personal item carrier showing my new design in an open
position;

position;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view shown in an open flat
position;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view;

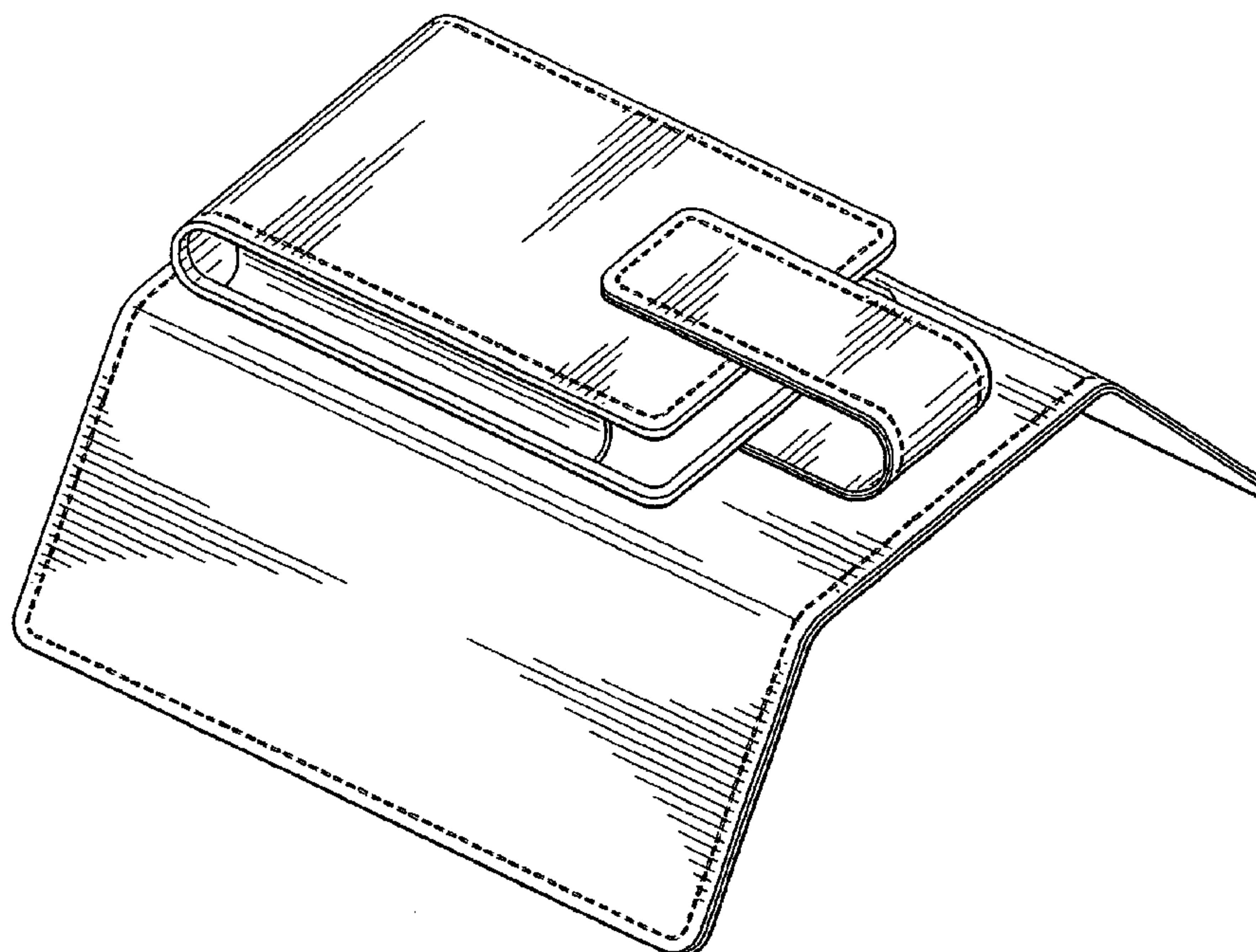
FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view;

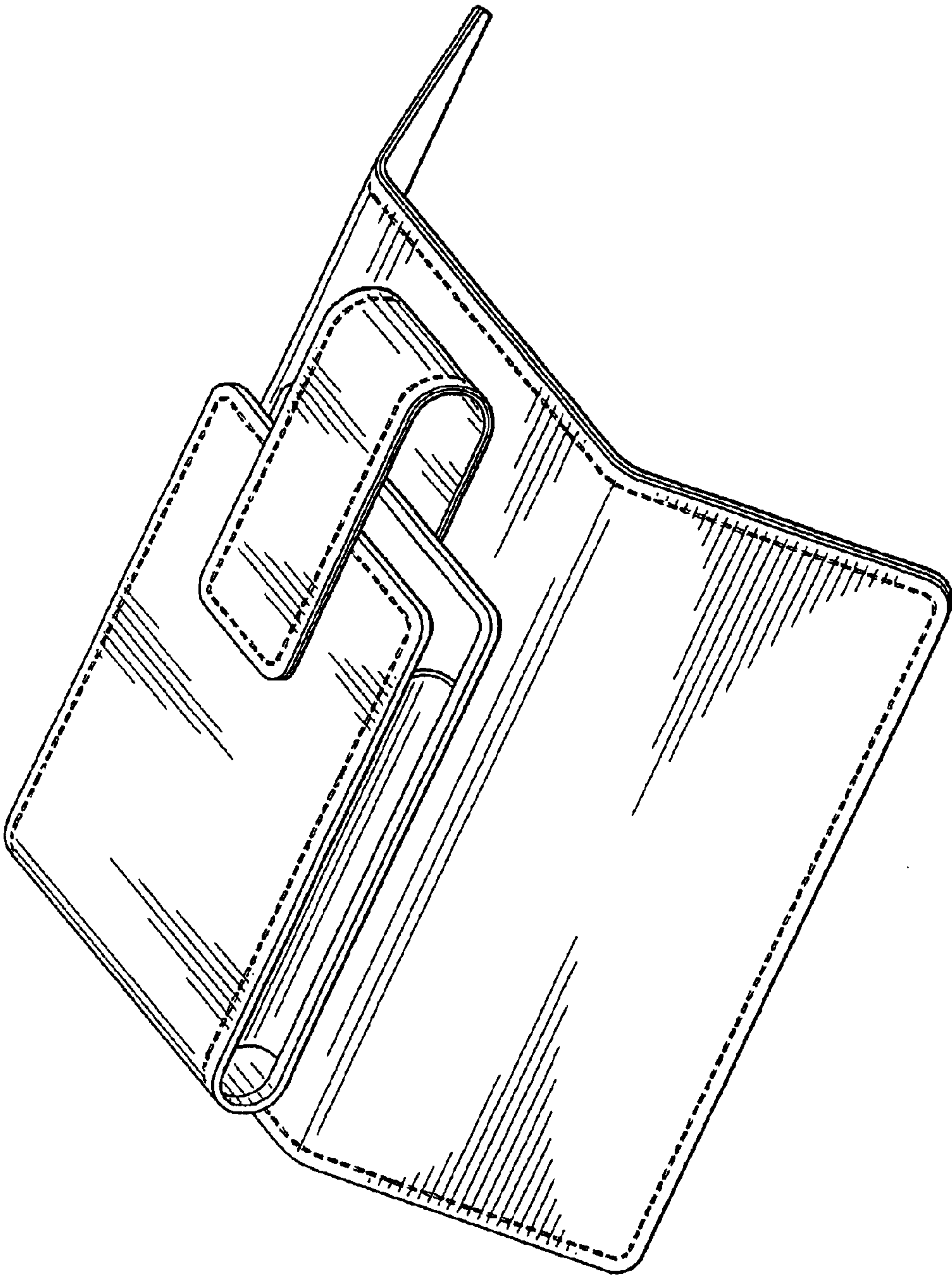

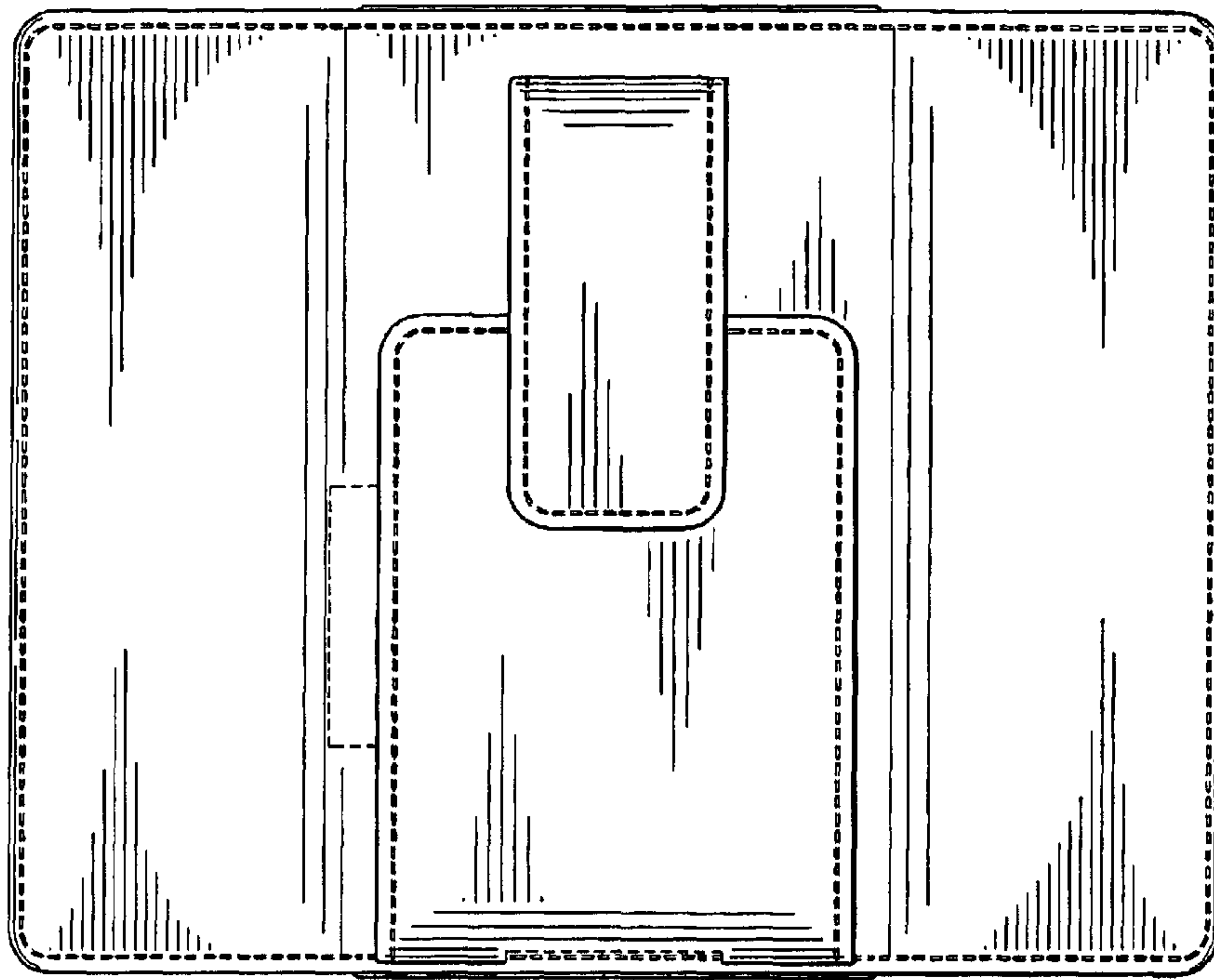

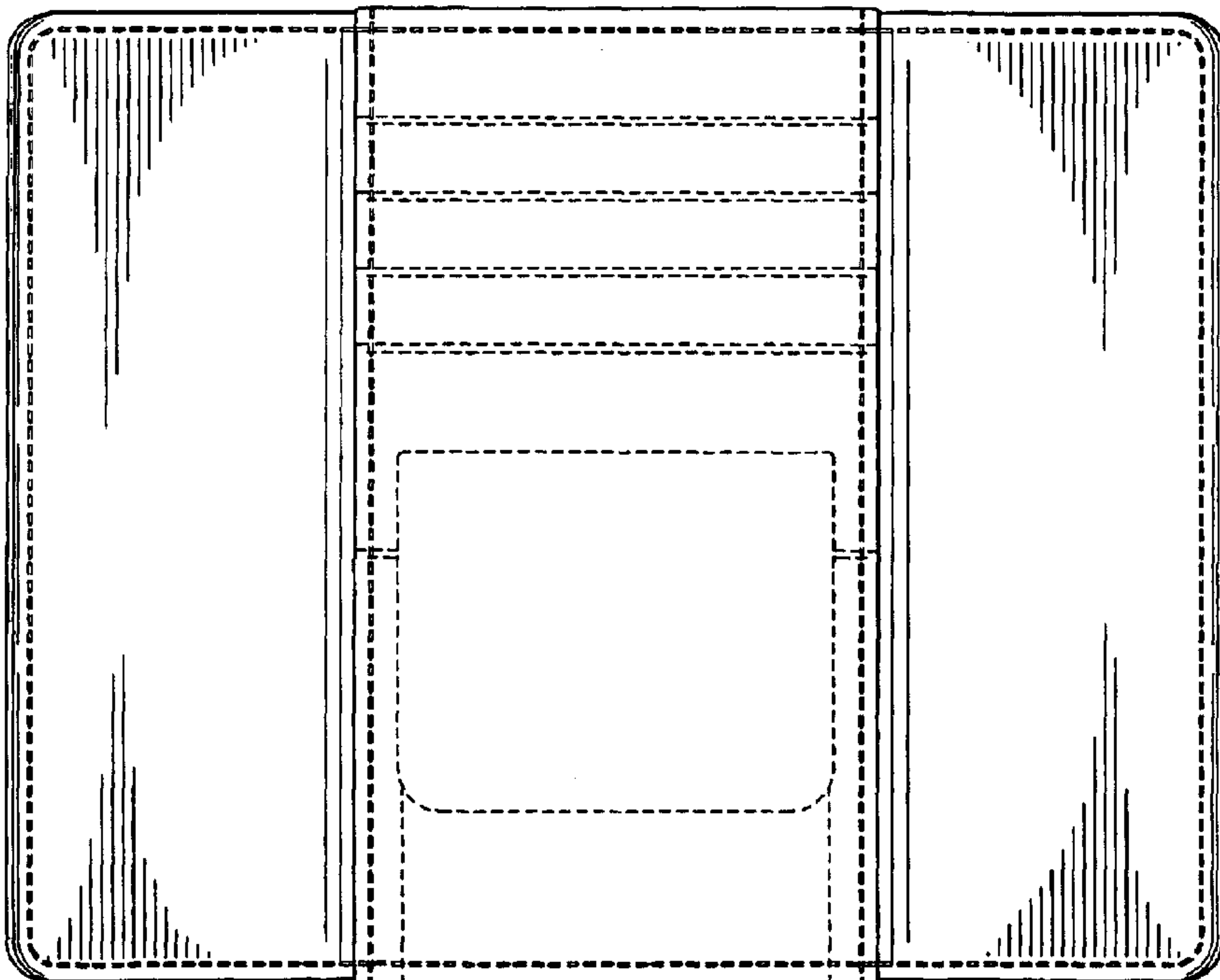

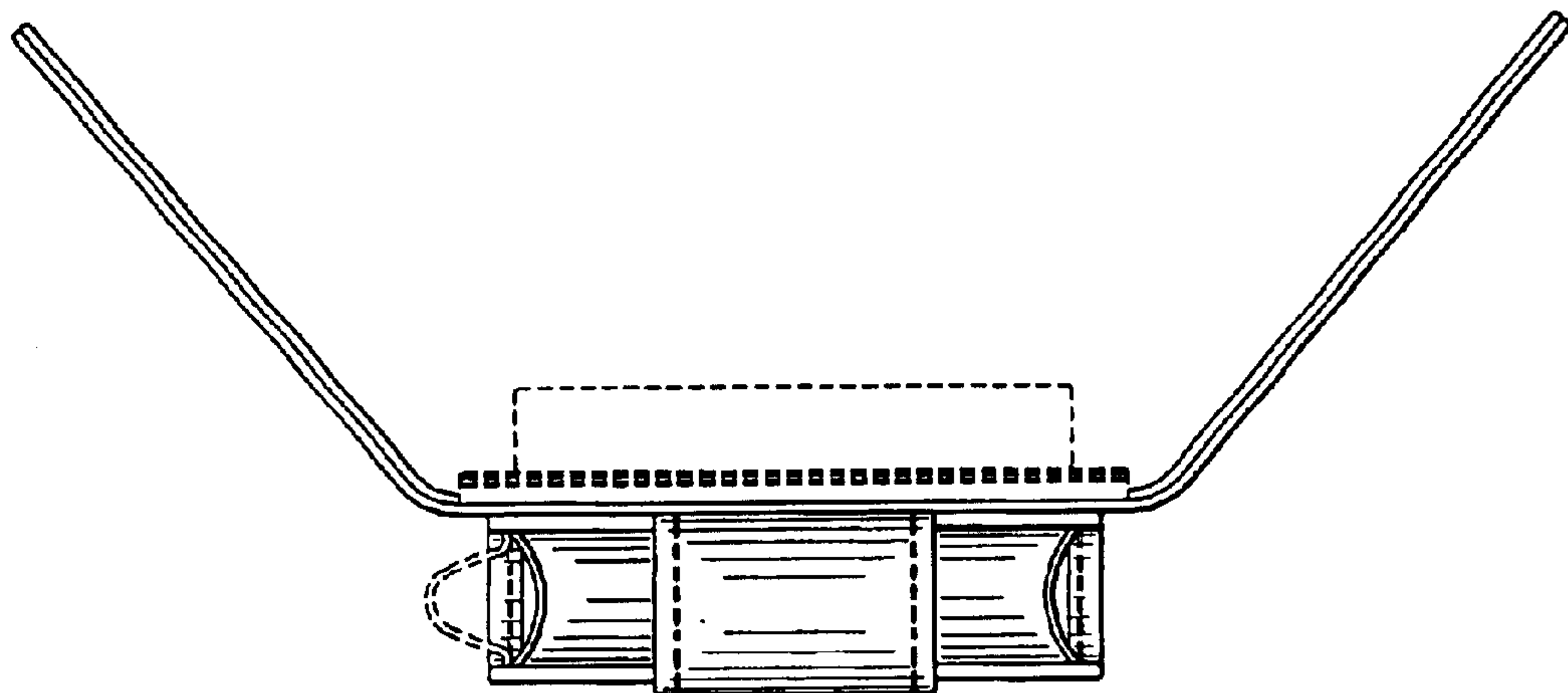

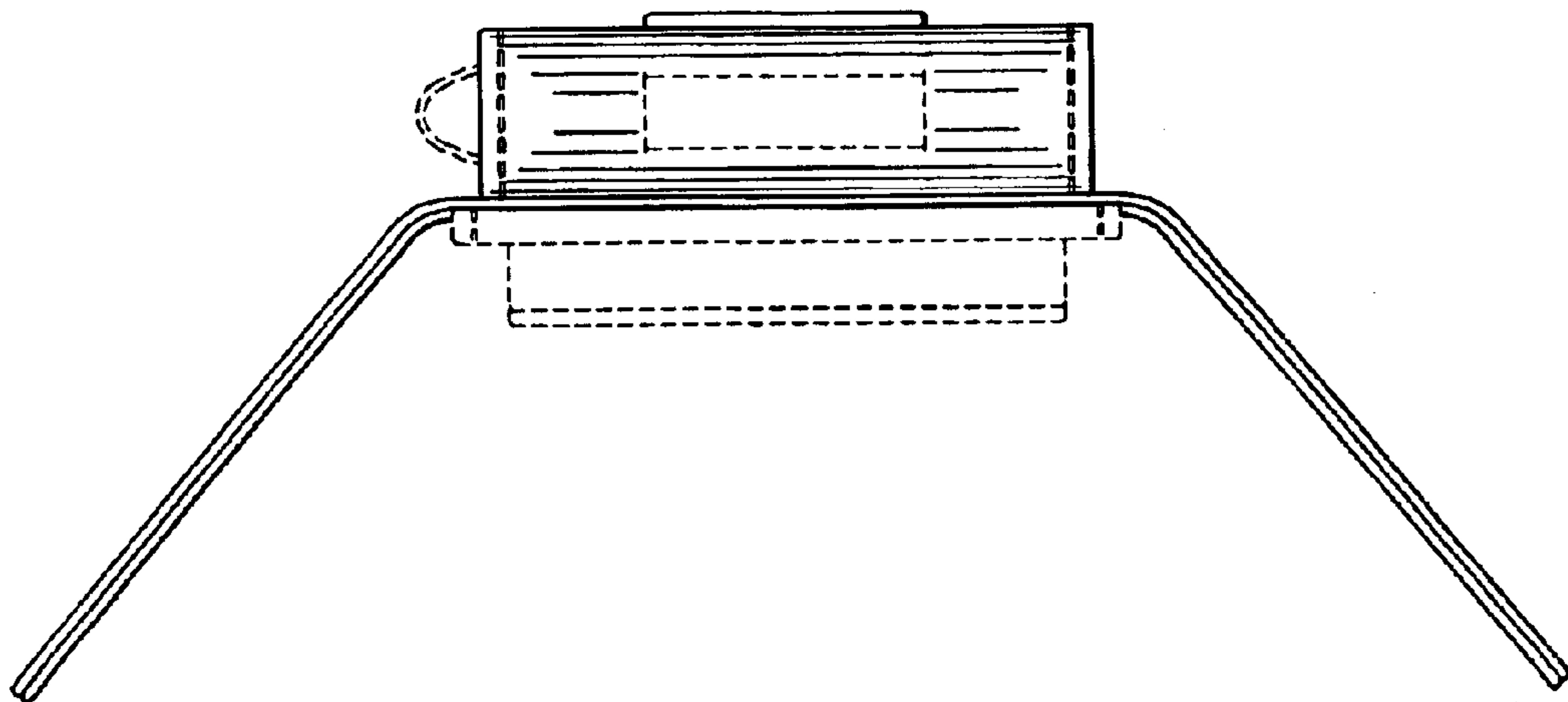

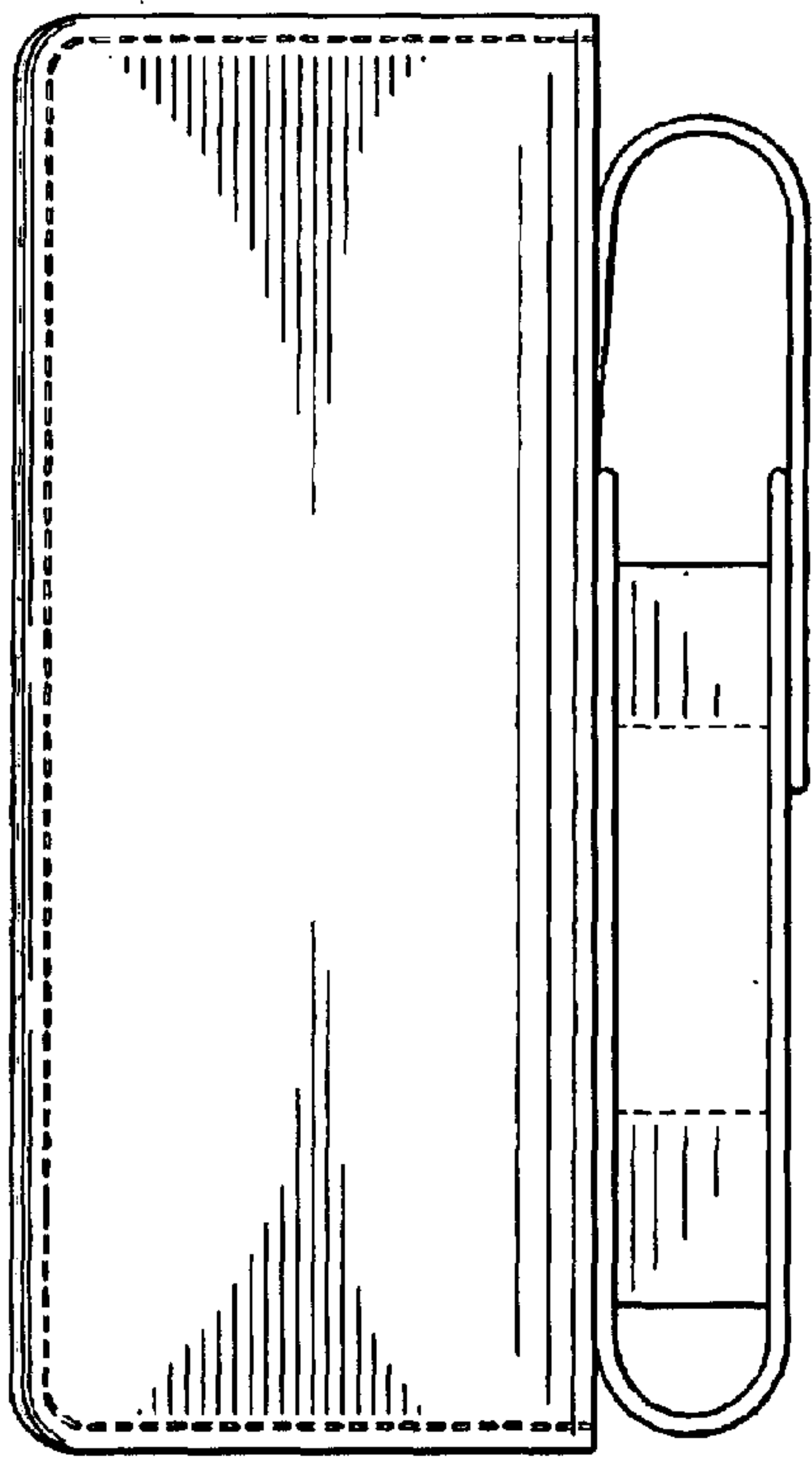
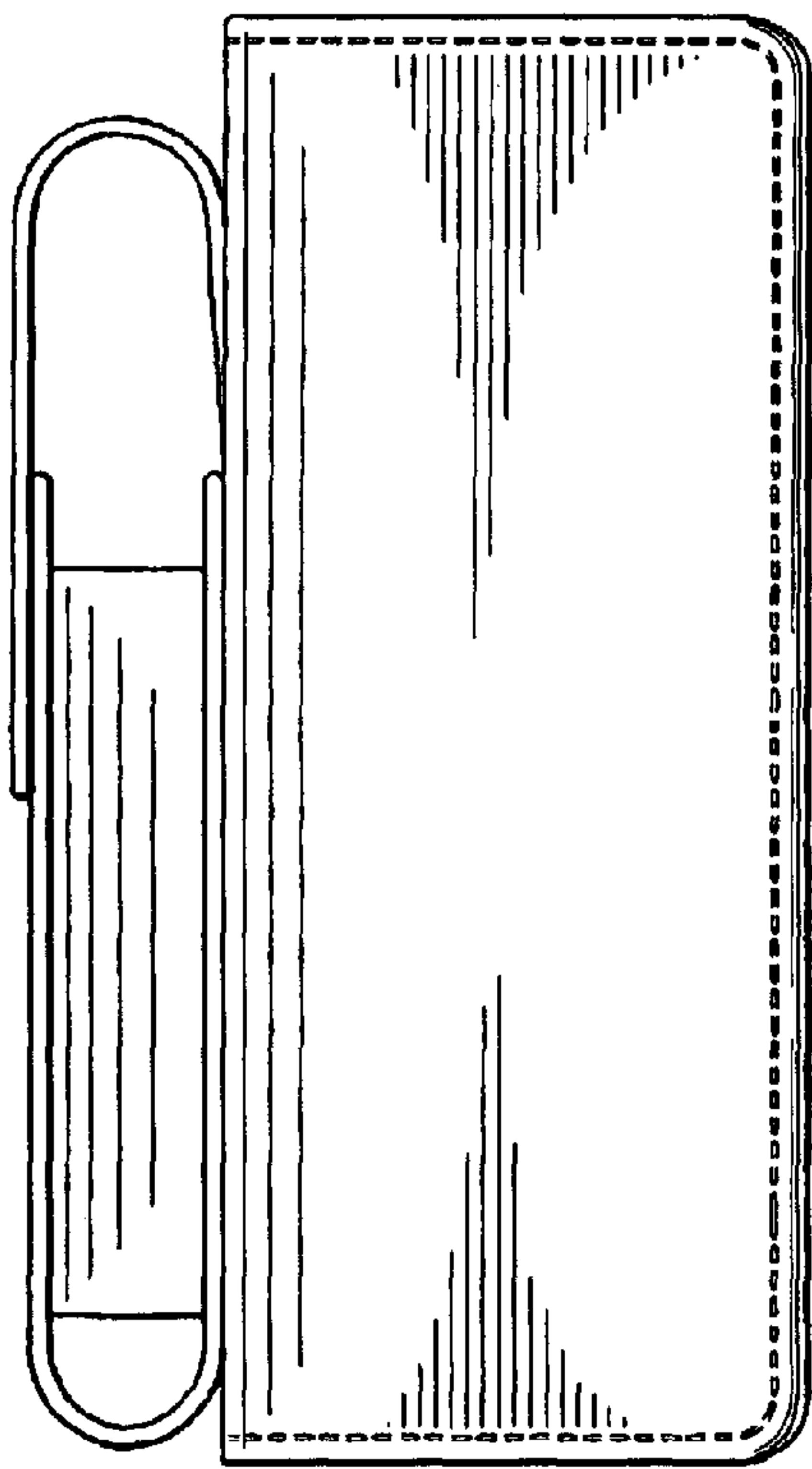

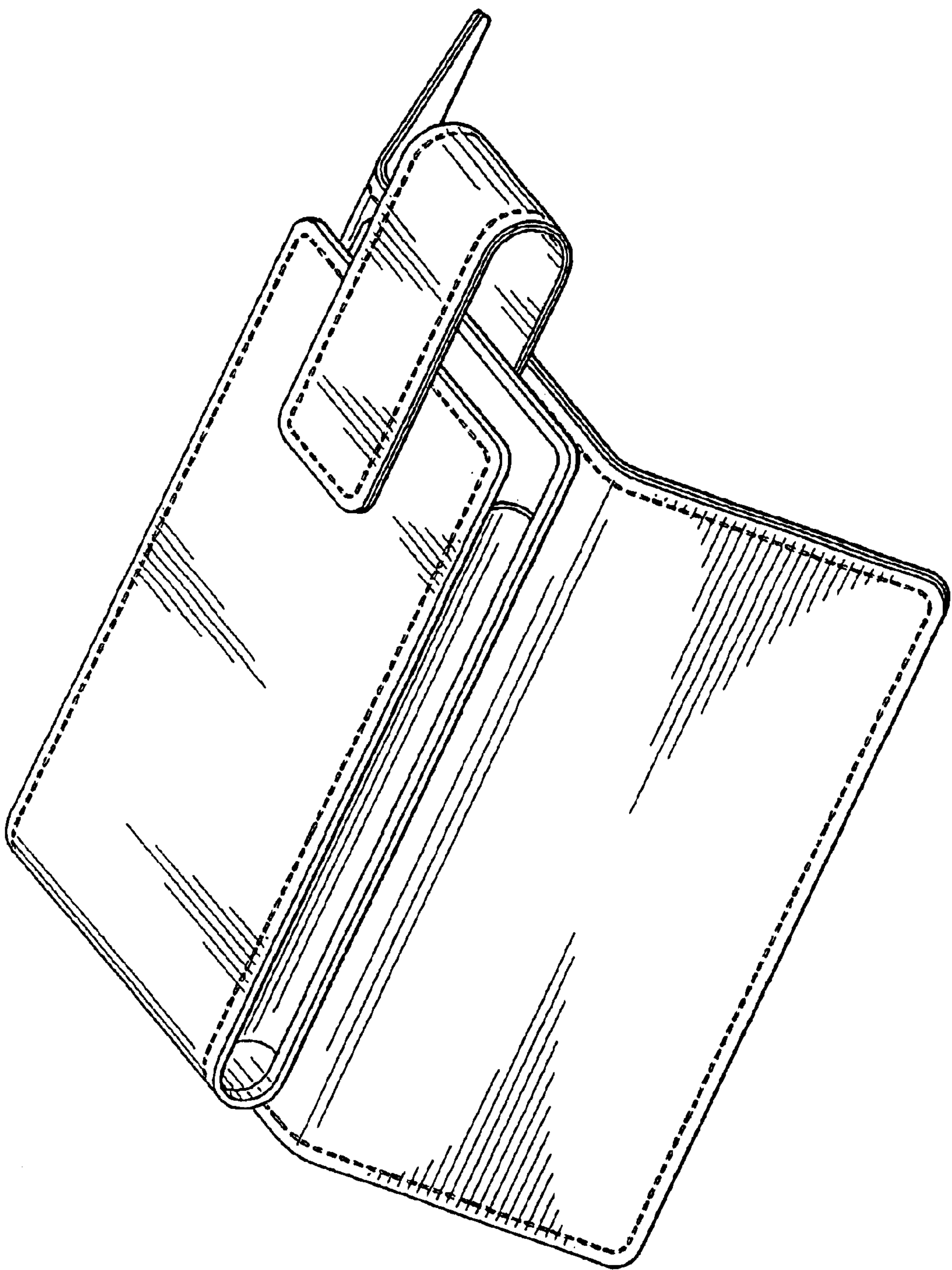
