The ornamental design for a vehicle charger, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a right side orthographic view thereof.

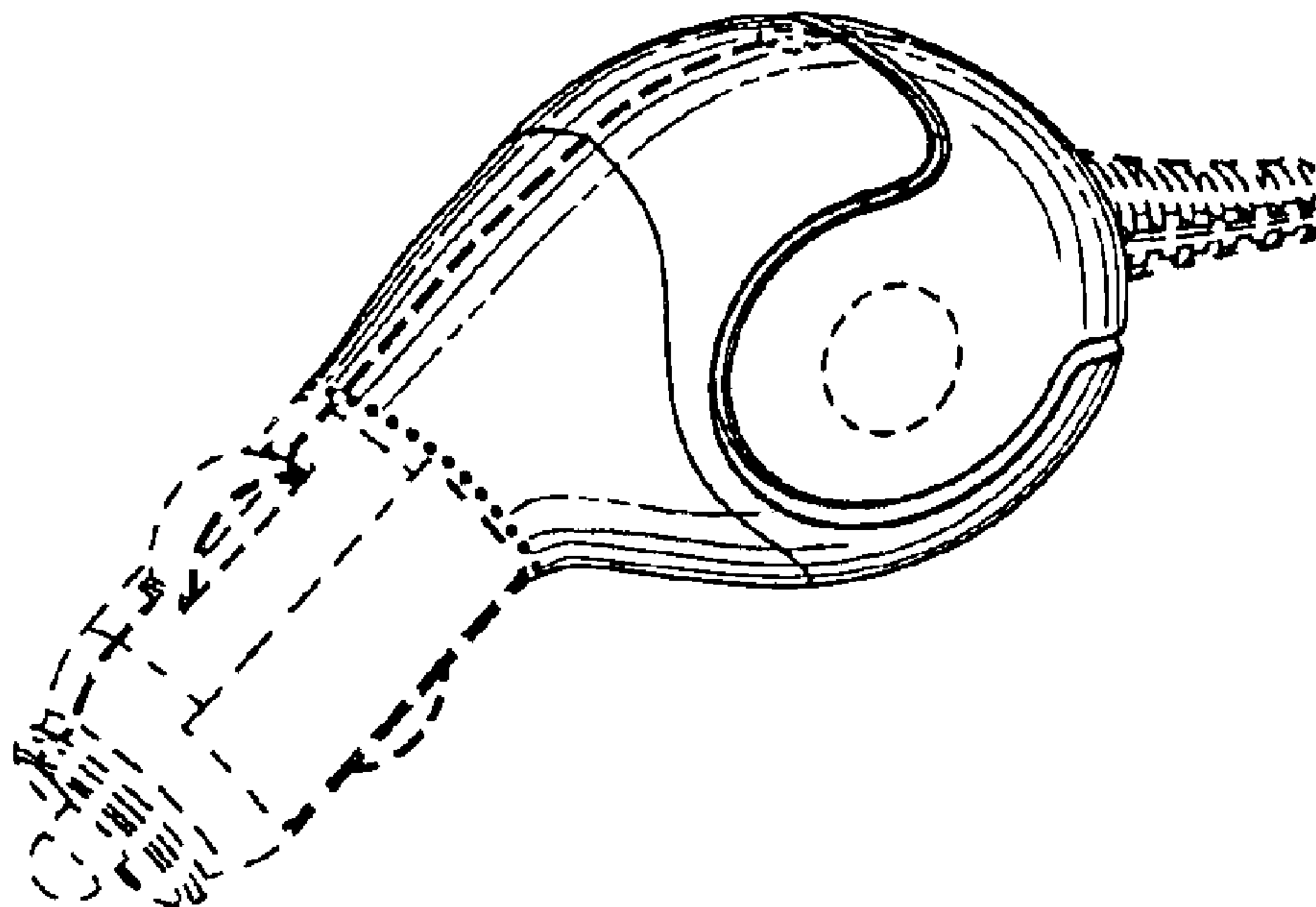
FIG. 6 is a top orthographic view thereof; and,

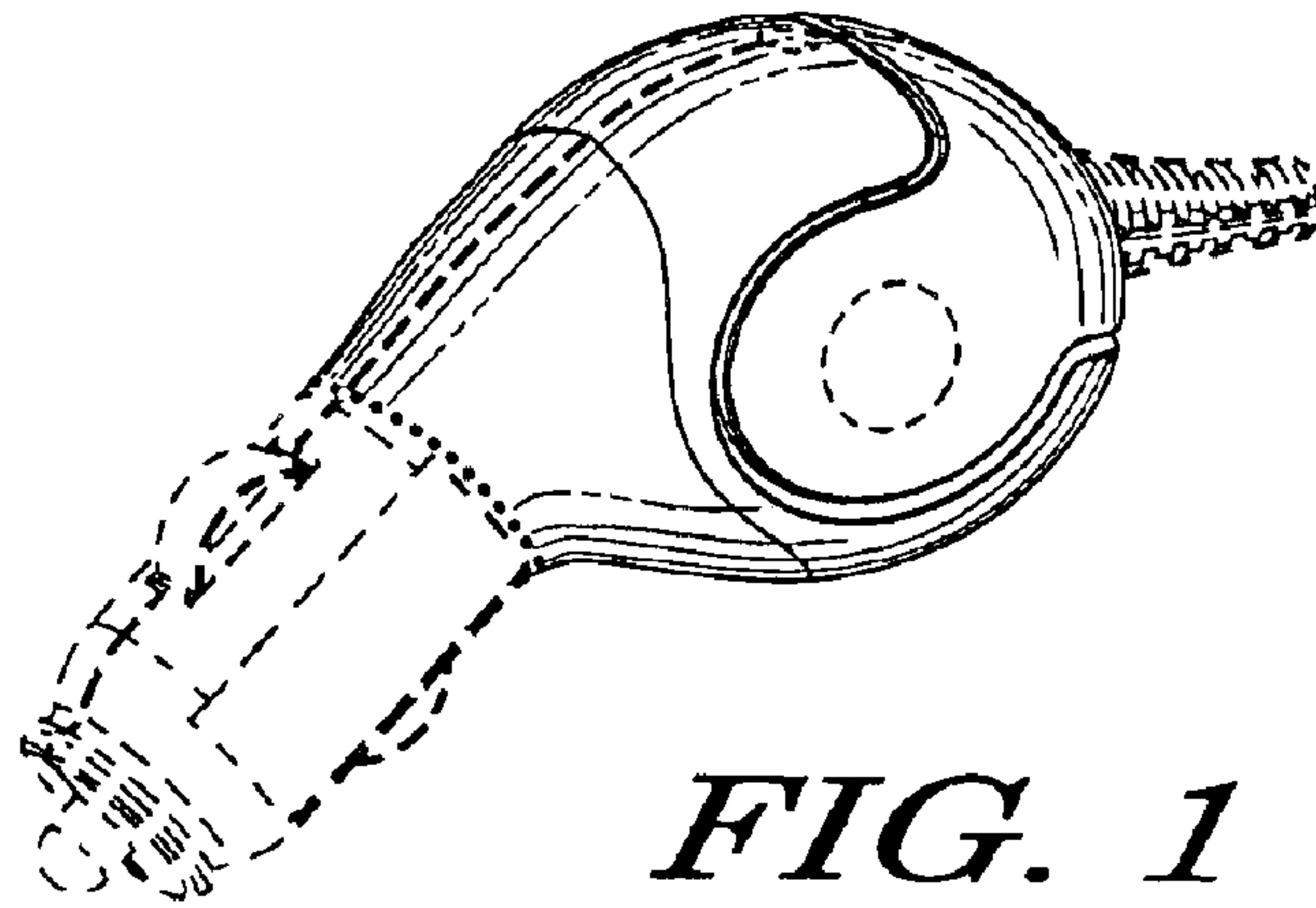

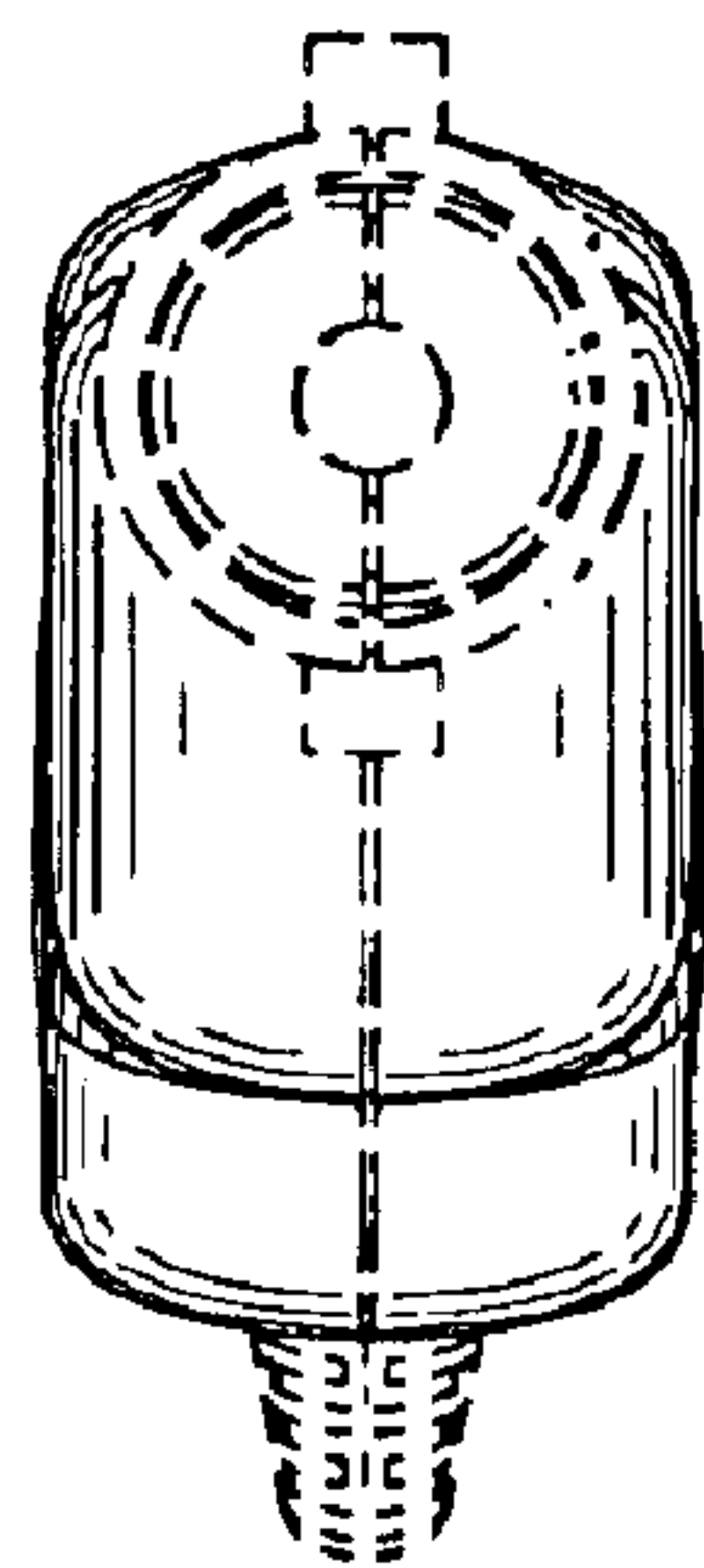

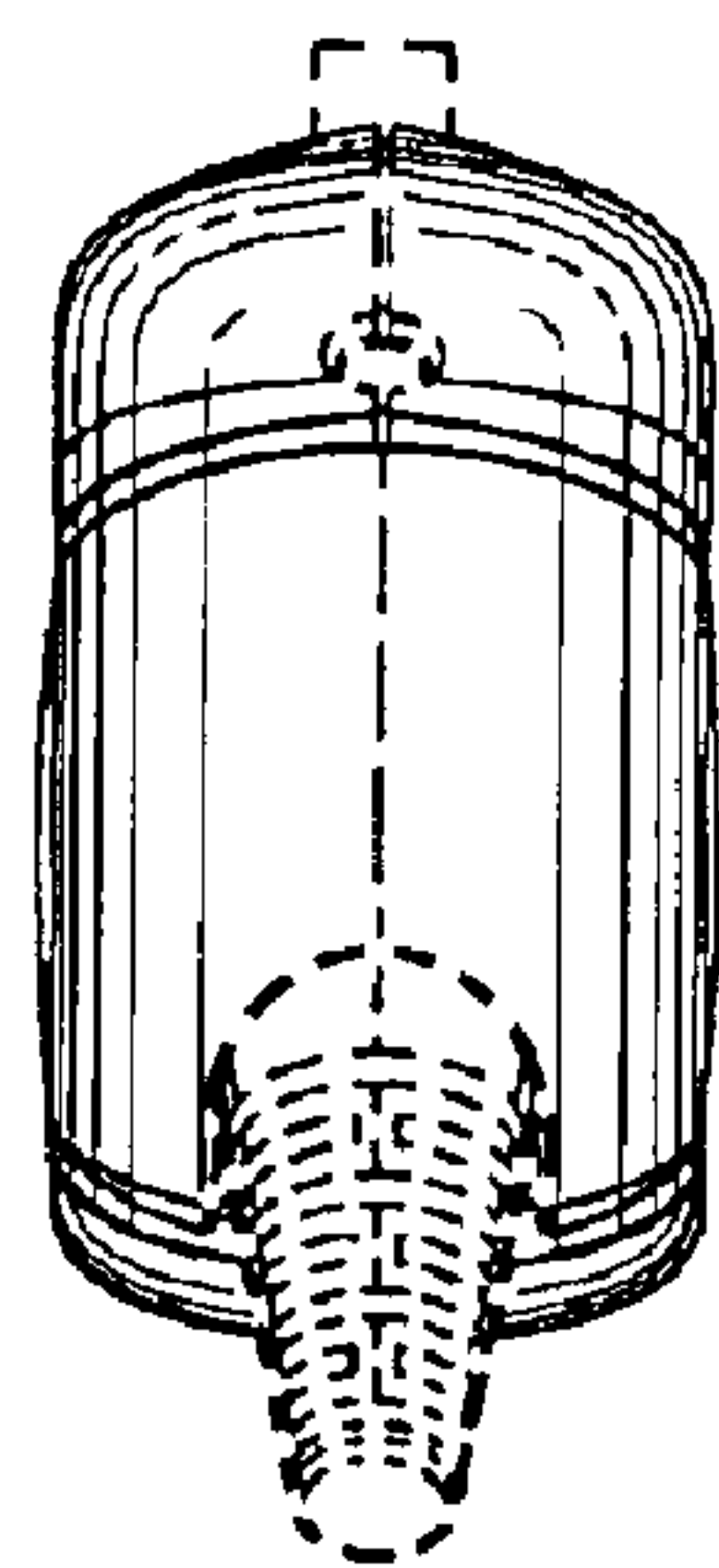

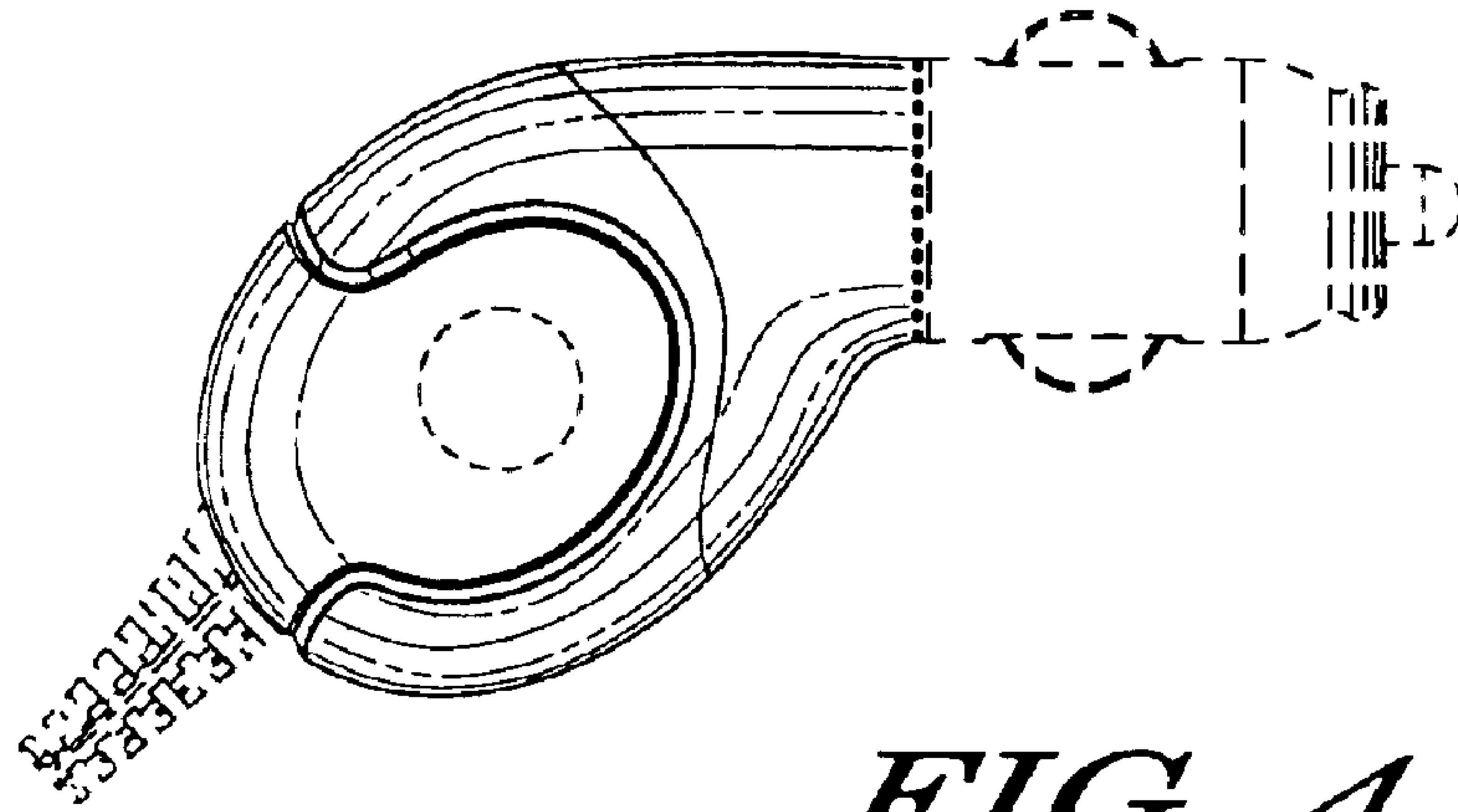

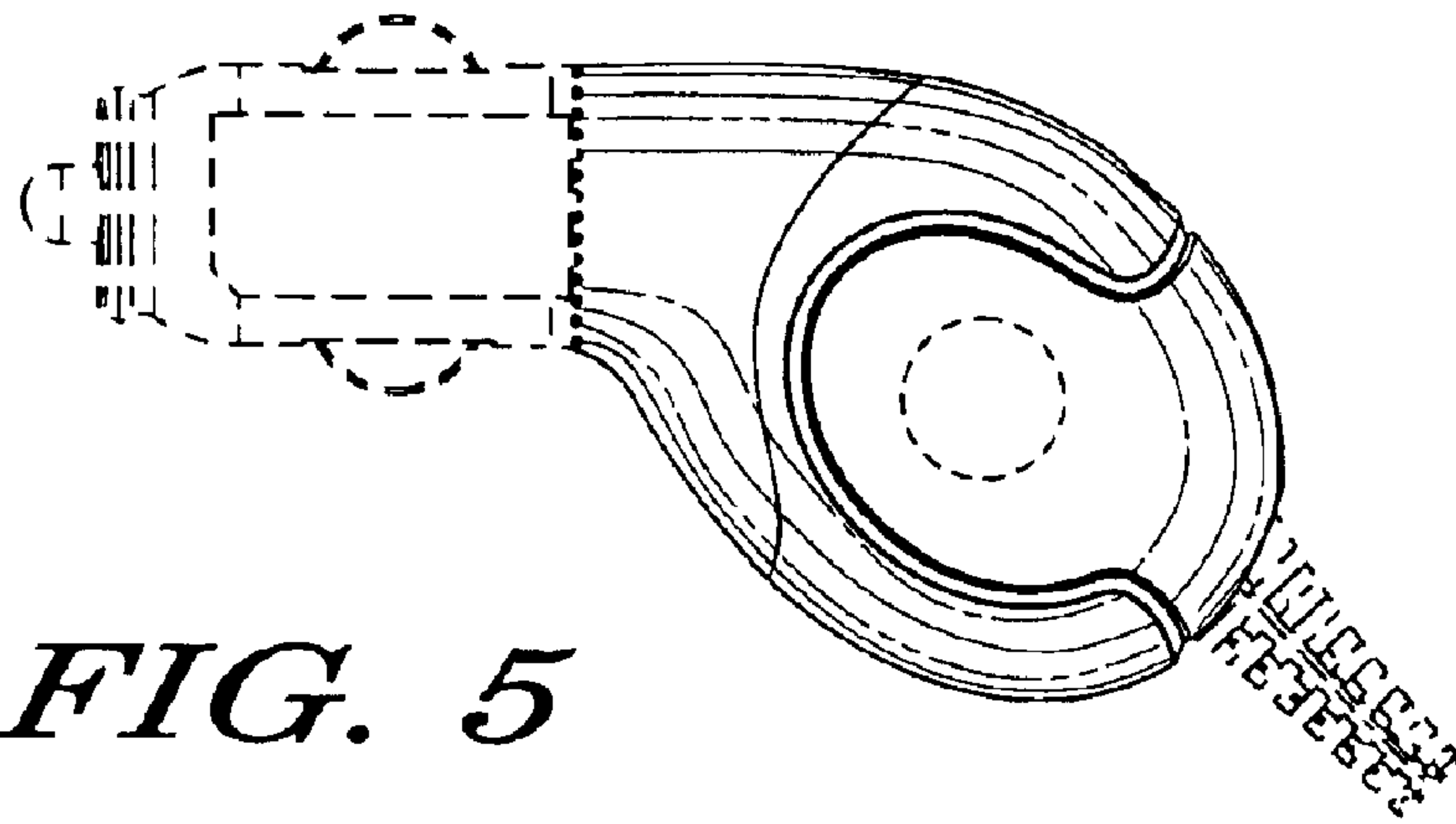

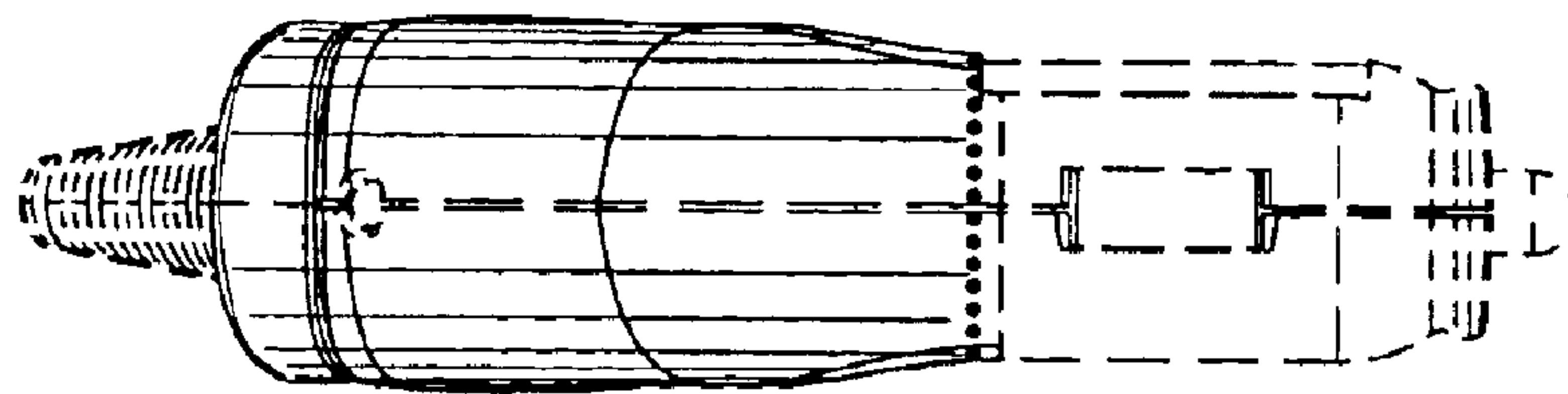

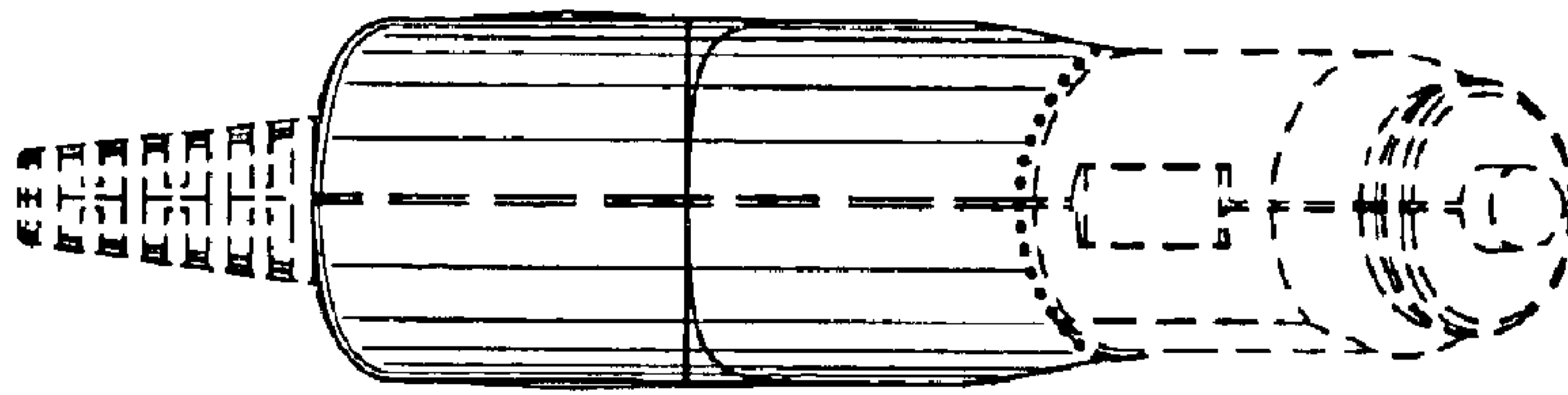
