design;

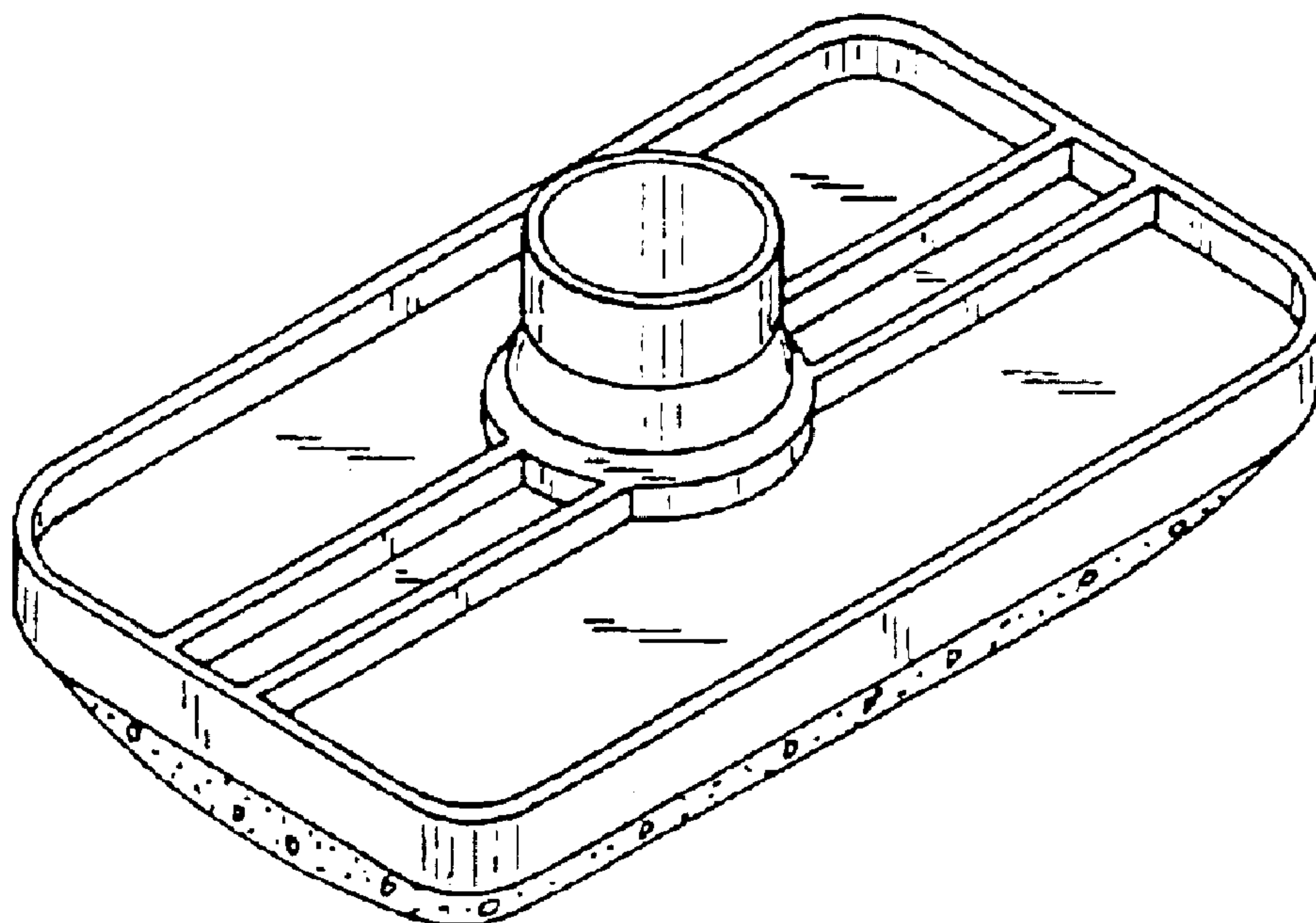
FIG. 2 illustrates a bottom view thereof;

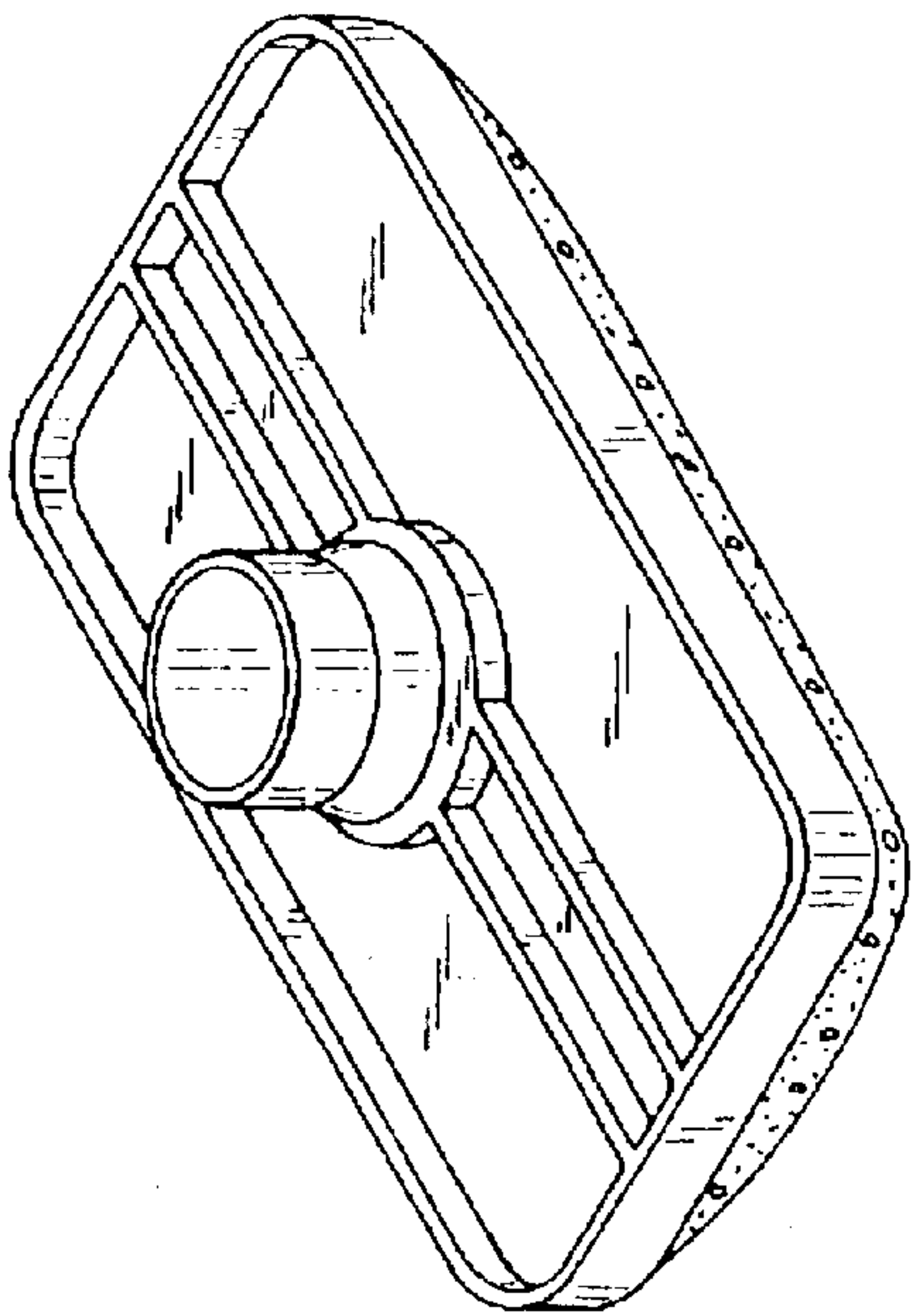

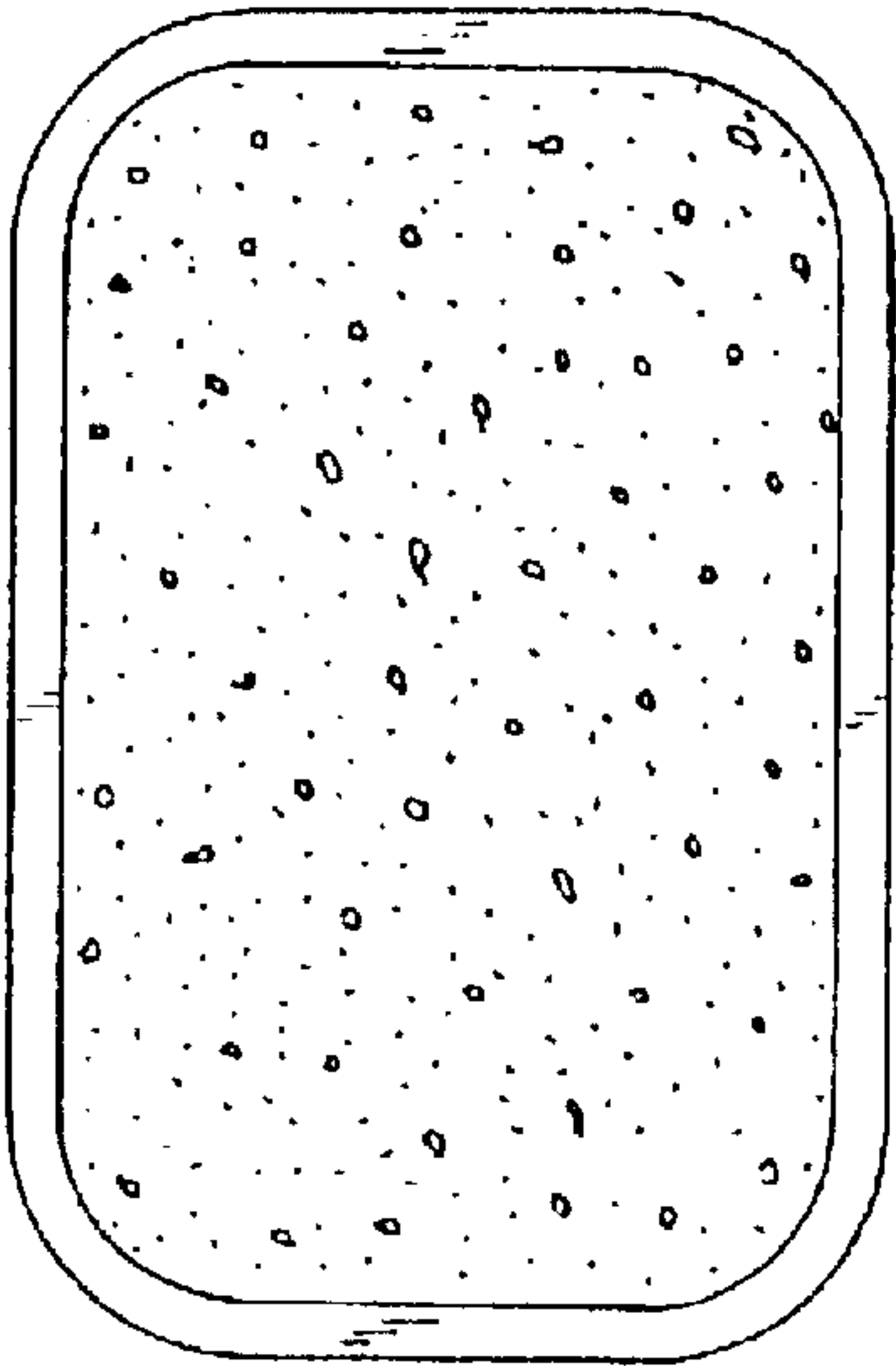

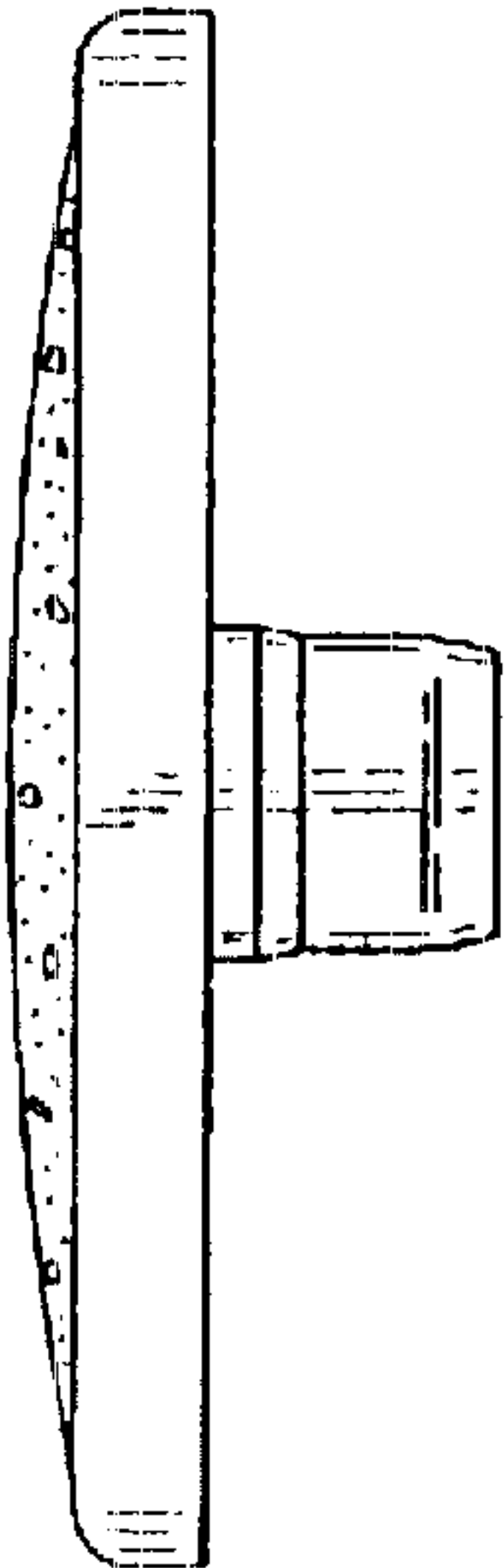

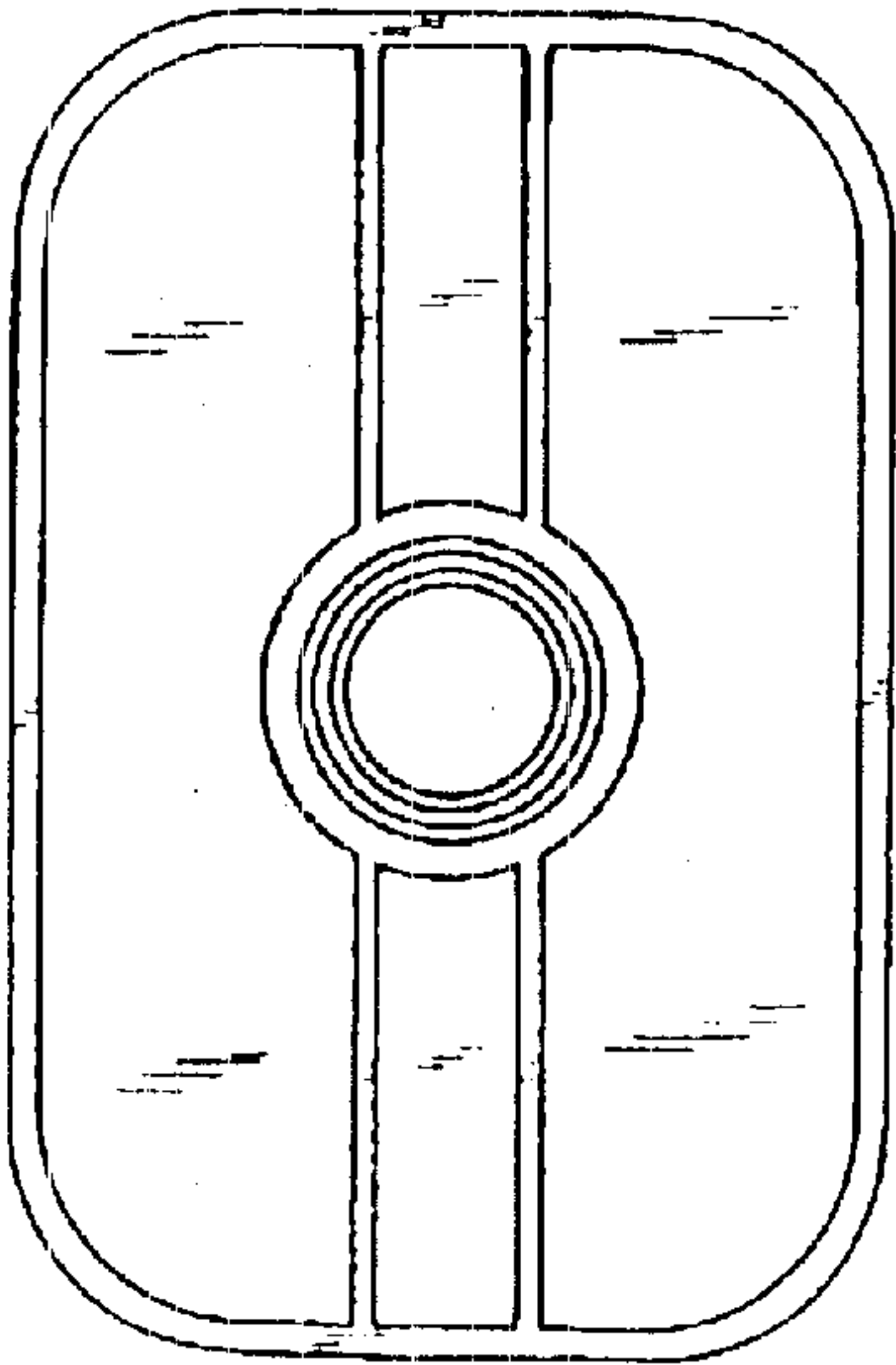

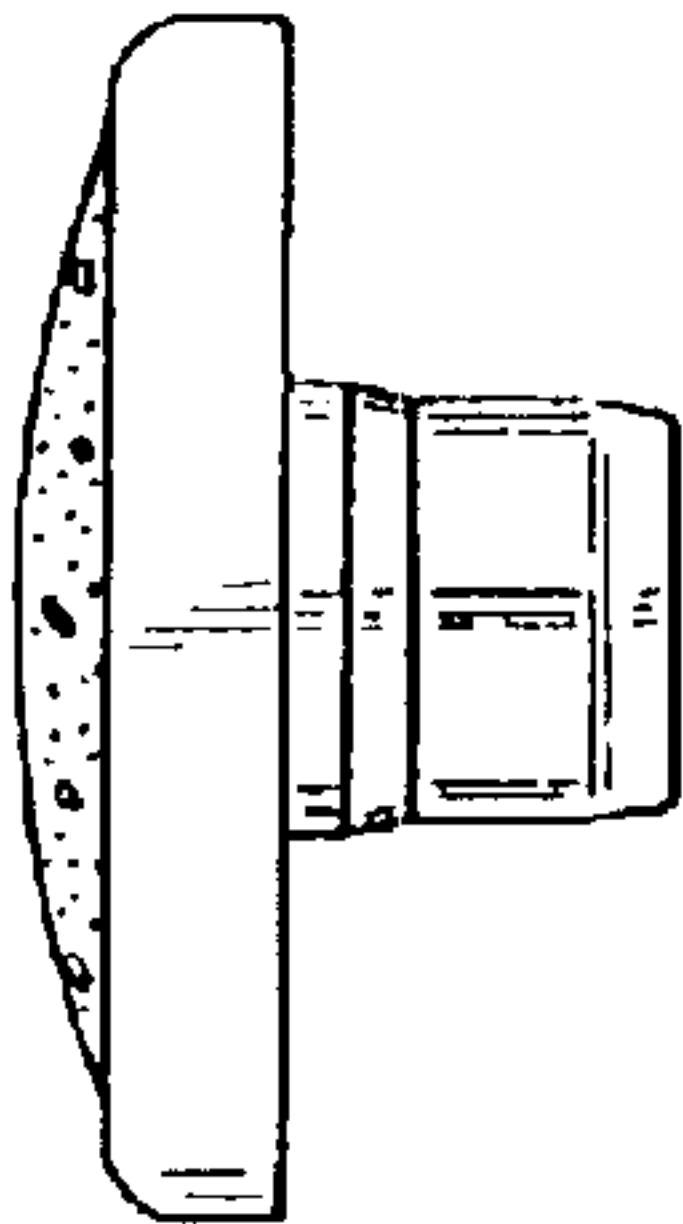
