The ornamental design for a wicker chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the wicker chair showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of the wicker chair shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a back view of the wicker chair shown in FIG. 1.

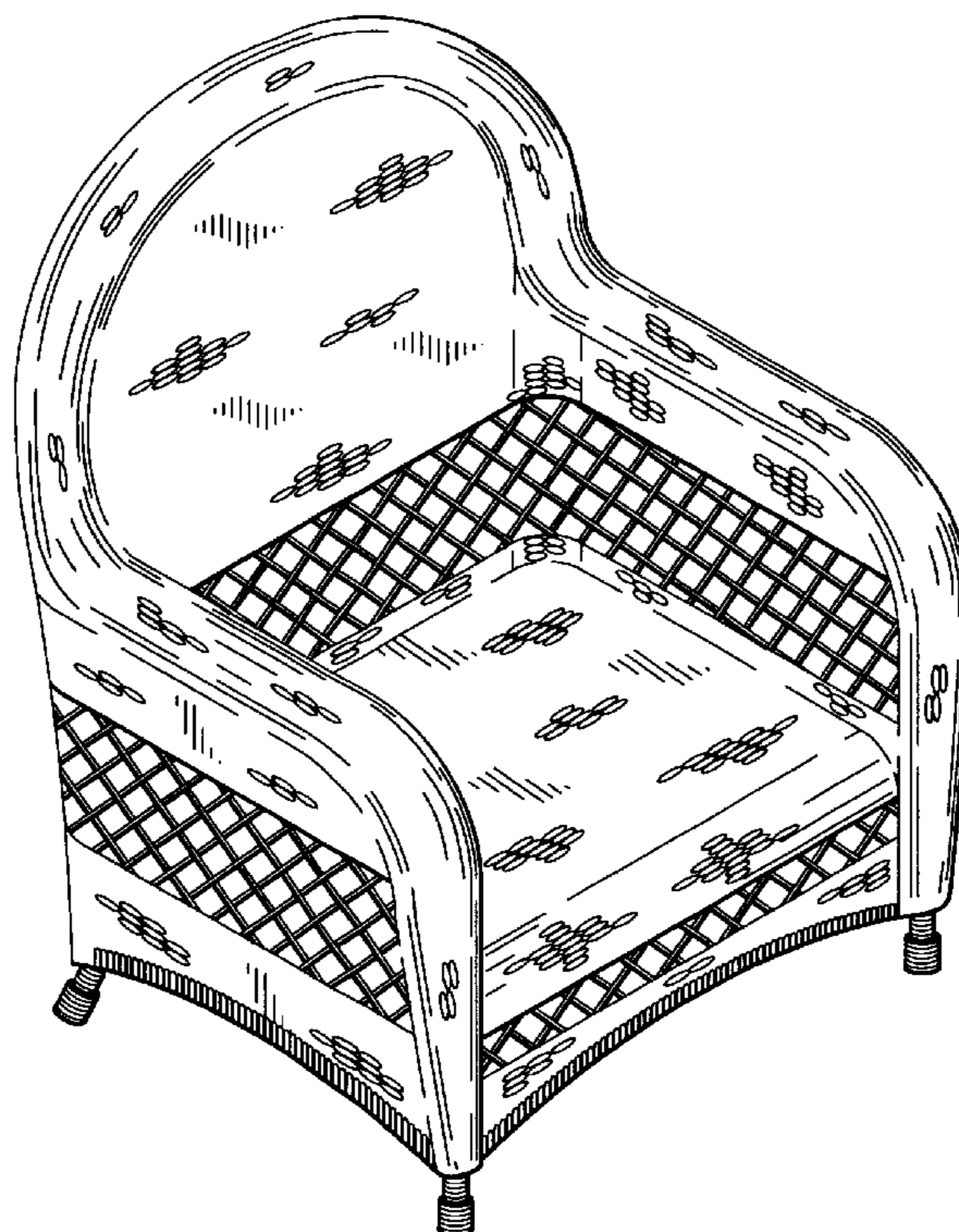
FIG. 4 is a top view of the wicker chair shown in FIG. 1.

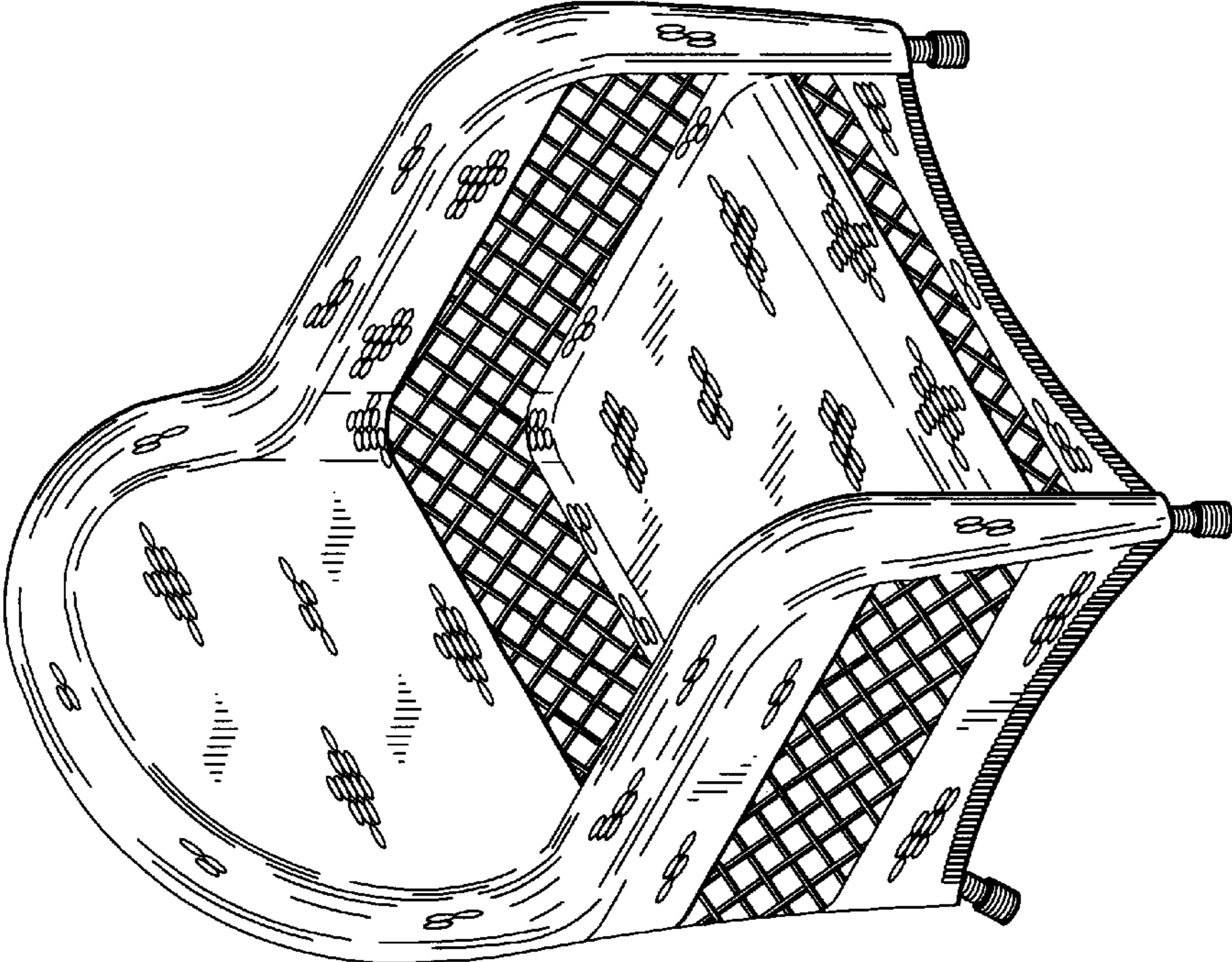

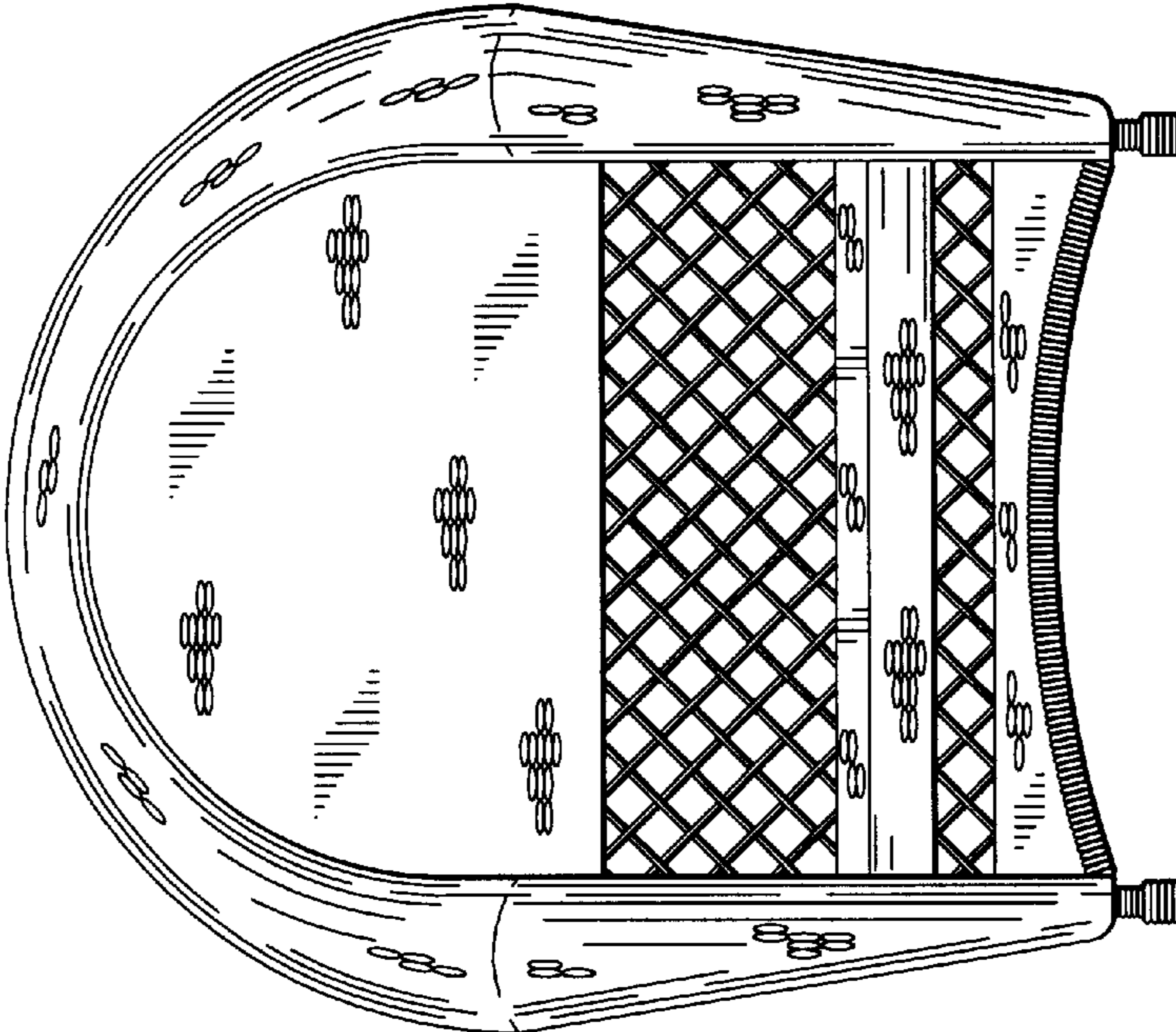

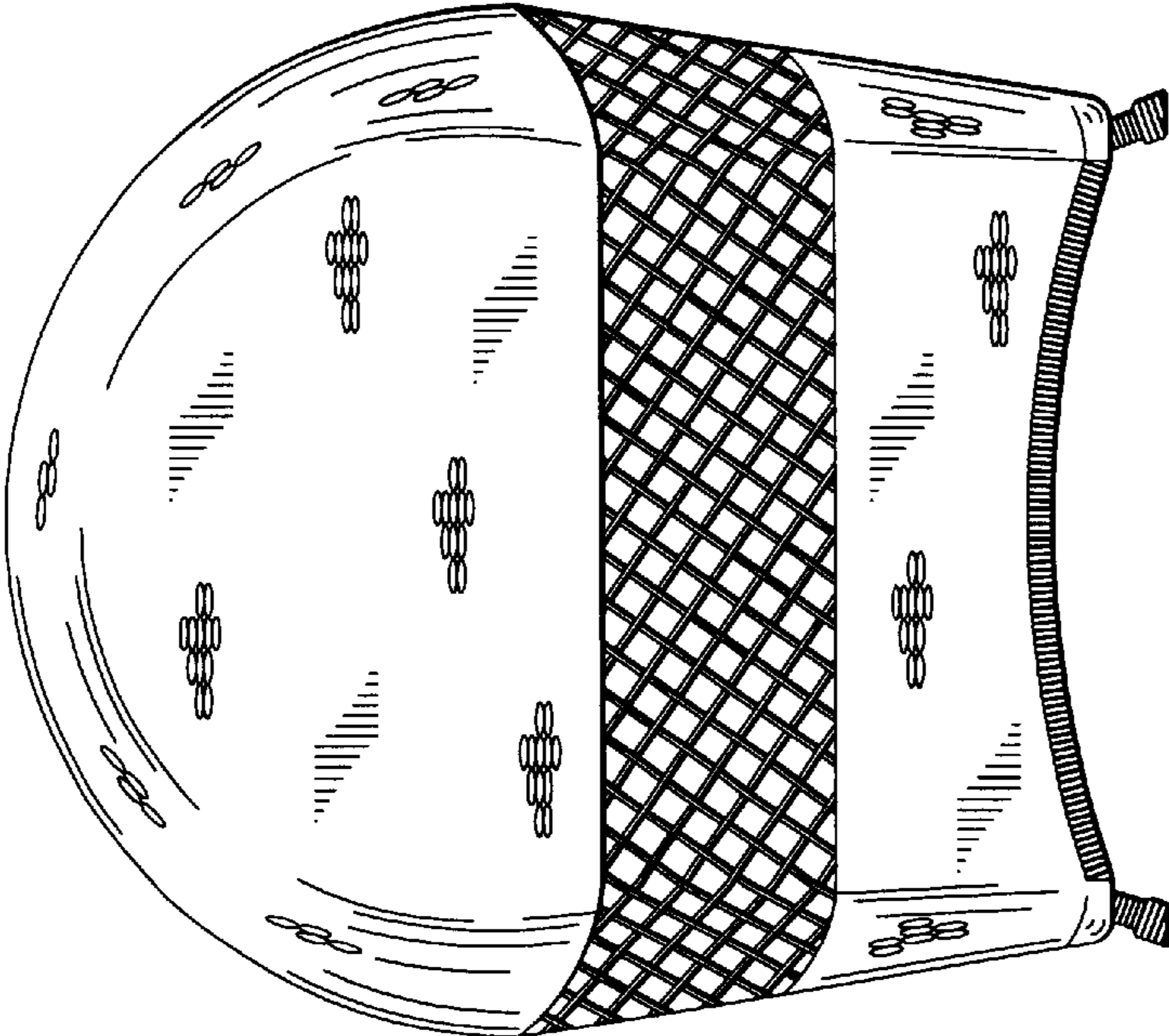

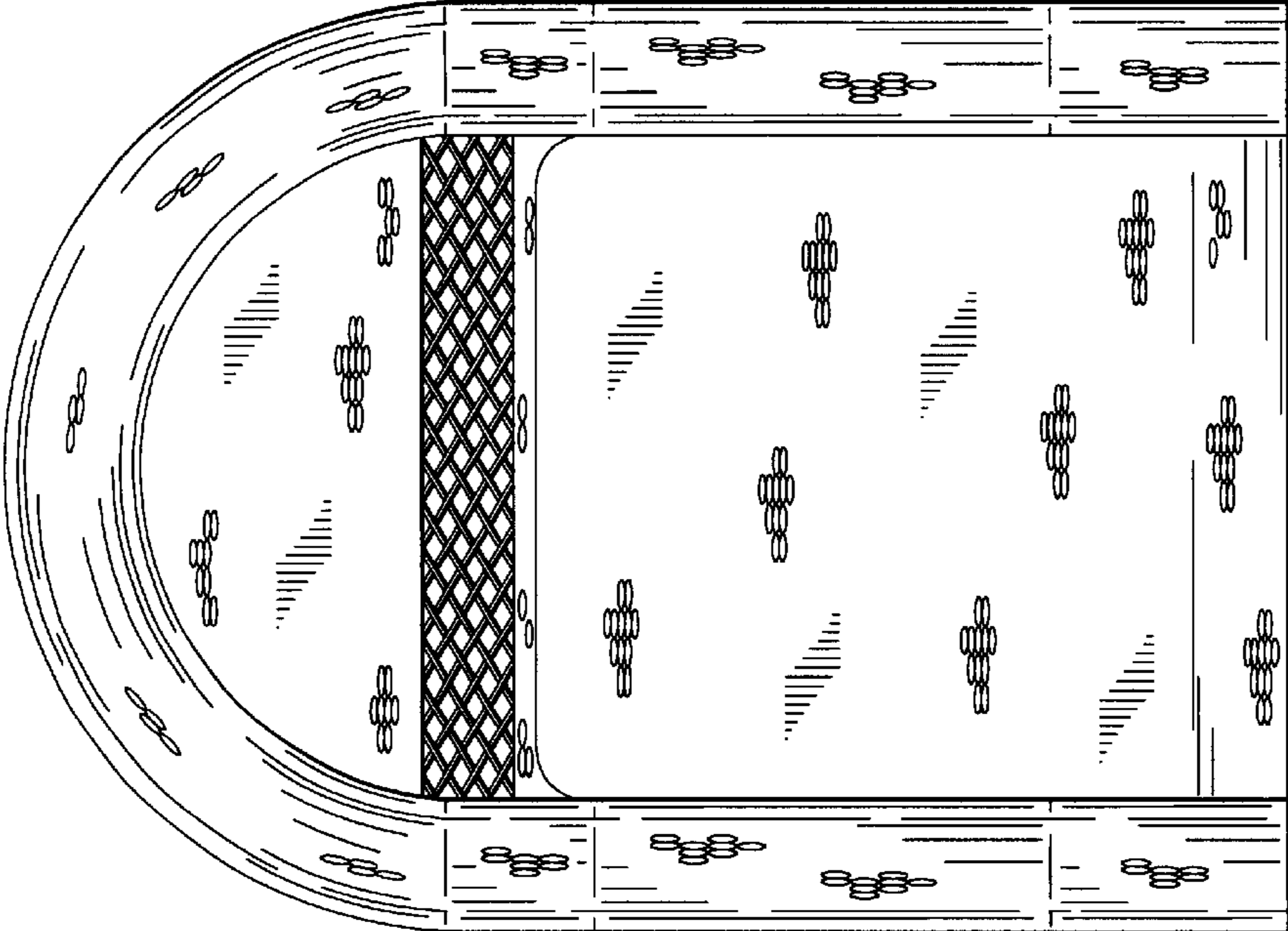

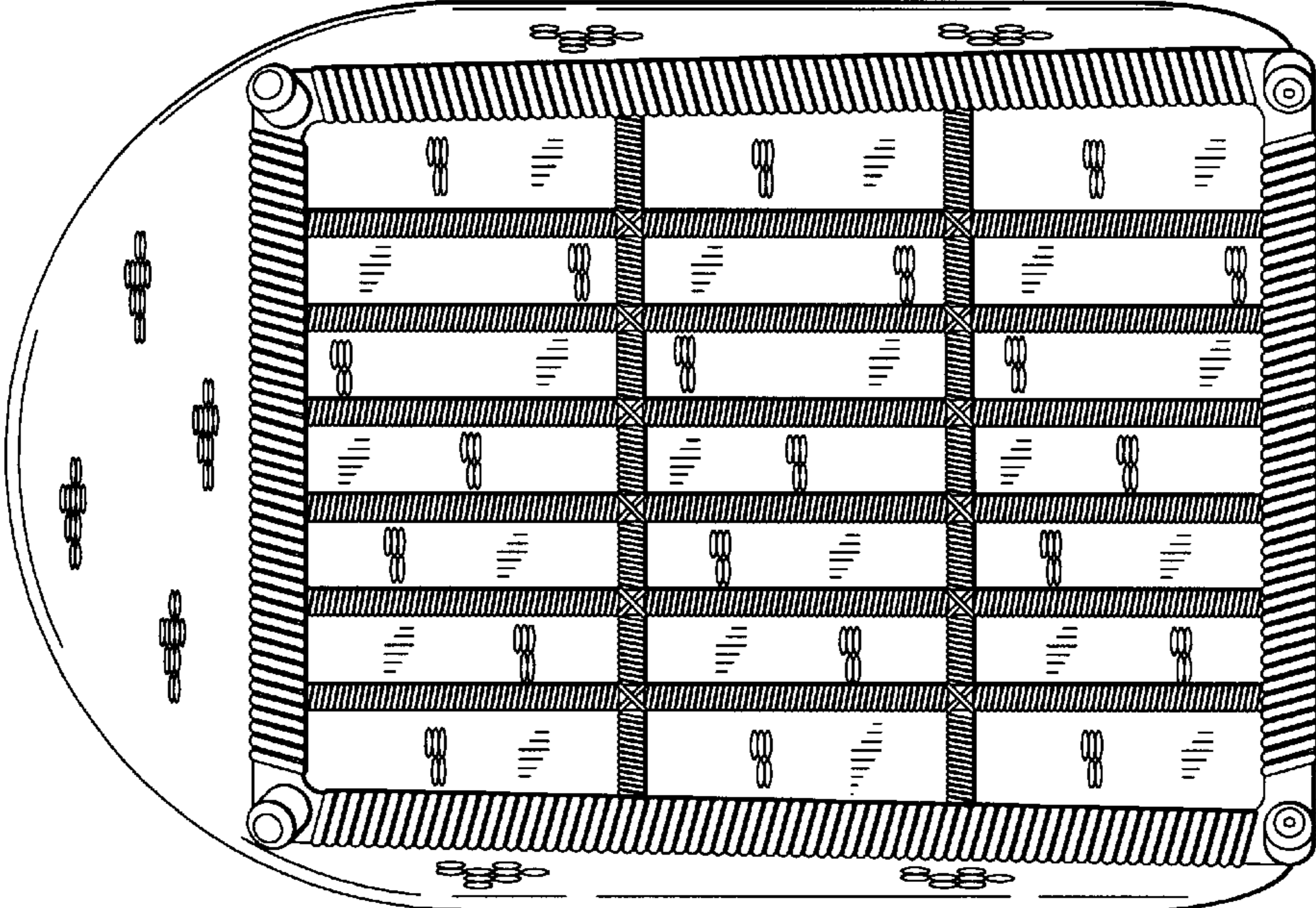

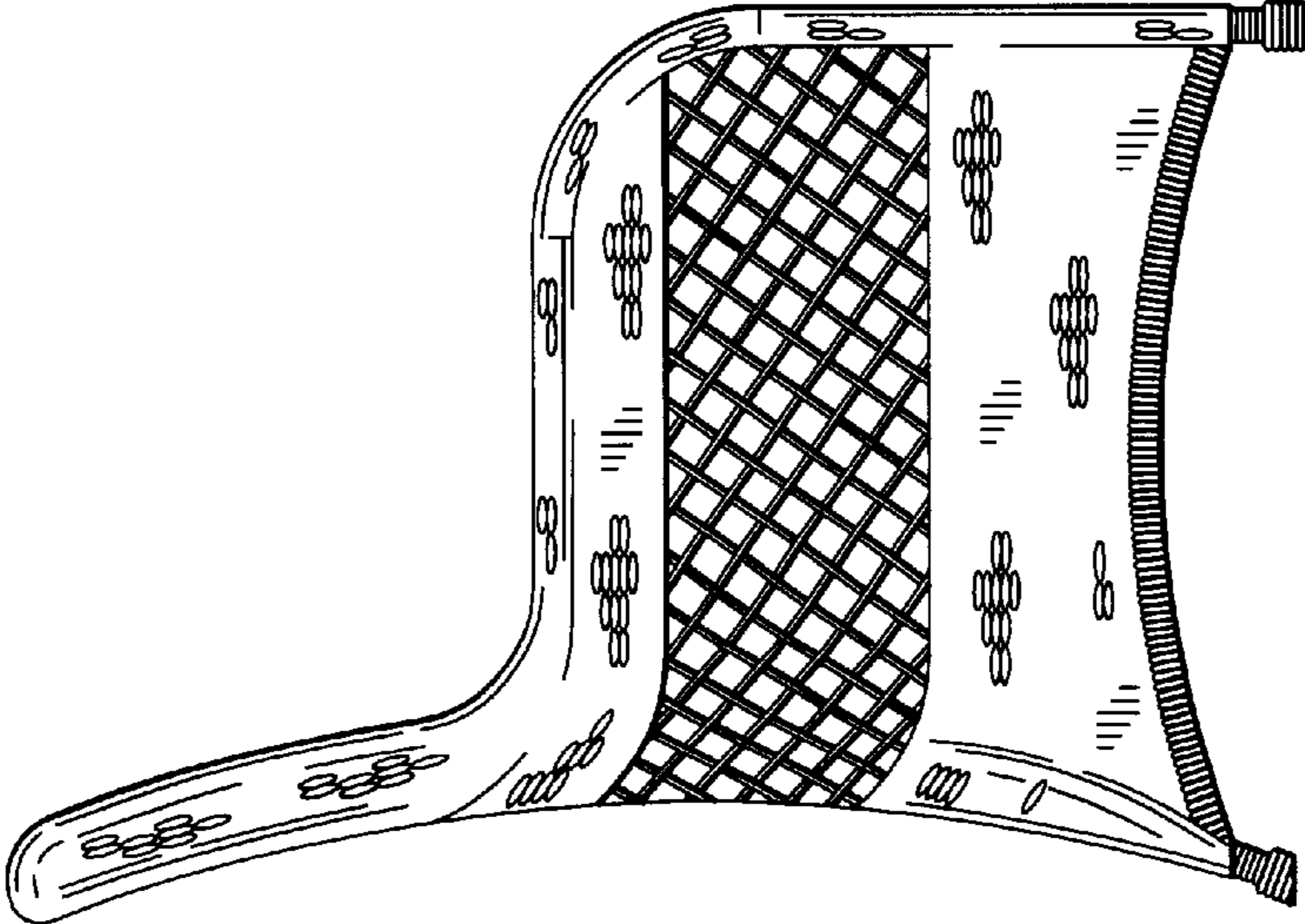
