FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

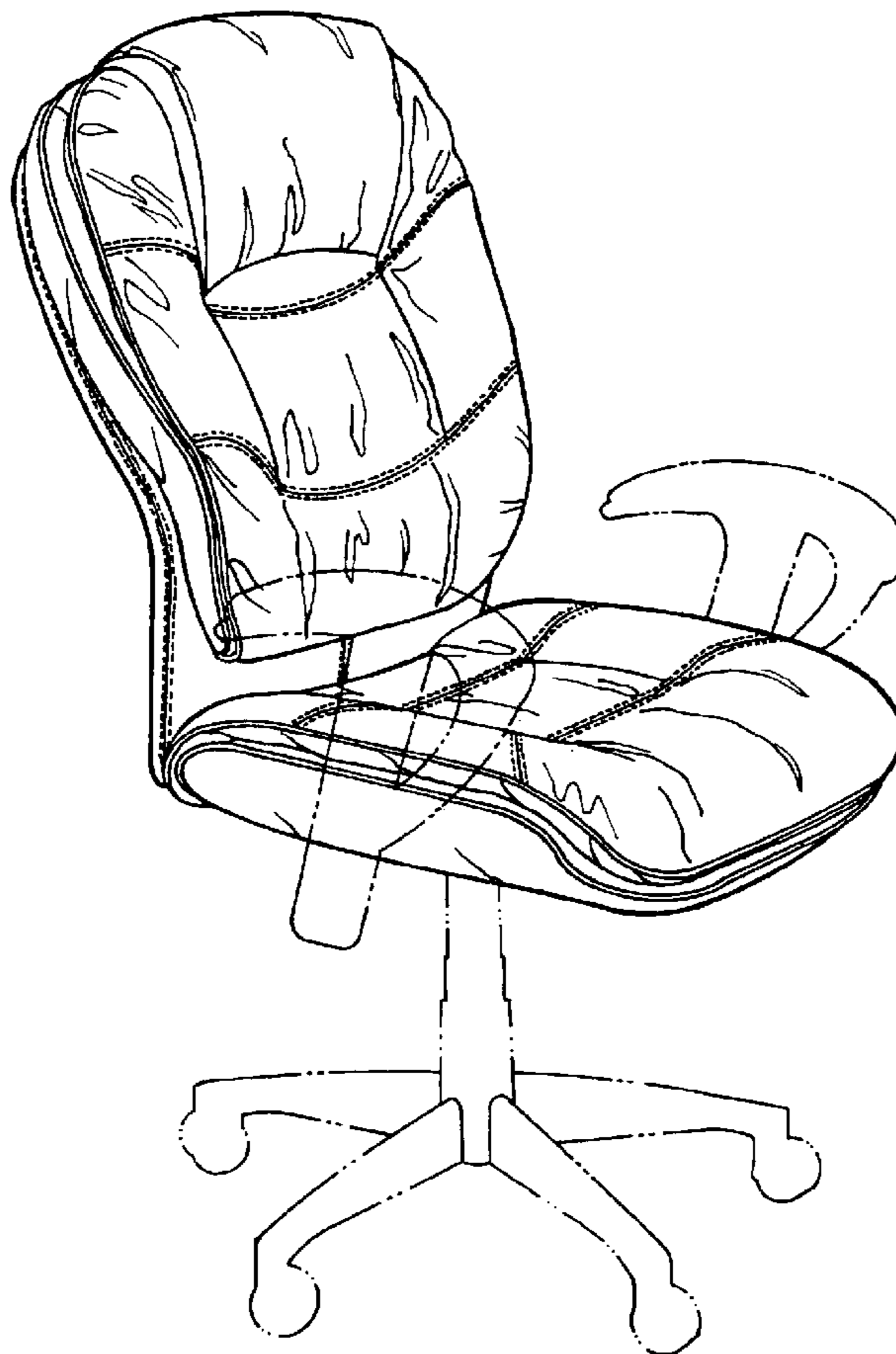
The short broken lines shown on the seat and back rest along seam lines in FIGS. 1 through 5 are understood to represent stitching.

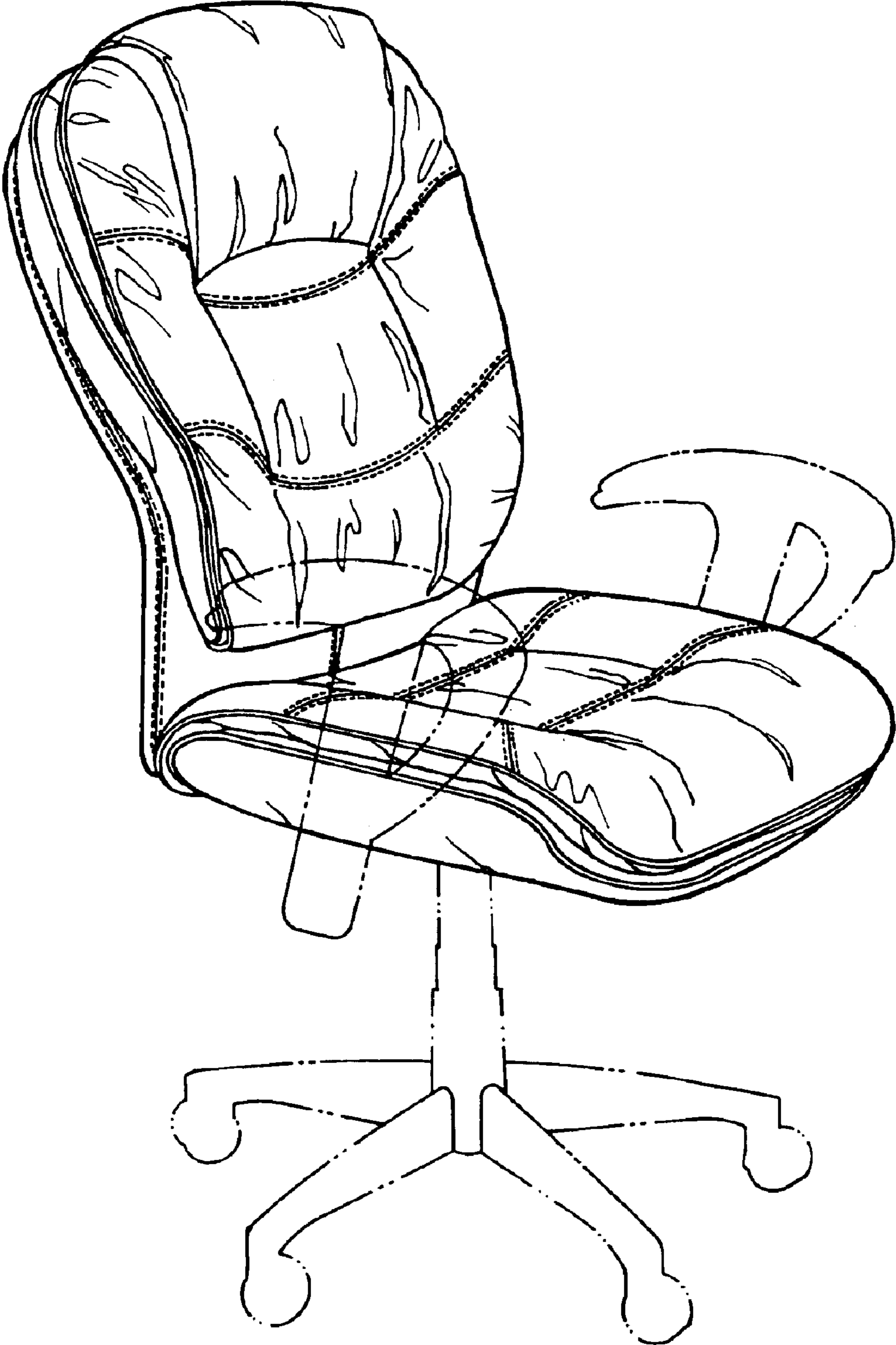

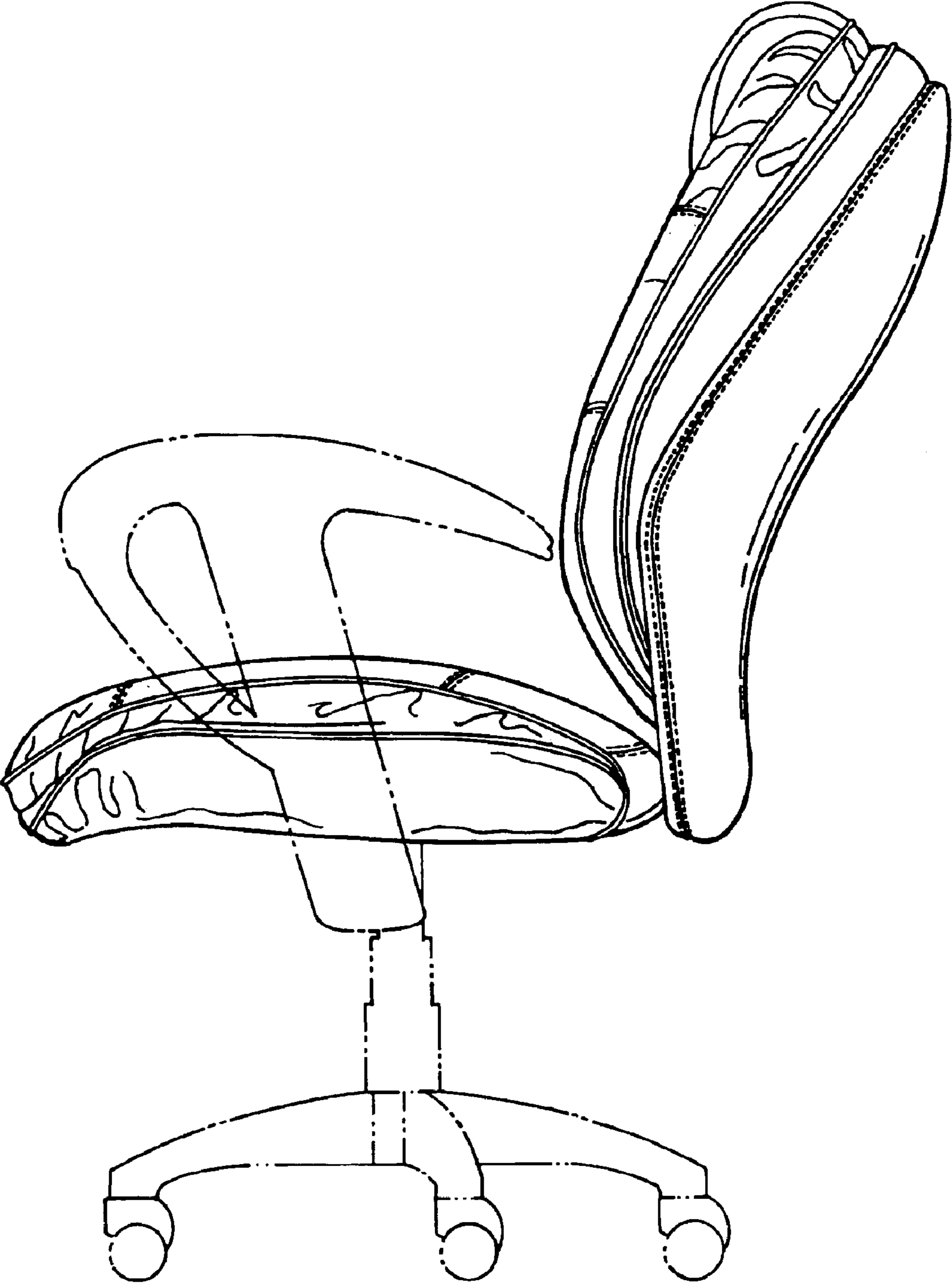

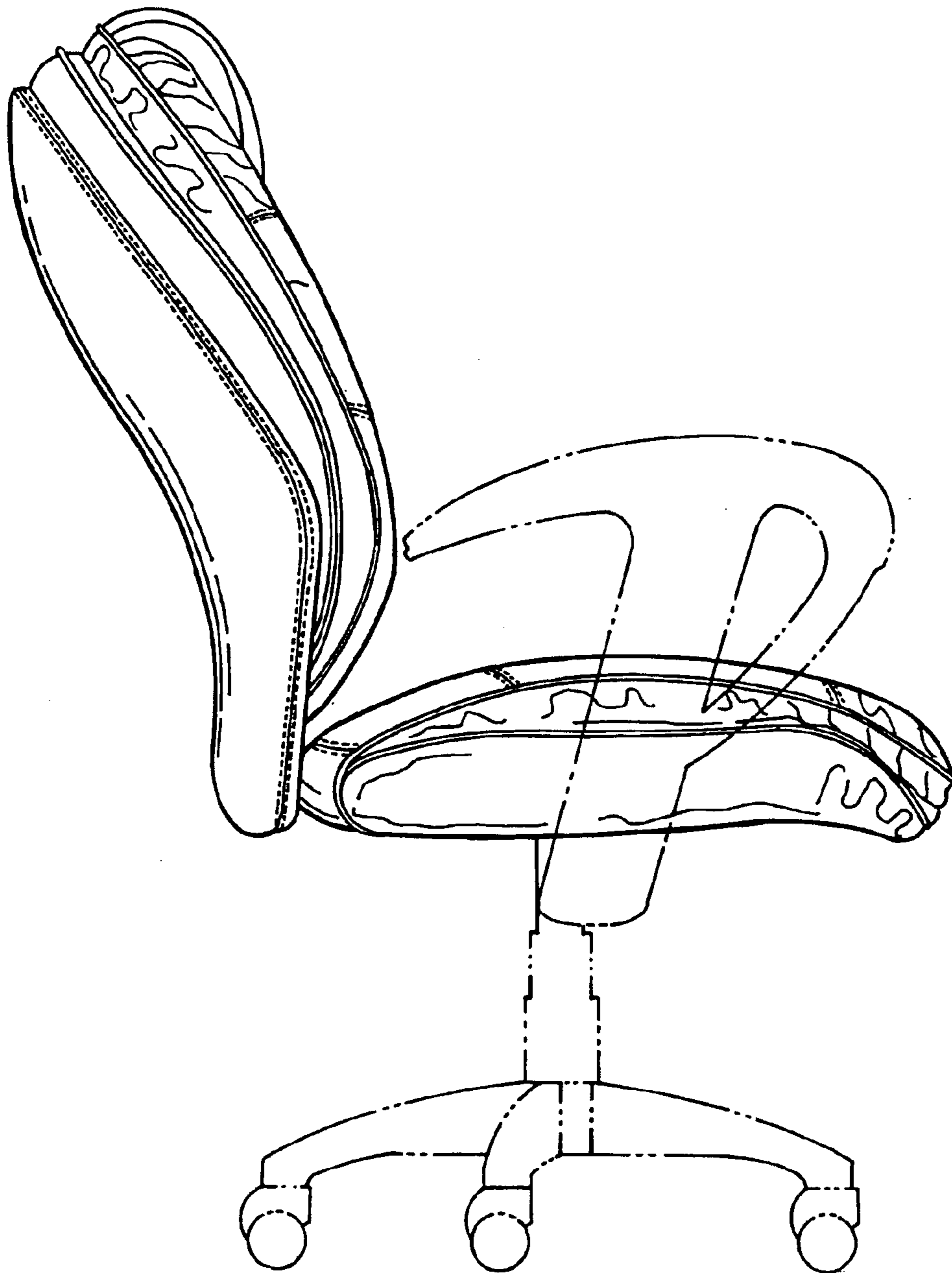

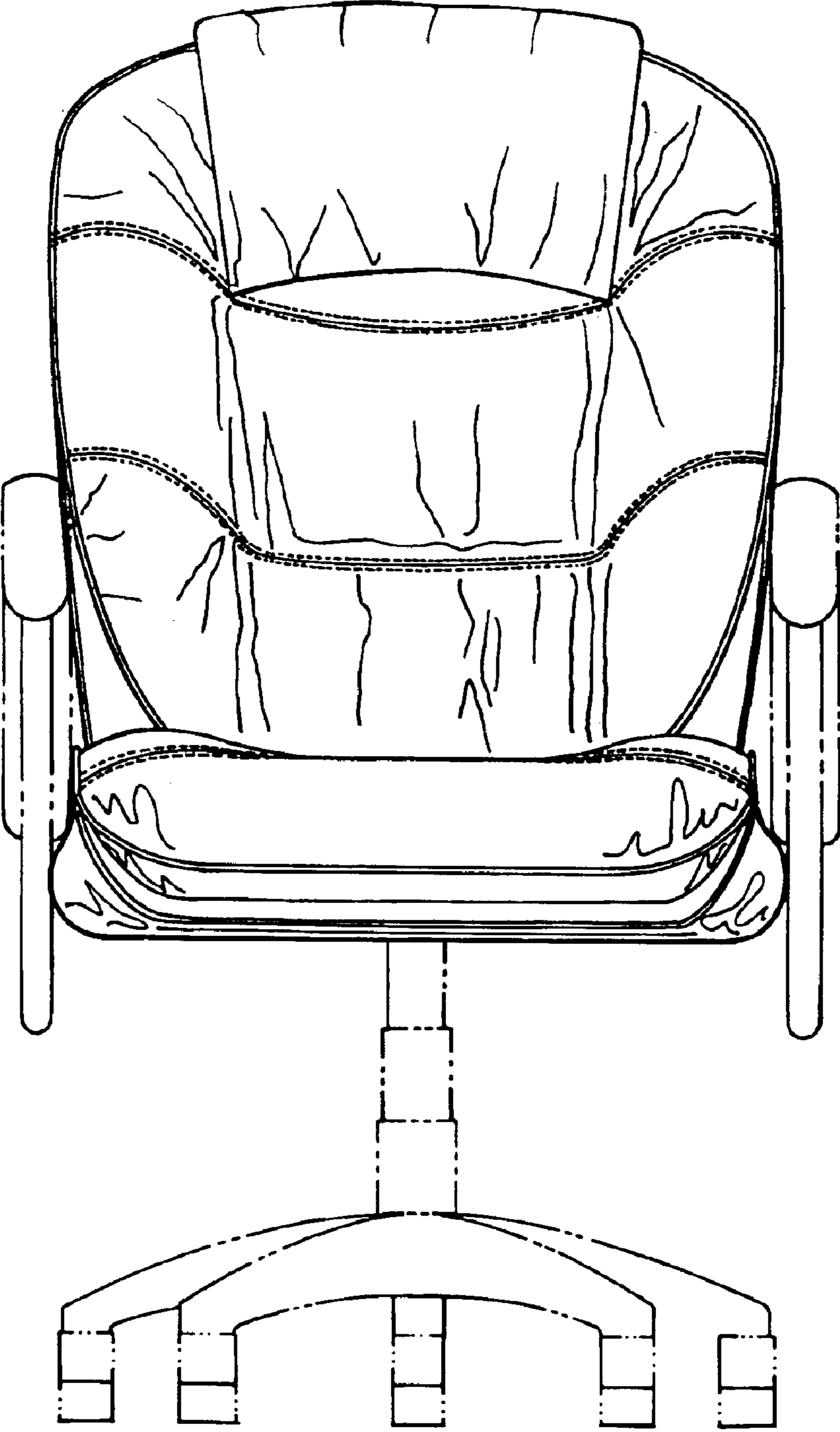

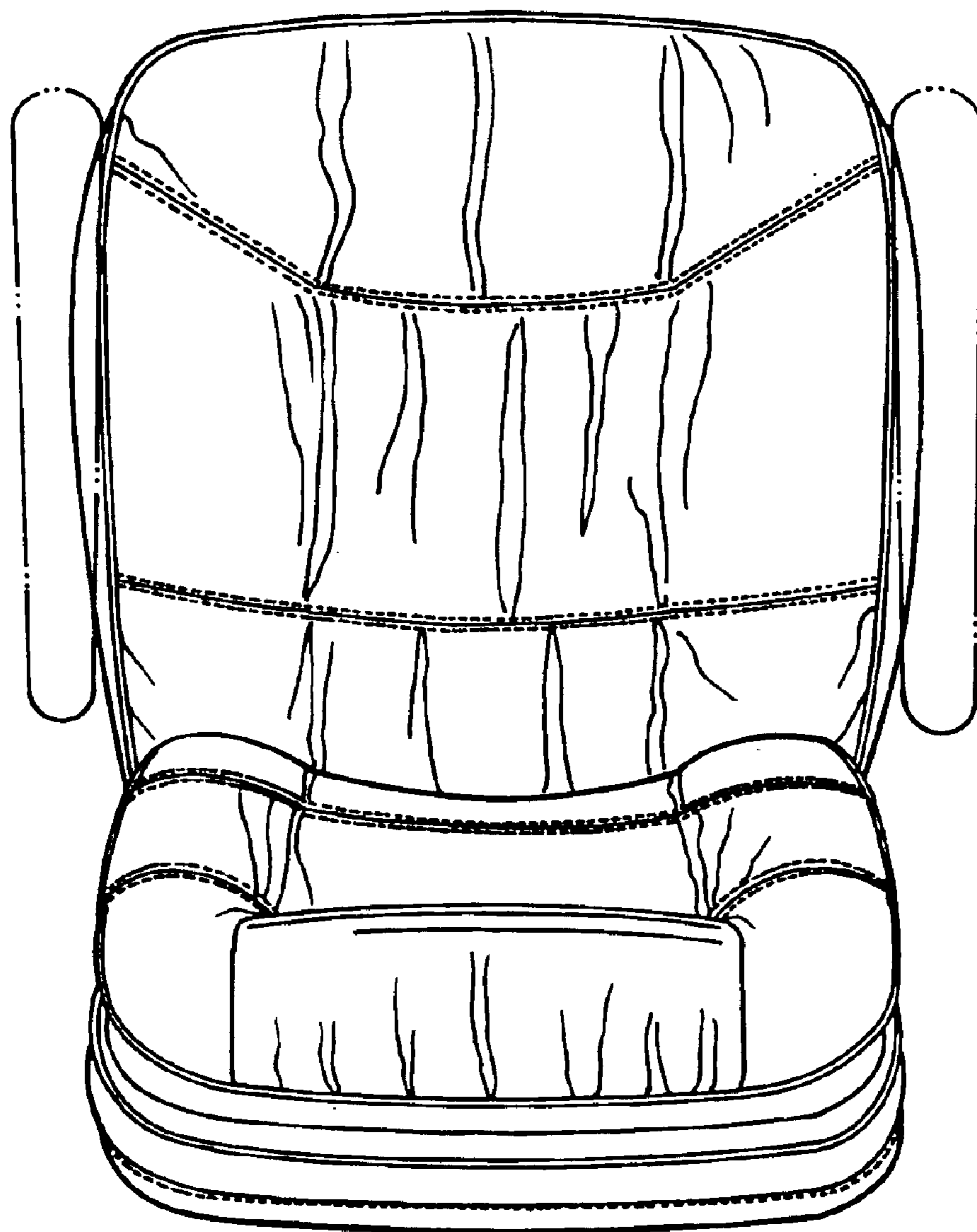

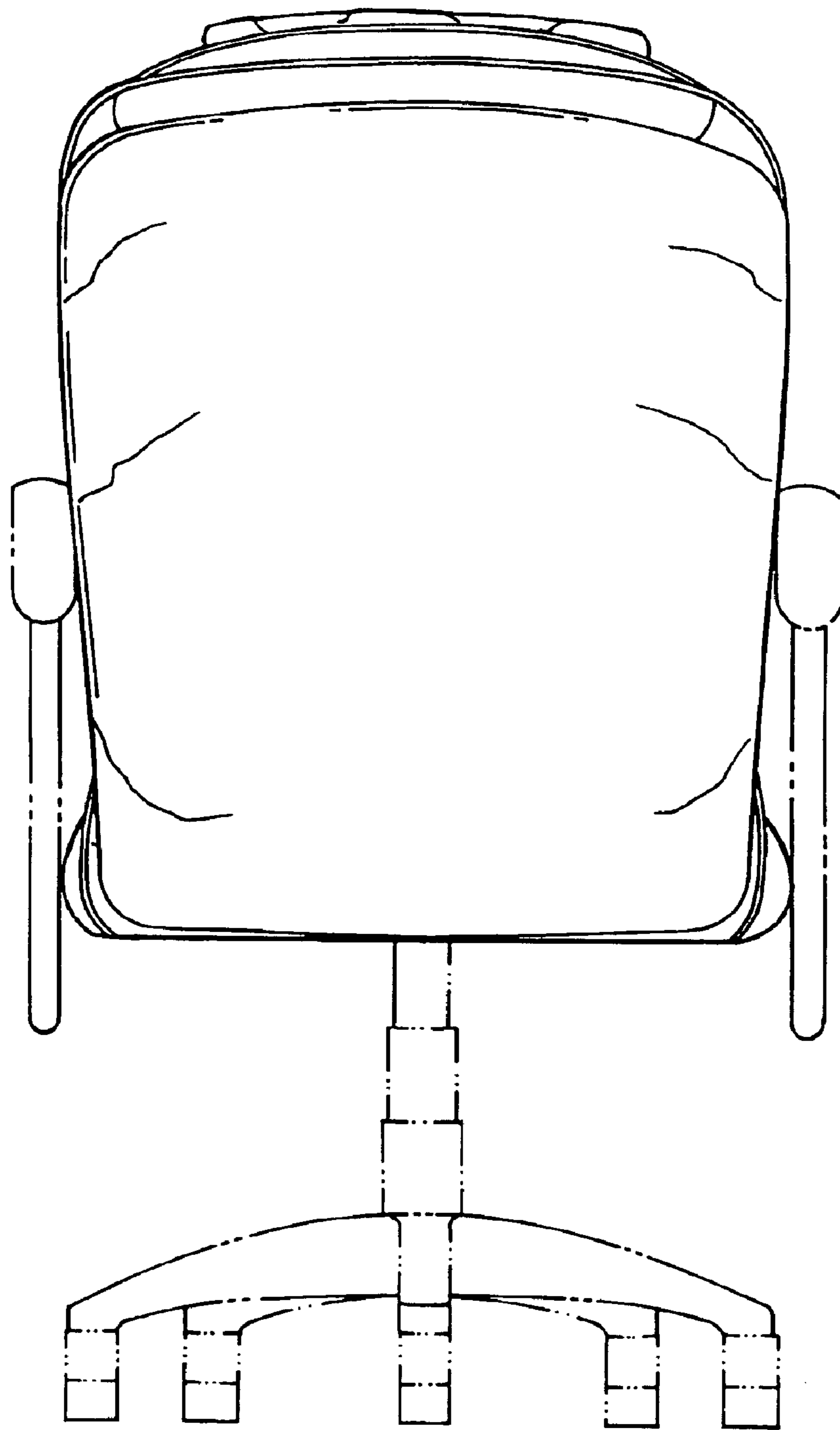
