I claim the ornamental design for the shoe midsole, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shoe midsole of this invention as seen from the rear, bottom and left side, wherein the broken lines do not constitute a part of the claimed design;

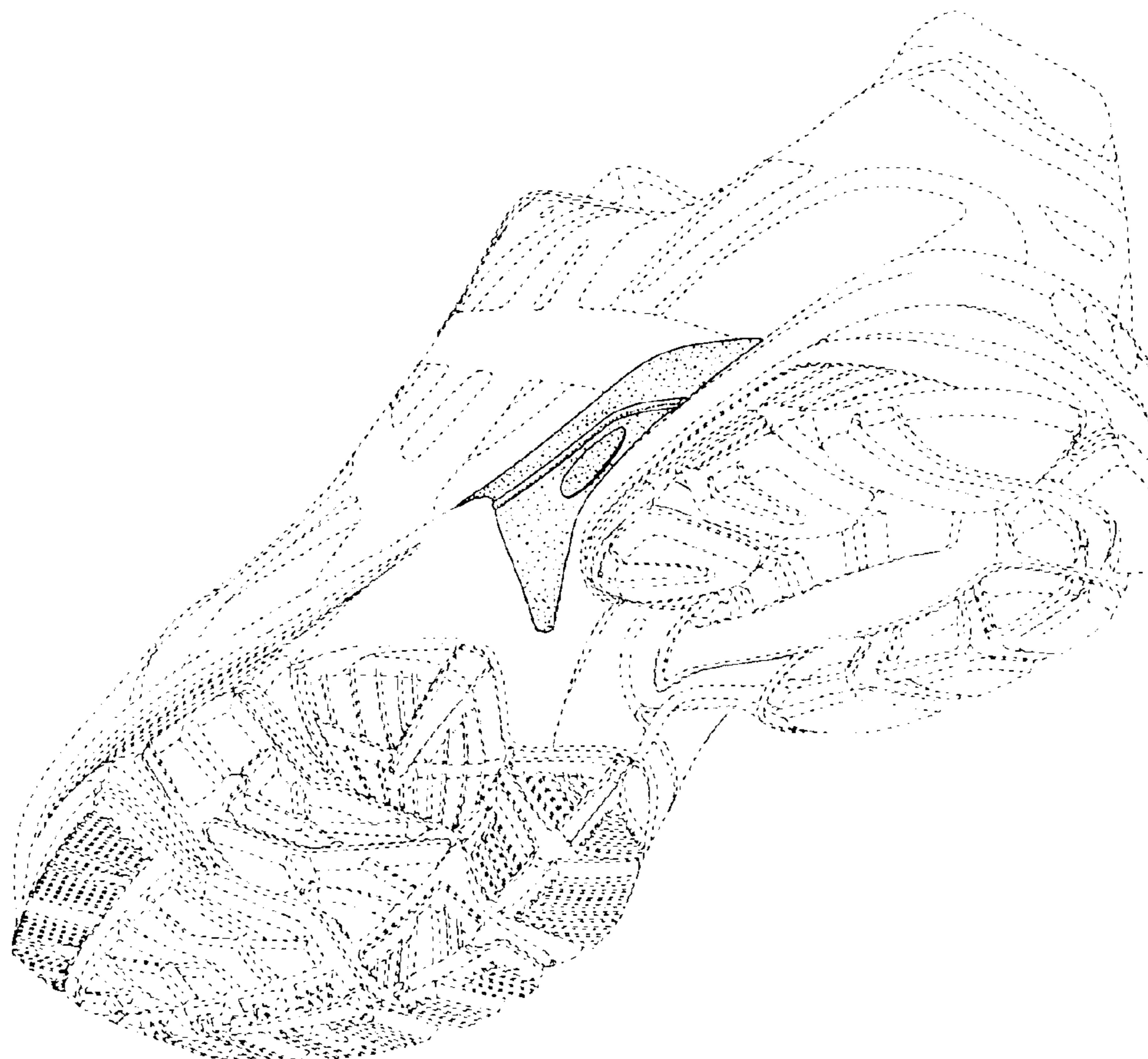
FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view thereof;

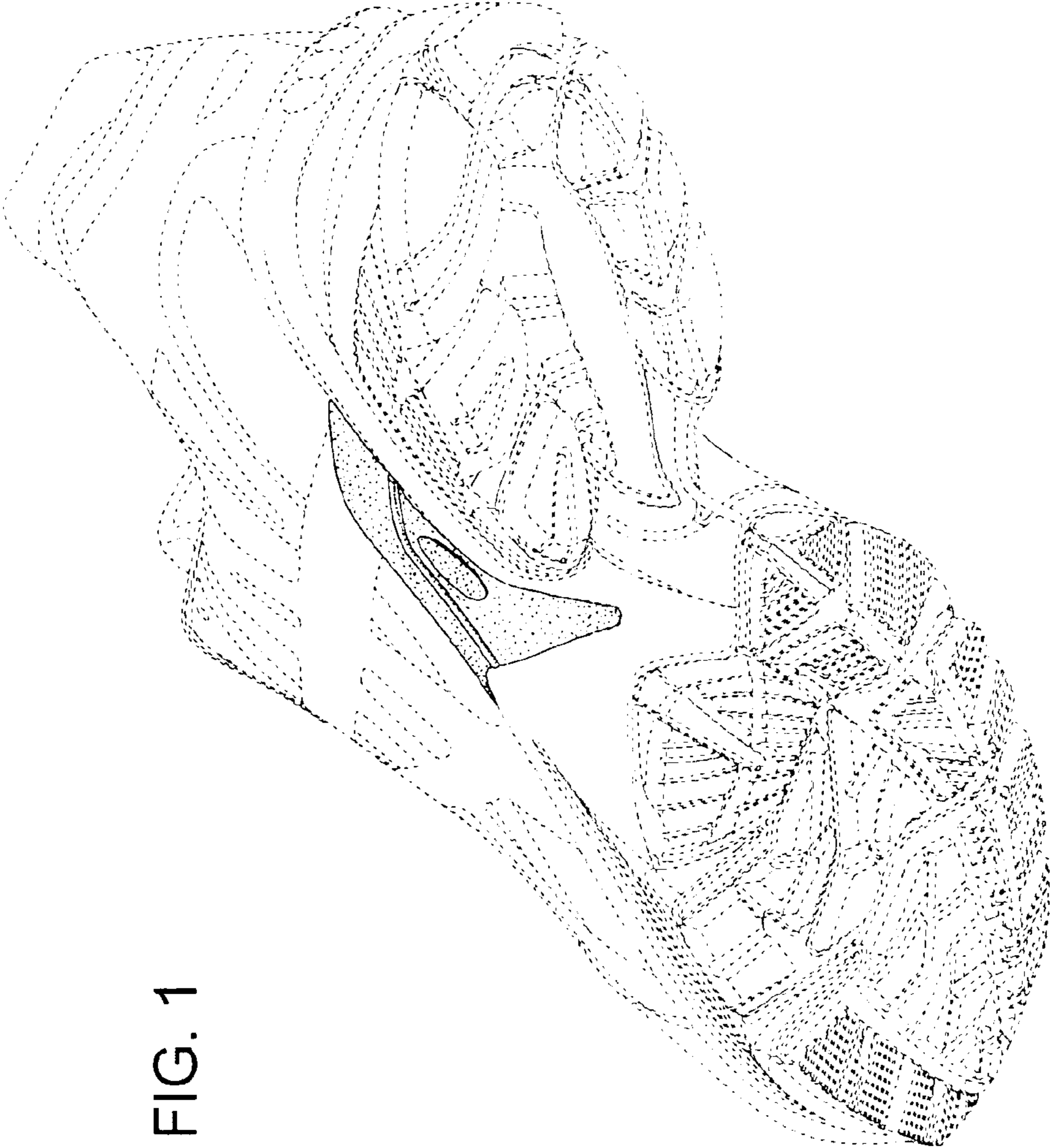

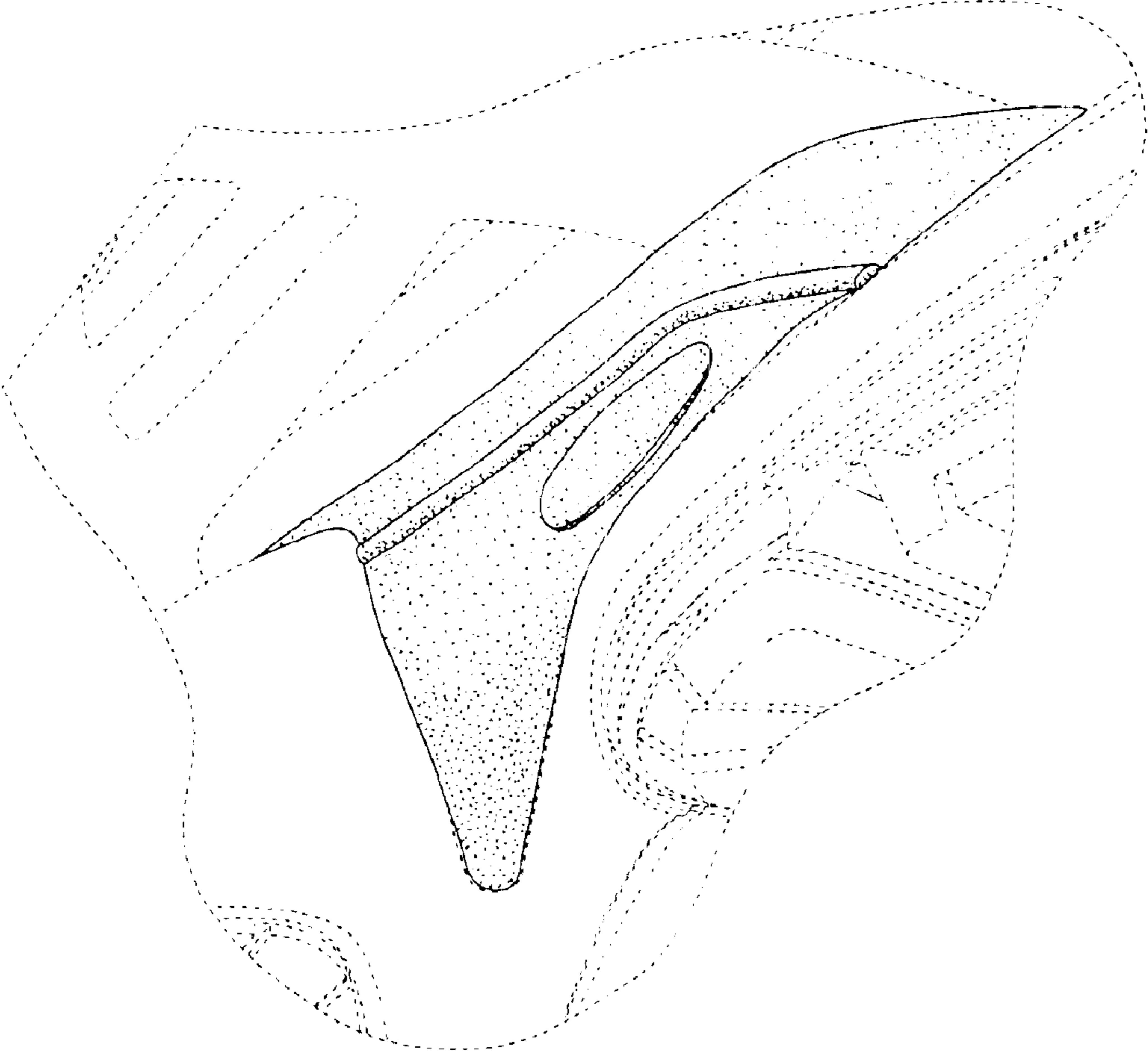

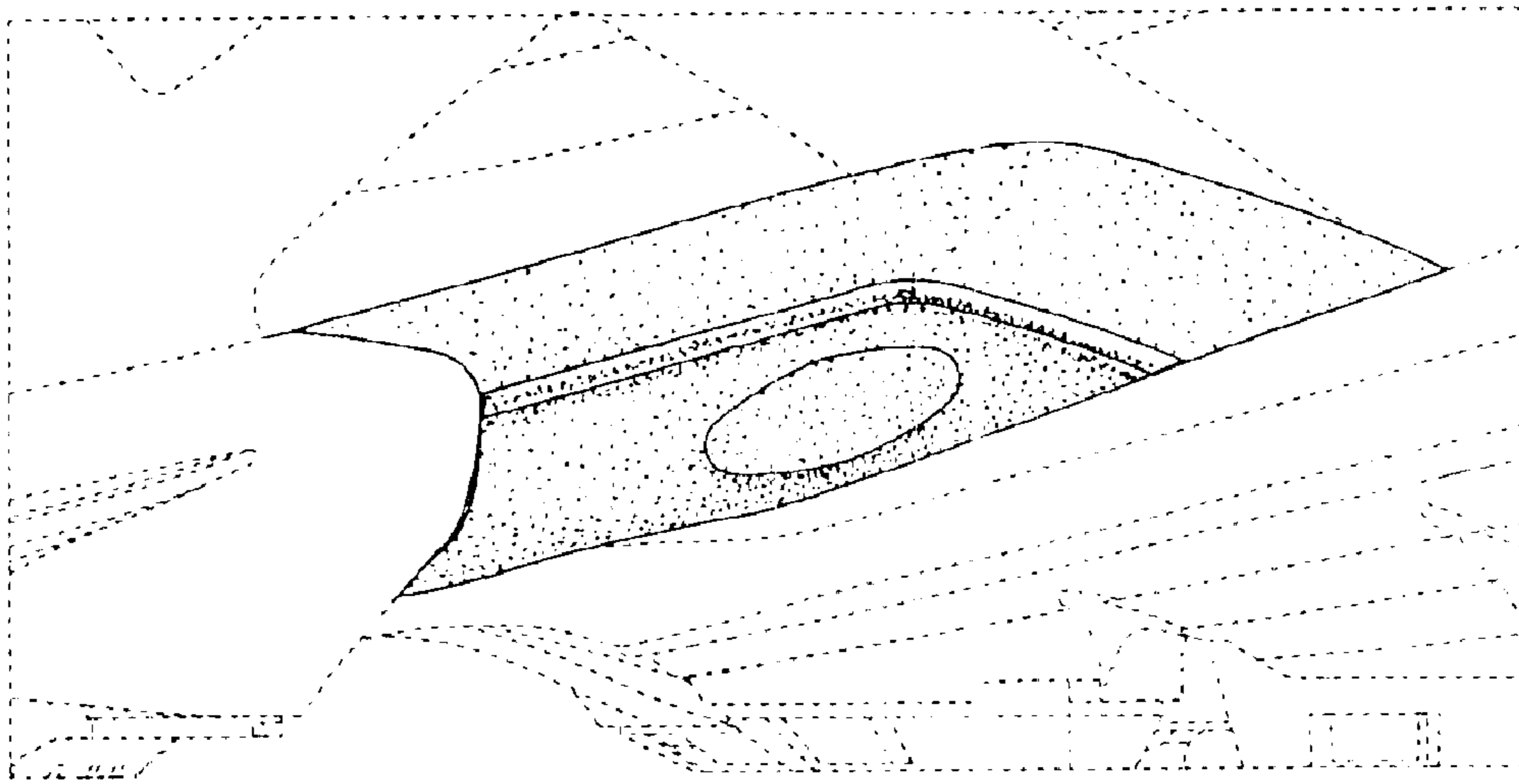
