The ornamental design for an arch ligament support, shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the arch ligament support according to a right foot embodiment of the invention, a left foot embodiment of the invention being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is an isometric view thereof, wherein the arch ligament support is applied to the right foot of a user;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

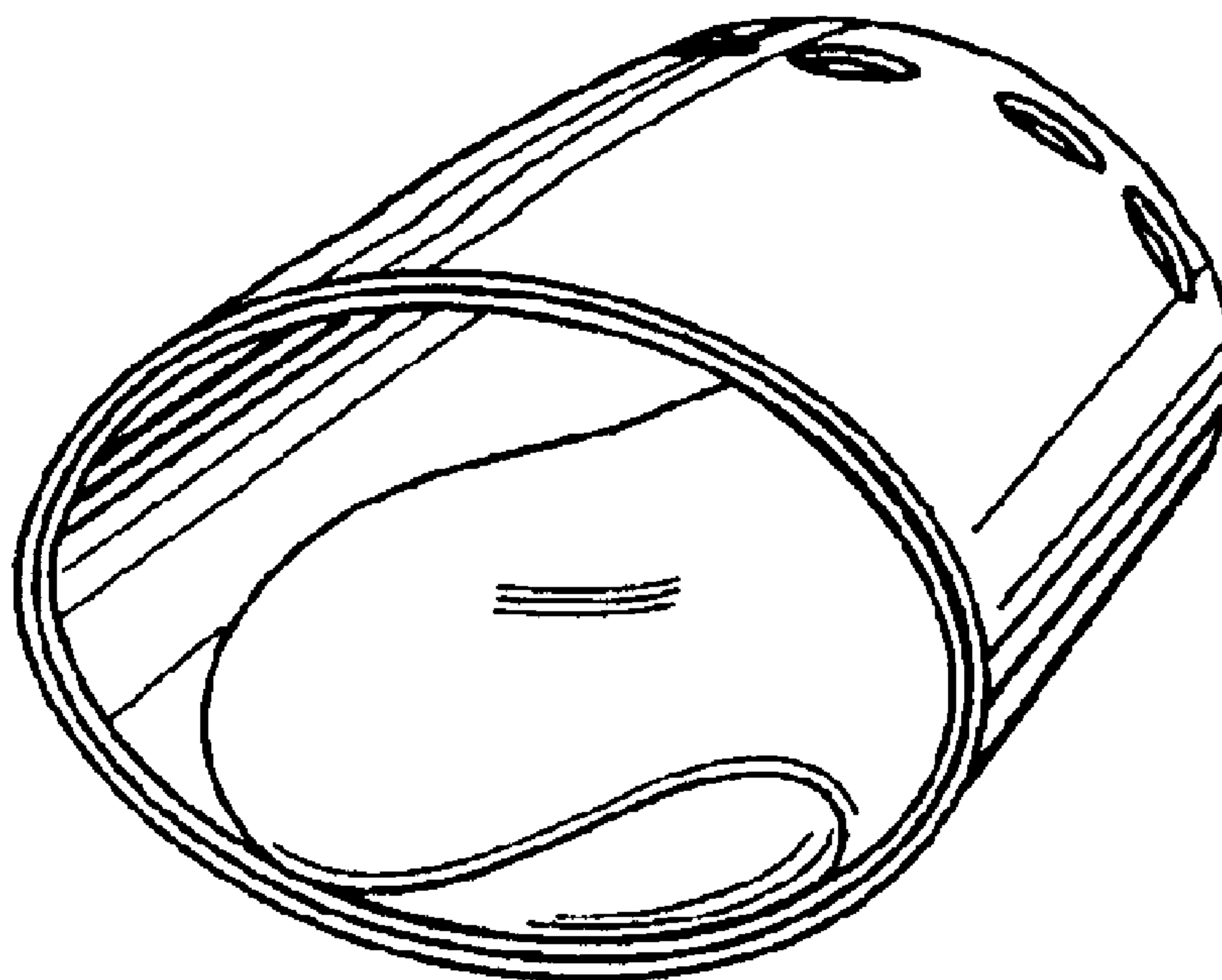
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a longitudinal cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 6; and,

FIG. 6 is a transverse cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 6—6 in FIG. 4.

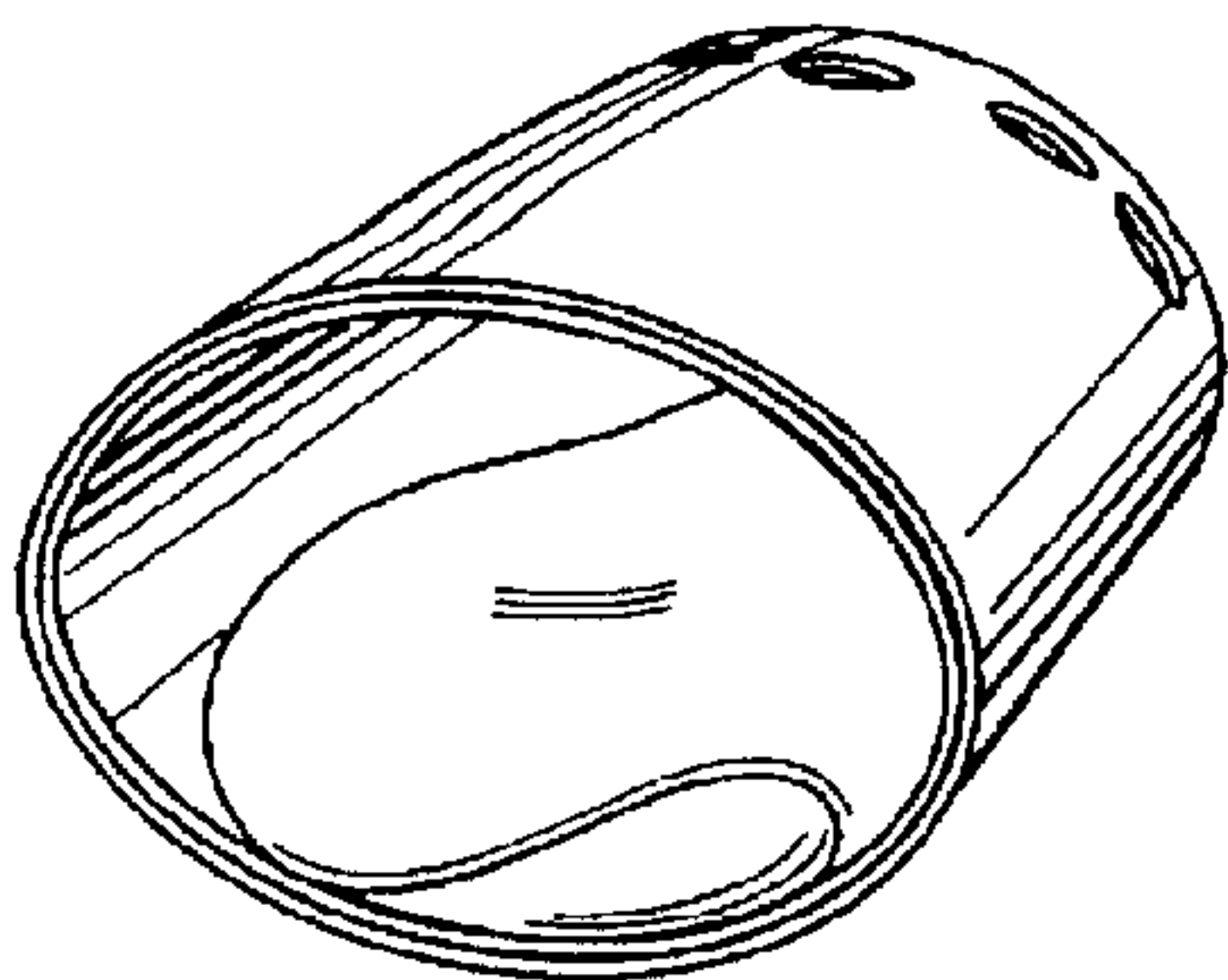

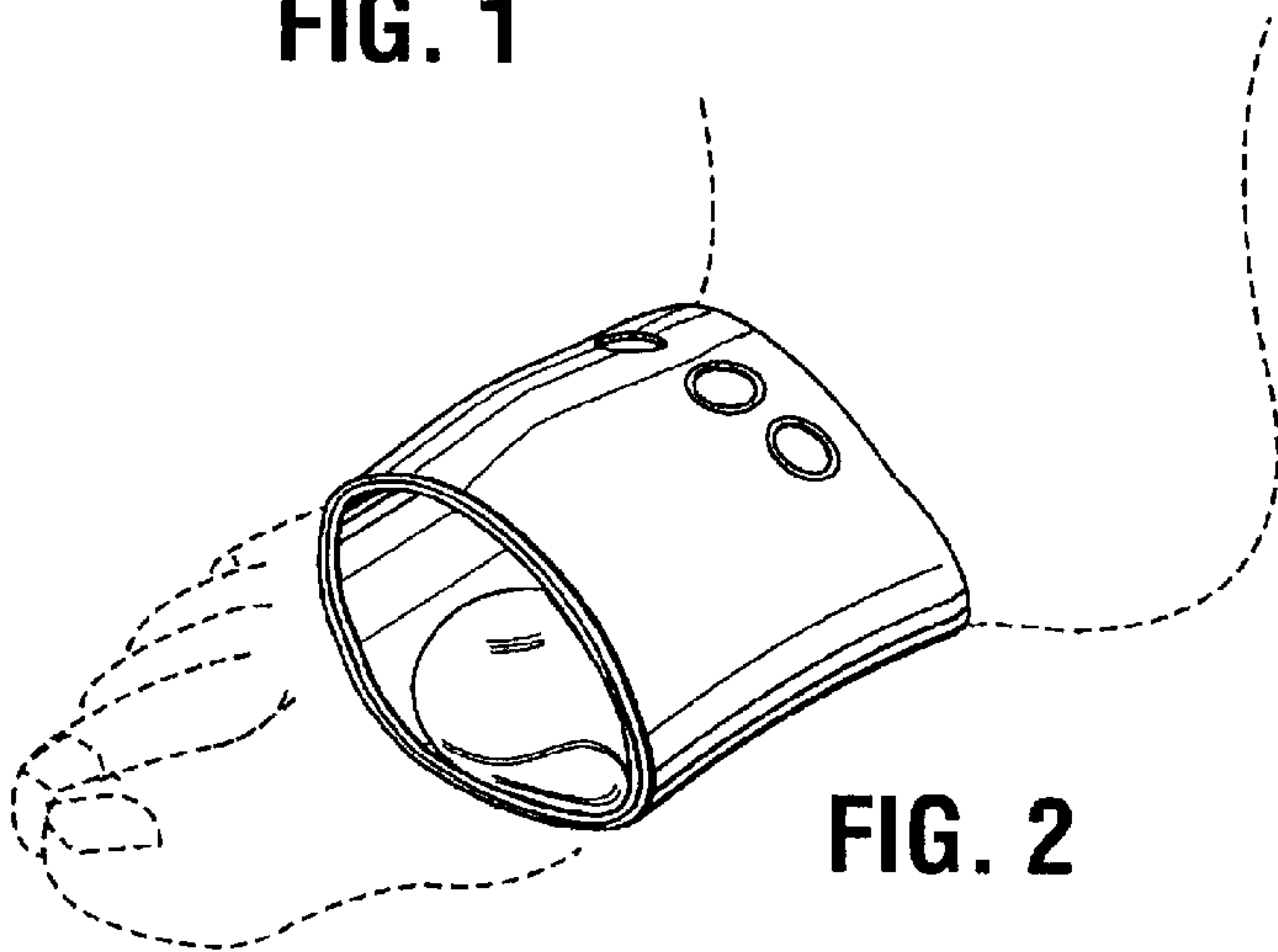

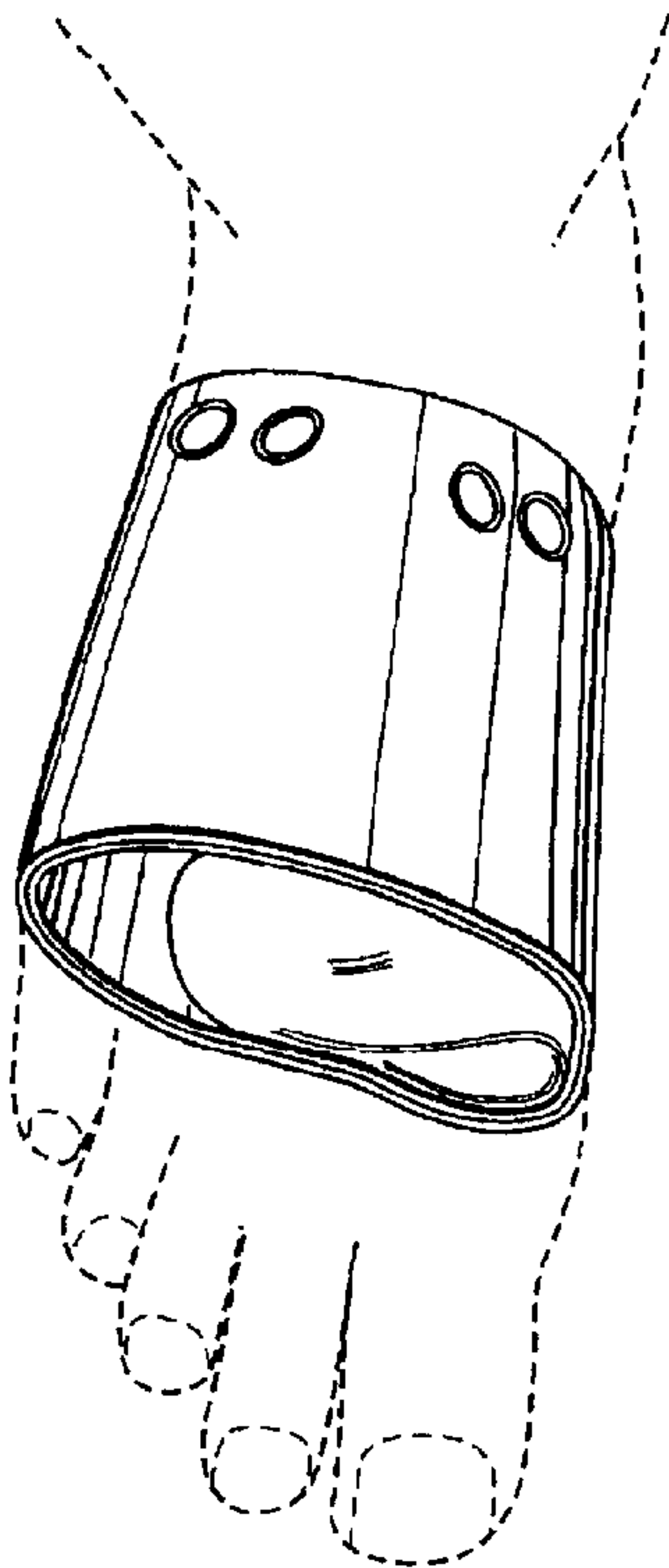

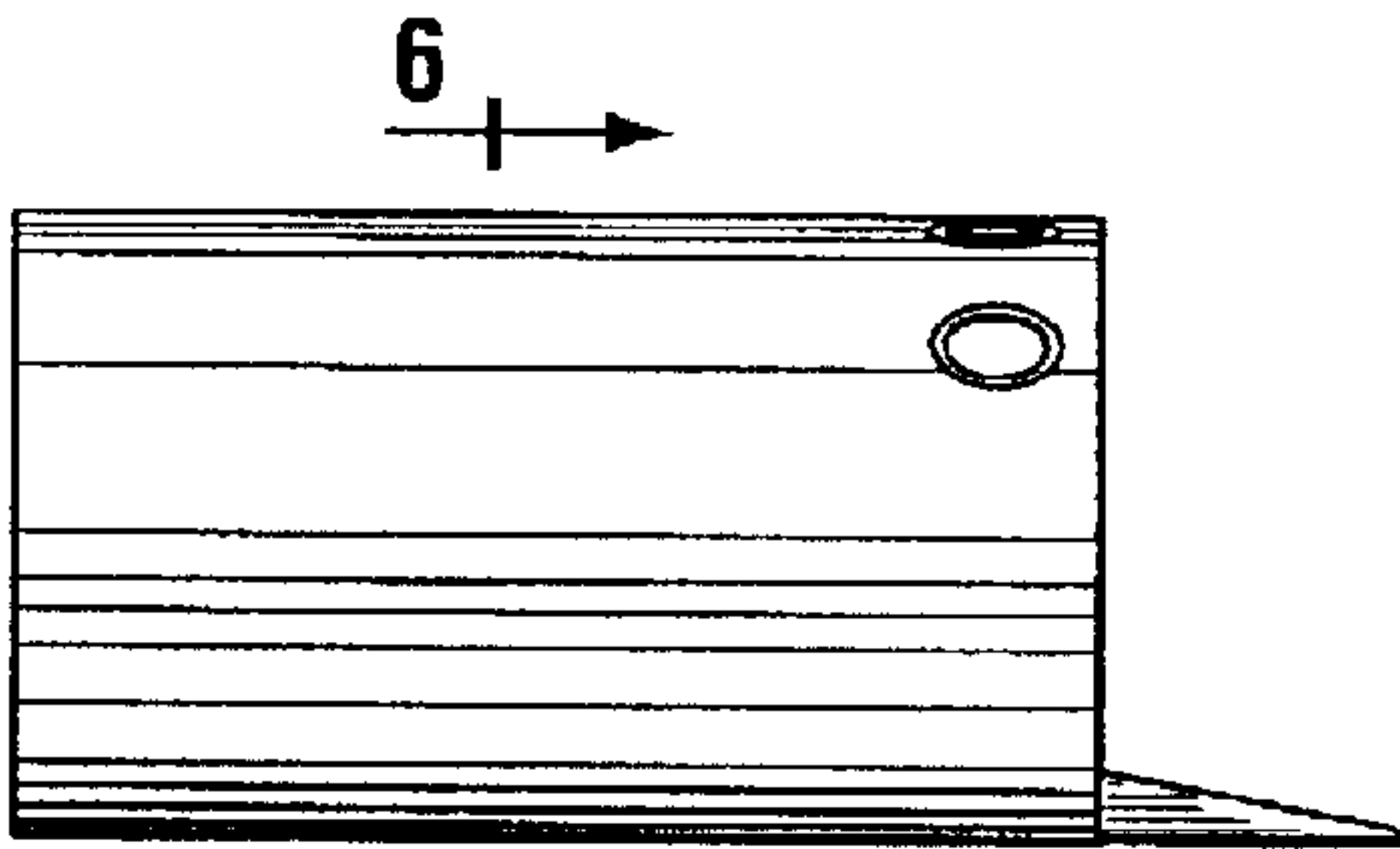

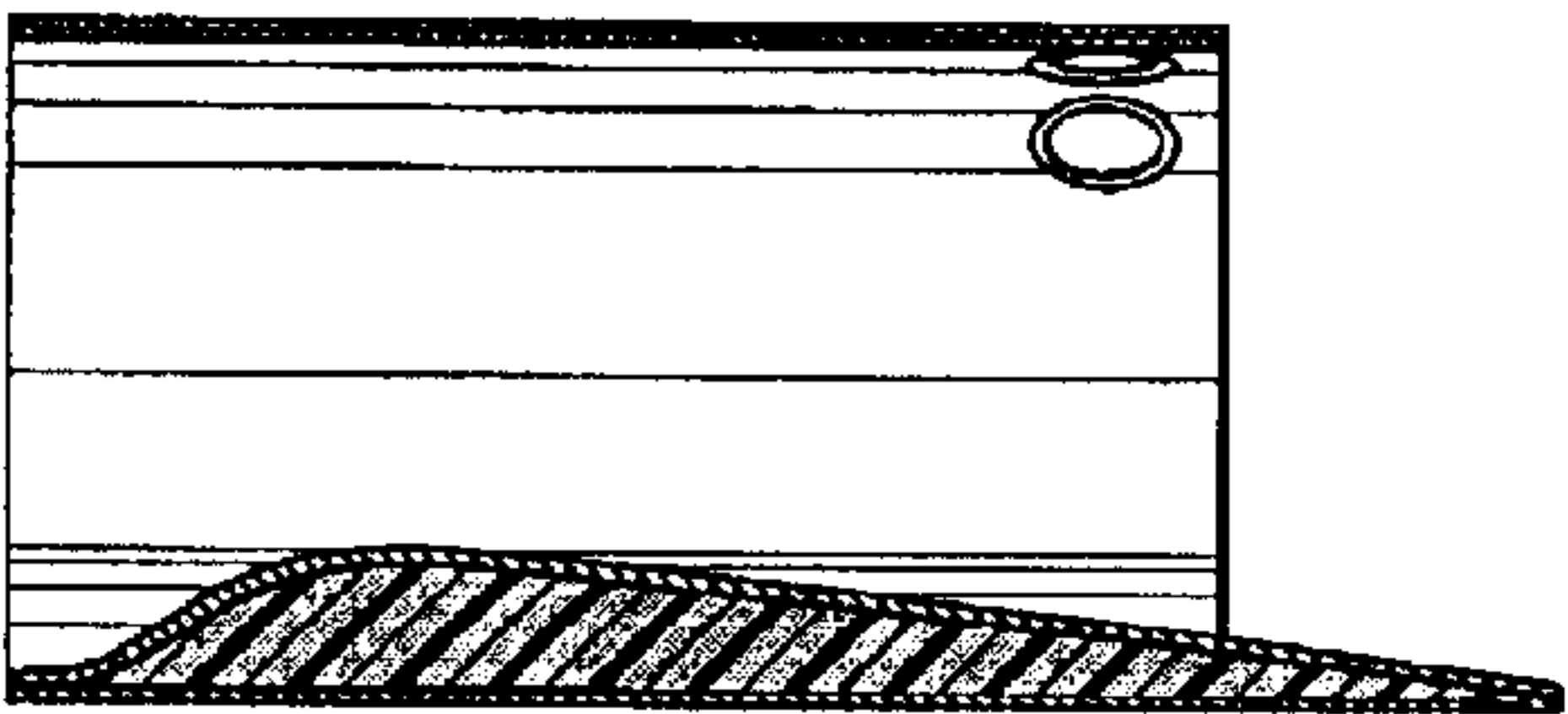

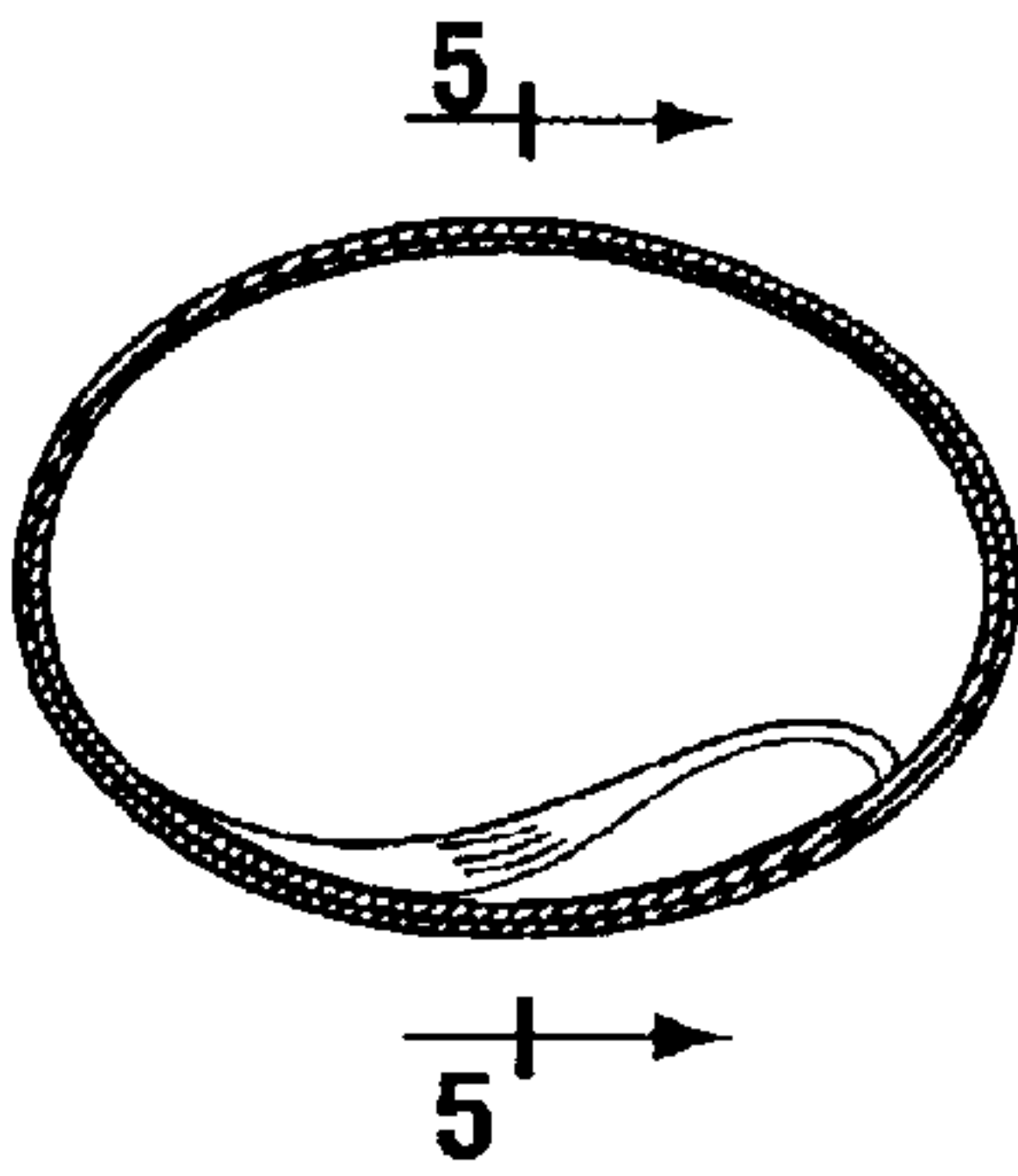
