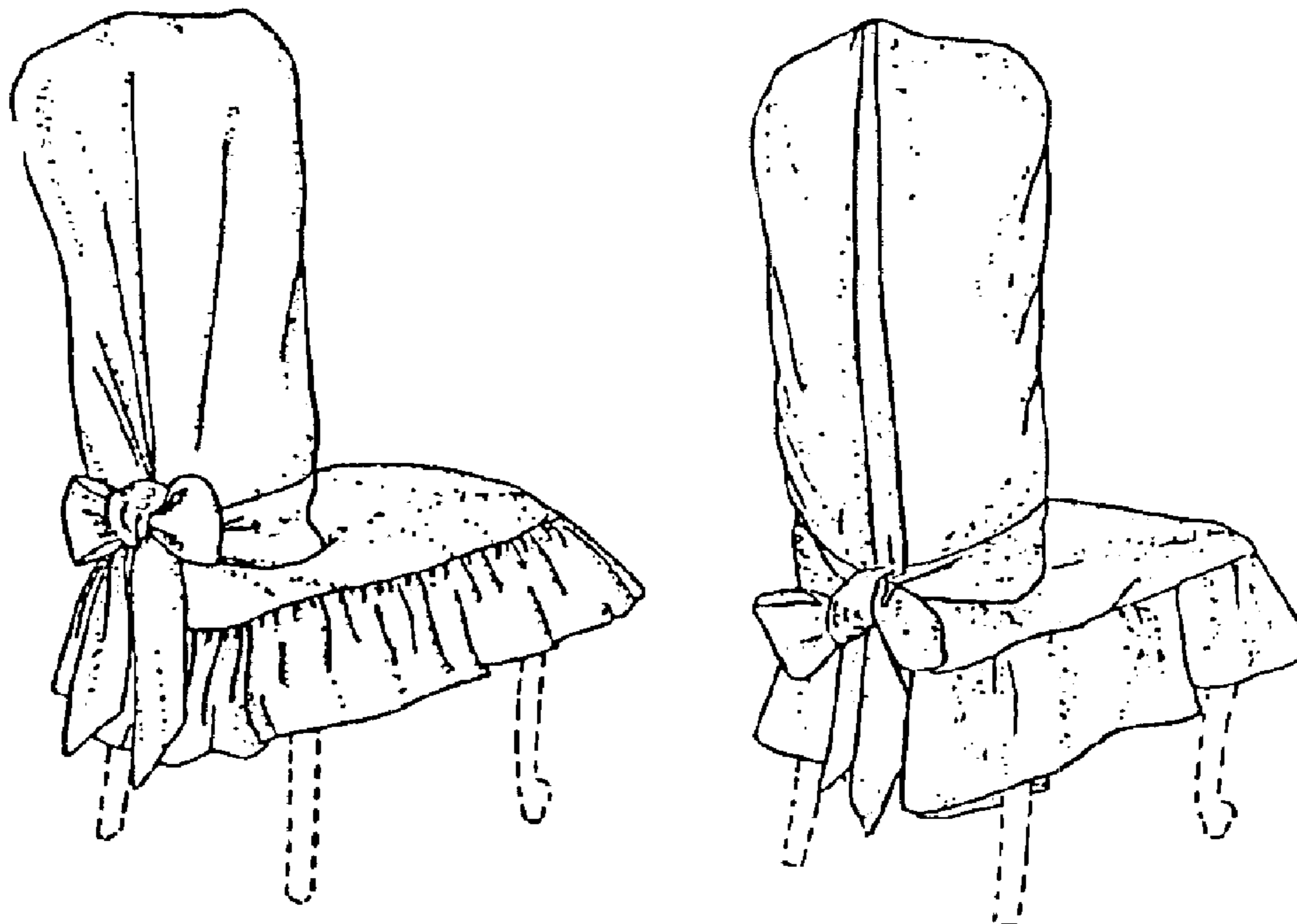

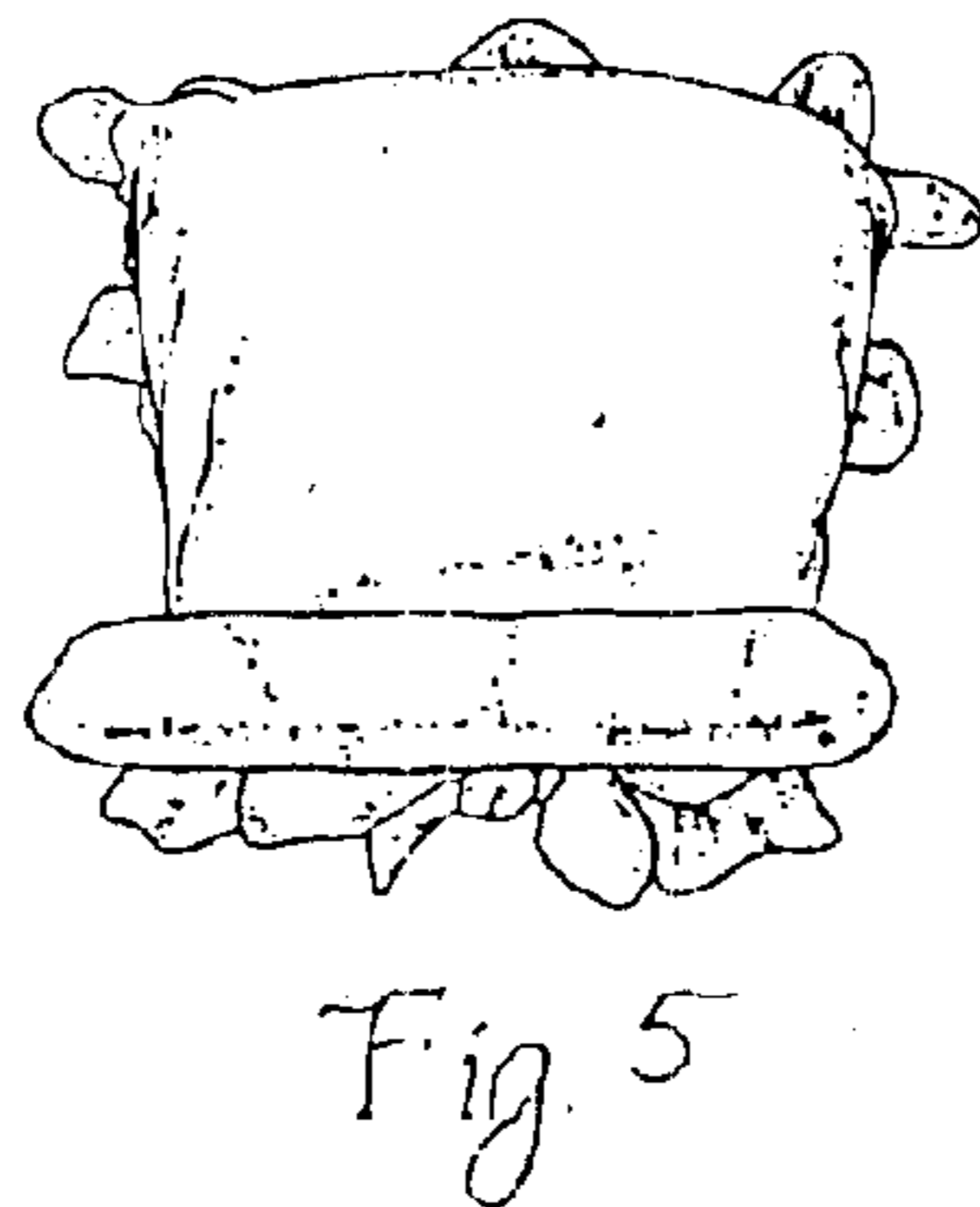
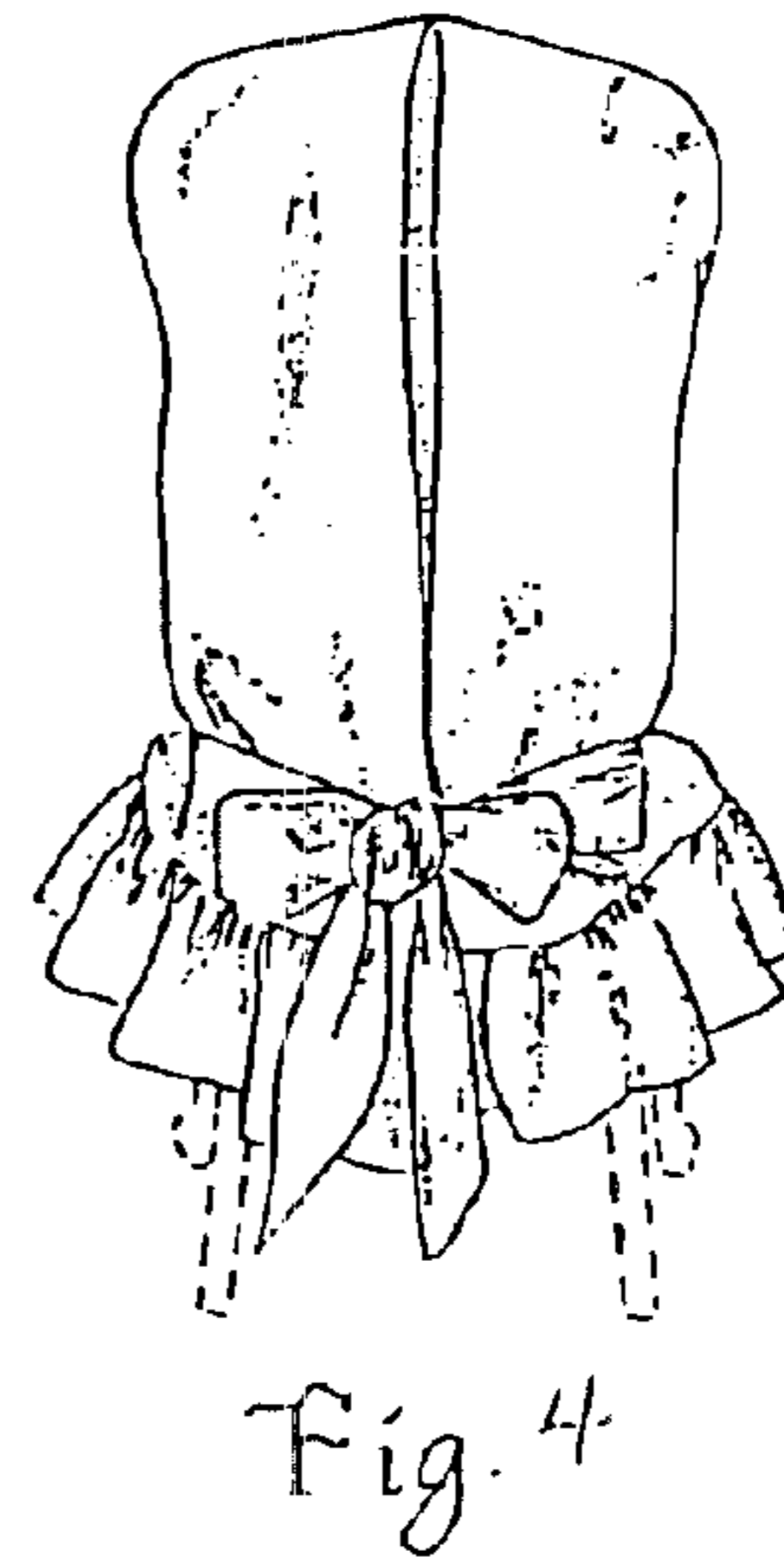
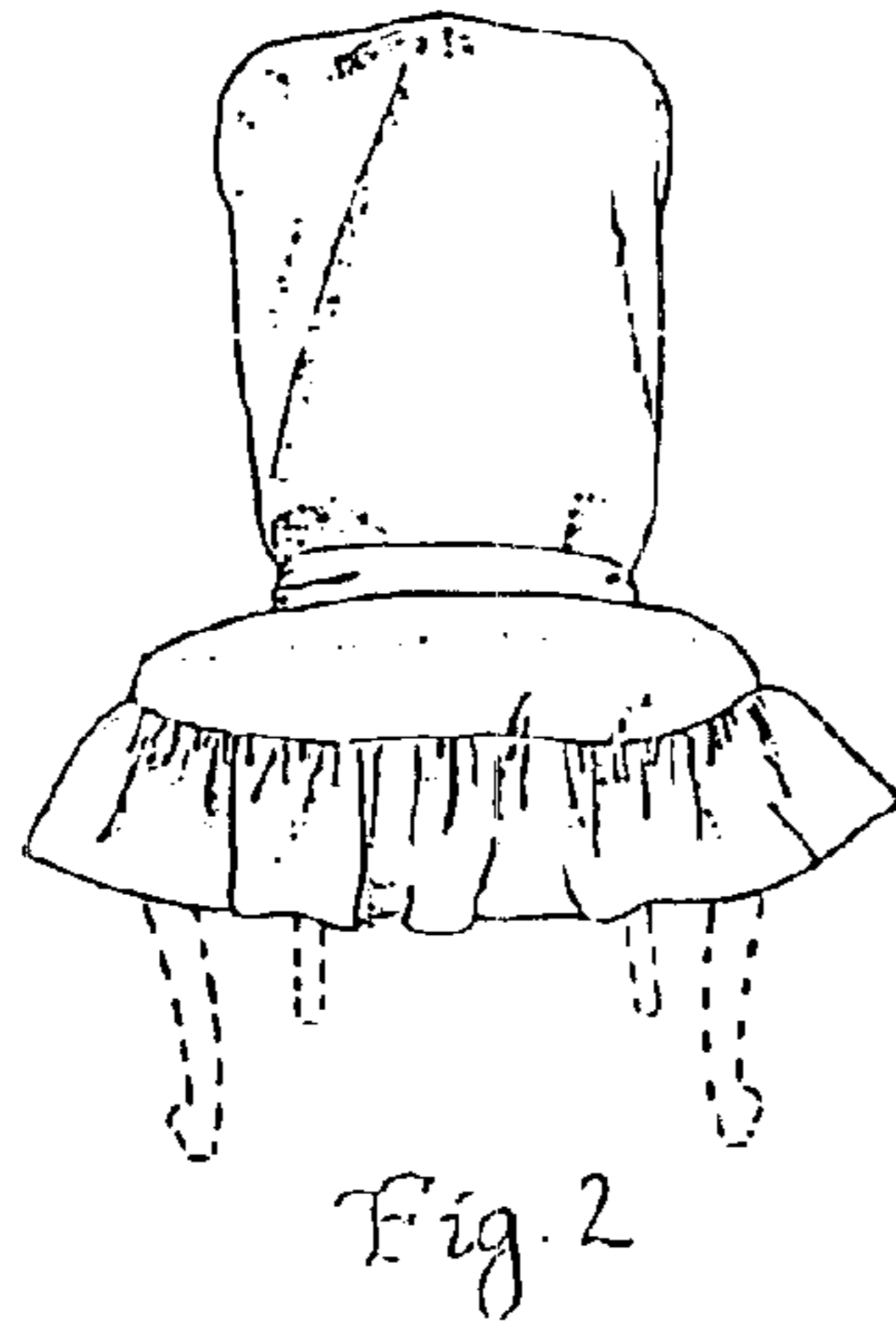
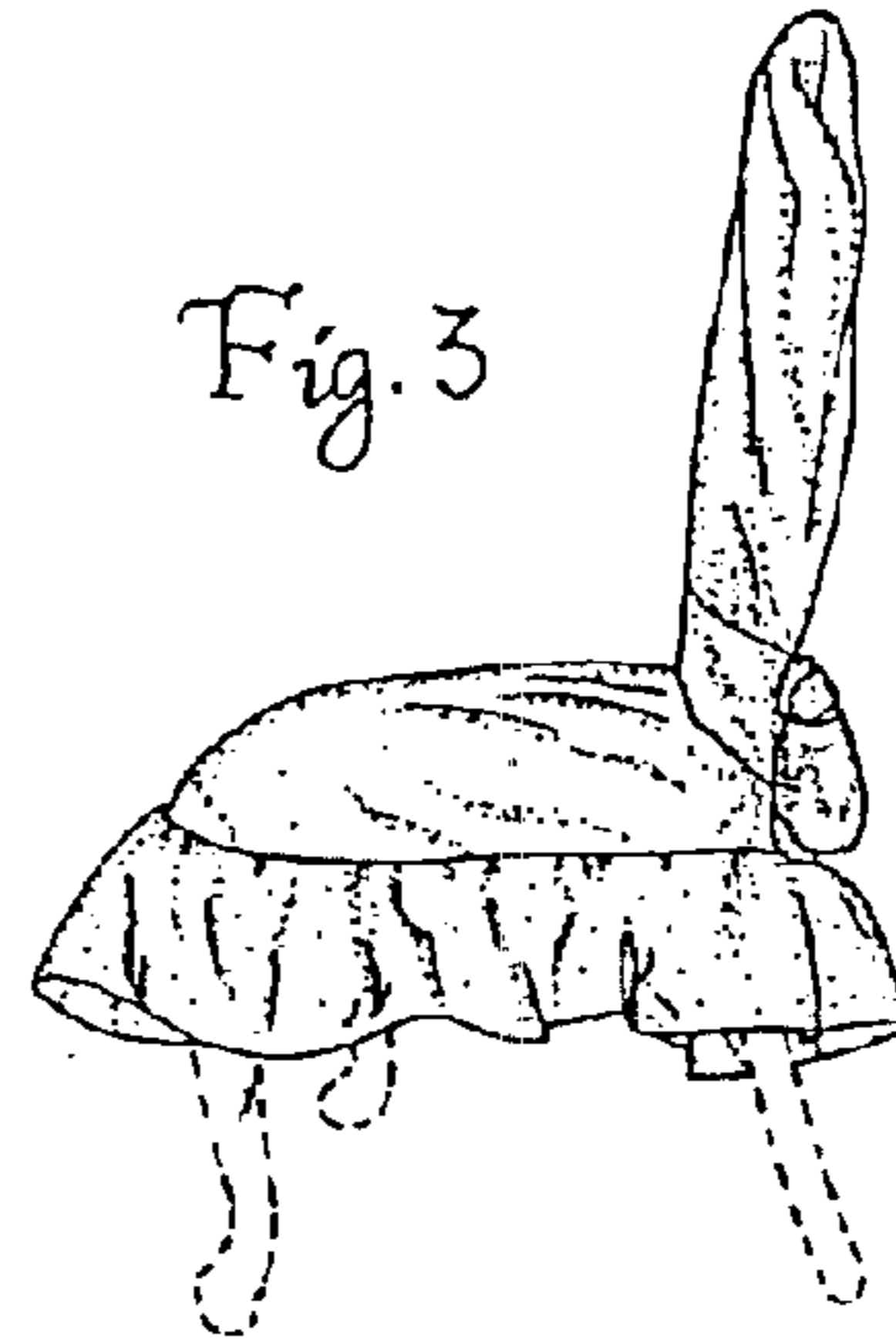
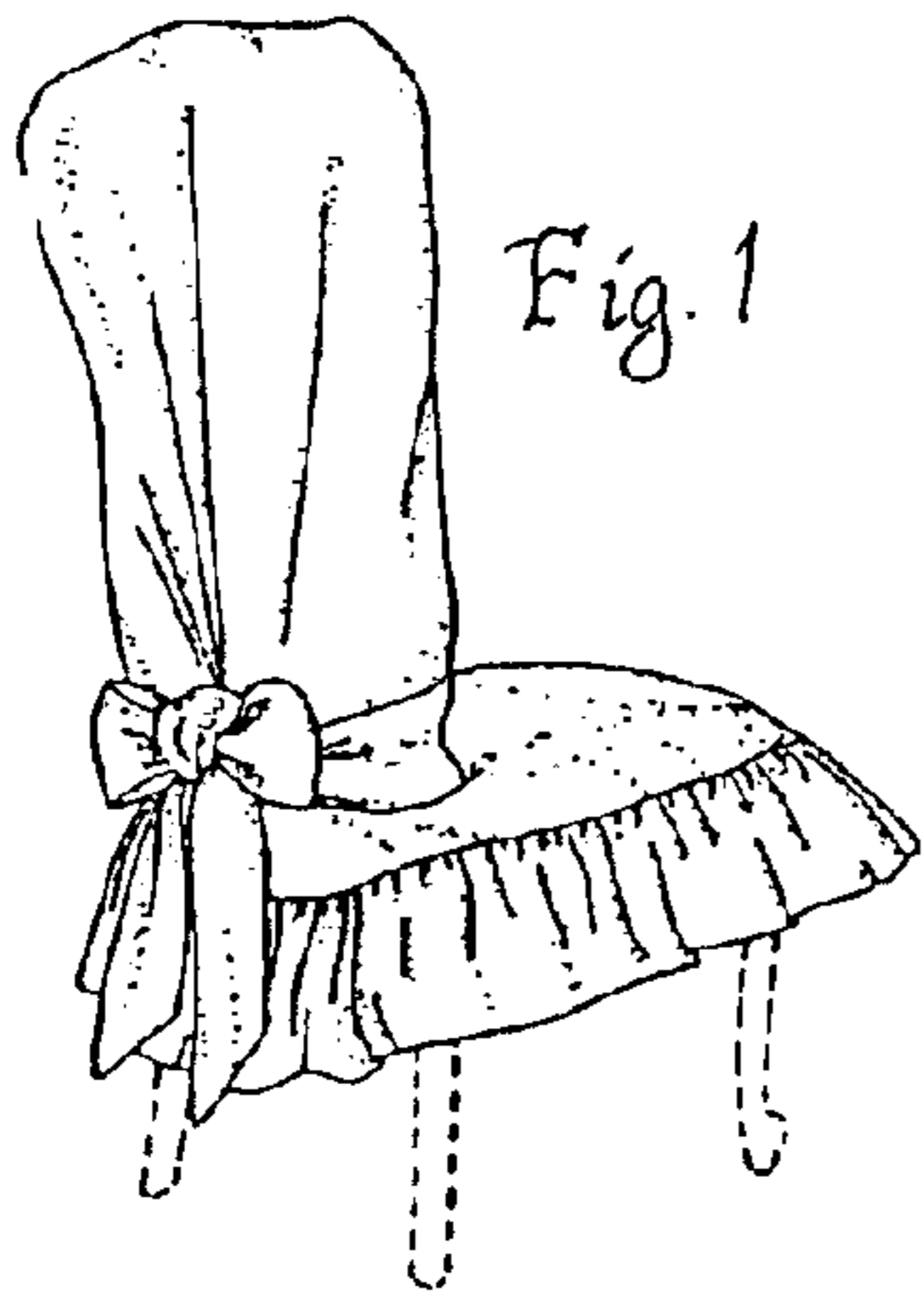
The ornamental design for a chair slip cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of the chair slip cover with gathered skirt in accordance with this invention;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the chair slip cover of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the chair slip cover in FIG. 1, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a back elevational view of the chair slip cover in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the chair slip cover in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is an alternate embodiment showing a rear perspective view of the chair slip cover with straight skirt;
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the chair slip cover of FIG. 6;
 FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of the chair slip cover of FIG. 6, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 9 is a back elevational view of the chair slip cover of FIG. 6; and,
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the chair slip cover of FIG. 6.
 The broken line showing of chair legs, in FIGS. 1–4, and 6–9, is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

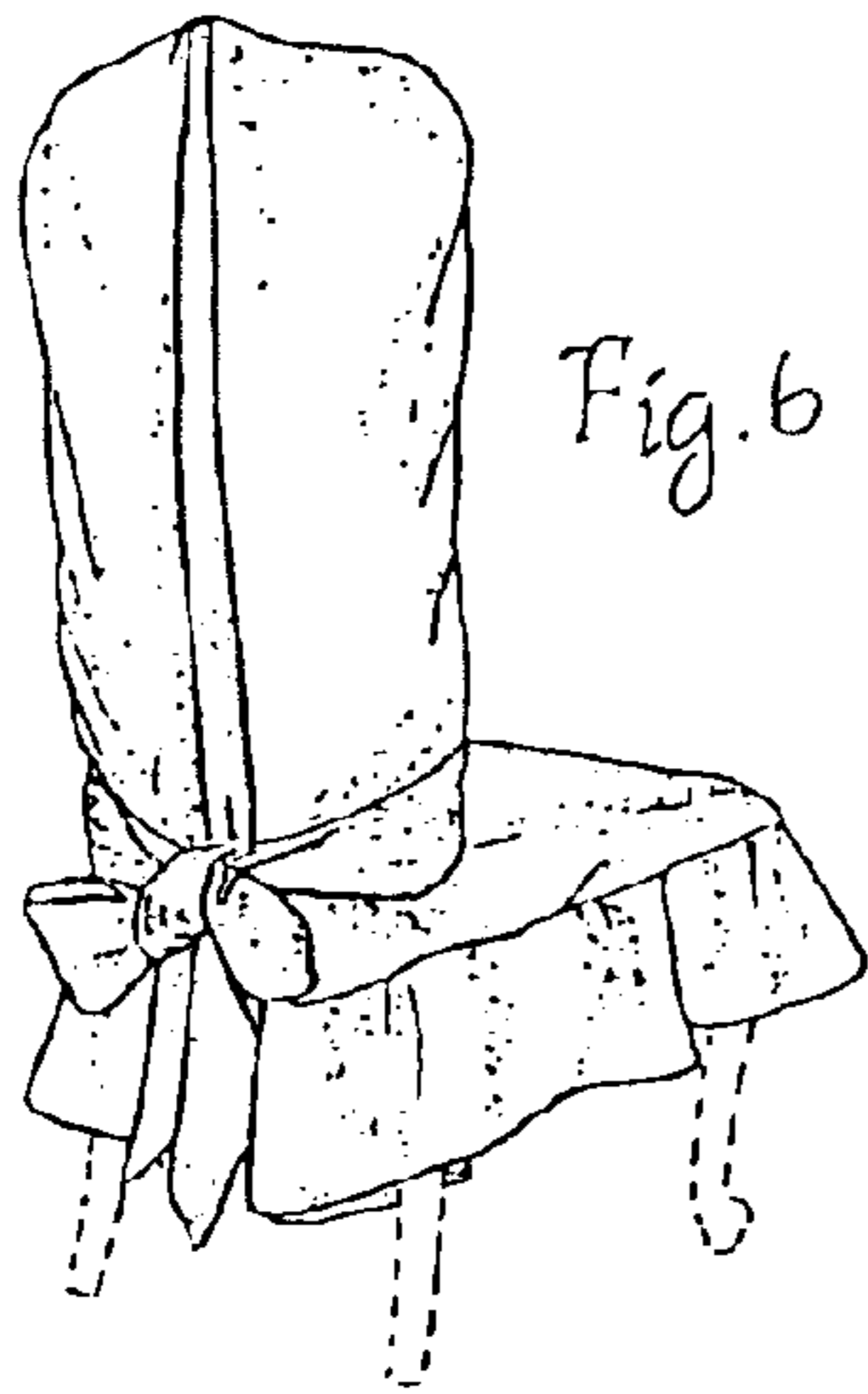

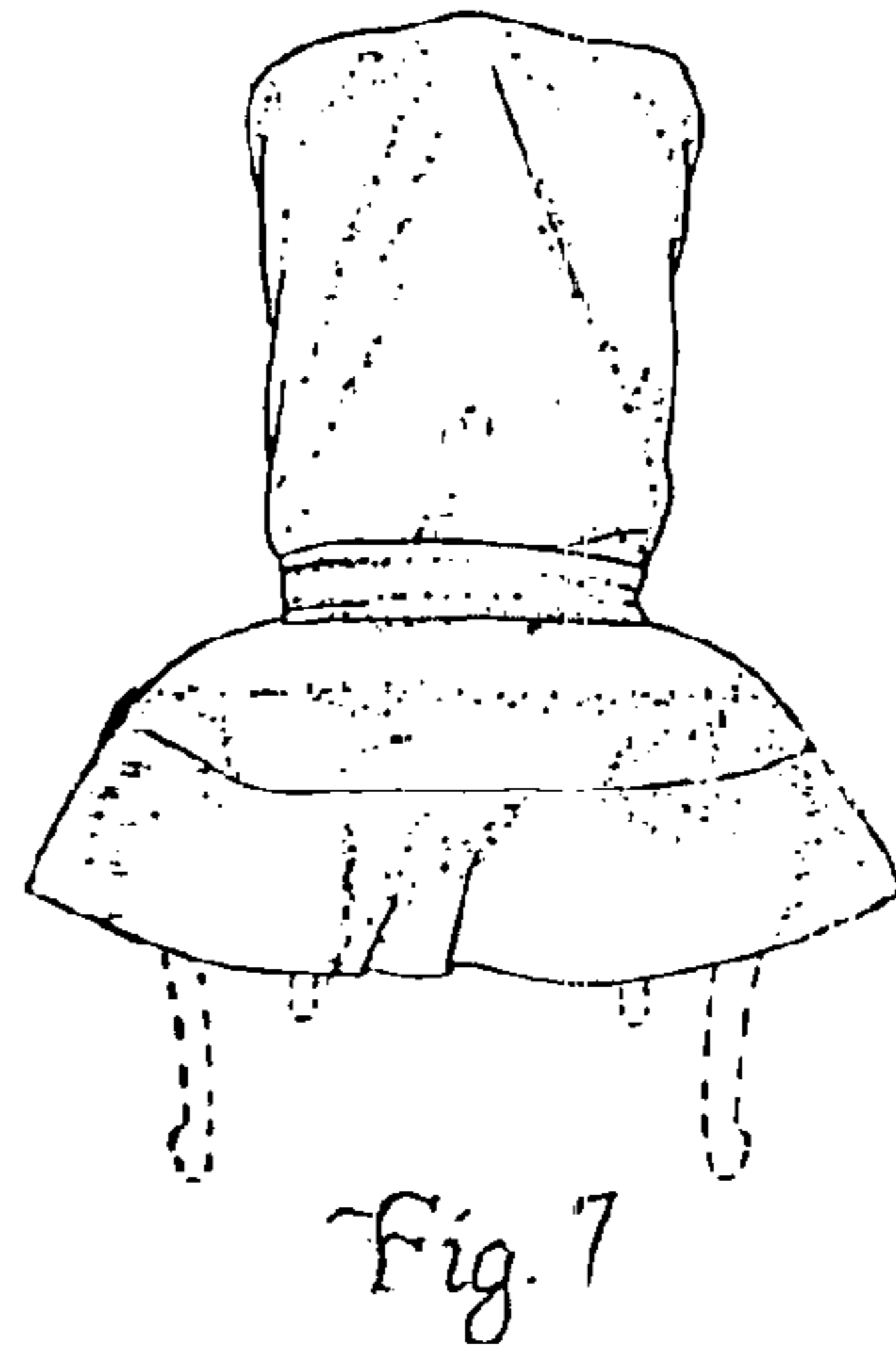

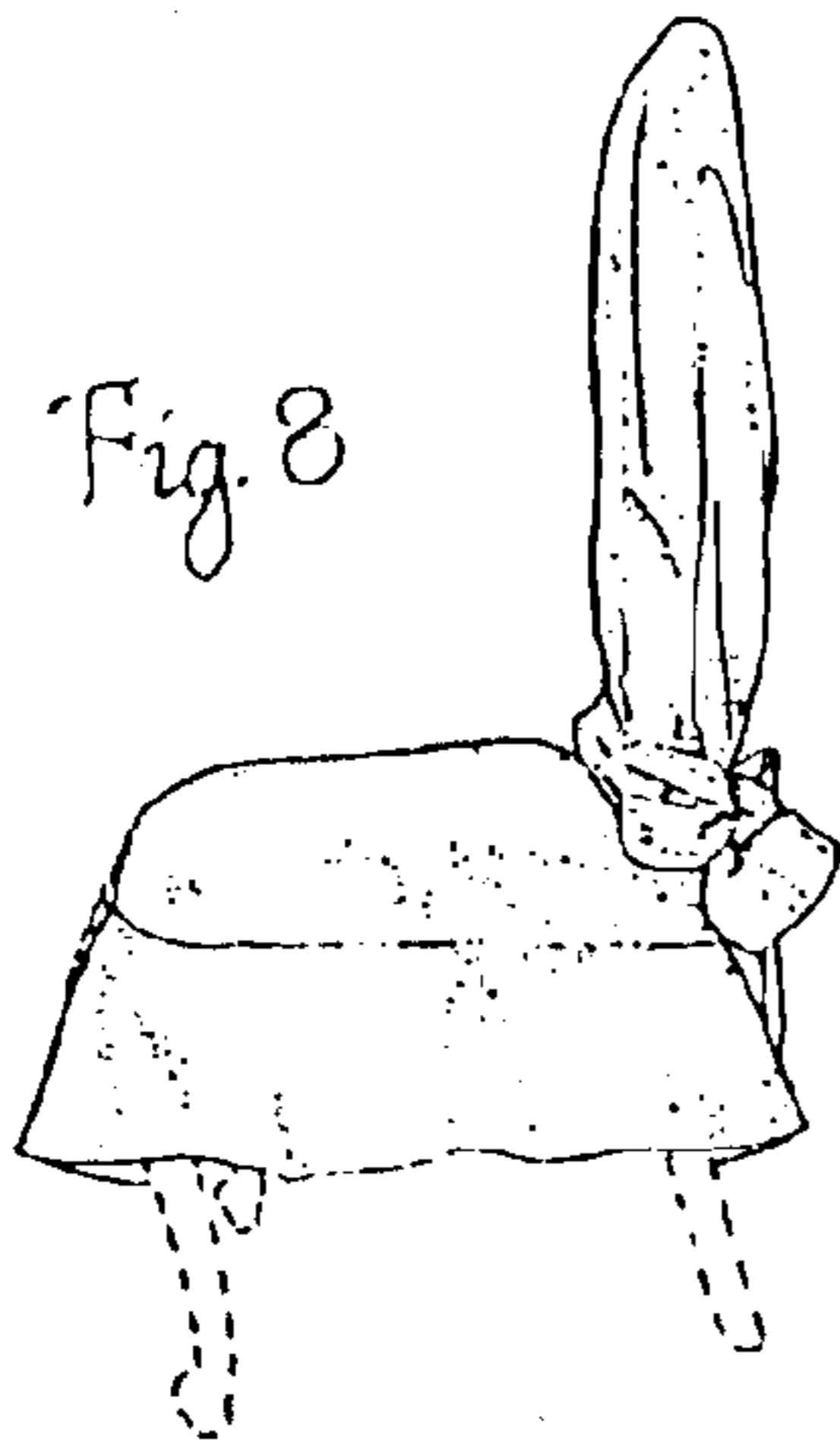

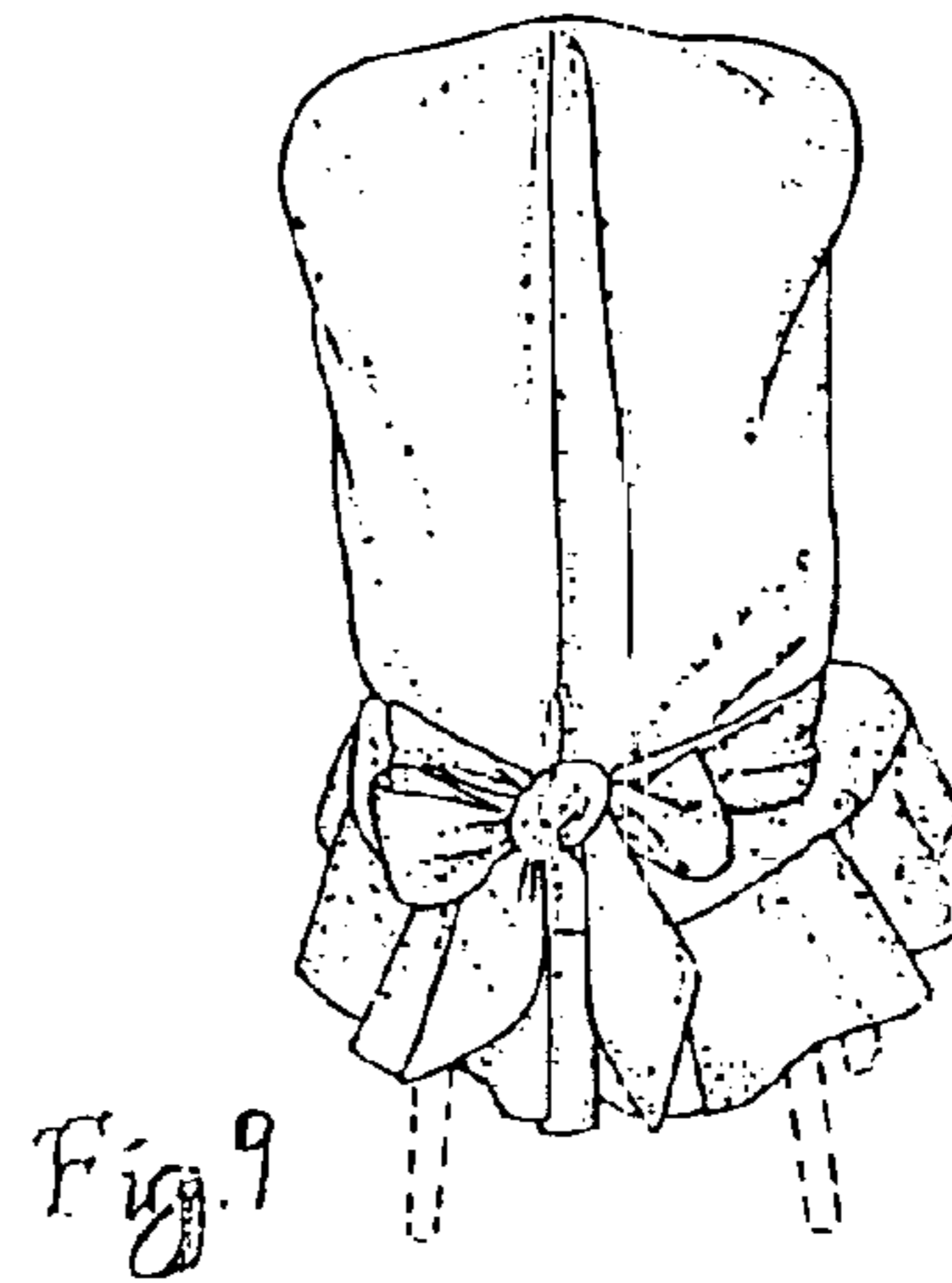

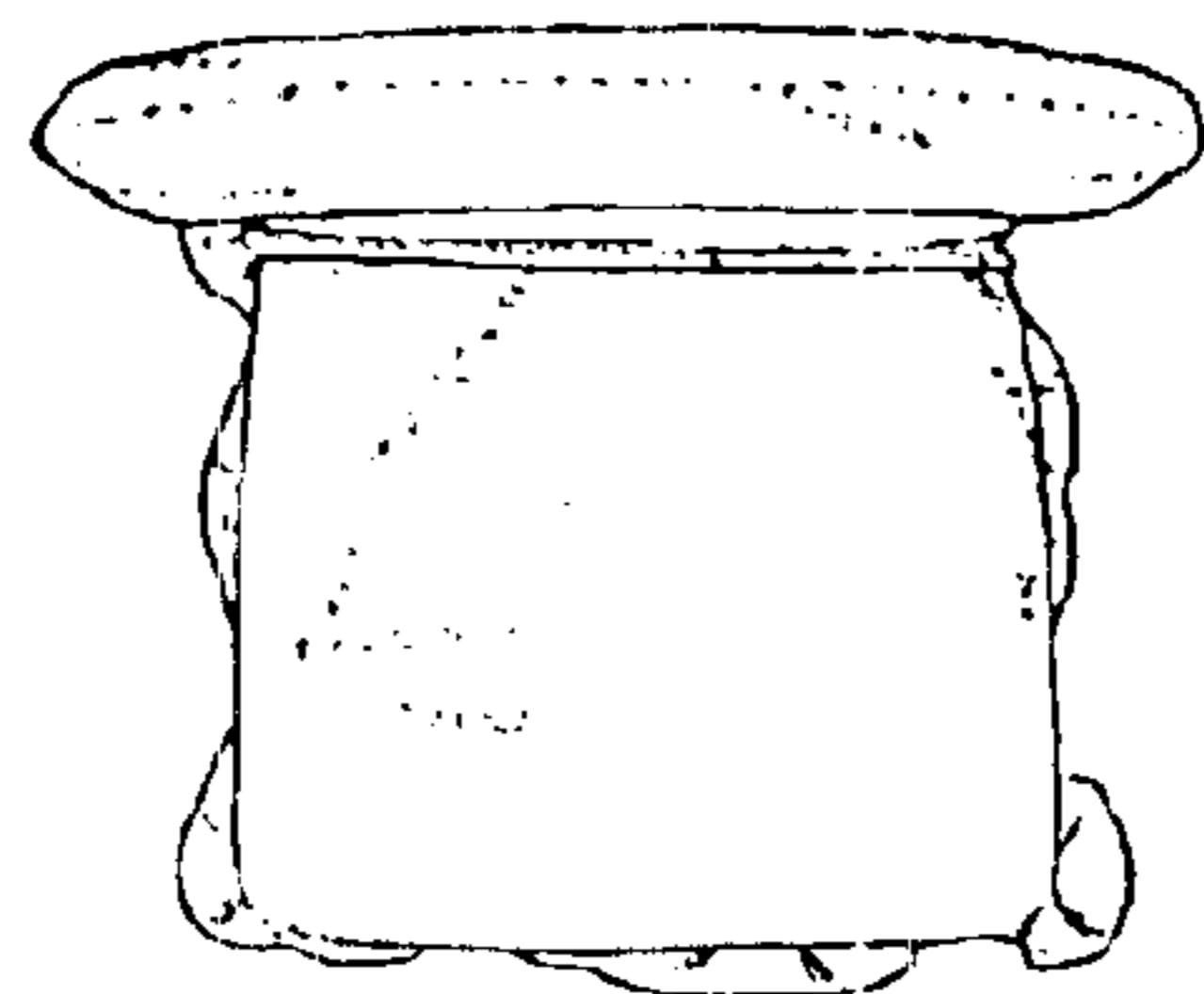
