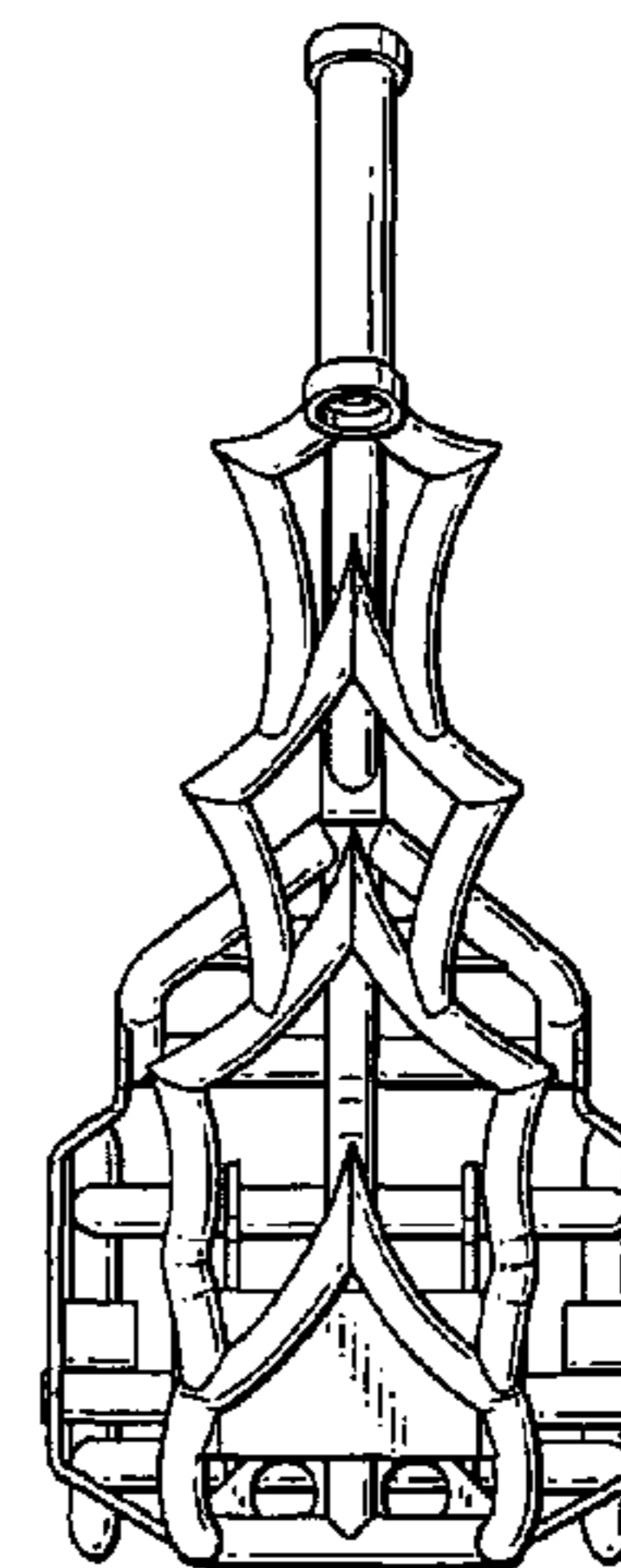
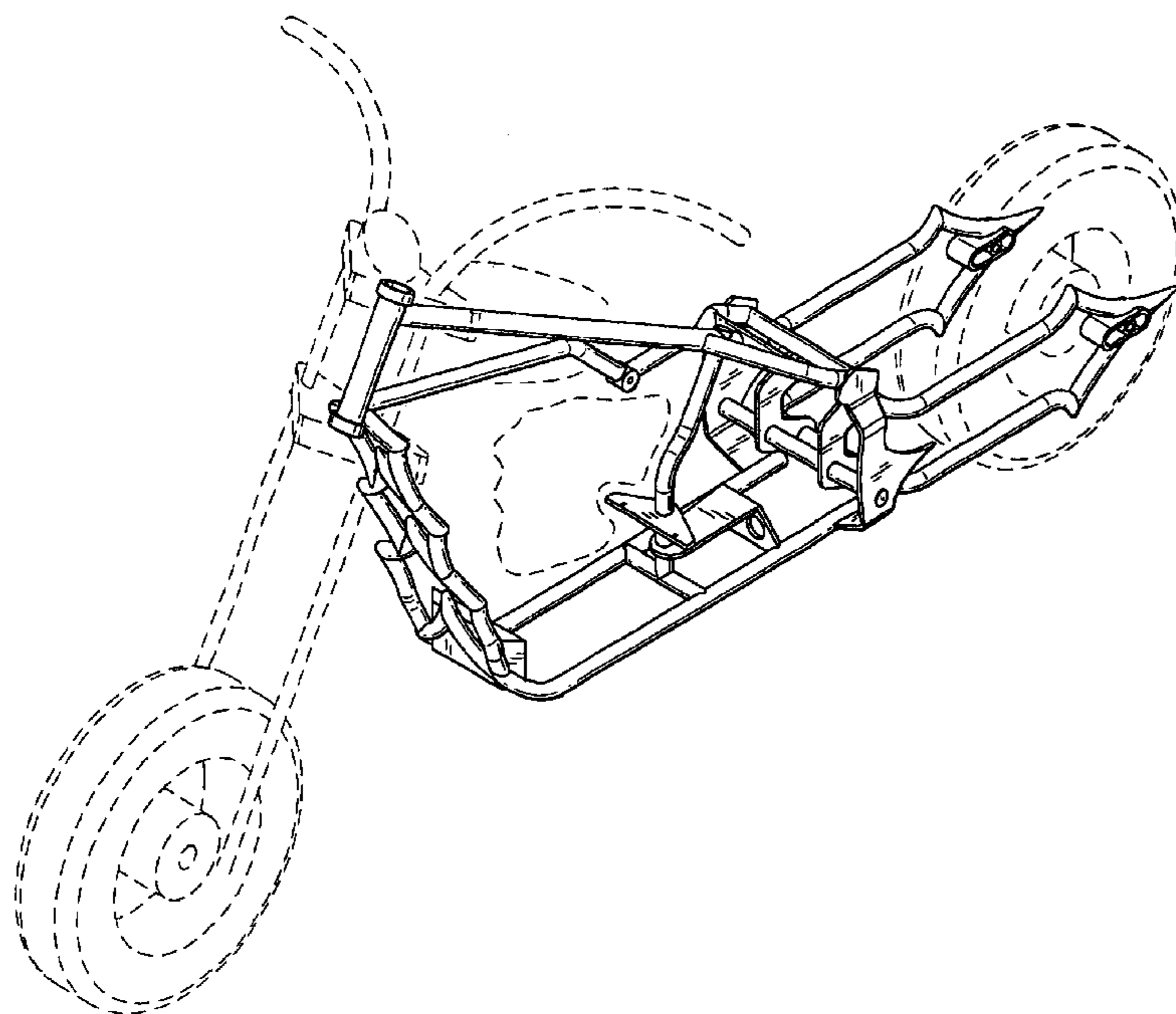
FIG. 1 is an environmental perspective view of a motorcycle frame showing our new design;

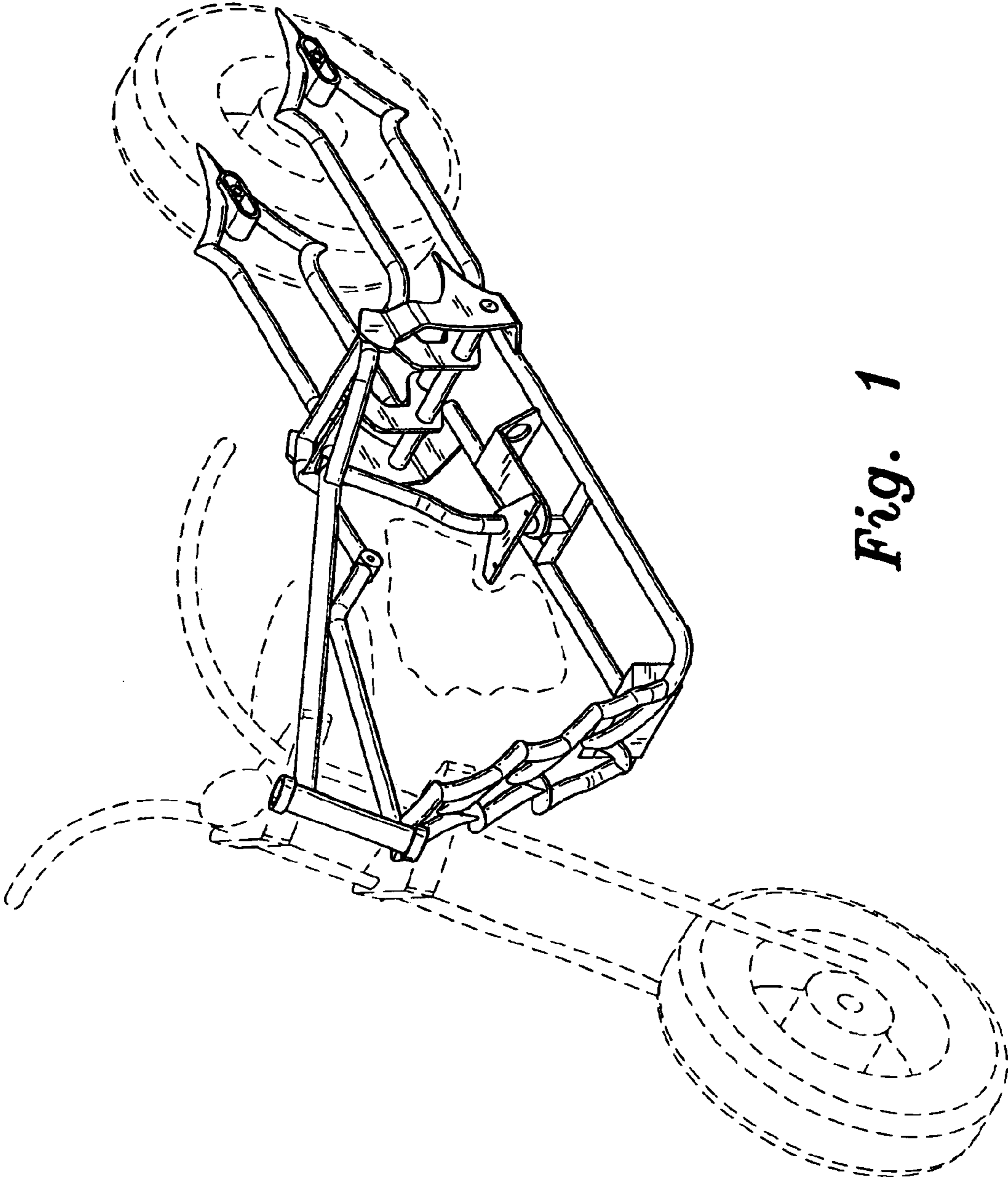

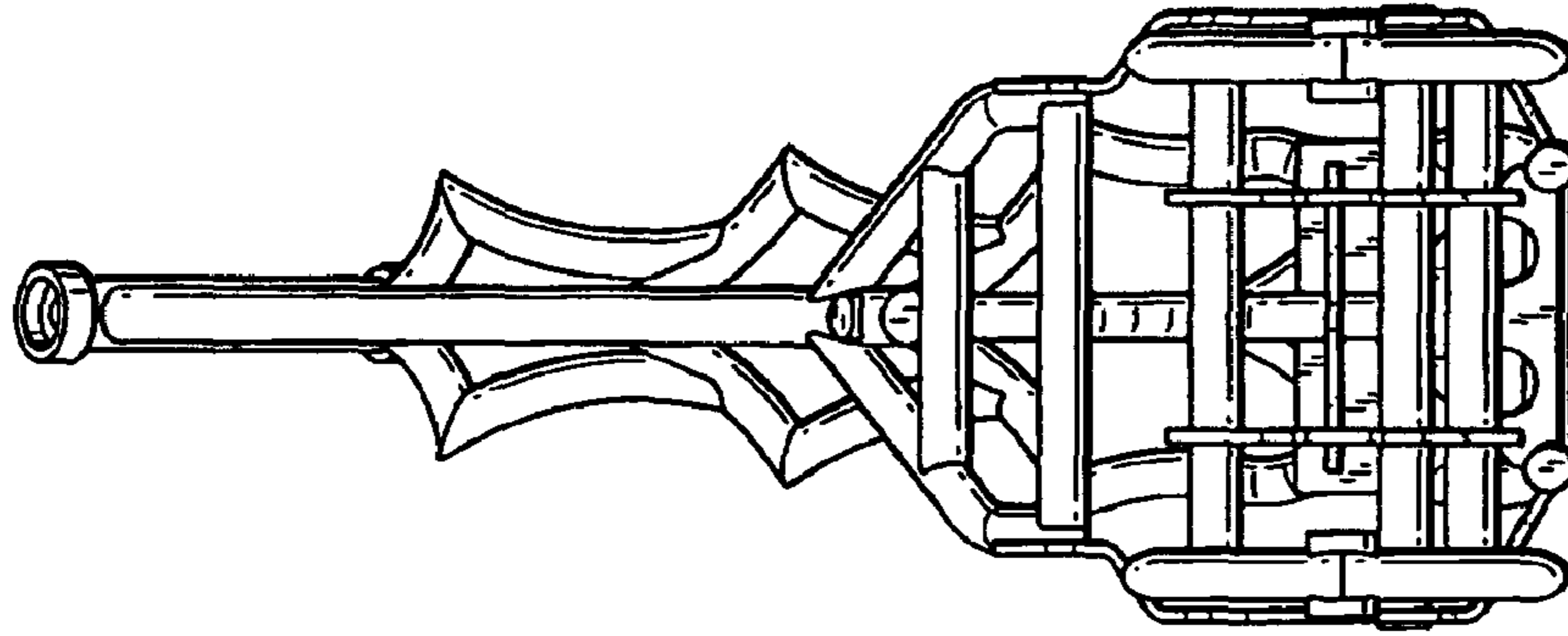

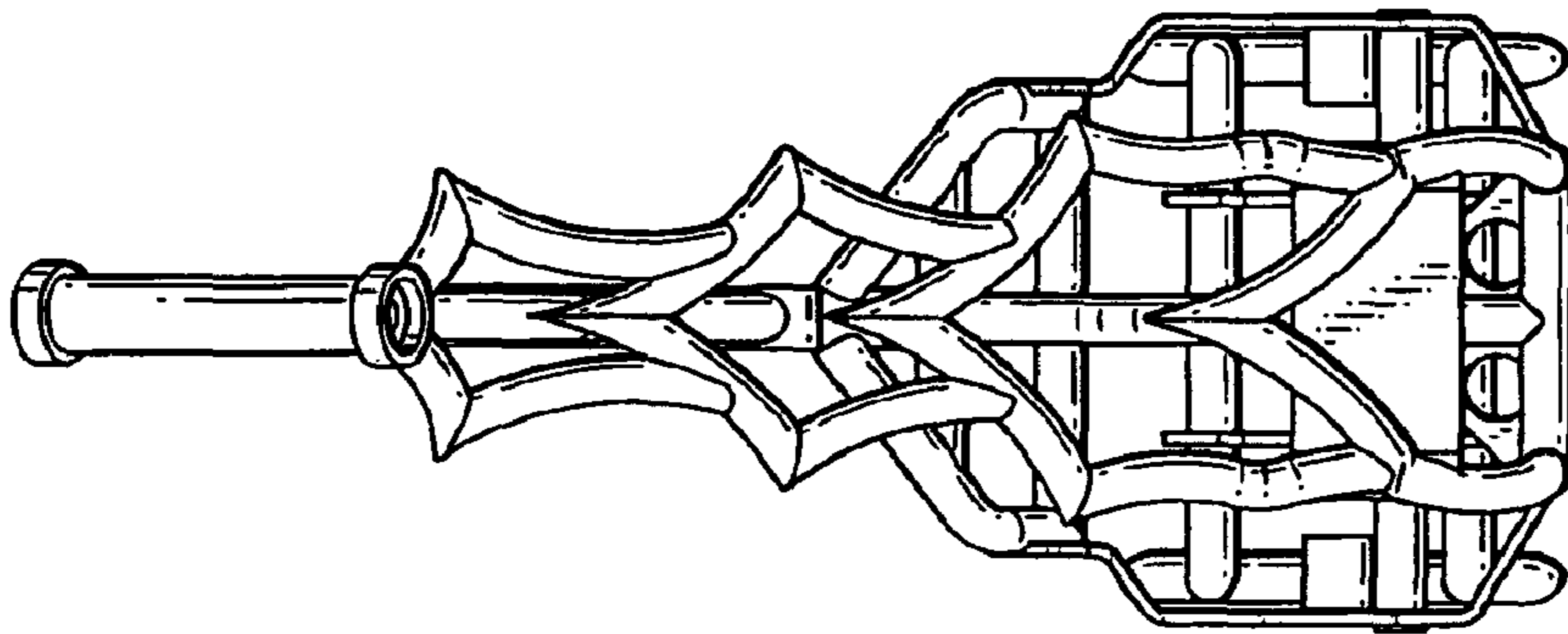

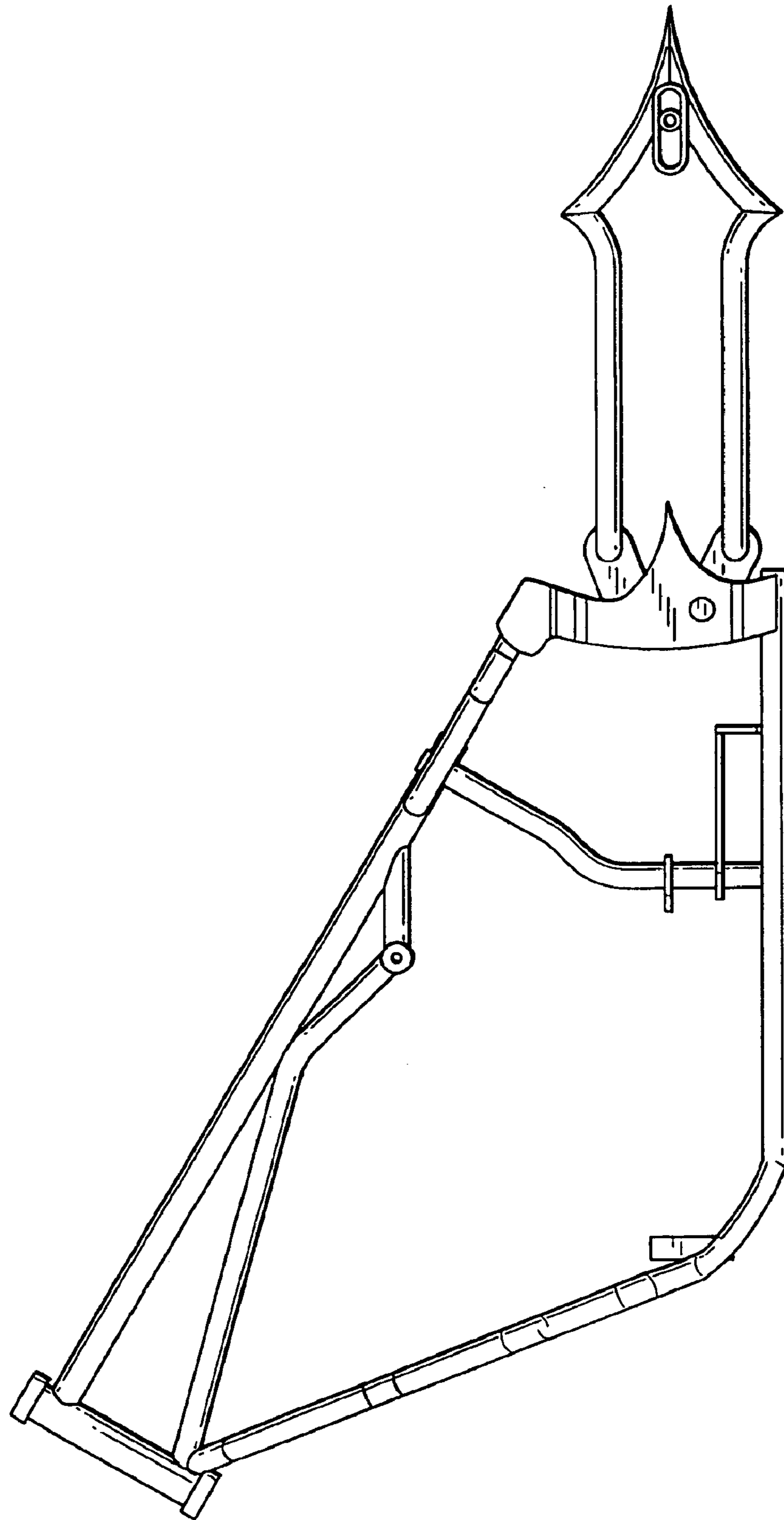

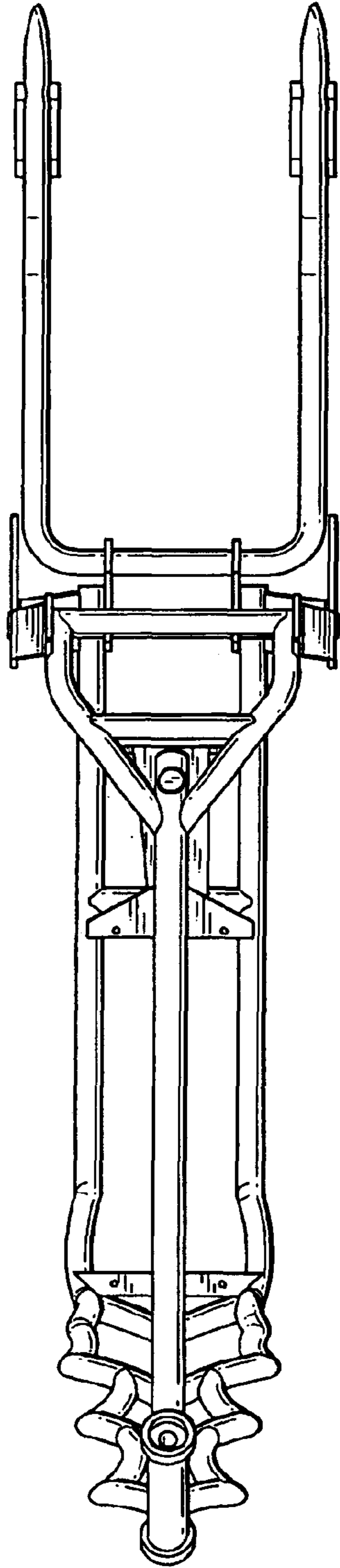

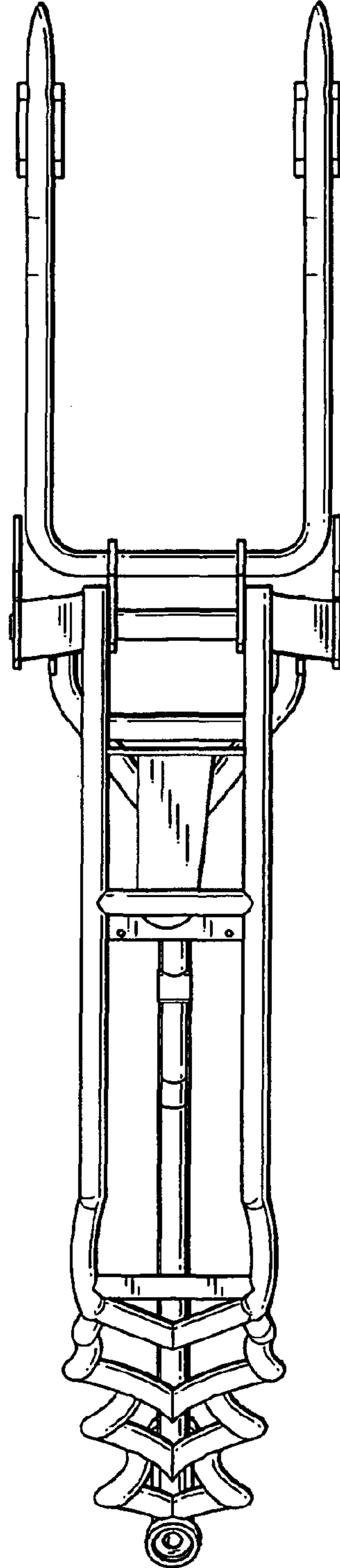
