FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.

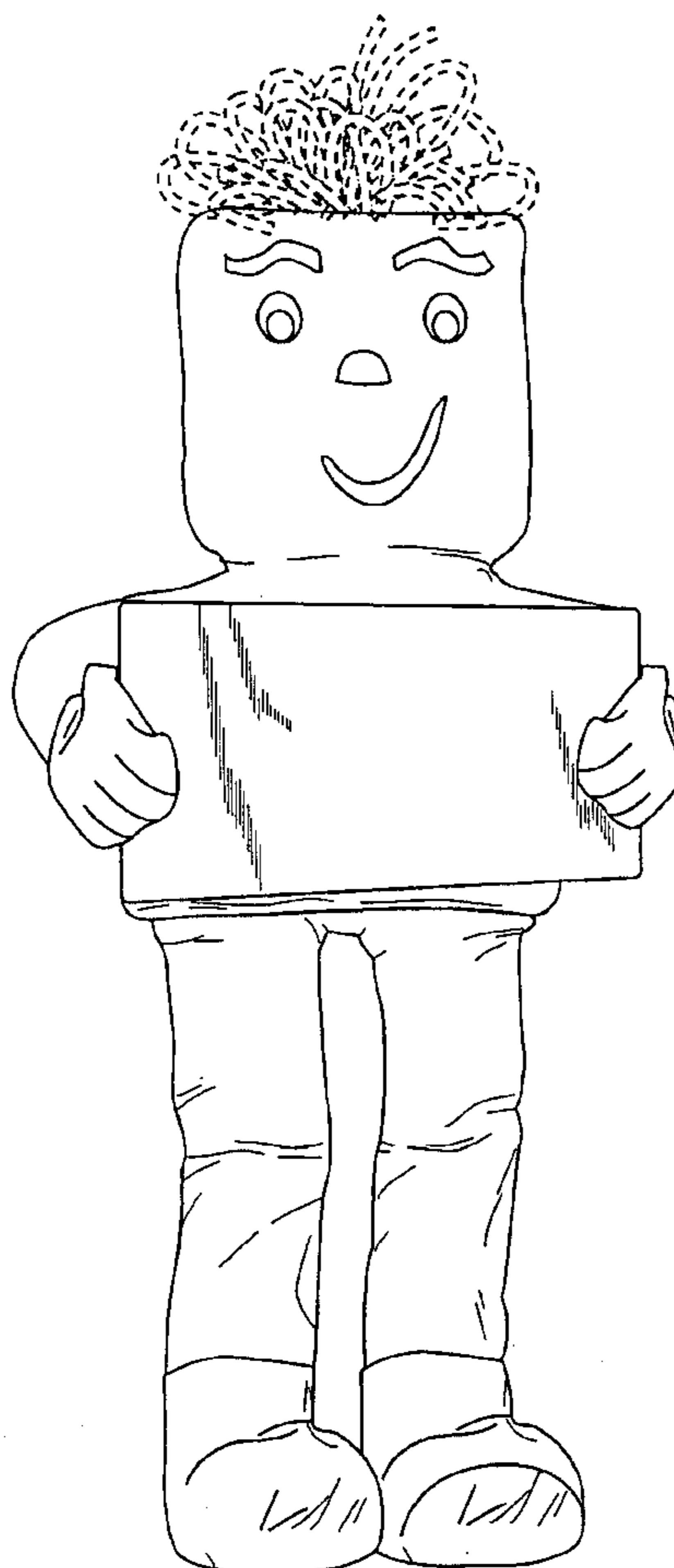

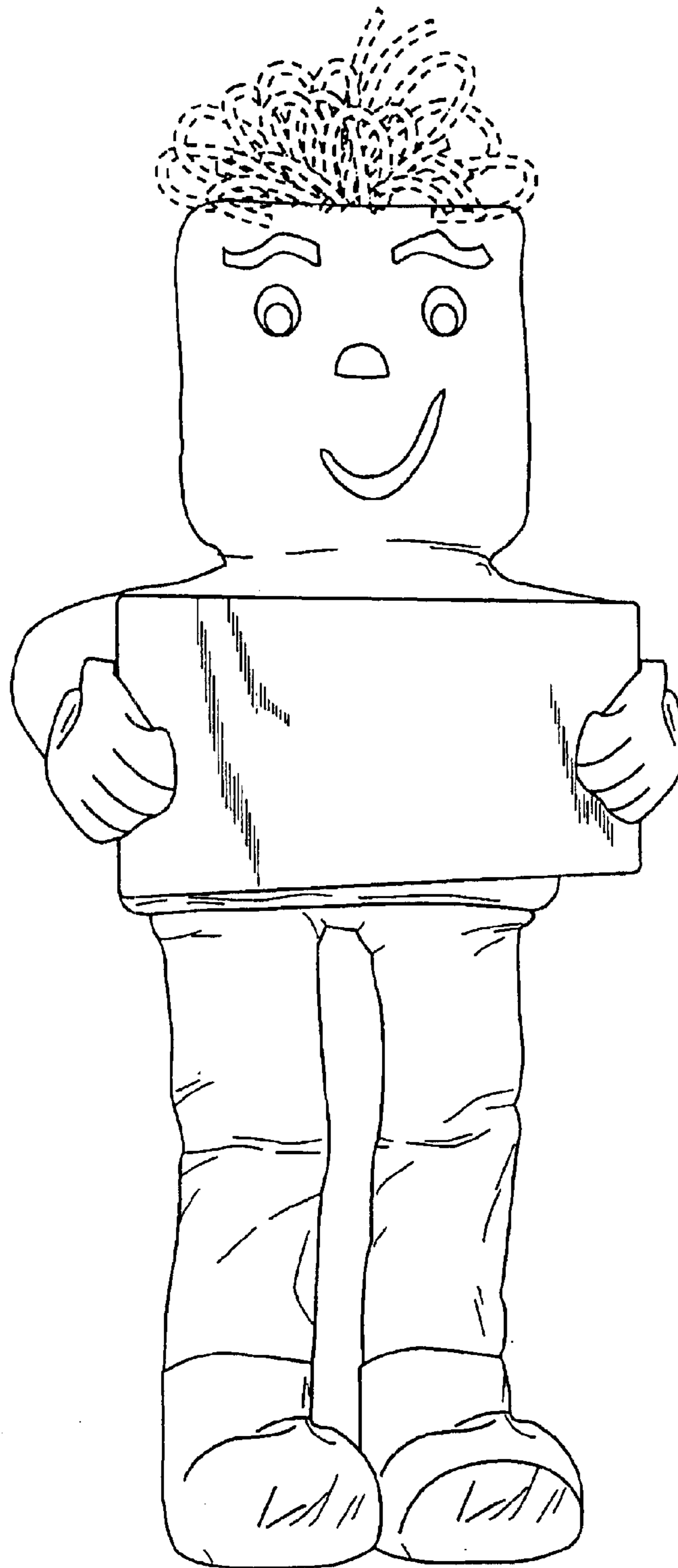

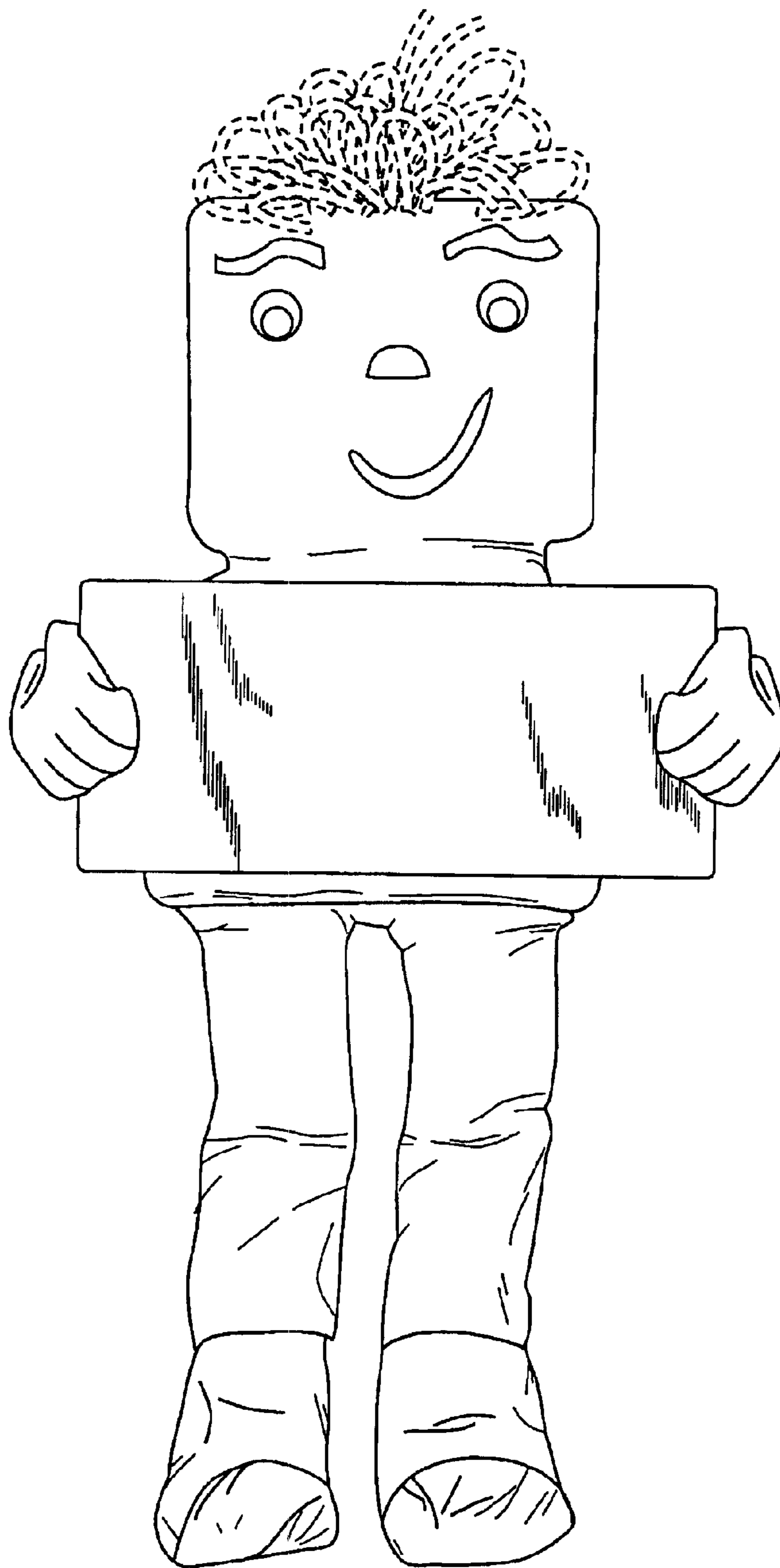

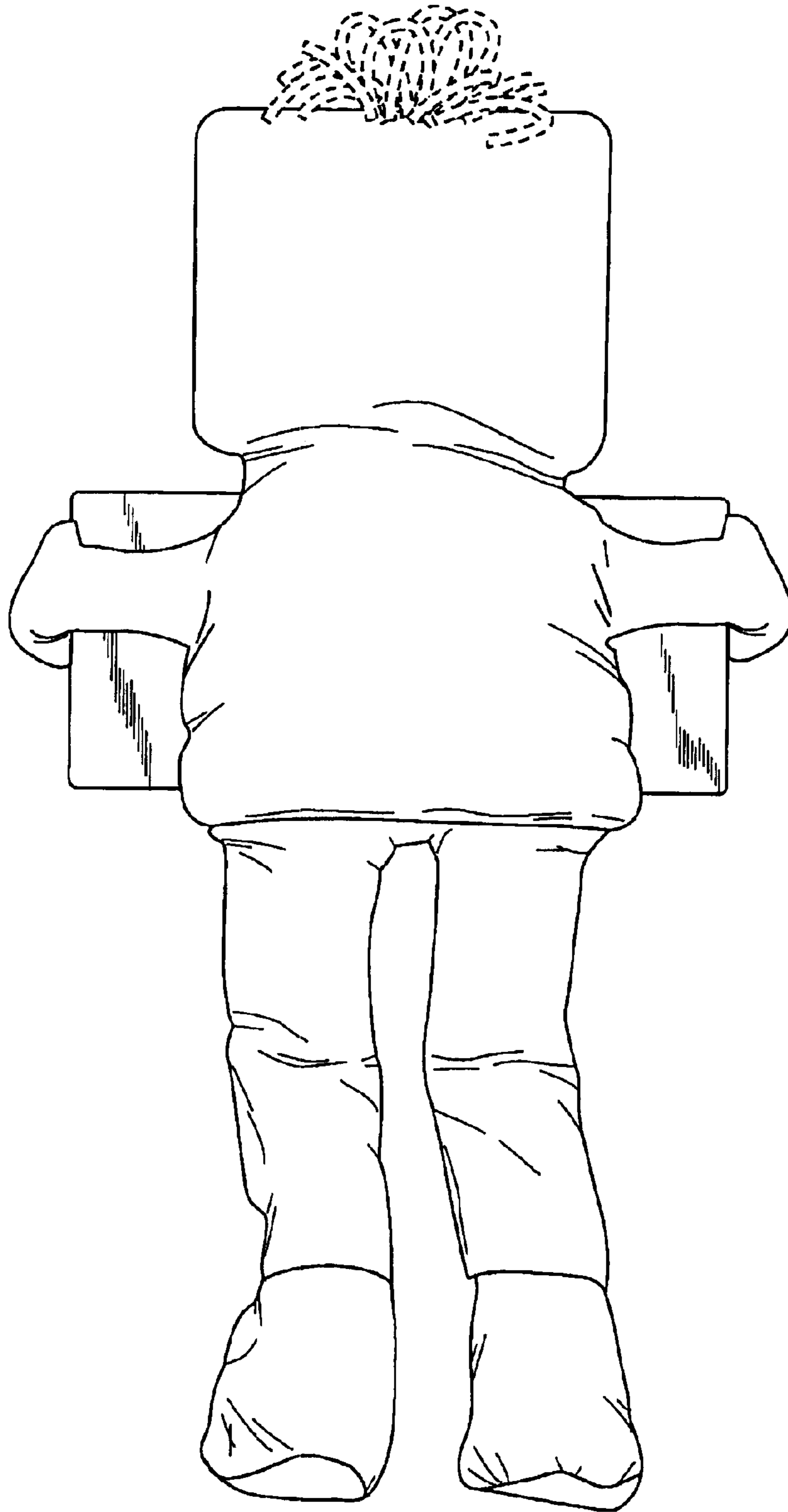




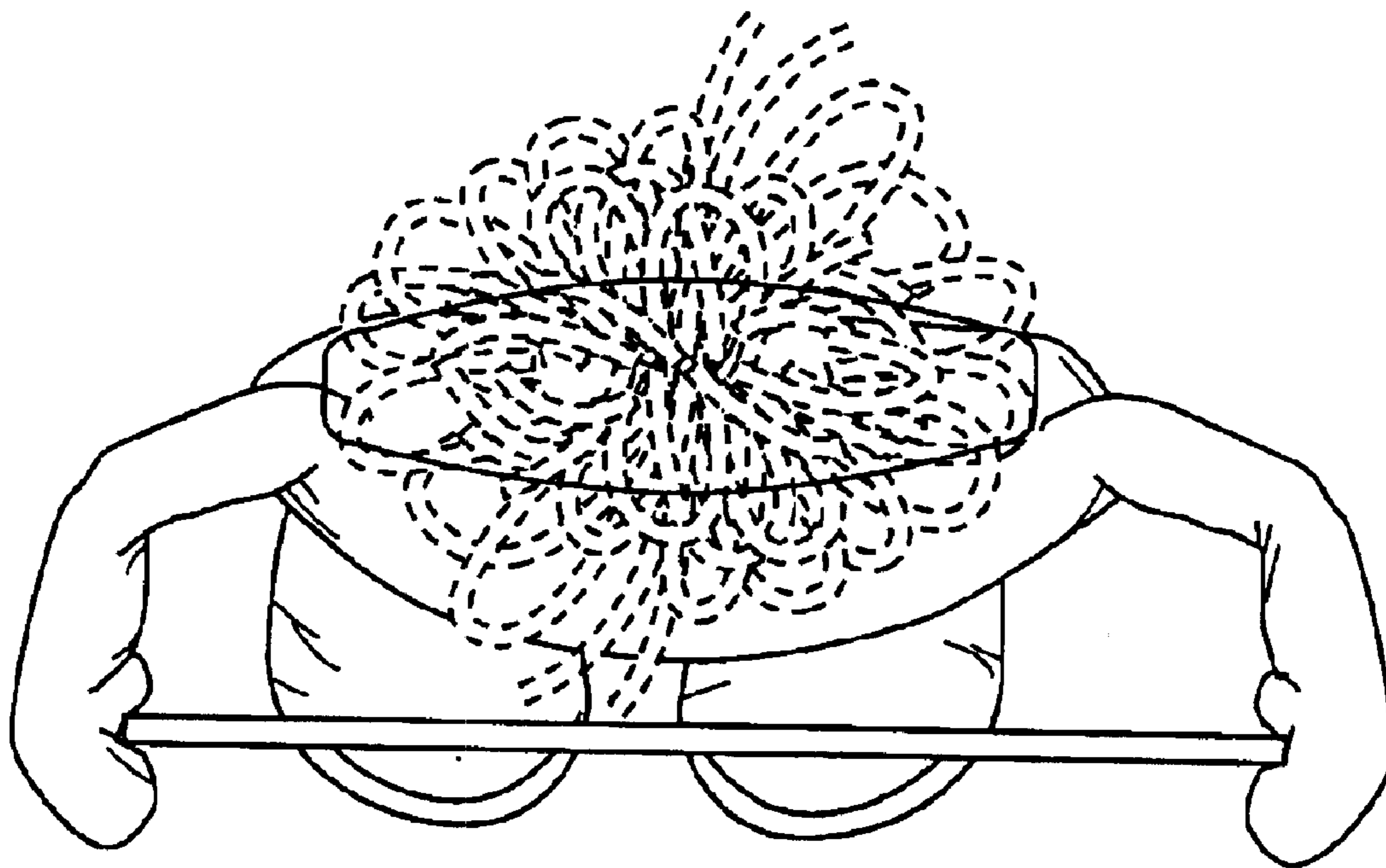
