DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of an armoire showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

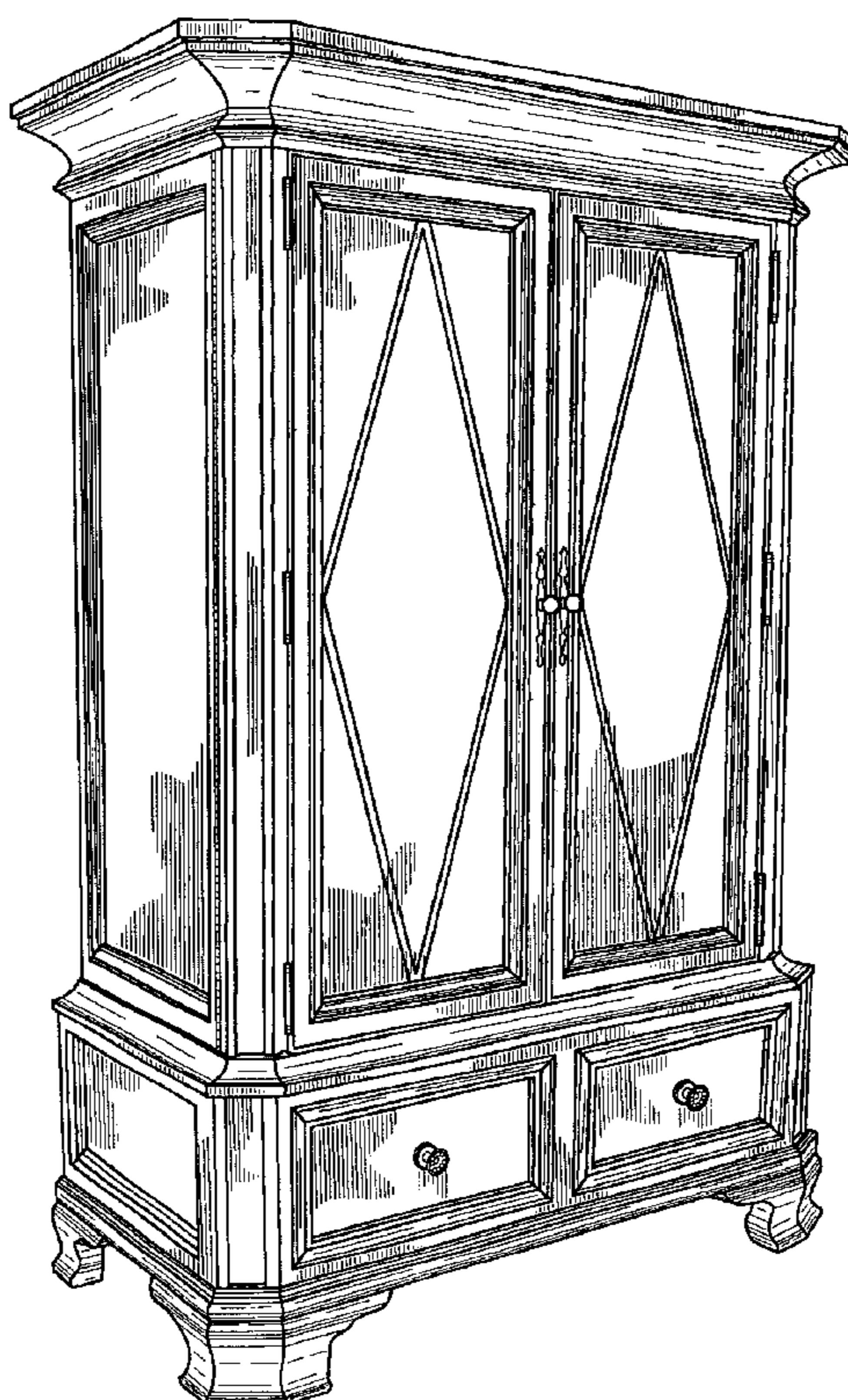
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

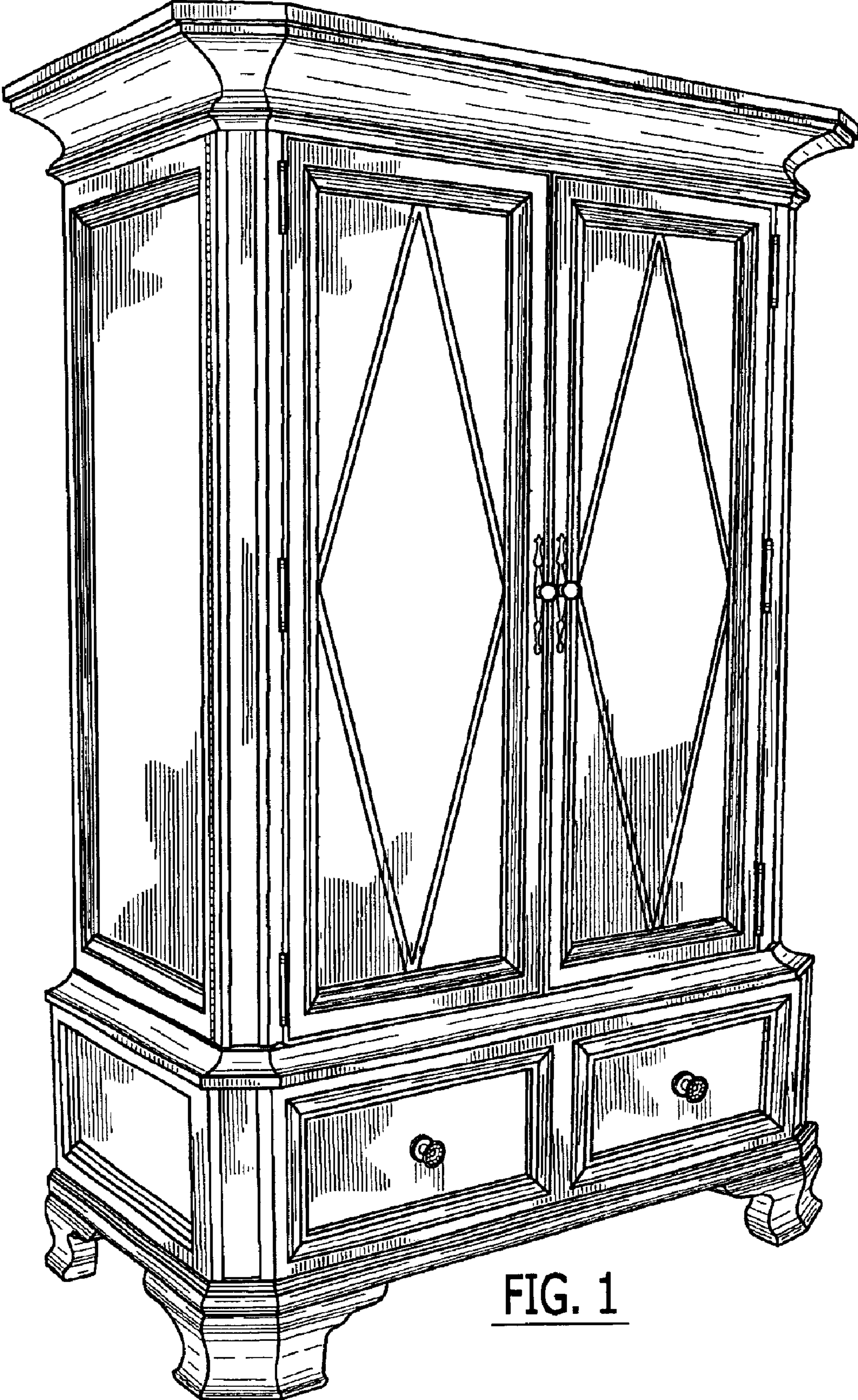

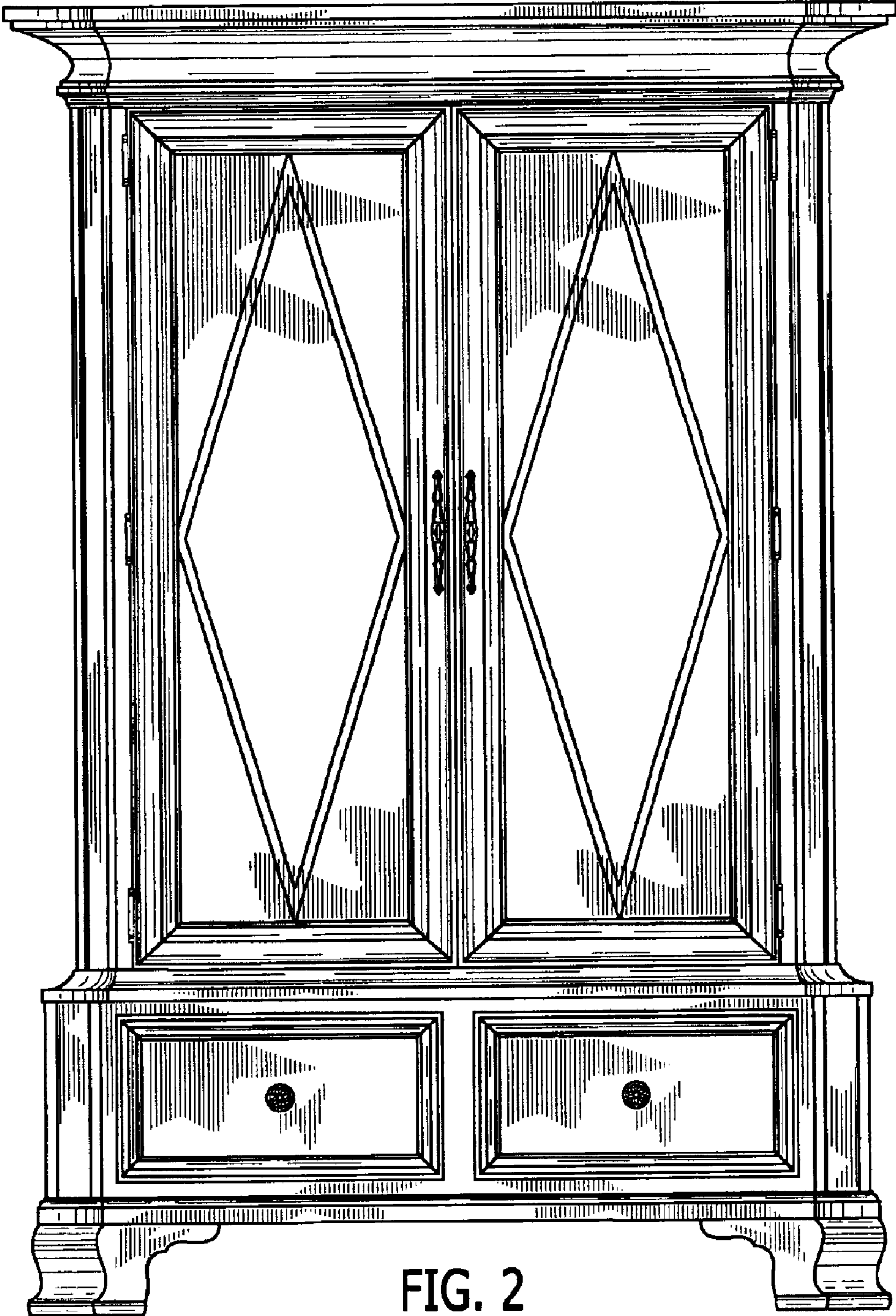

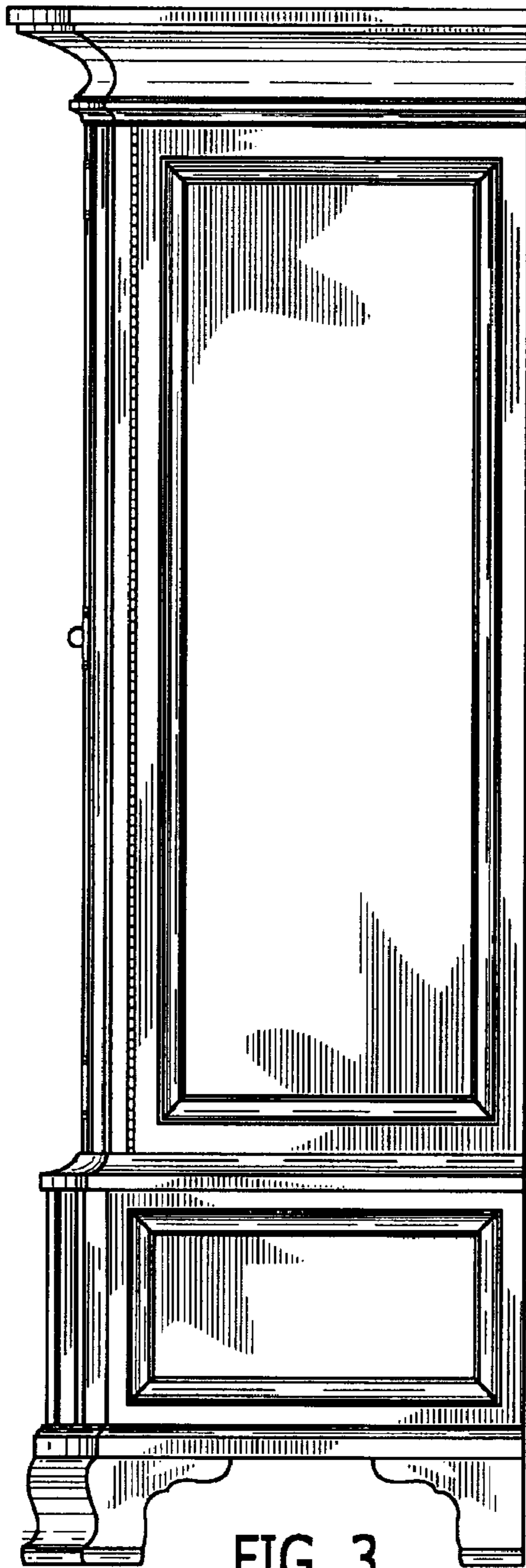

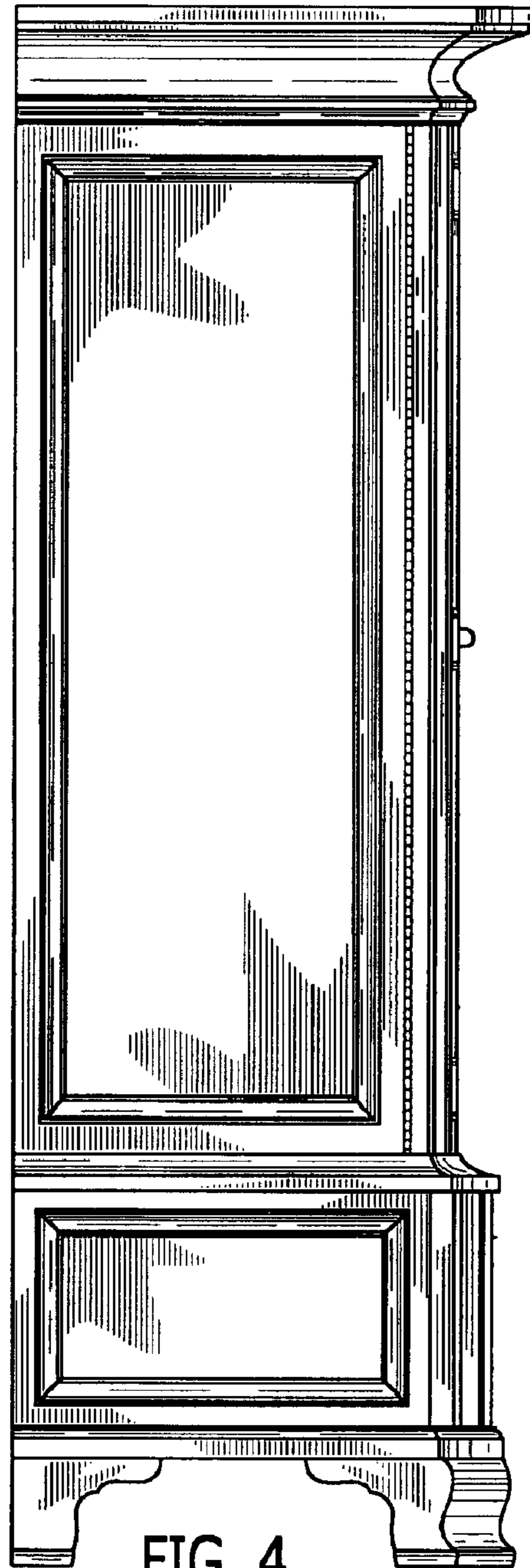

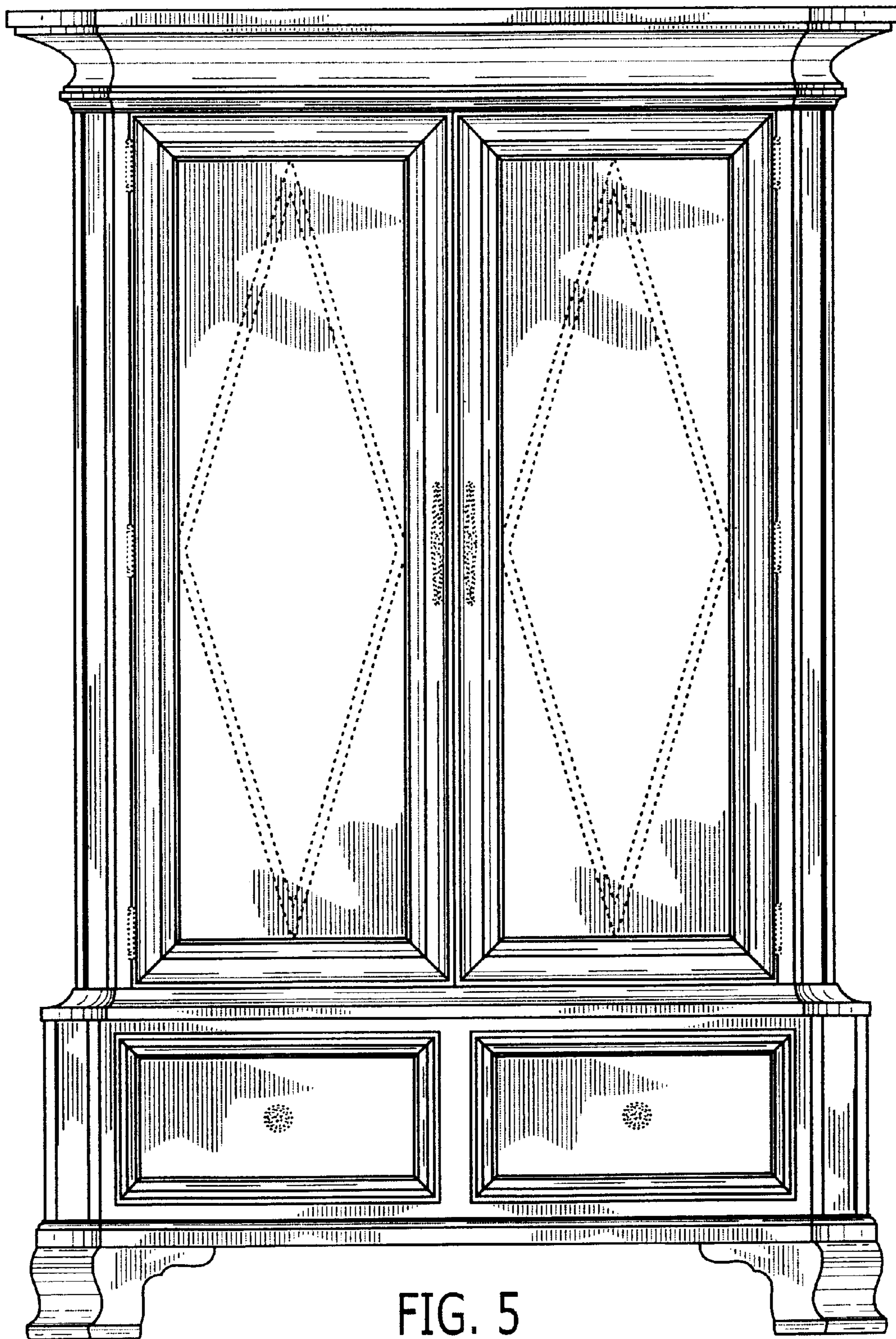
