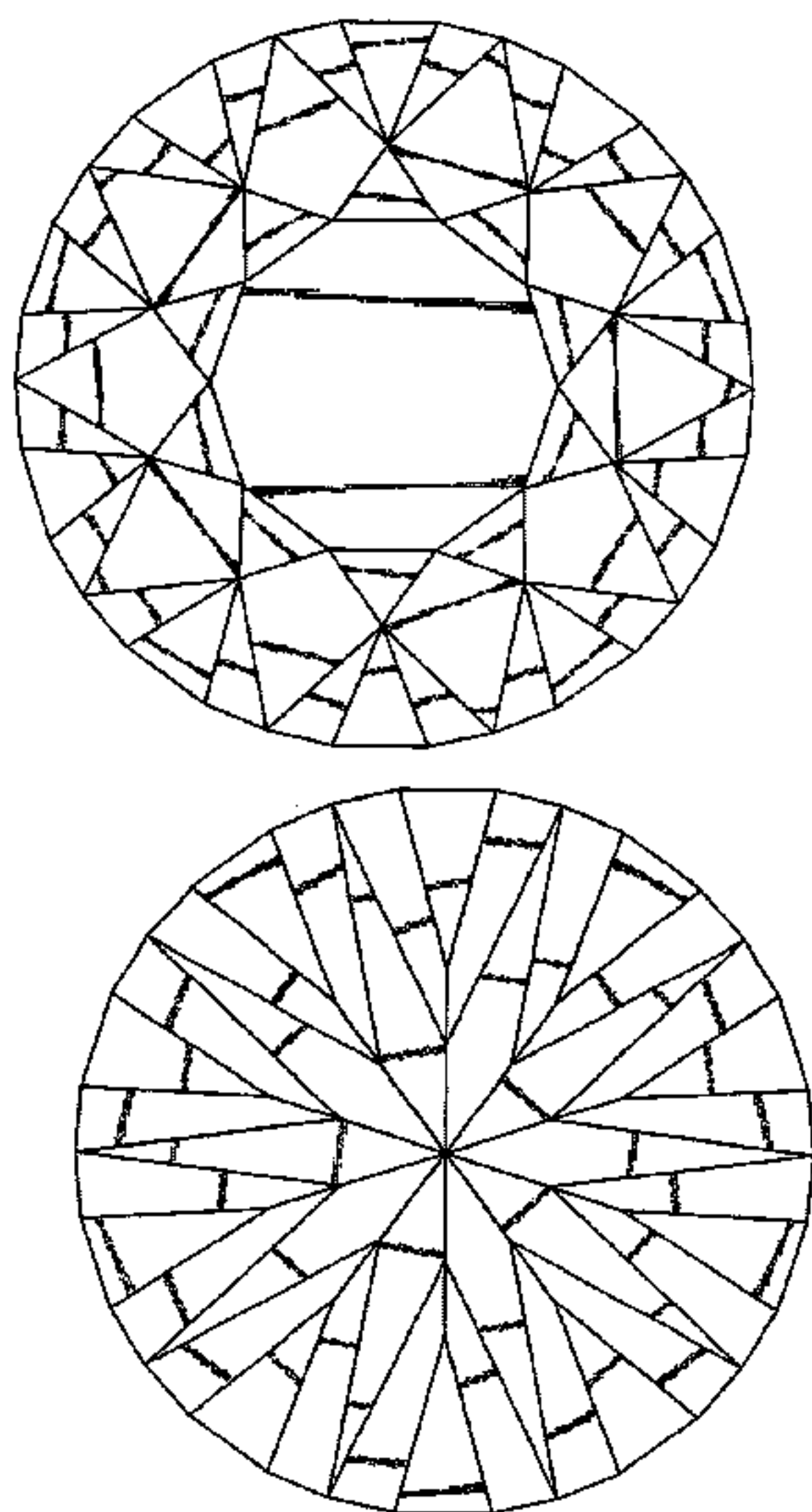

The ornamental design for a precious stone cut, as shown and described in the accompanying figures.

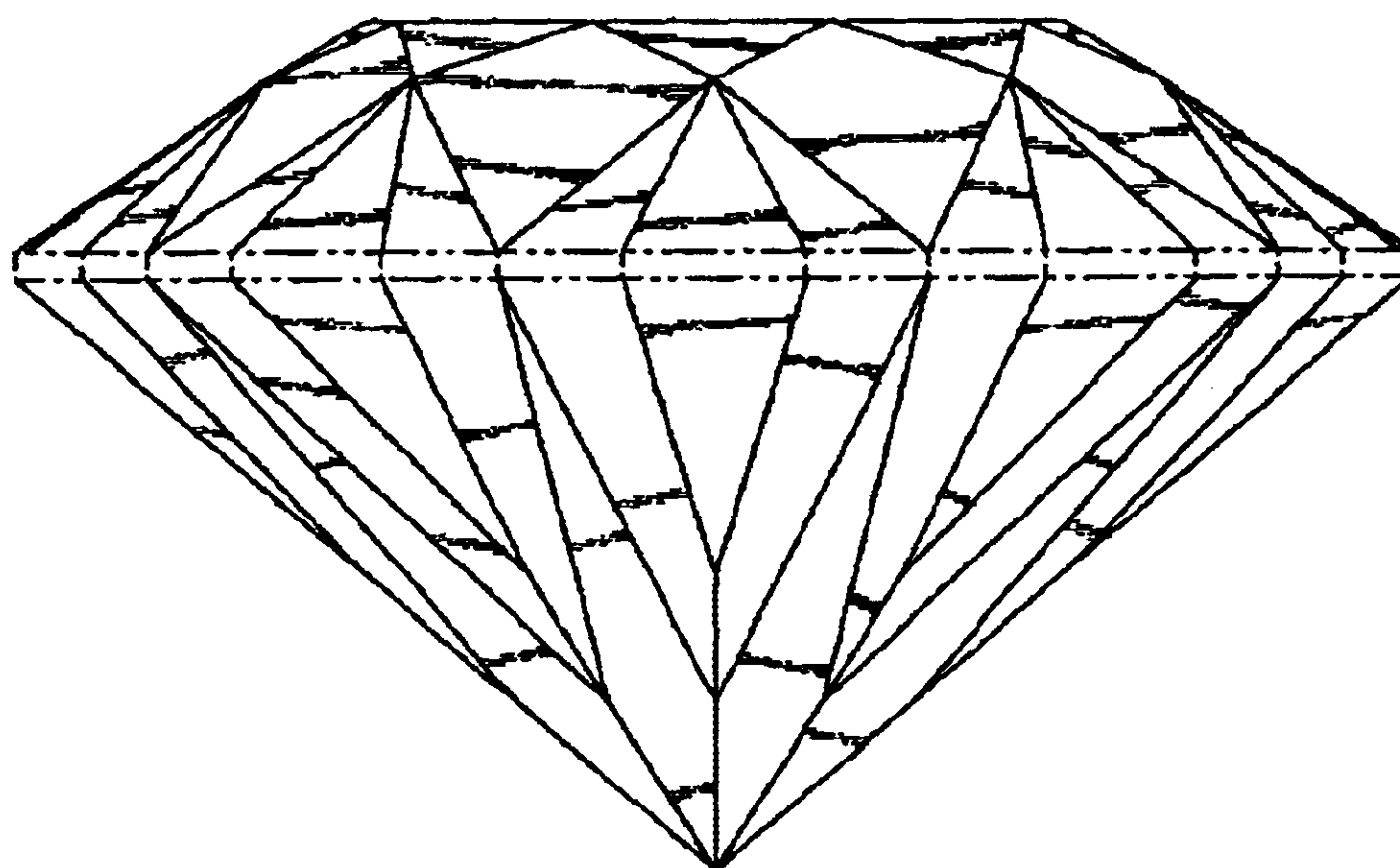
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side view of a precious stone illustrating my new design for a precious stone cut;  
FIG. 2 is another side view thereof showing the precious stone rotated 90 degrees about a center axis from the position illustrated in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the precious stone illustrated in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the precious stone illustrated in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 5 is a side view of a transparent precious stone illustrating my new design for a precious stone cut;  
FIG. 6 is another side view thereof showing the transparent precious stone rotated 90 degrees about a center axis from the position illustrated in FIG. 5;  
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the transparent precious stone illustrated in FIG. 5; and,  
FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the transparent precious stone illustrated in FIG. 5.  
All portions shown in broken lines are environmental and illustrative only and form no part of the claimed design. Any facets that may be visible through the transparent precious stone are not shown for the sake of clarity.

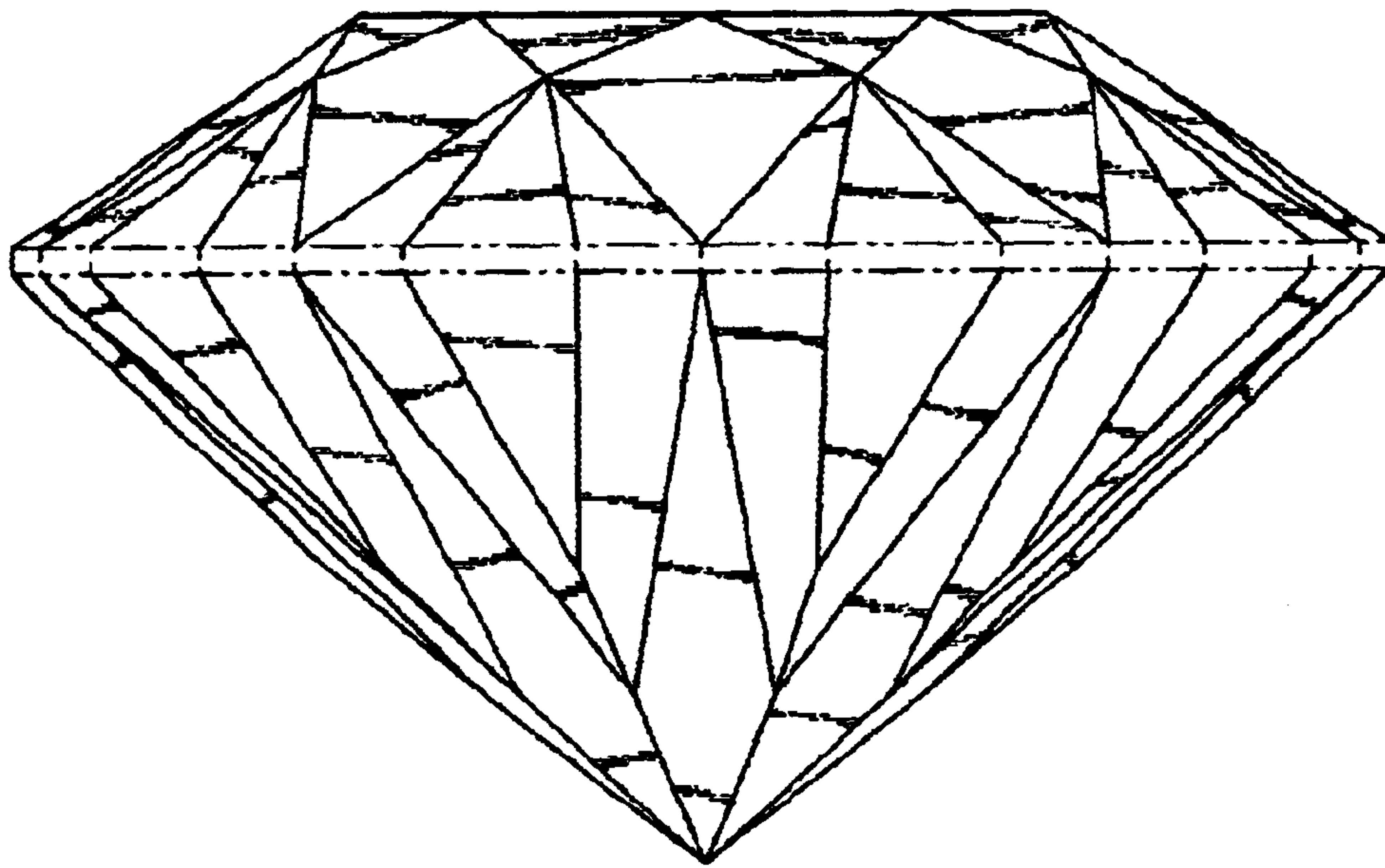






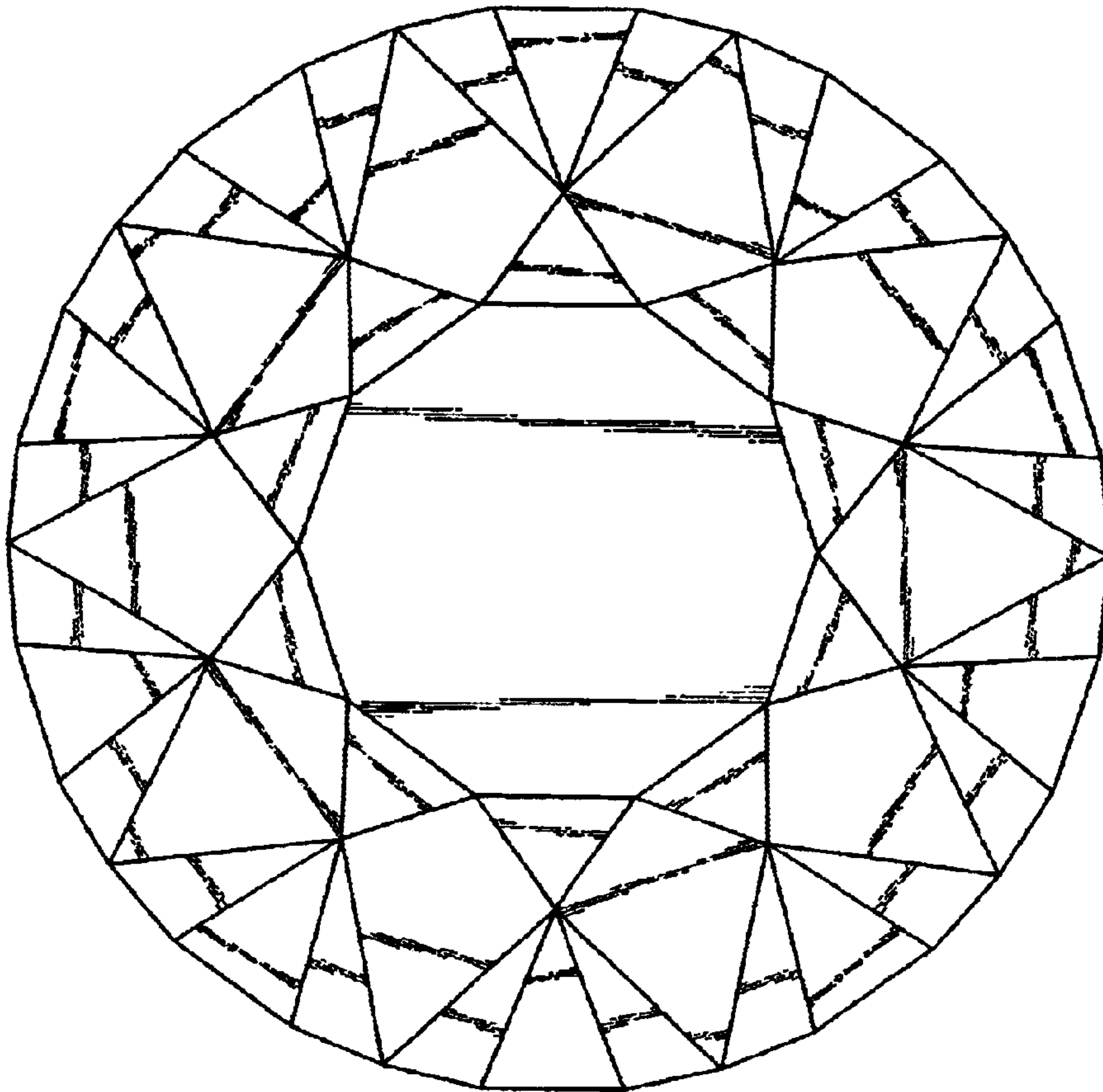

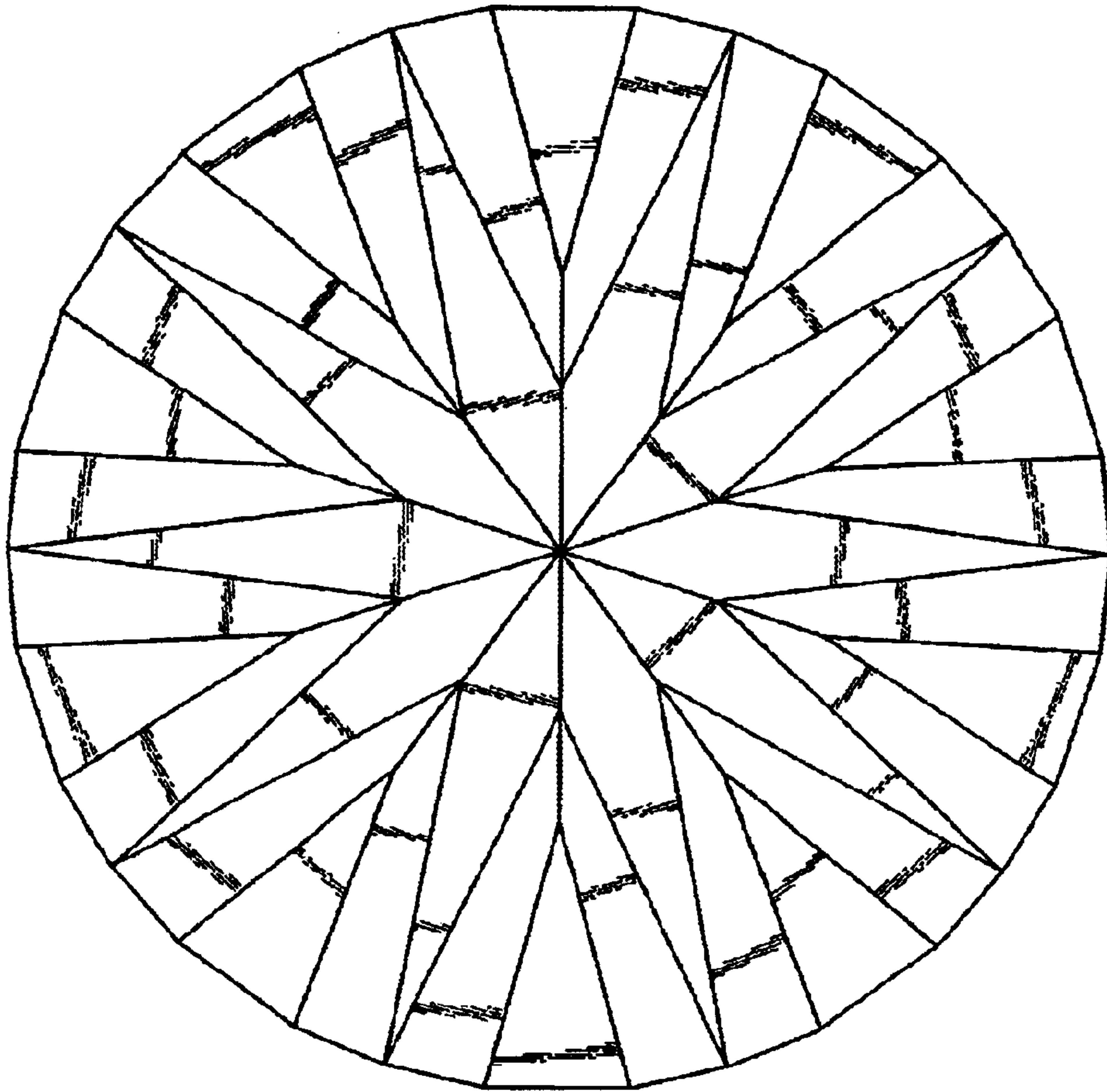

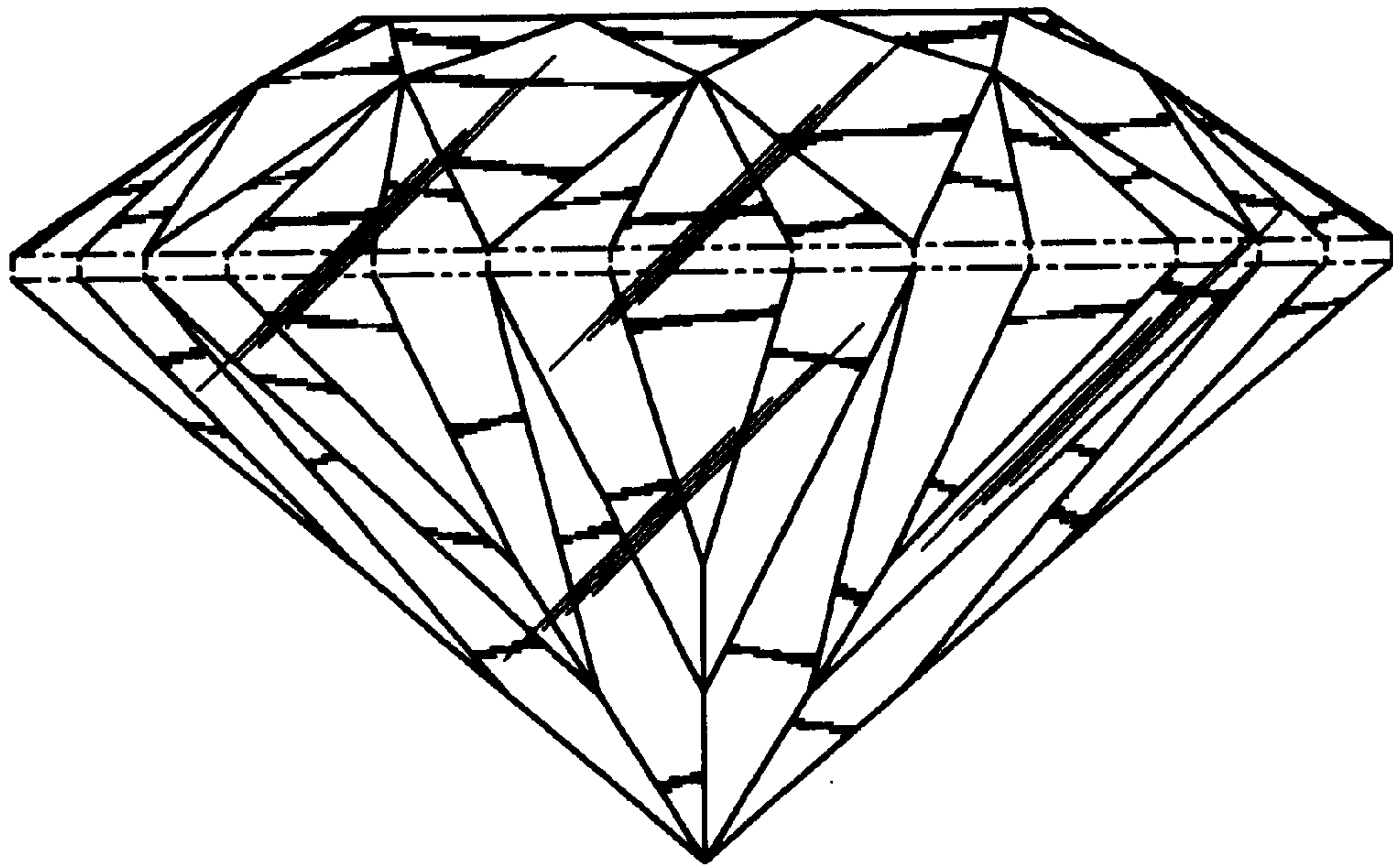

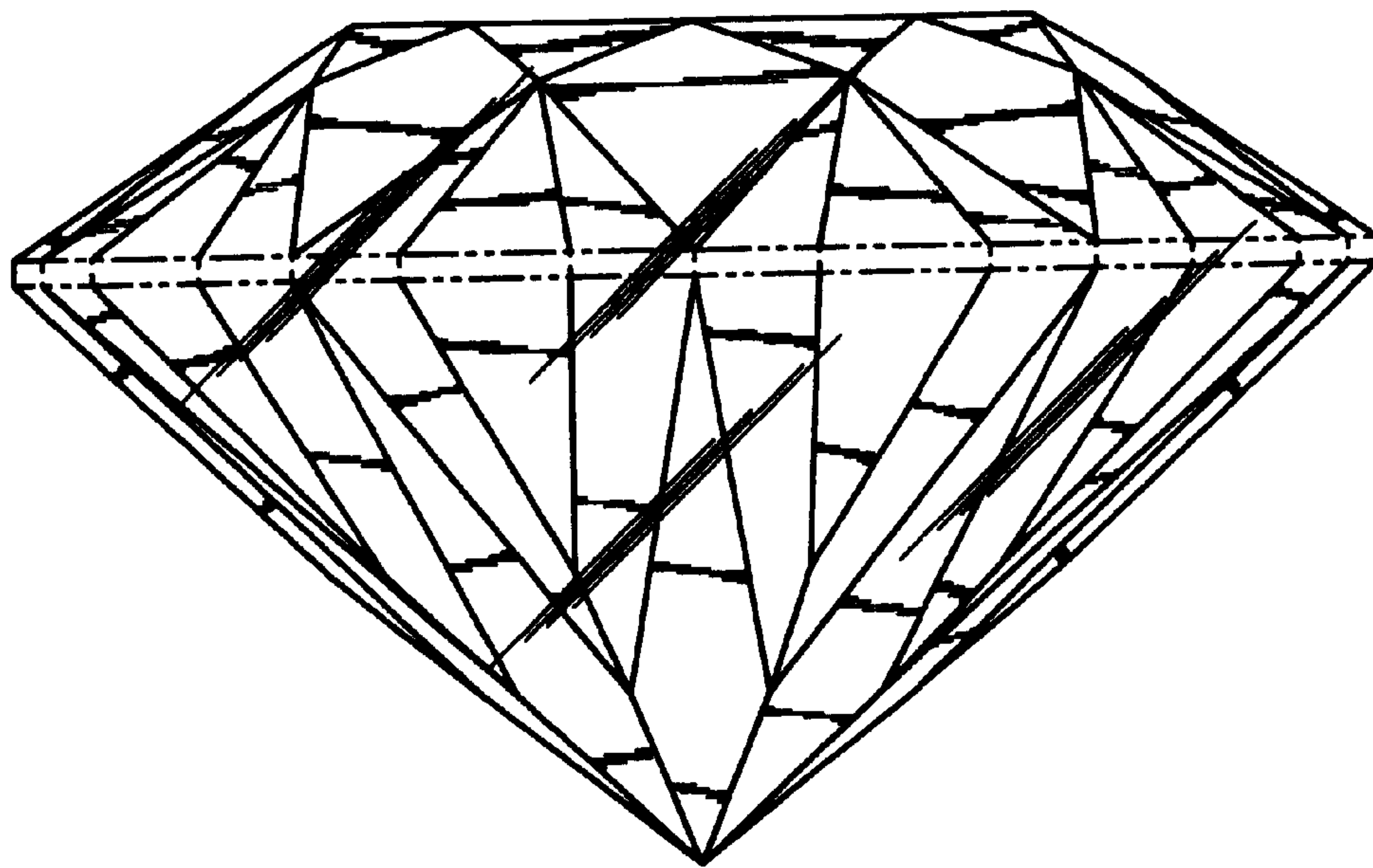

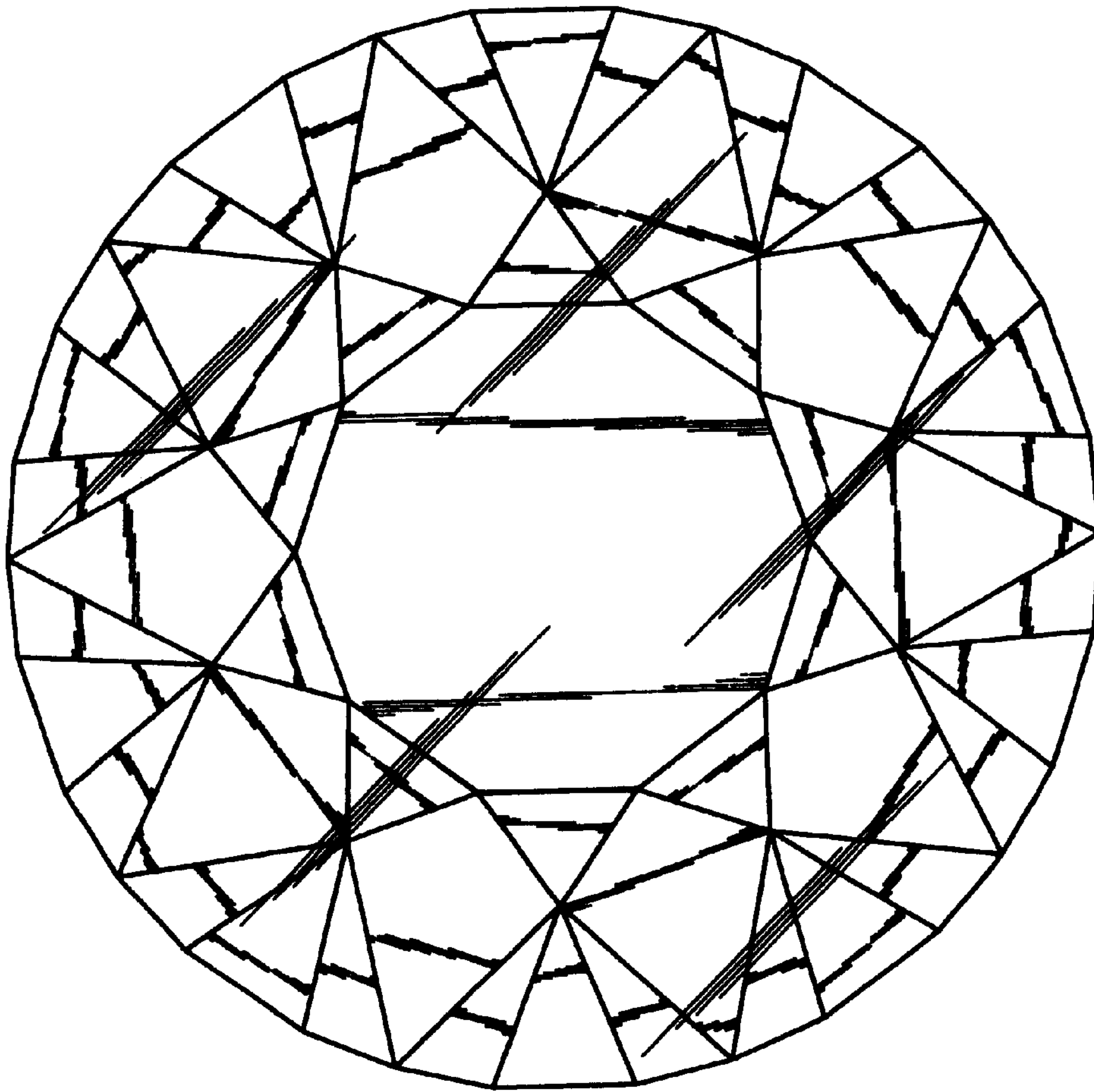

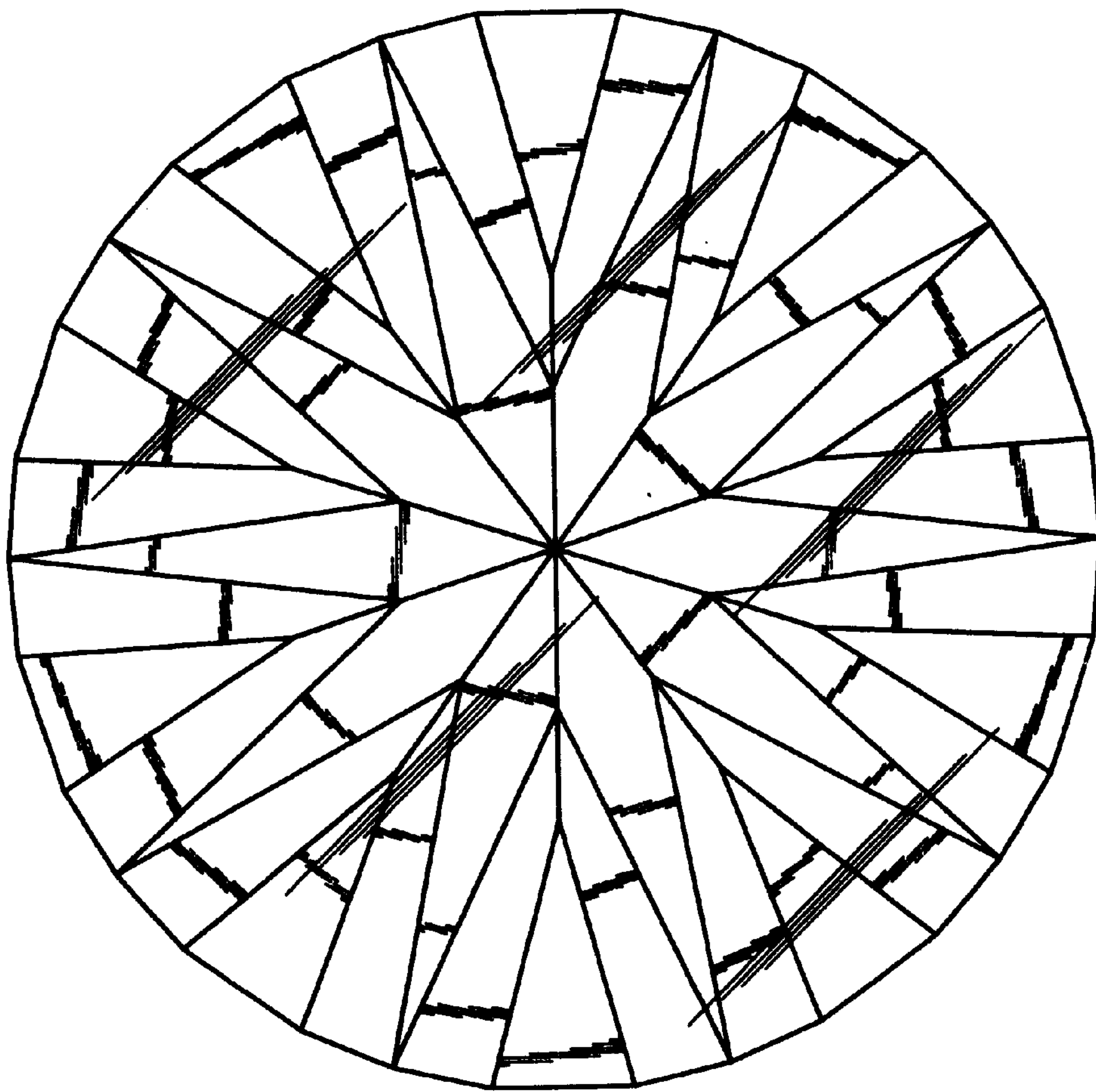
