(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a display for a tester device, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

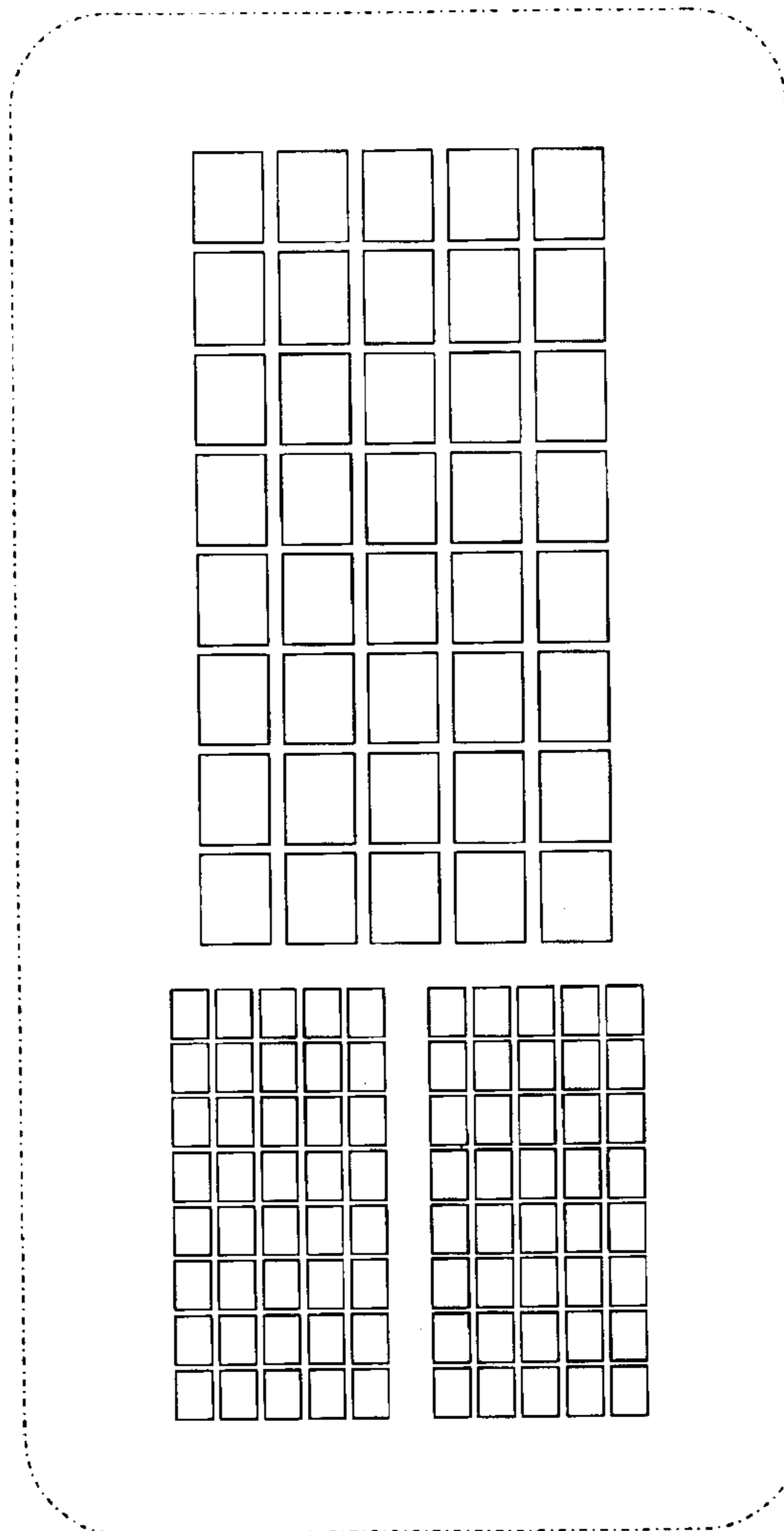
