FIG. 3 is a front view of the foil cutter of FIG. 1;

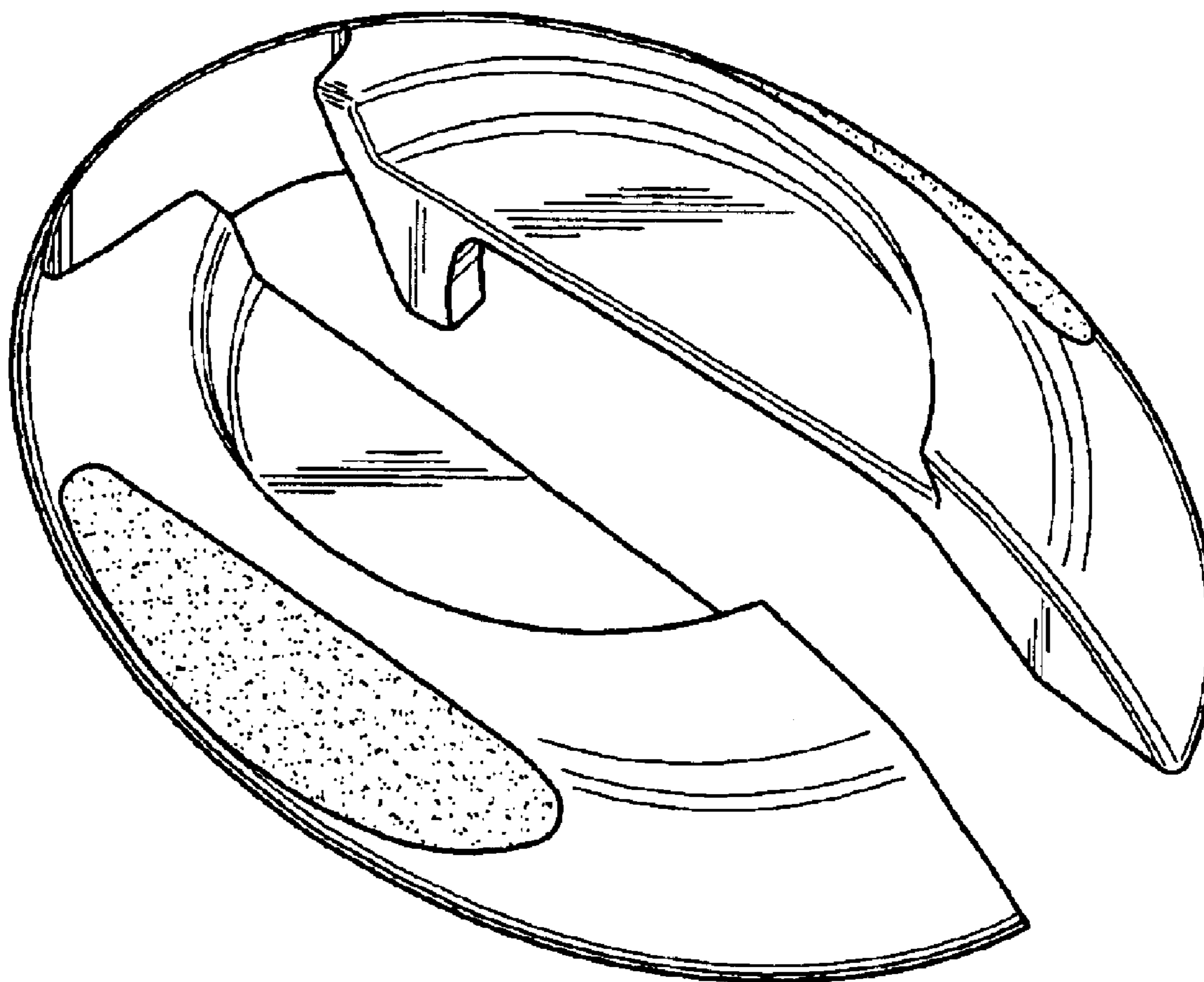
FIG. 4 is a top view of the foil cutter of FIG. 1;

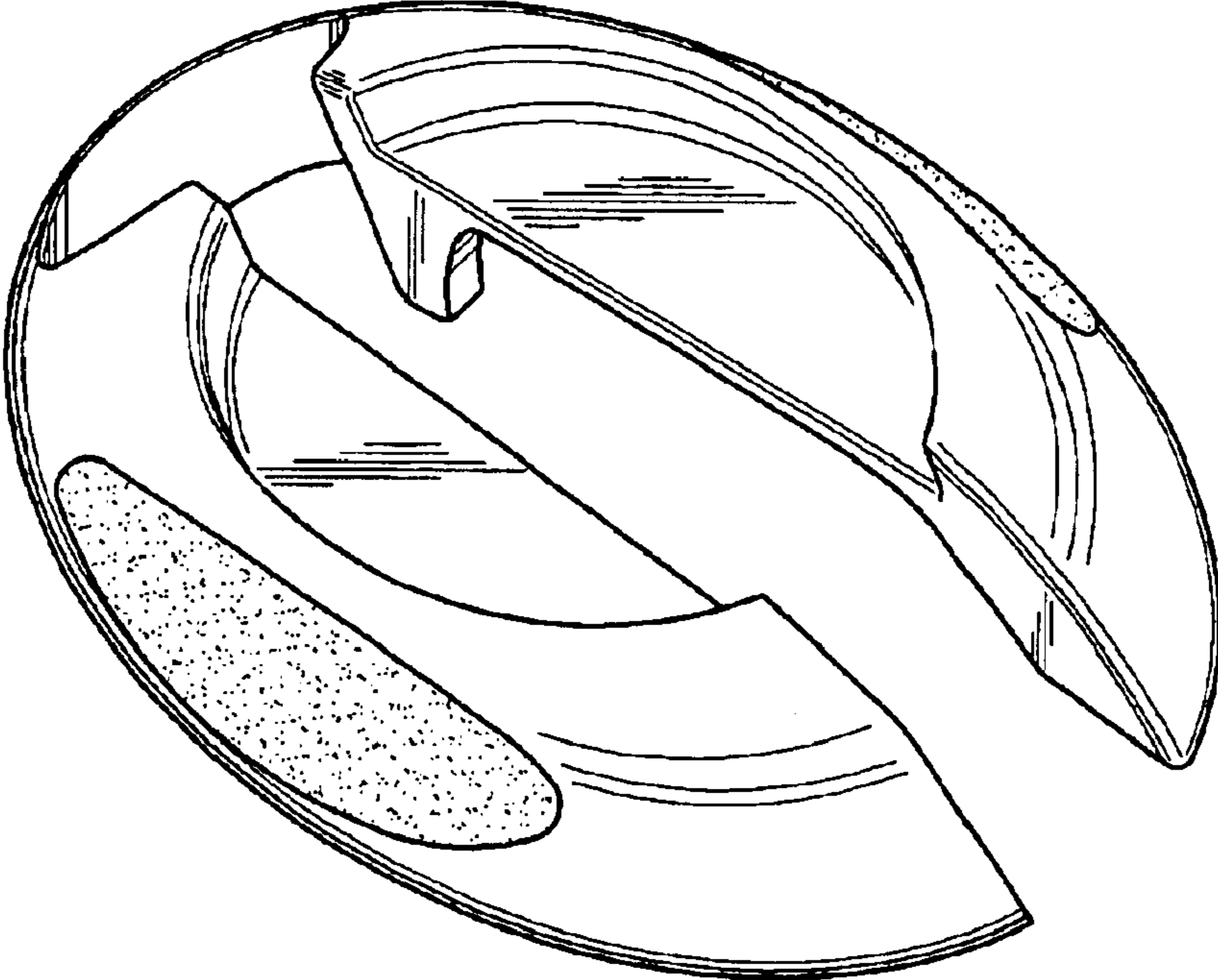

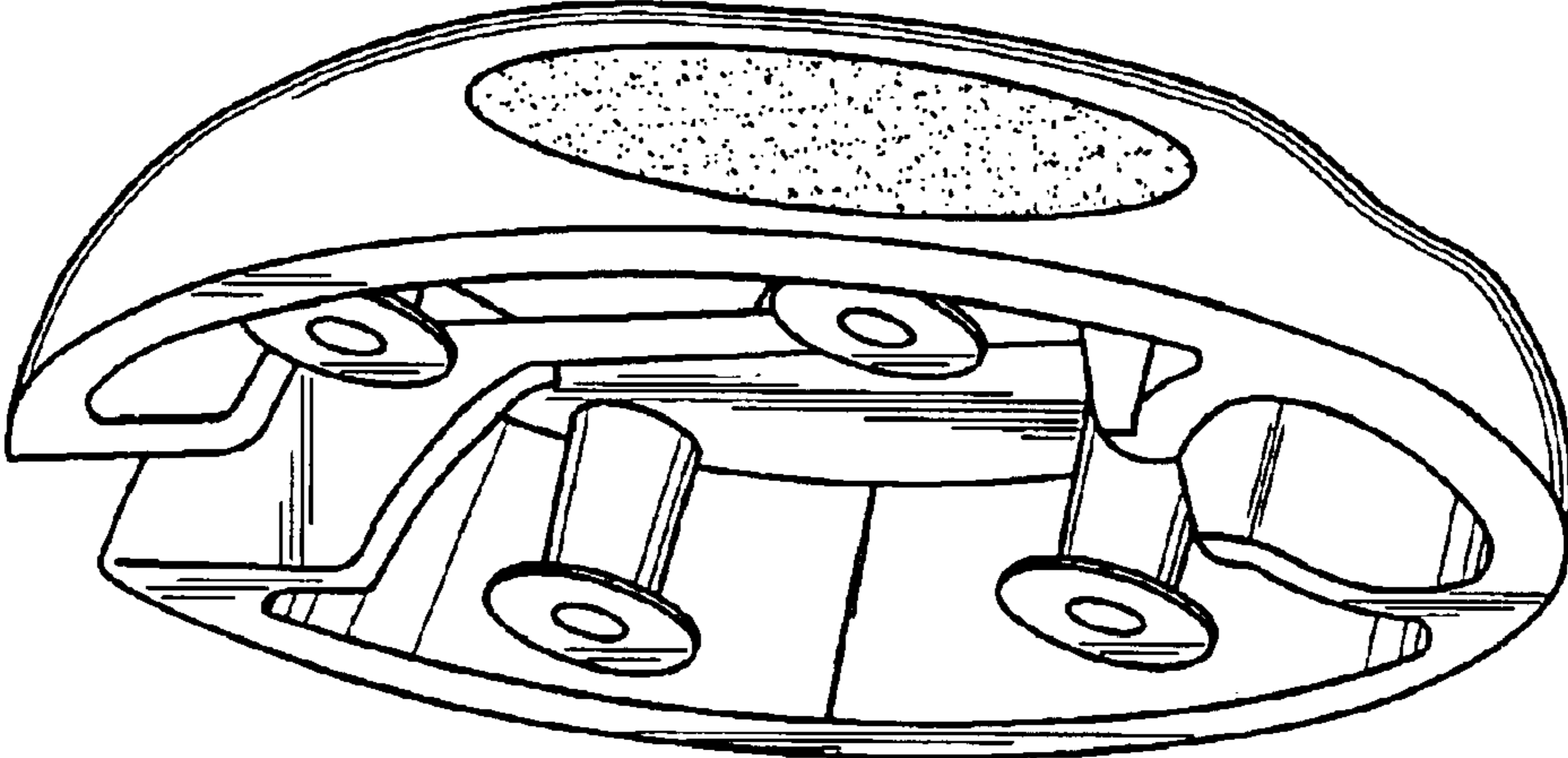

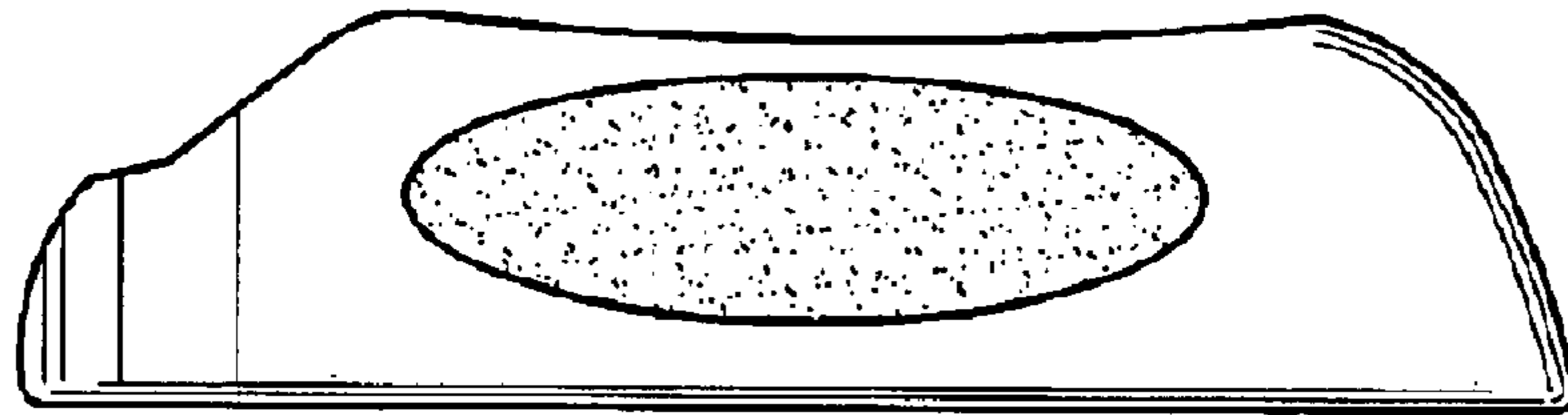

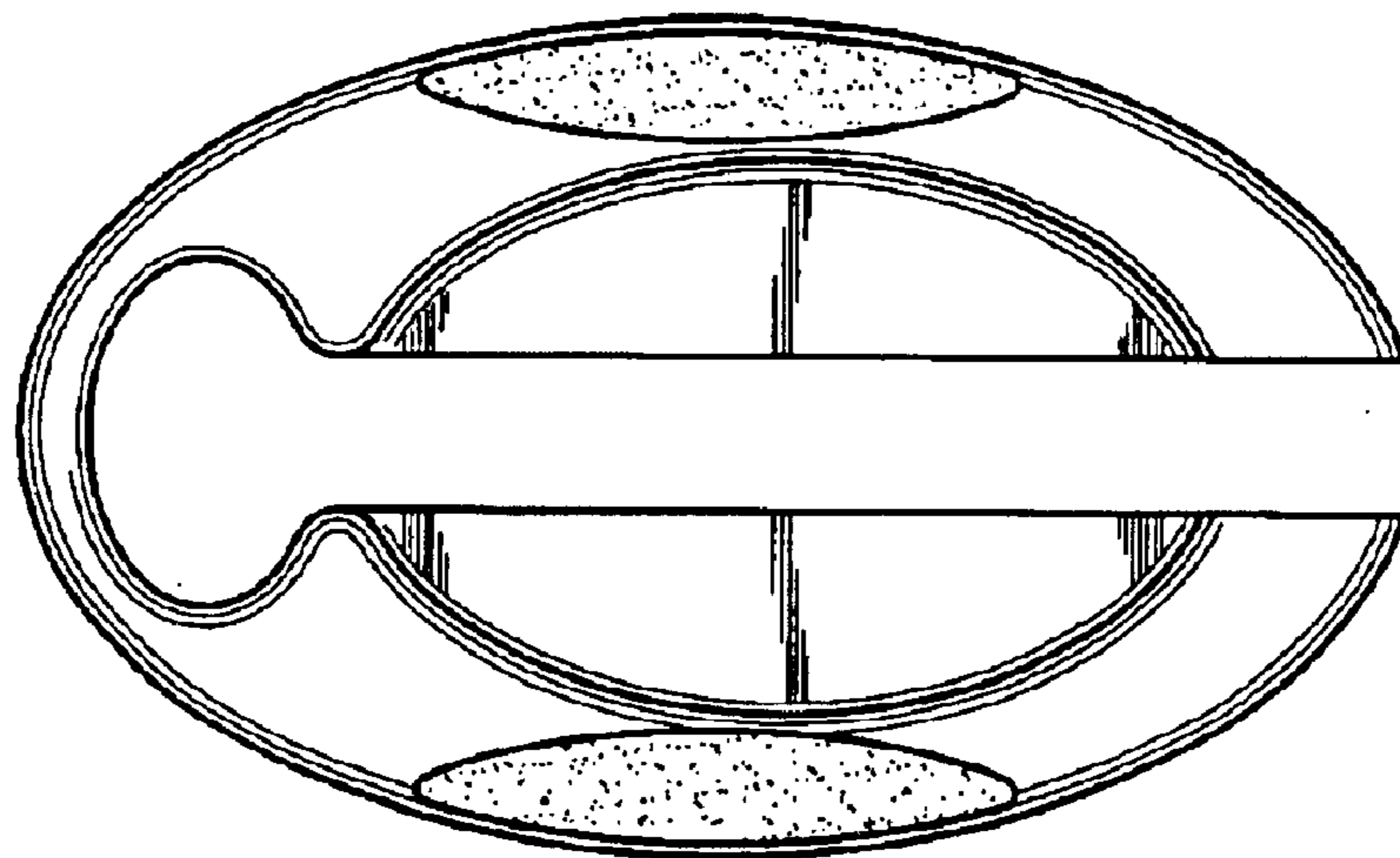

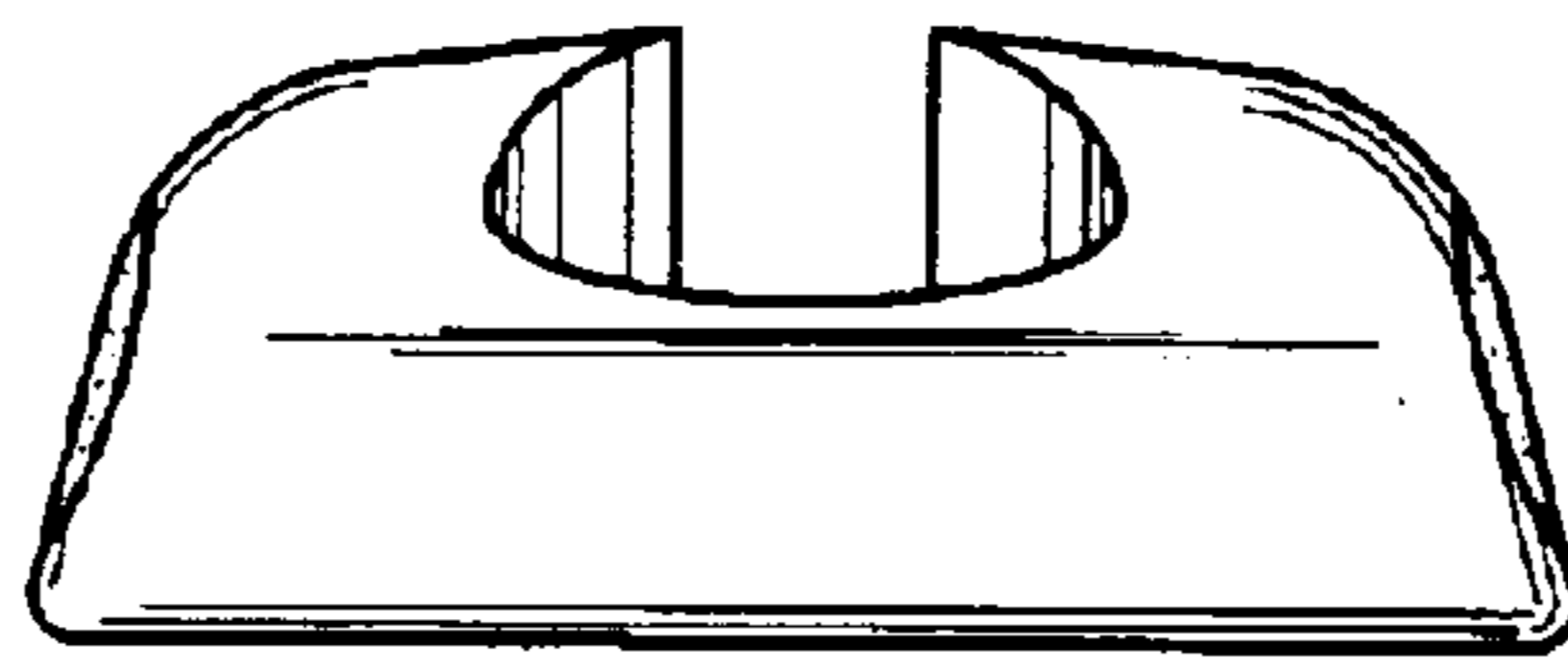

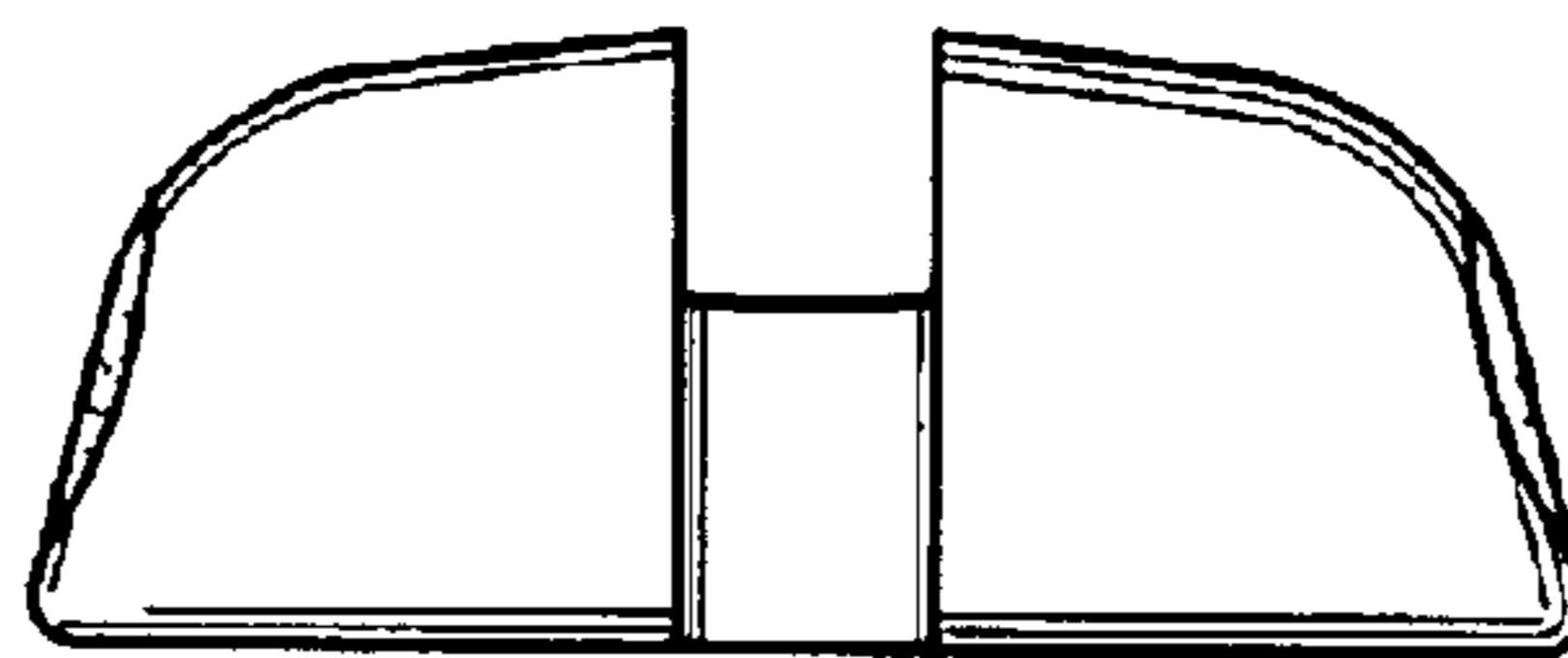

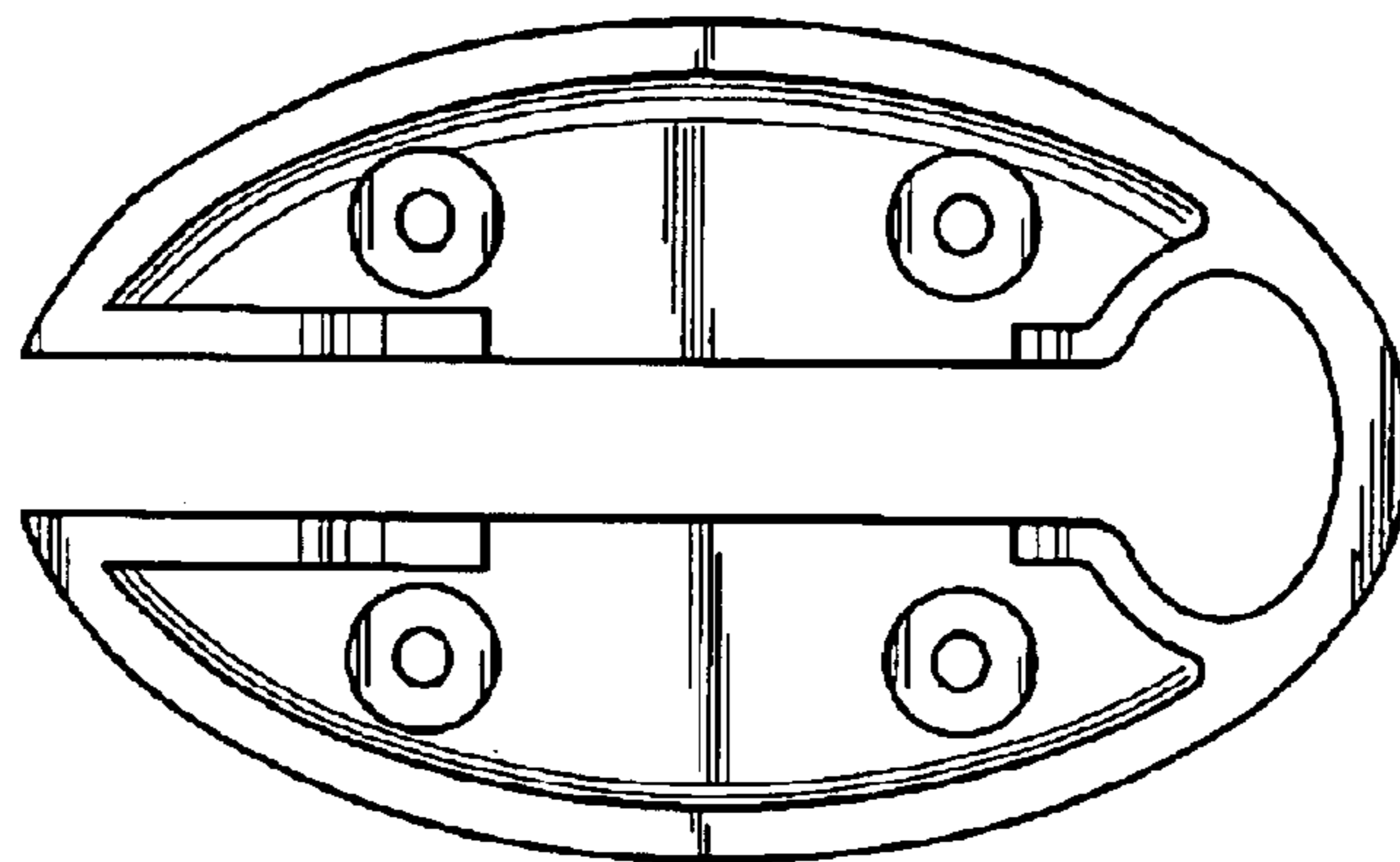
