FIG. 1 is a front view of scrollbar for an image processing office machine showing the design of the present invention, on a reduced scale;

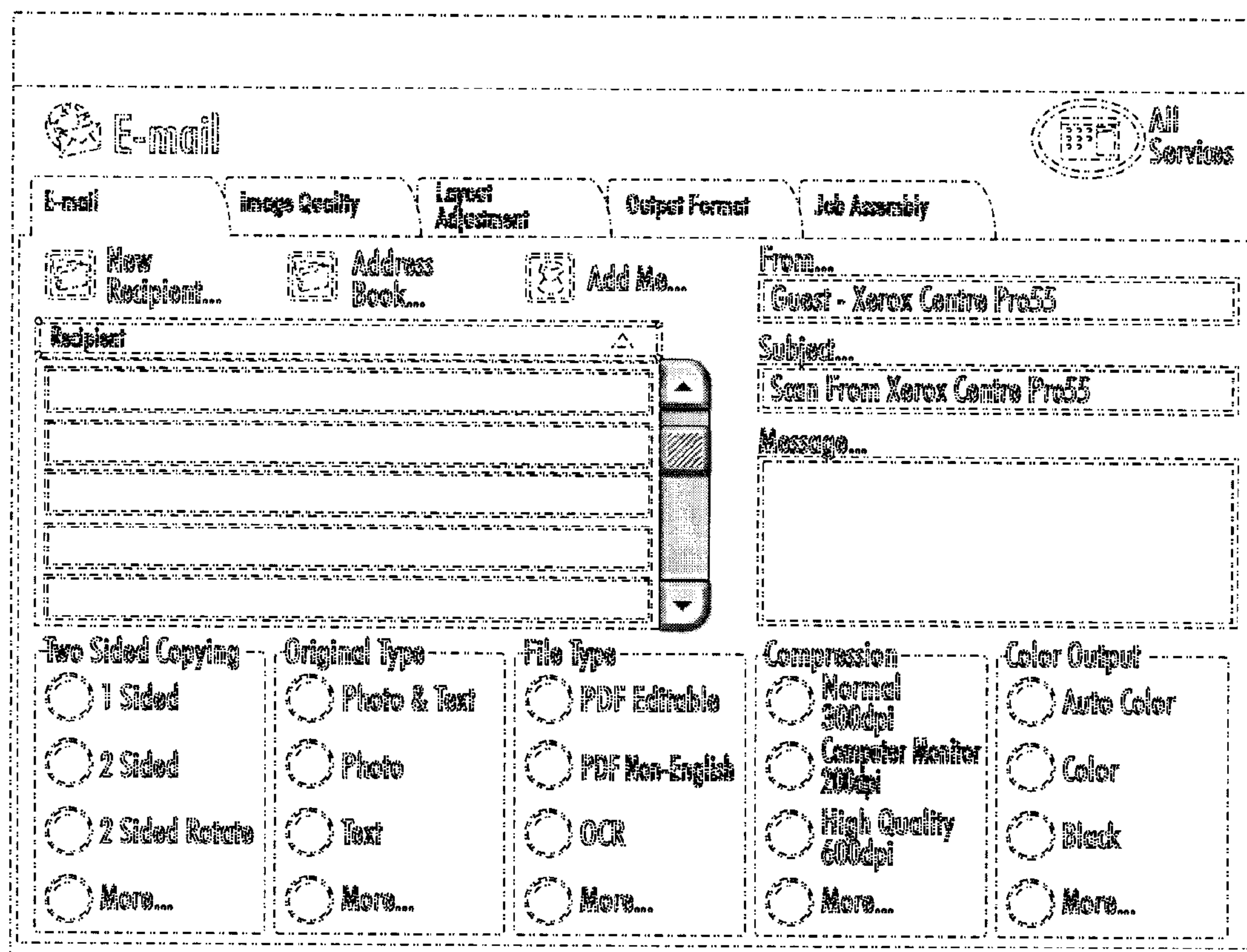
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

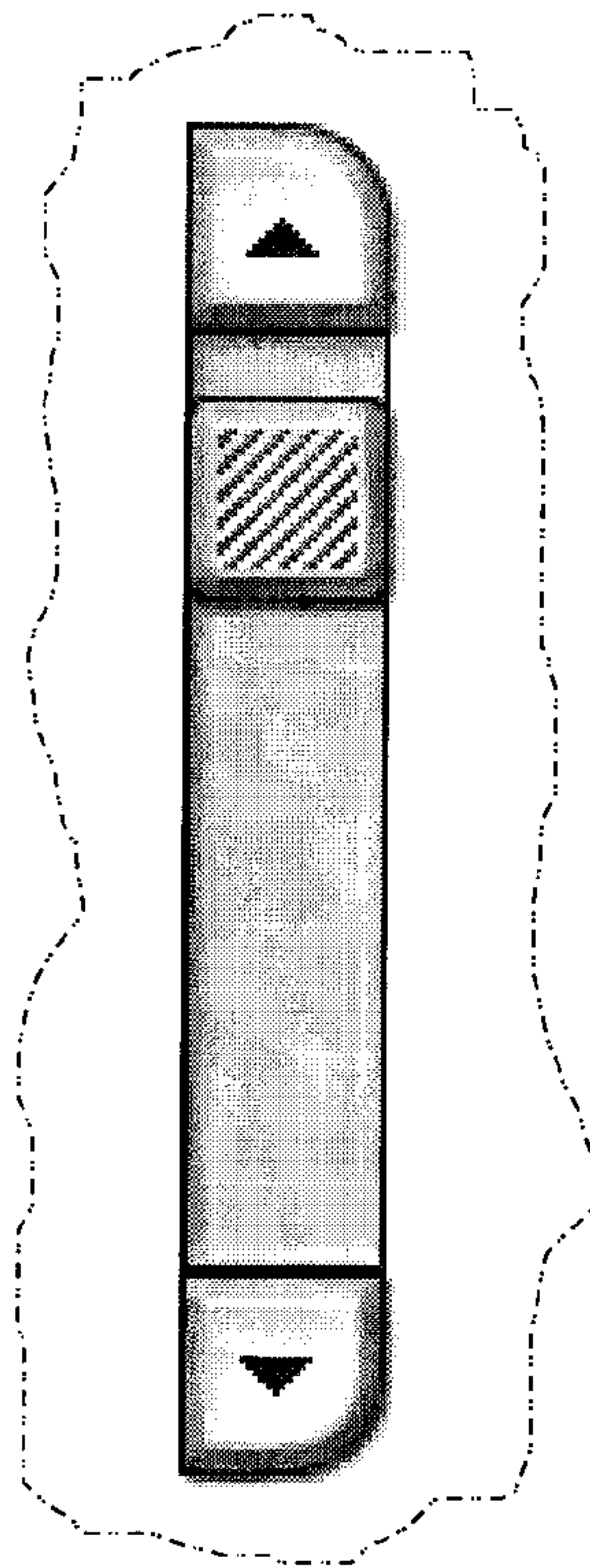

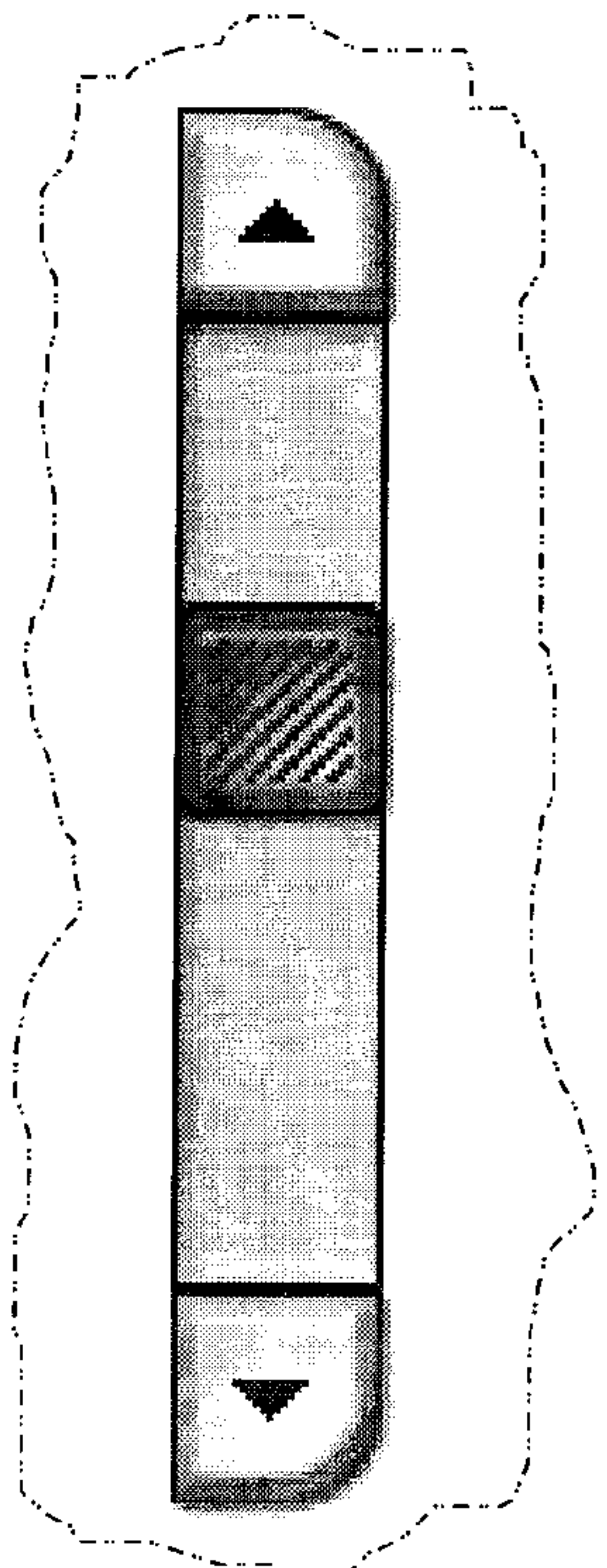

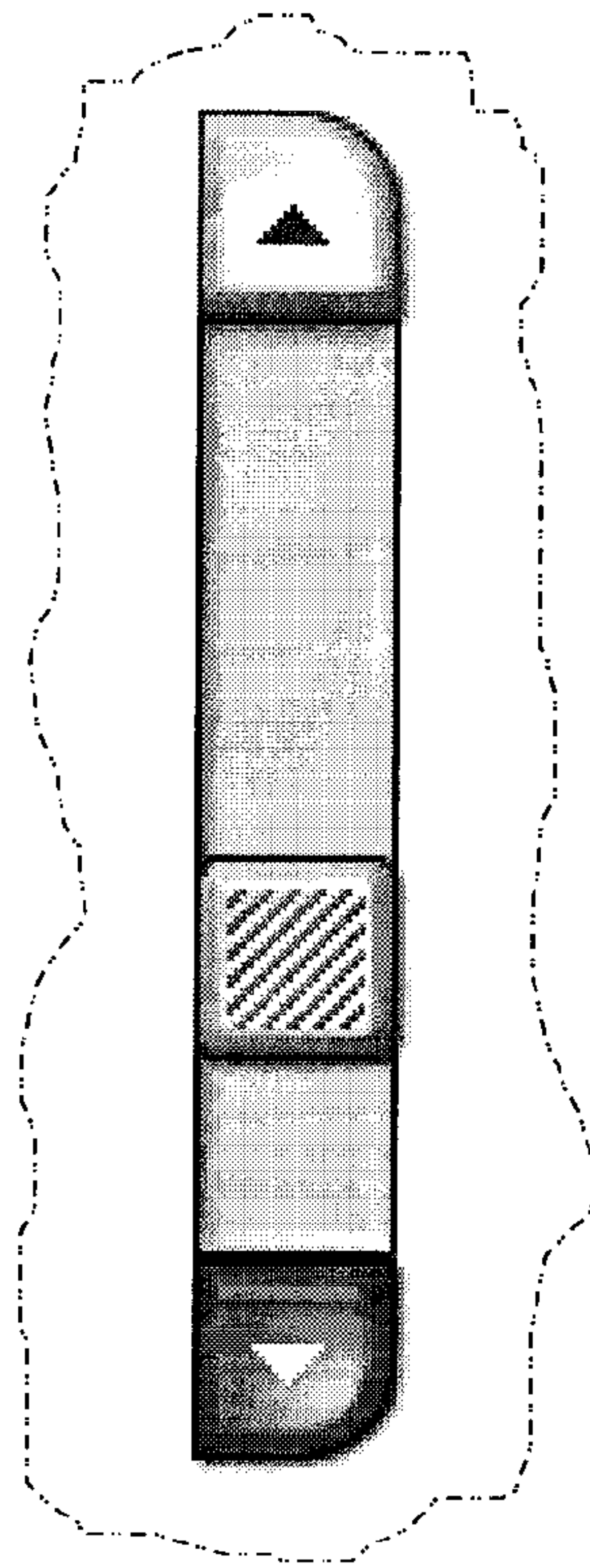

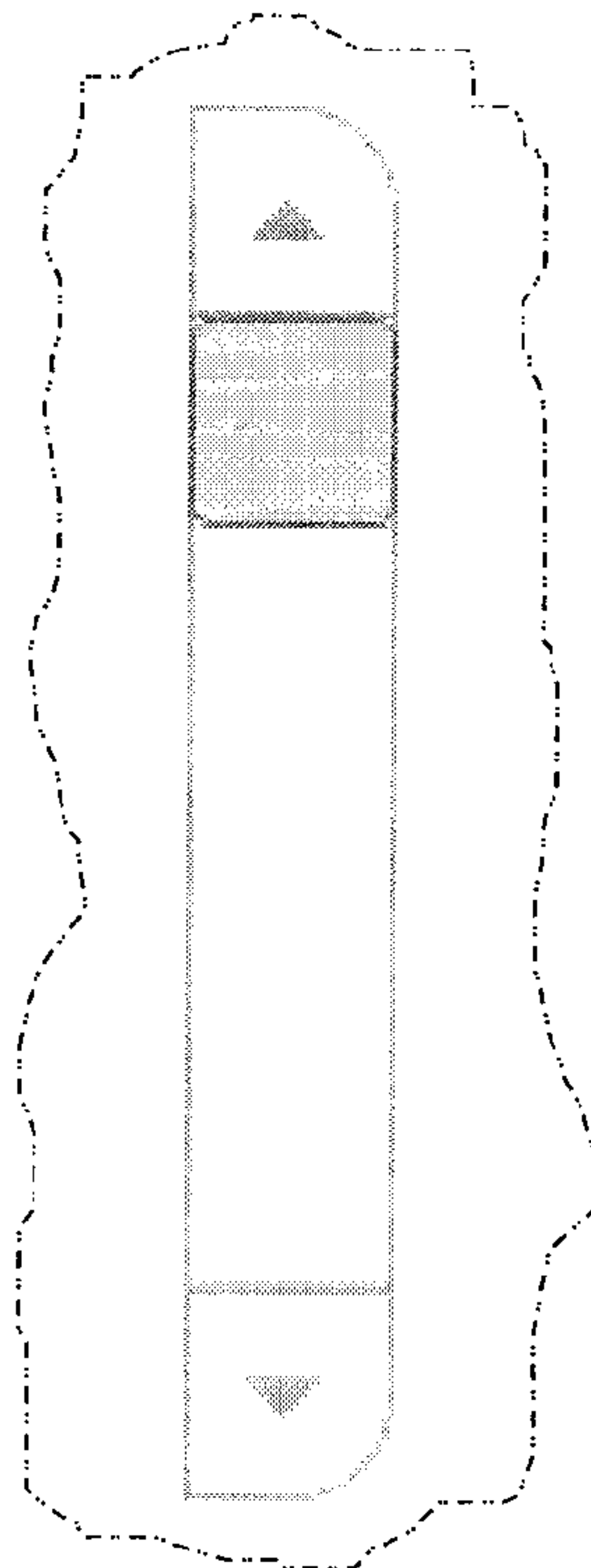
