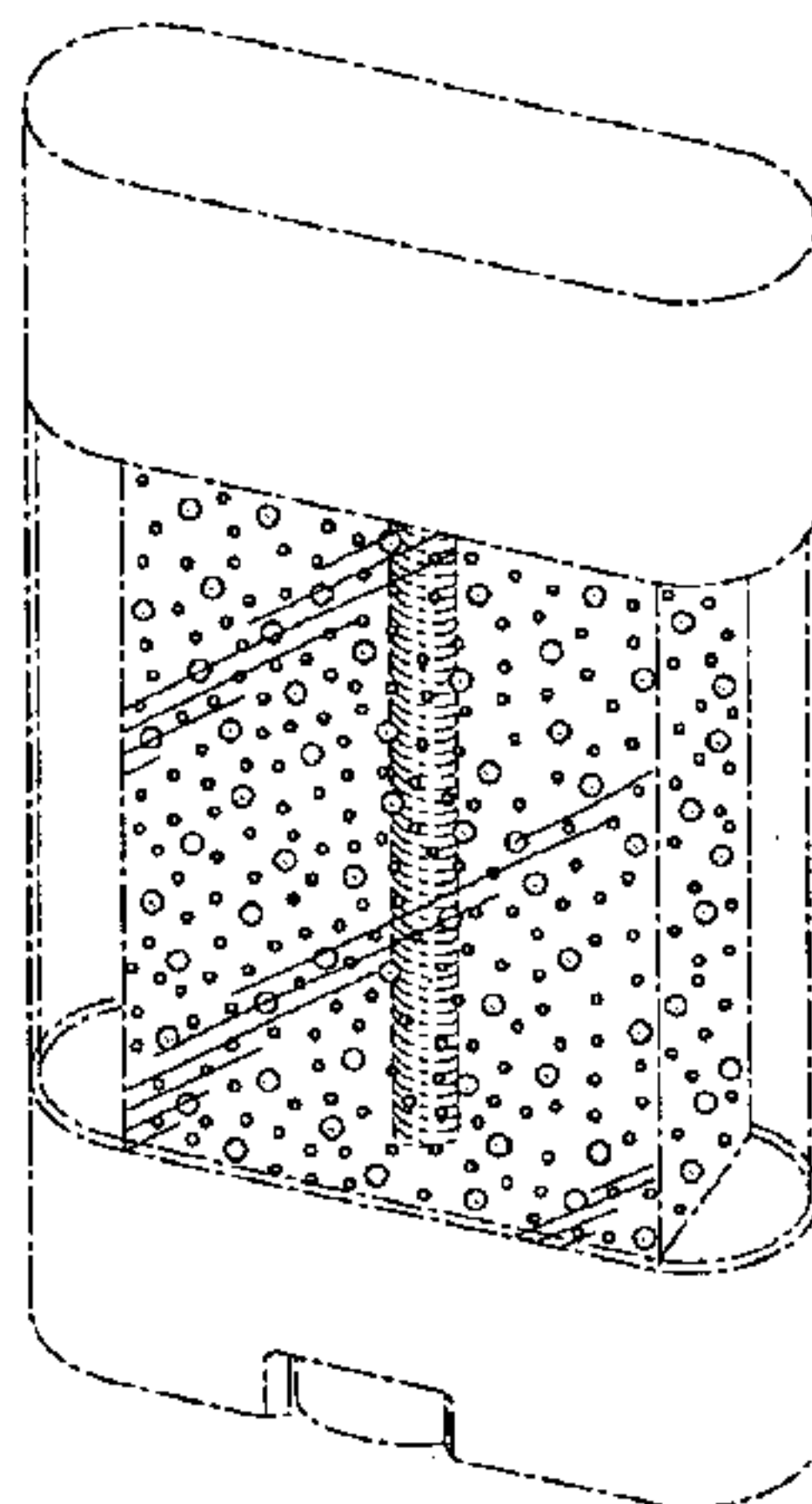

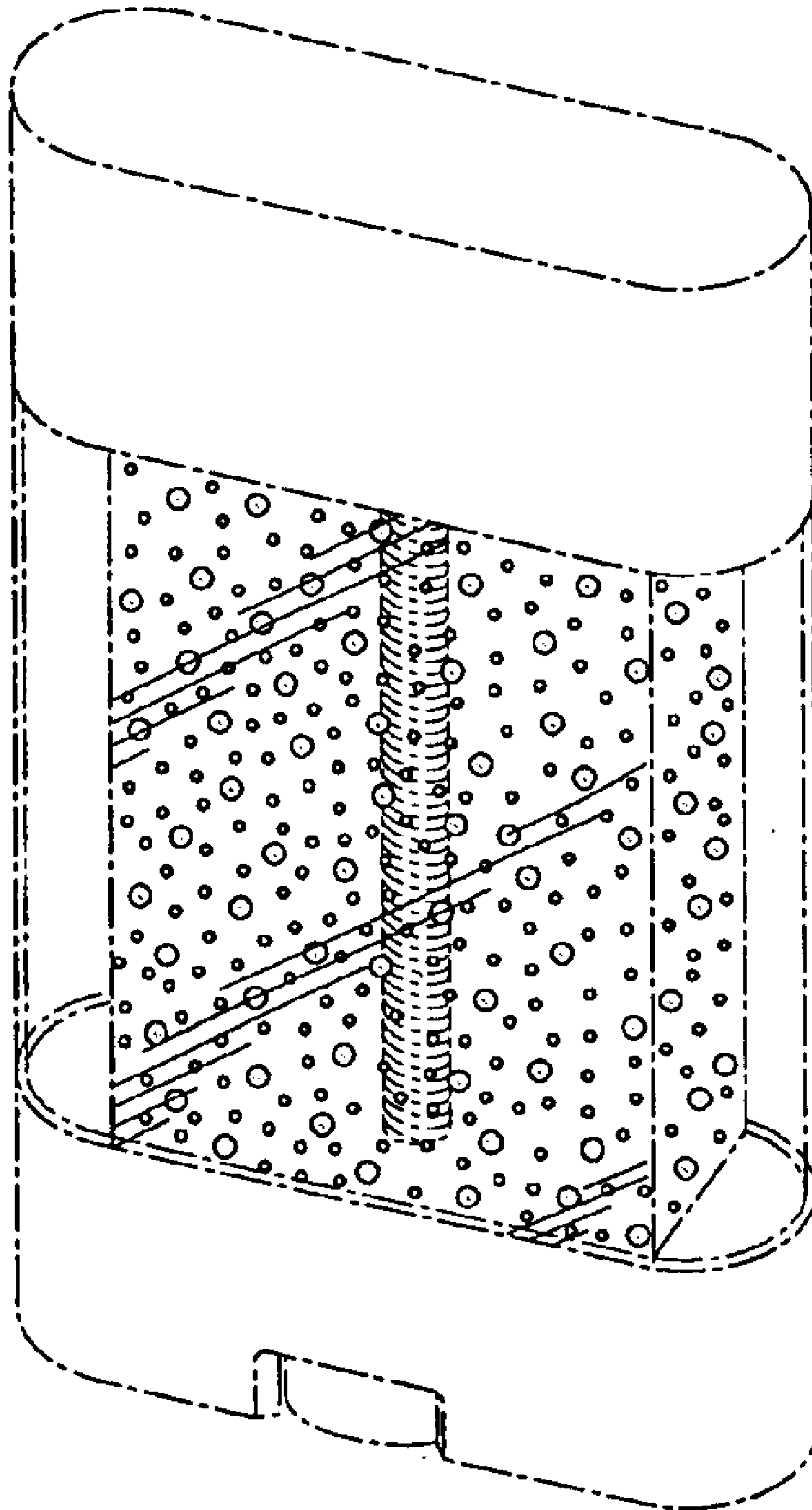

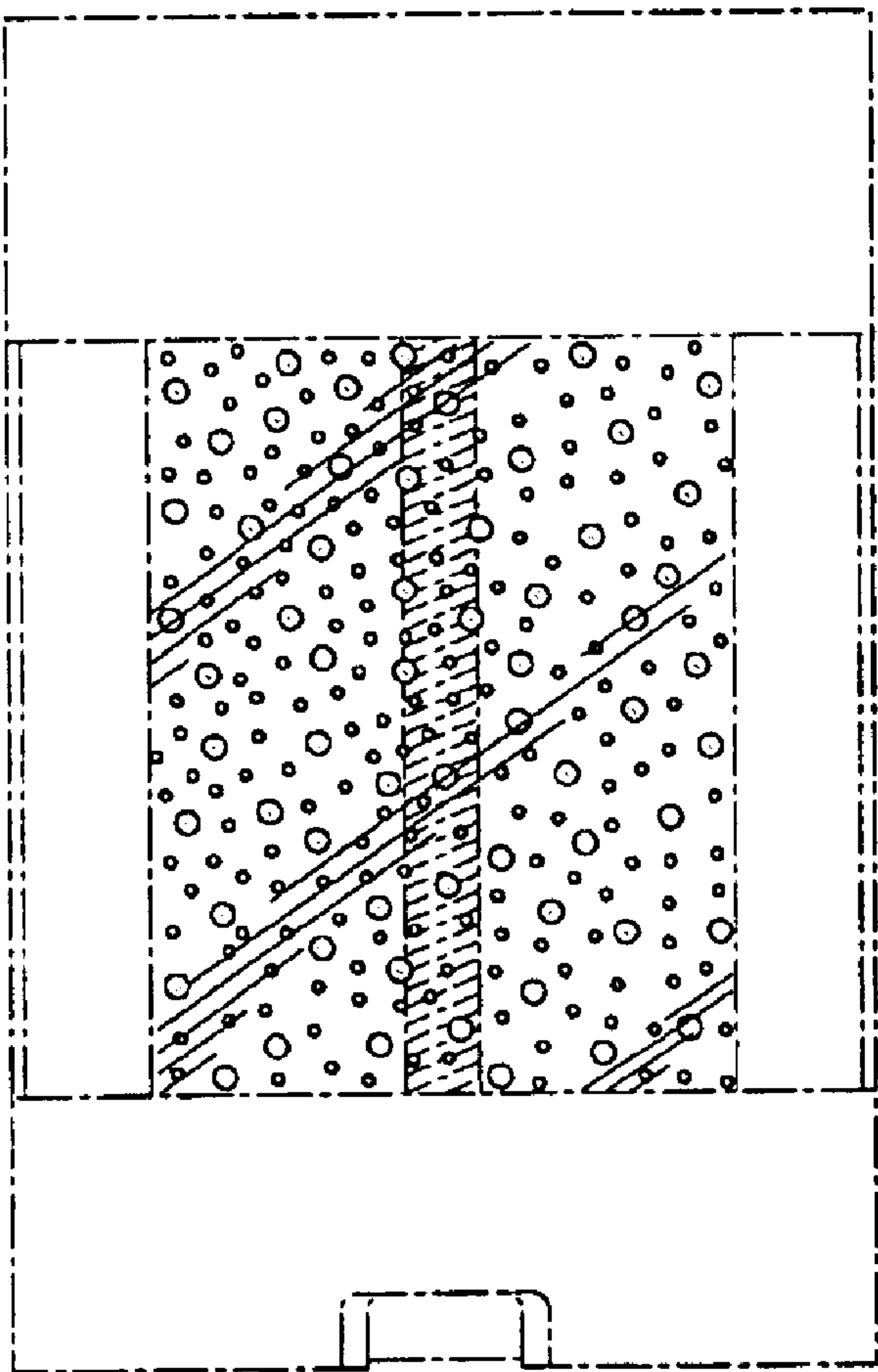
