(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a camouflage pattern applied to material, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The sole FIGURE is a top plan view of a camouflage pattern applied to material showing my new design. The broken line border about the outer perimeter is indicative of indeterminate size and shape and depicts the material to which the camouflage pattern is applied and is not part of the design. The vertical and horizontal sinusoidal shaped white lines, which are not part of the claimed design, indicate that the design continues indeterminately in both length and width. It is to be understood that the pattern as well as the scale of the repeat unit may be varied. The varying patterns of grey tones, dots, and solid black are understood to represent contrast. The bottom surface is plain and unadorned.
