The ornamental design for a snack food, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a right elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention, with the left elevation view a mirror image of the right elevation view;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

FIG. 5 is a top elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

FIG. 6 is a bottom elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

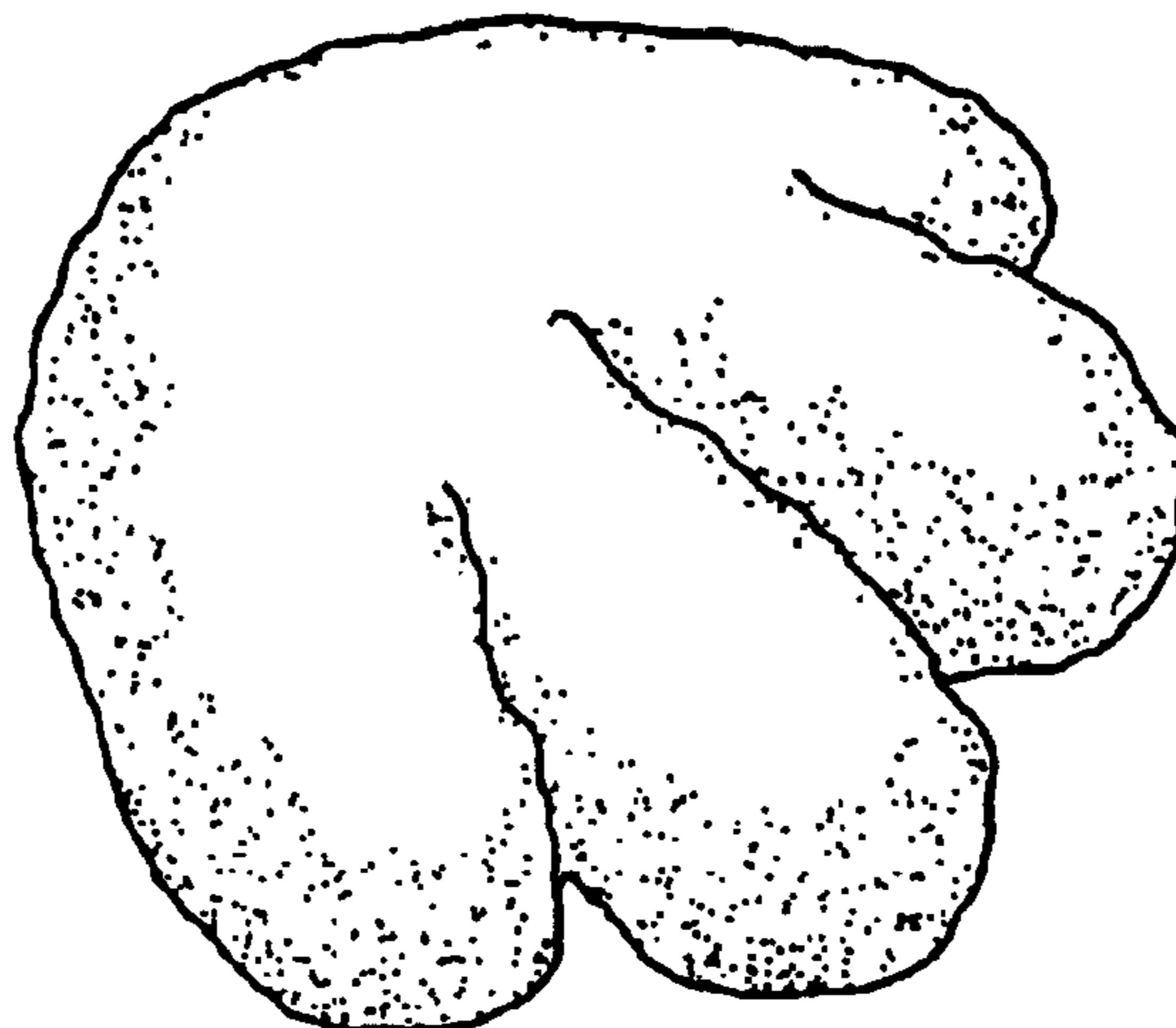
FIG. 9 is a right elevation view of the alternative embodiment of the snack food of the present invention, with the left elevation view a mirror image of the right elevation view;

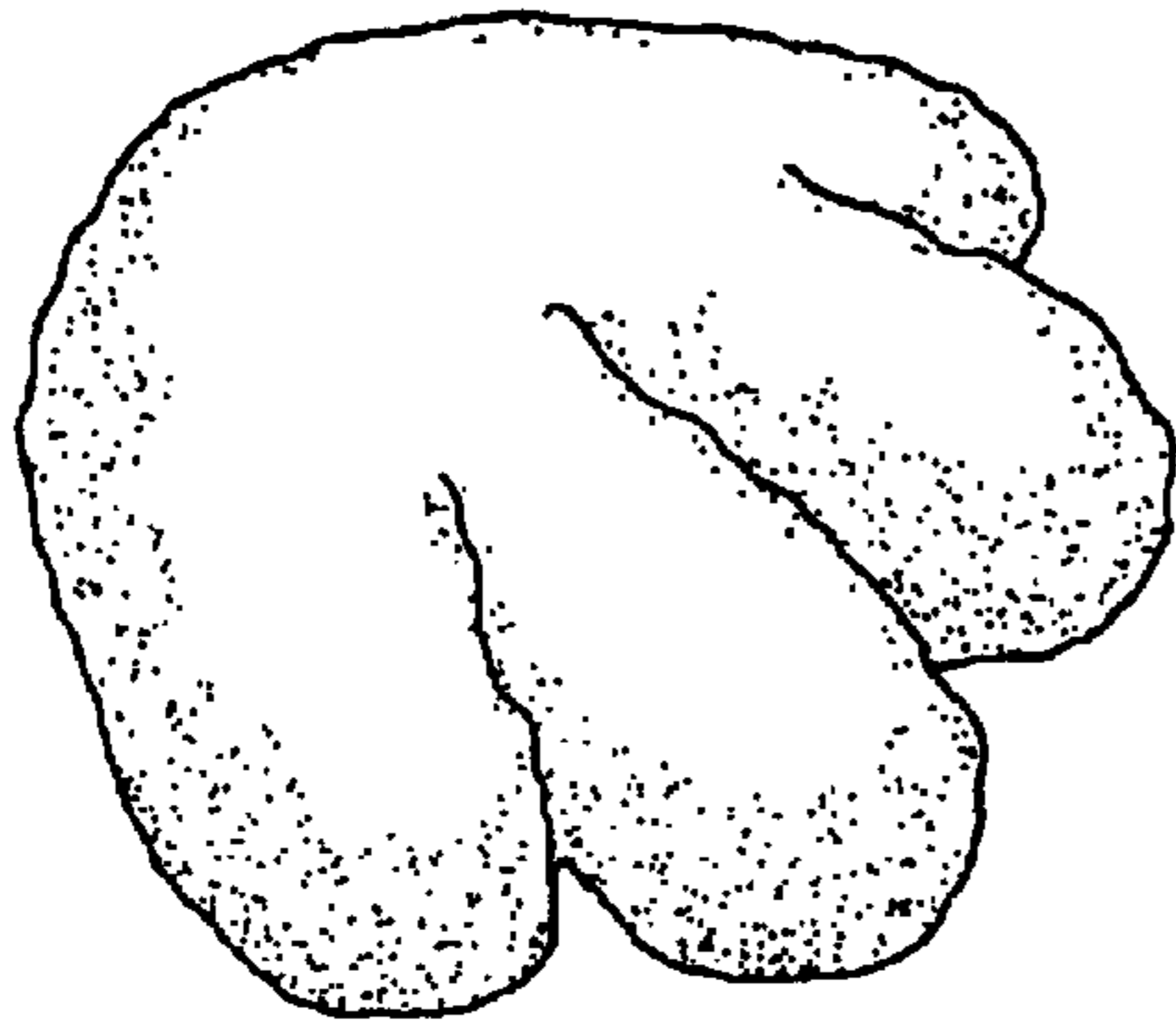

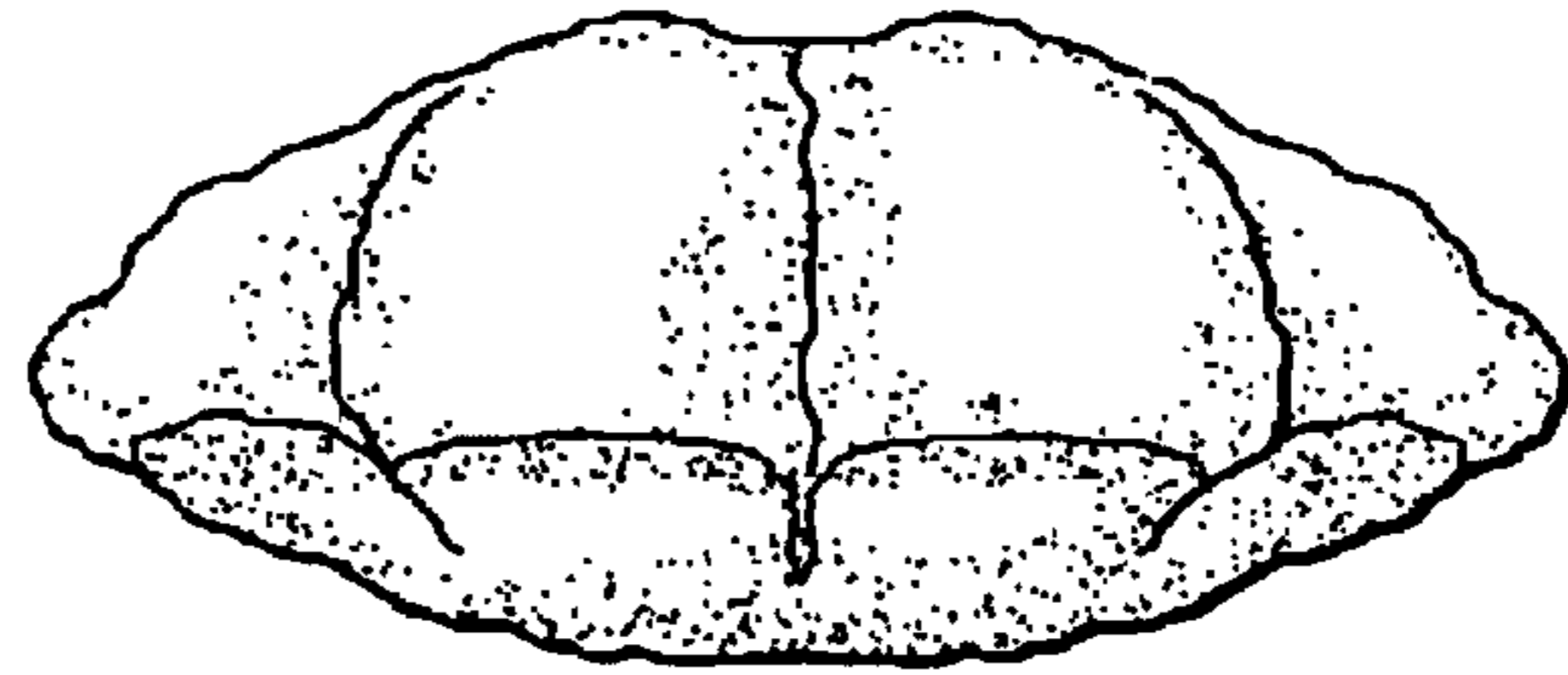

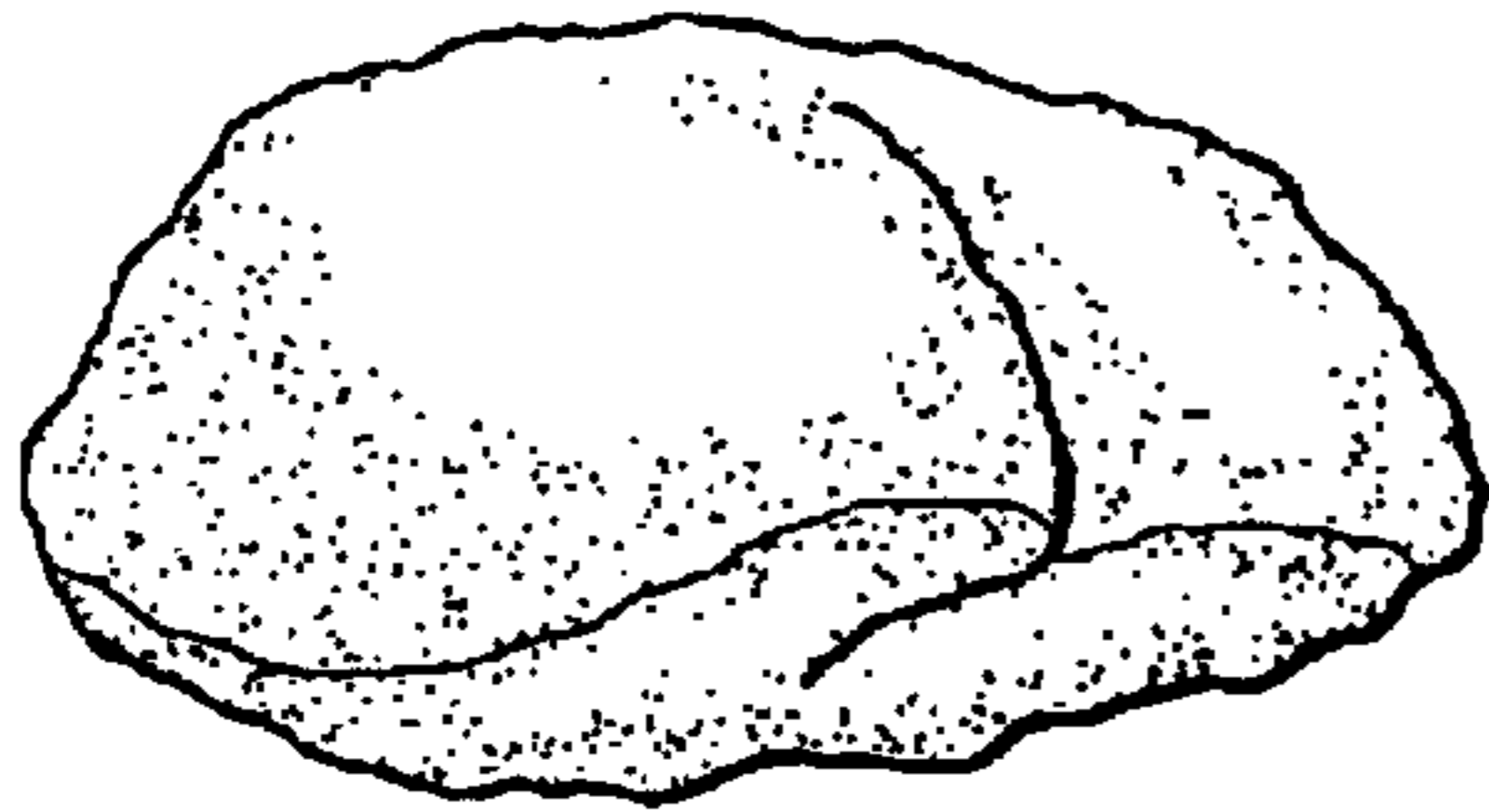

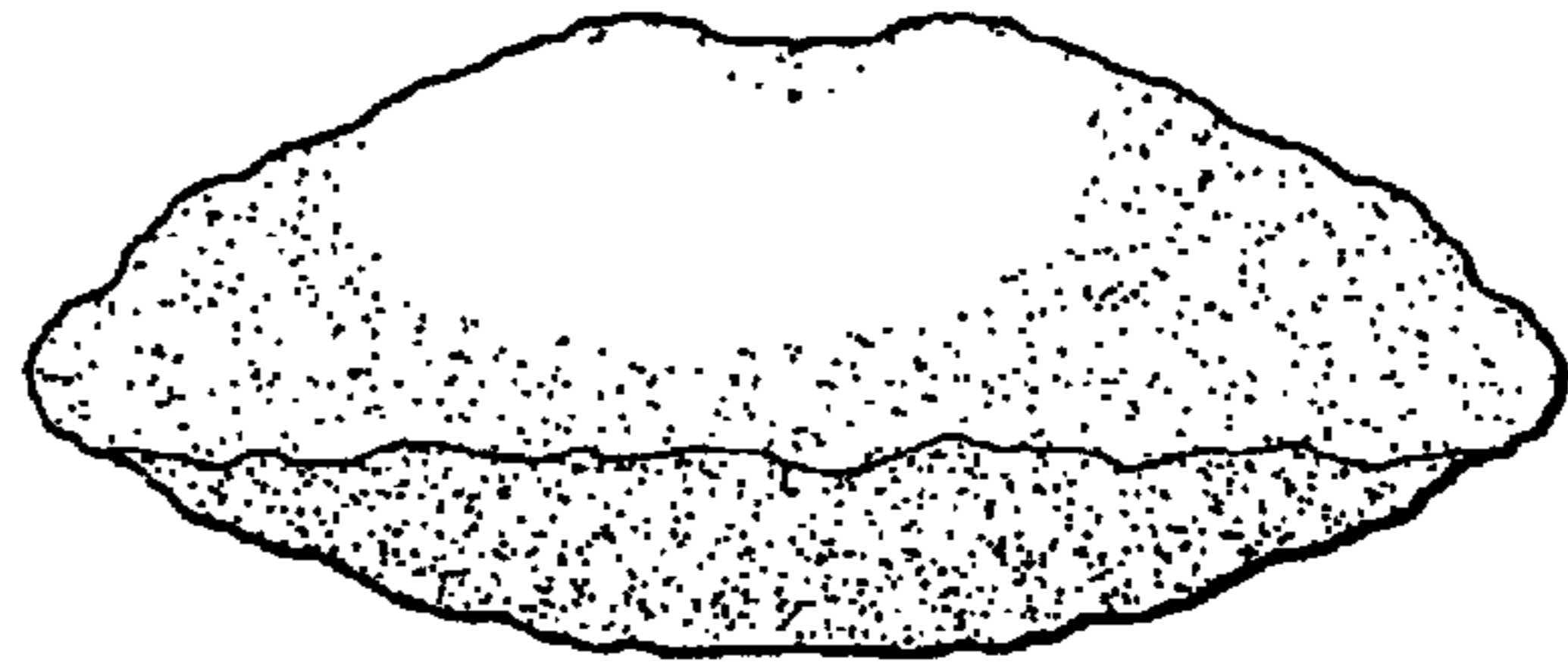

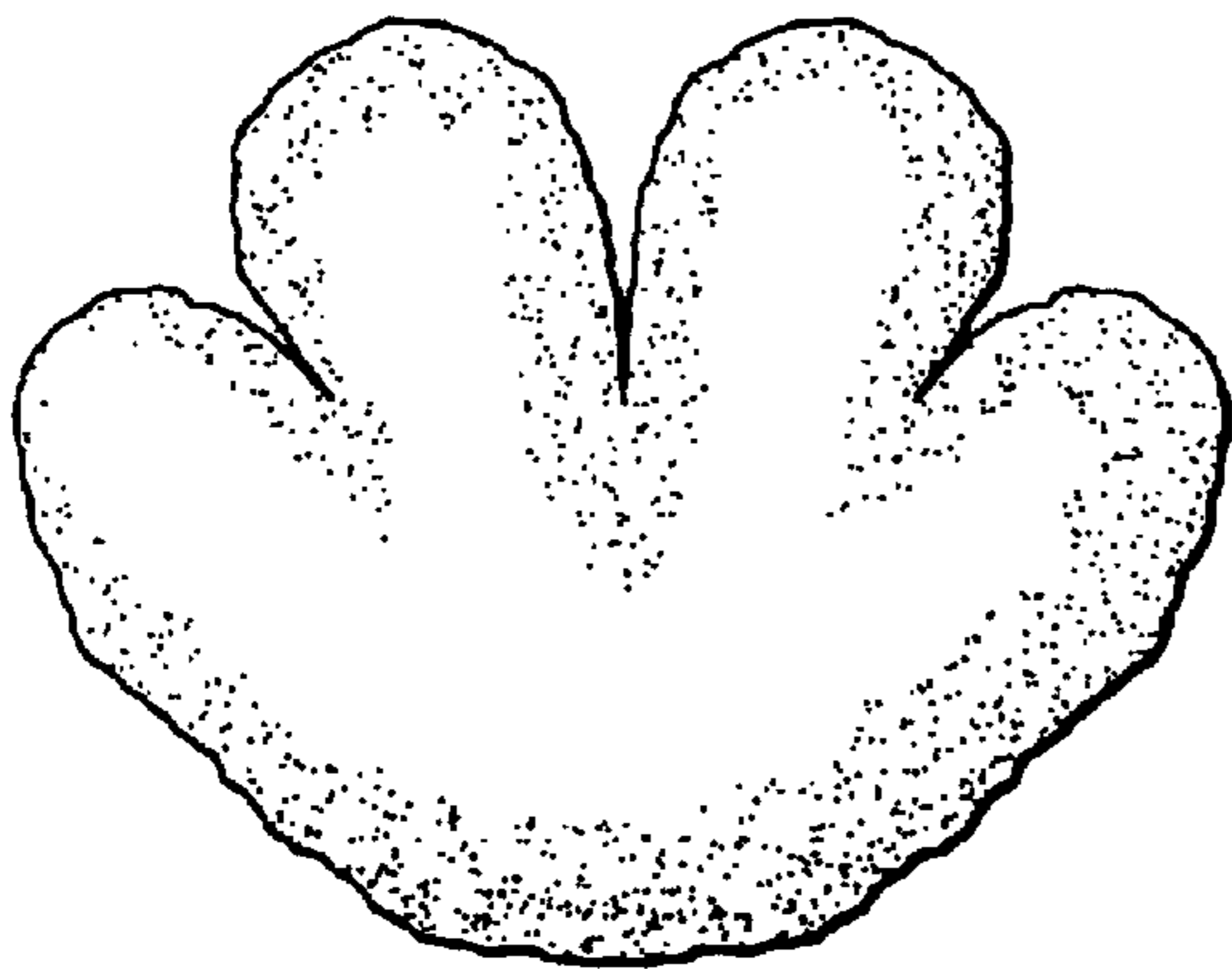

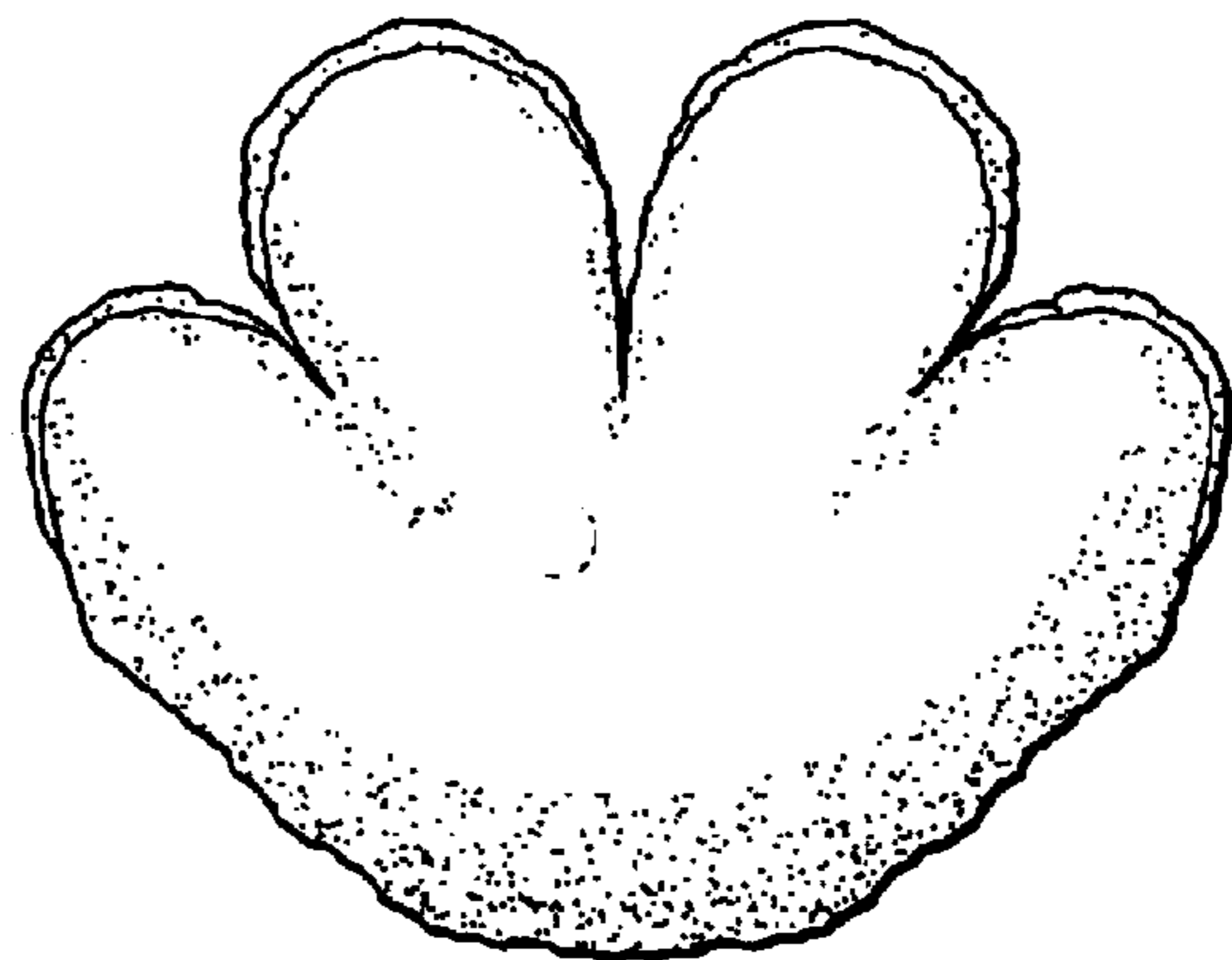

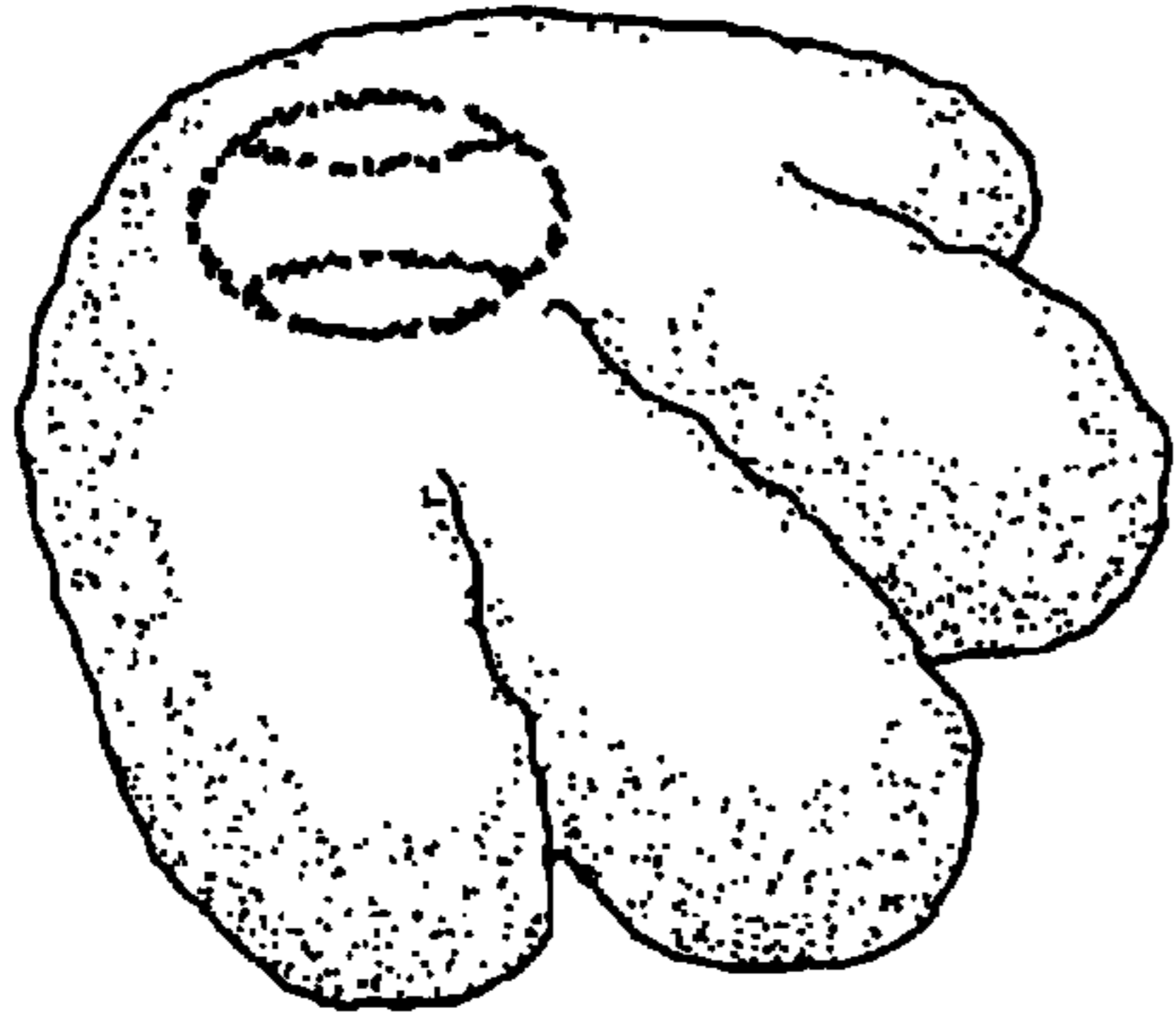

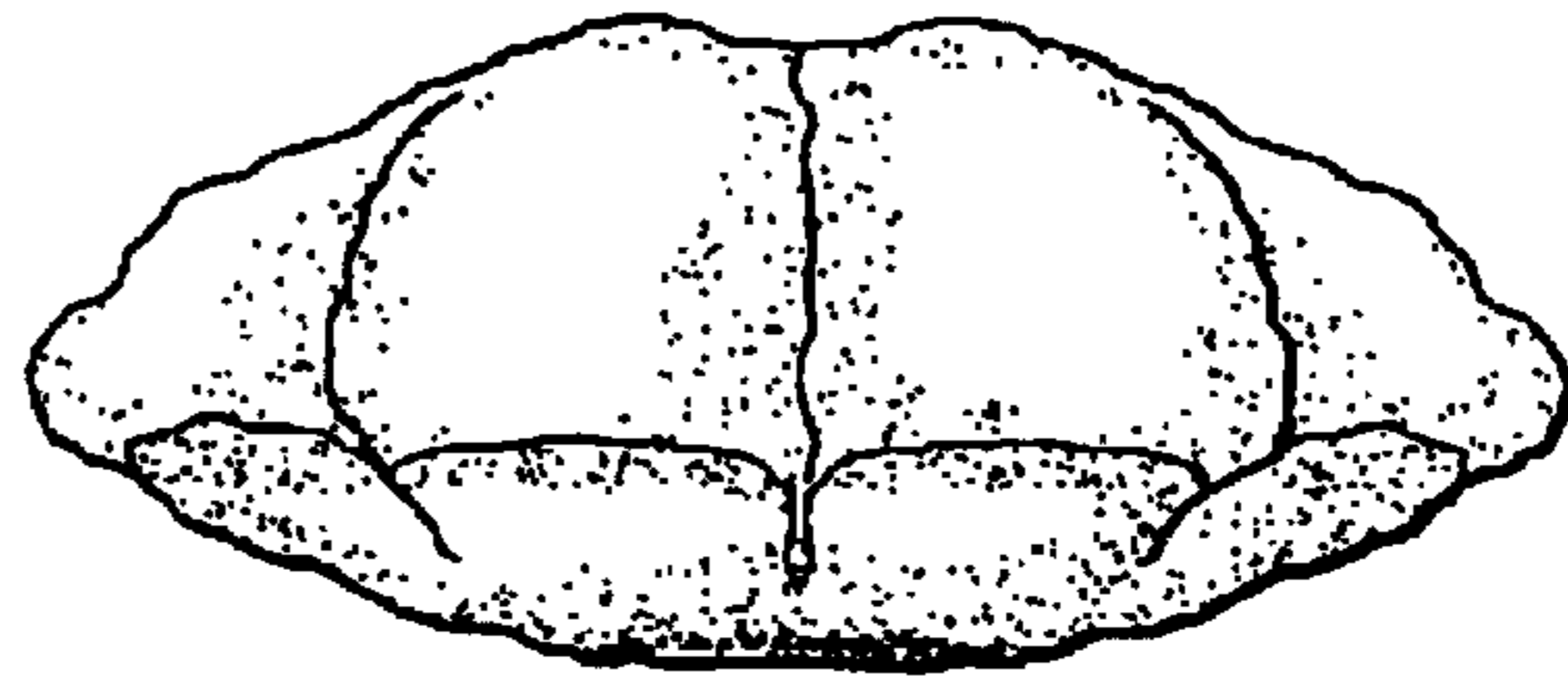

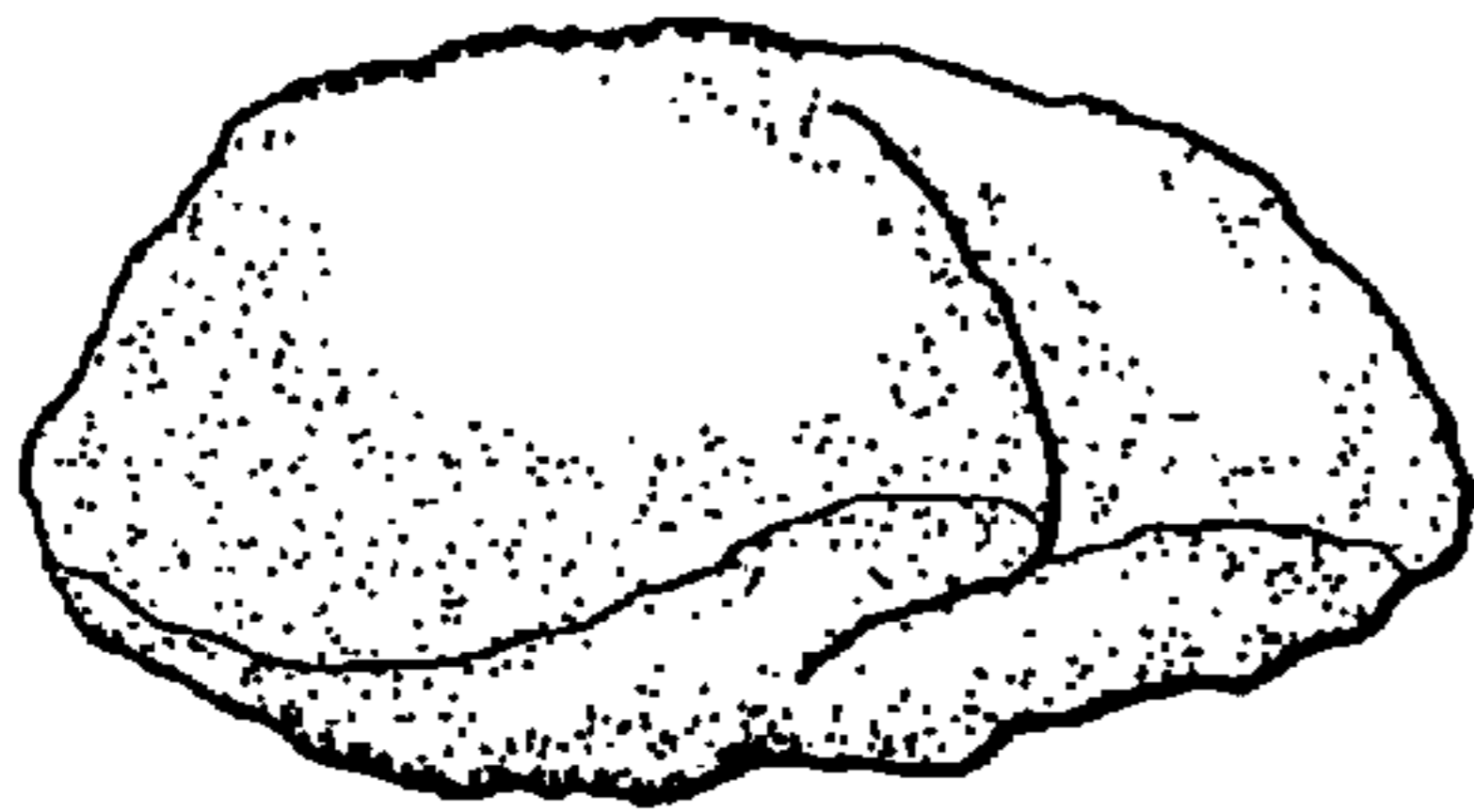

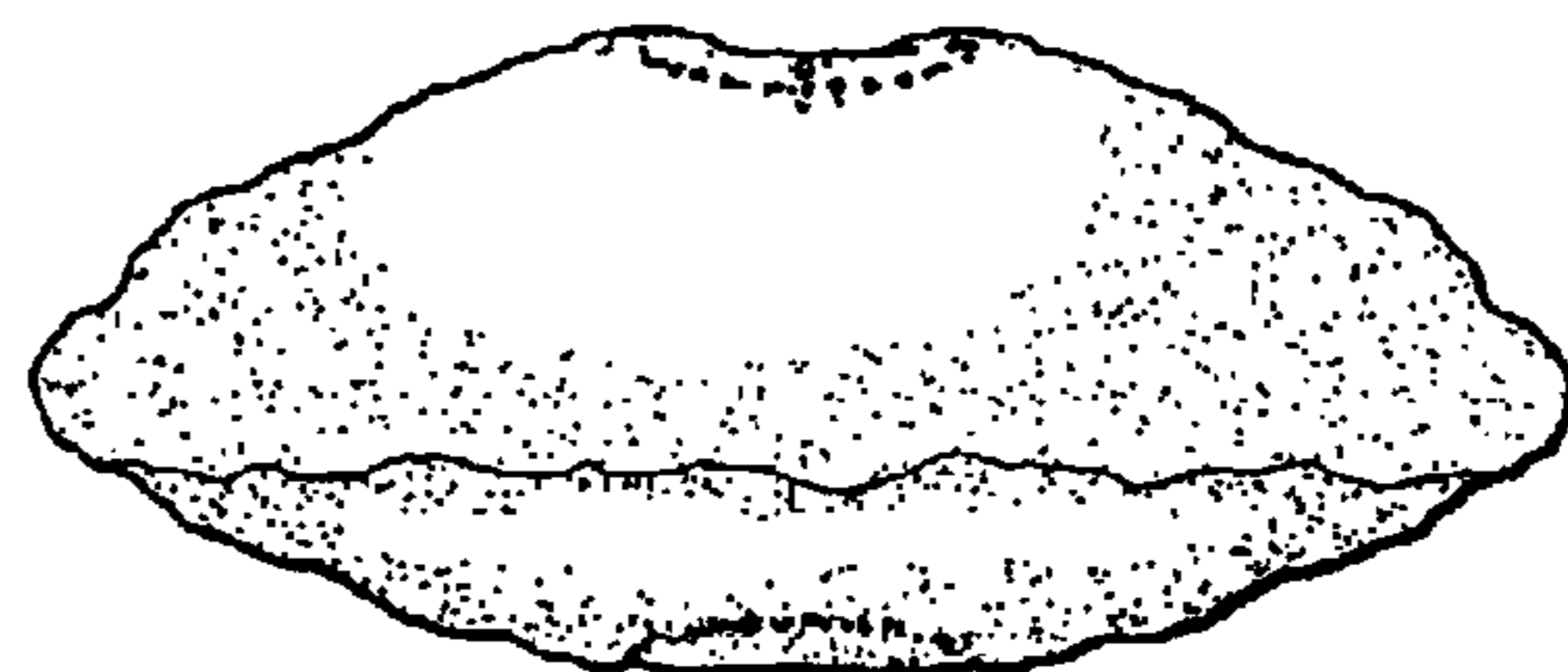

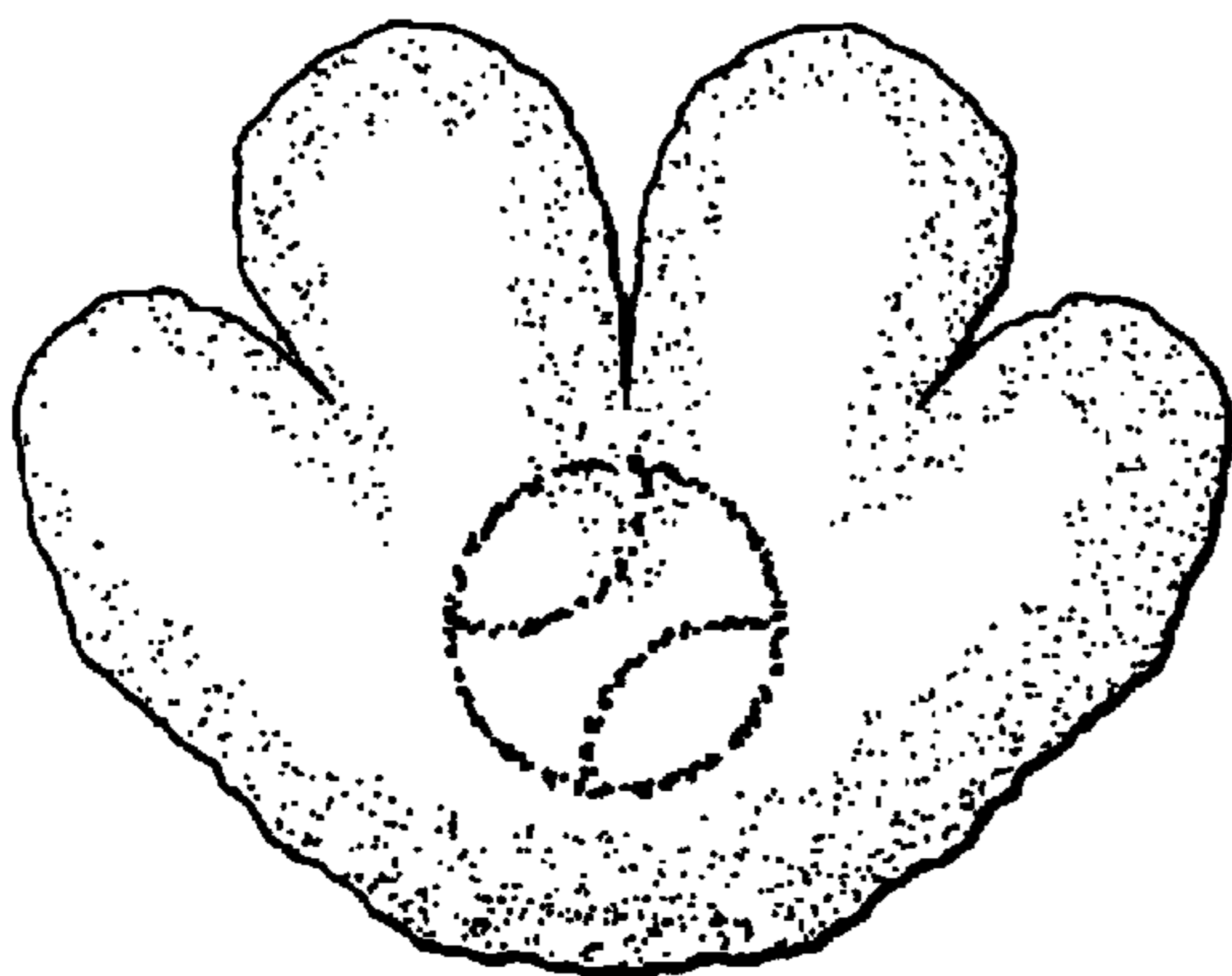

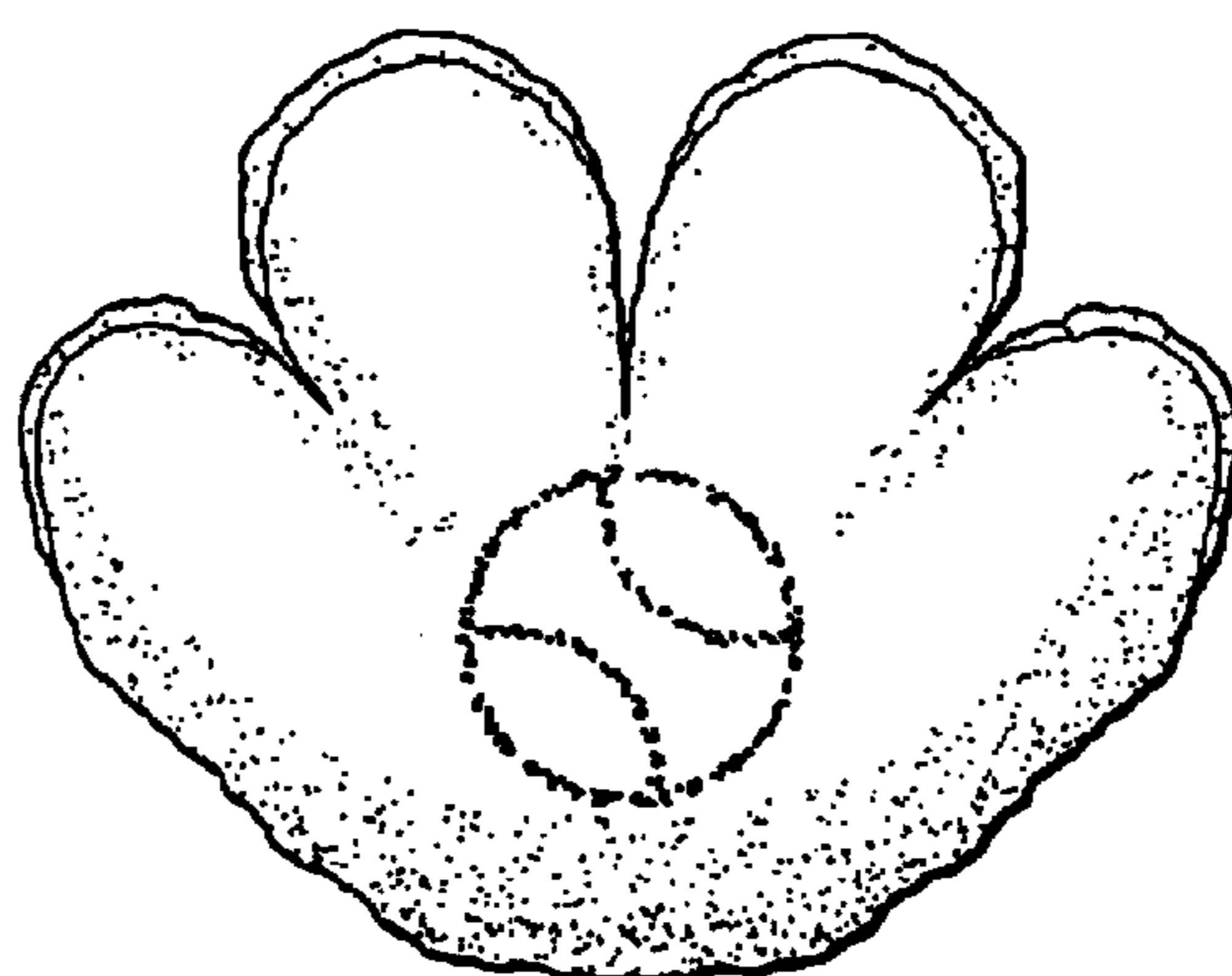
