DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a neck tie of my new design,
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof,
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof,
FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof,
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof,
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a supplemental drawing thereof showing folded condition.

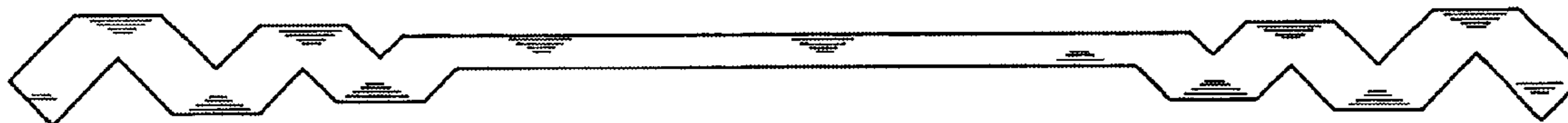

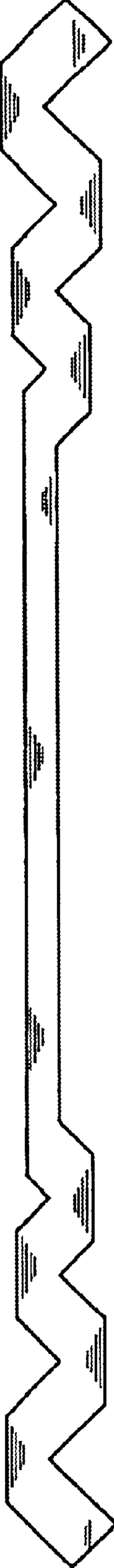

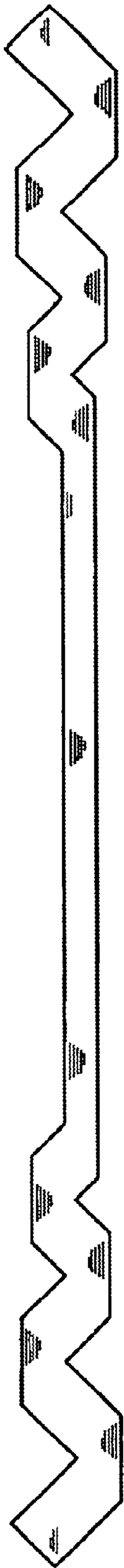
