FIG. 3 is a left side view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention.


FIG. 4 is a top view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention.


FIG. 5 is a front view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention; and,


FIG. 6 is a rear view of the motorcycle trike body according to the present invention.




