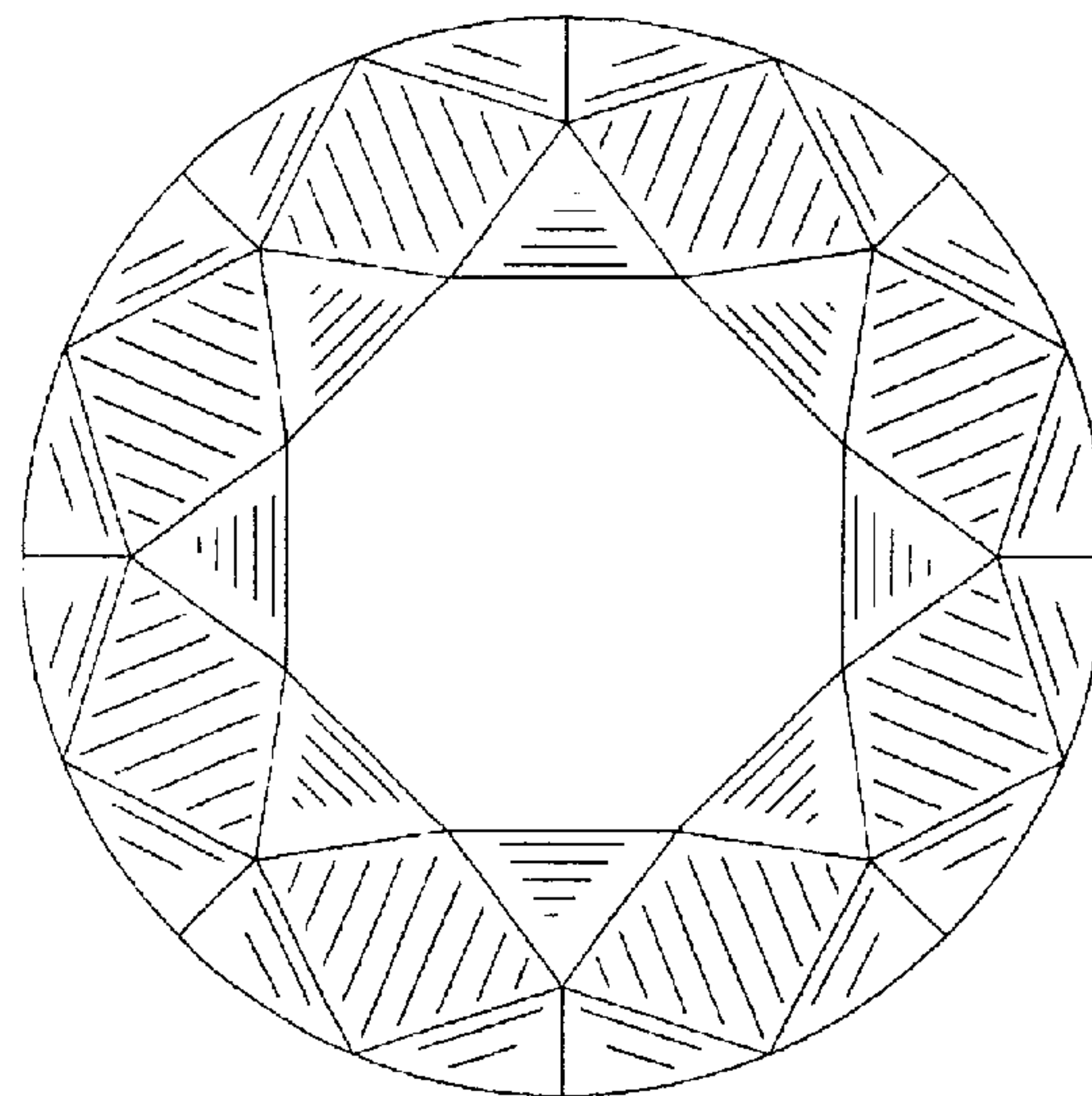
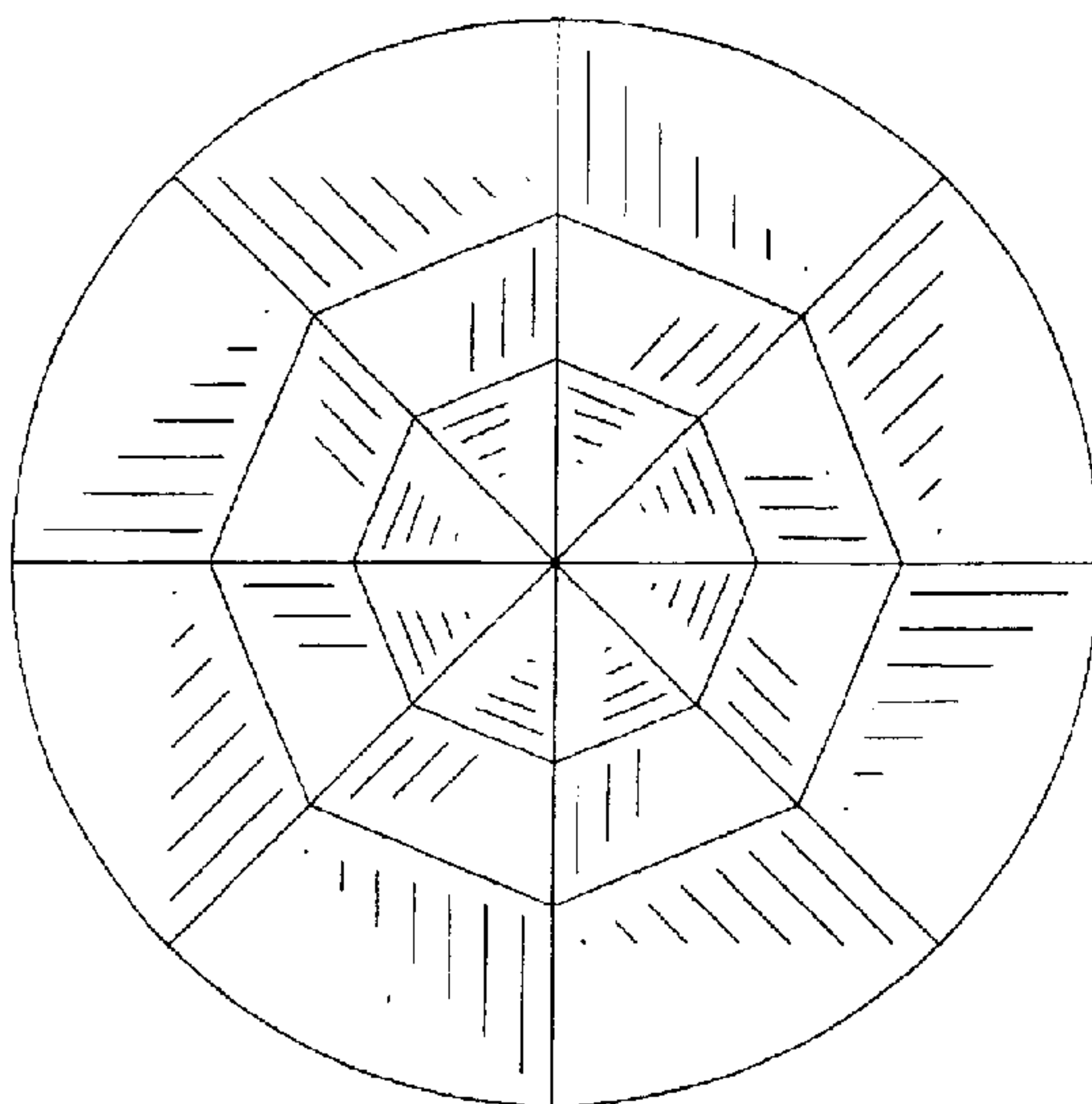
FIG. 1 is a top view of gemstone.

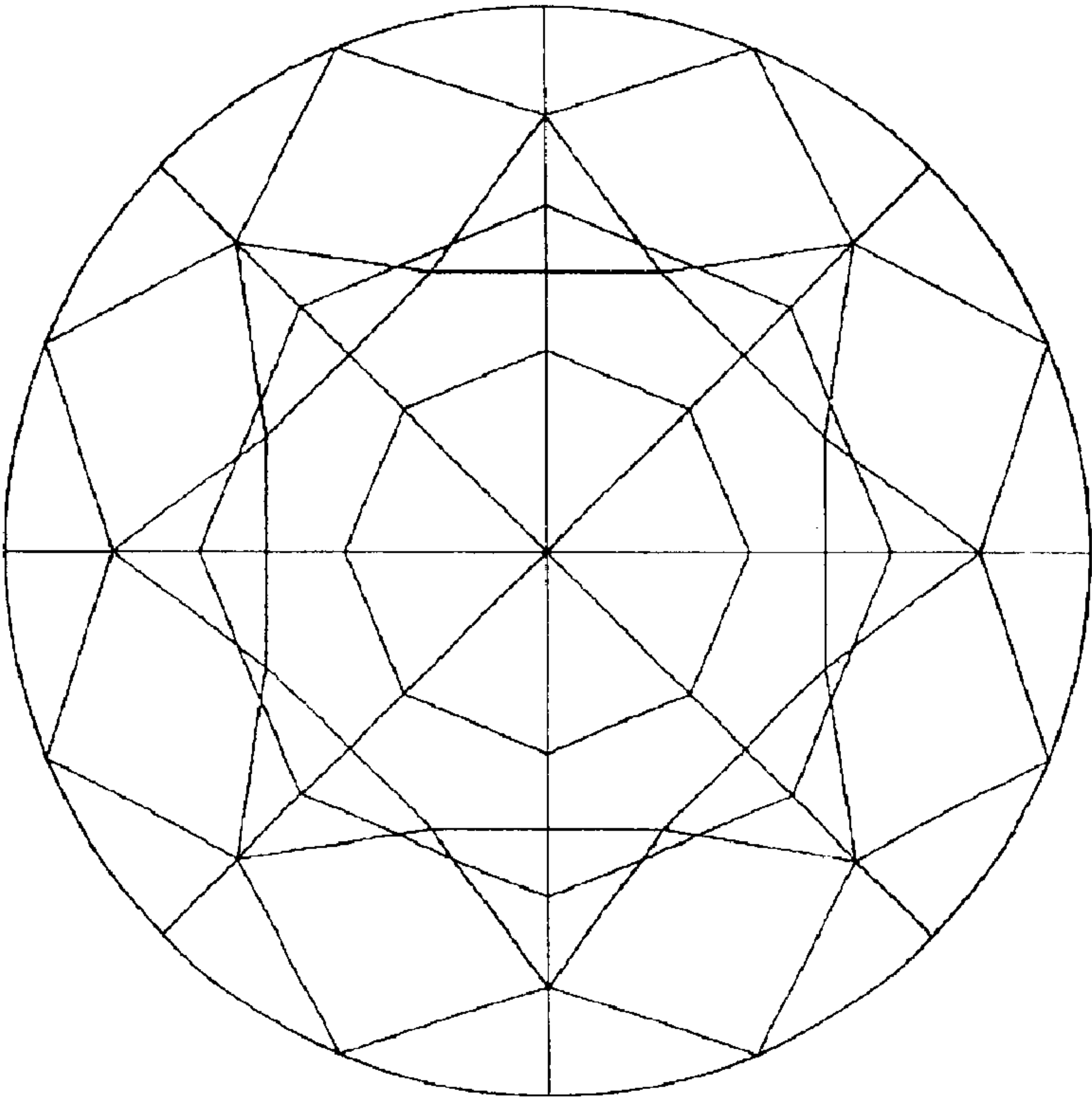

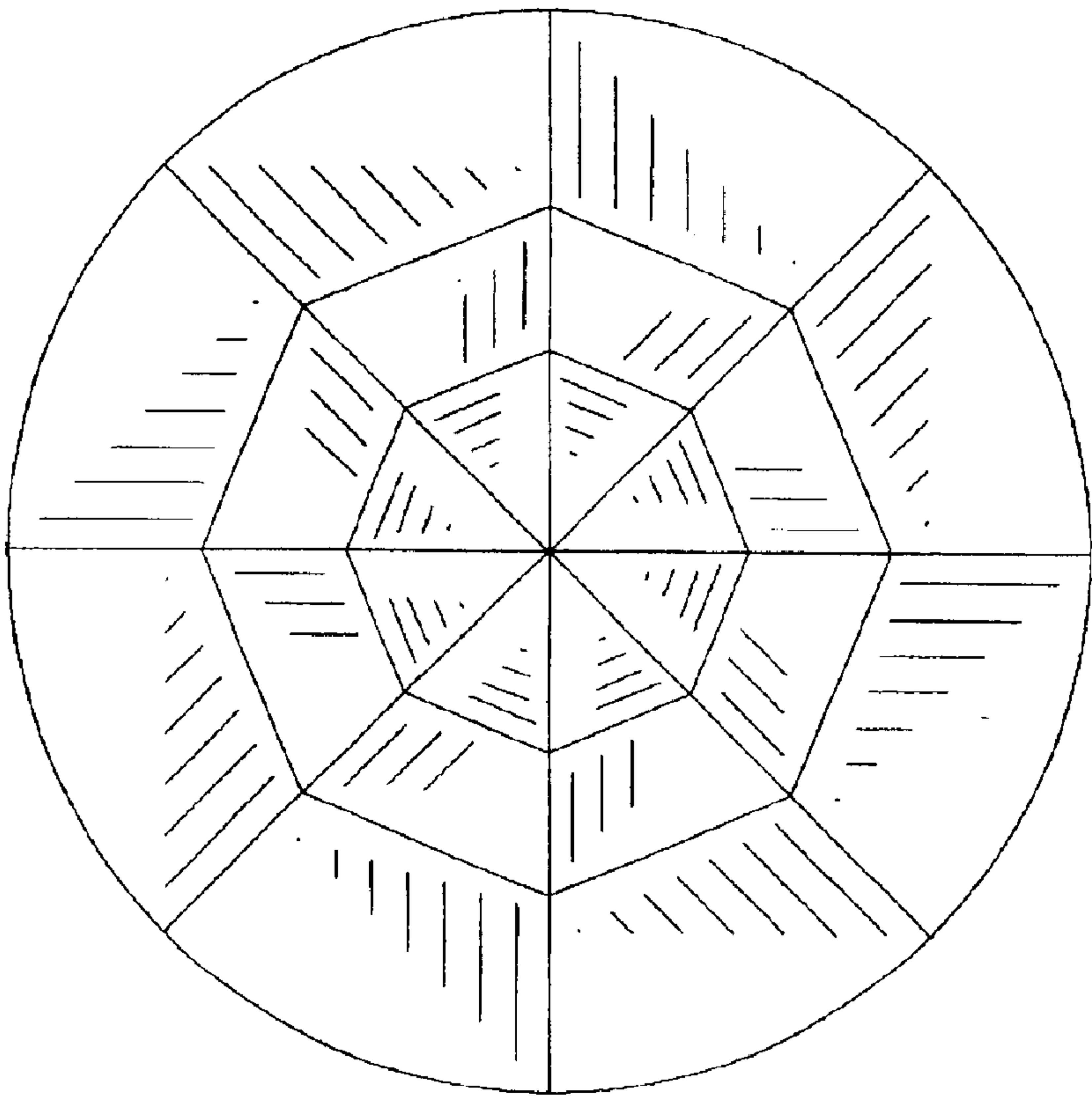

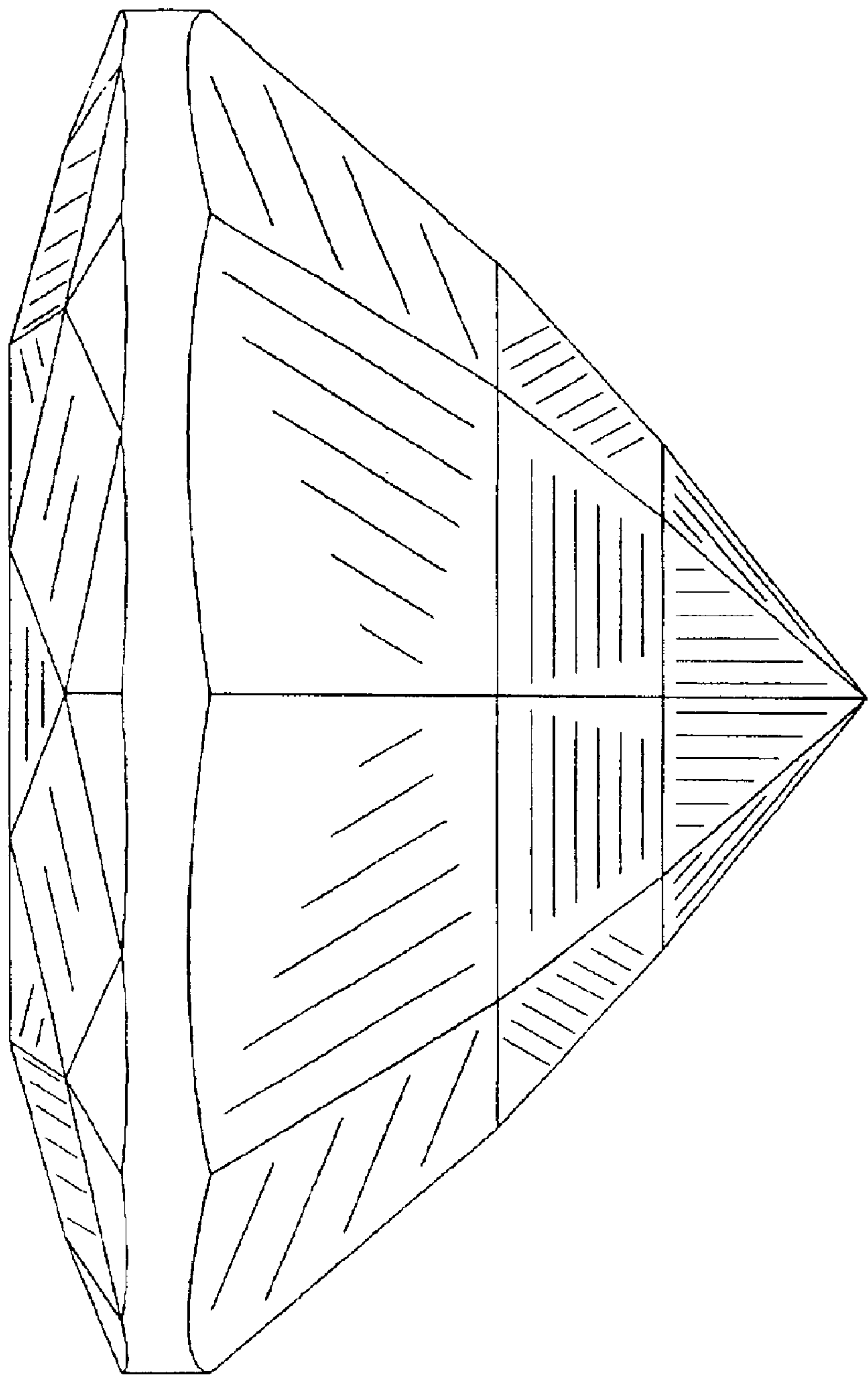

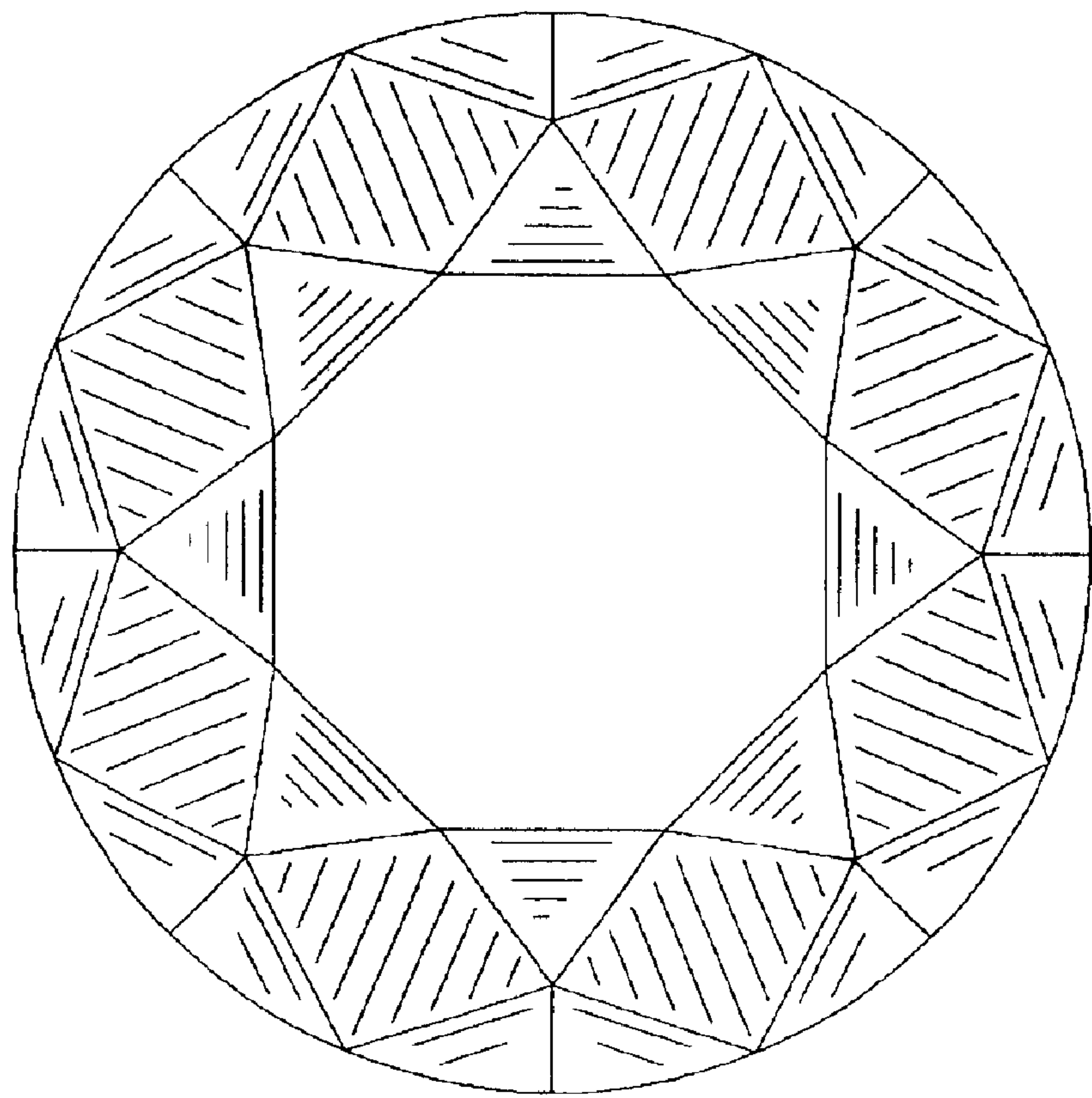
