
The ornamental design for a snack food, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;


- FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention;

- FIG. 12 is a bottom elevation view of the preferred embodiment of the snack food of the present invention.










