The ornamental design for a tennis ball bag, as shown and described.

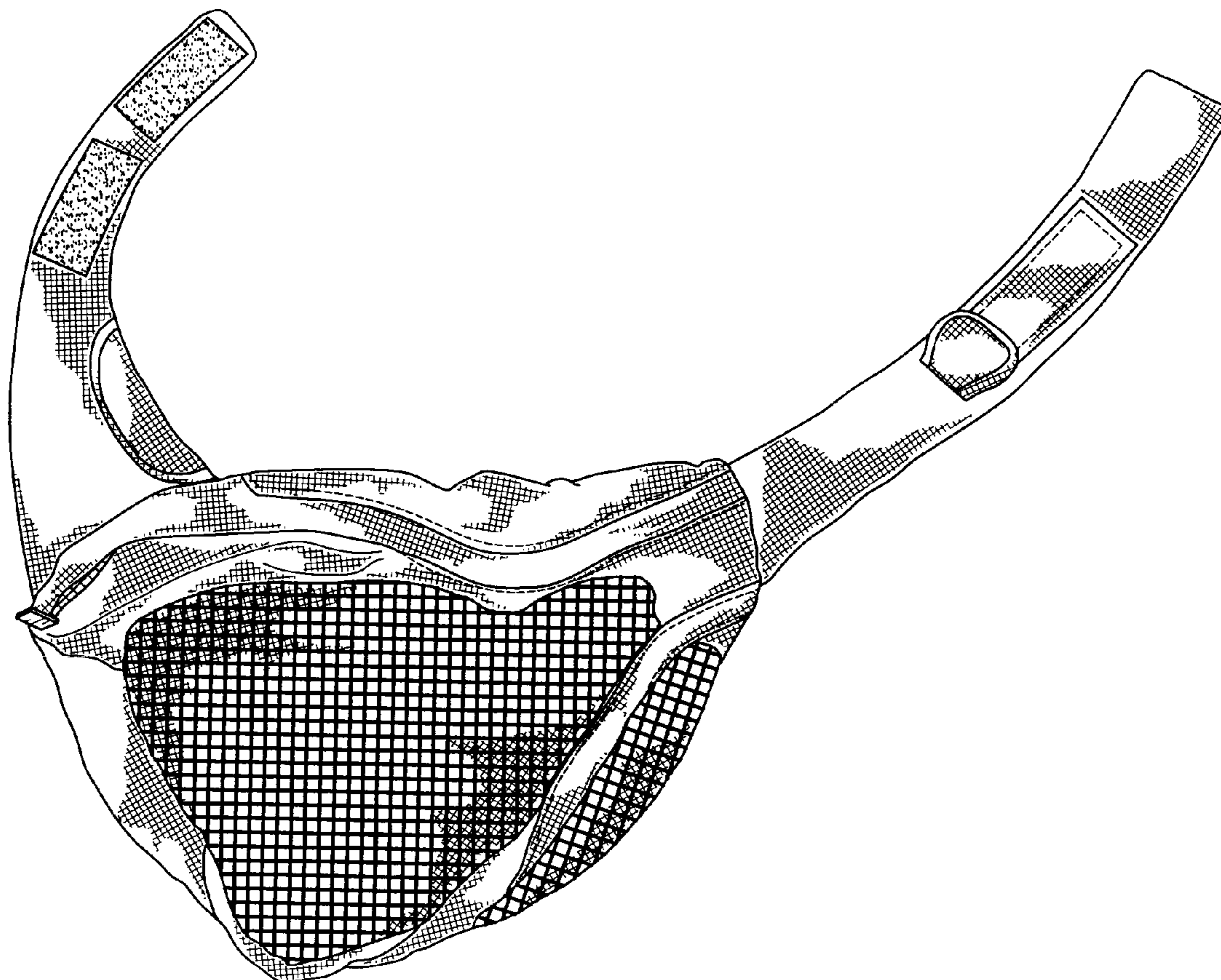
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a tennis ball bag embodying my design; and,
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the tennis ball bag as shown in FIG. 1.
The patches of cross-hatching represent a texture that continues throughout the surfaces.

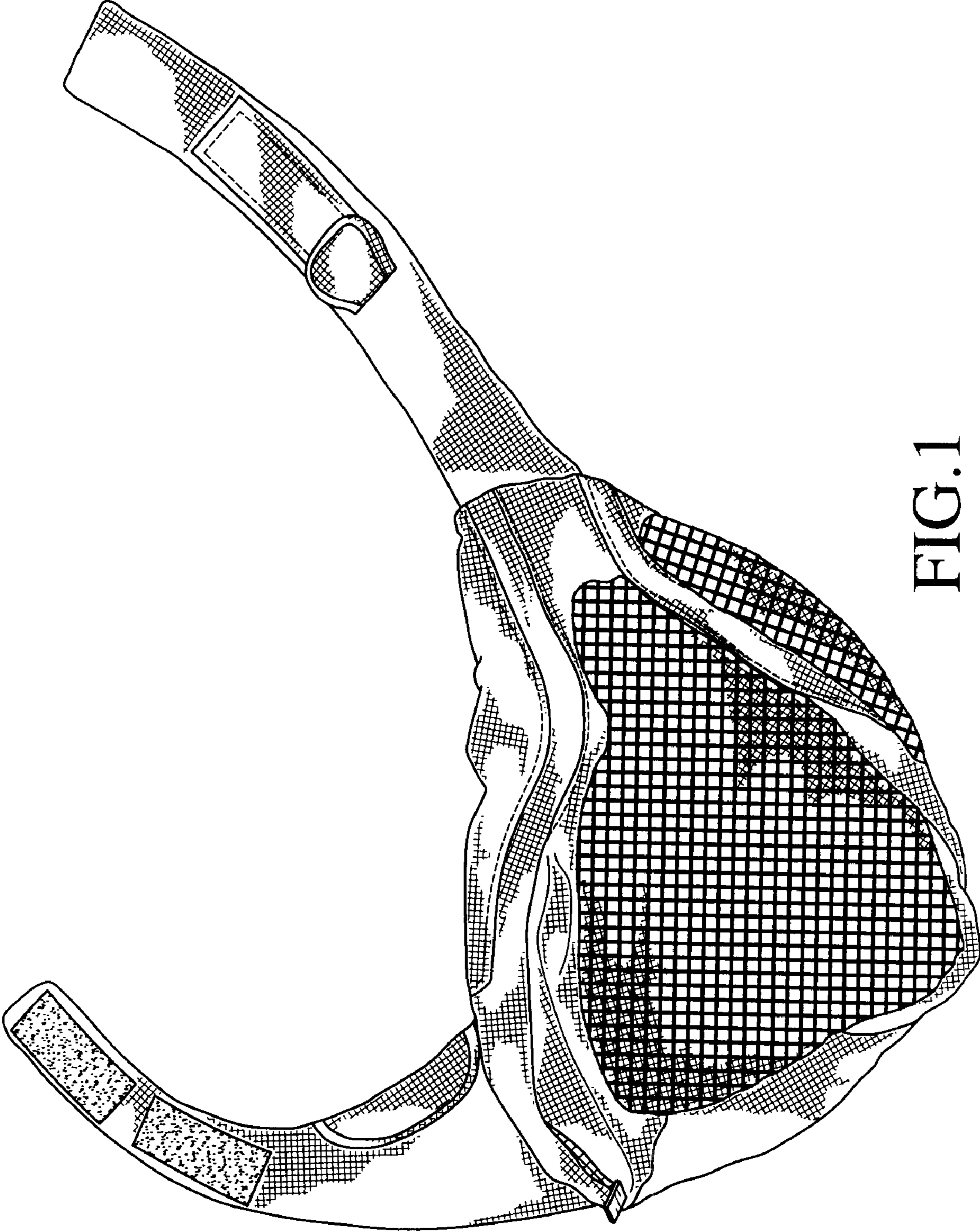

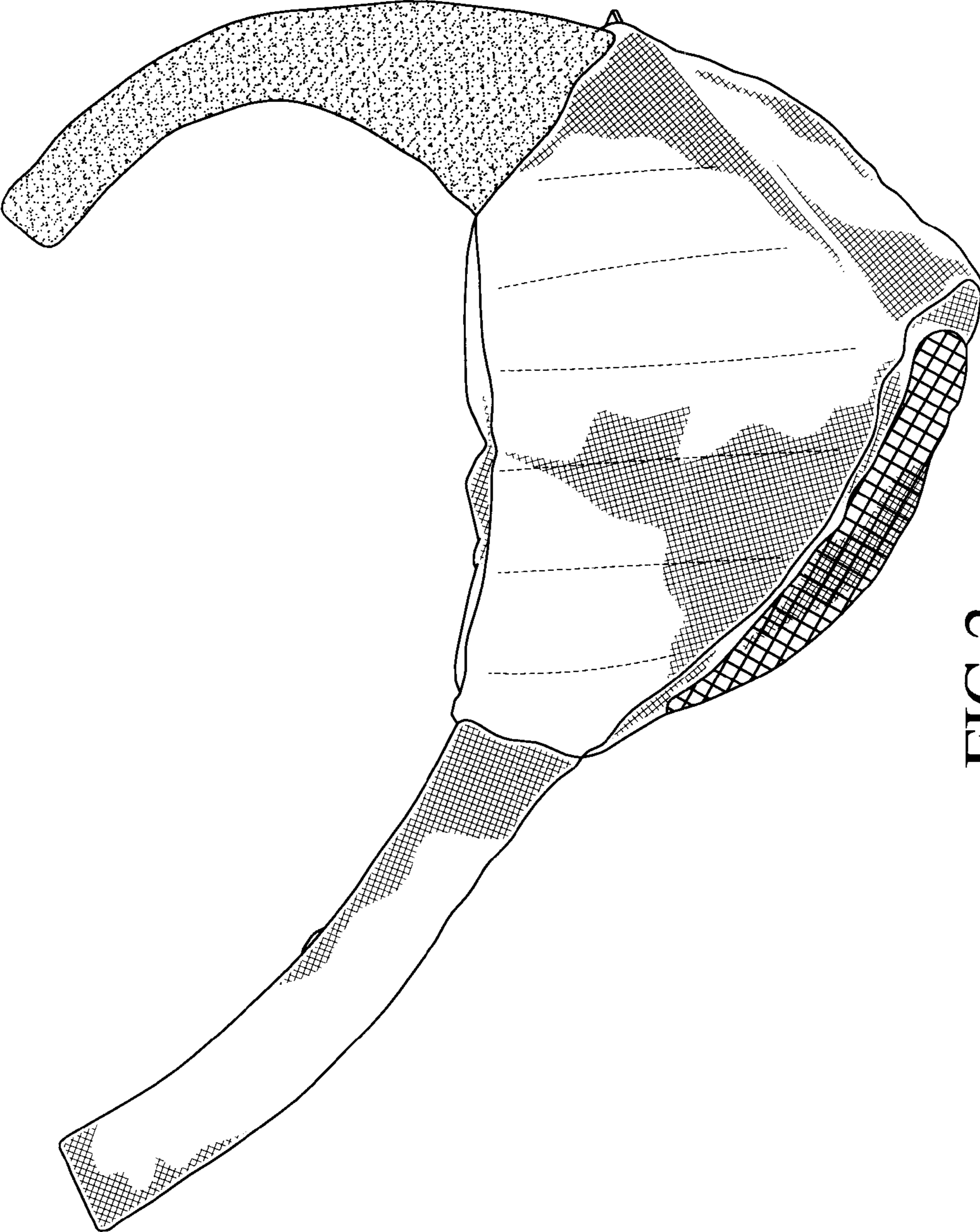
