part of the claimed design.

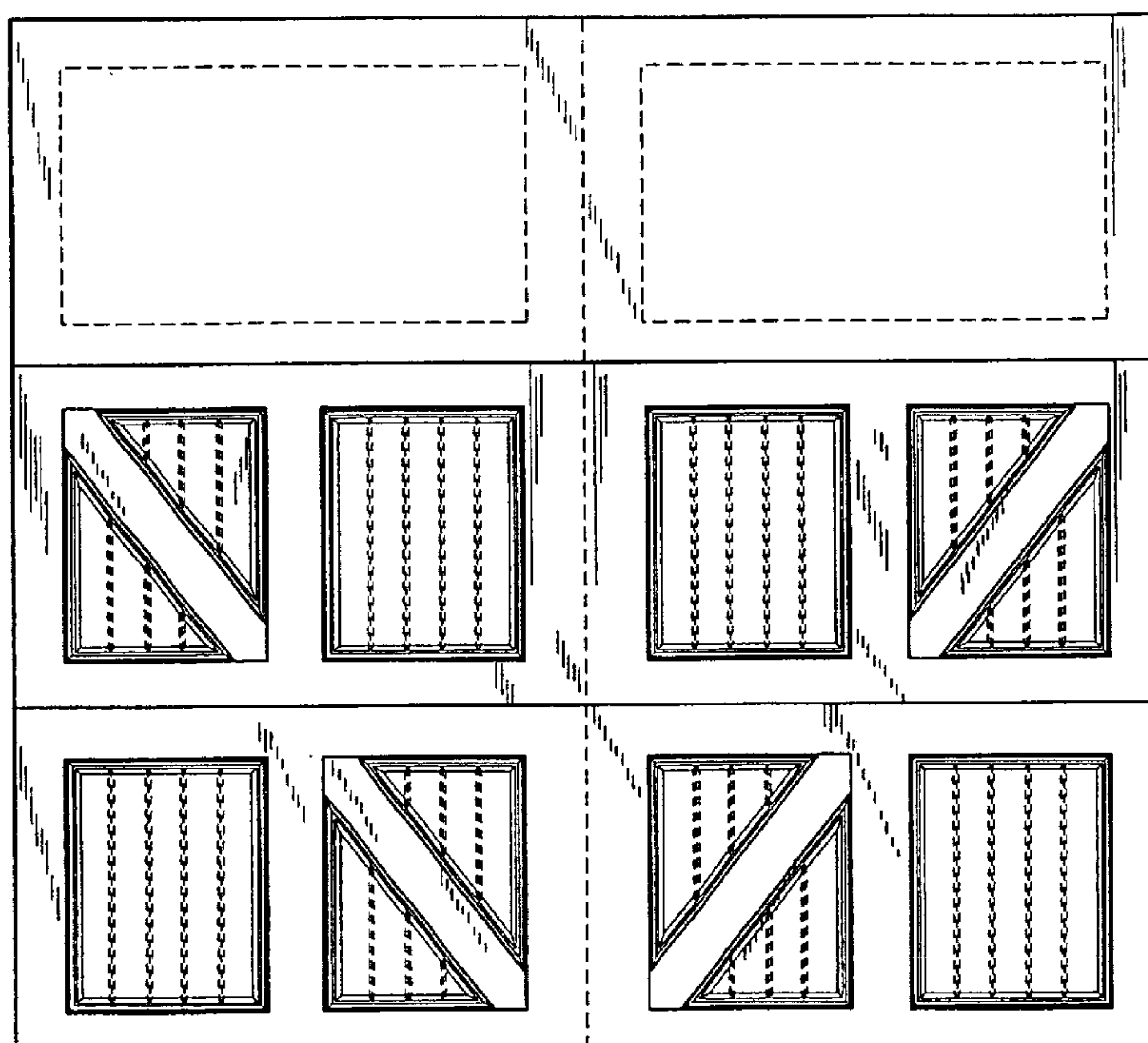
The broken lines depicting various ornamental and func-

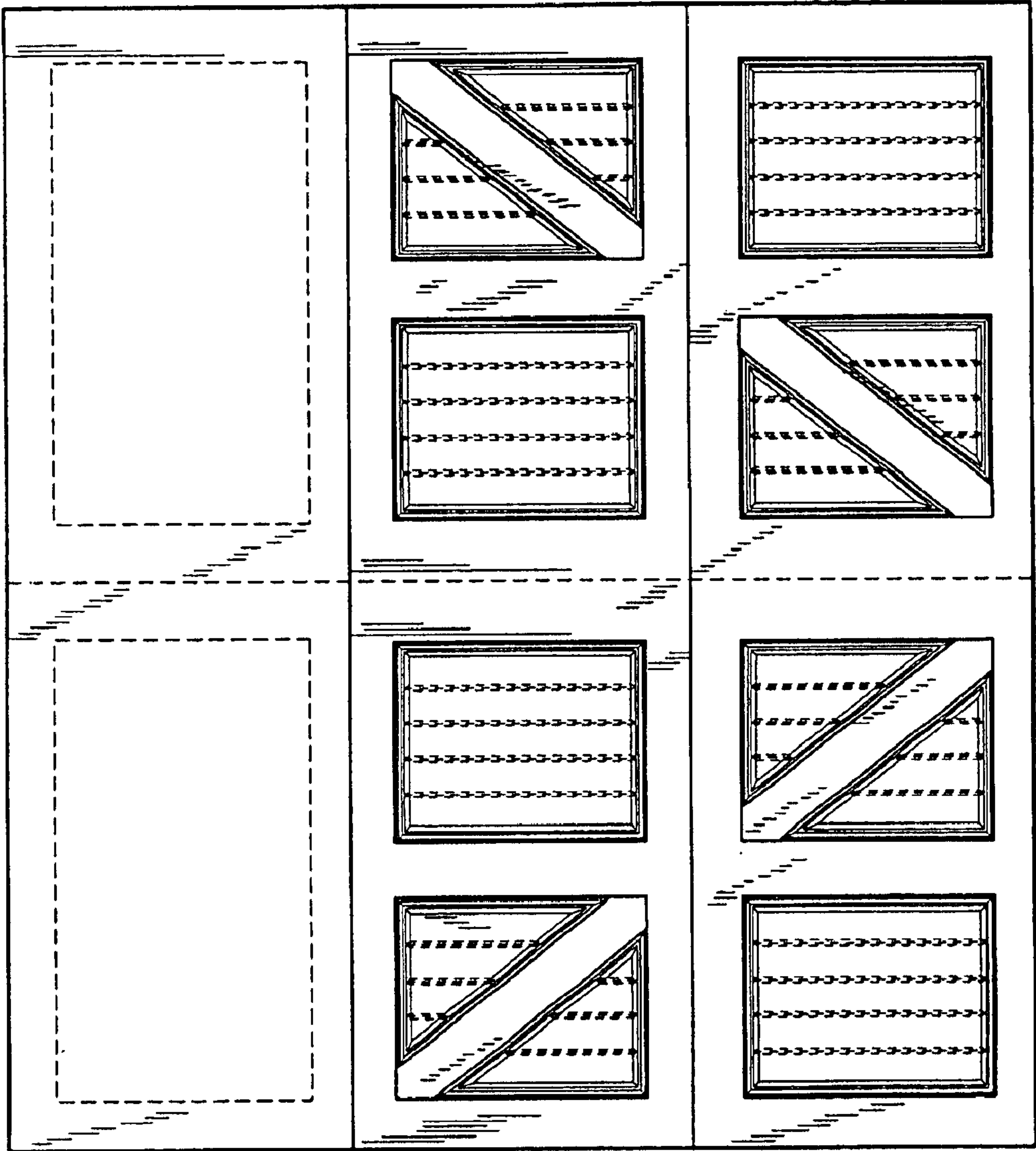

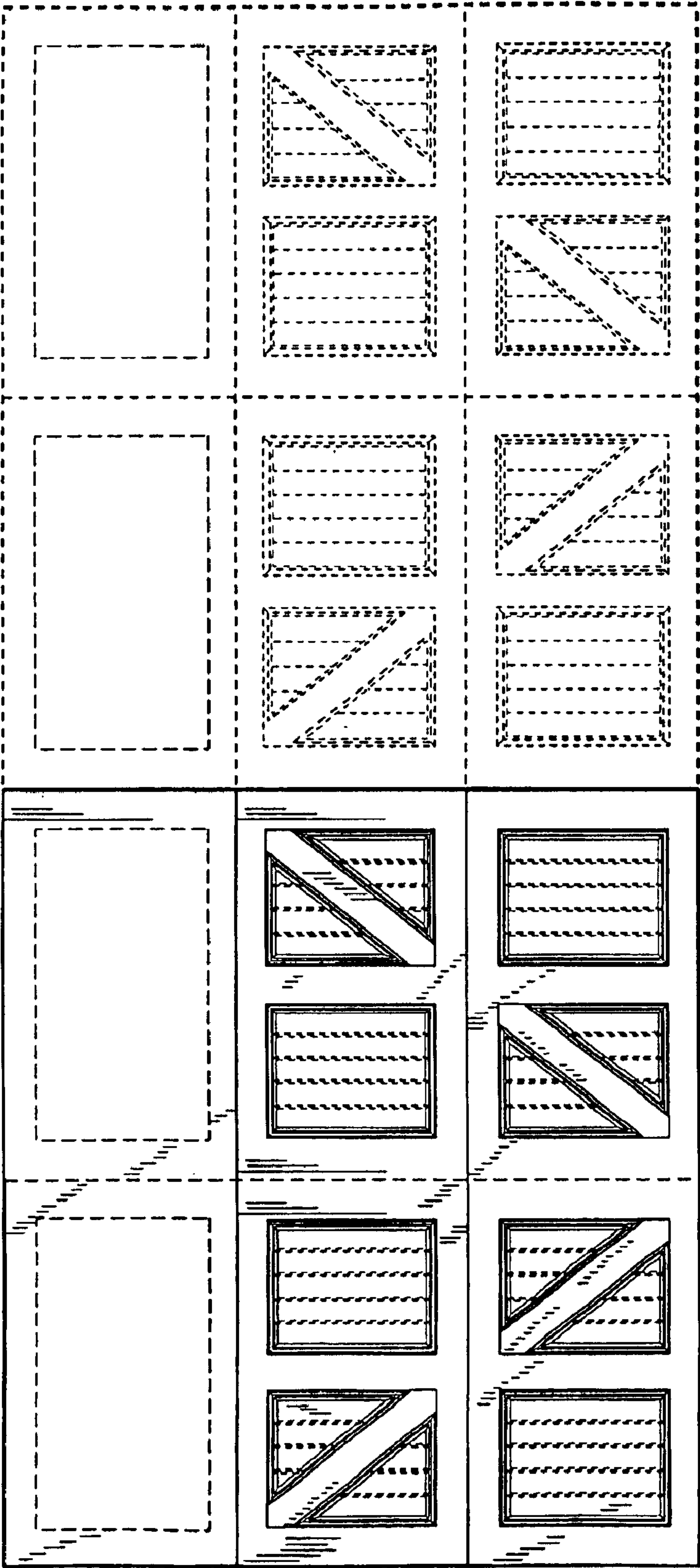
