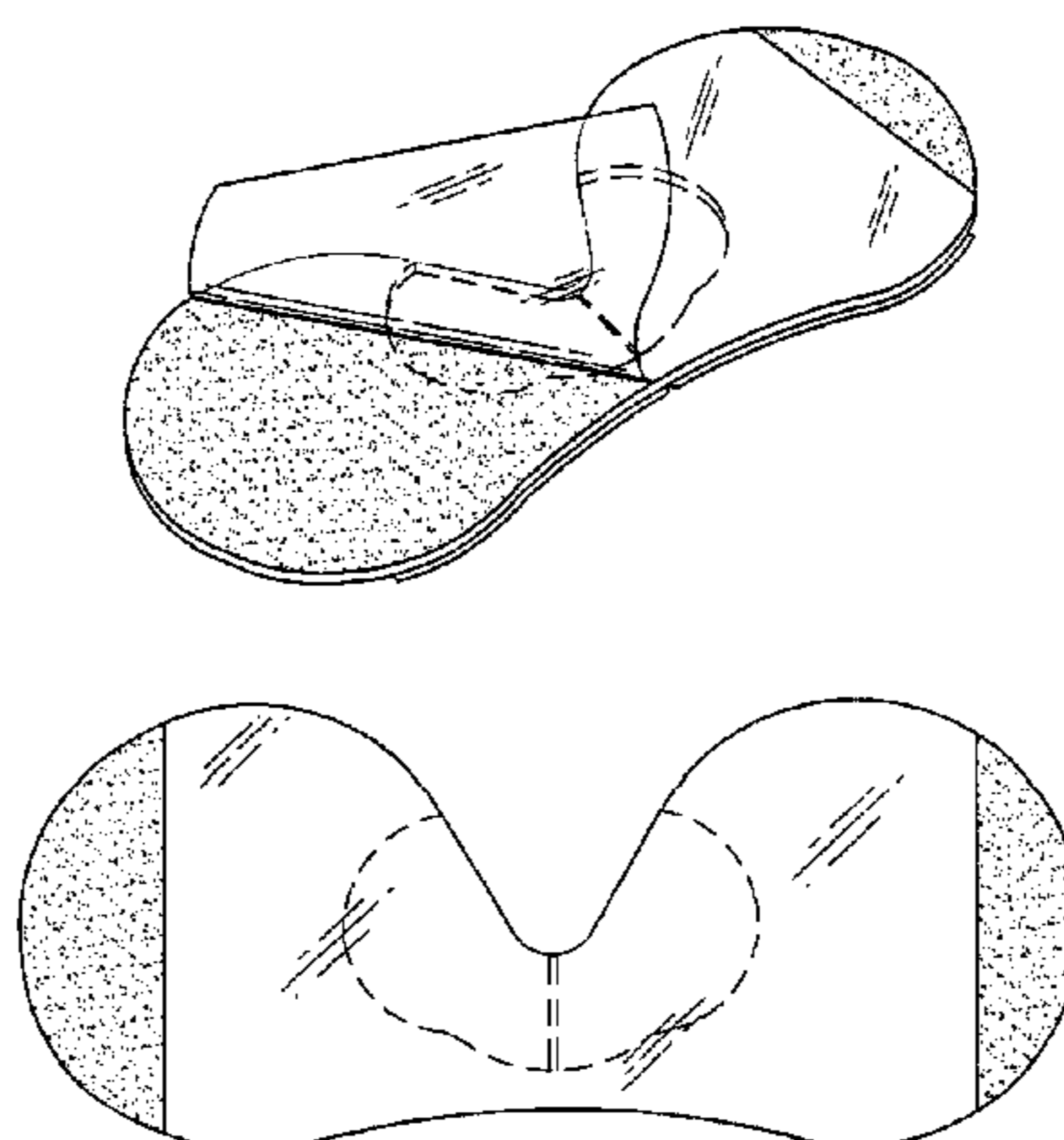
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an anchor pad, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an anchor pad configured in accordance with a preferred embodiment of the present invention, with the broken line showing for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, with the release layer shown in slightly raised condition; FIG. 3 is a top elevational view thereof, with the broken line showing for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 4 is a bottom elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.

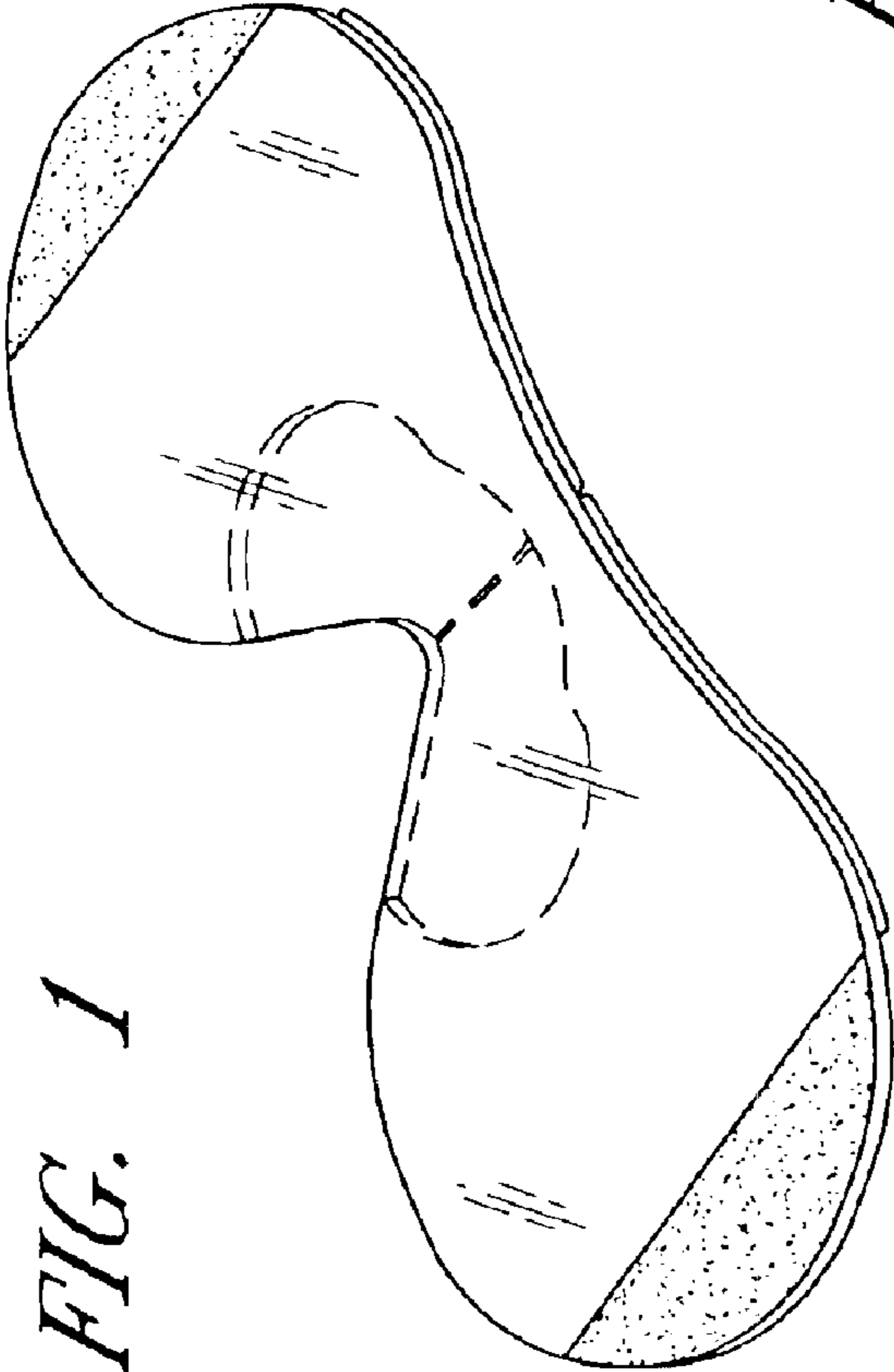

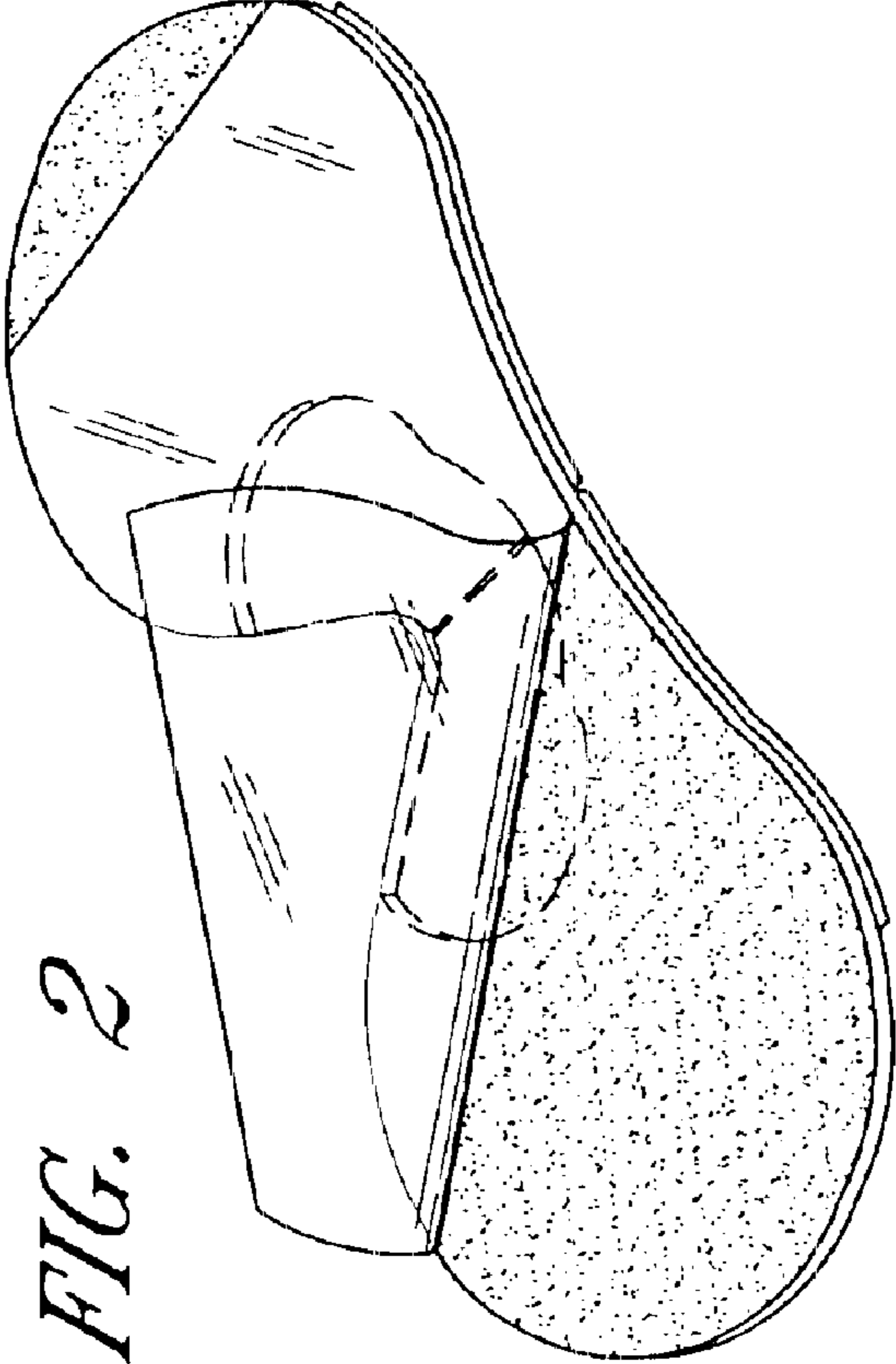

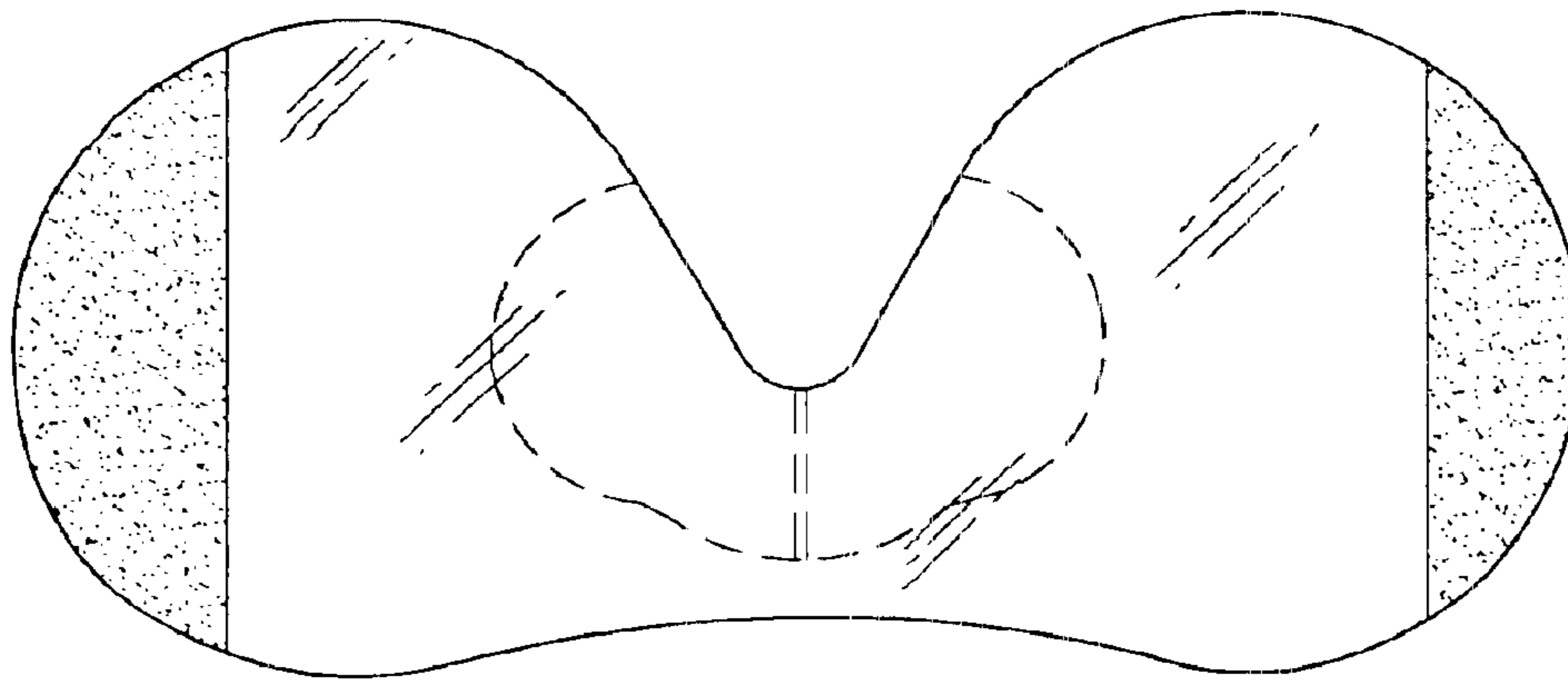

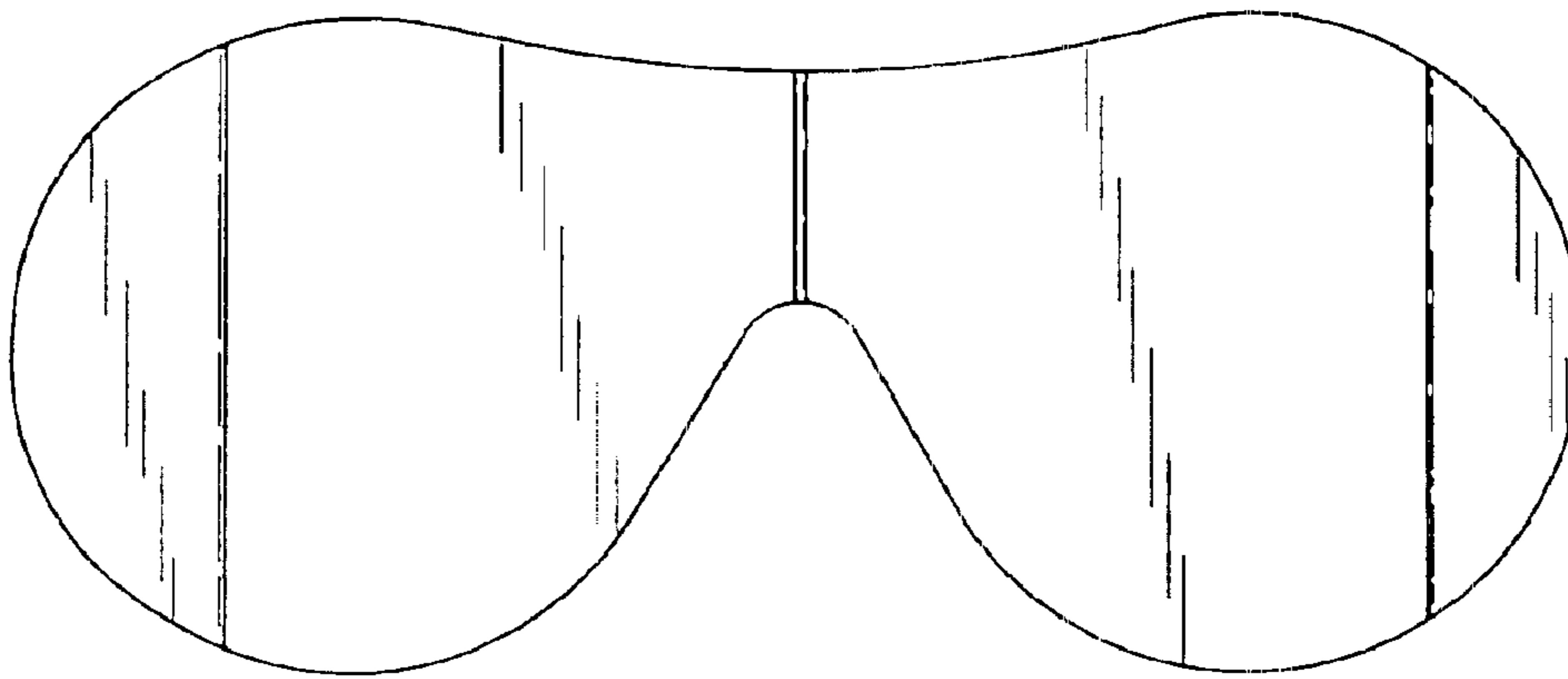

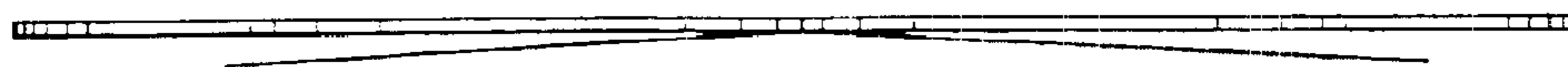

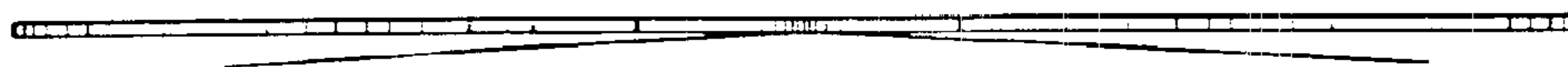

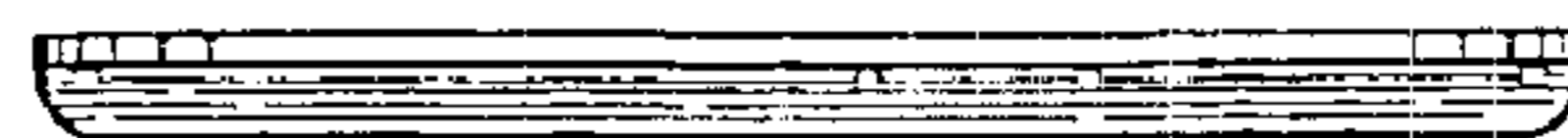
