FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the invention.

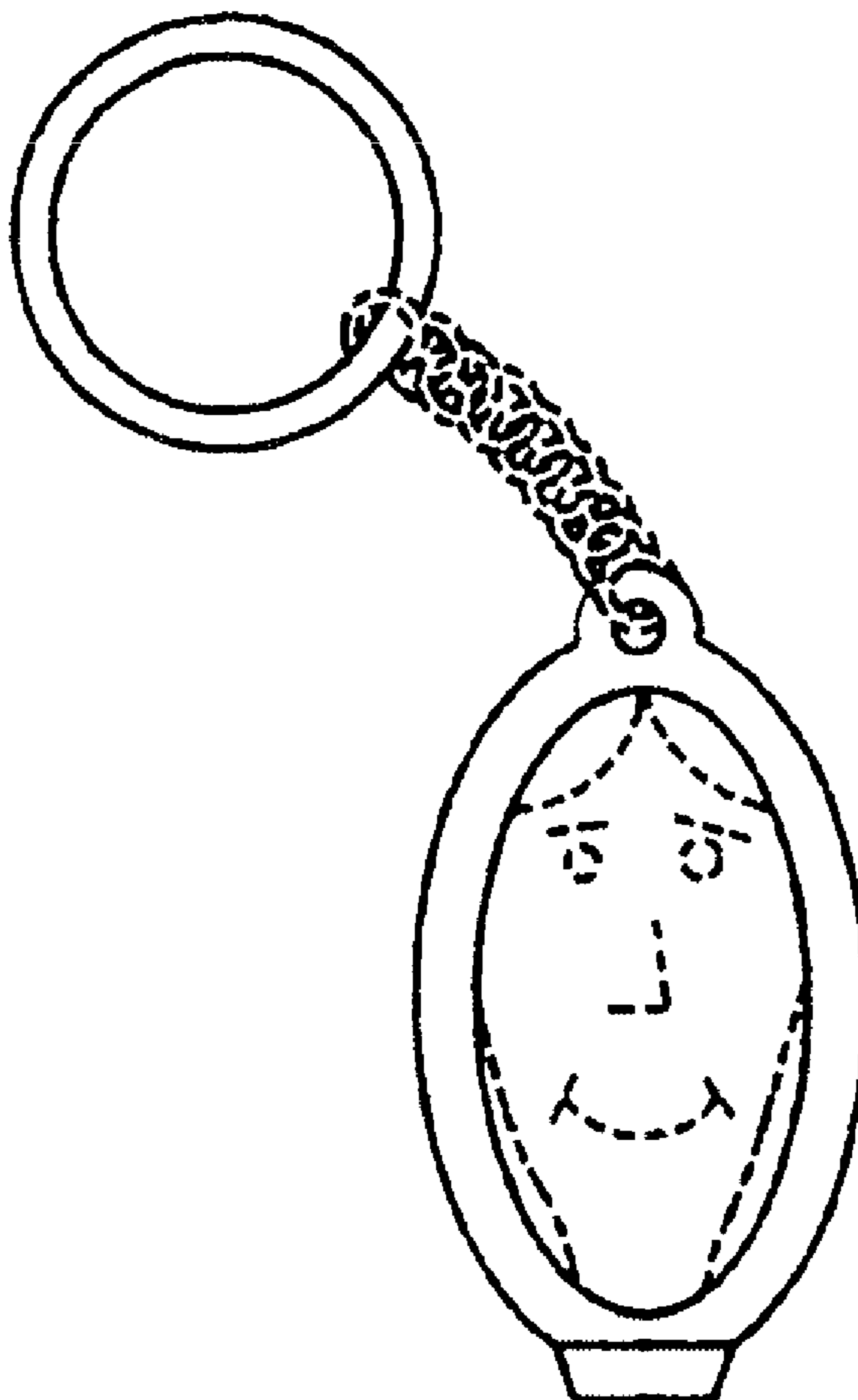

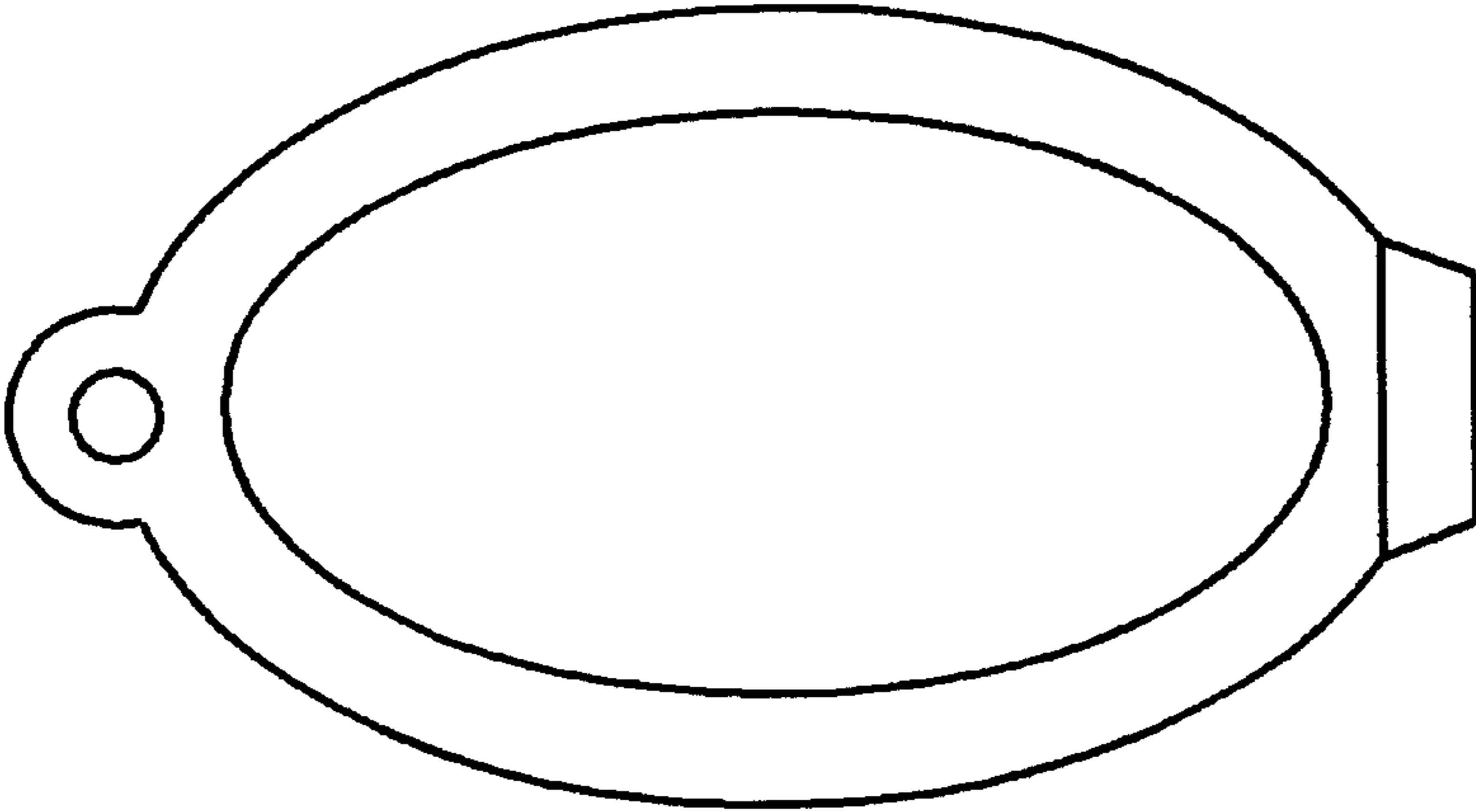

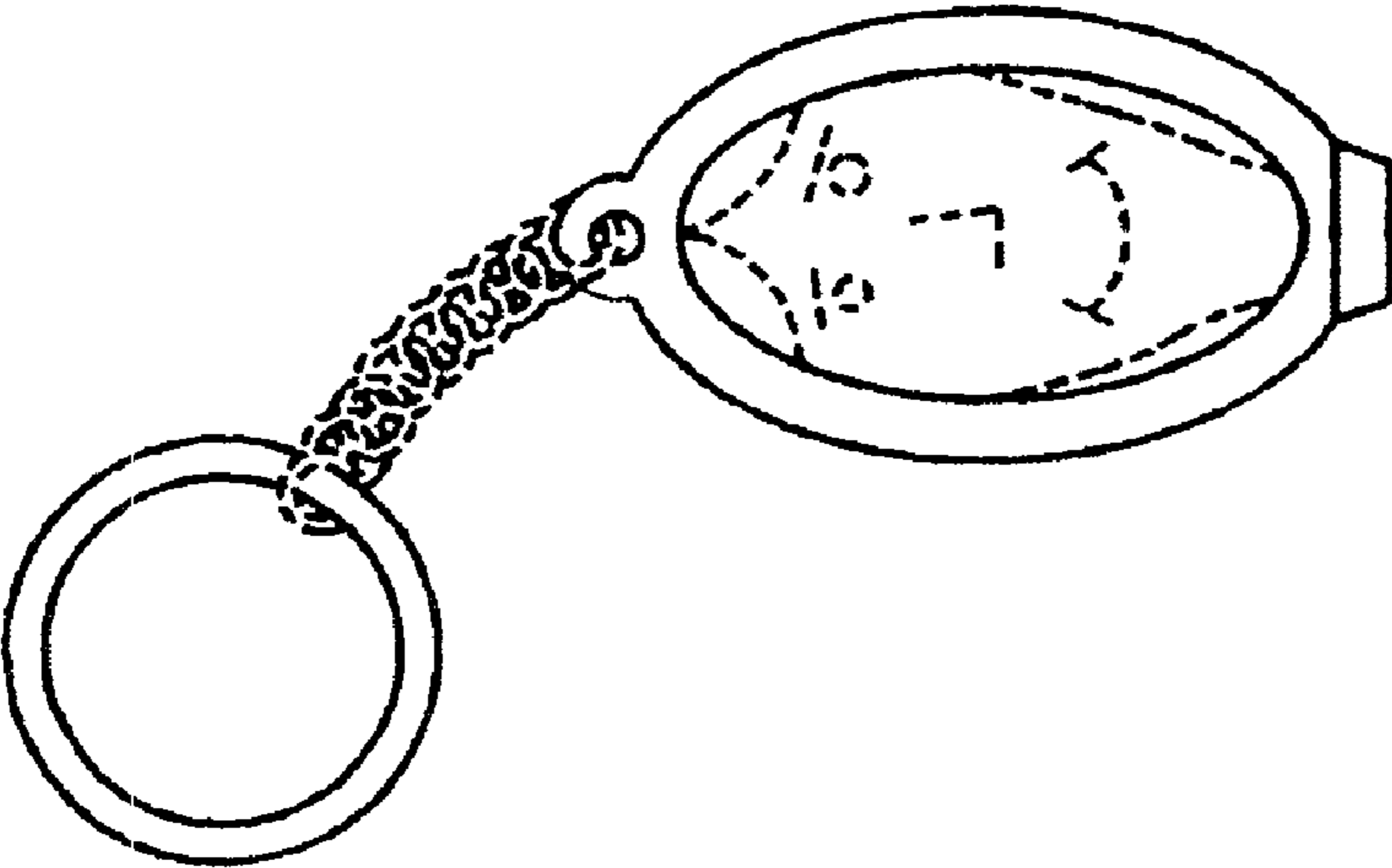

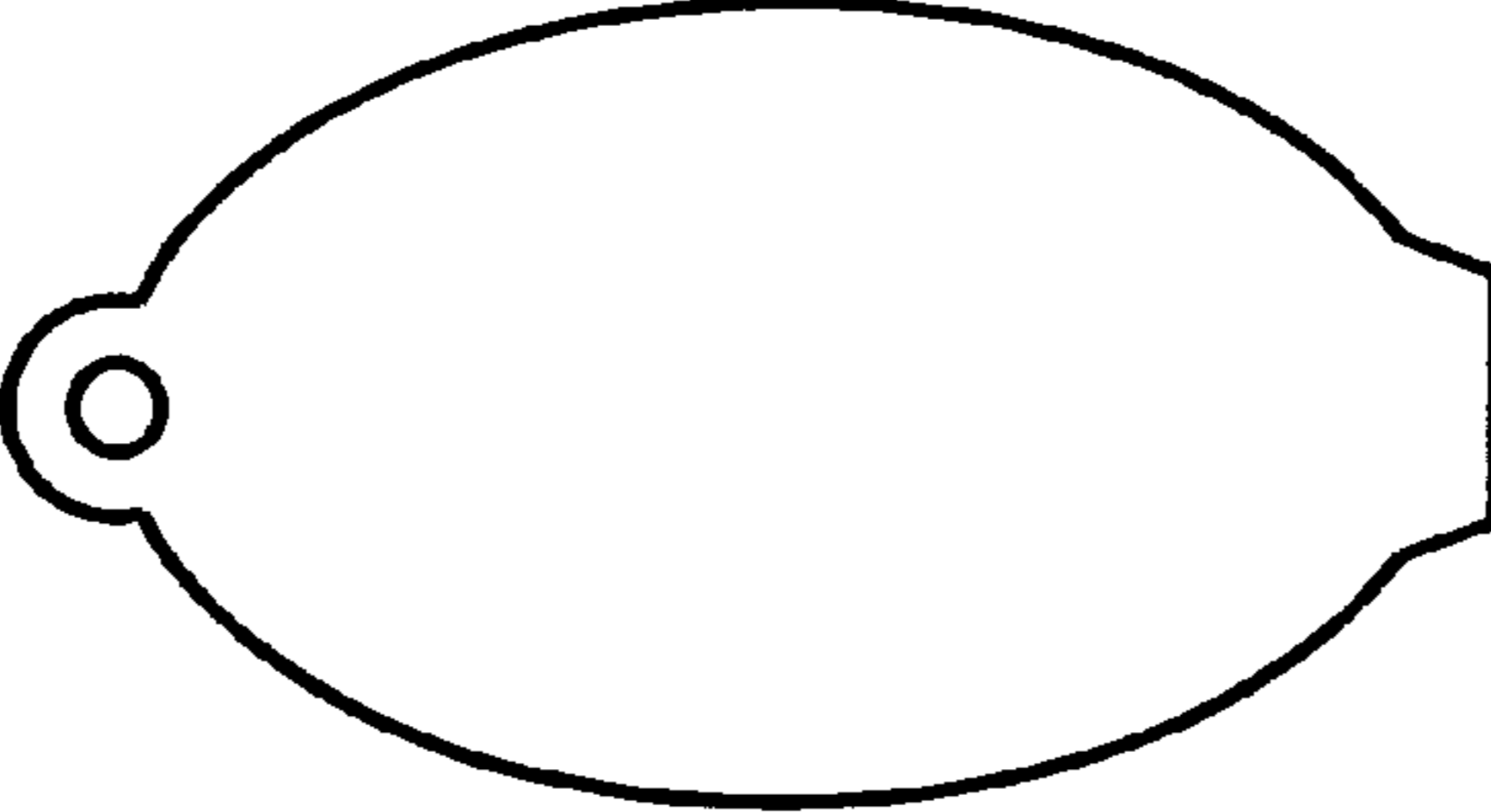
