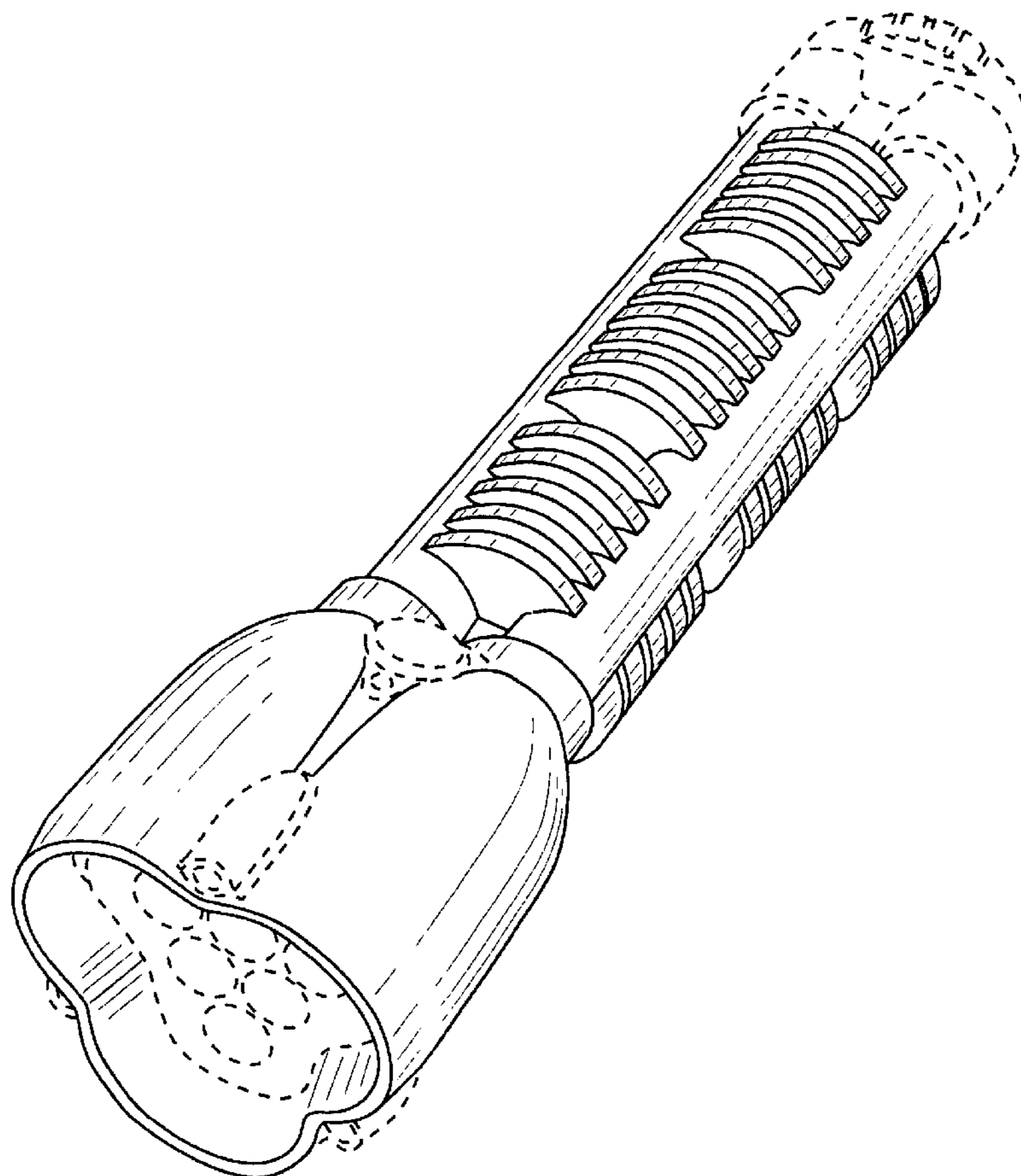
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

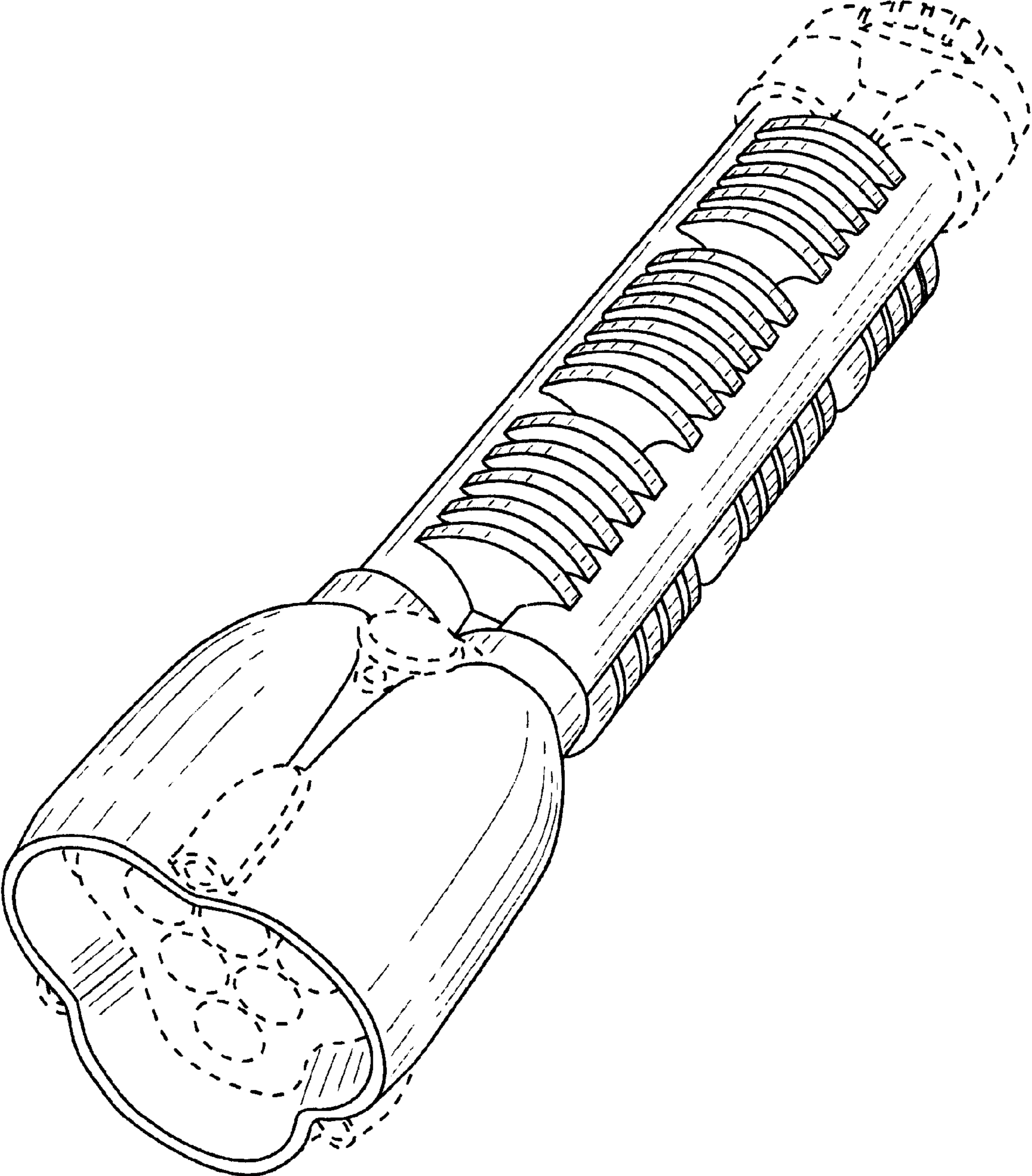

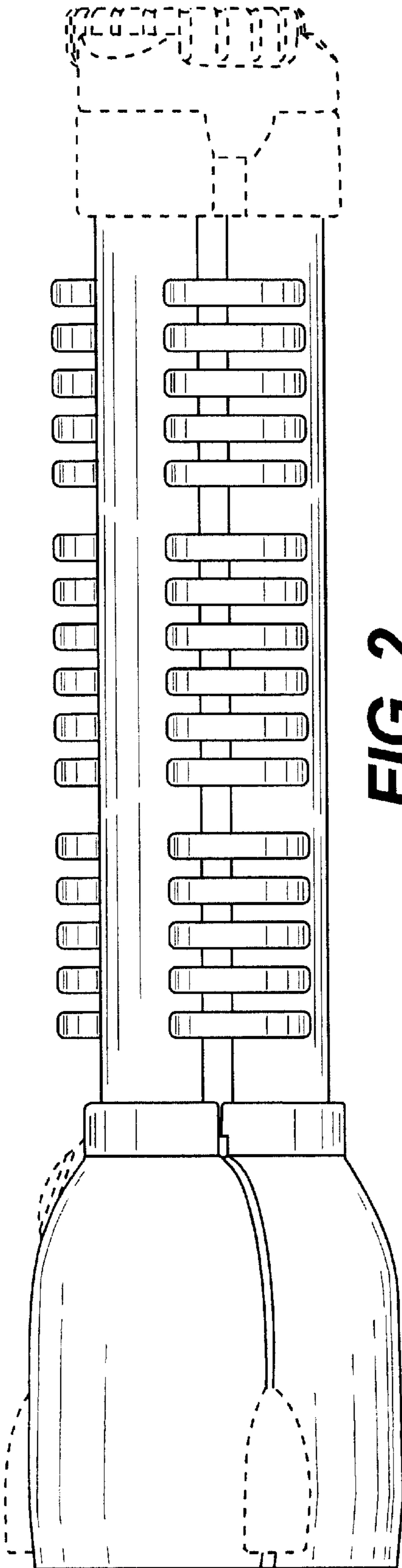

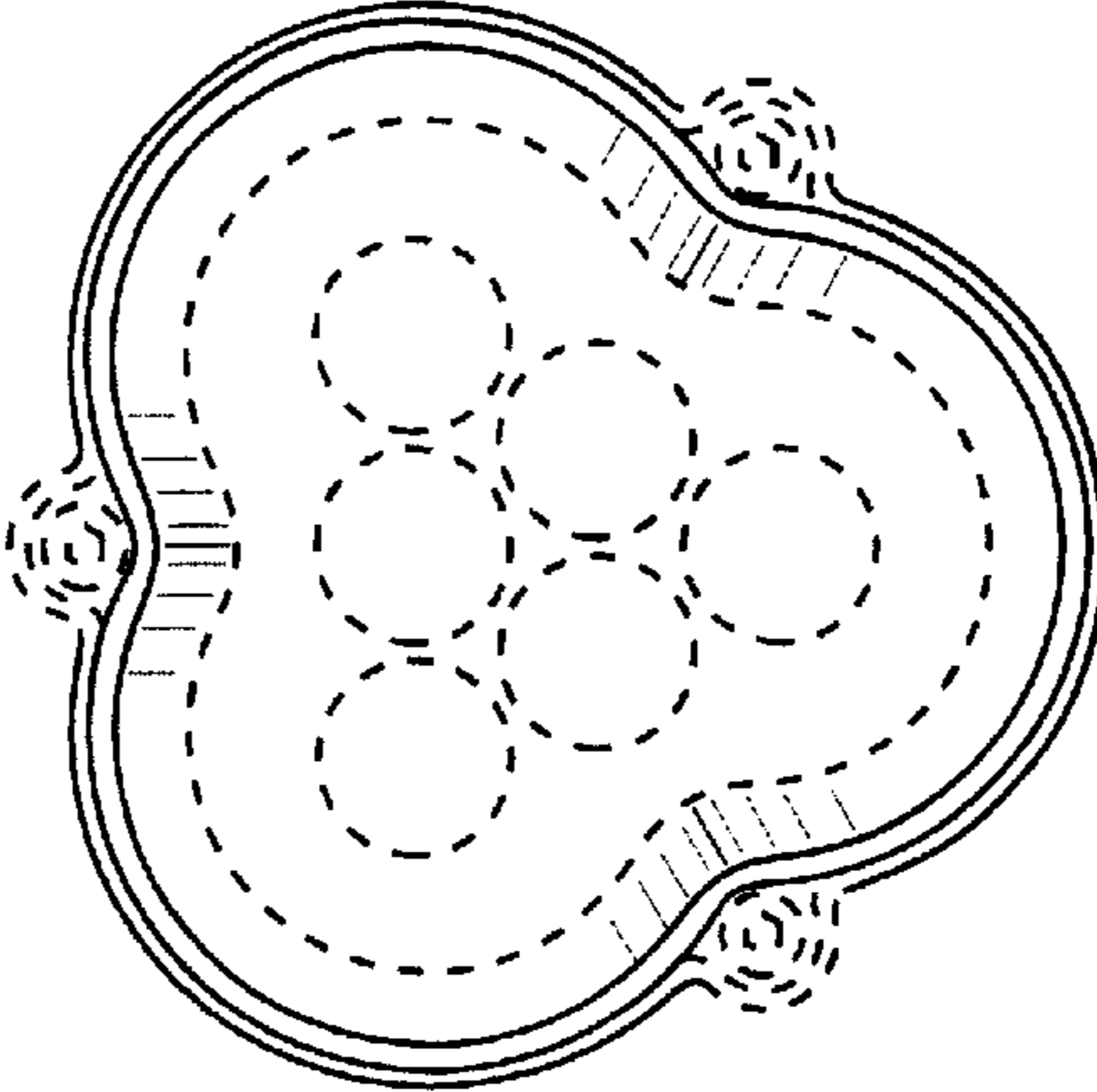

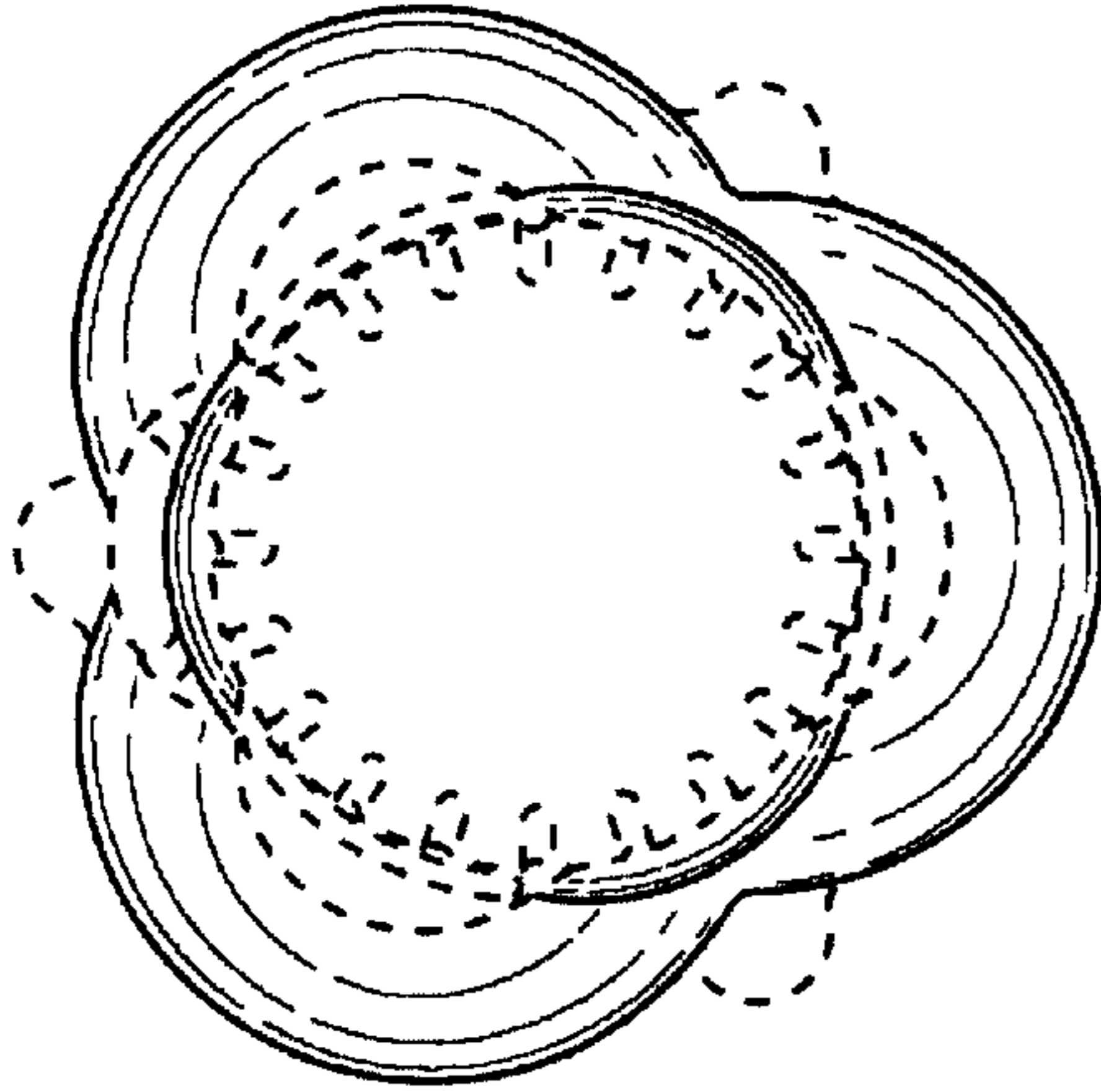

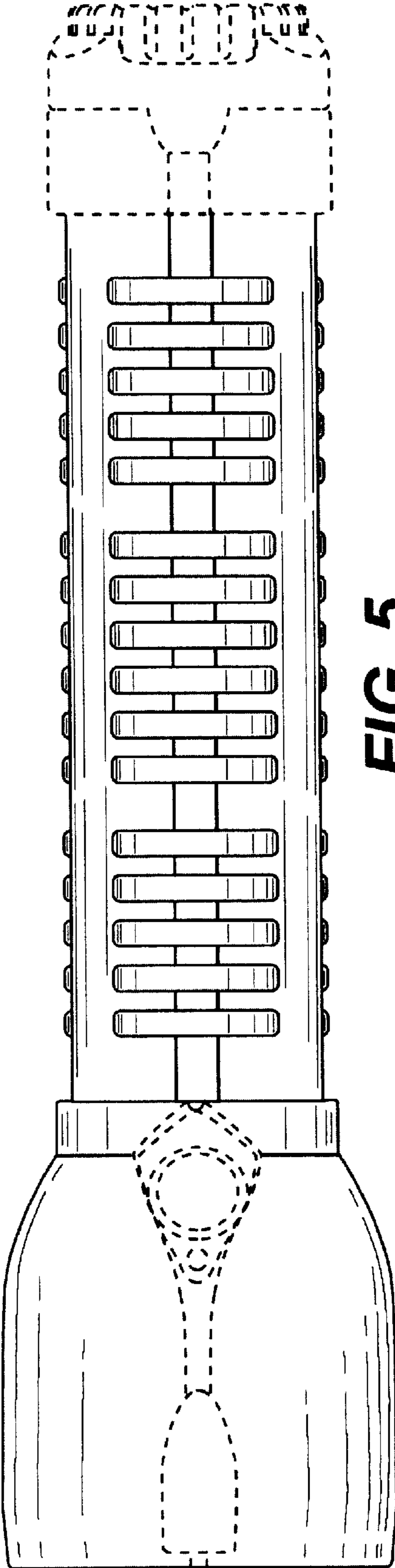
