(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined ceiling fan motor housing and light kit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

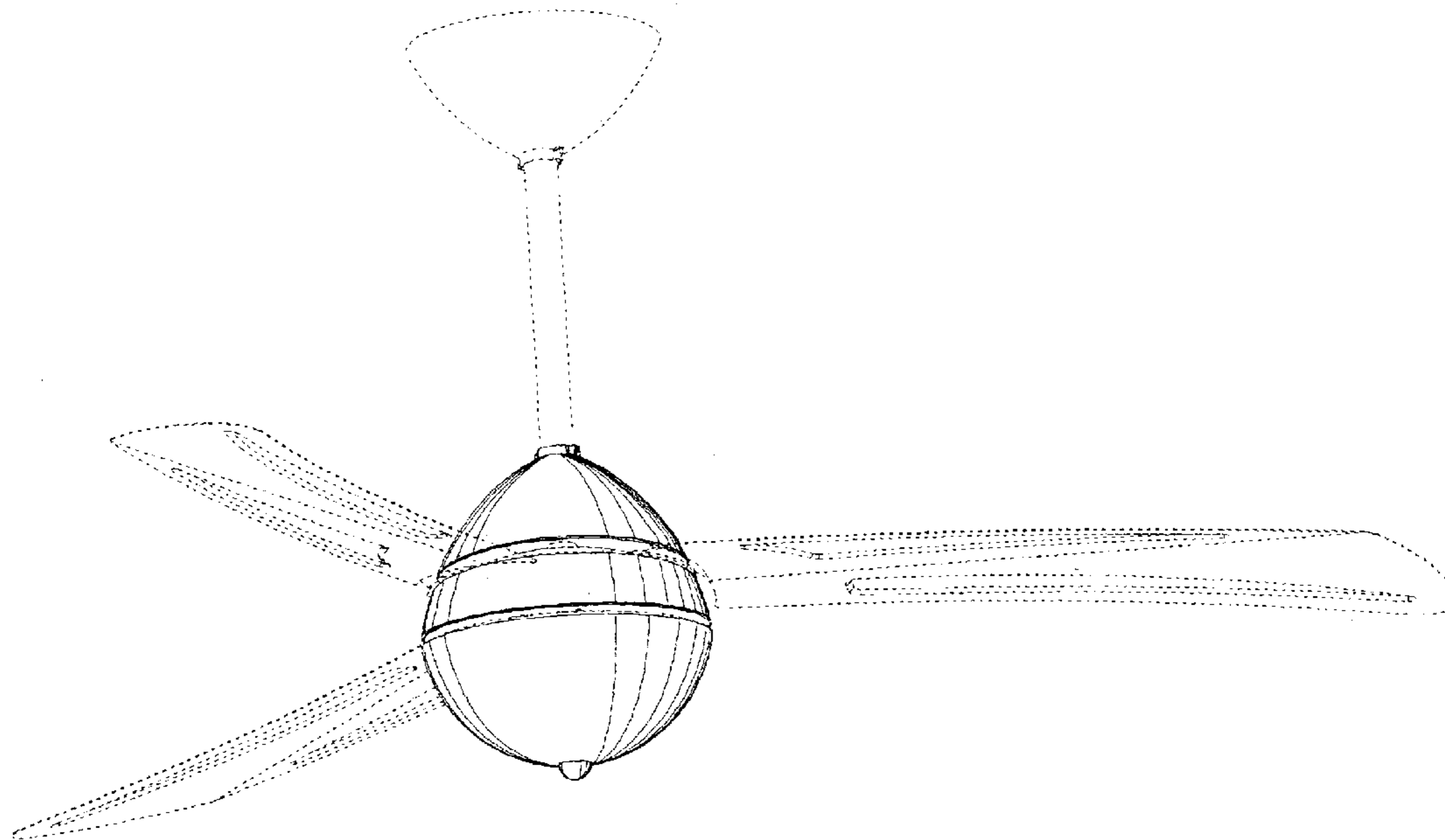

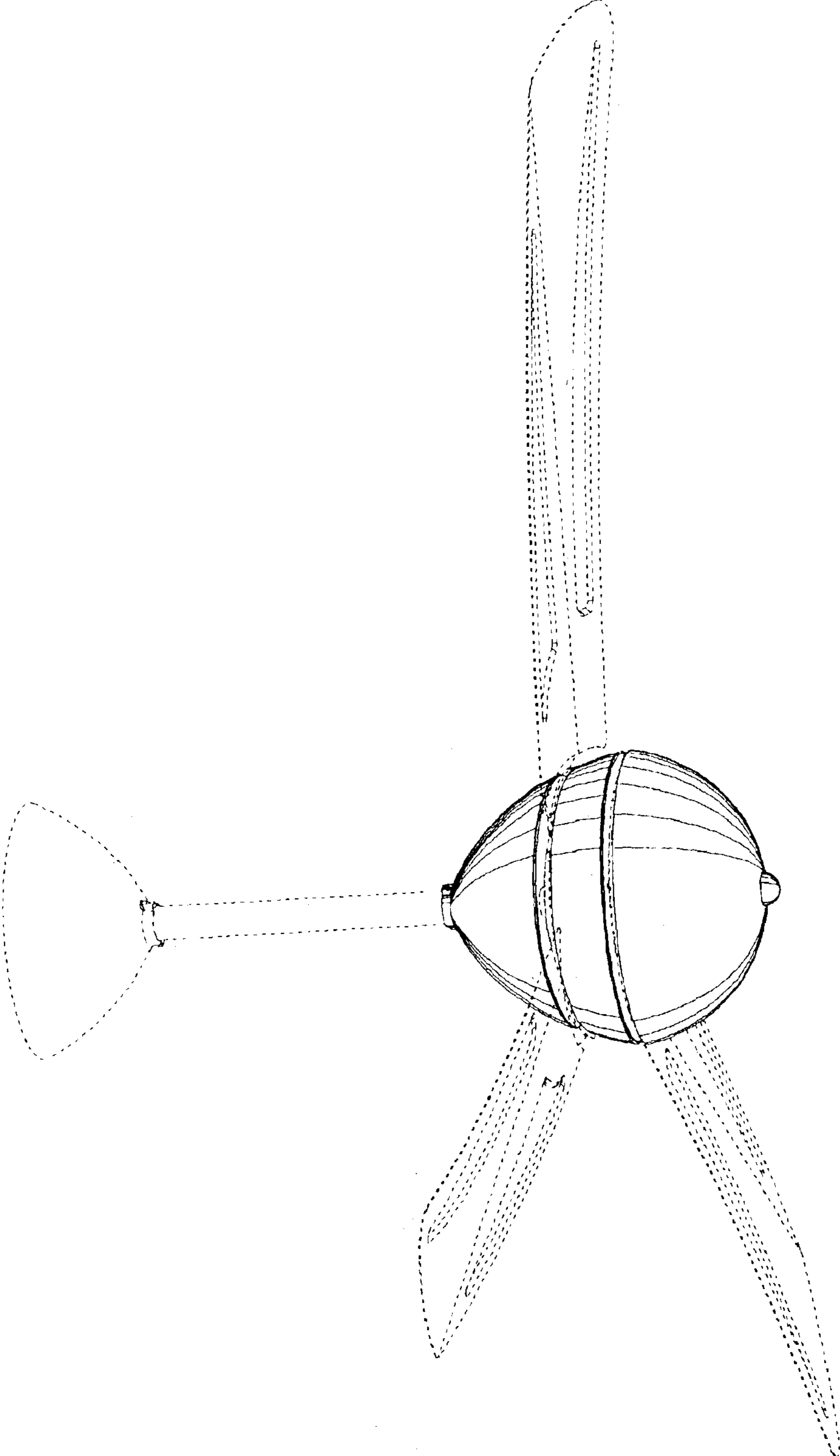

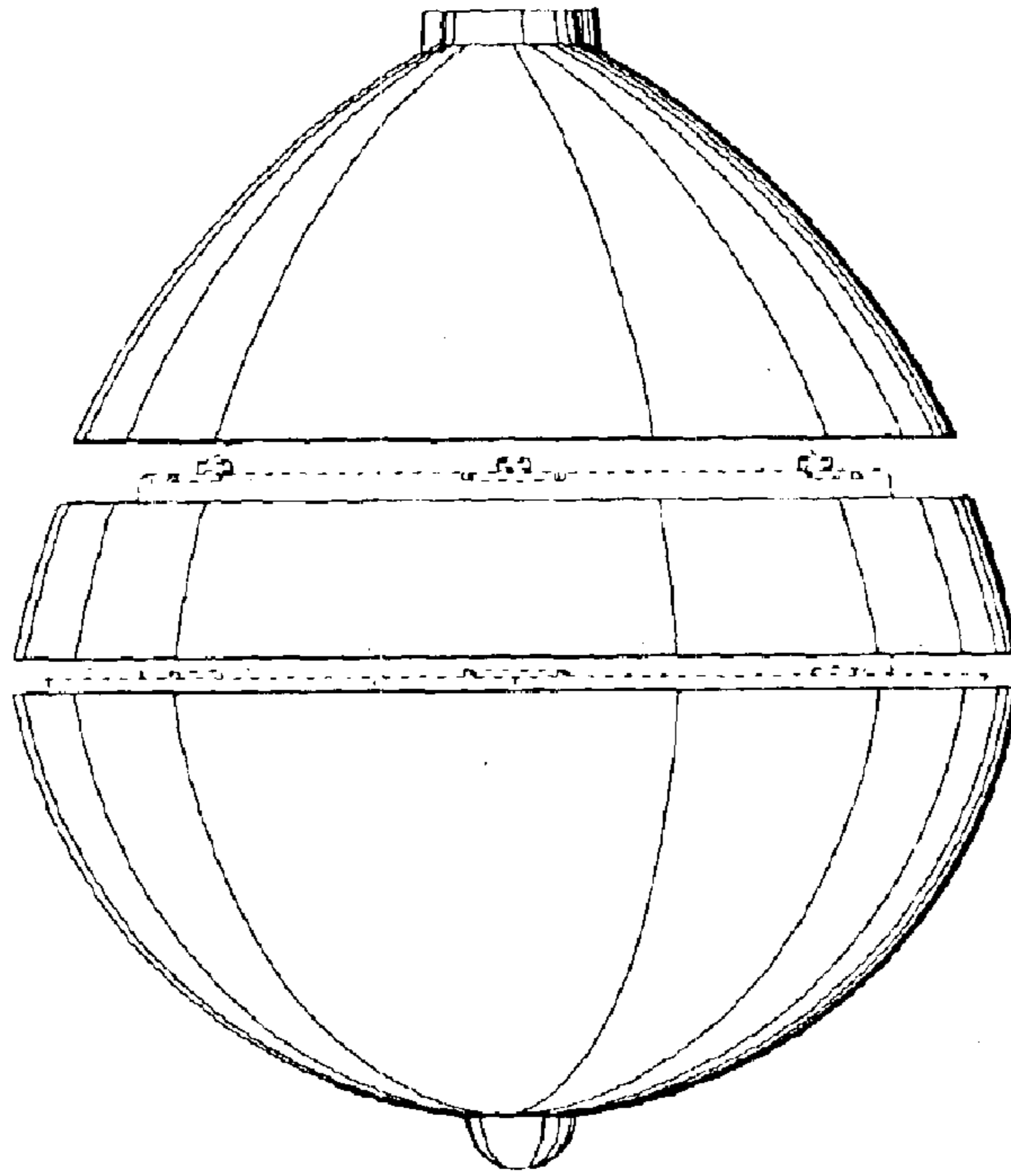

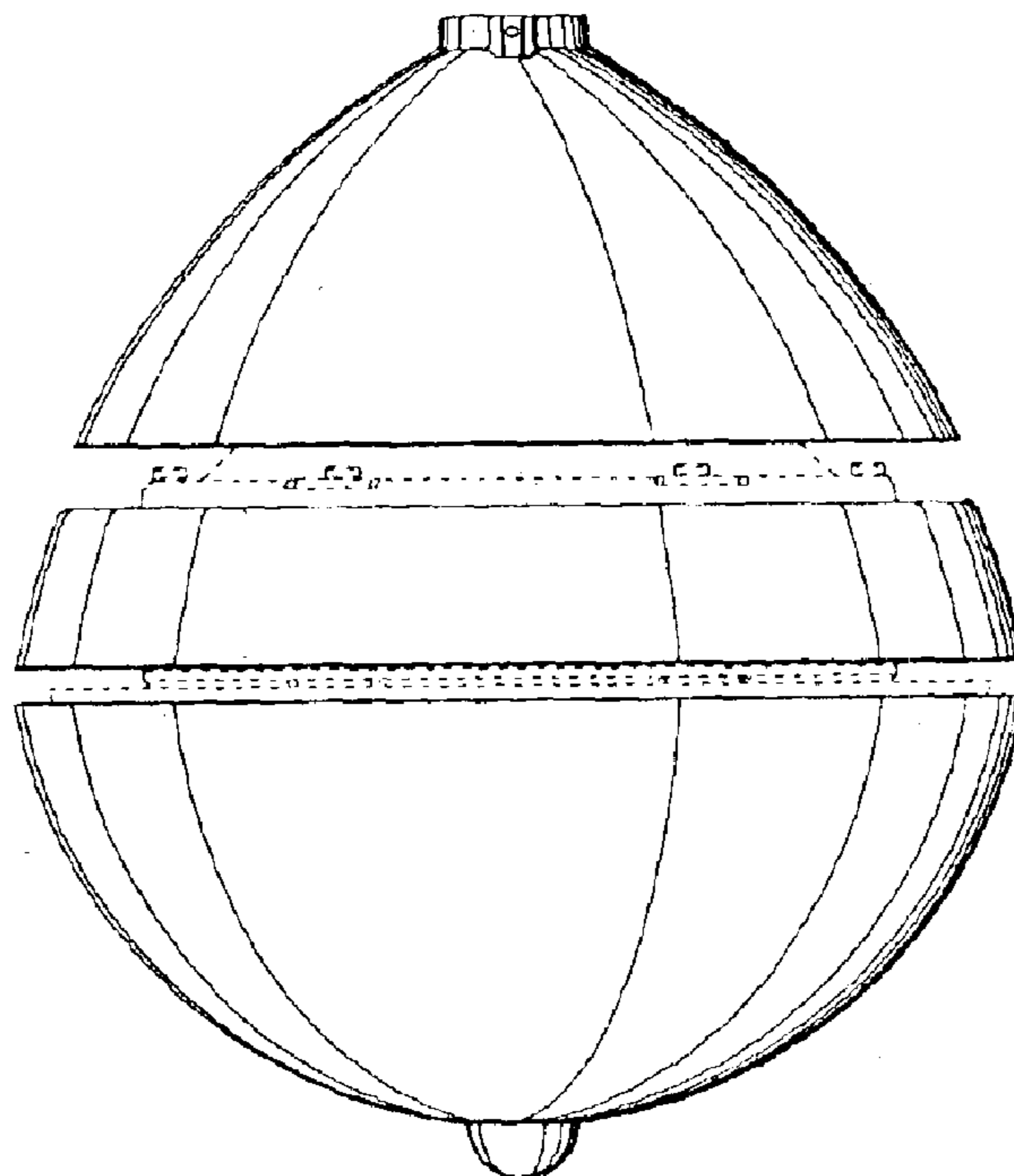

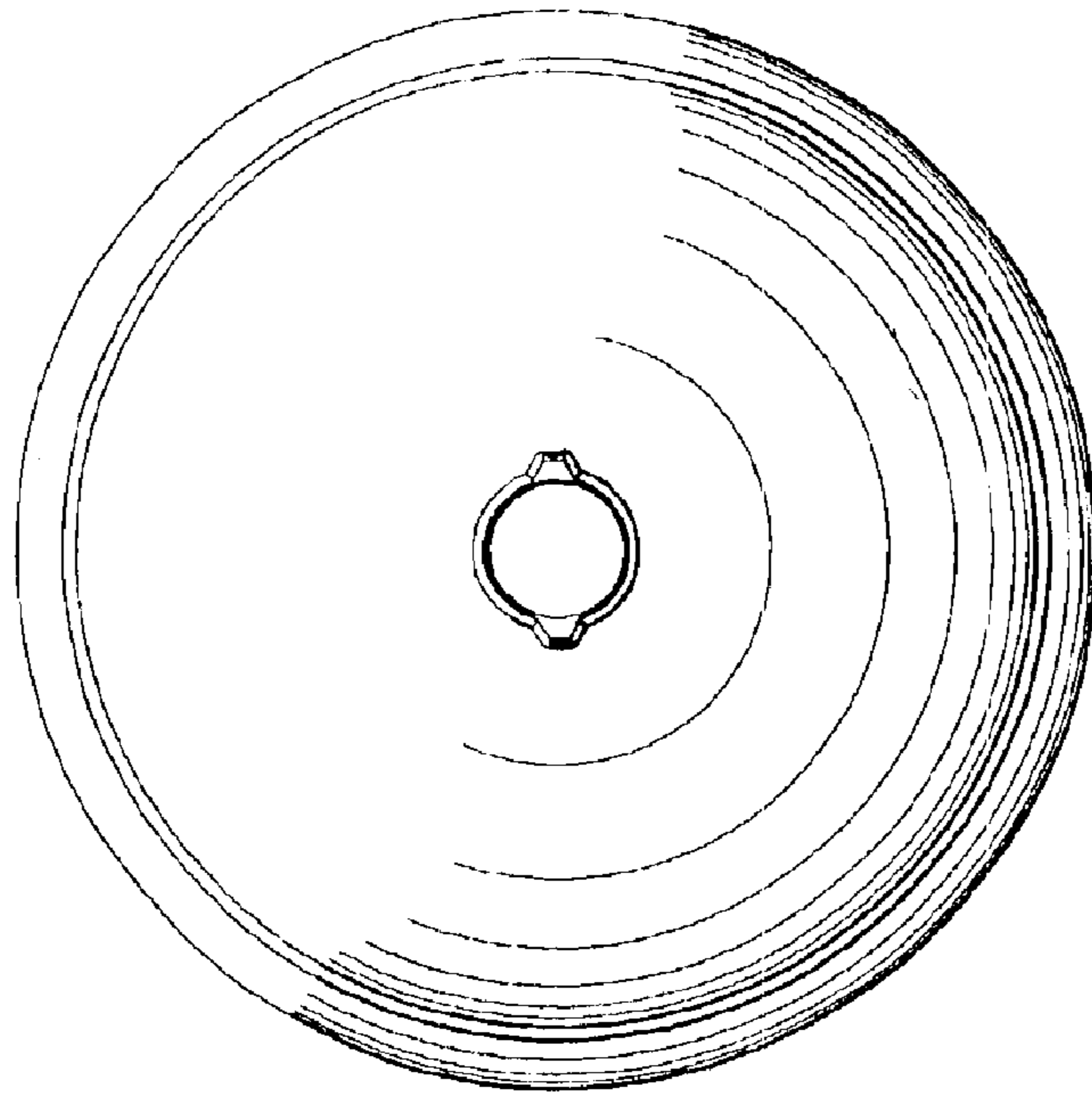
