(57)**CLAIM** 

The ornamental design for a faucet, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is as a plumbing fixture primarily useful for washing various objects and in the form of a combined faucet body/handle, a faucet body, or a handle.

FIG. 1 is a right, top, front perspective view of a faucet body embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the right side shown;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line representation of wall structure in FIGS. 1, 3, and 6 is for the purpose of illustration only, and forms no part of the claimed design.






