DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the embodiment of the
present invention;

FIG. 3 is a top perspective view thereof with the hand guard
removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a top perspective view as in FIG. 3 with an
alternative embodiment of the handle shown;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the blade removed for ease of
illustration;

FIG. 8 is a top view of the blade removed showing a second
embodiment of the blade edge pattern;

FIG. 9 is a top view of the blade removed showing a third
embodiment of the blade edge pattern;

FIG. 10 is a top view of the blade removed showing a fourth
embodiment of the blade edge pattern;

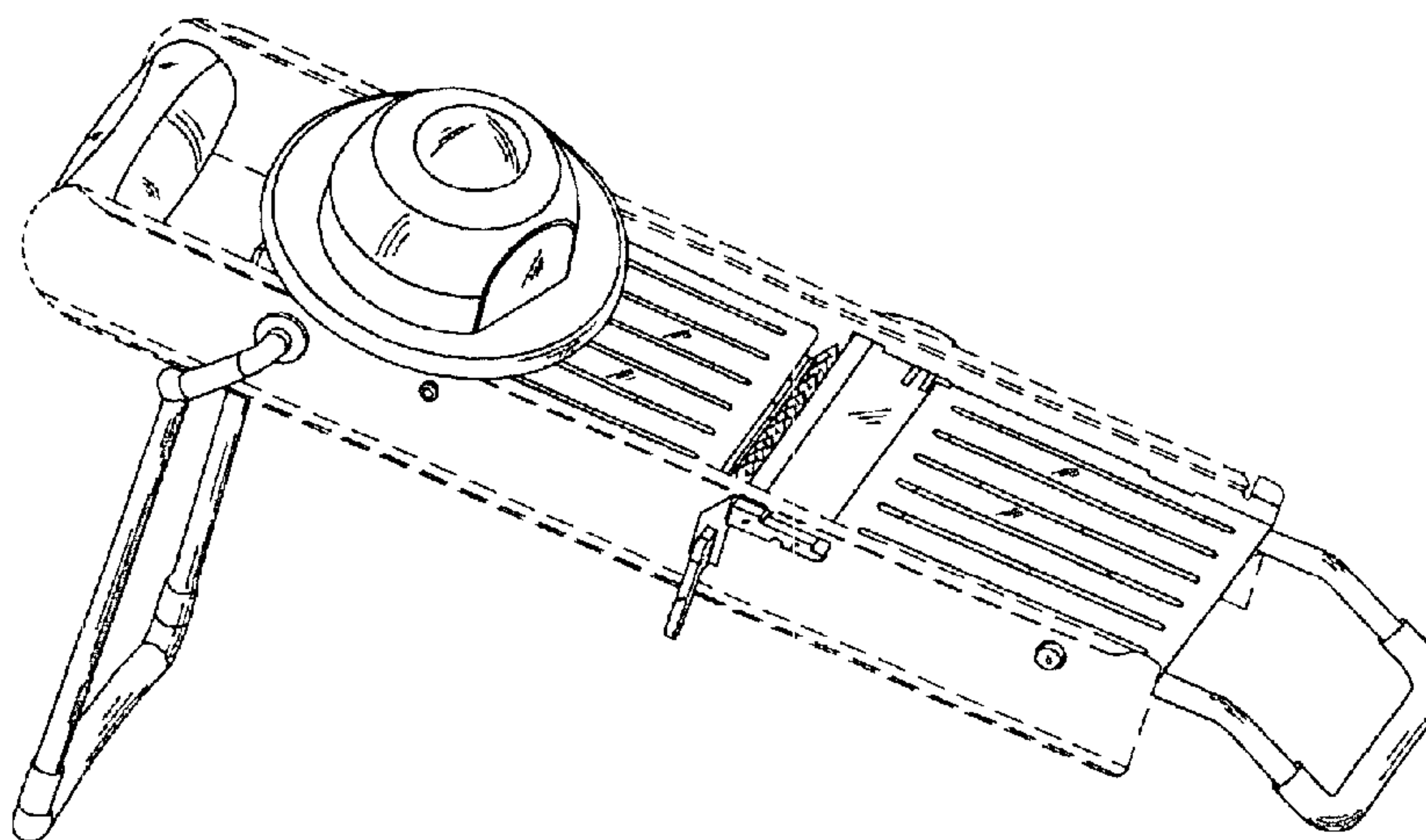
FIG. 11 is a top view of the blade removed showing a fifth
embodiment of the blade edge pattern; and,

FIG. 12 is a top view of the blade removed showing a sixth
embodiment of the blade edge pattern.

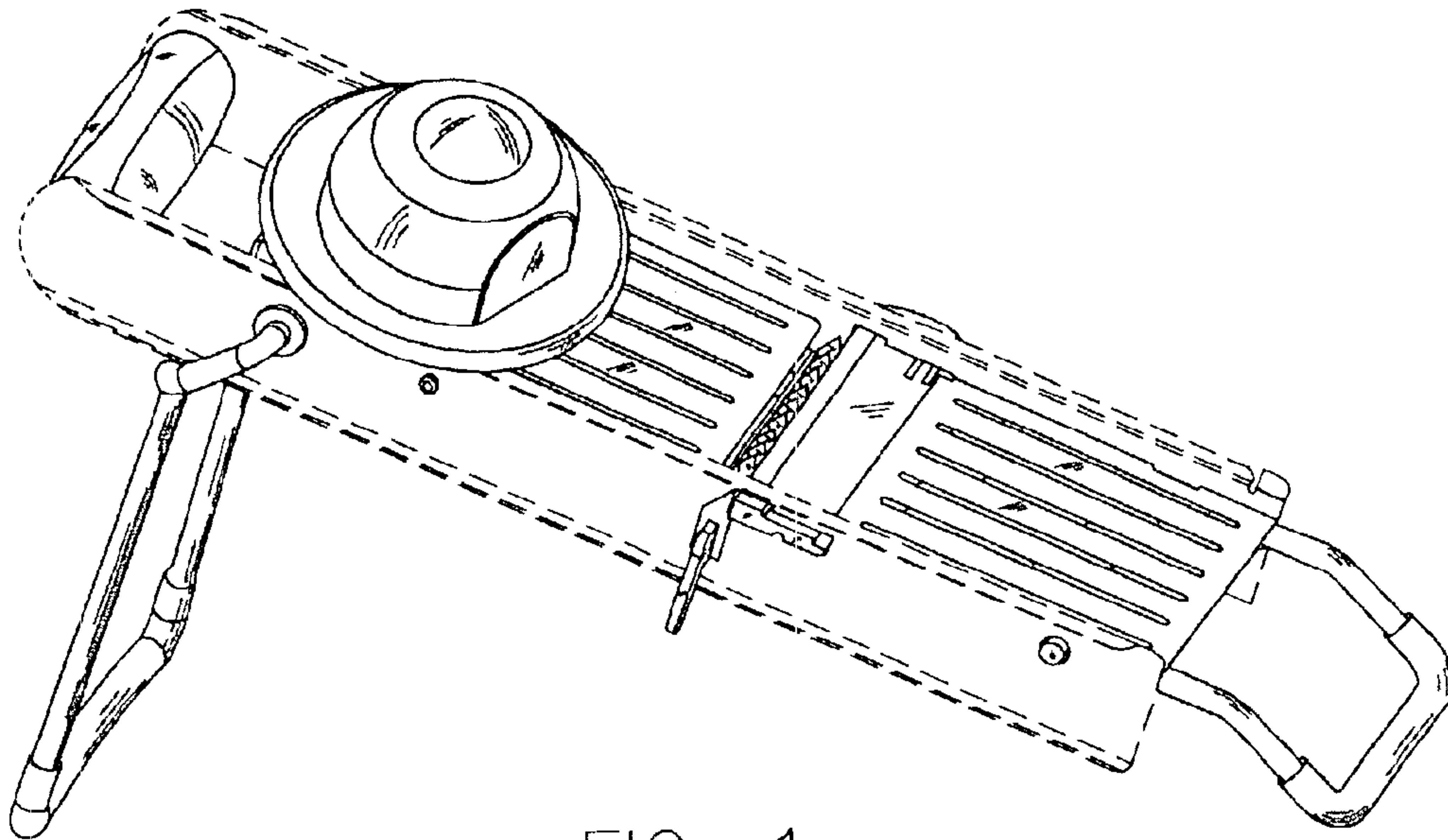

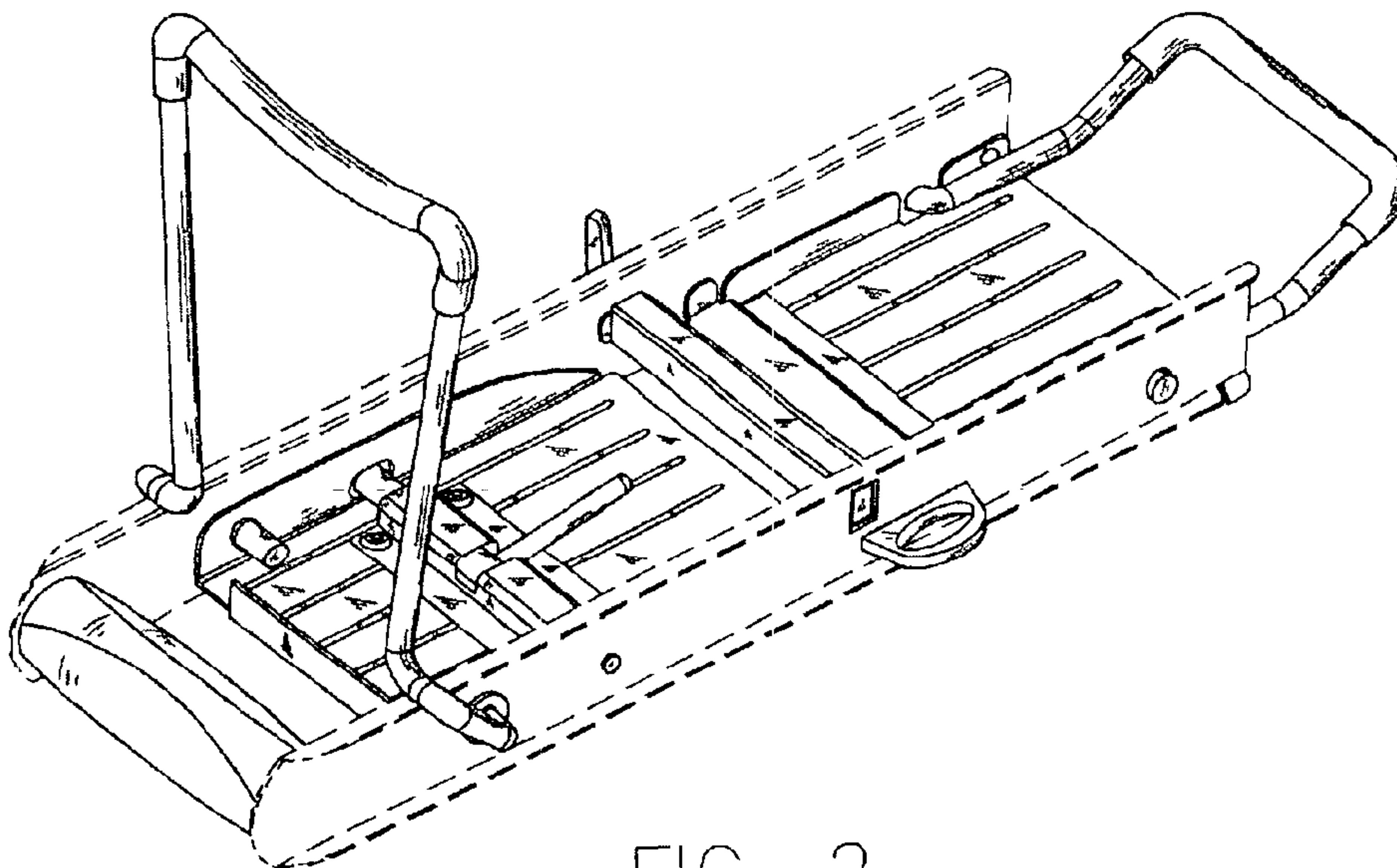

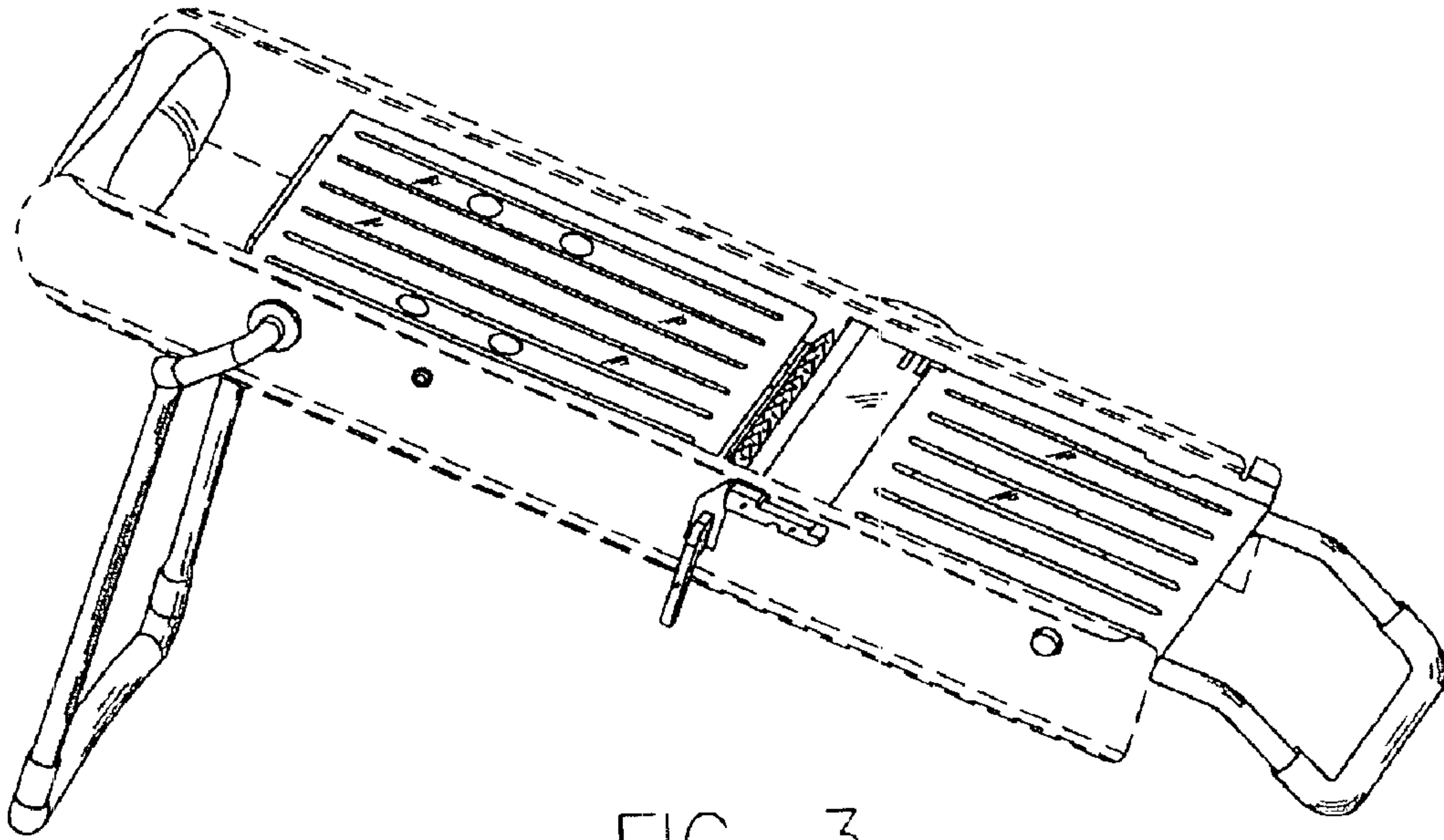

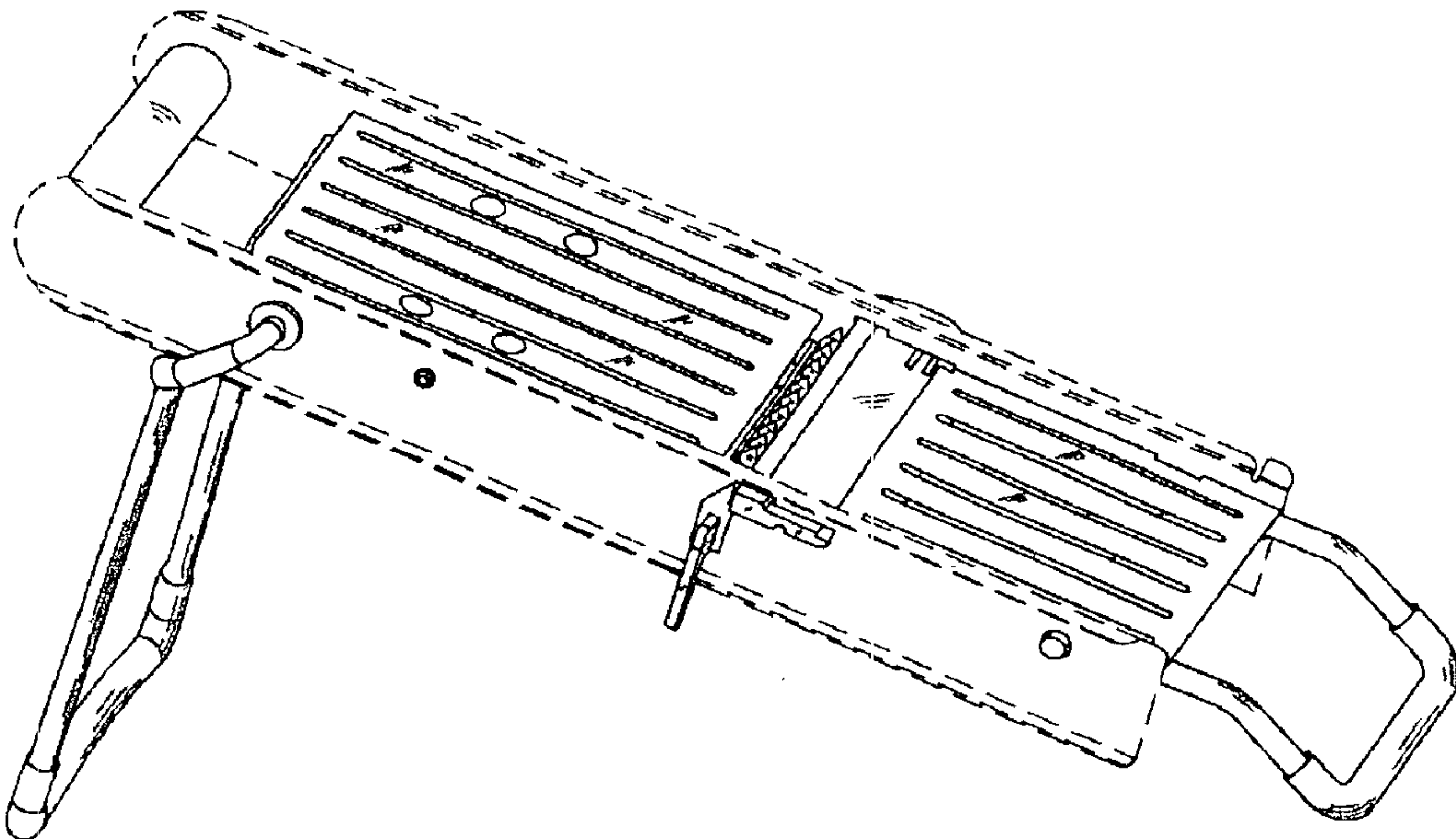

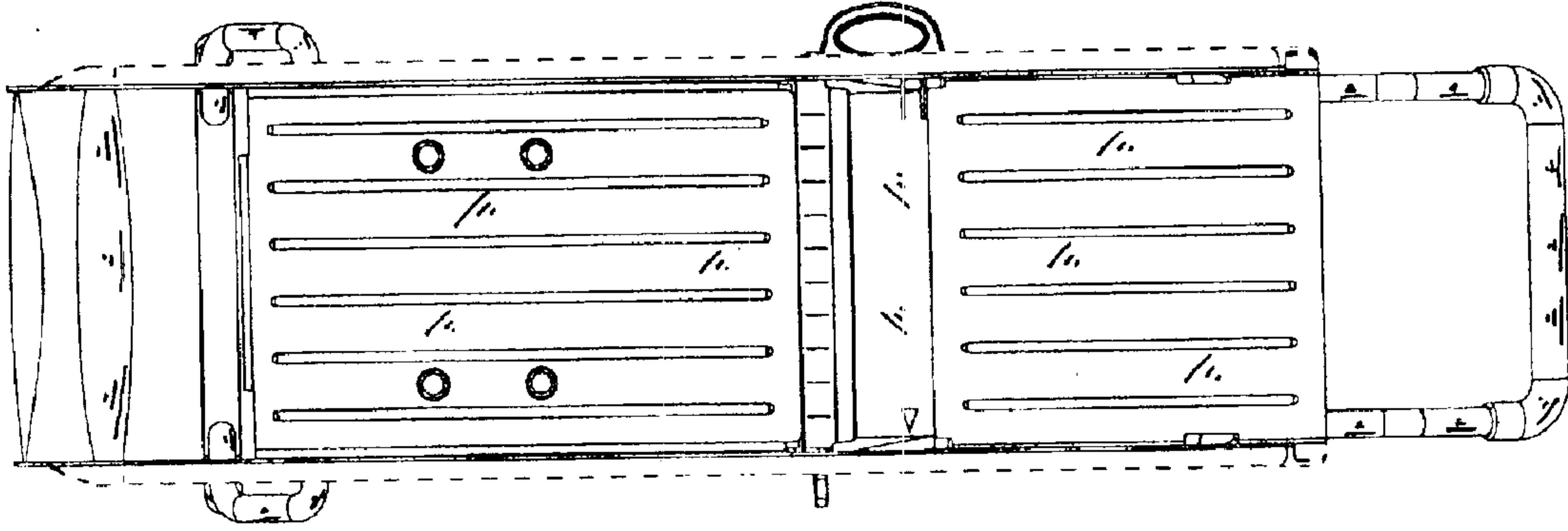

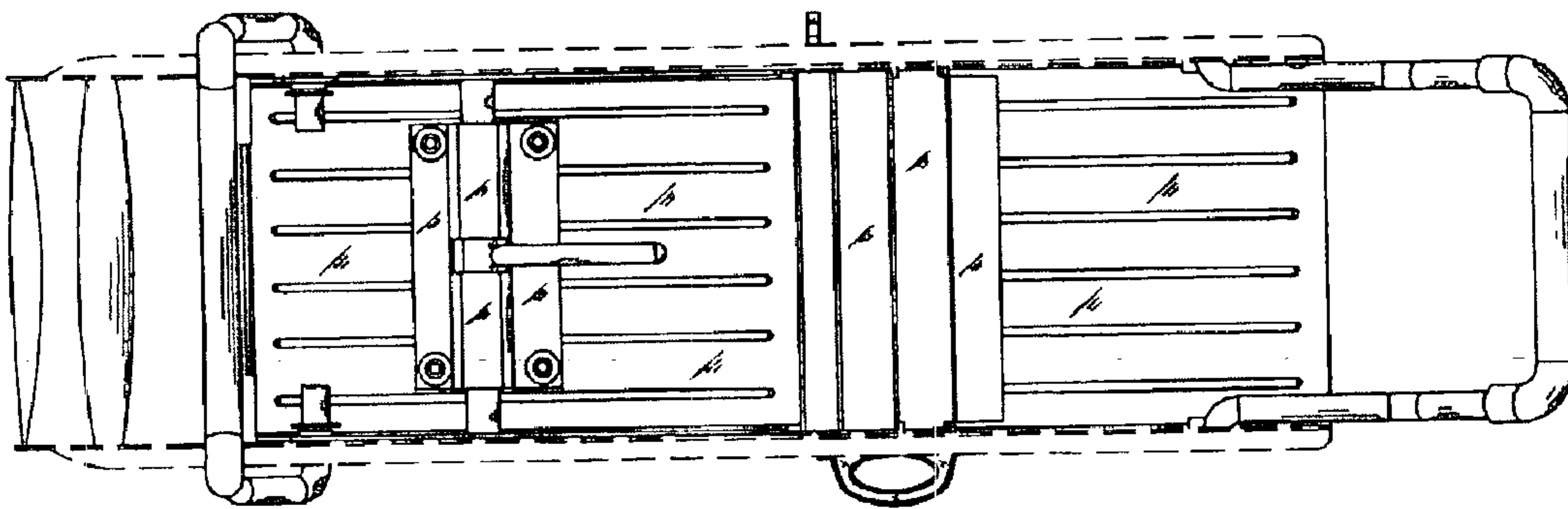

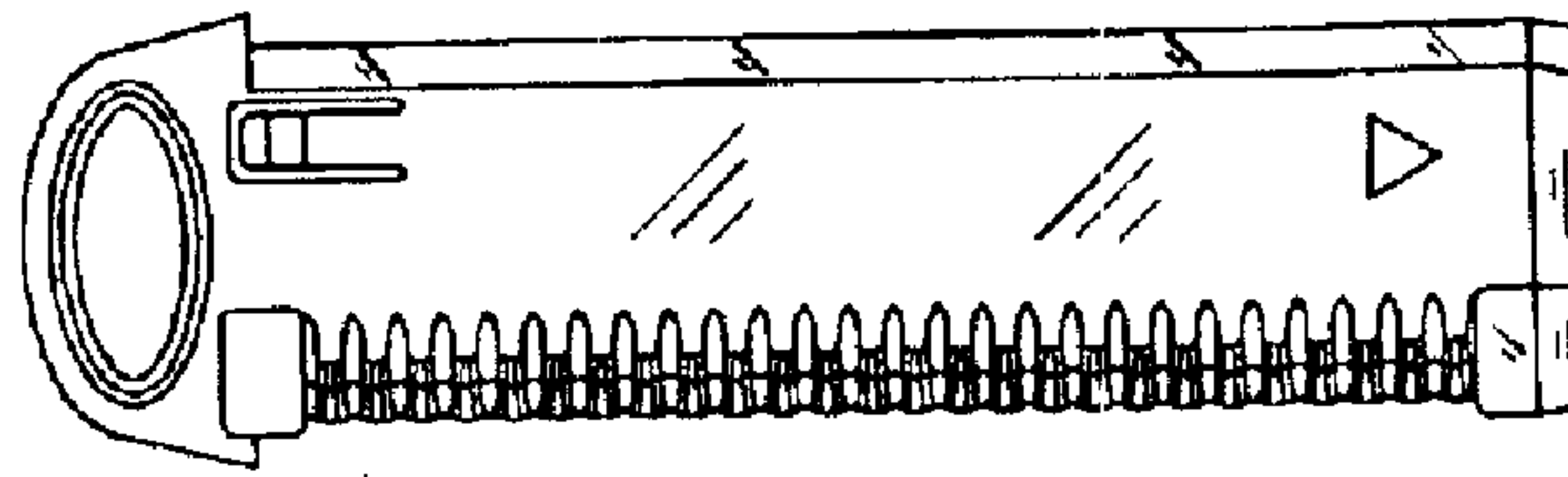

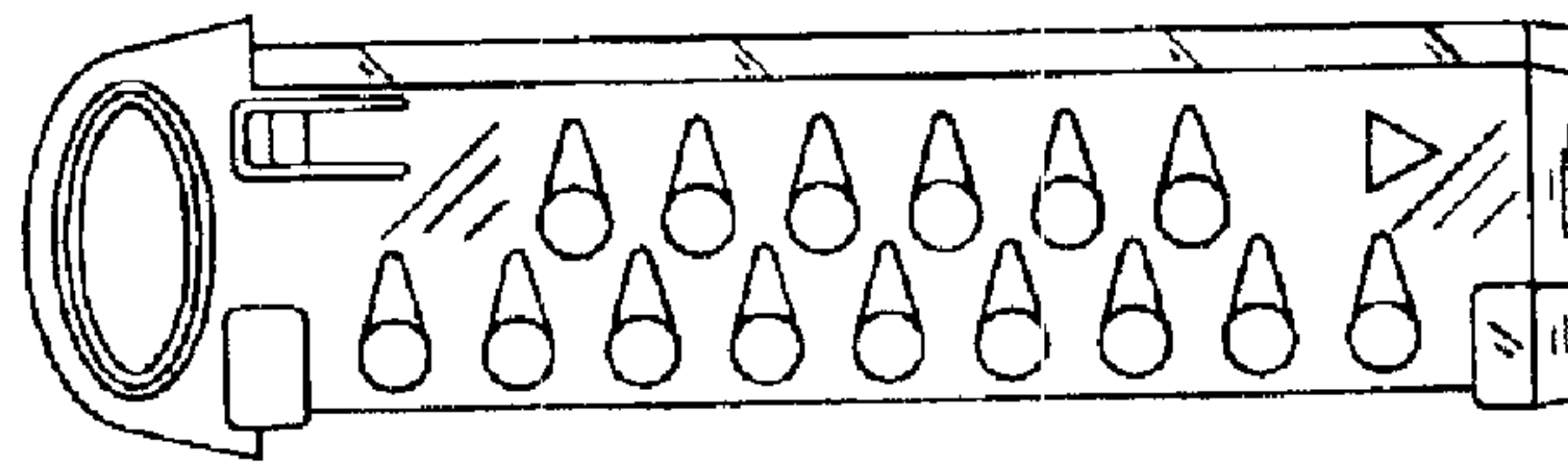

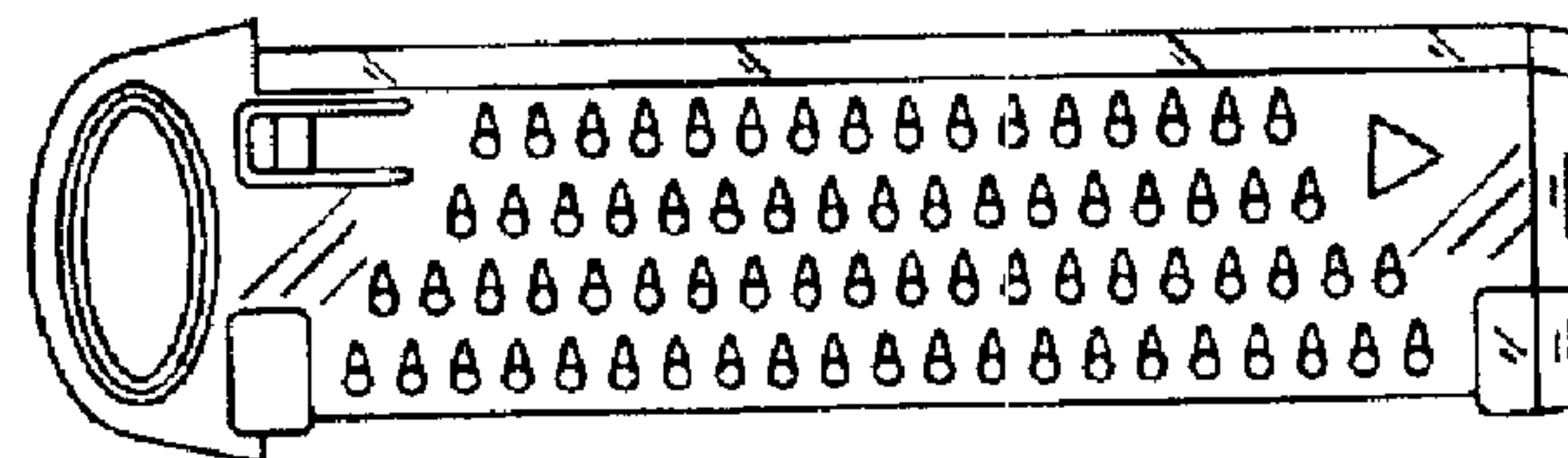

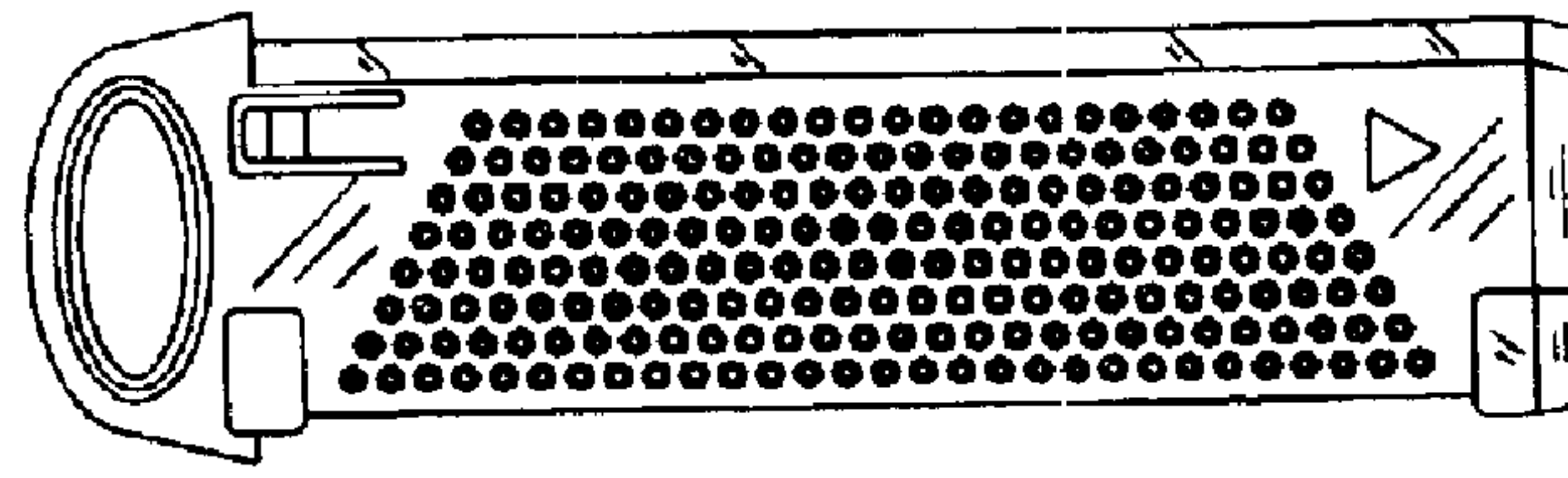

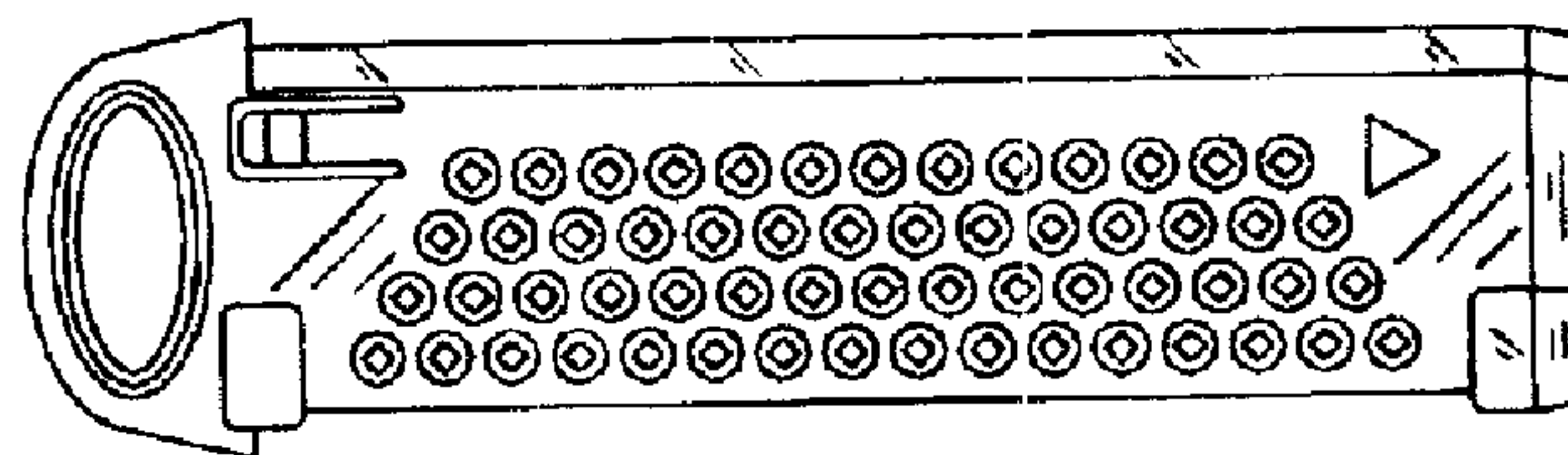

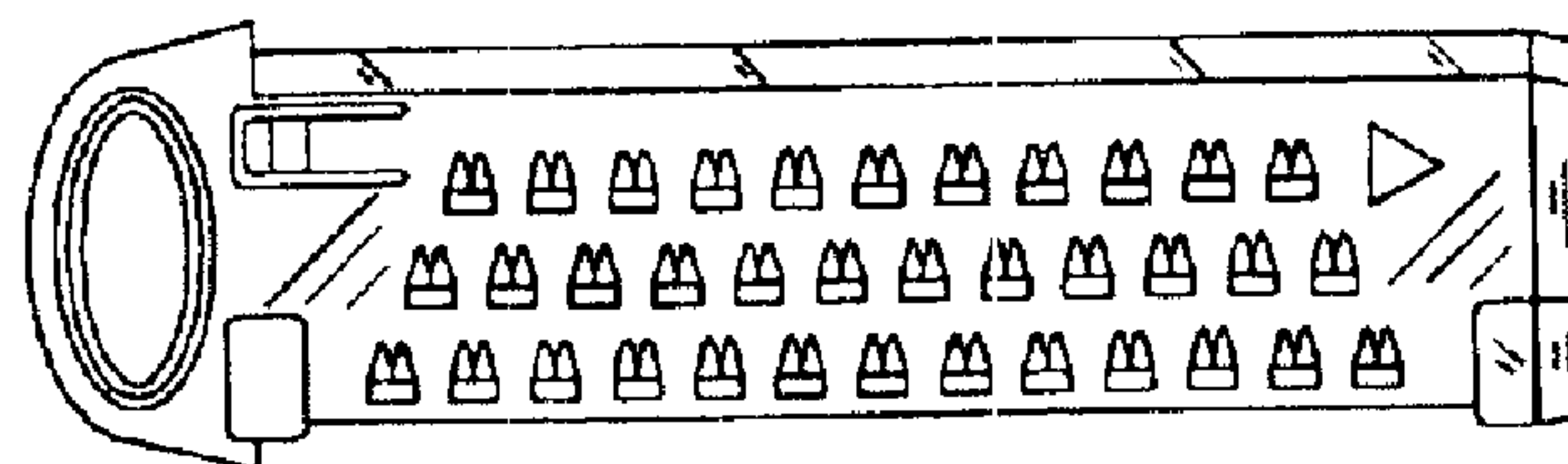
