The ornamental design for a bootjack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bootjack, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view, thereof;

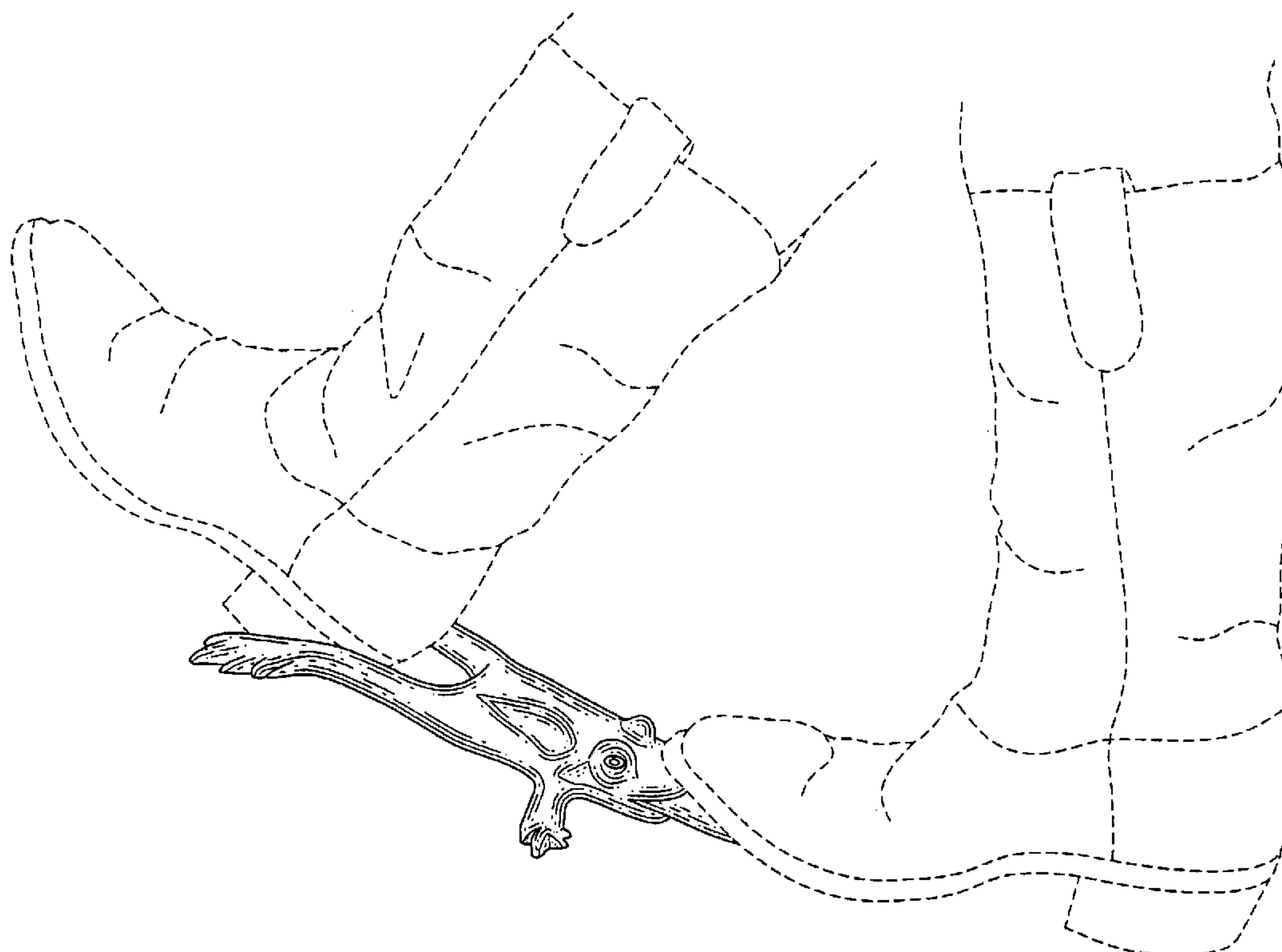
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view, thereof;

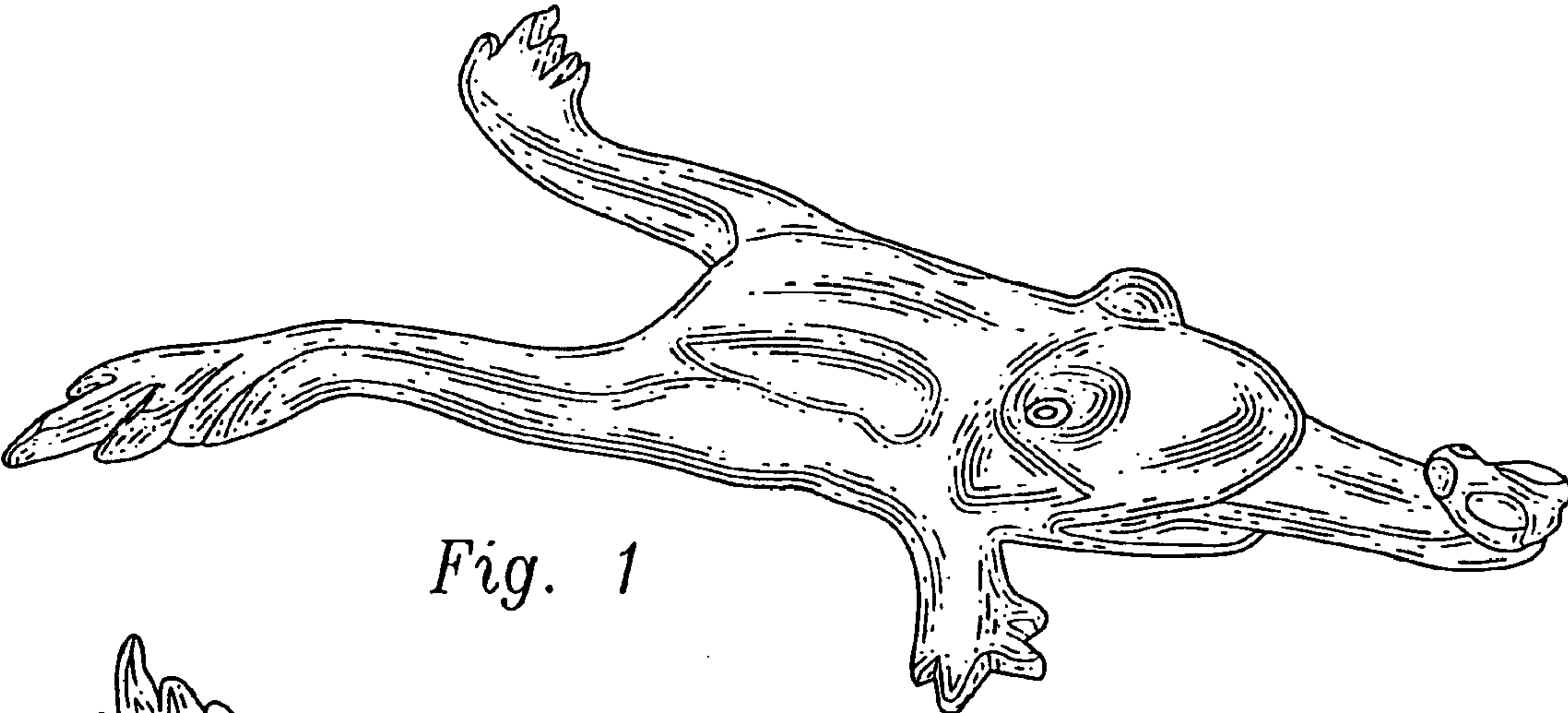

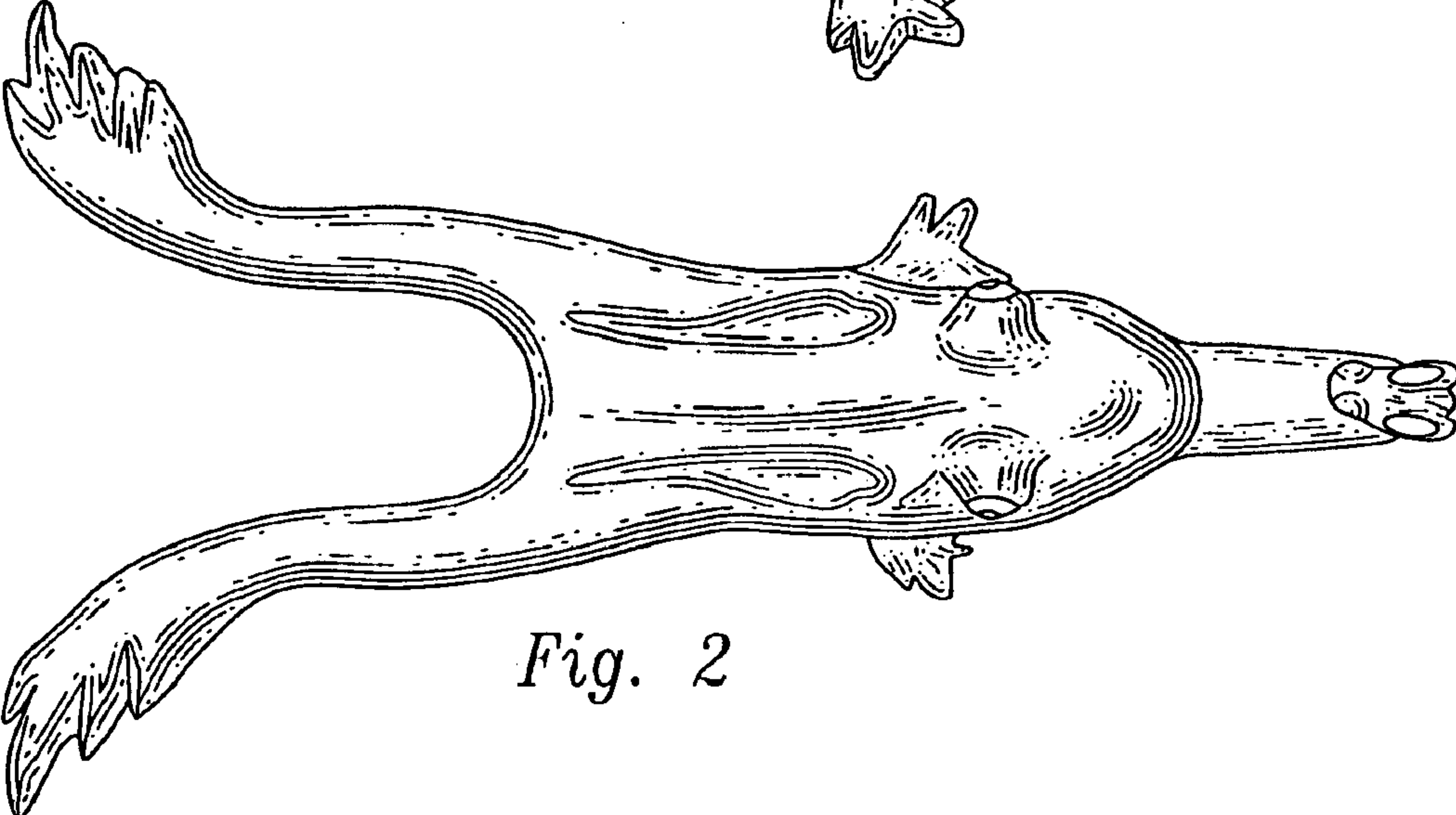

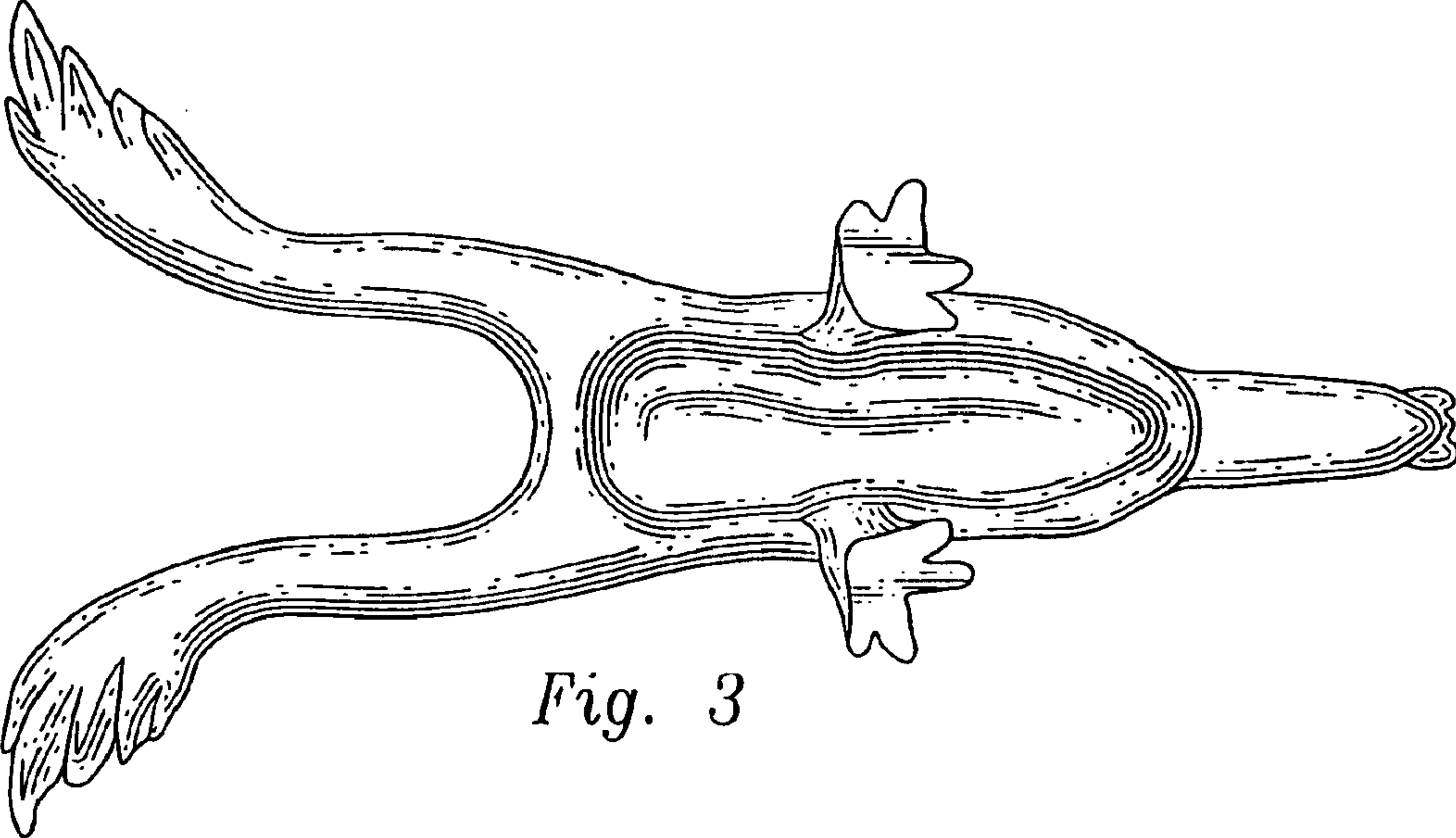

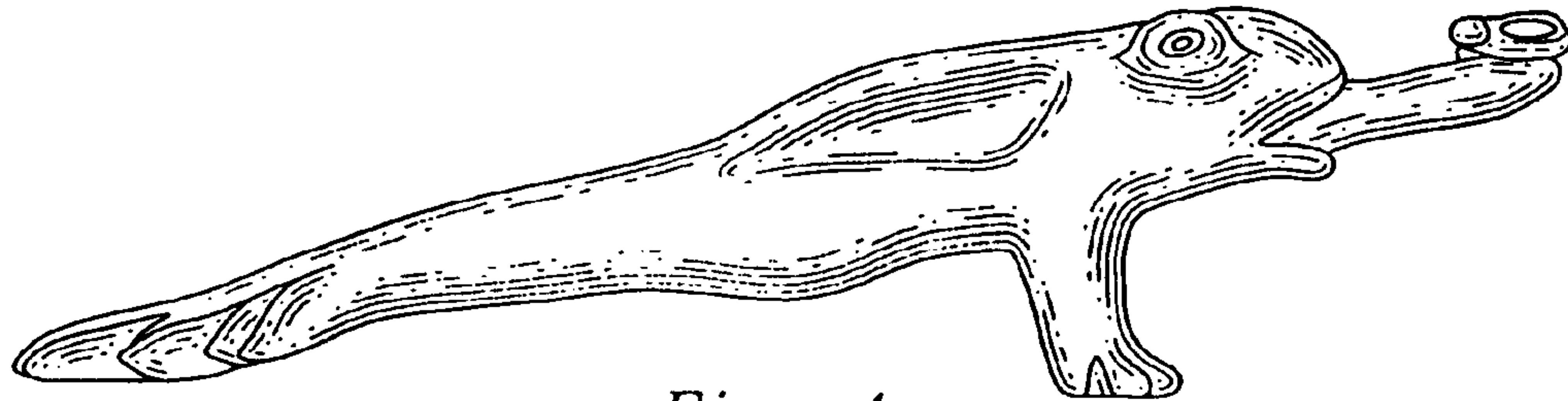

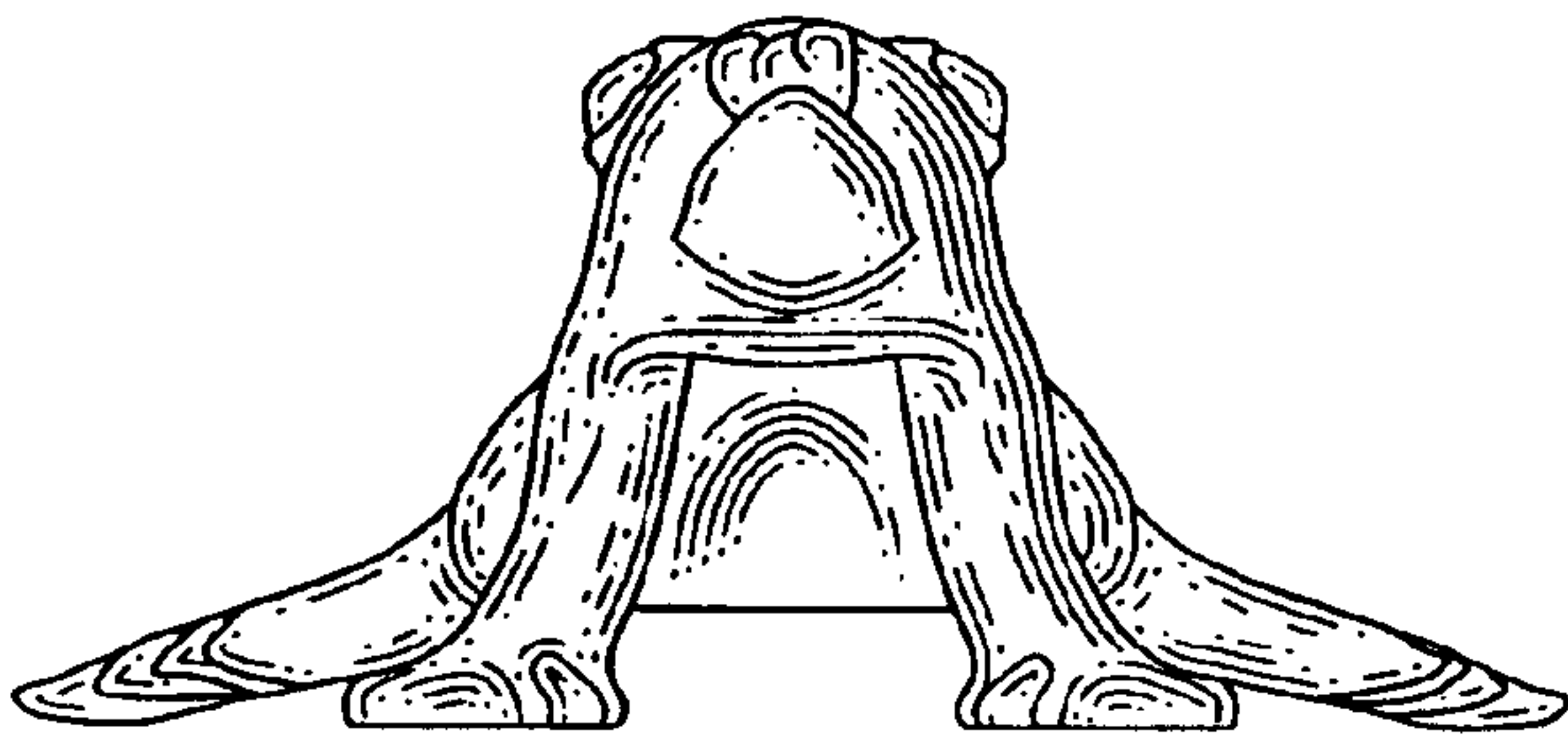

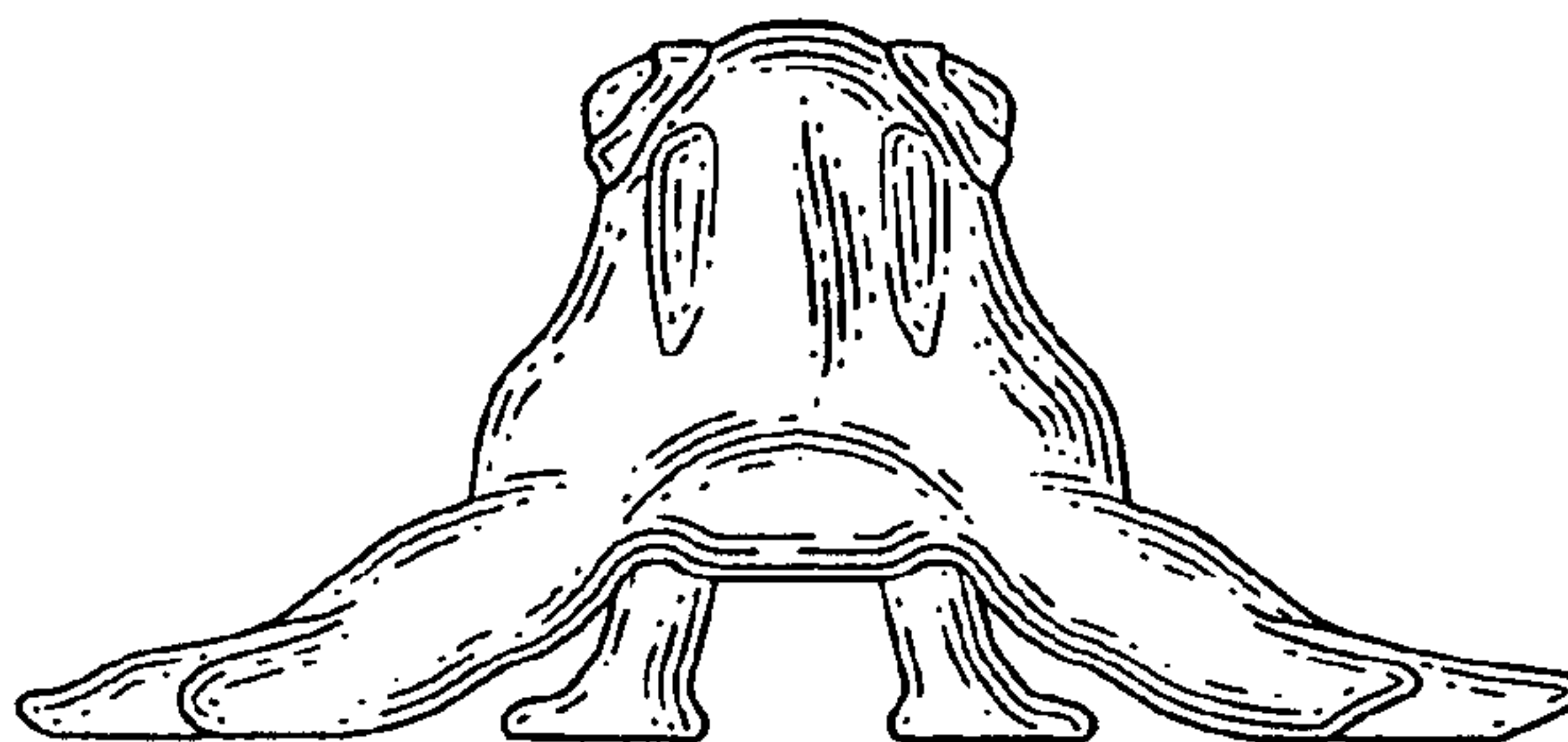

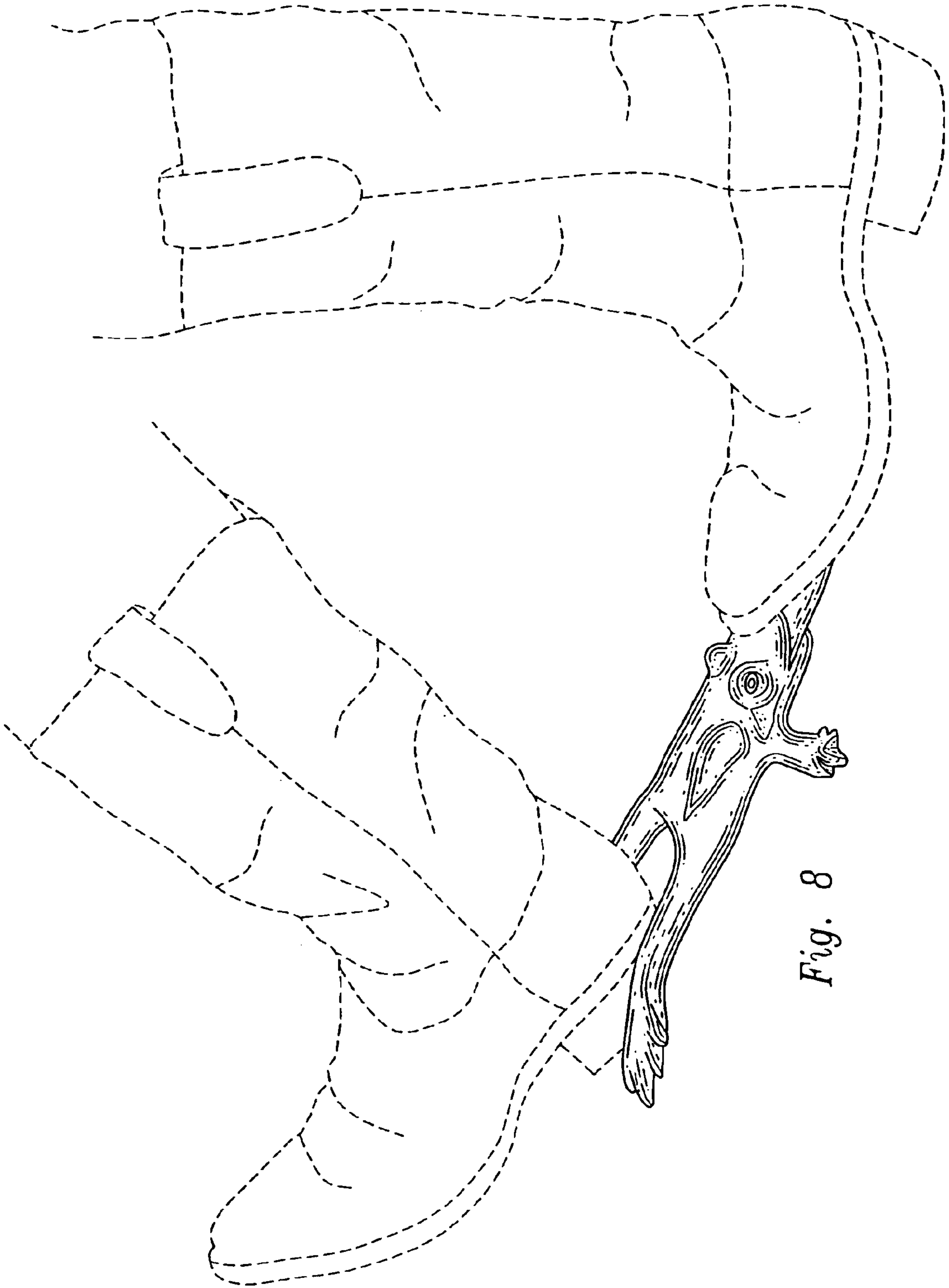
