(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fishing lure brake away hook harness, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view;

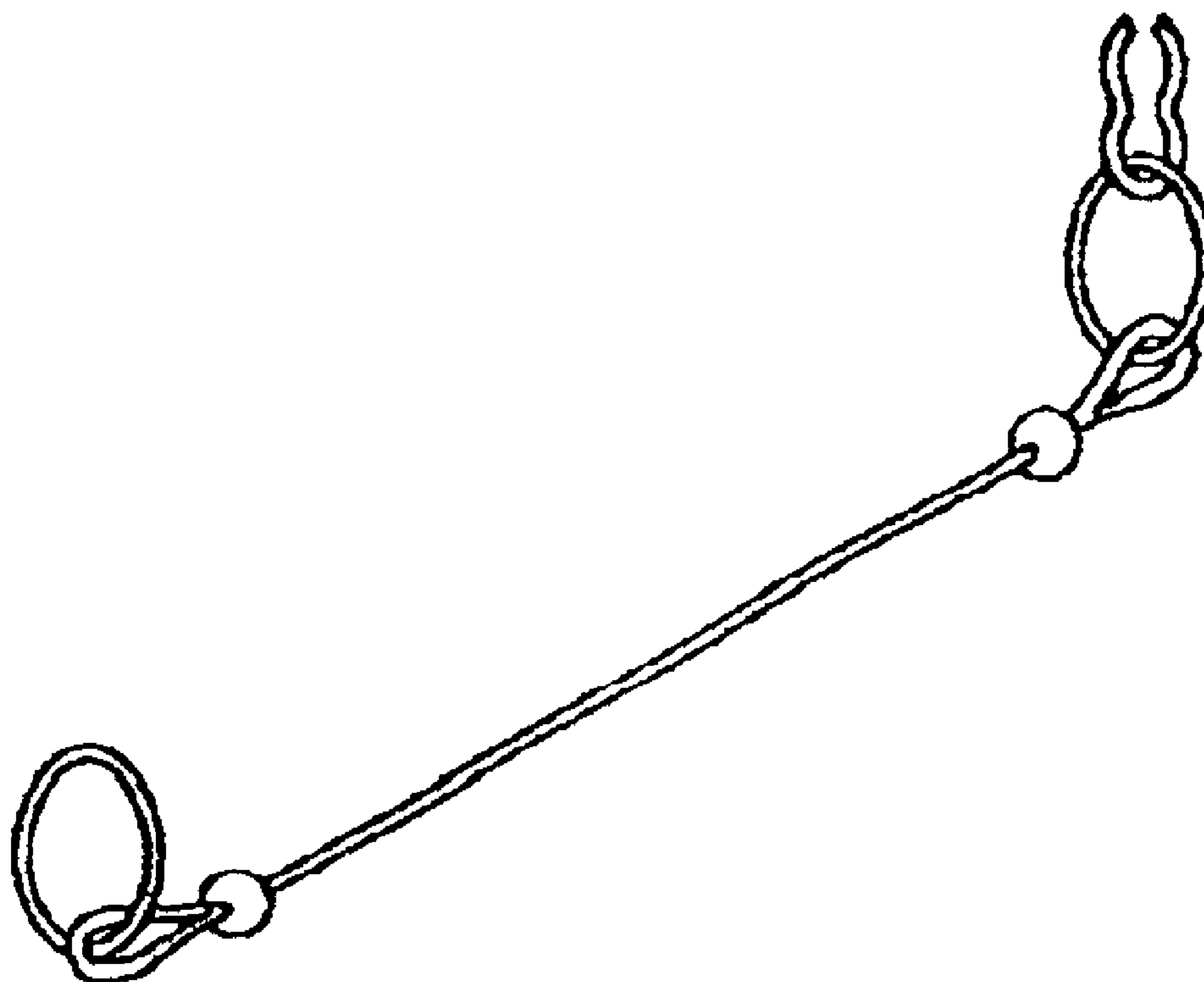
FIG. 8 is front view;

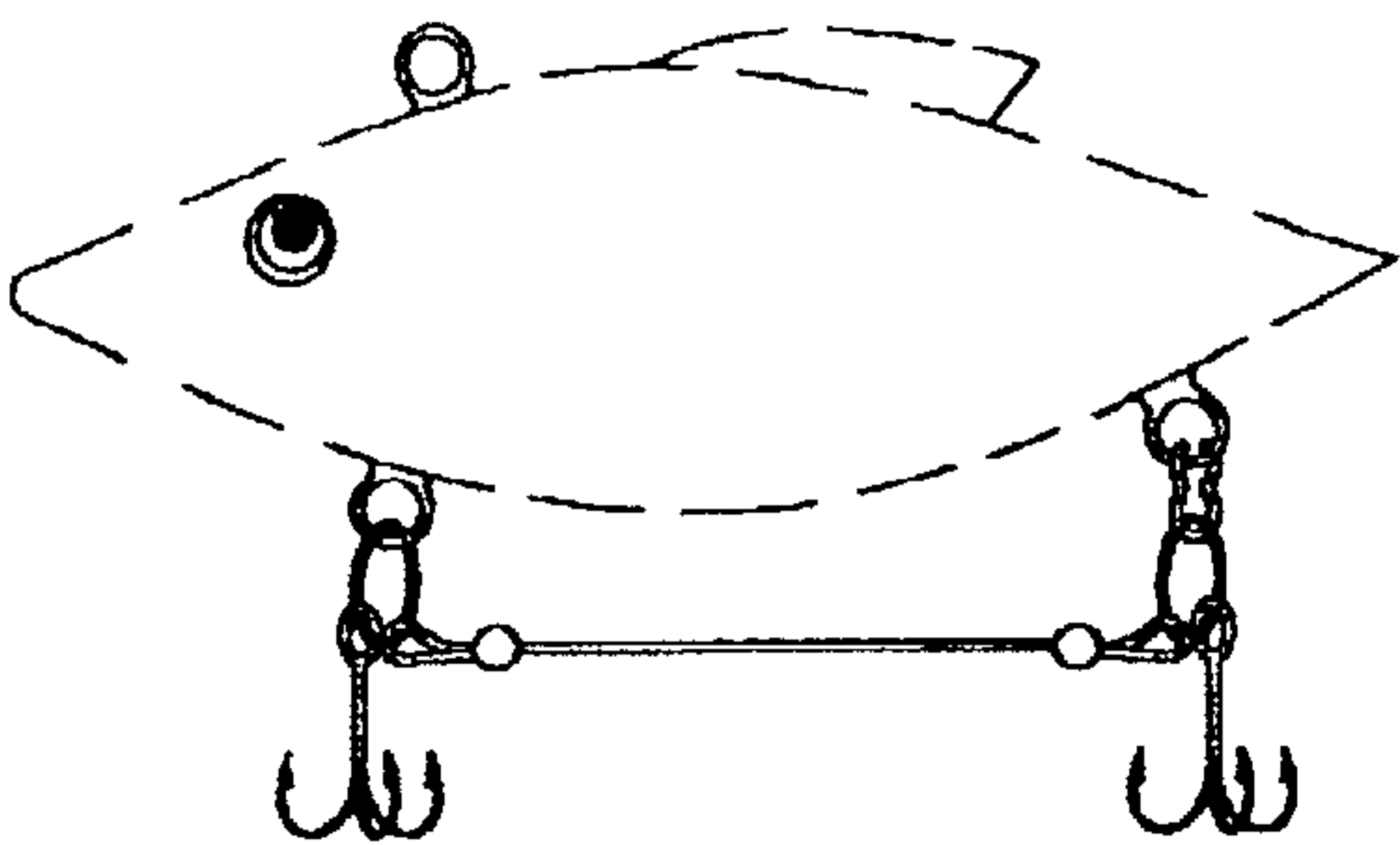

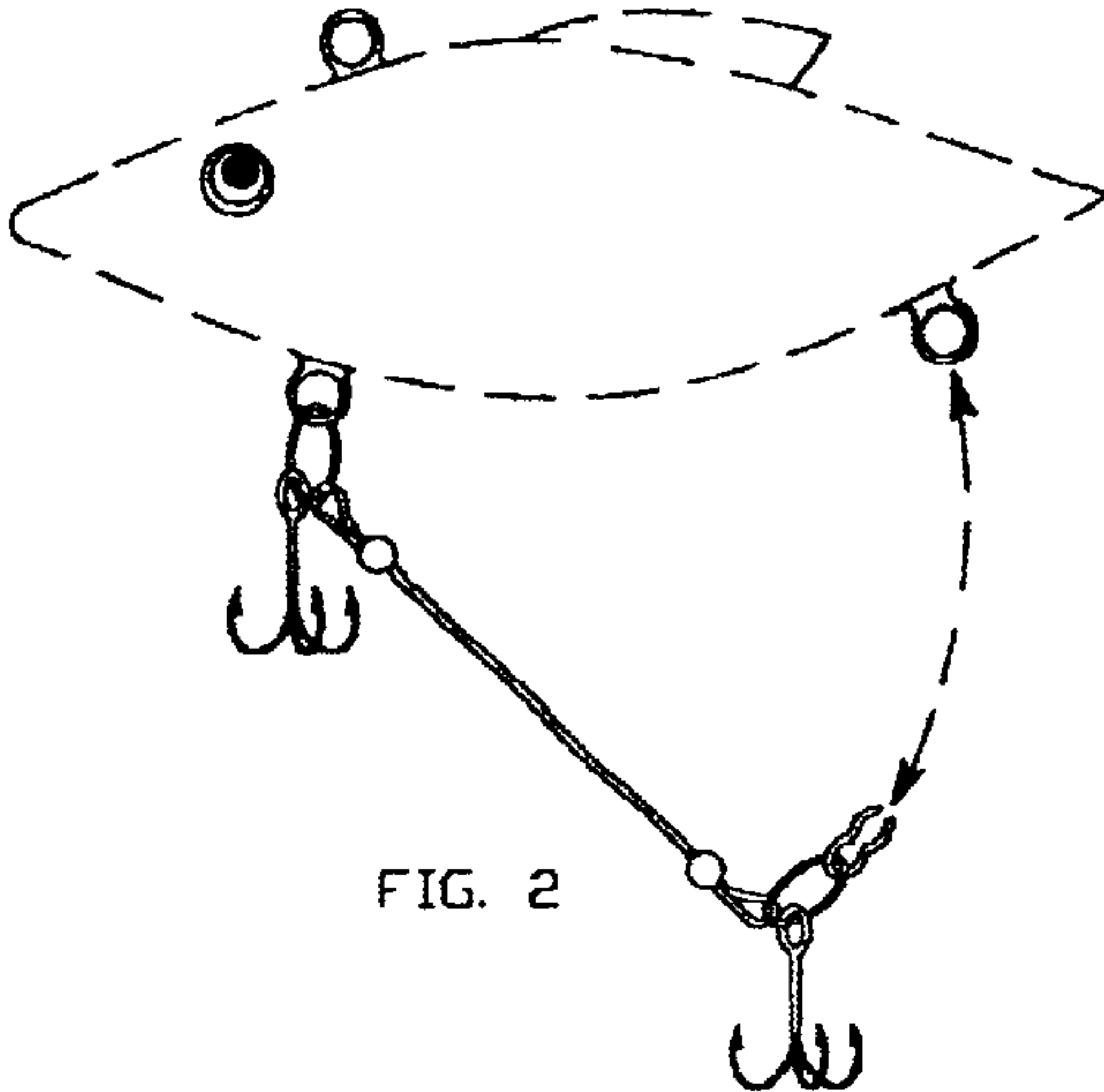

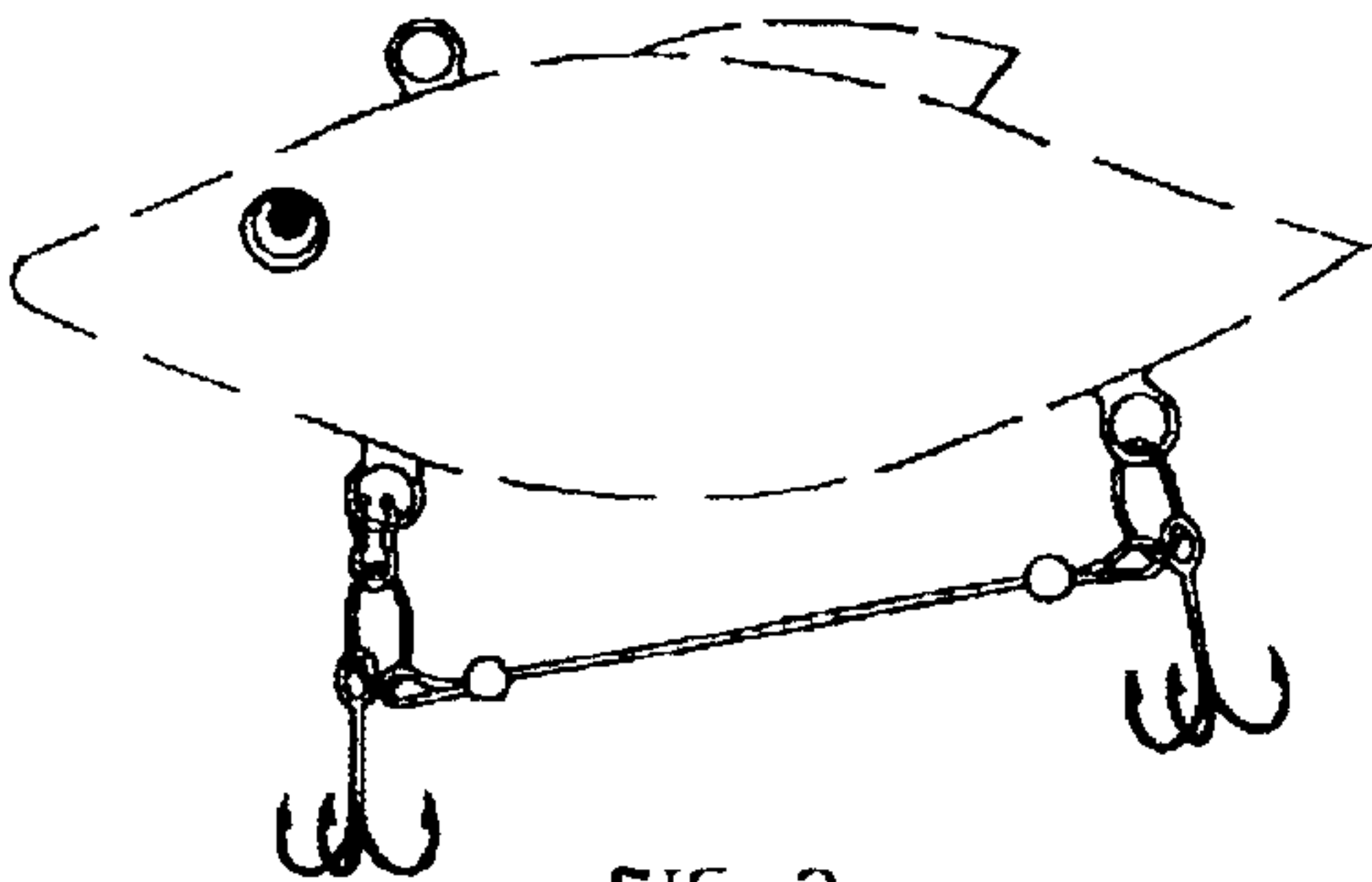

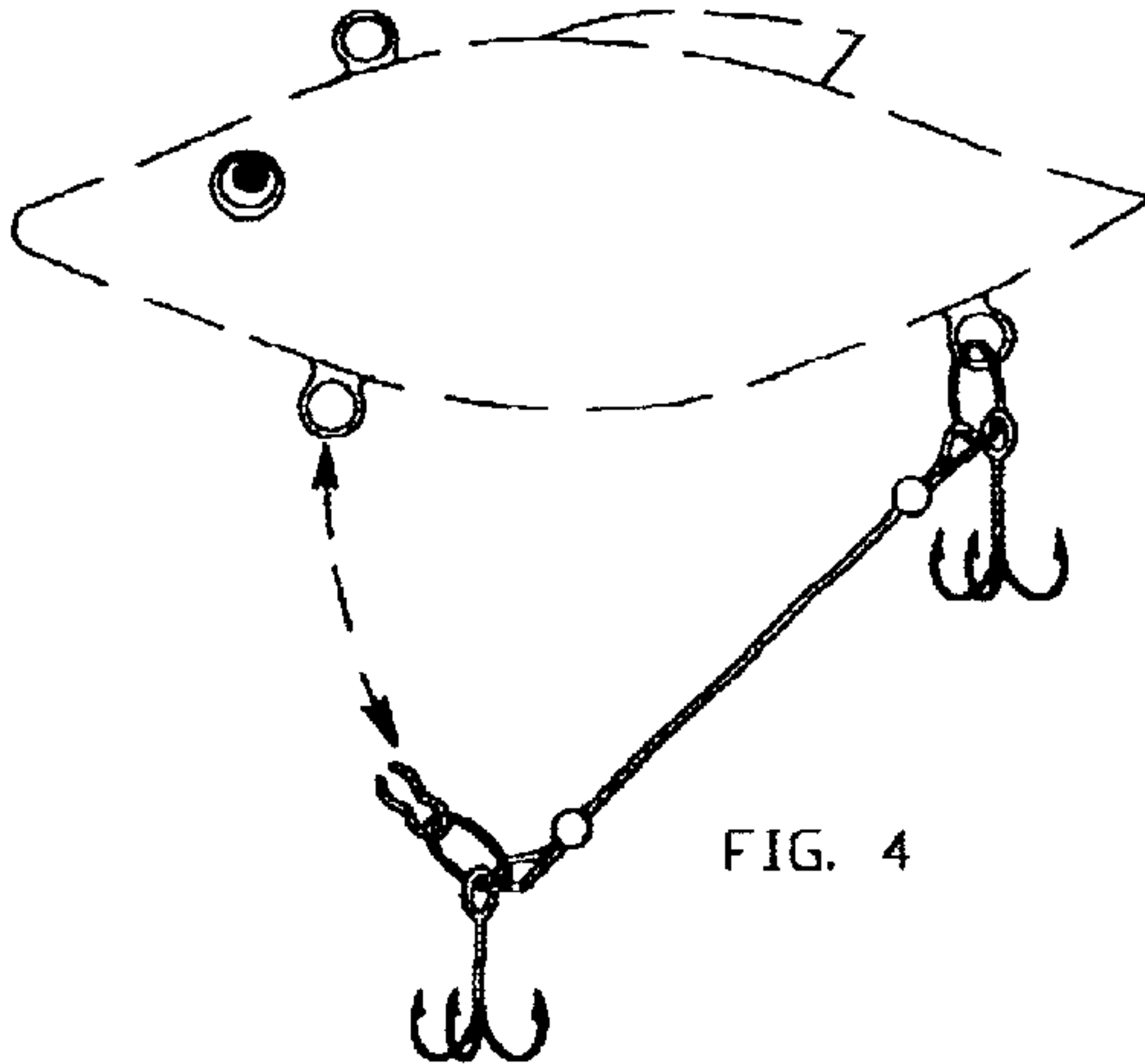

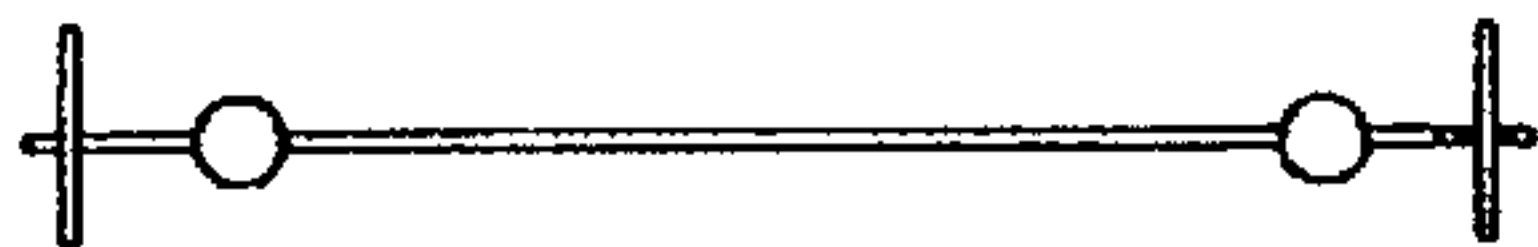

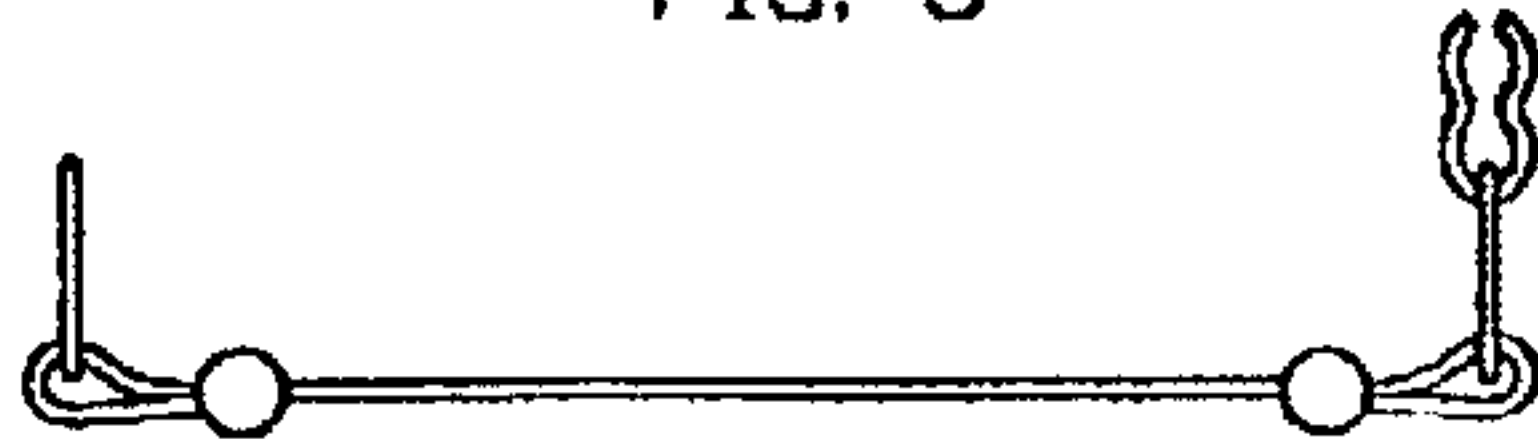

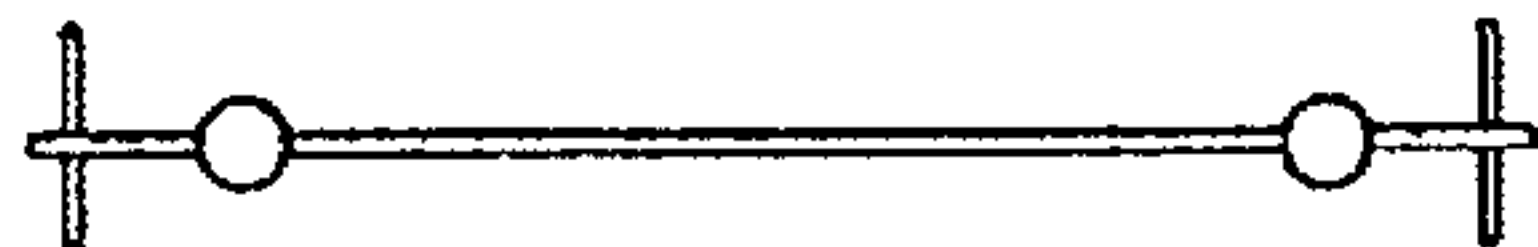

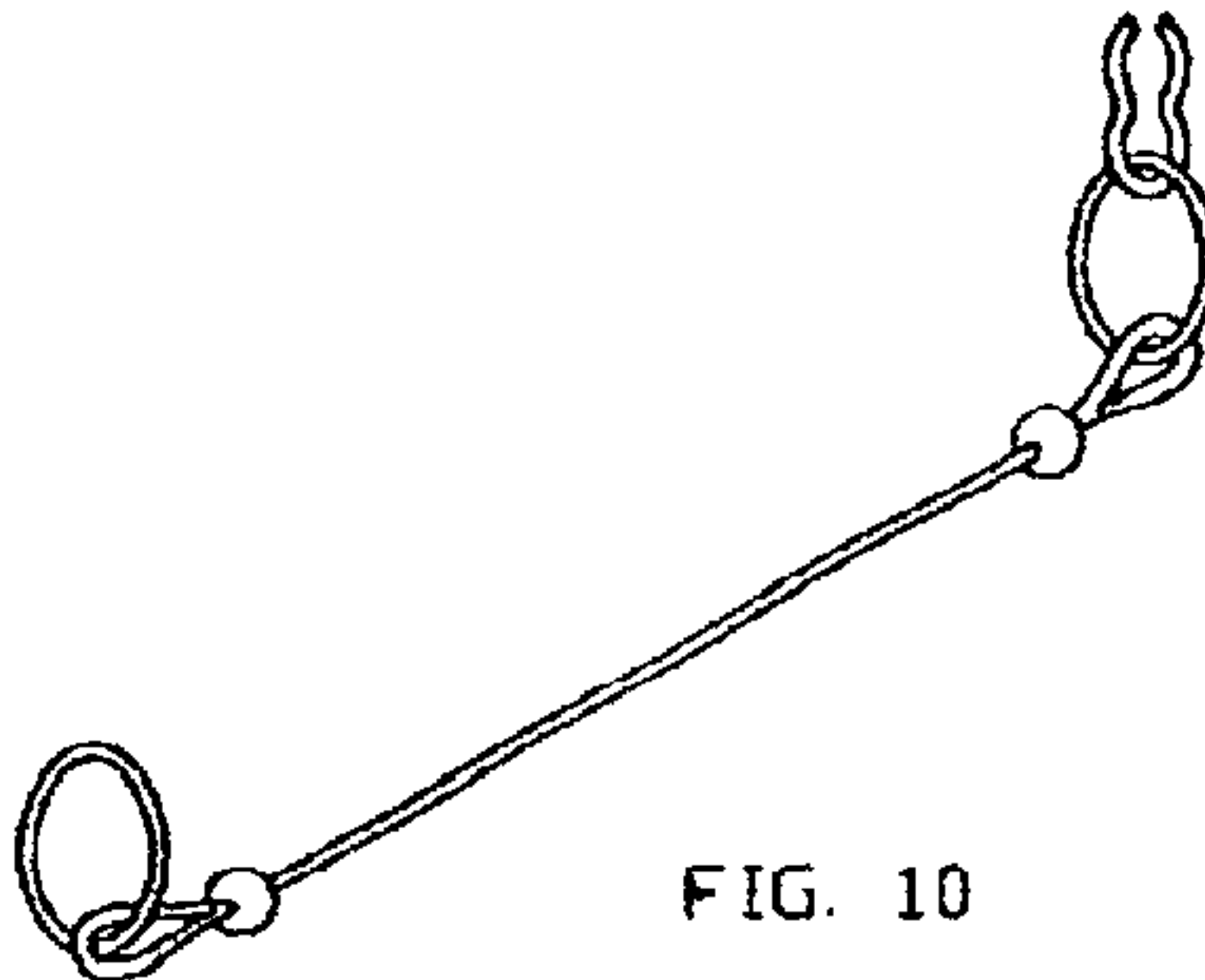
