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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an emergency trunk release handle for automobiles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the emergency trunk release handle showing my new design, the connecting portion being shown in phantom;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image of the right side elevational view, the connecting portion being shown in phantom;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof, the connecting portion being shown in phantom;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, the connecting portion being shown in phantom;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the connecting portion being shown in phantom;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 6—6 in FIG. 4 to depict the open figures formed in the emergency trunk release handle; and,

FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 7—7 in FIG. 4 to depict the open figures formed in the emergency trunk release handle.

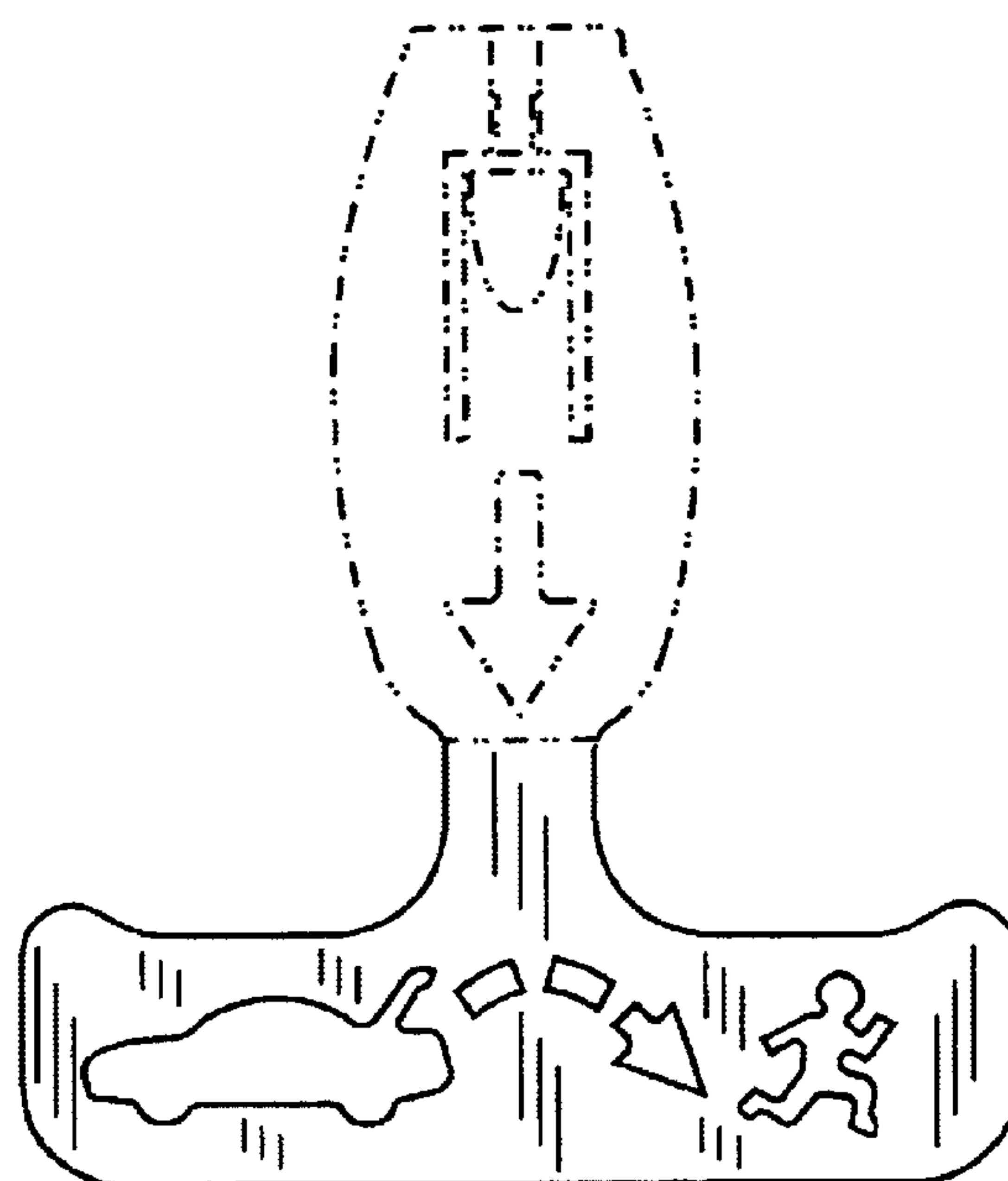

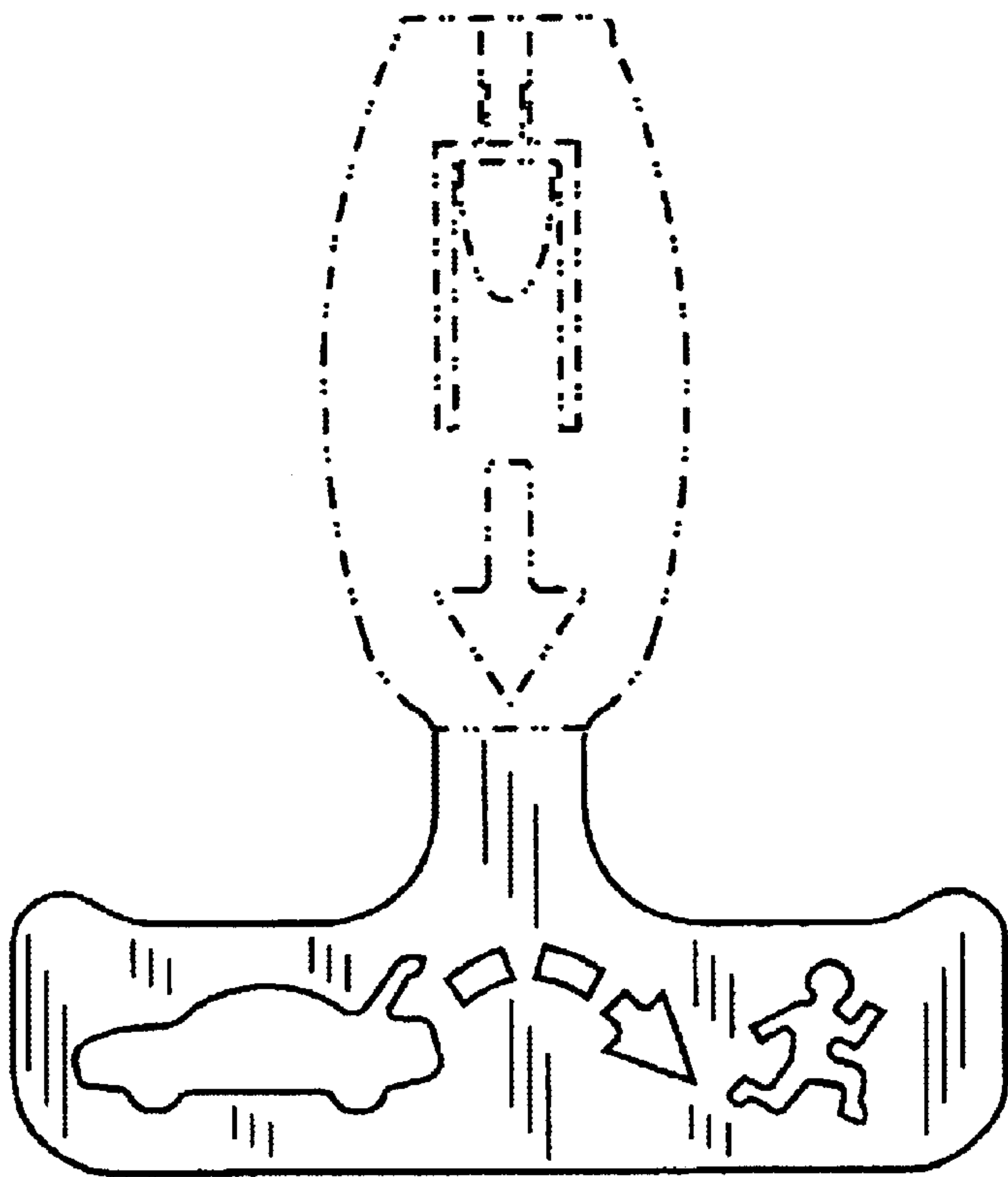

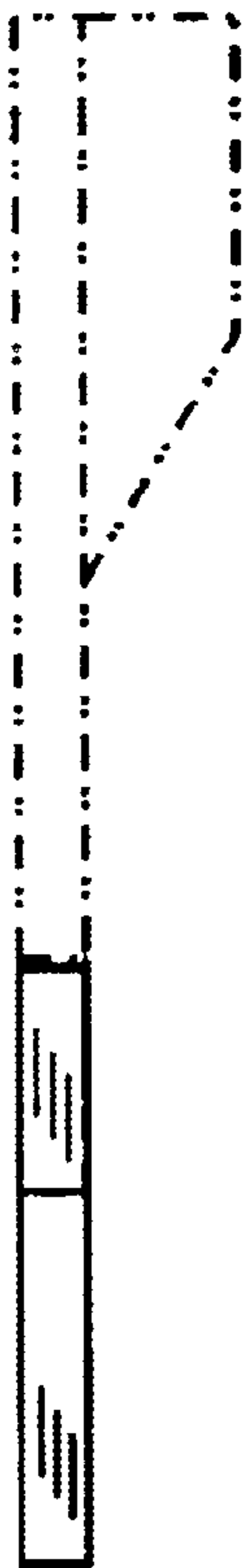

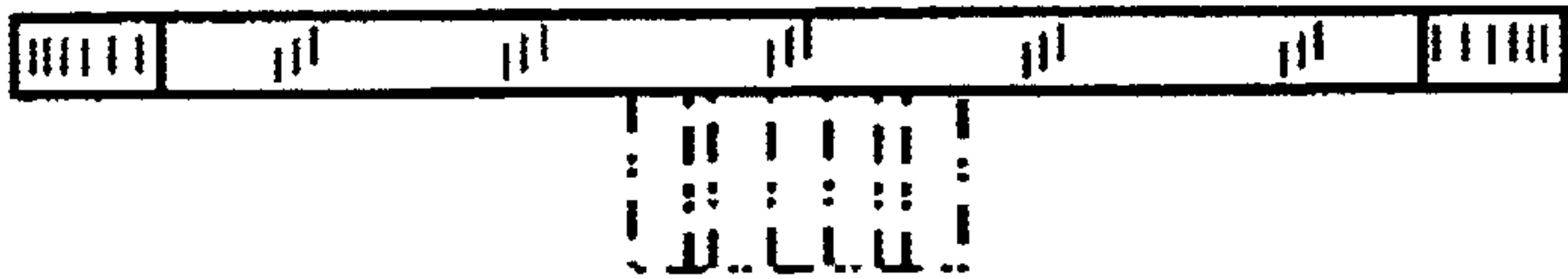

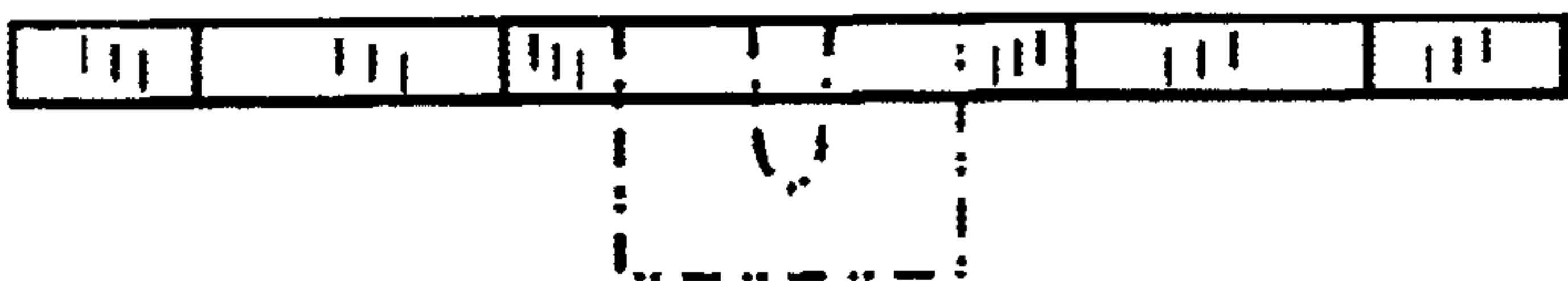

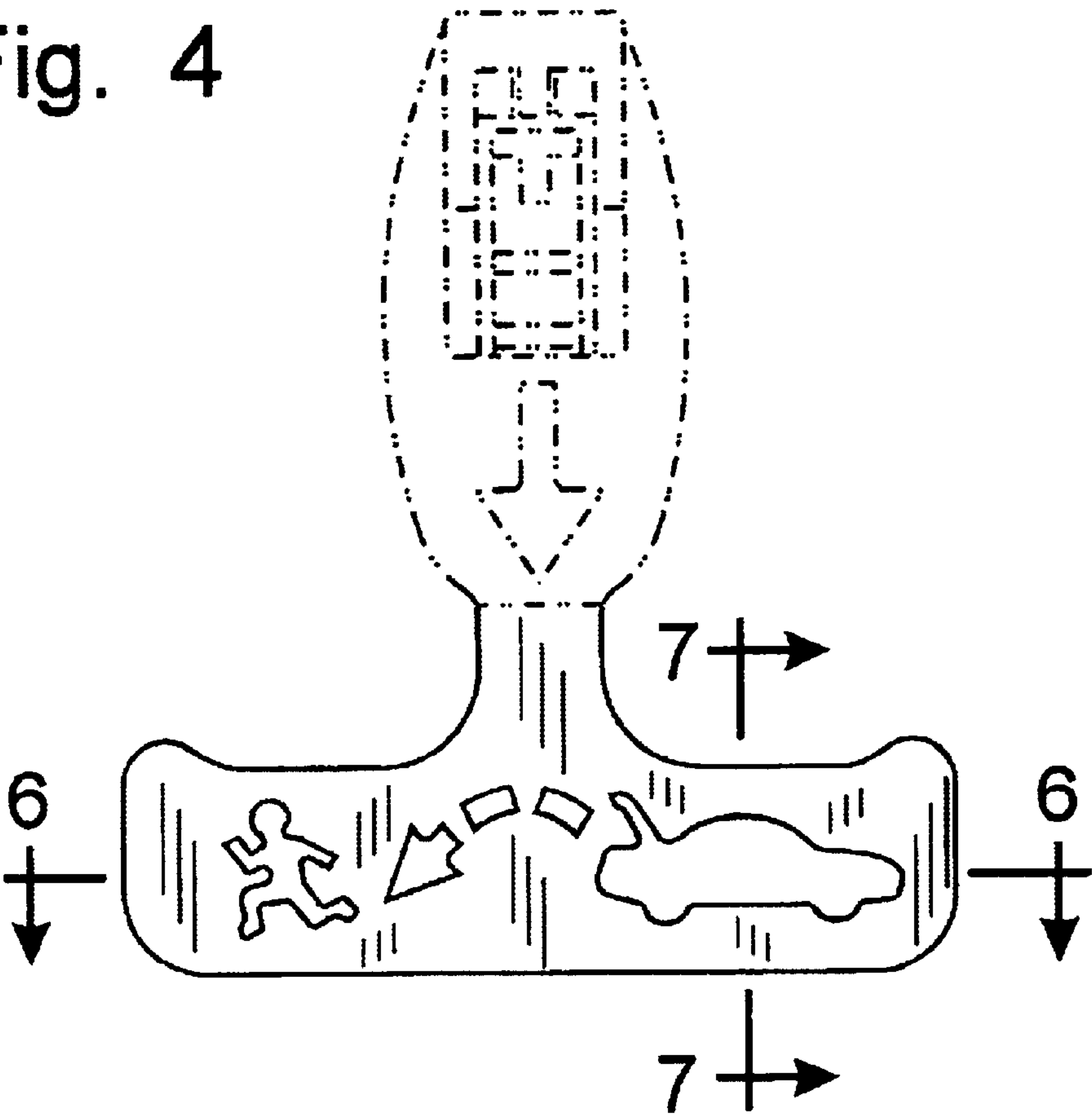
