CLAIM (57)

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the bottle in accordance with my new design, a rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view thereof, a left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a bottle in accordance with a second embodiment of my new design, a rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;


FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view of the second embodiment, a left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,


FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the second embodiment.


The broken lines in the figures are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.





