DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a reversible crown of this invention shown on a person's head;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view of the present invention;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged bottom plan view of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged side elevational view of the present invention;

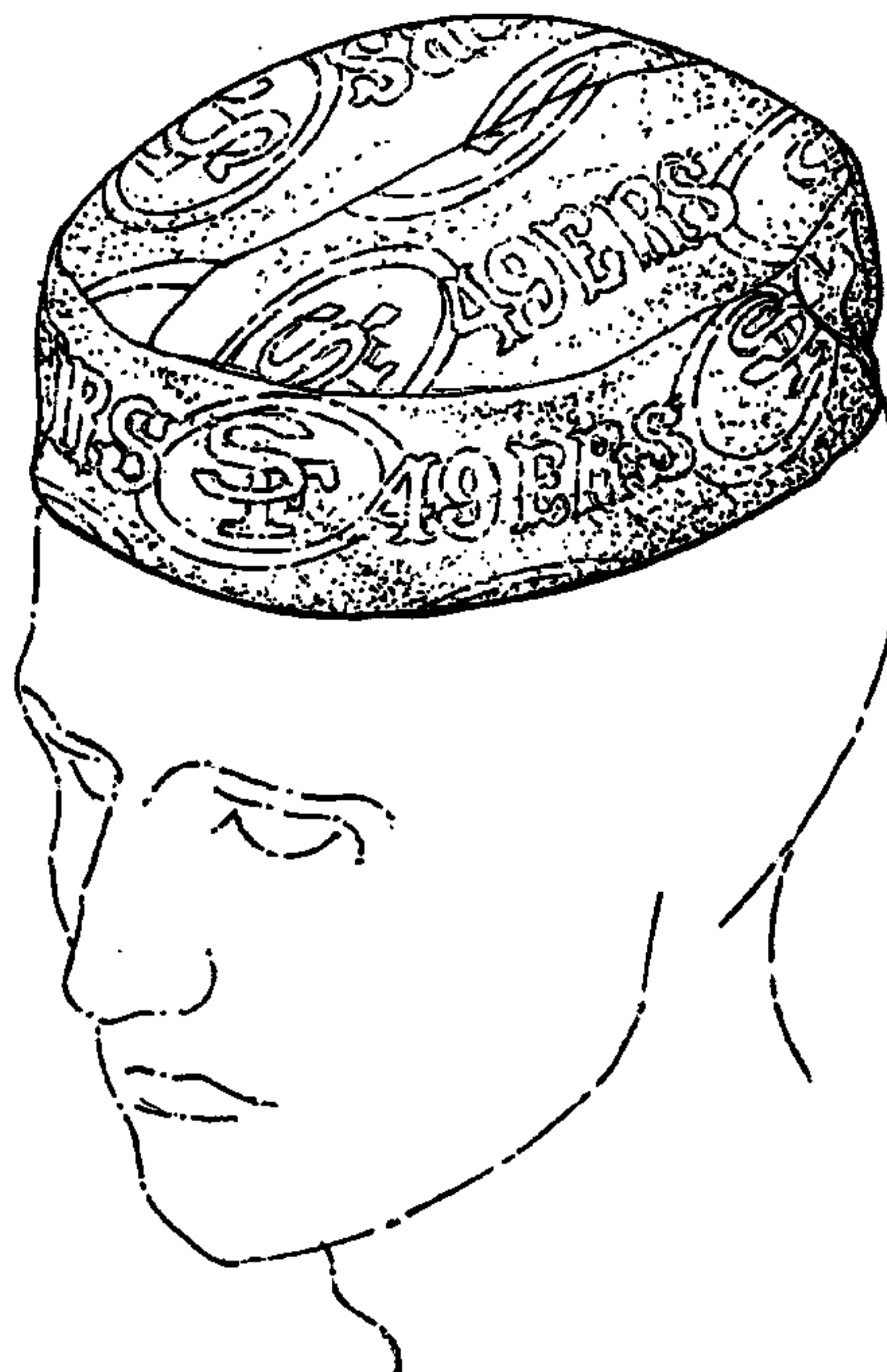
FIG. 5 is an enlarged front elevational view of the present invention;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged rear elevational view of the present invention; and,

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the present invention in an inside out position showing a pattern that is different than that shown in FIG. 1.

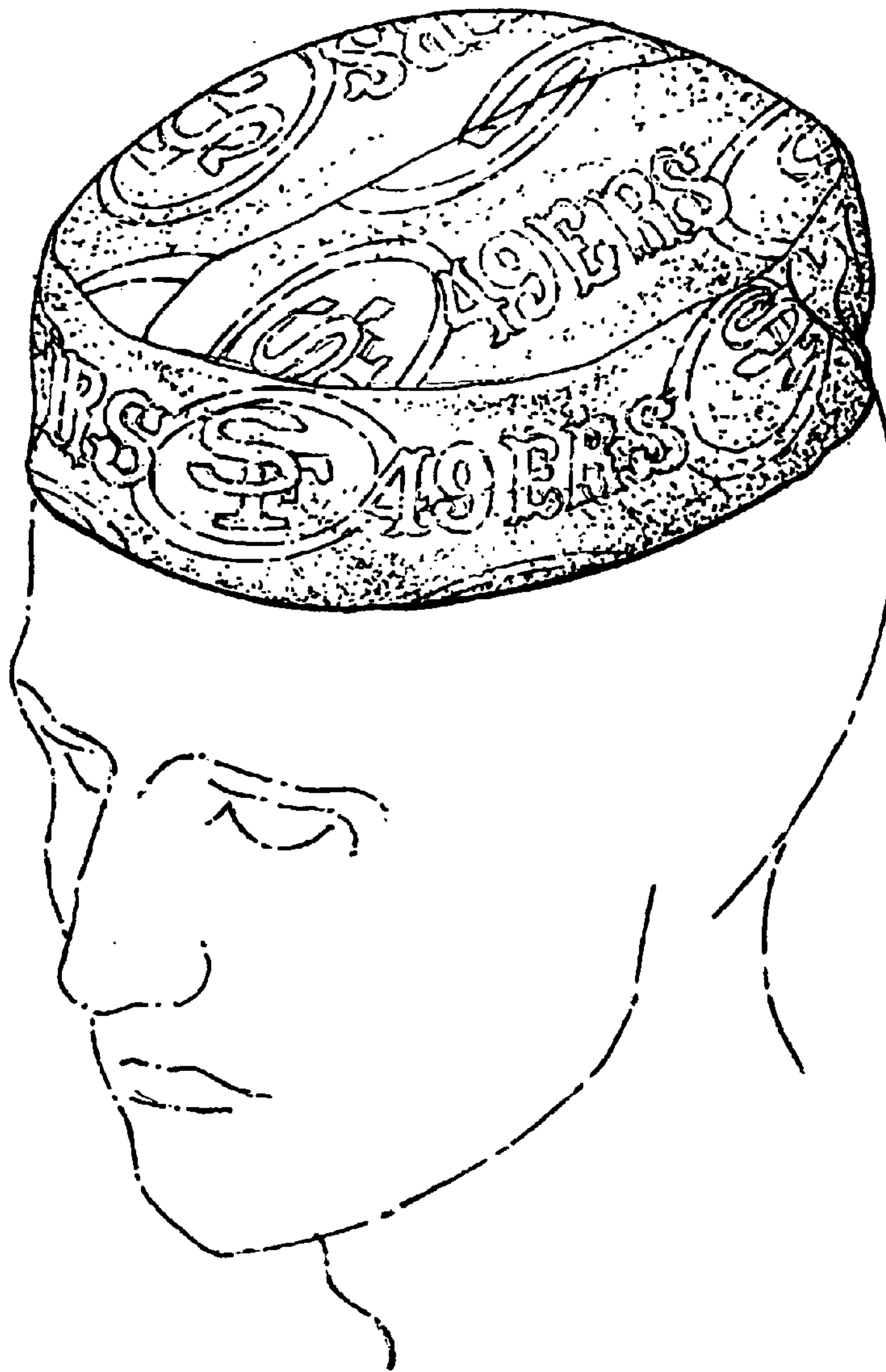

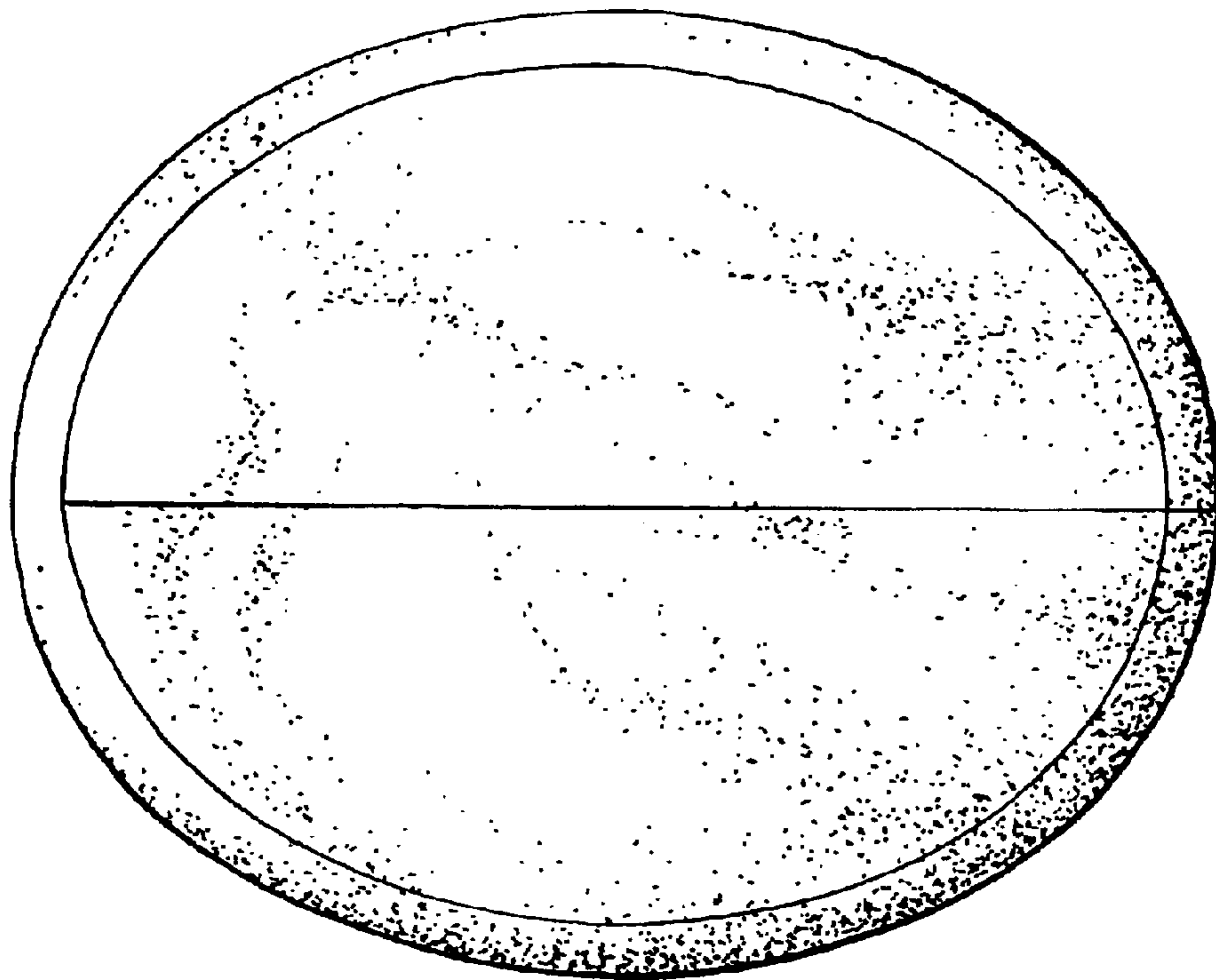

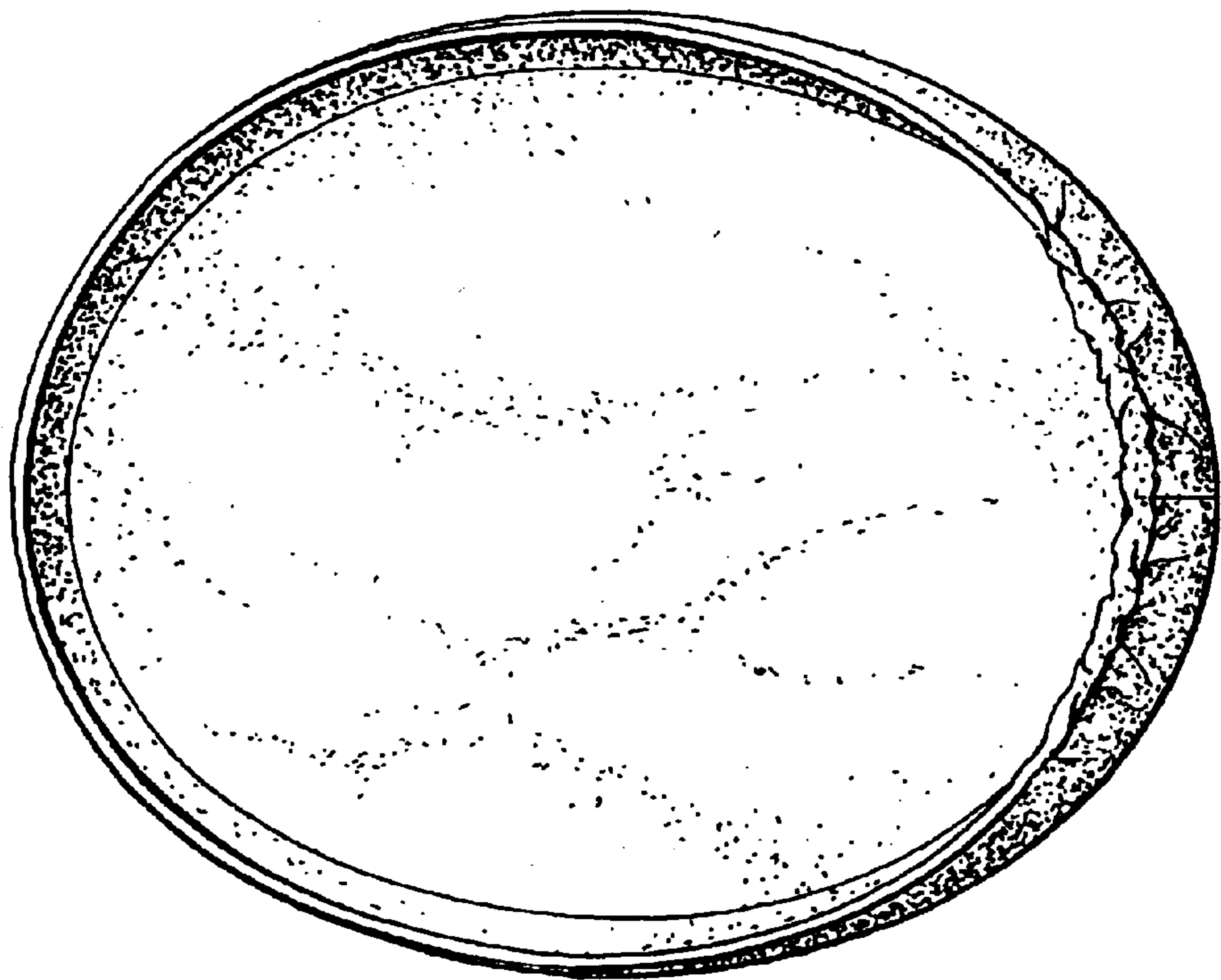

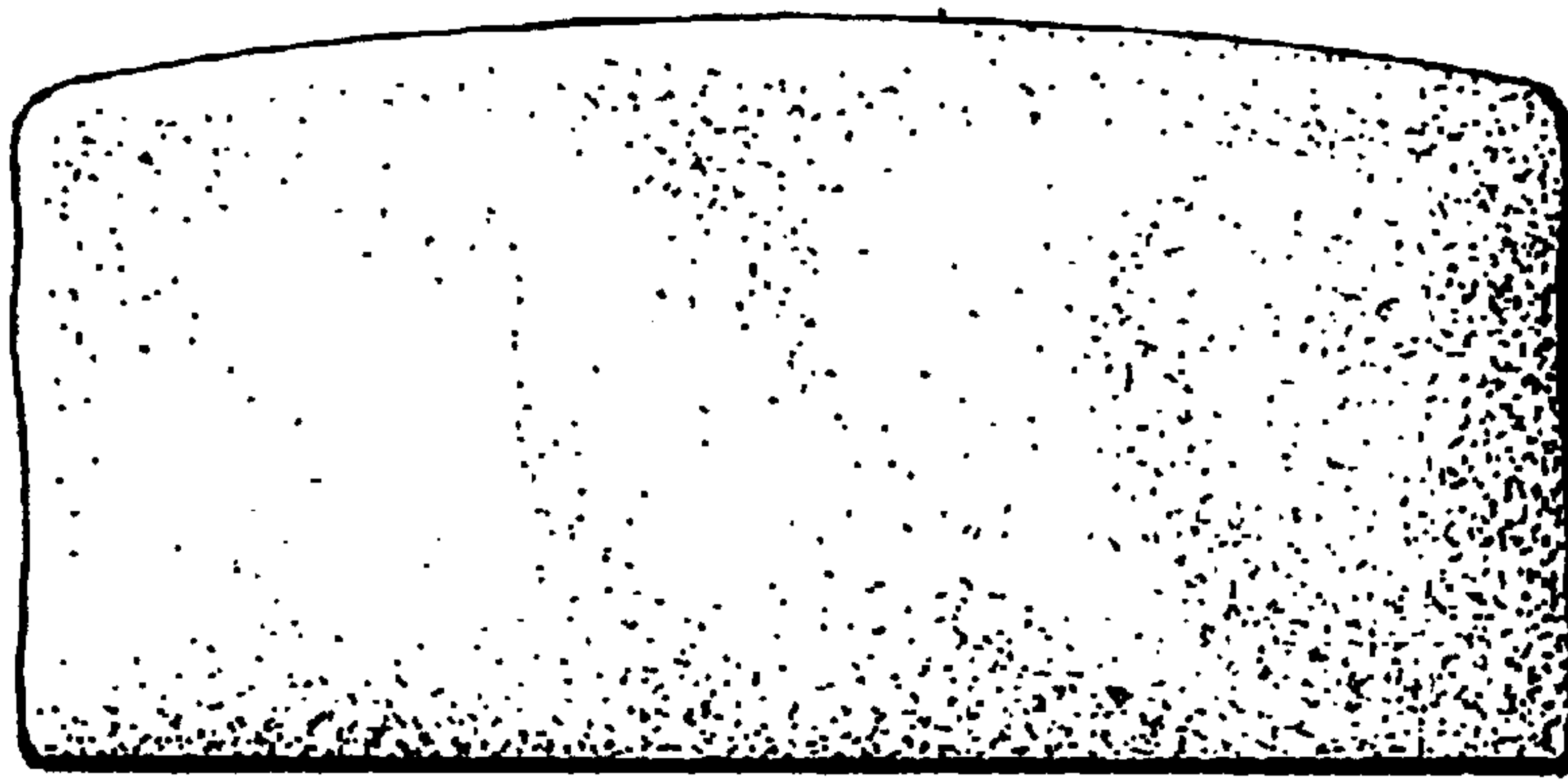

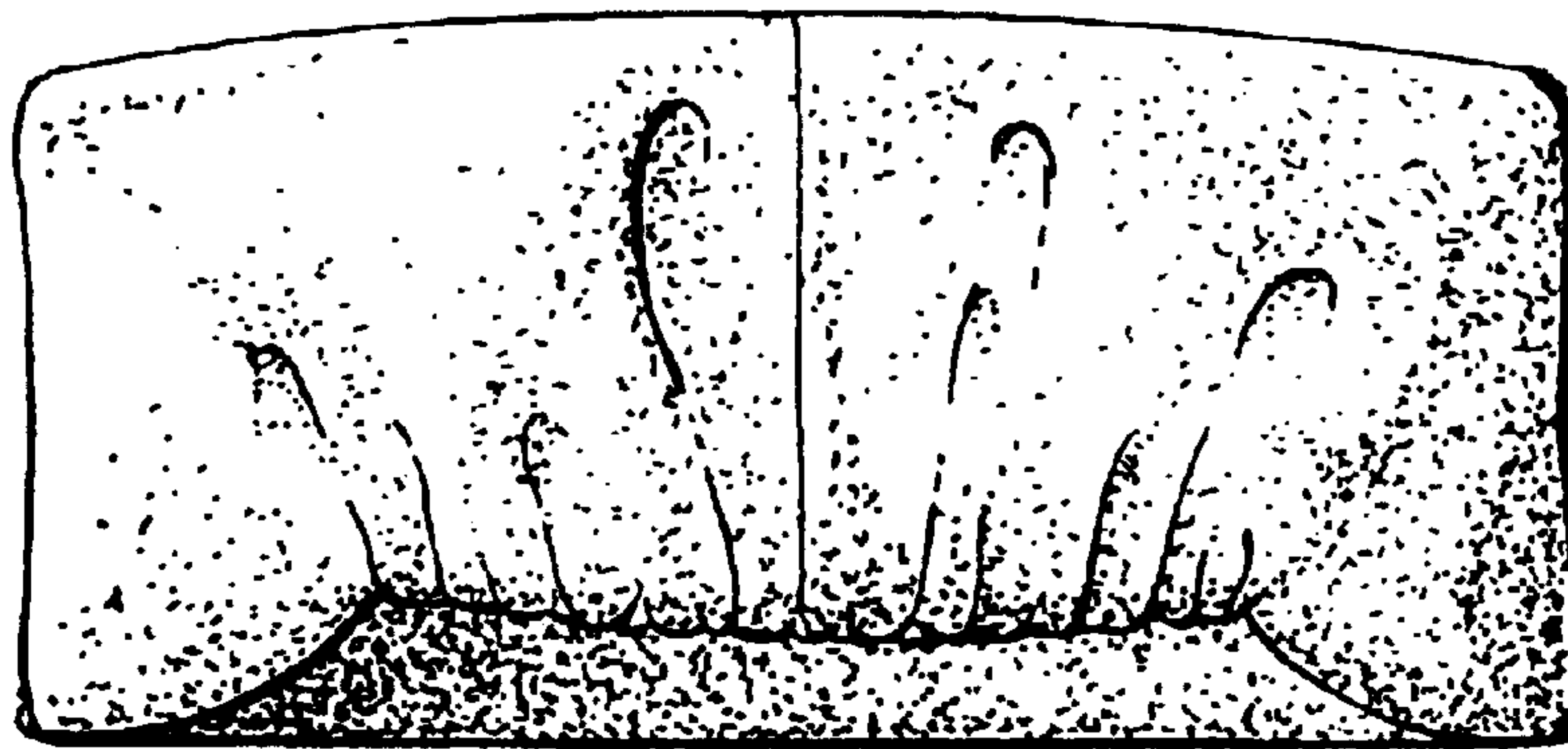

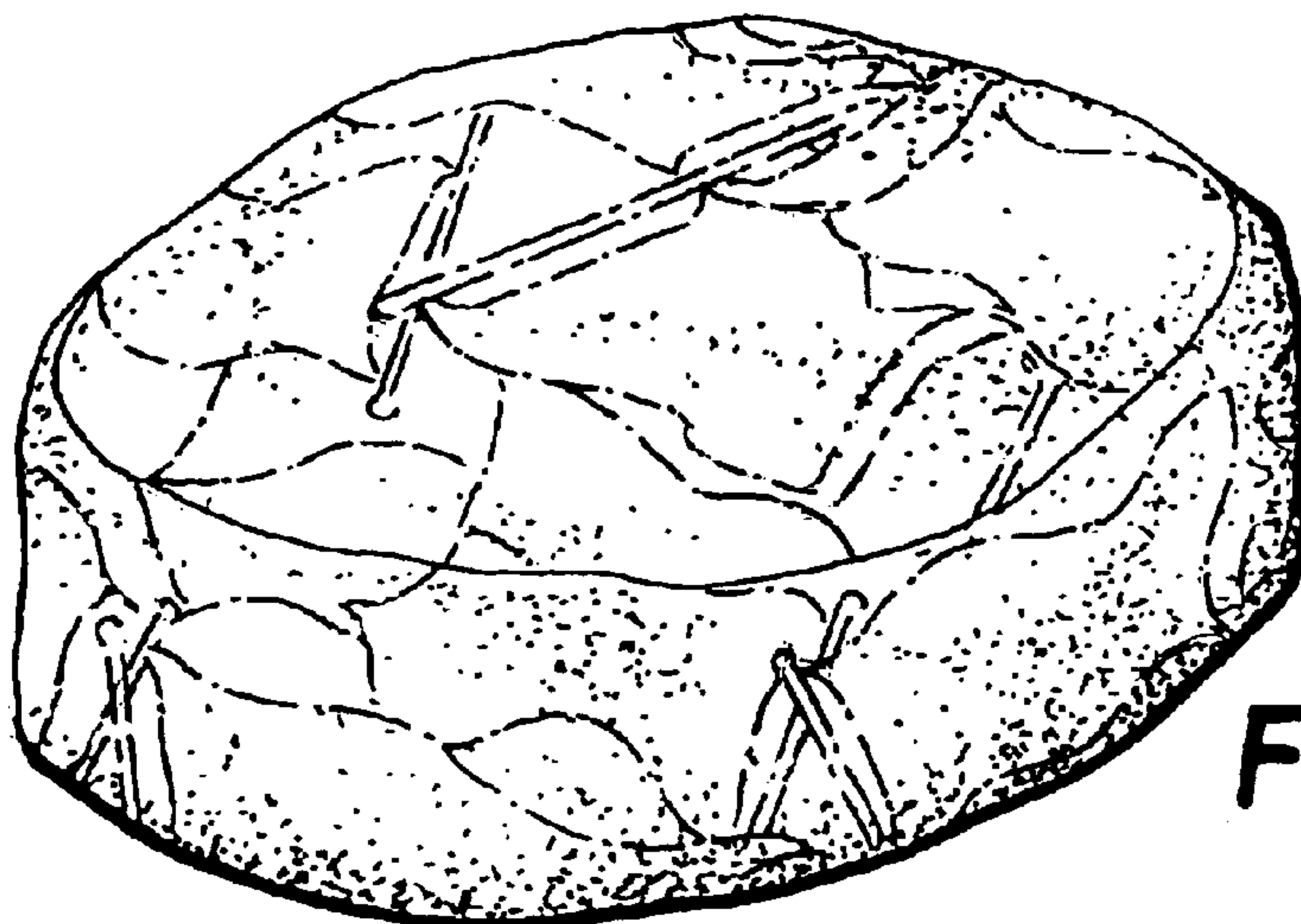
