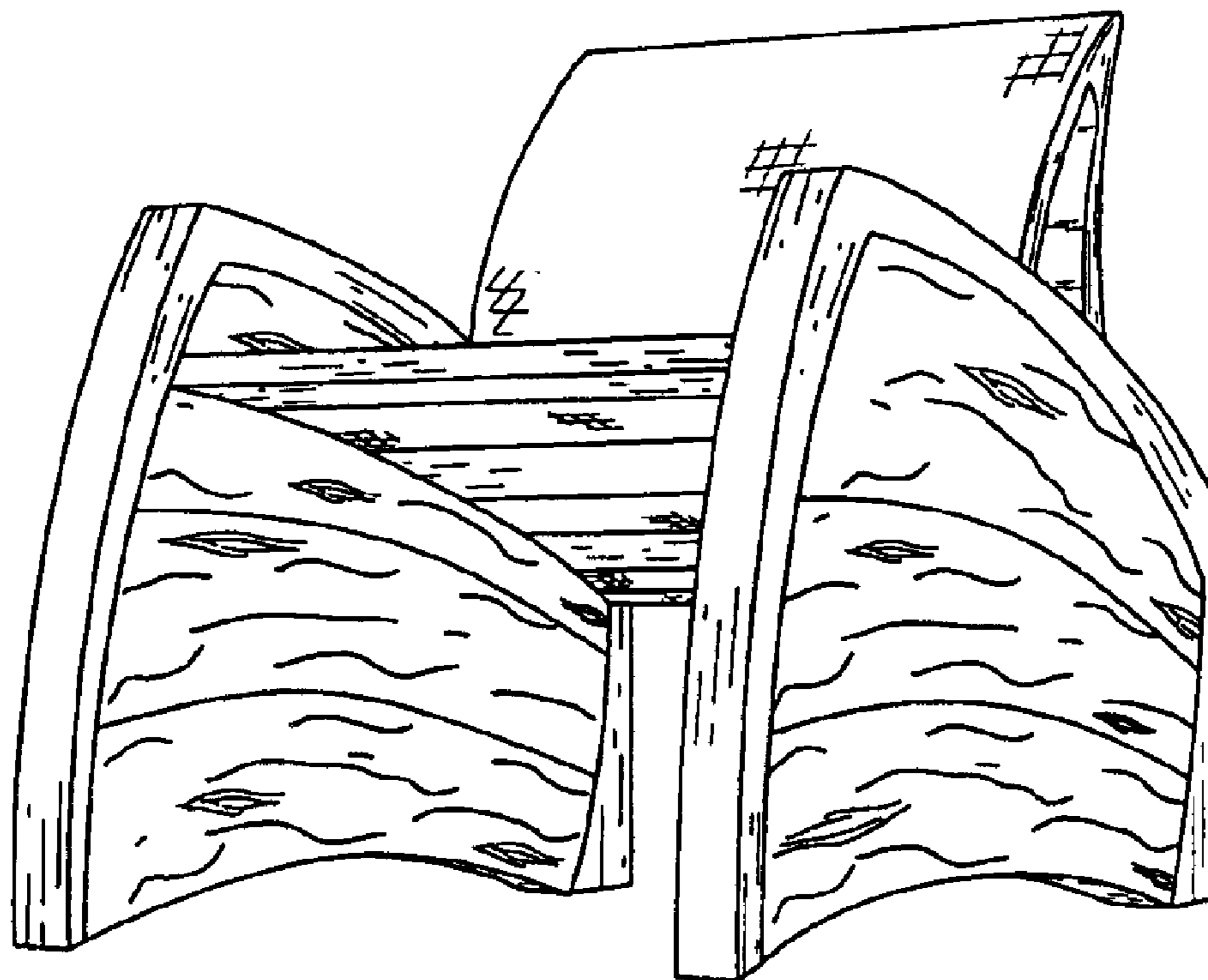
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of the chair;
 FIG. 2 is a left front perspective view of the chair shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a top view of the chair shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the chair in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of the chair in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is rear elevation view of the chair in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view of the chair in FIG. 1;
 and,
 FIG. 8 is a left side elevation view of the chair in FIG. 1.
 The fragmented cross-hatching shown on the seat and backrest is understood to represent fabric and would be continuous throughout the circumscribed areas.

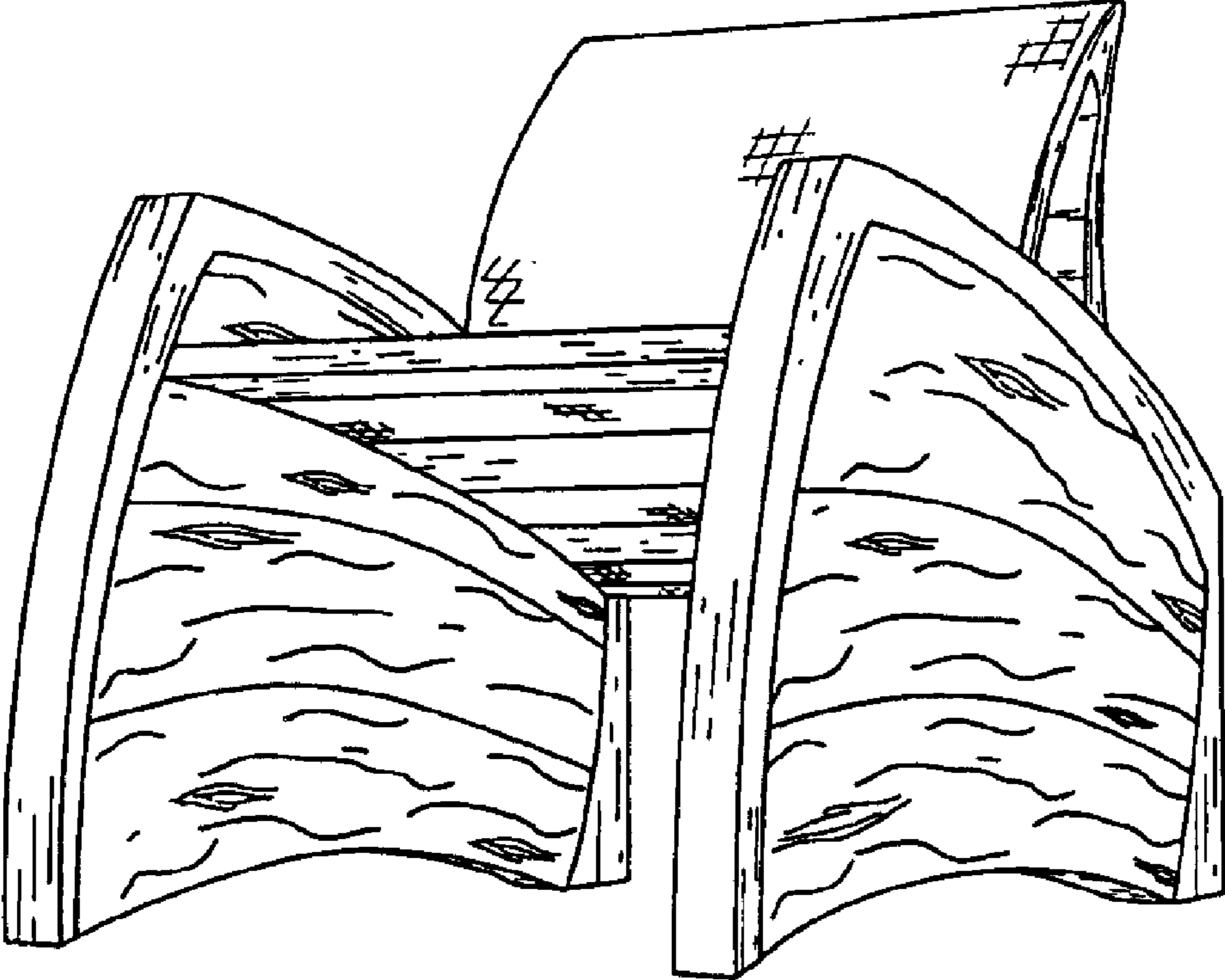

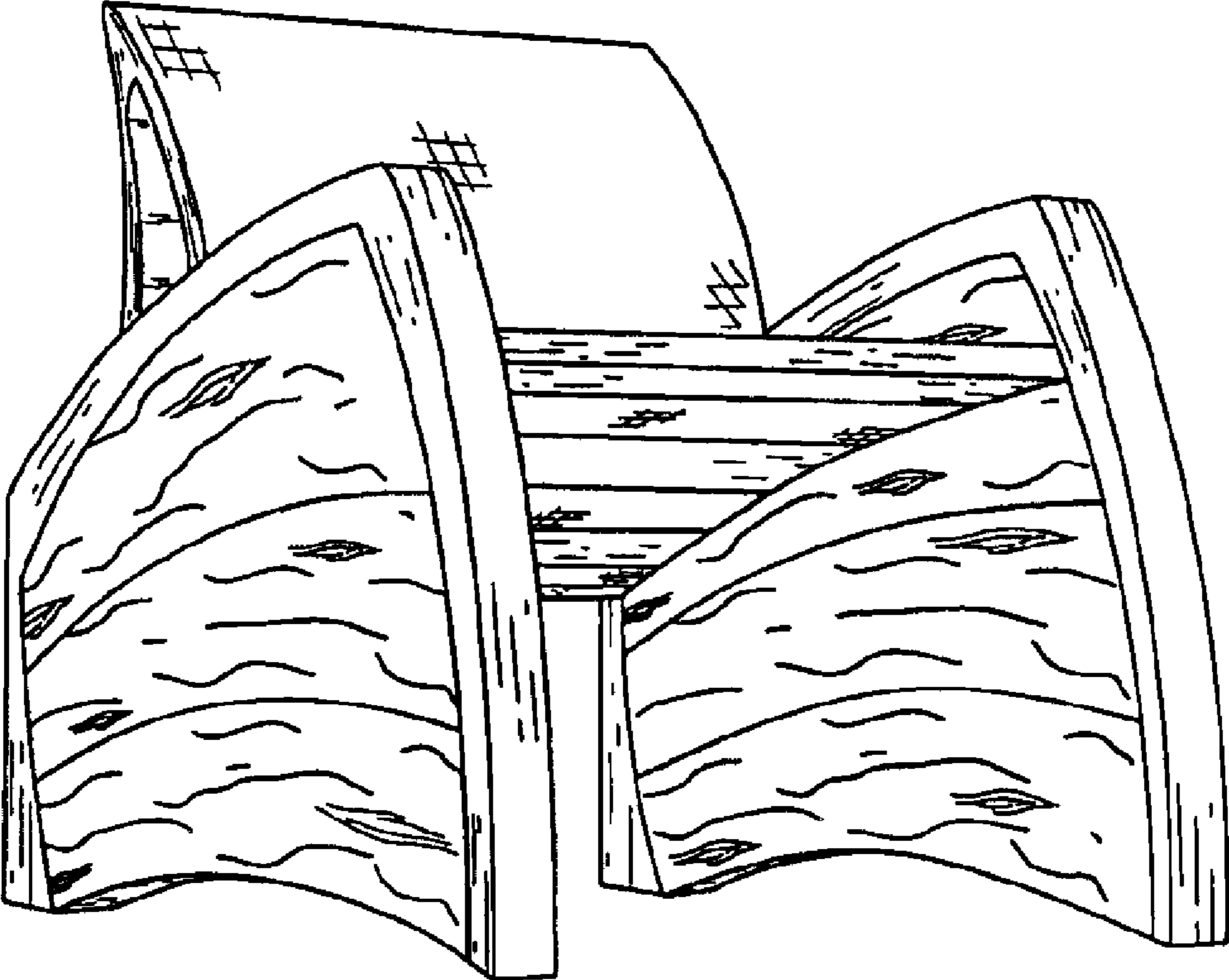

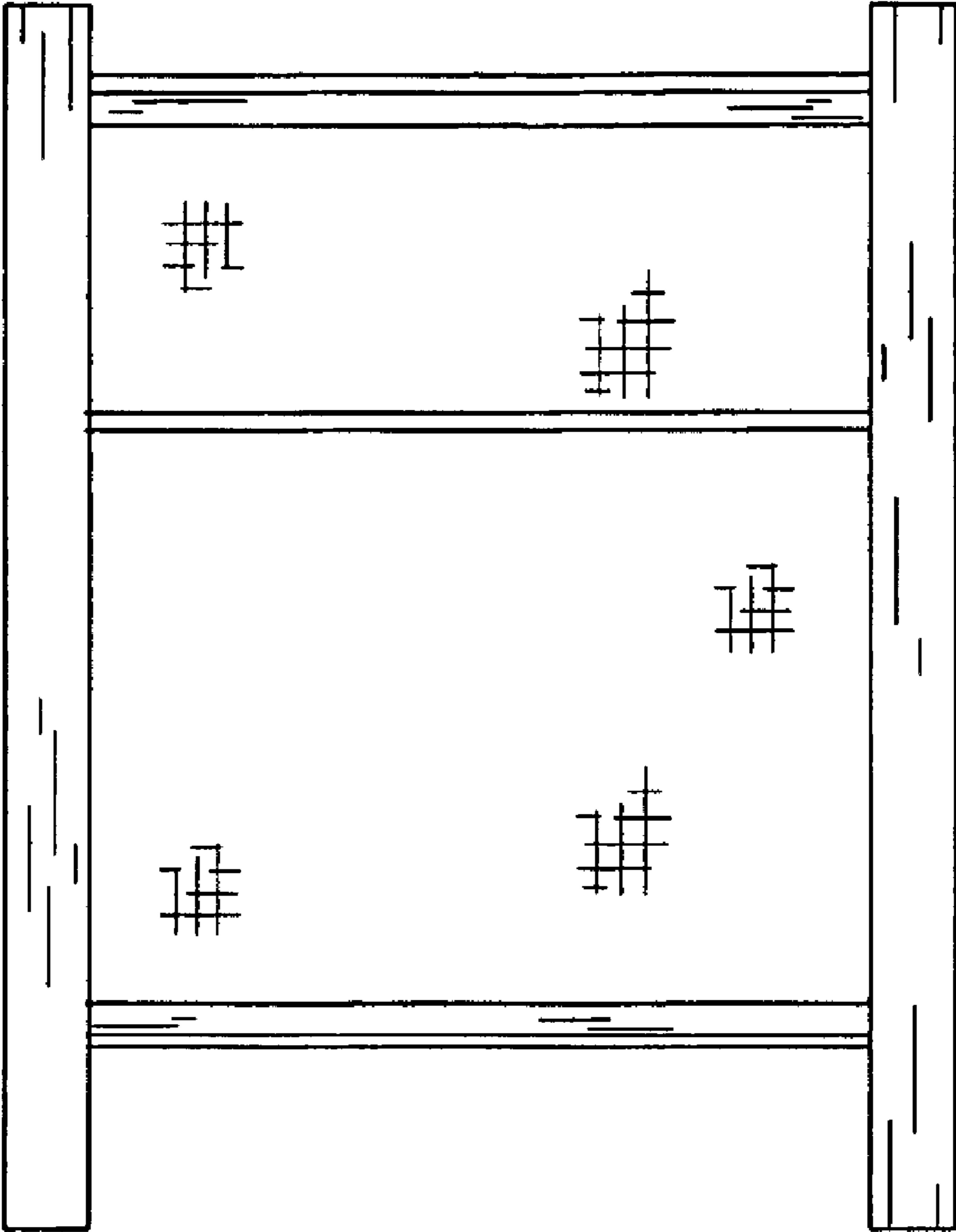

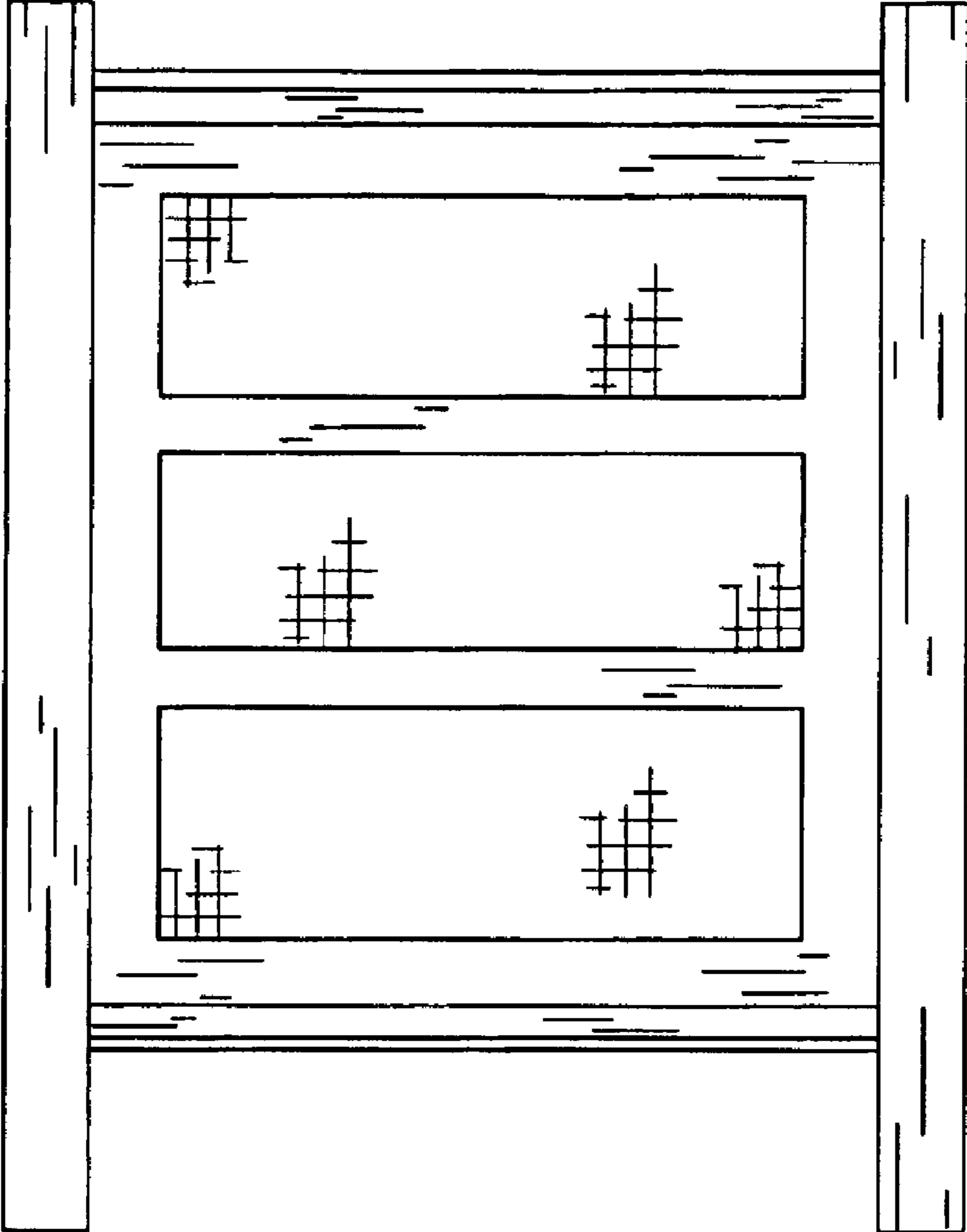

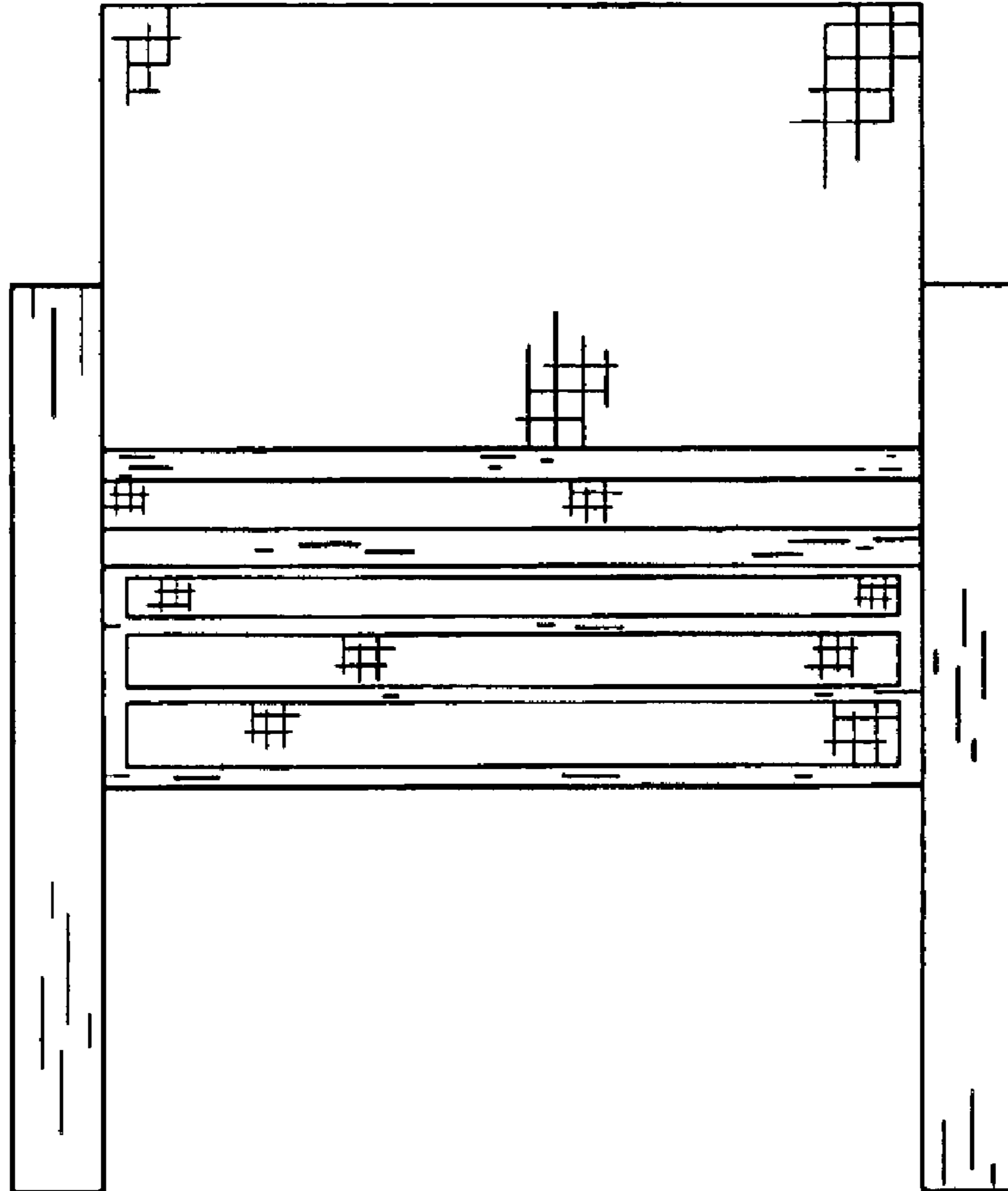

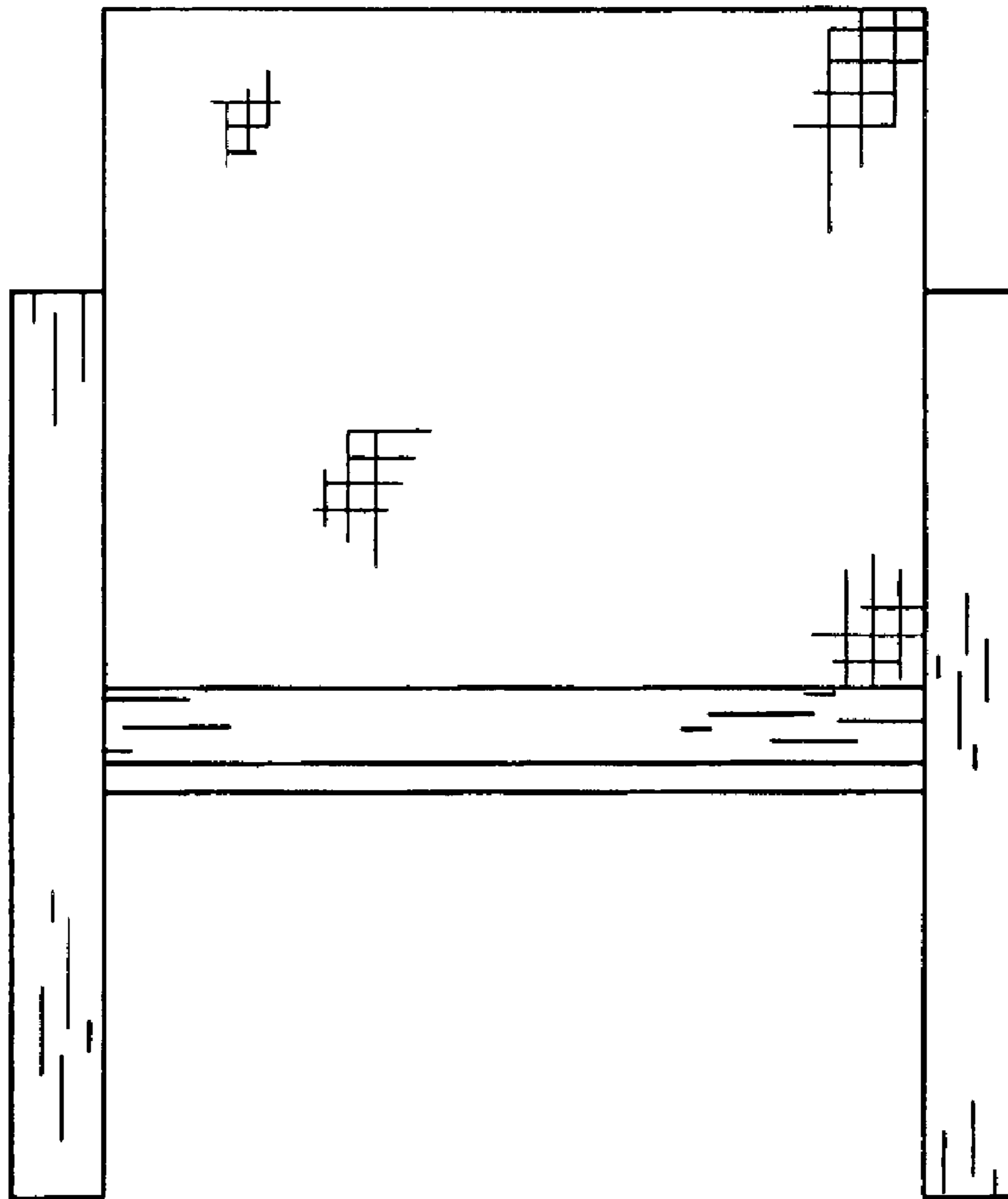

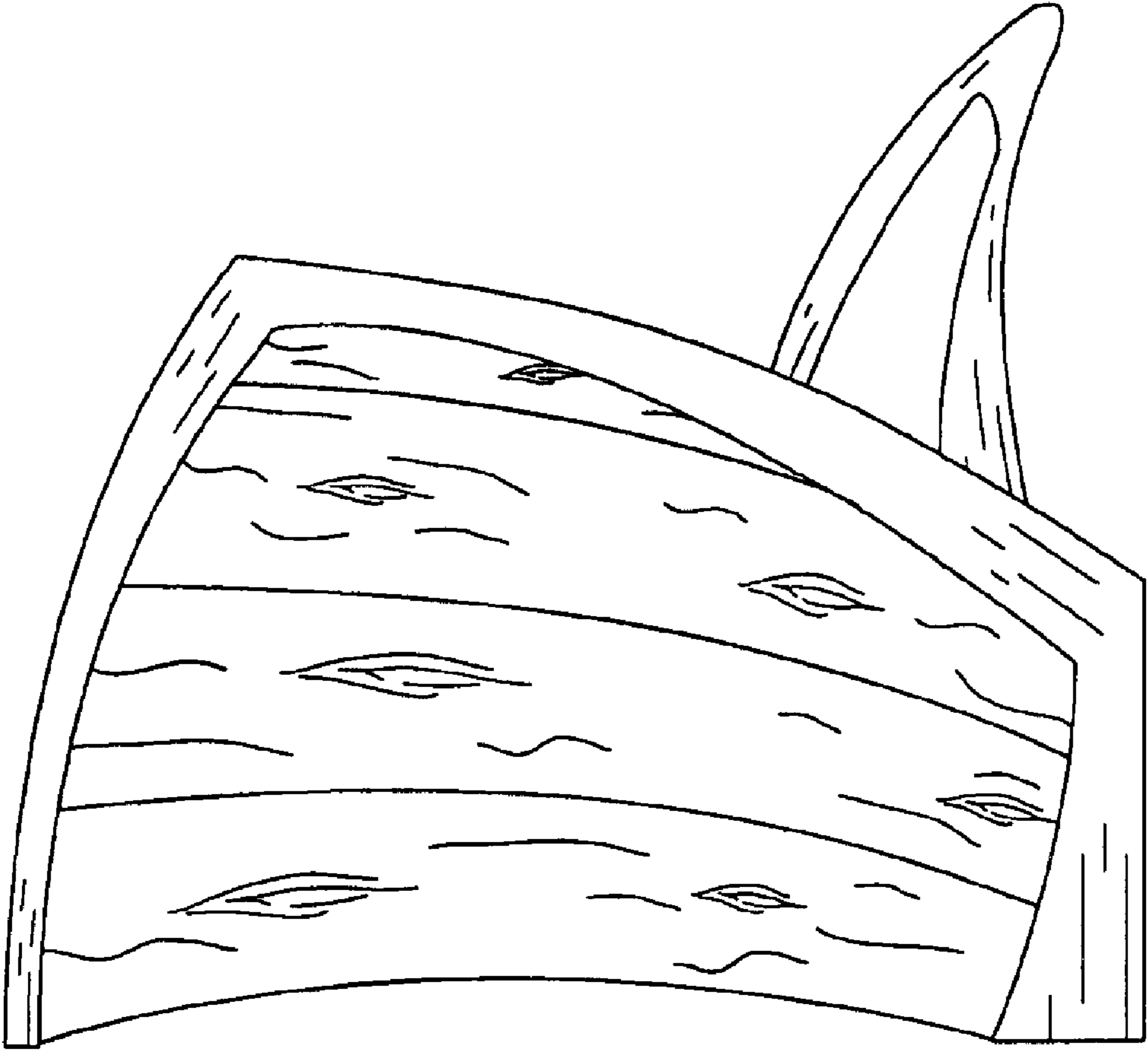

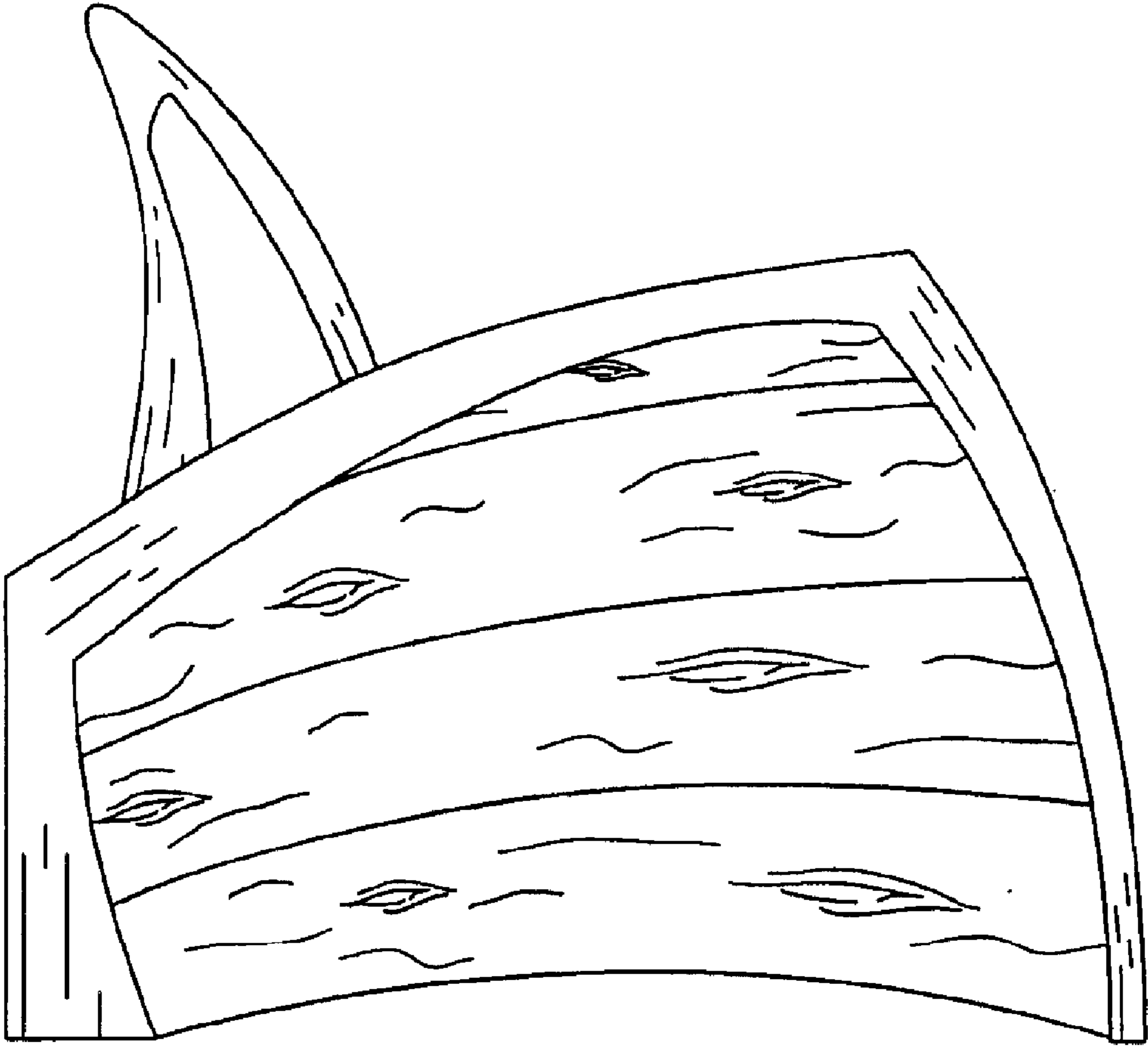
