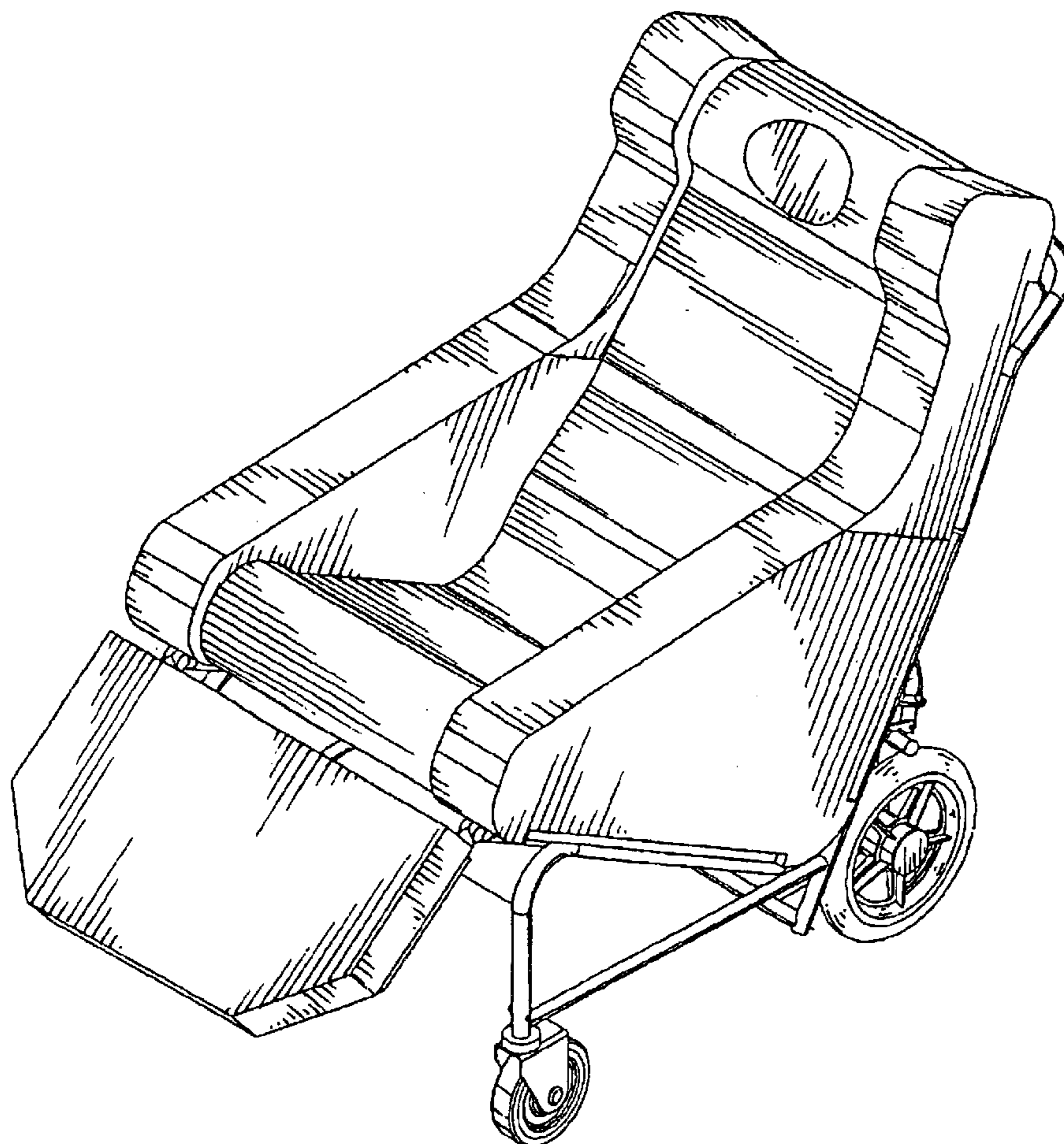
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a medical chair showing our new design;

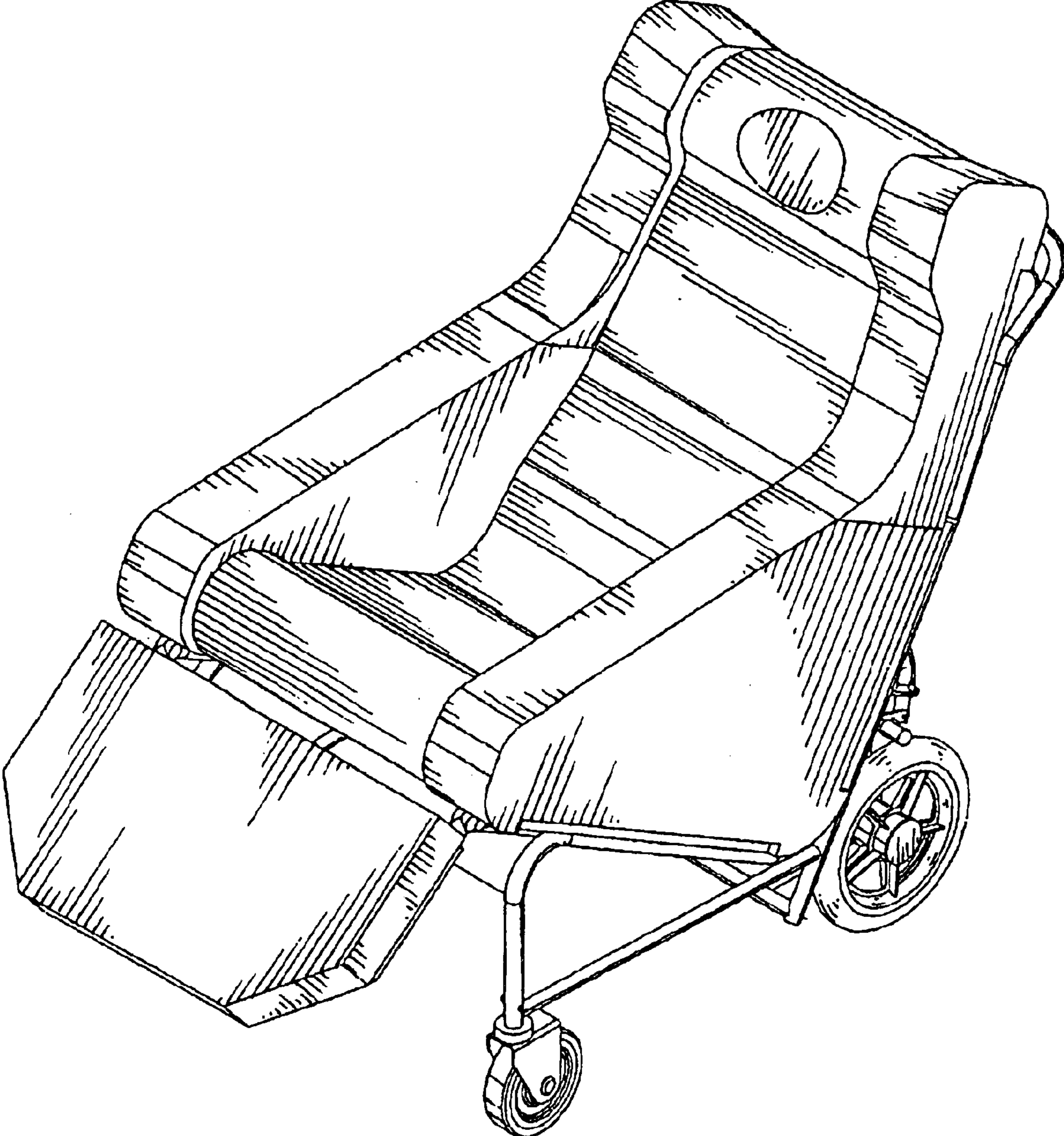

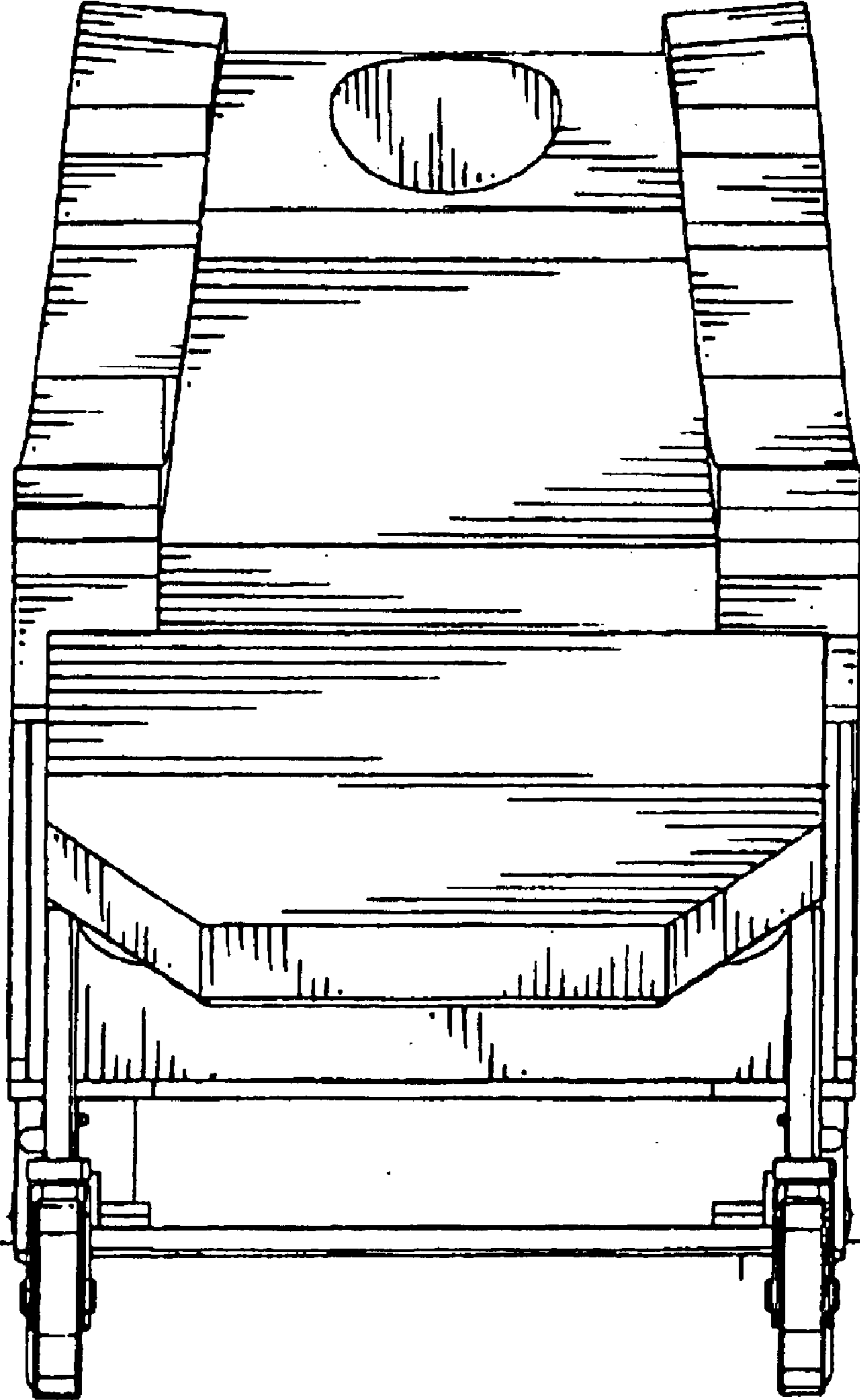

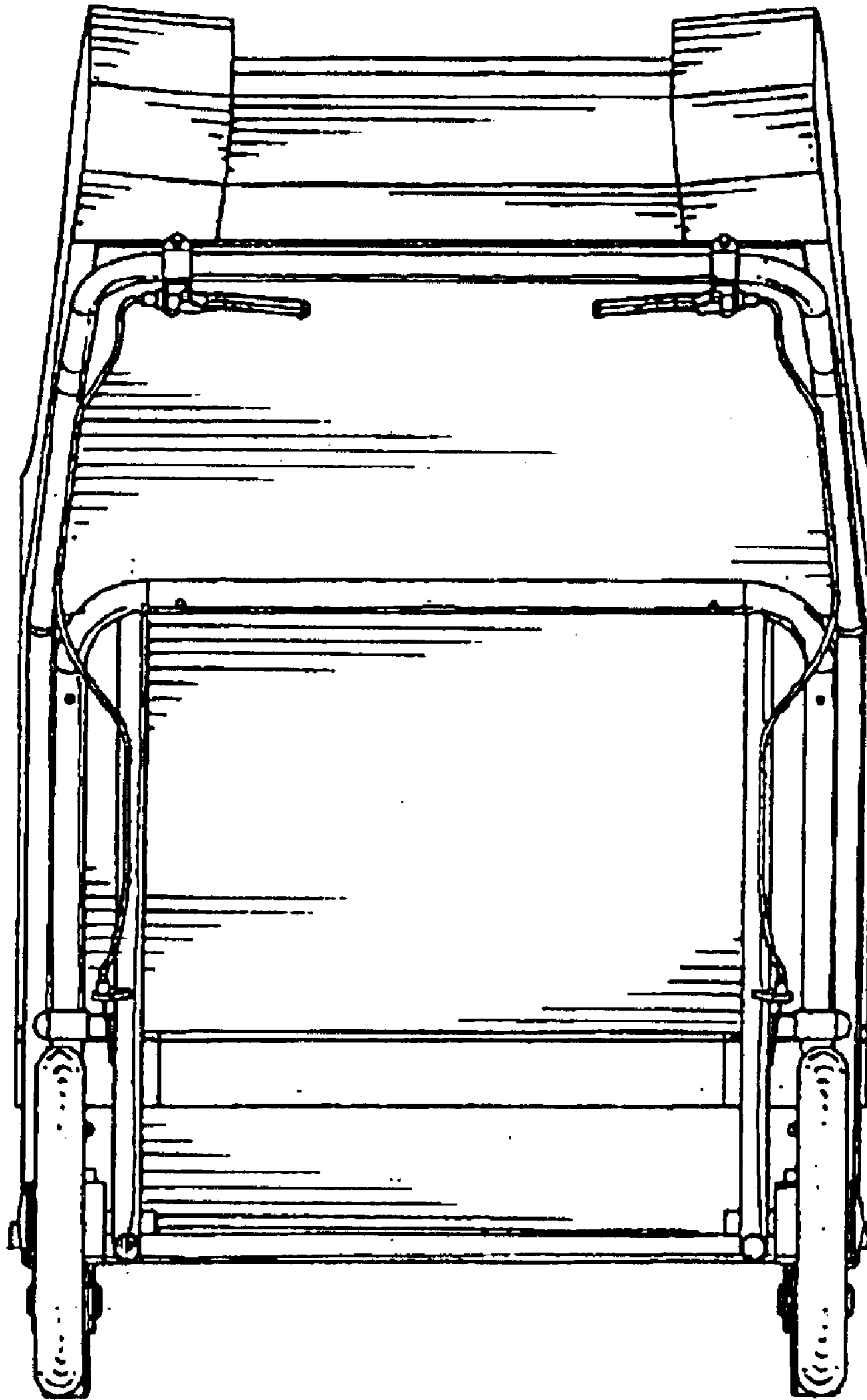

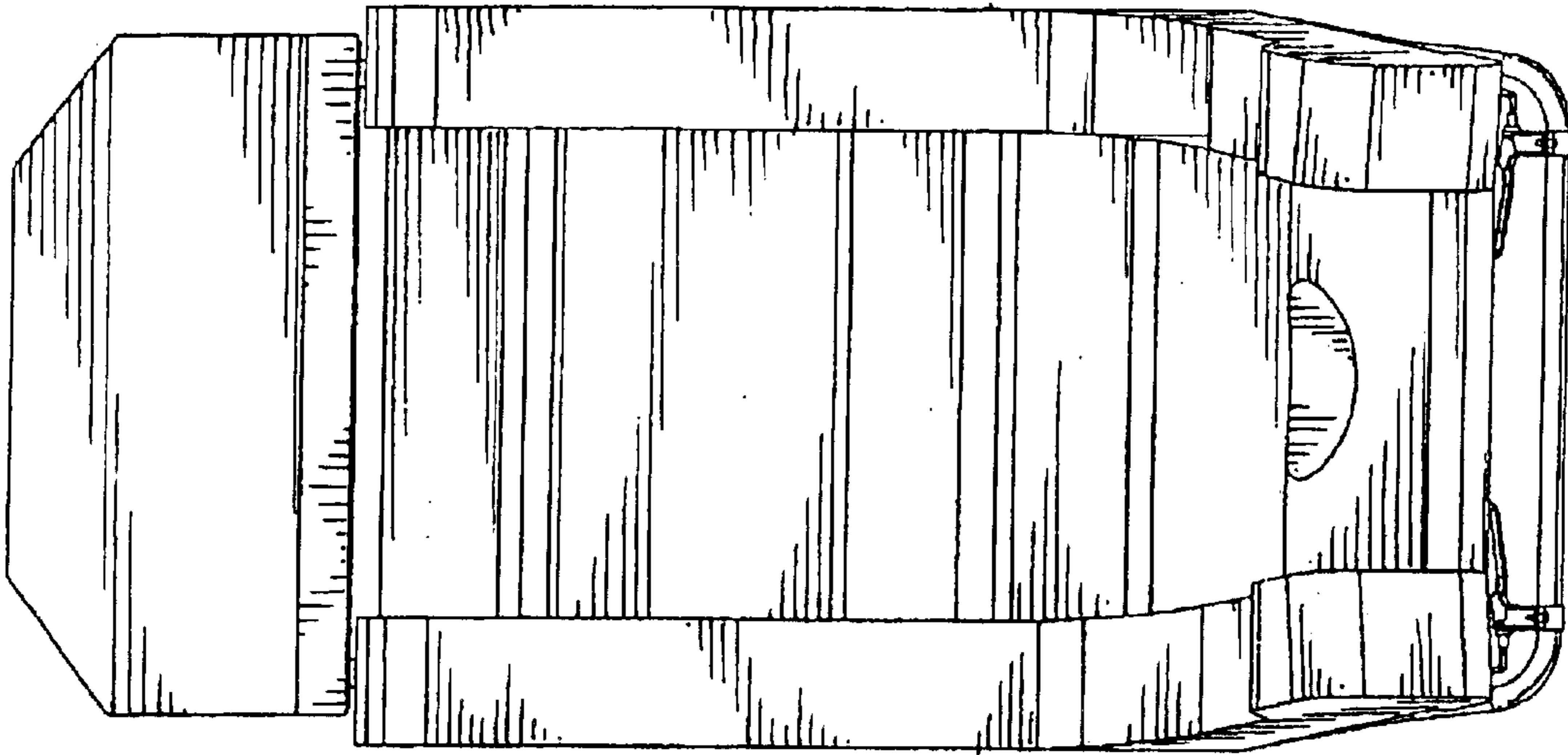

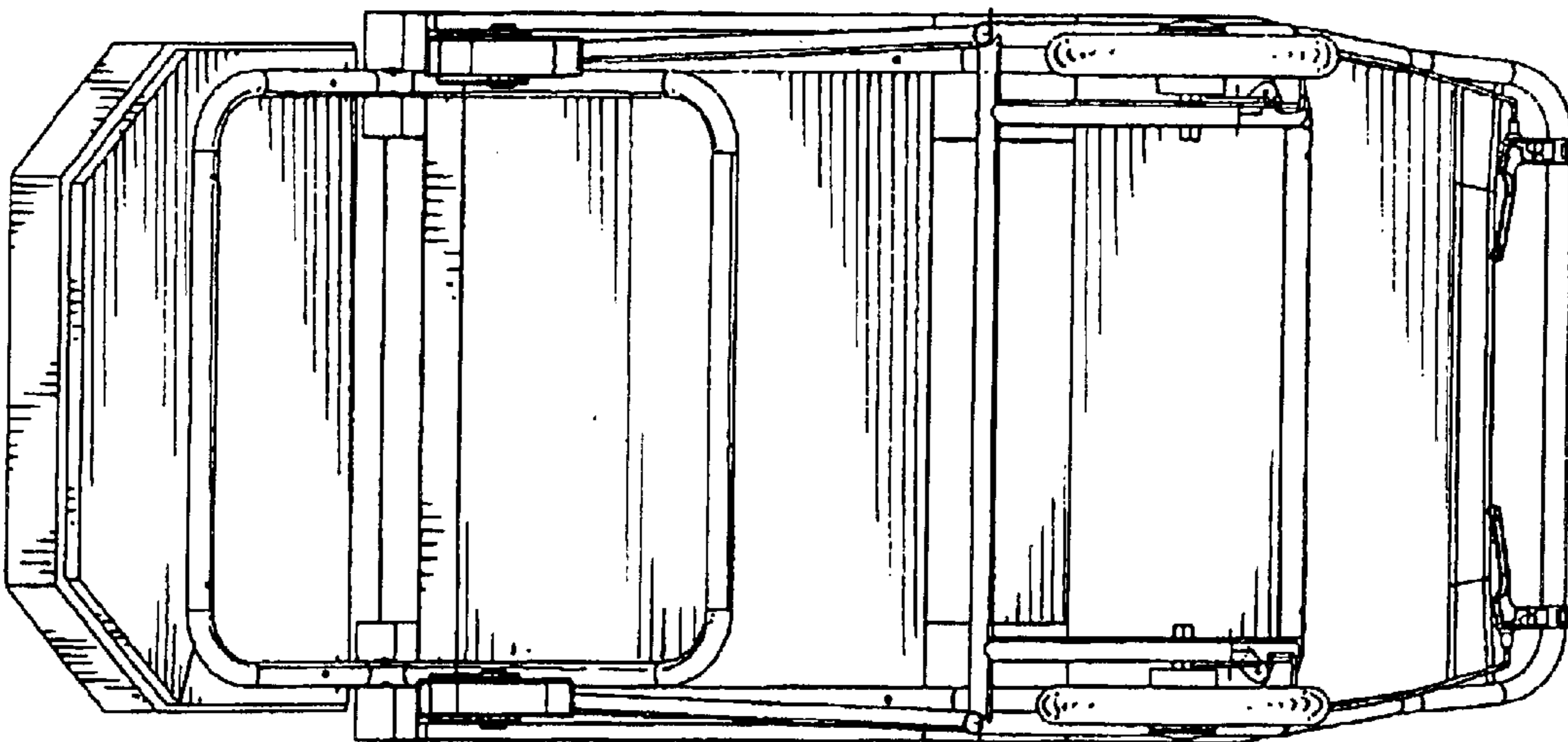

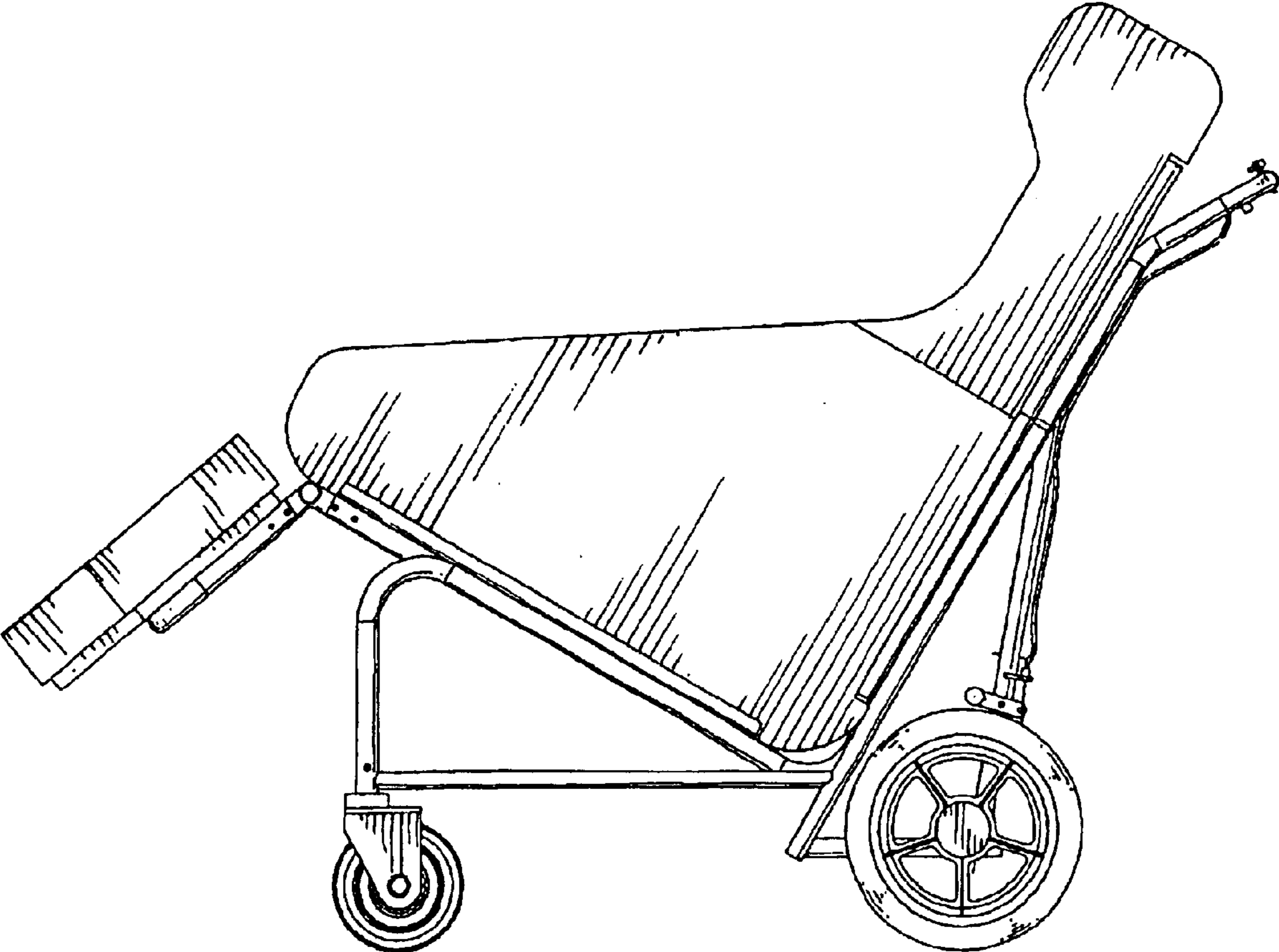
