DESCRIPTION

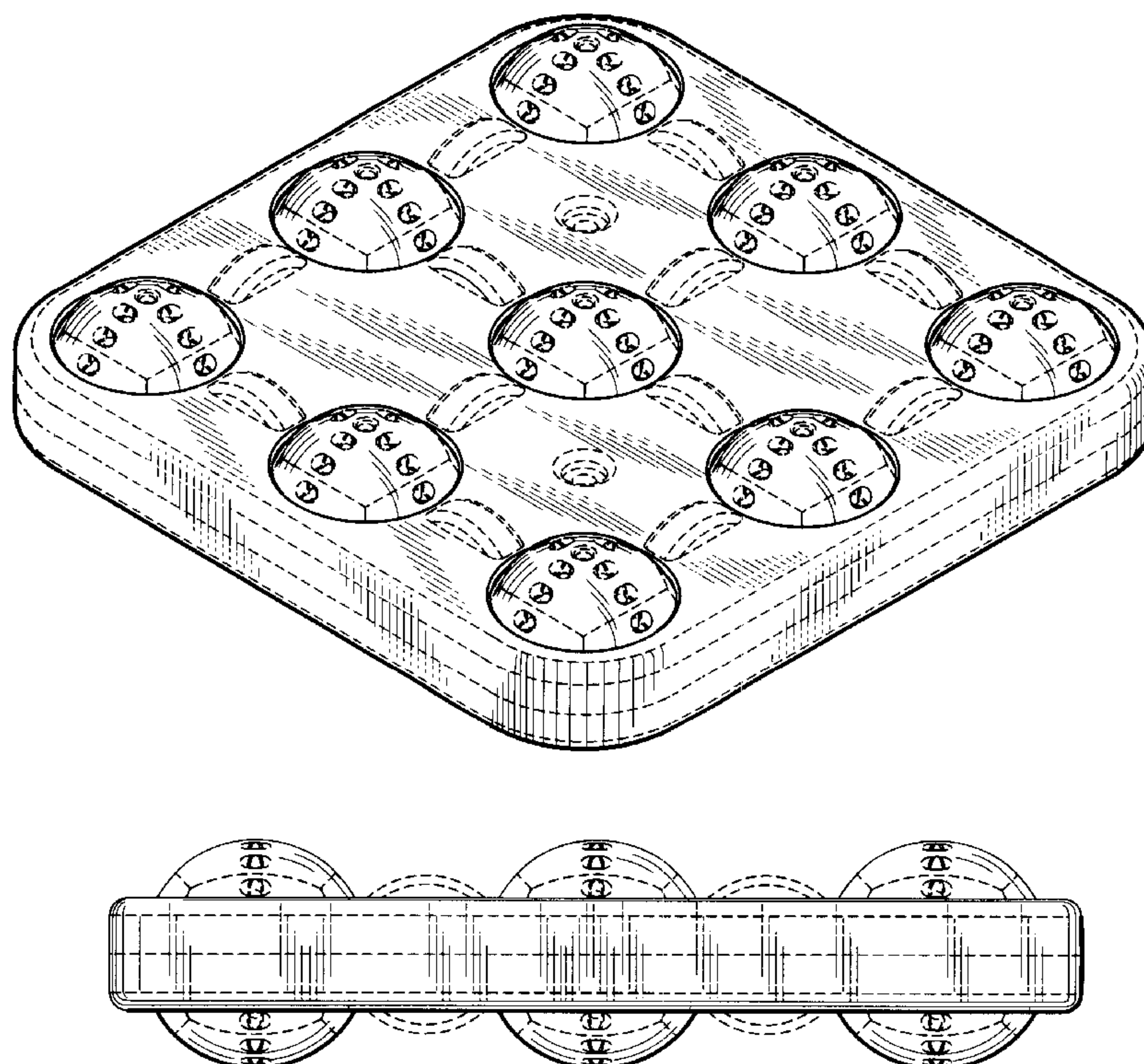
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FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a puzzle showing my new design;

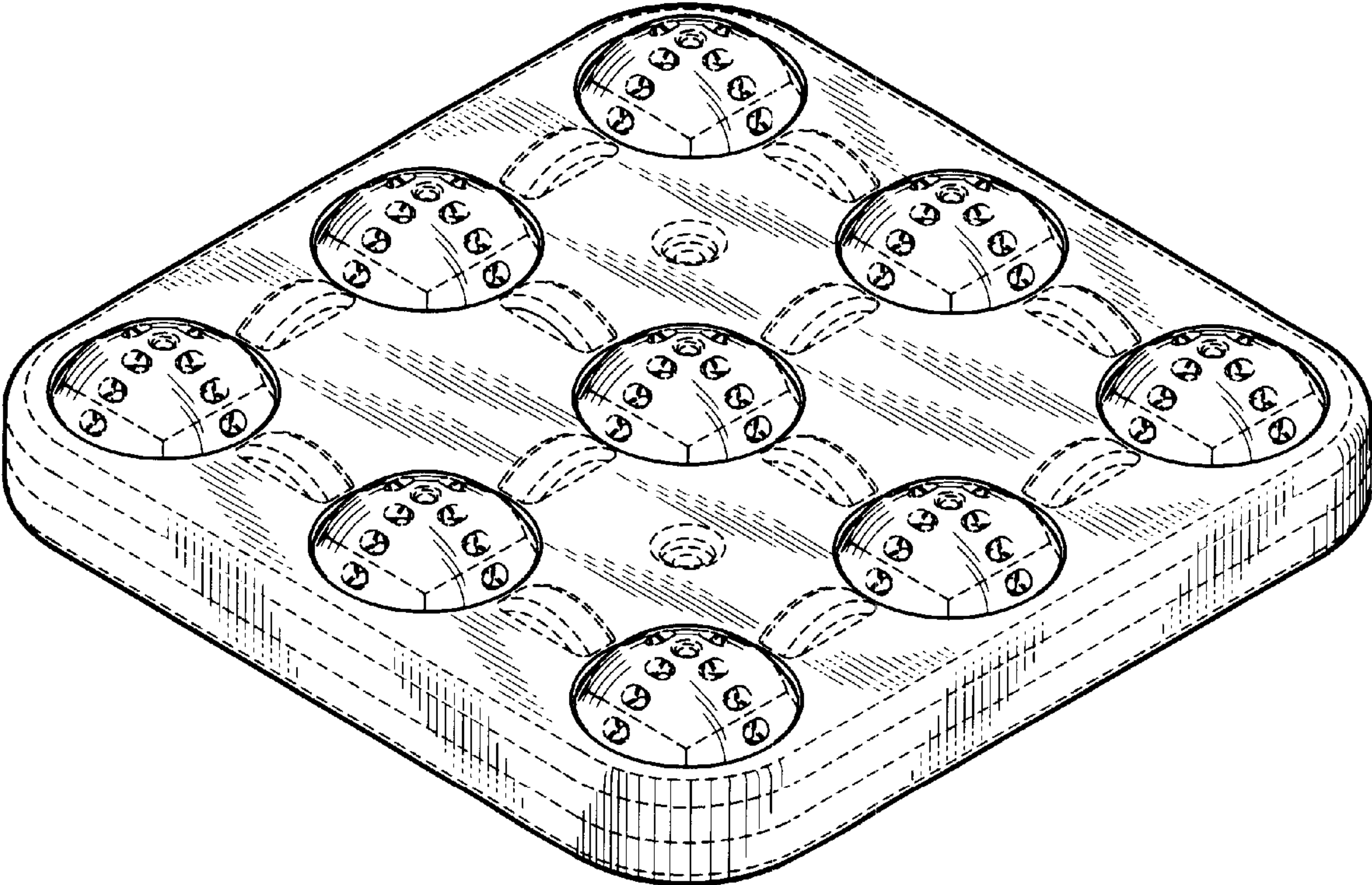

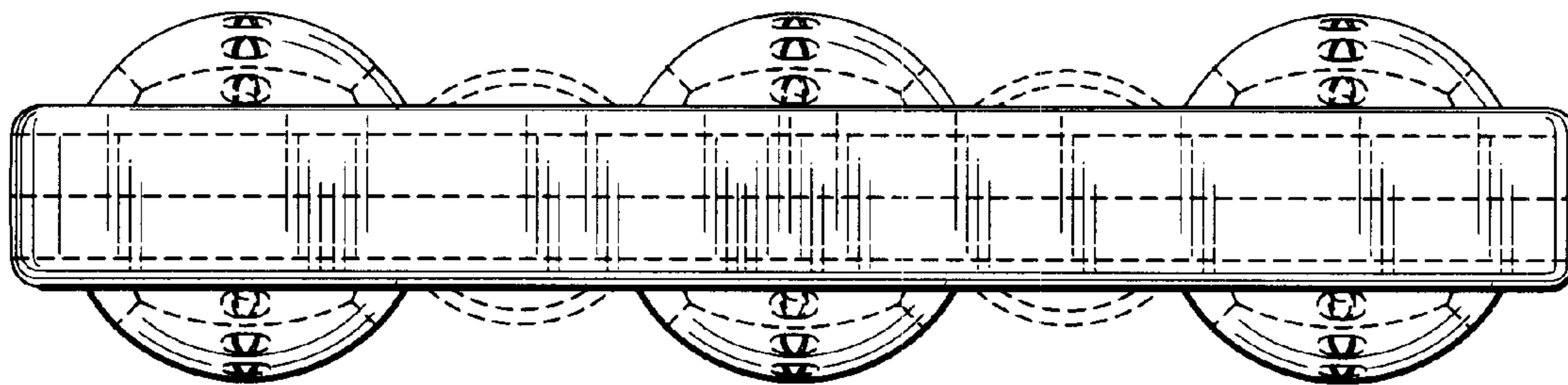

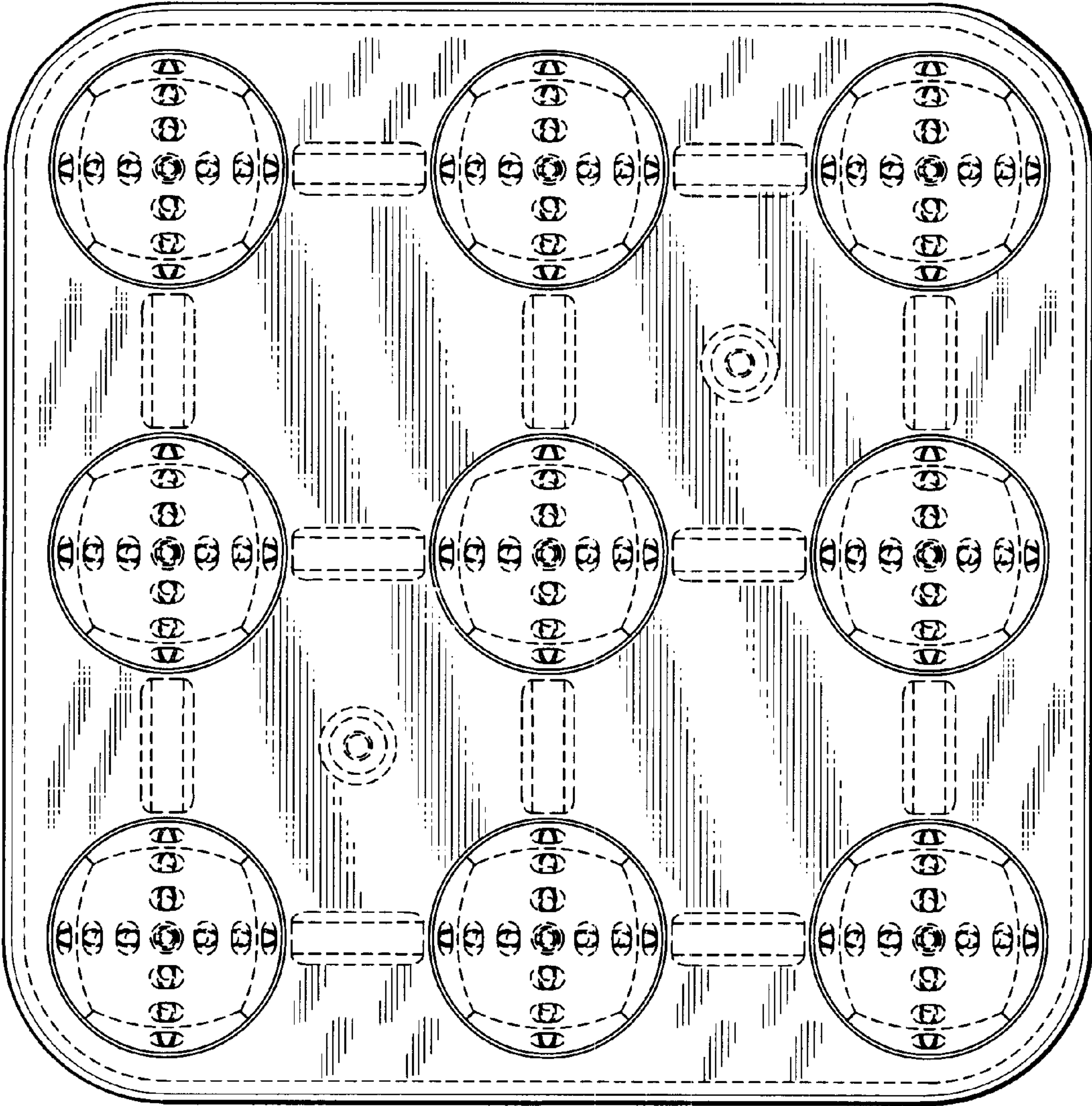
