FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of a chair showing my new design;

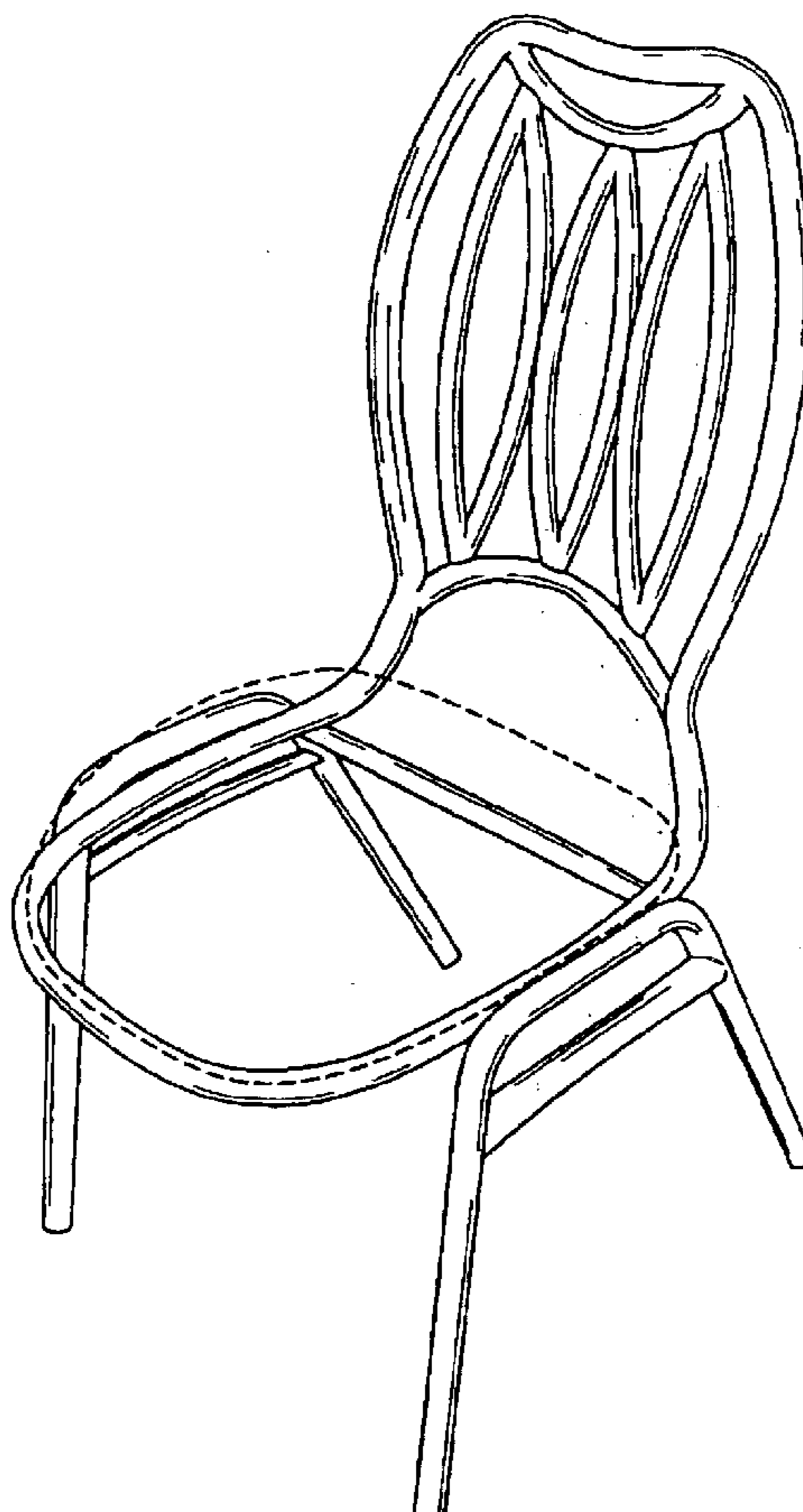
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of a chair showing my new design;

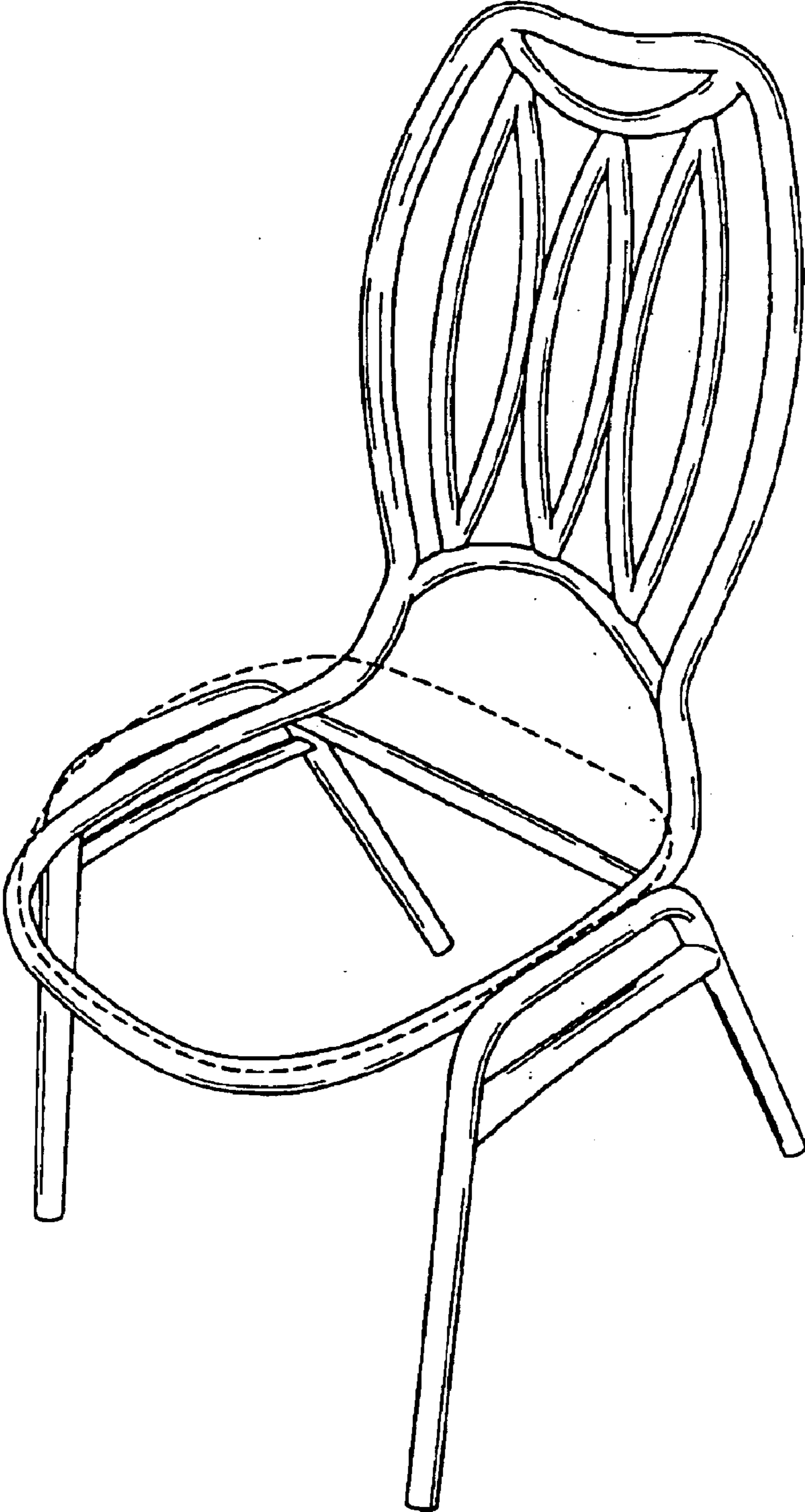

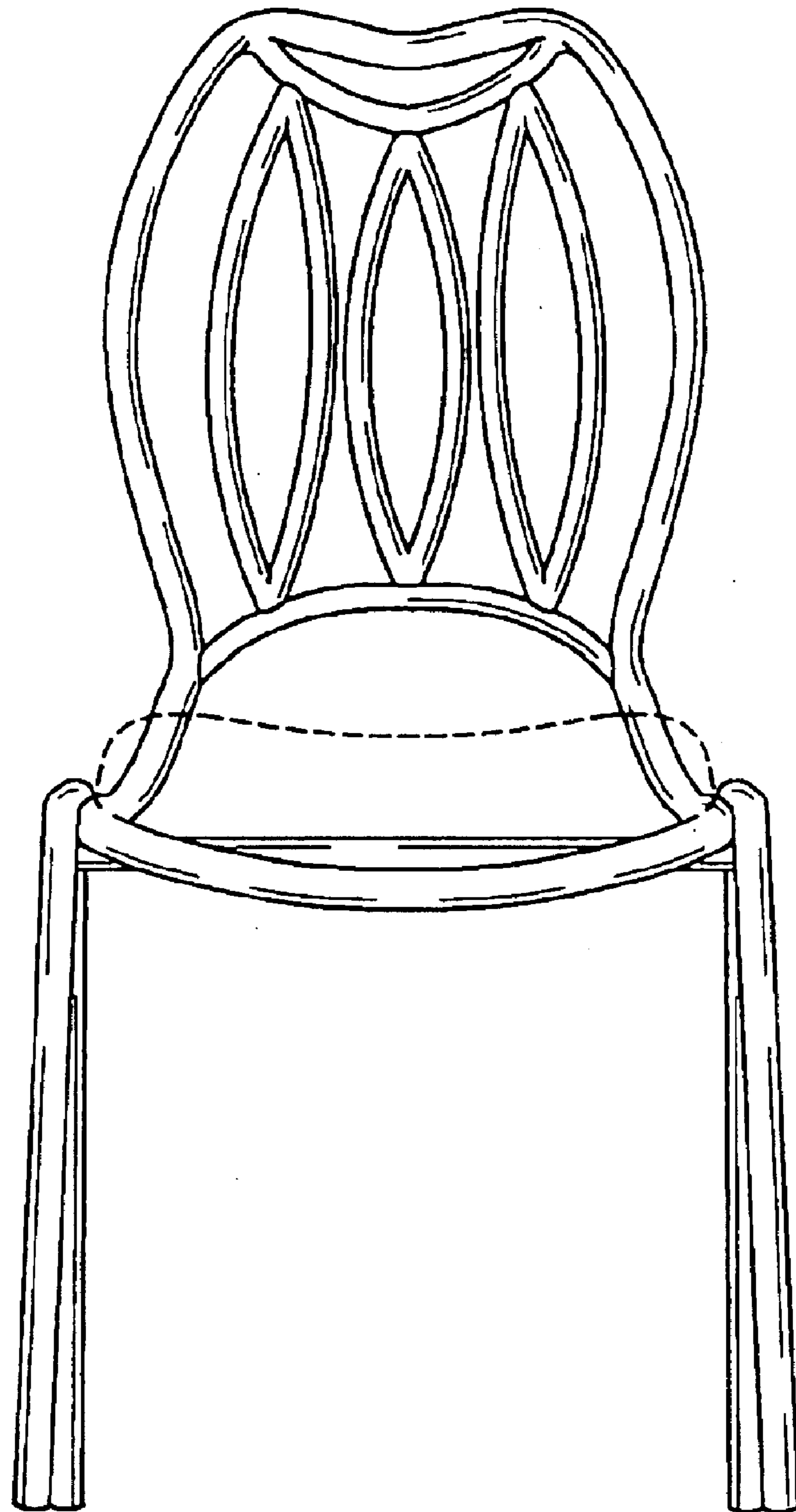

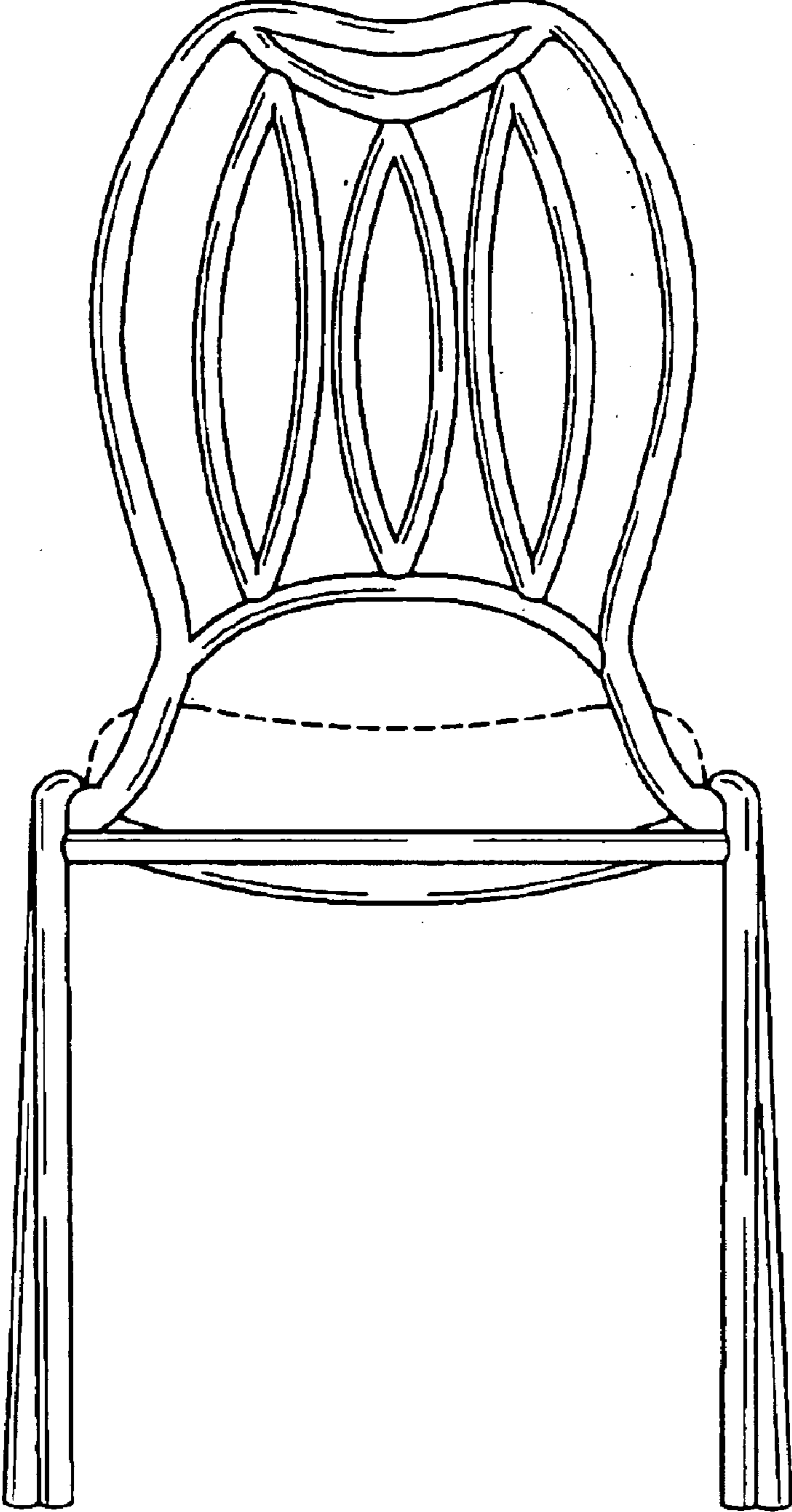

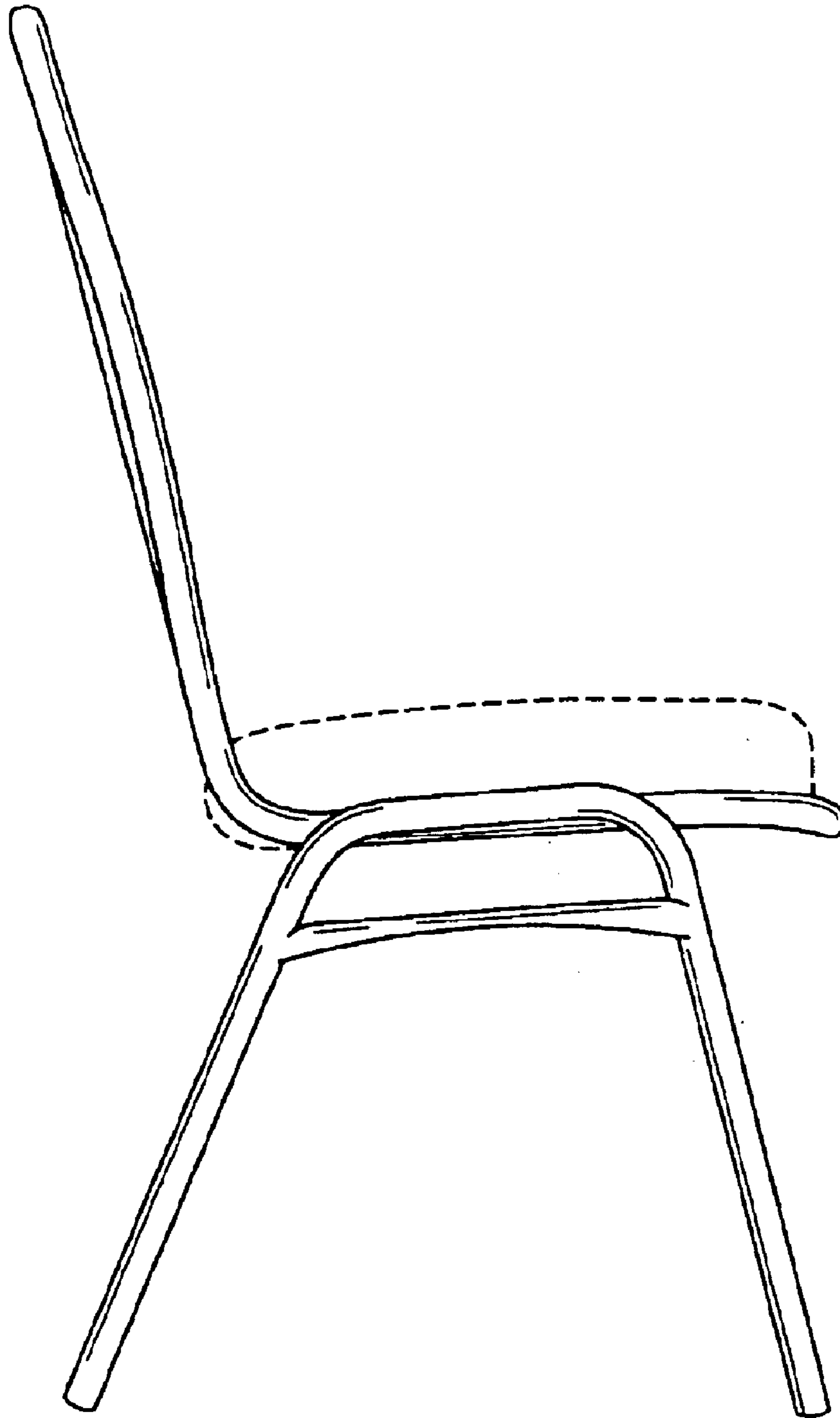

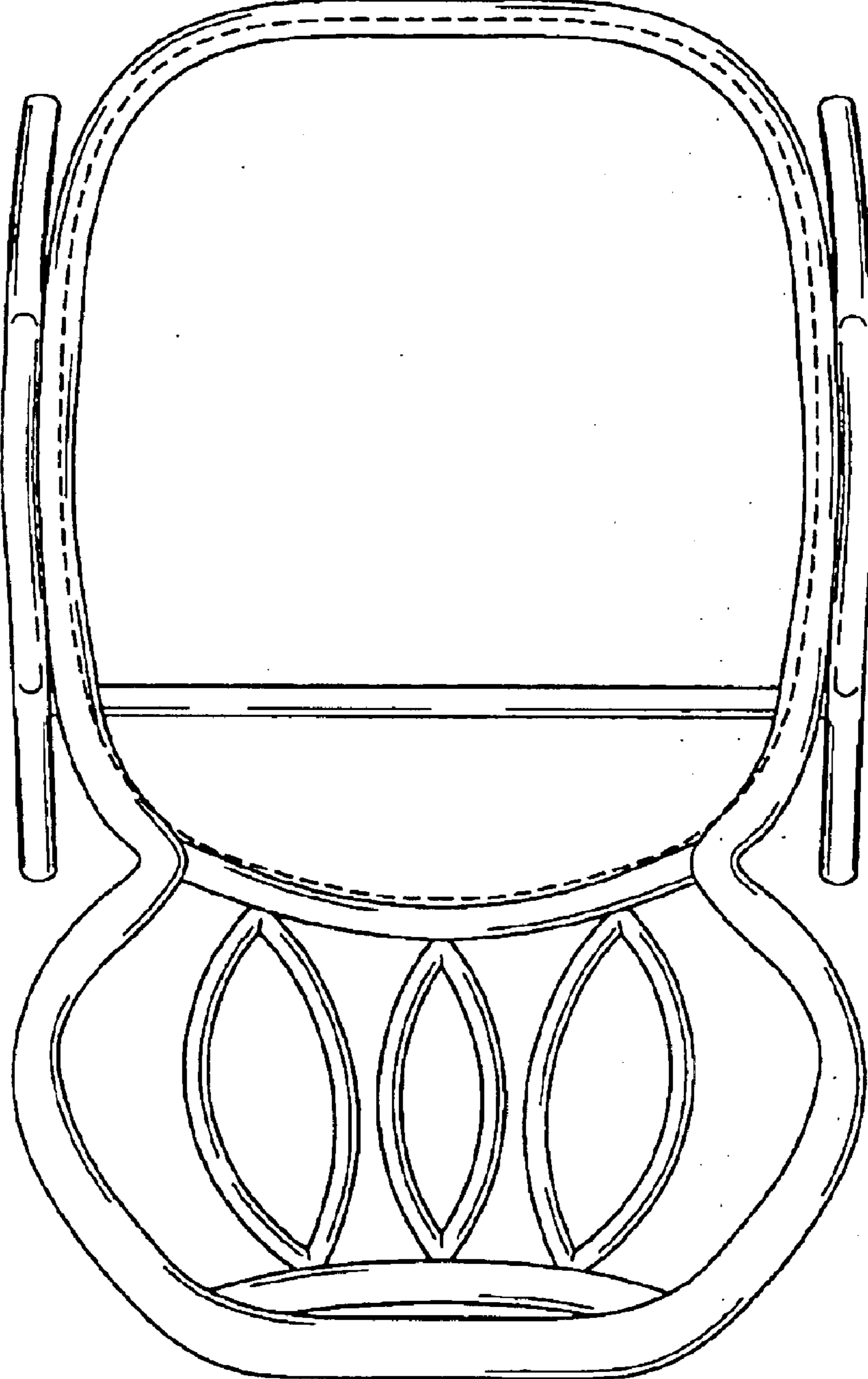

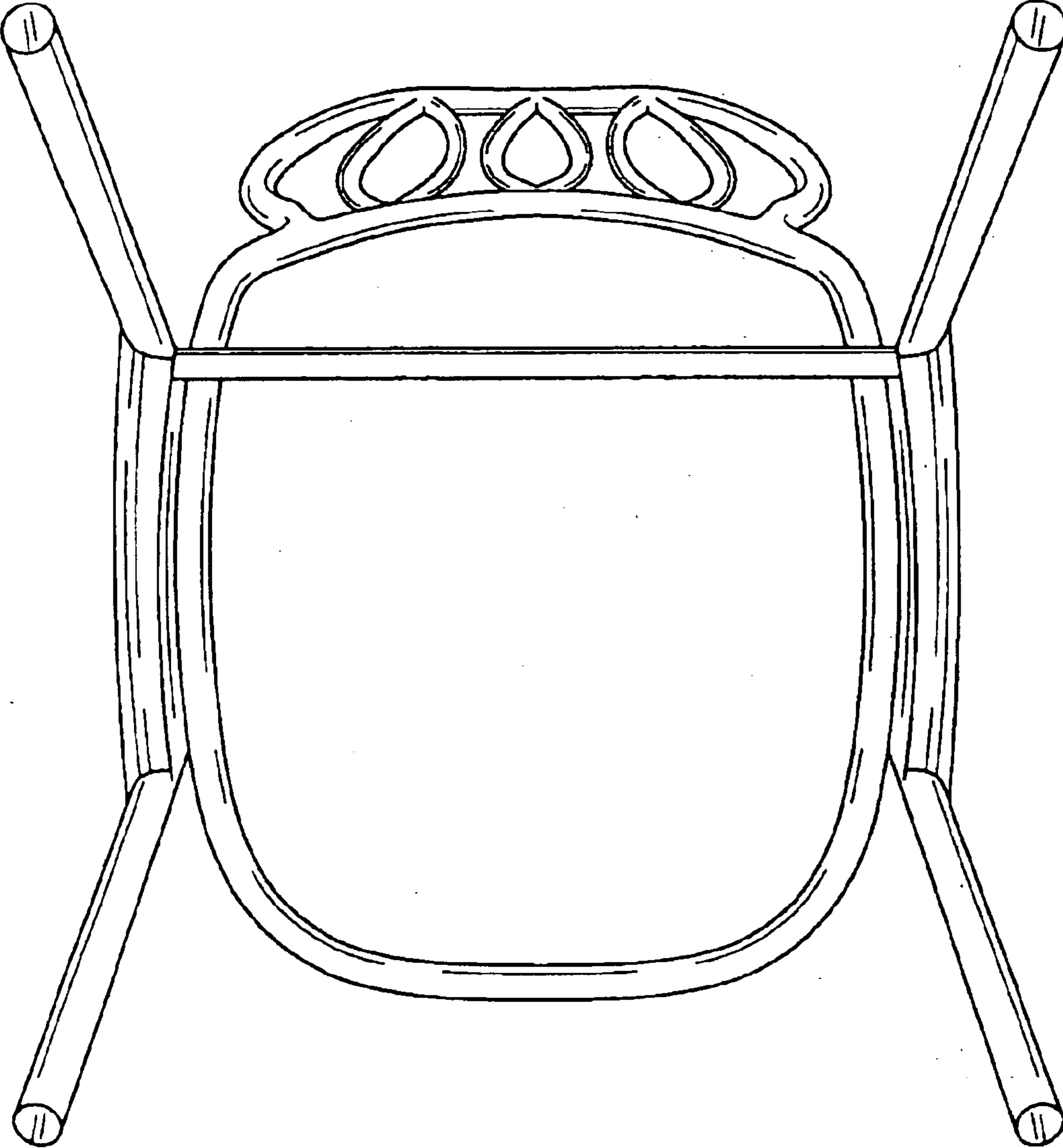
