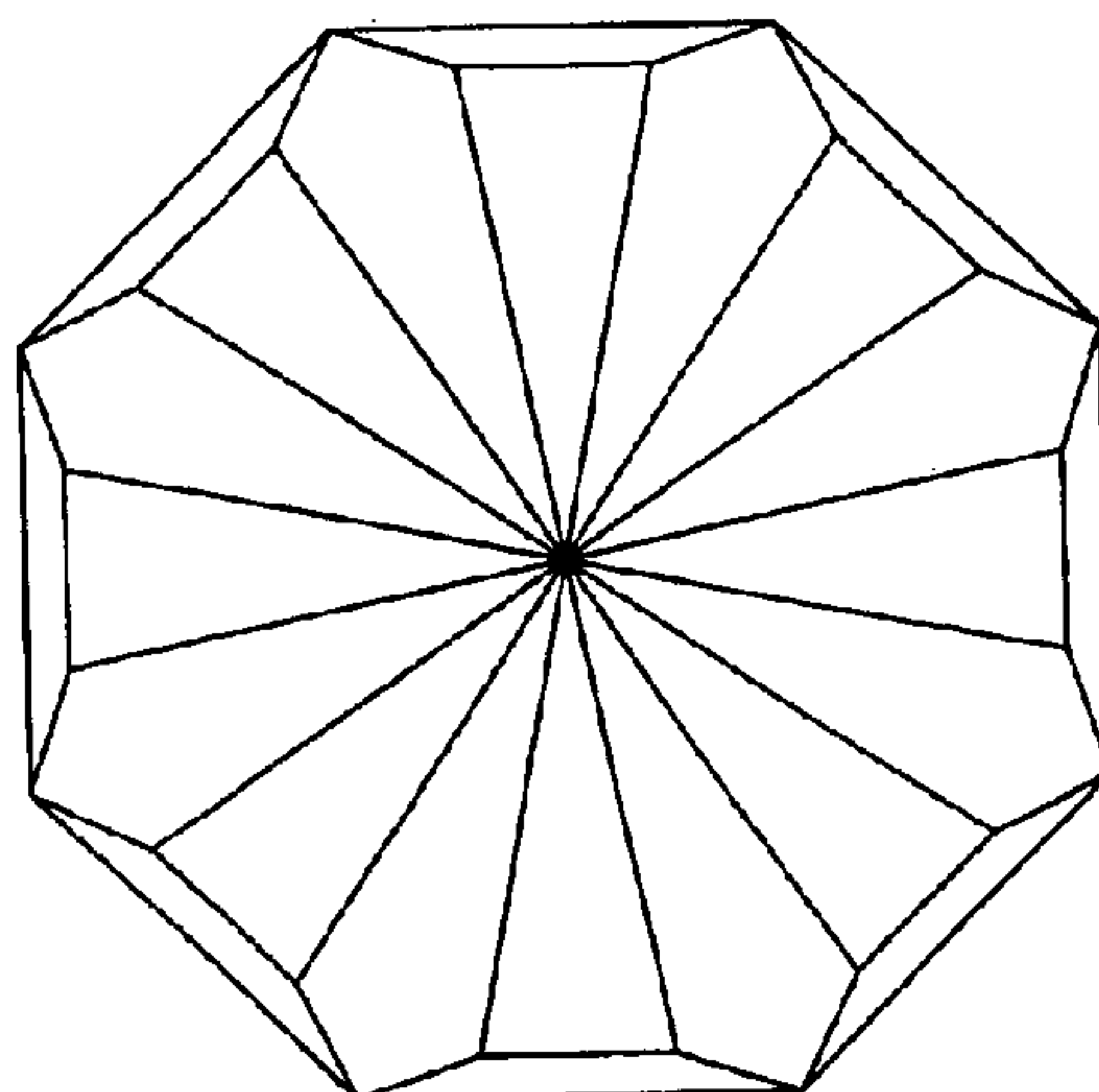
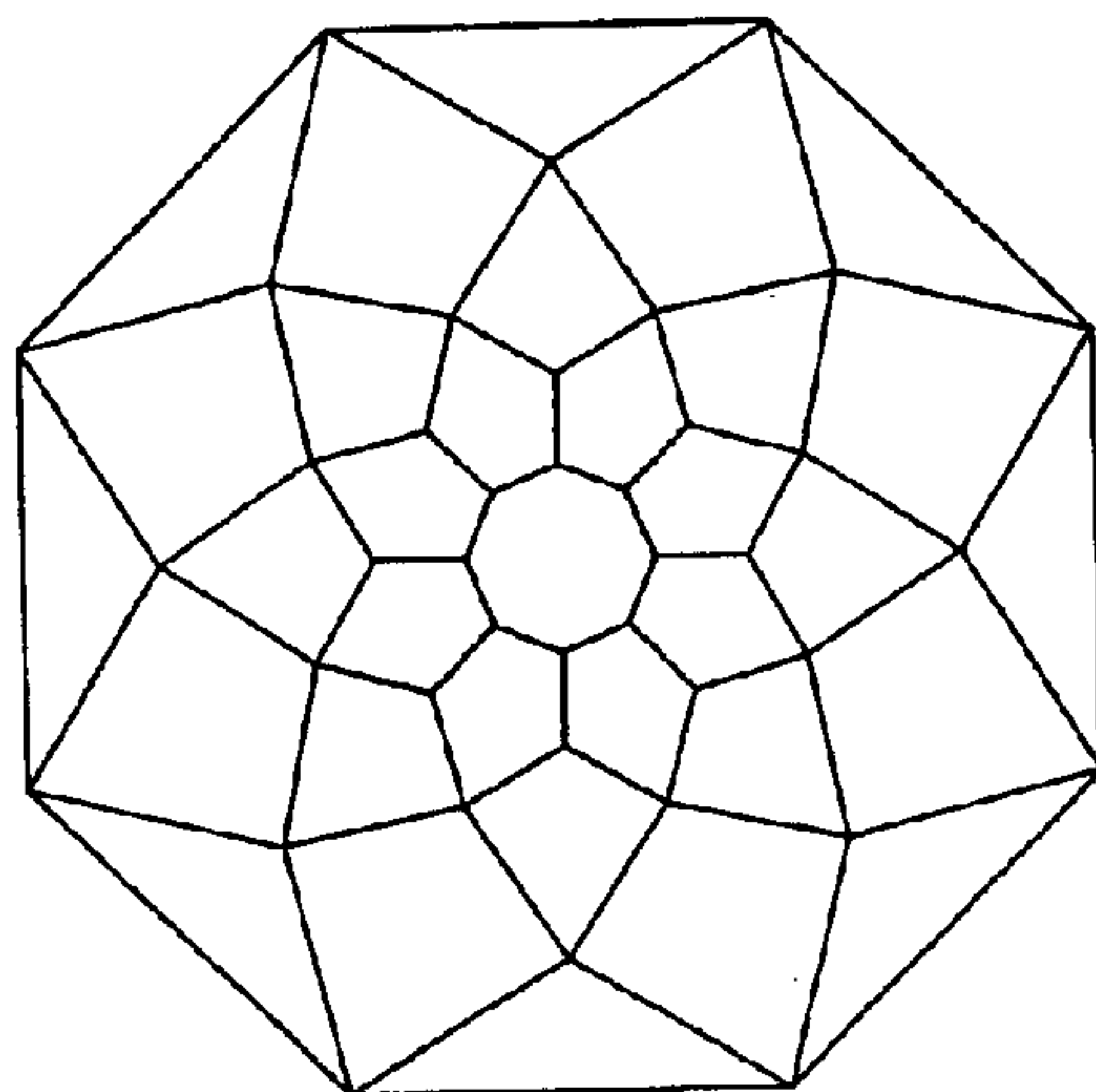
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FIG. 1 is a side view showing the design of the gem stone.

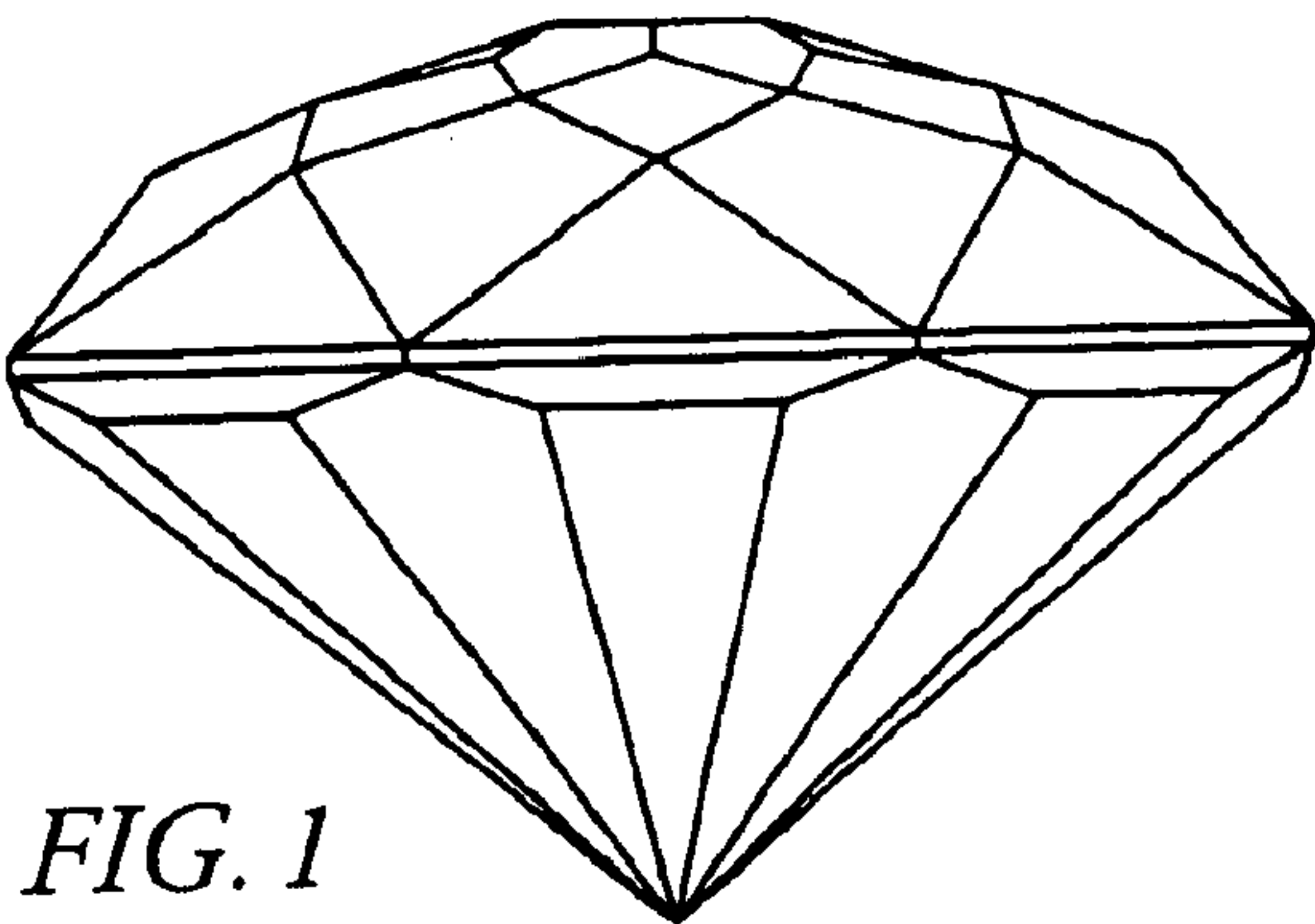

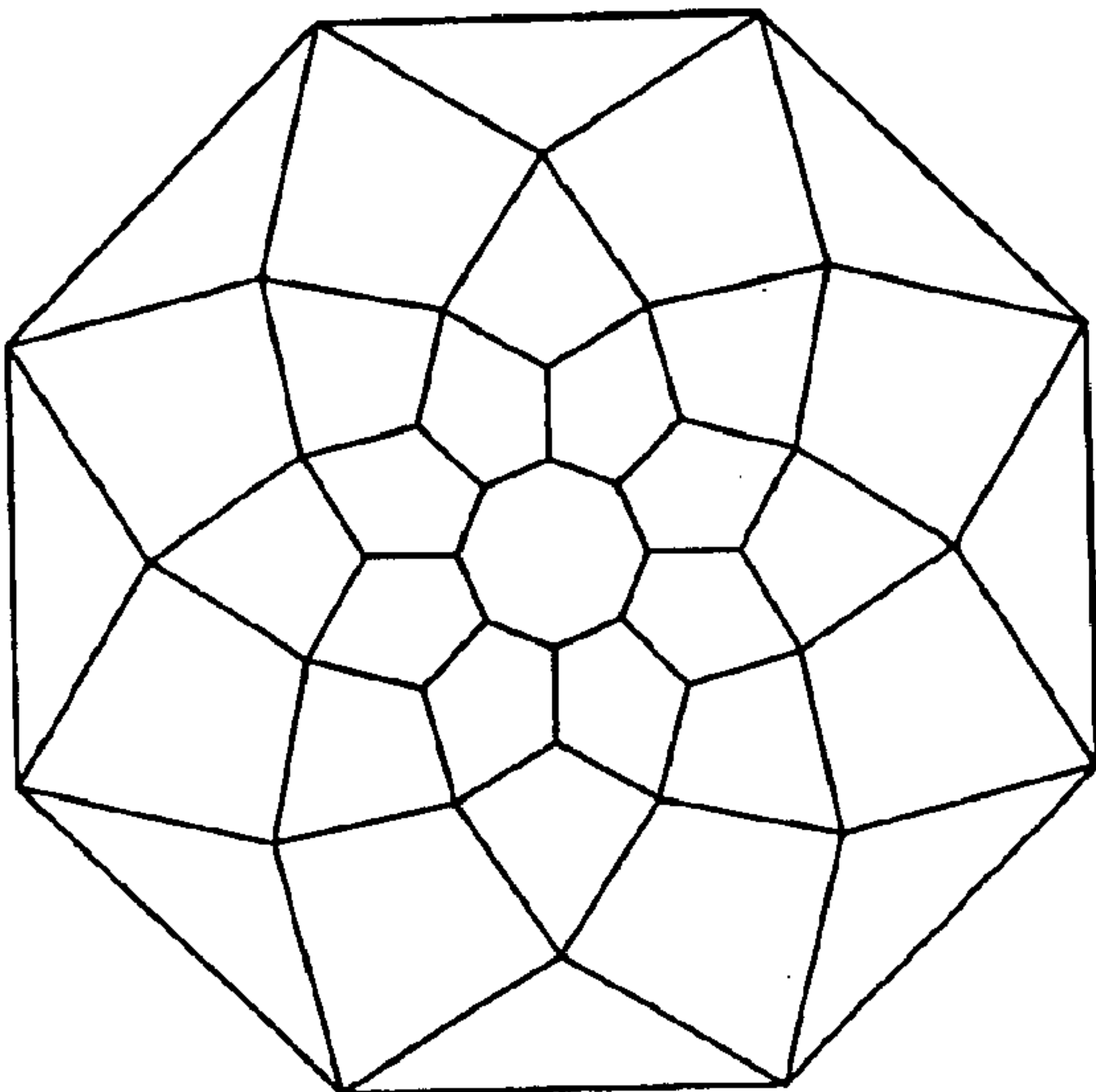

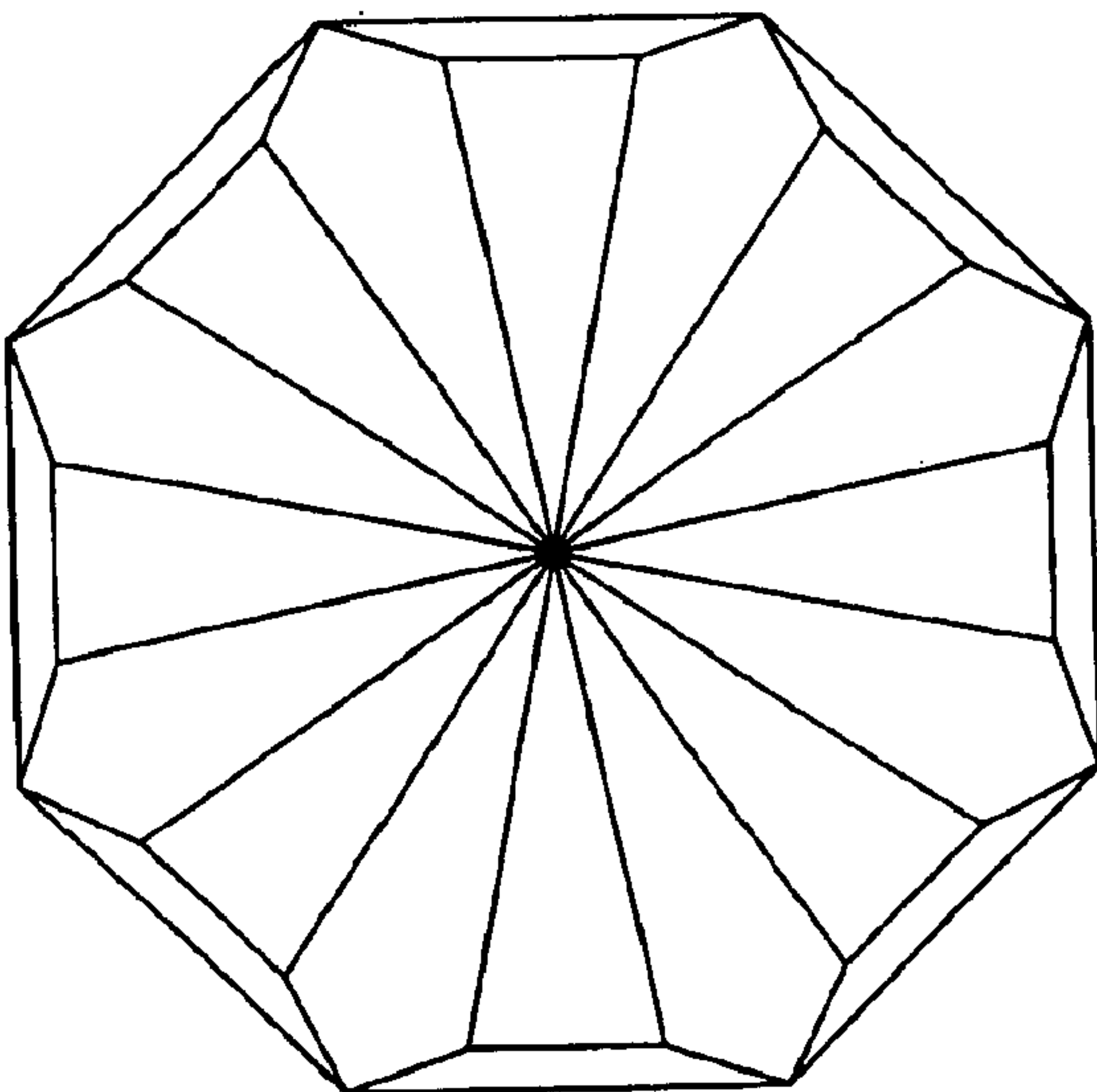
